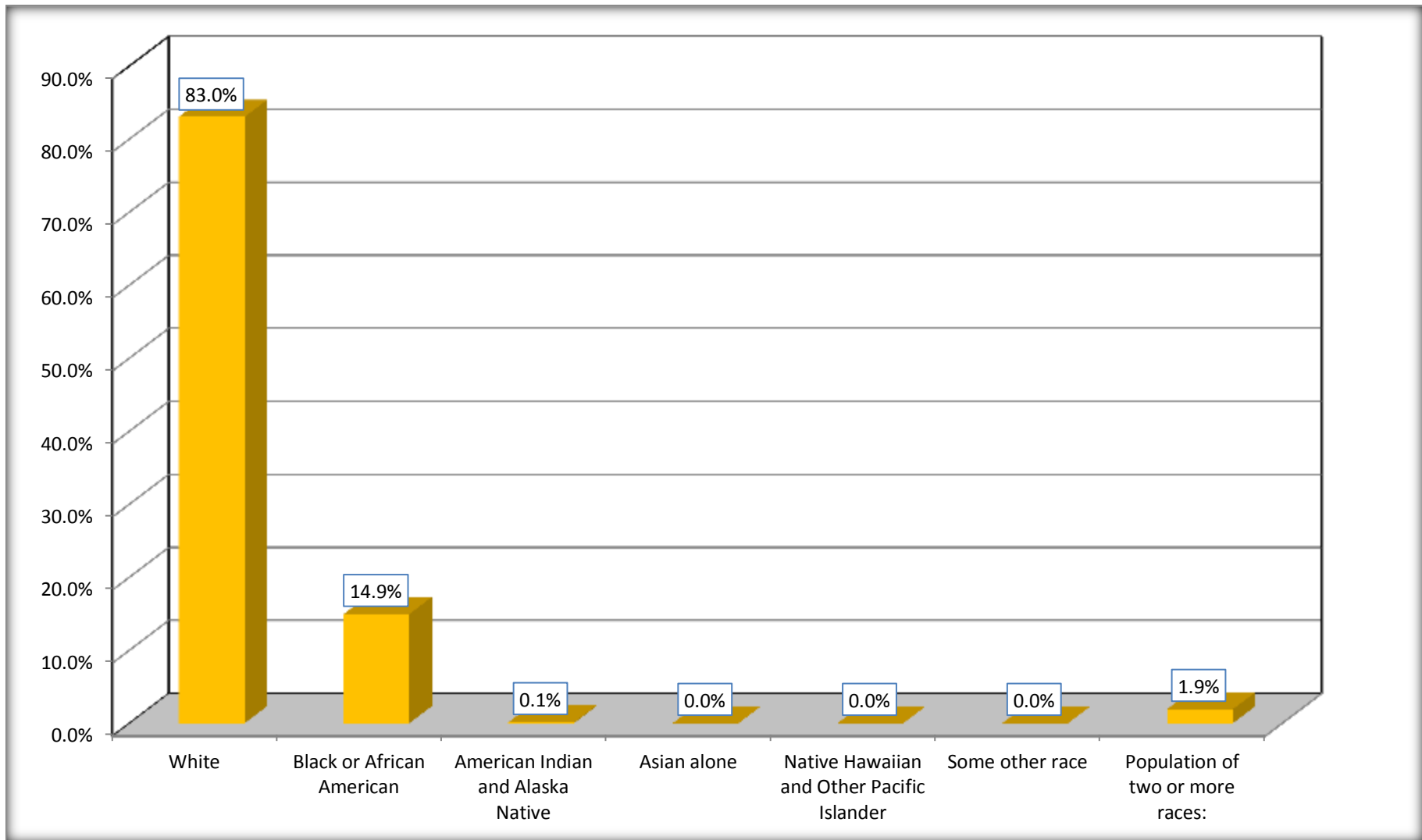

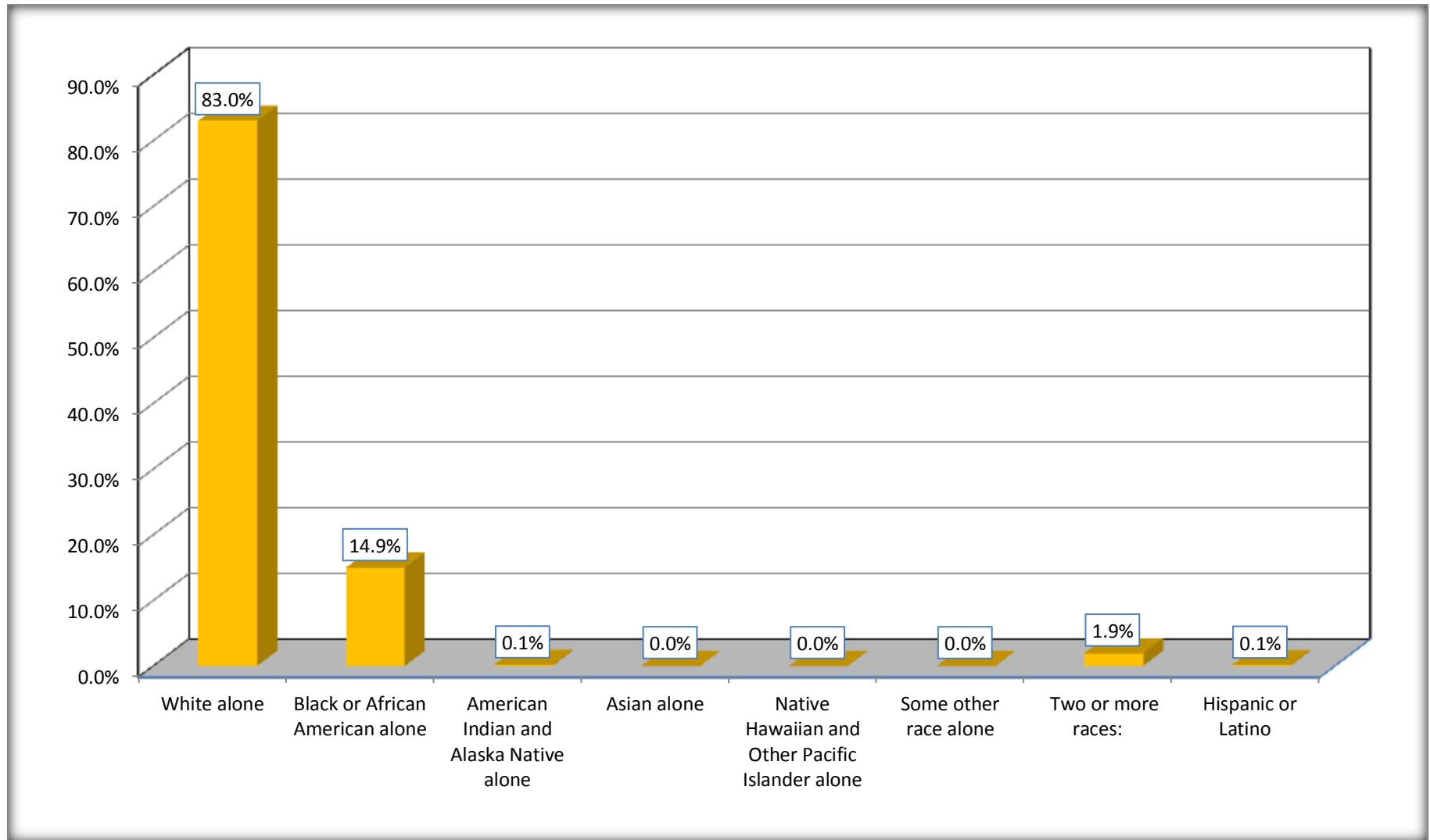
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# Non-Hispanic by Race and Hispanic Population

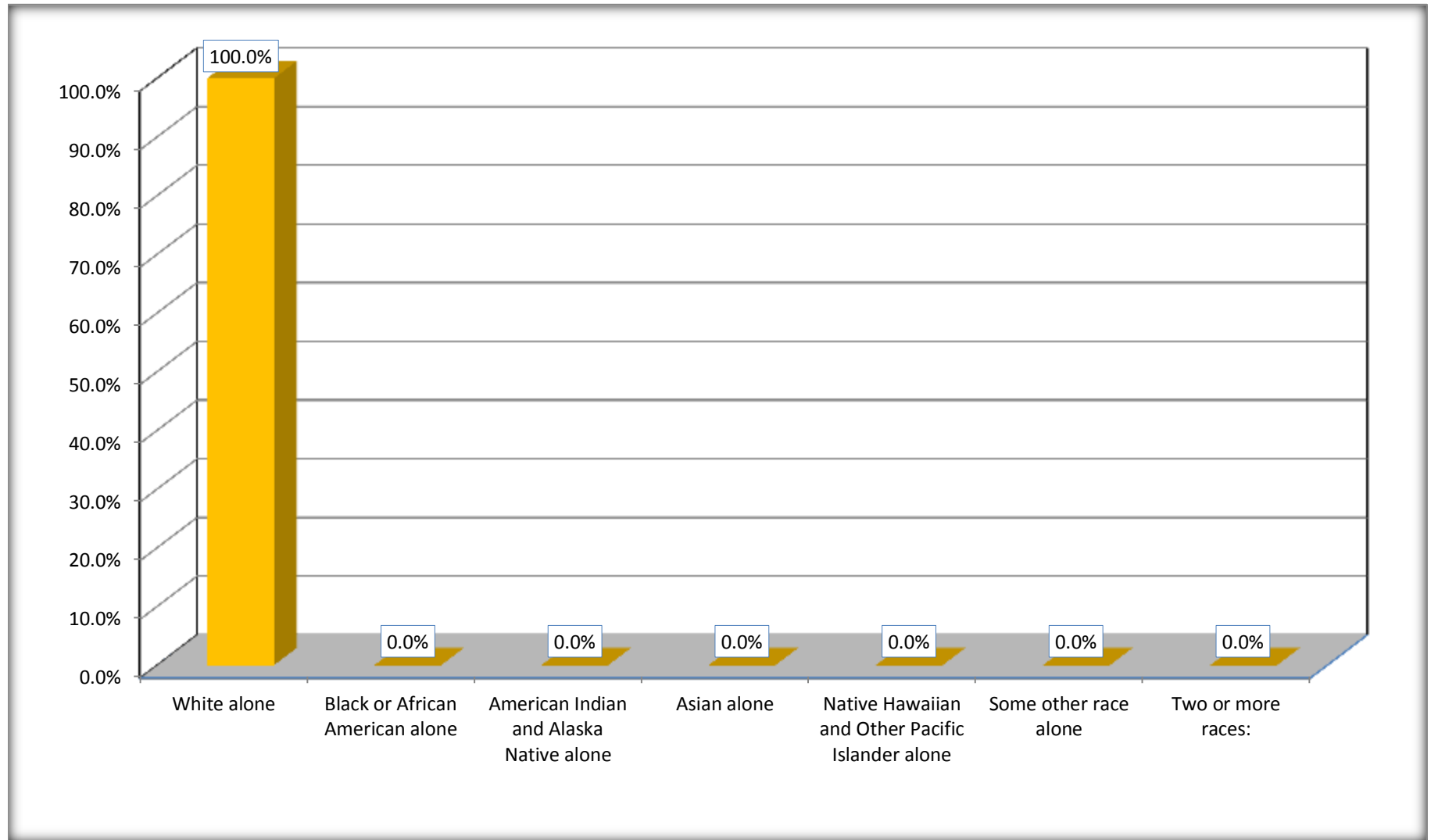
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# Hispanic or Latino Origin by Race

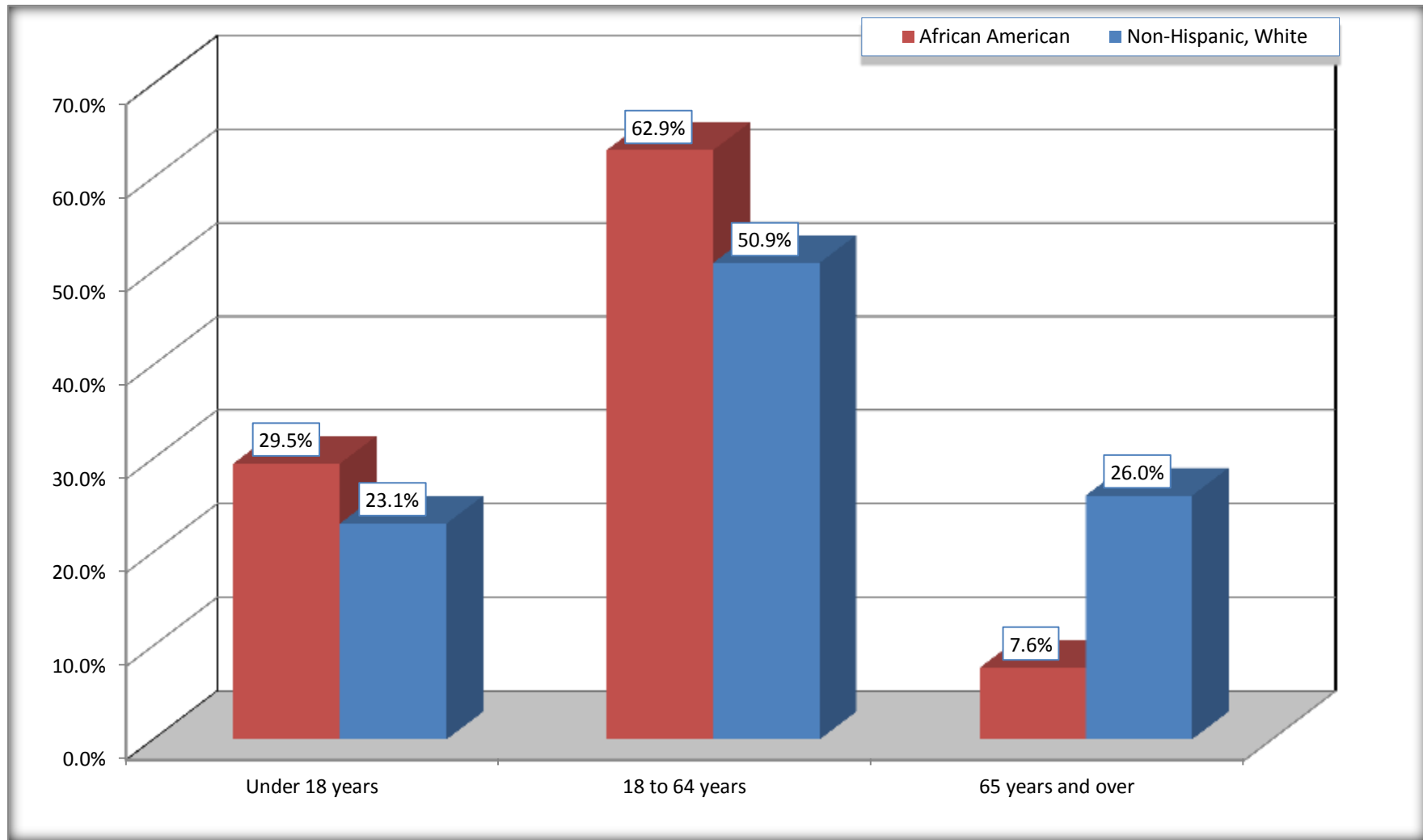
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## Population by Age

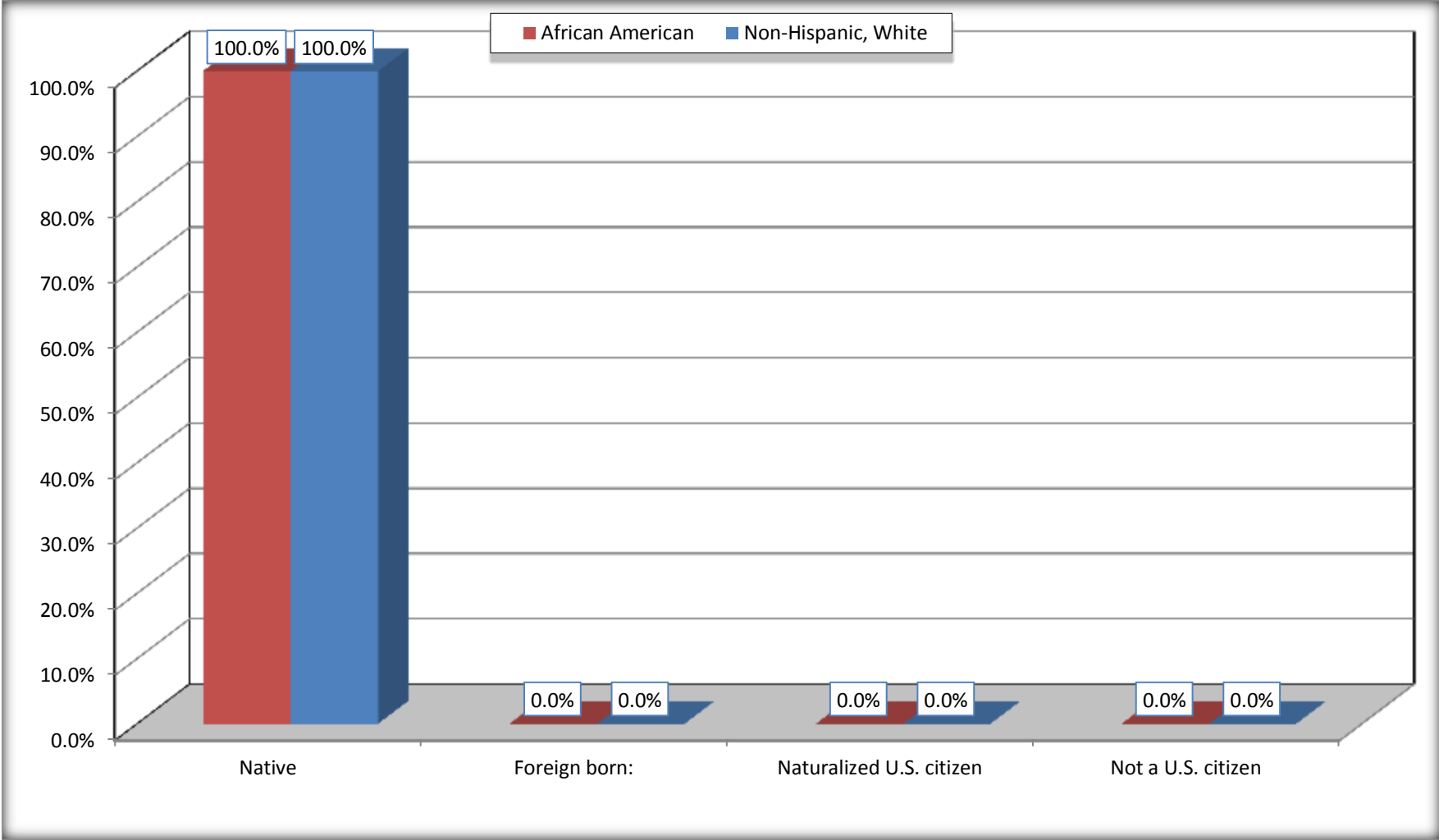

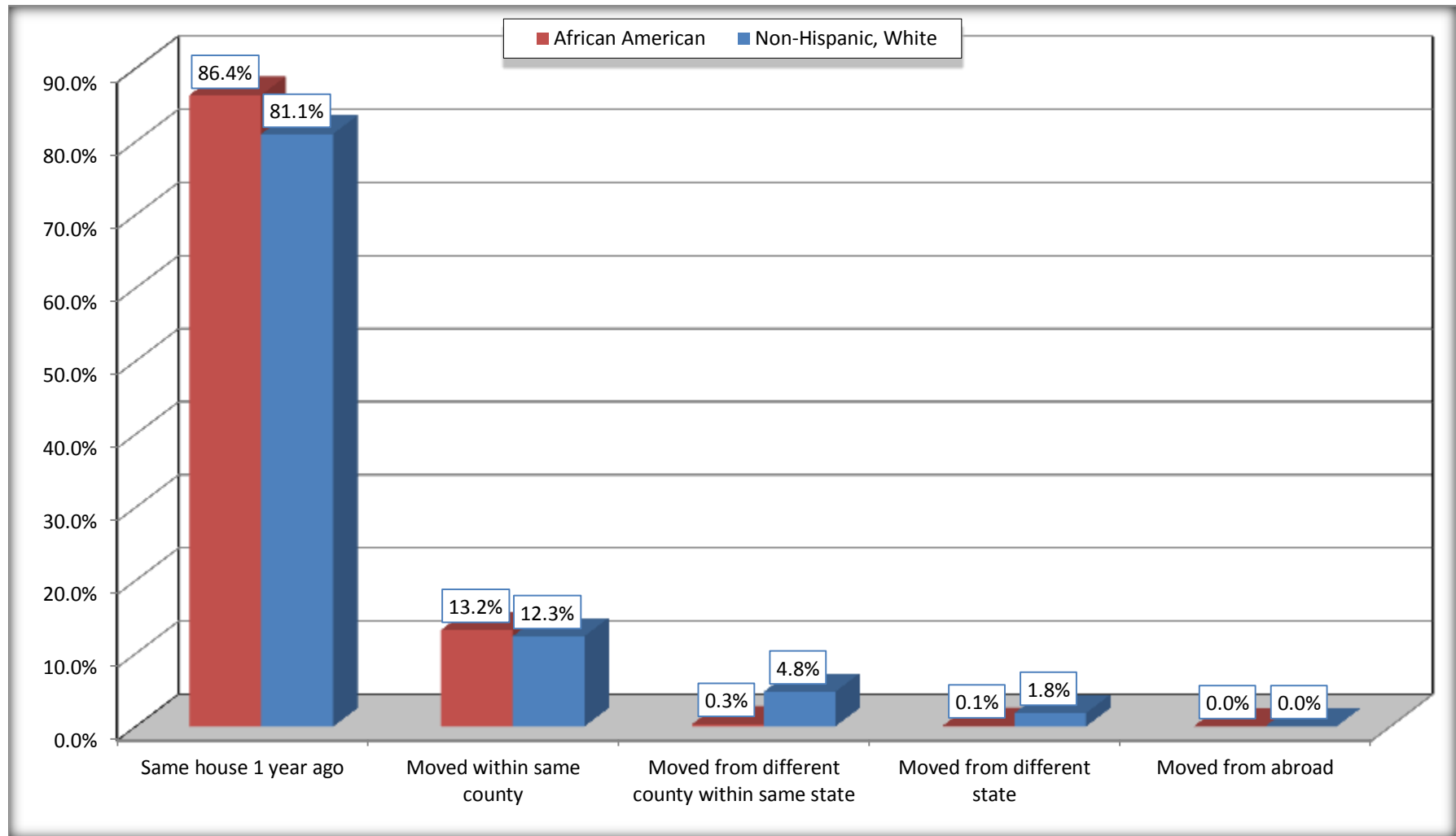

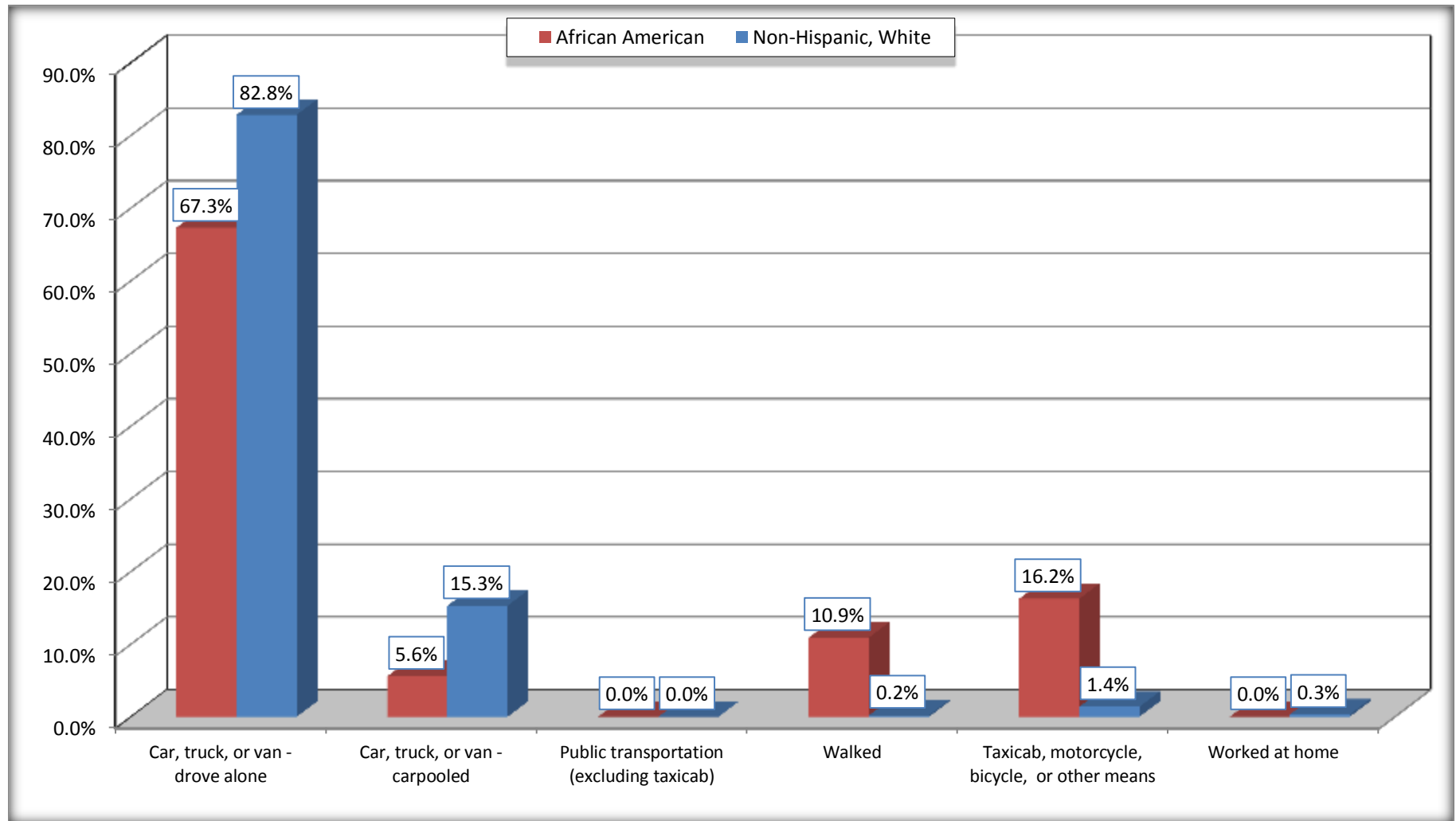

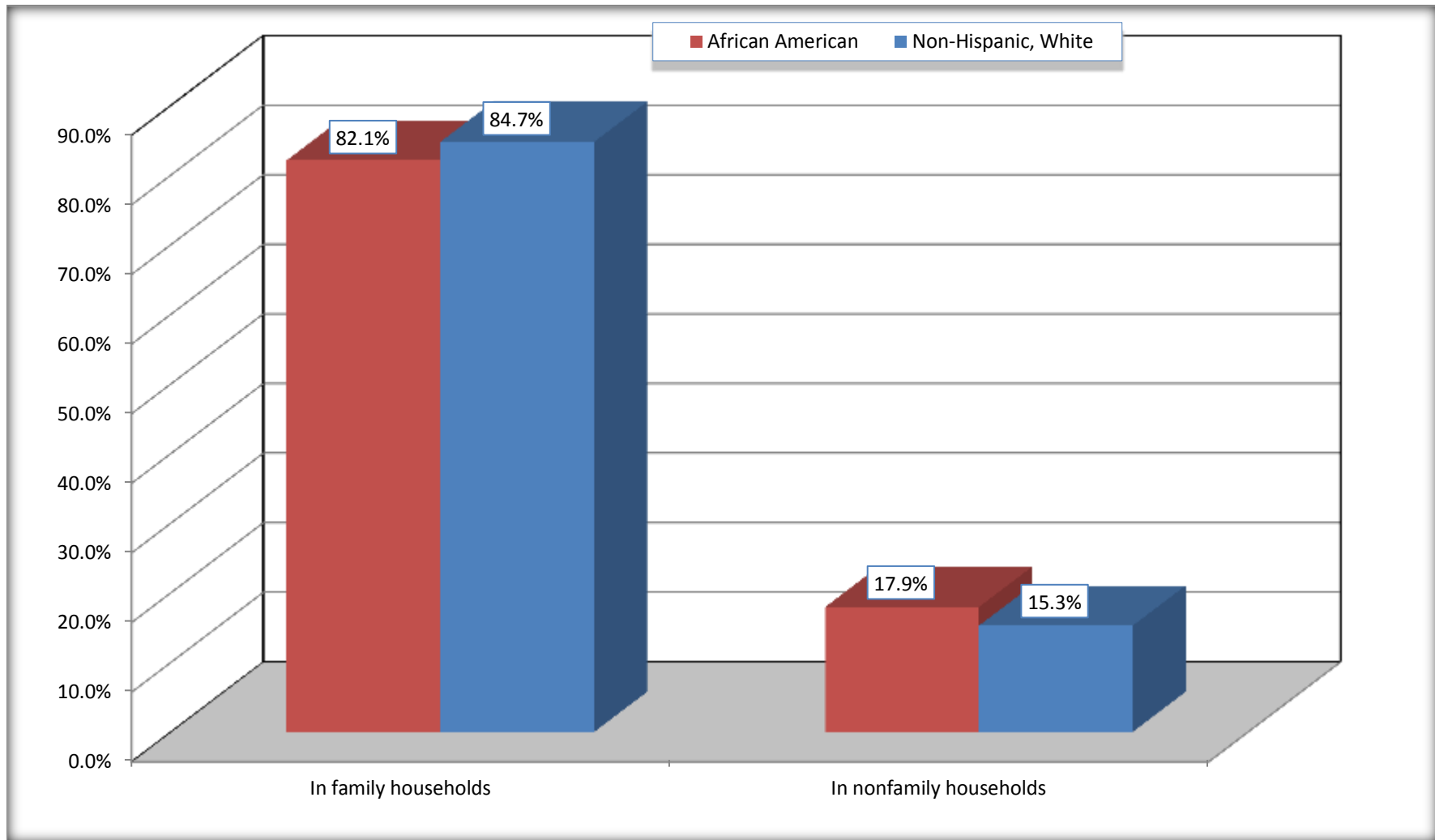

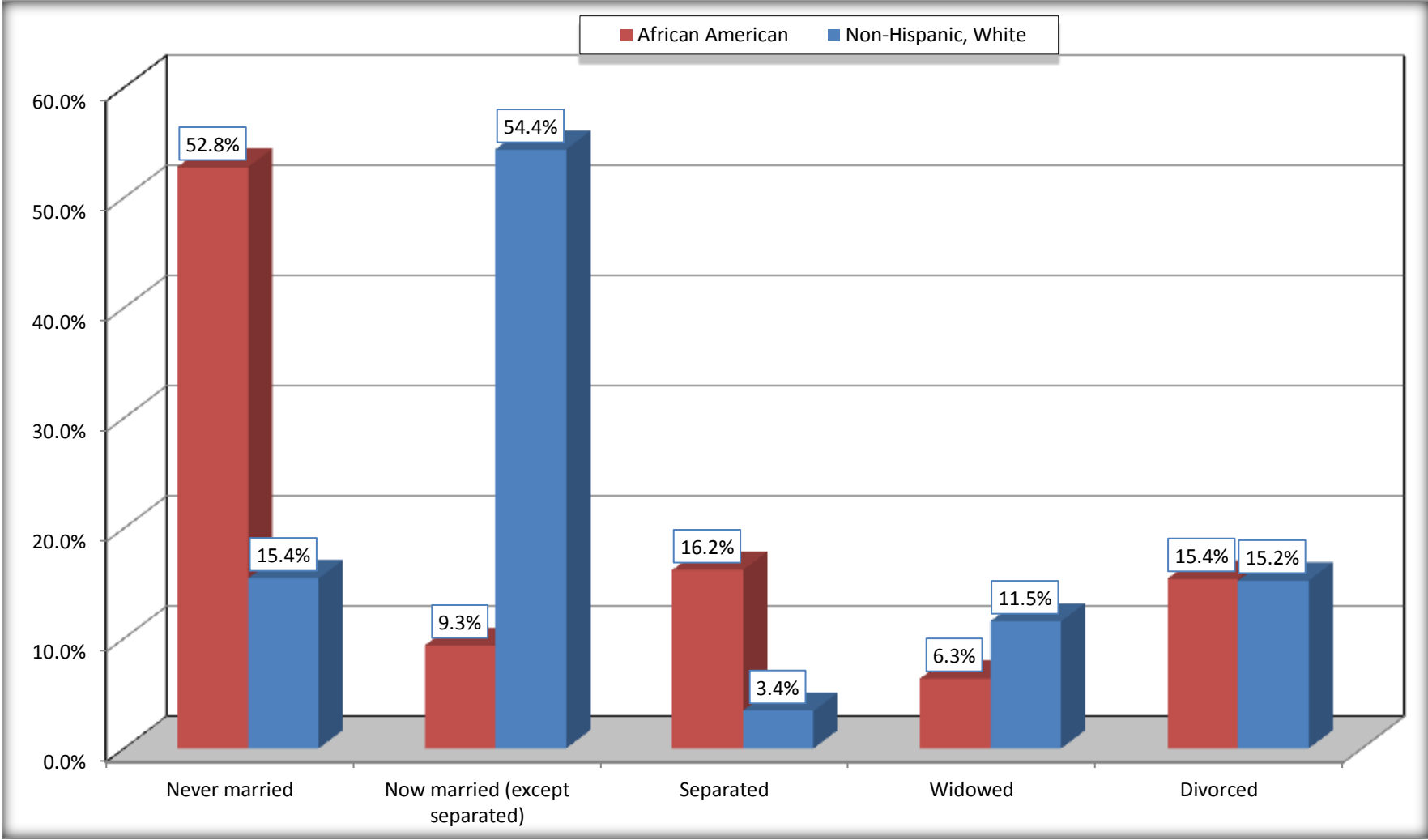

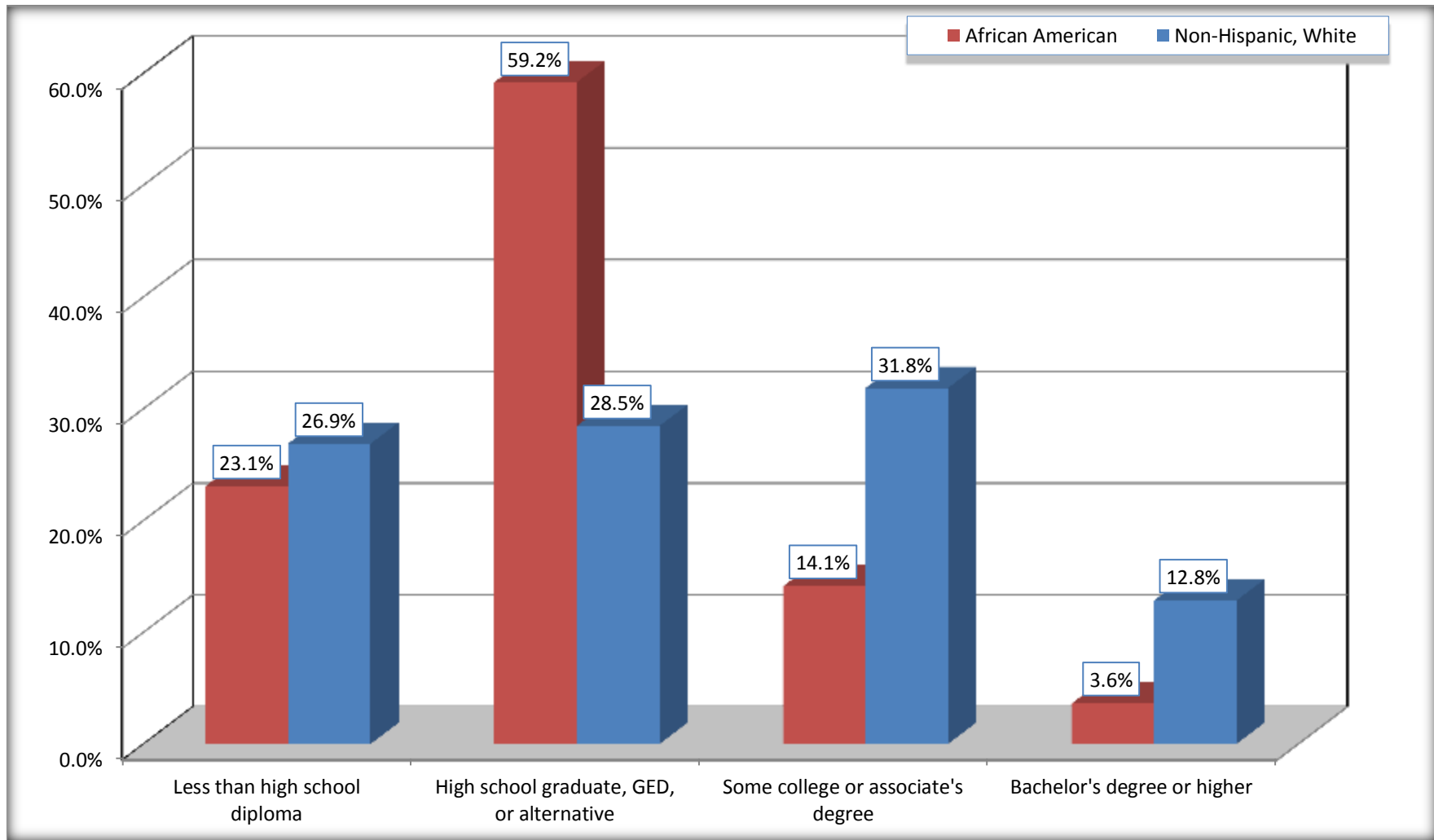

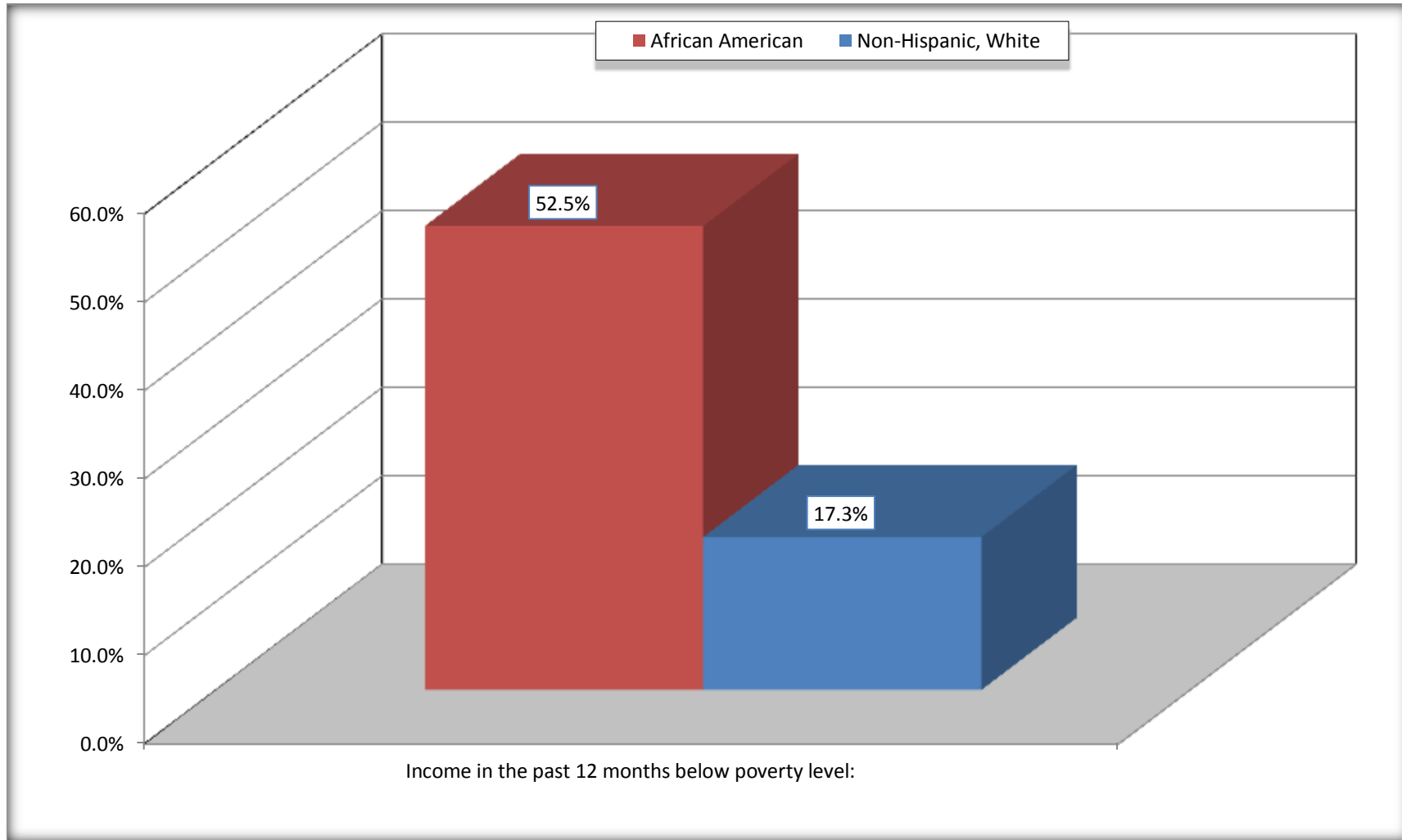

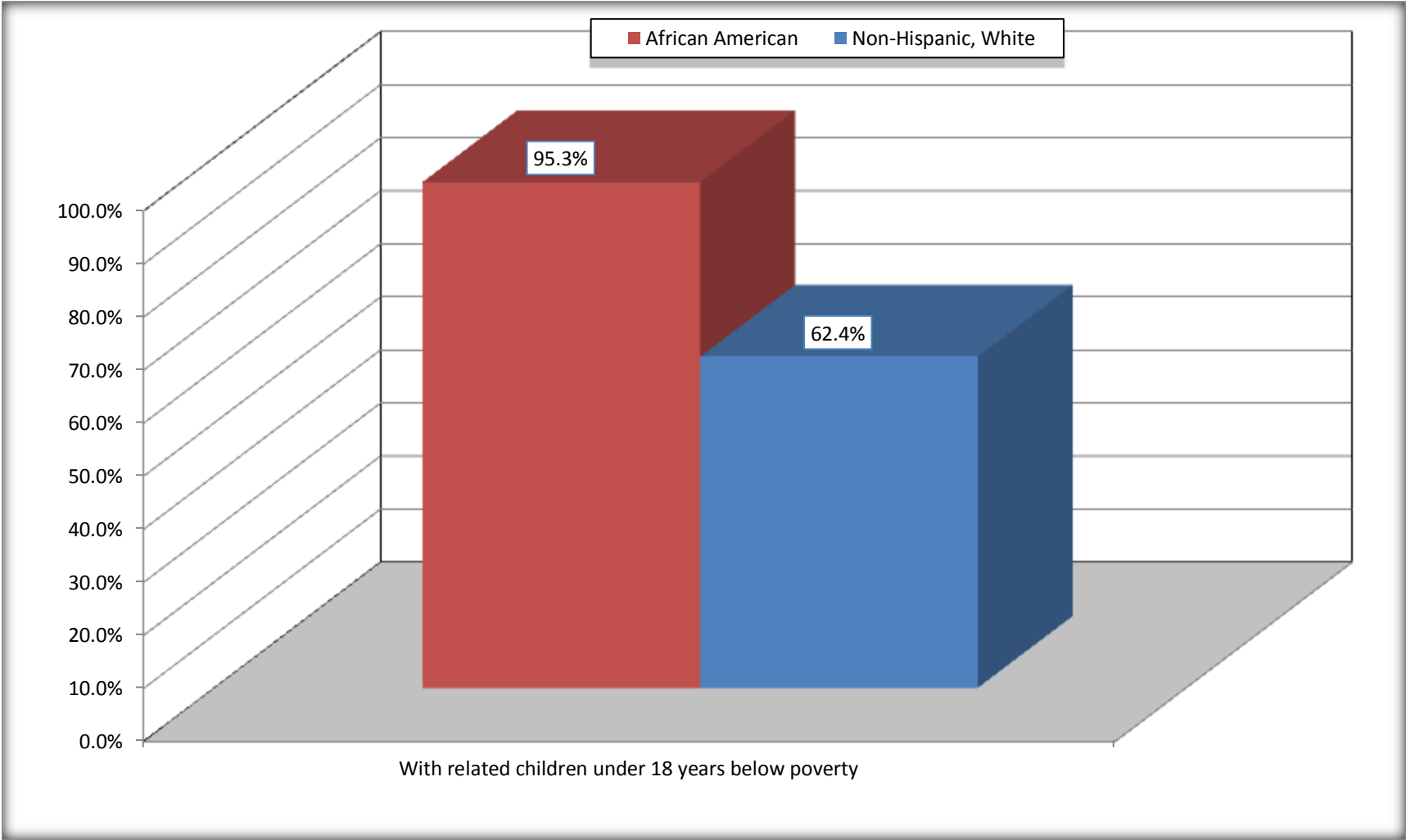

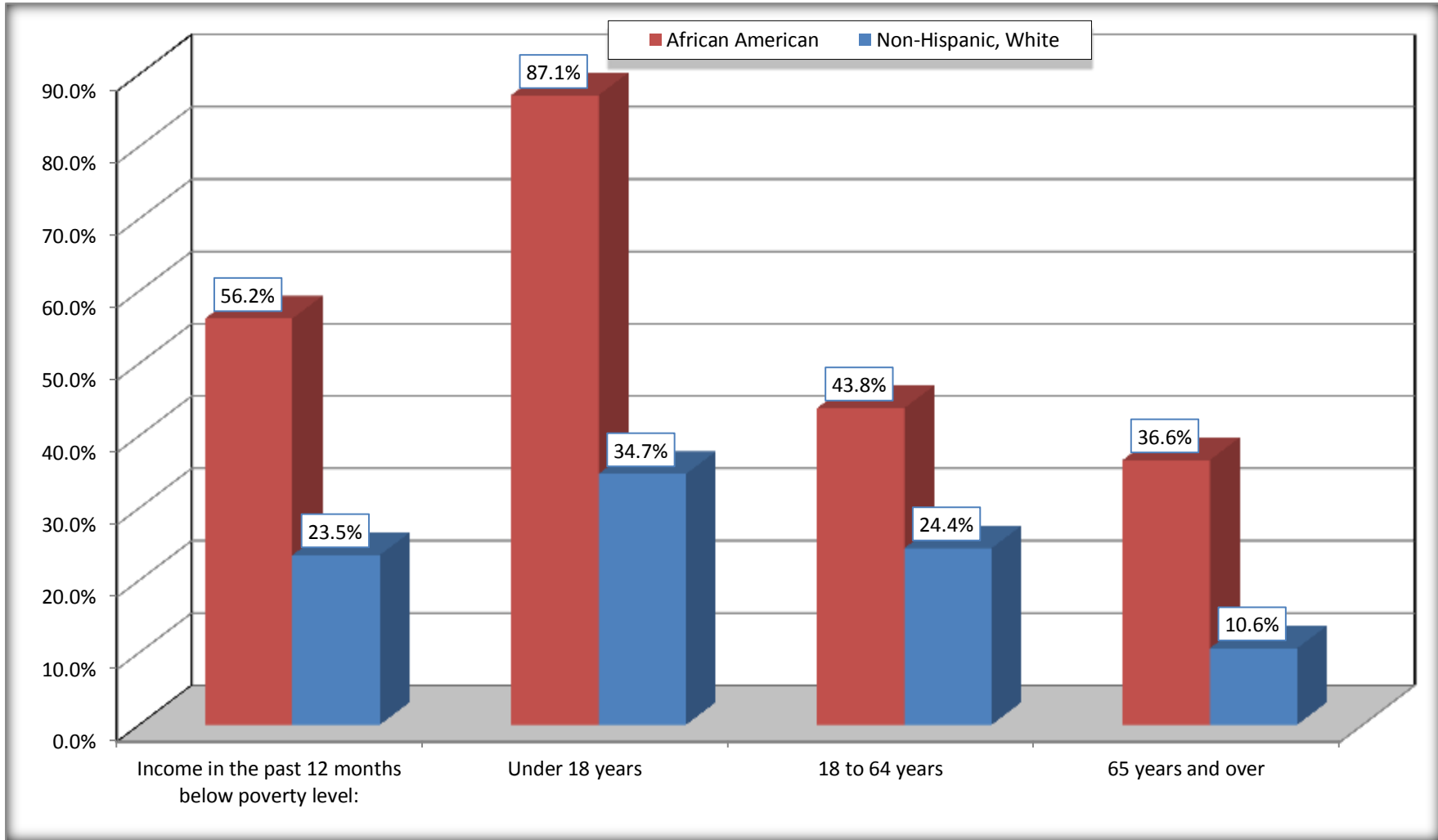

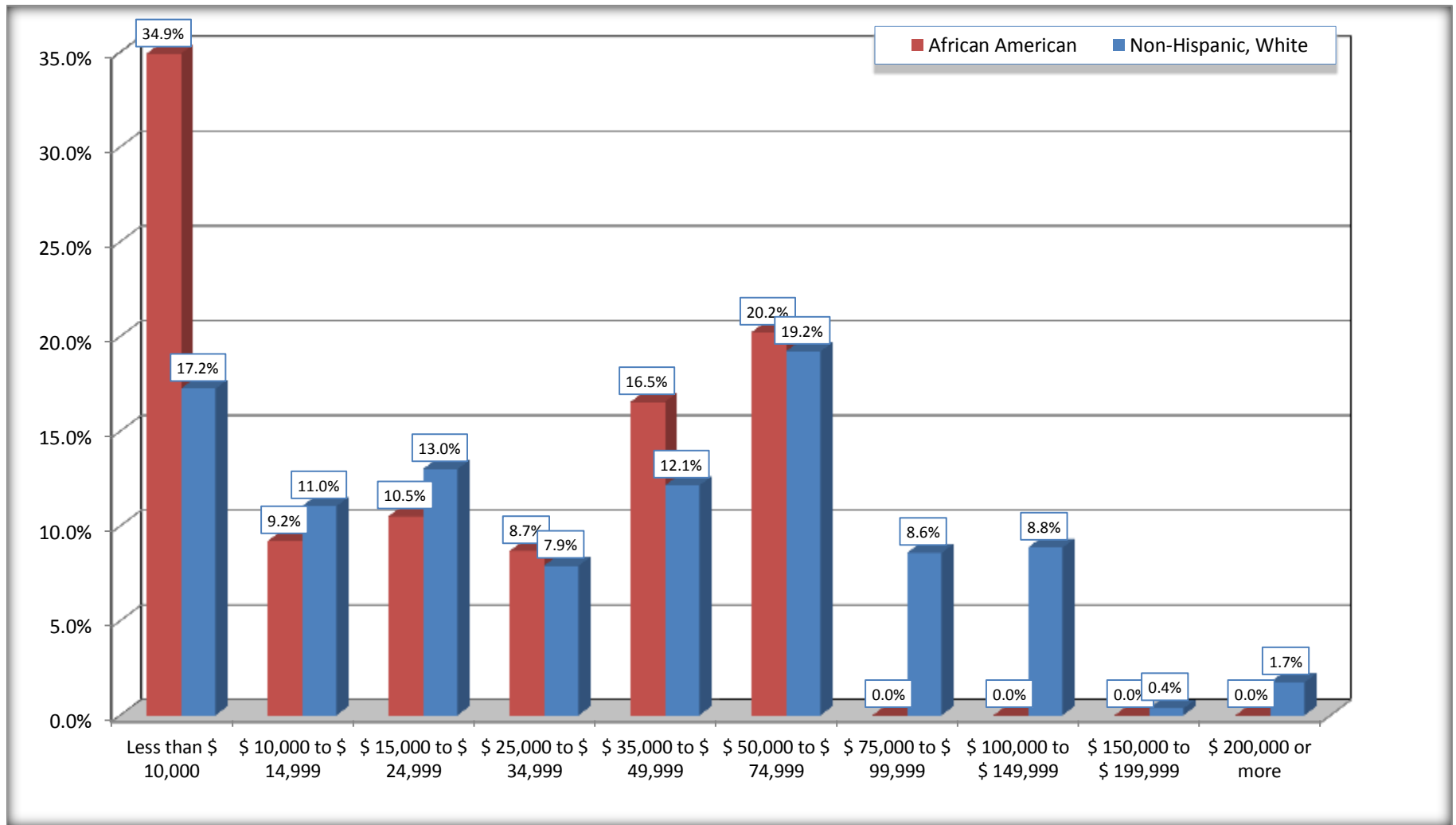

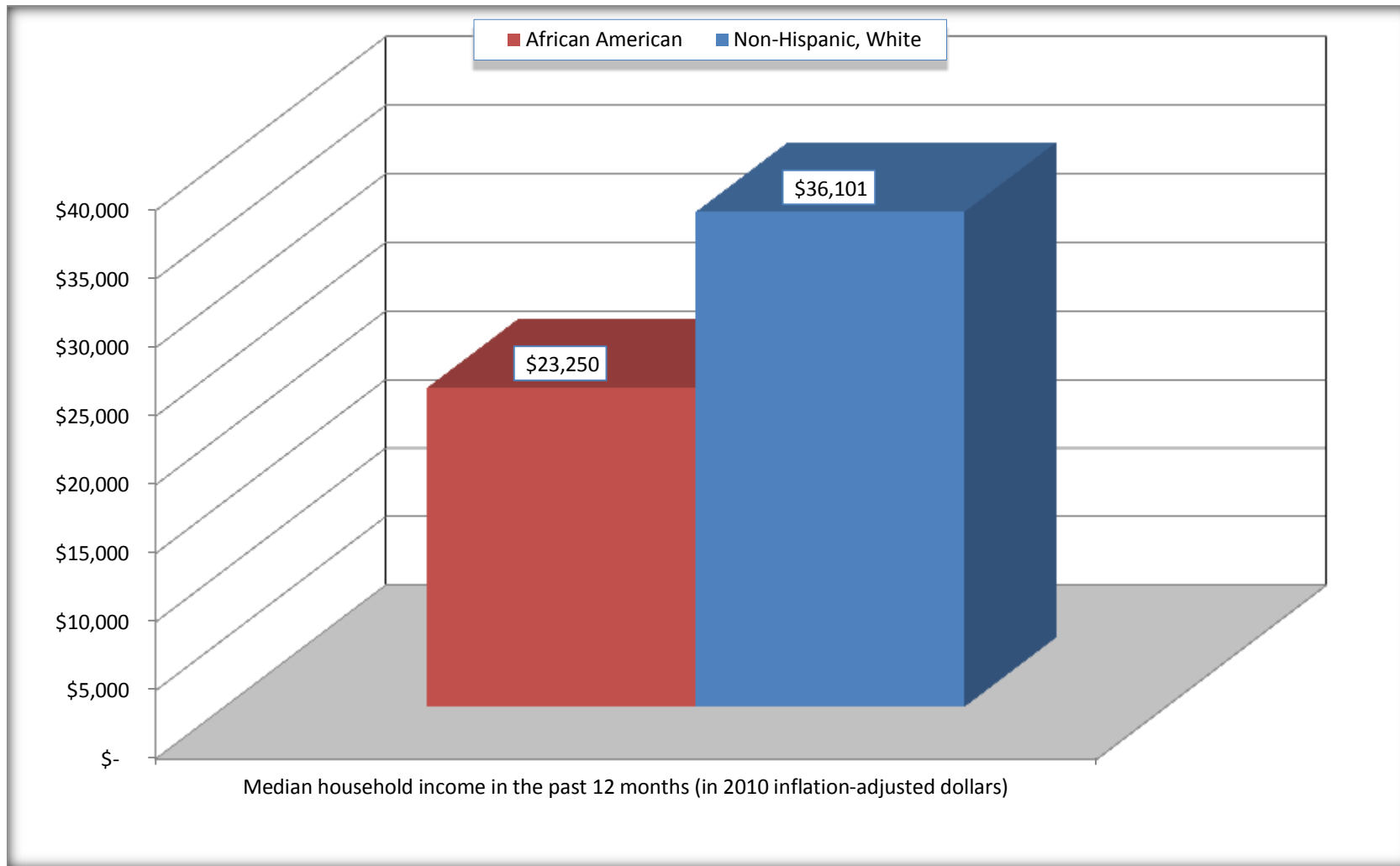

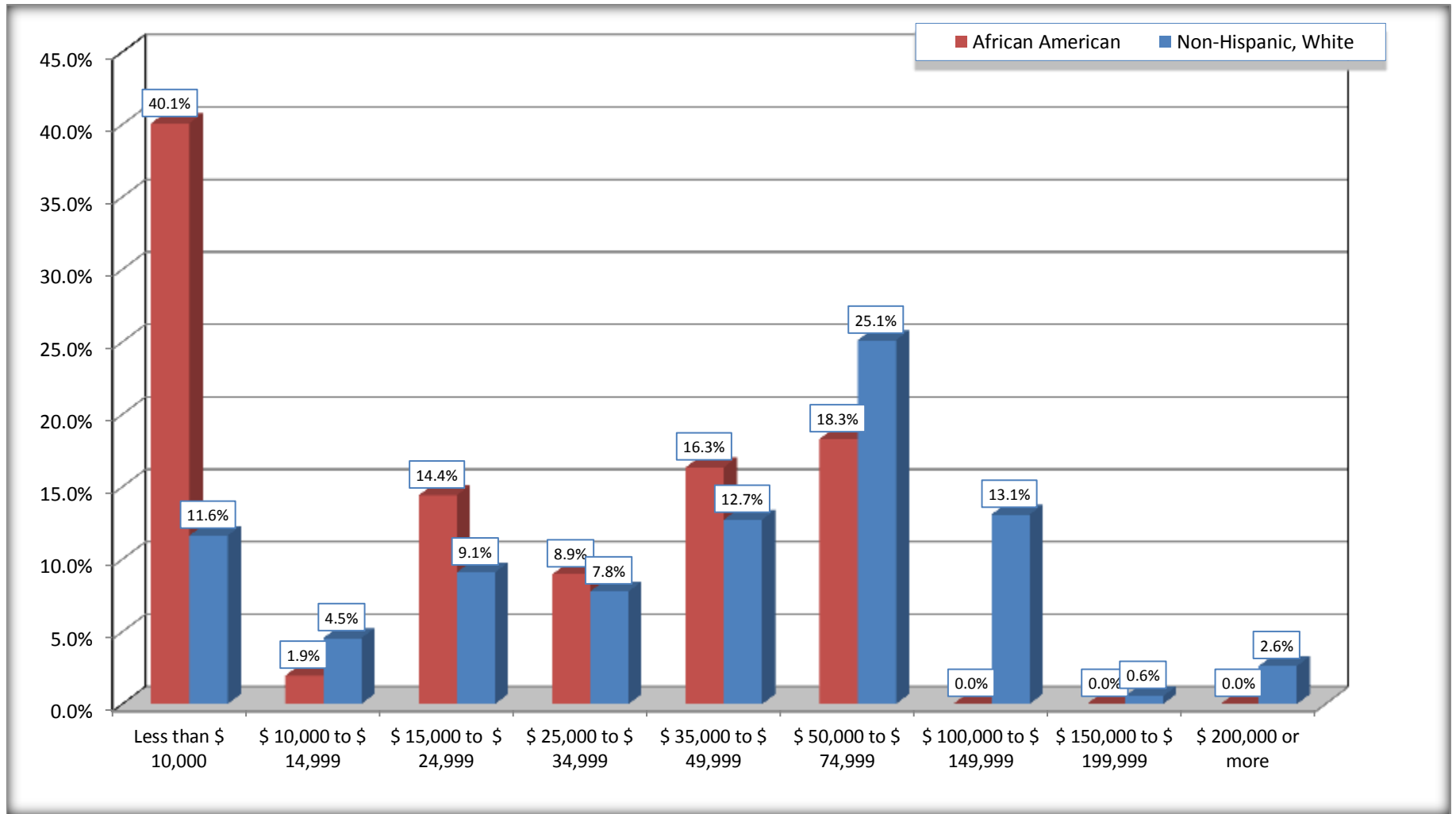

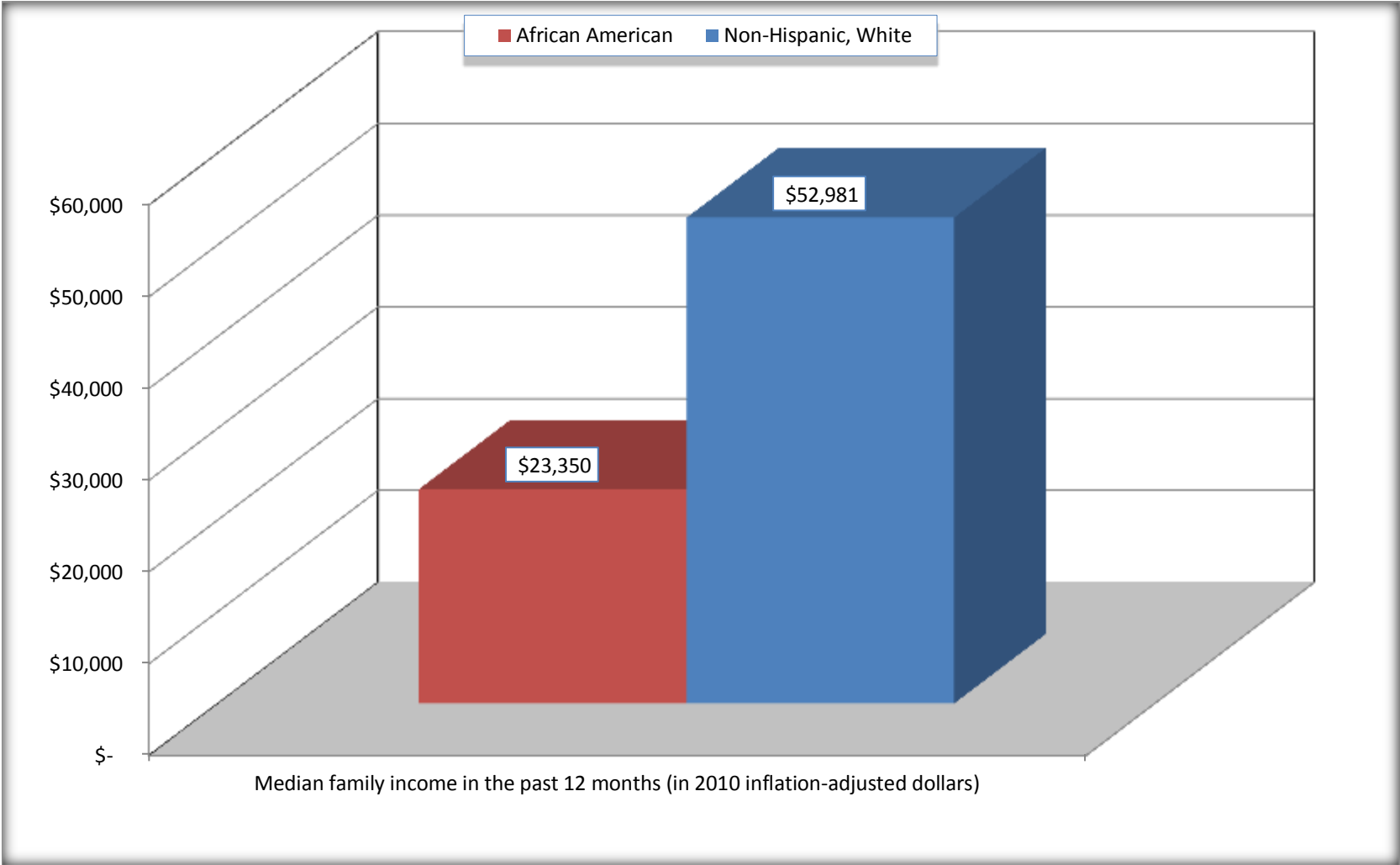

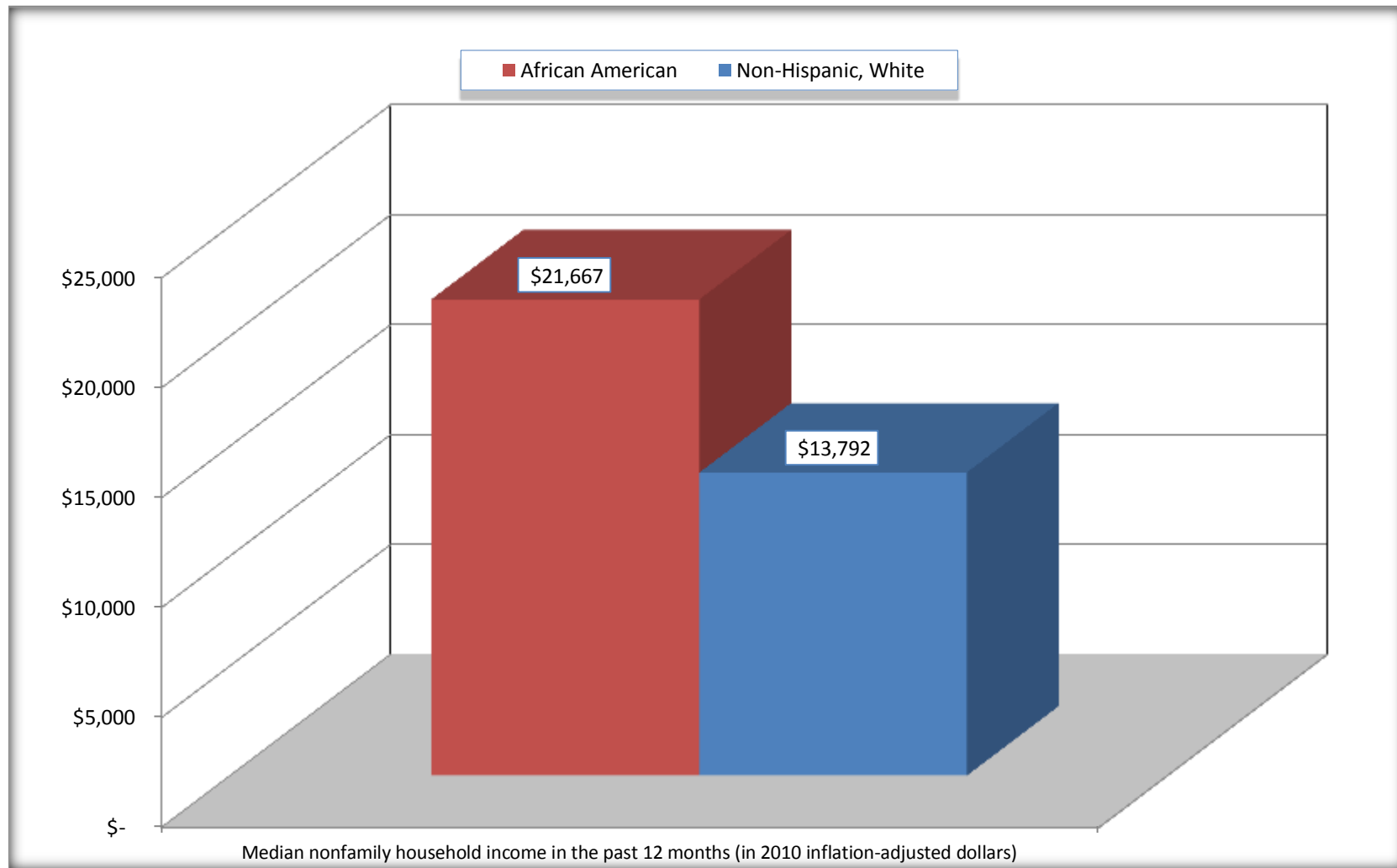

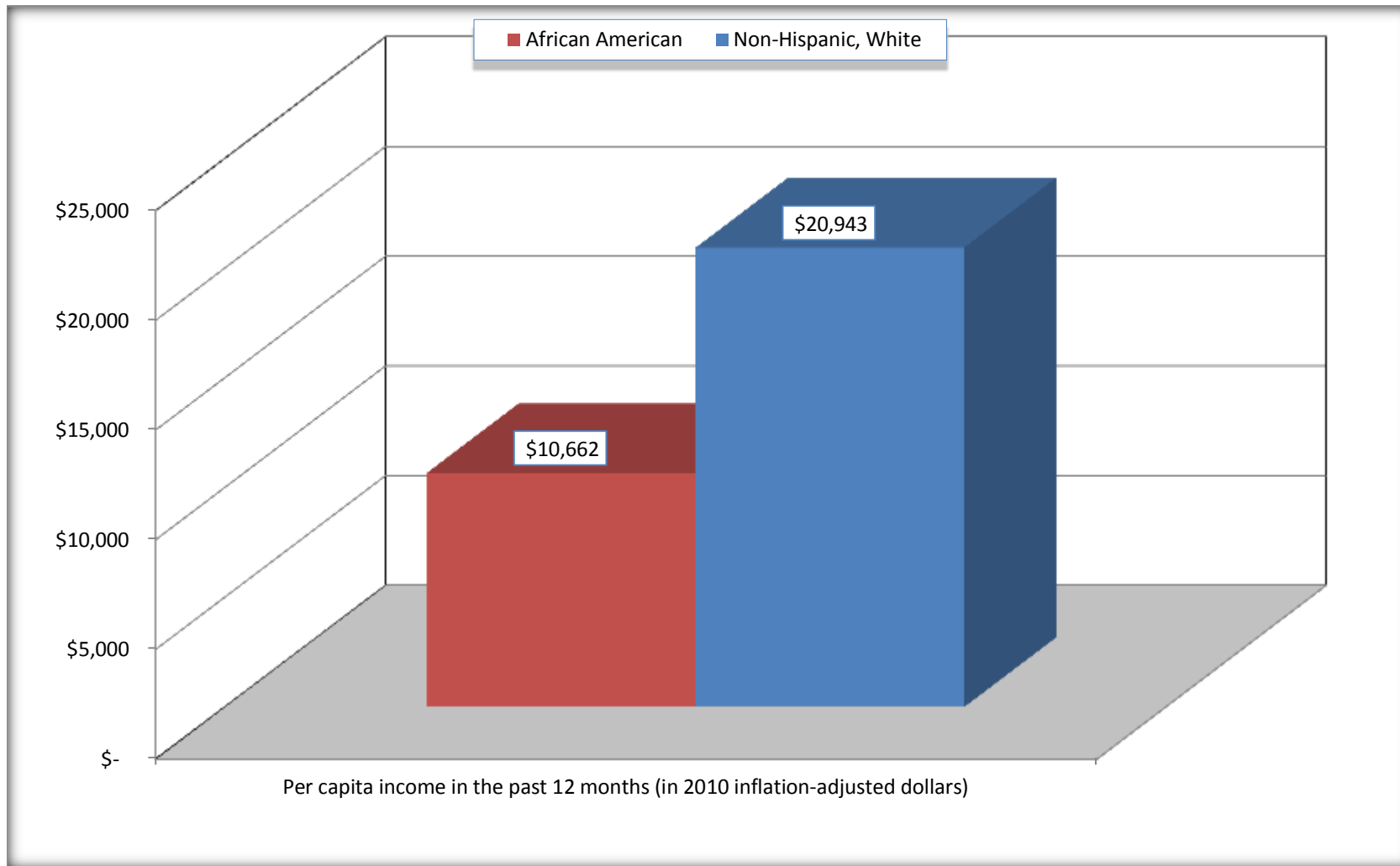

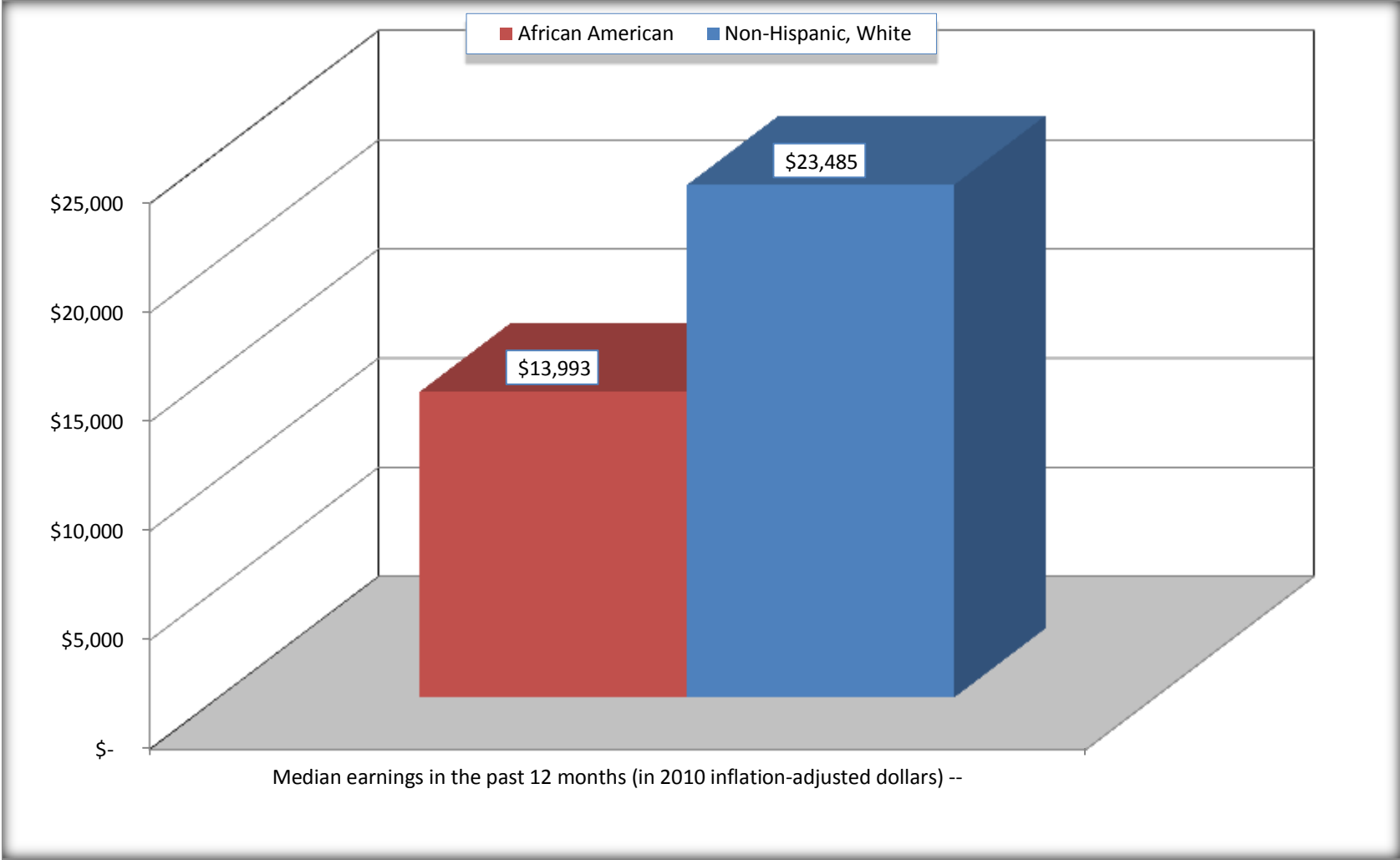

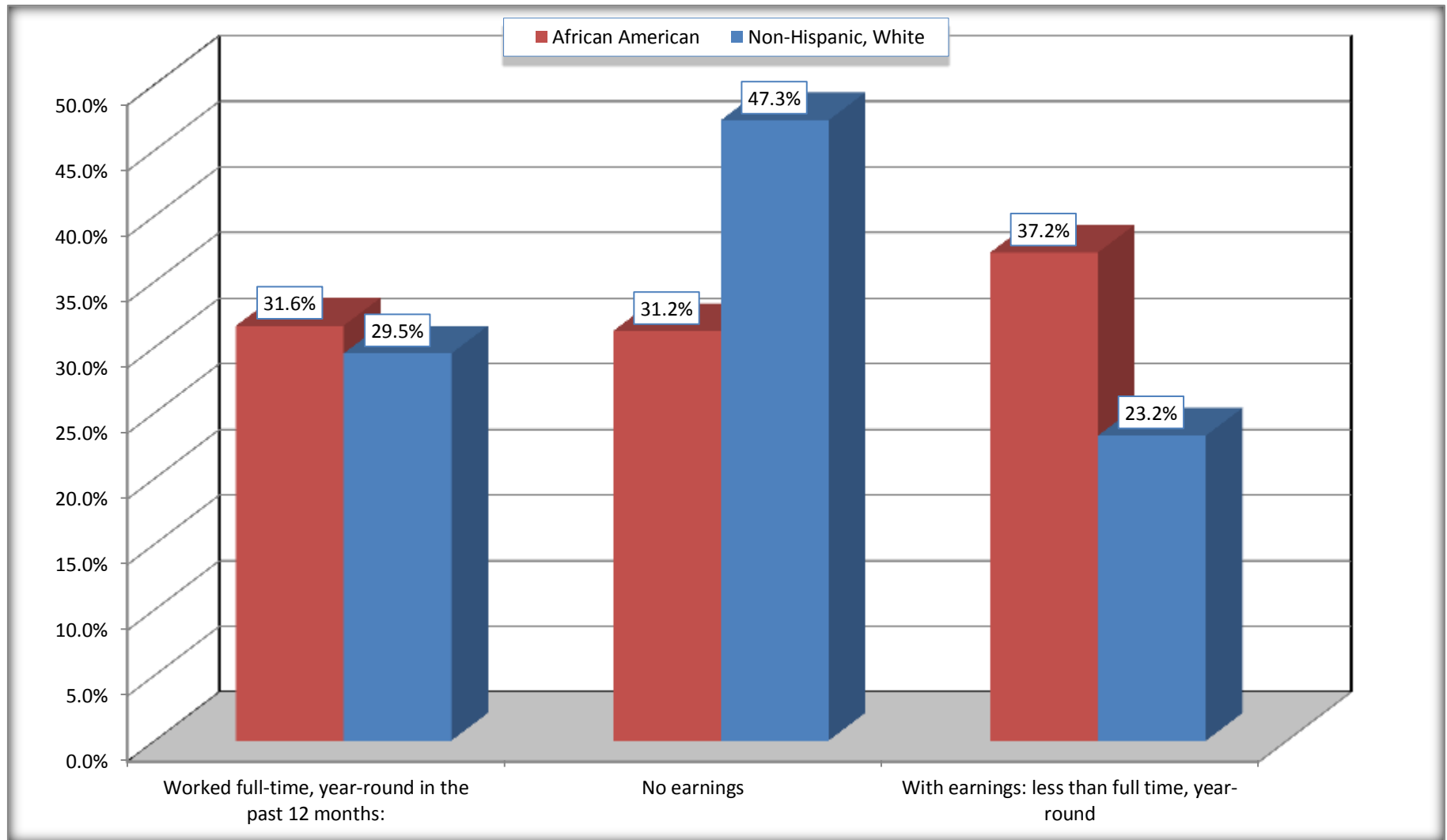

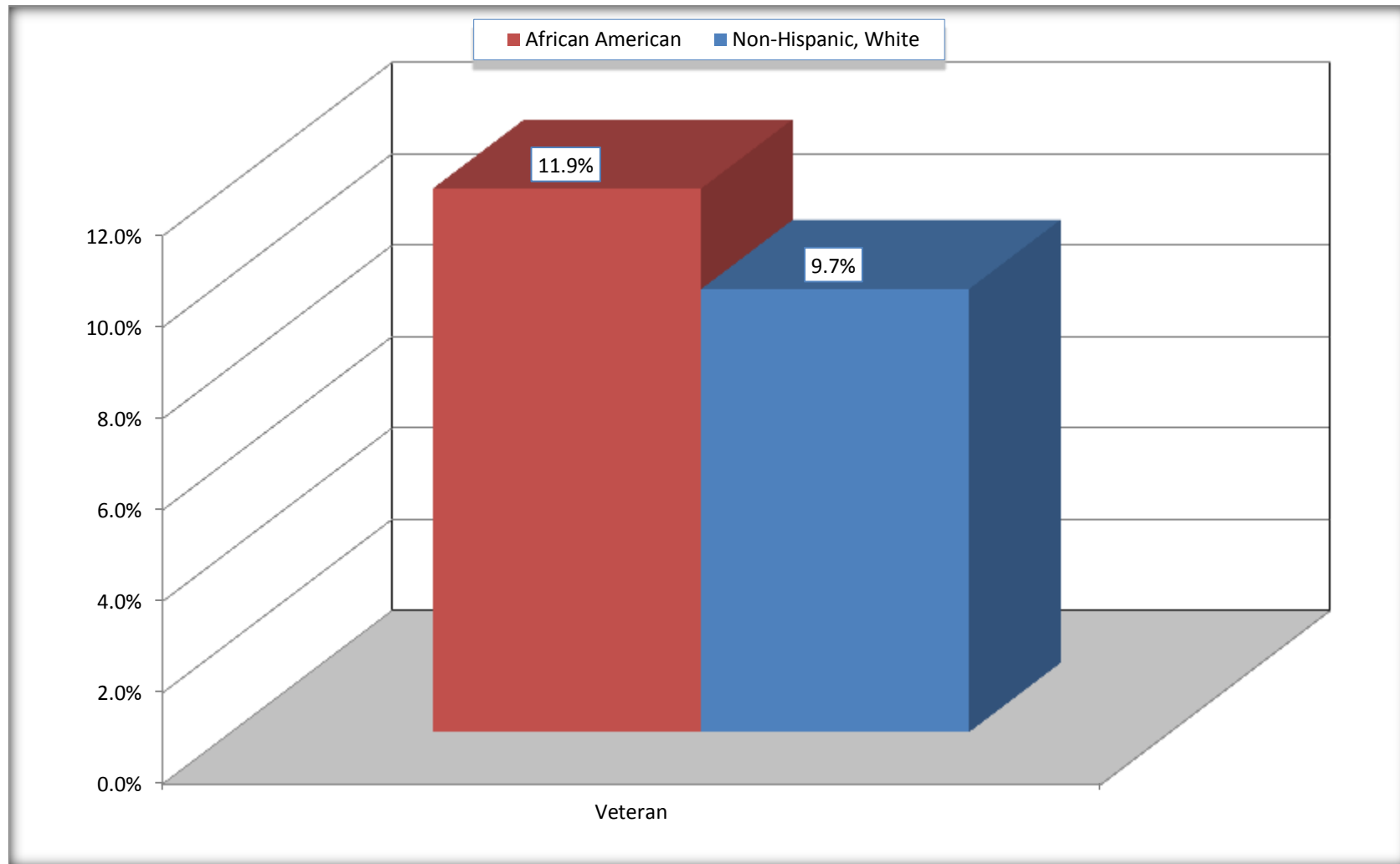

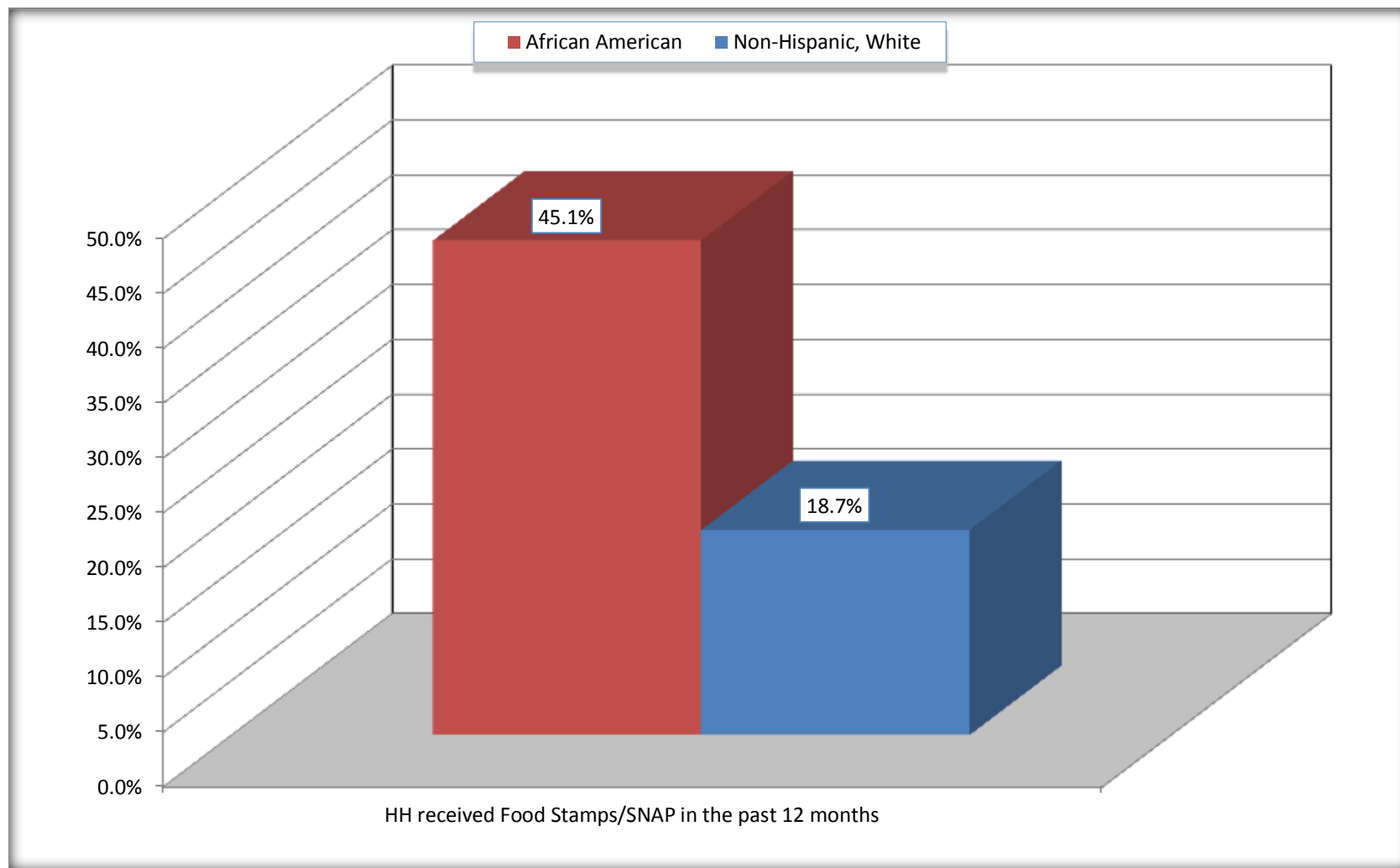

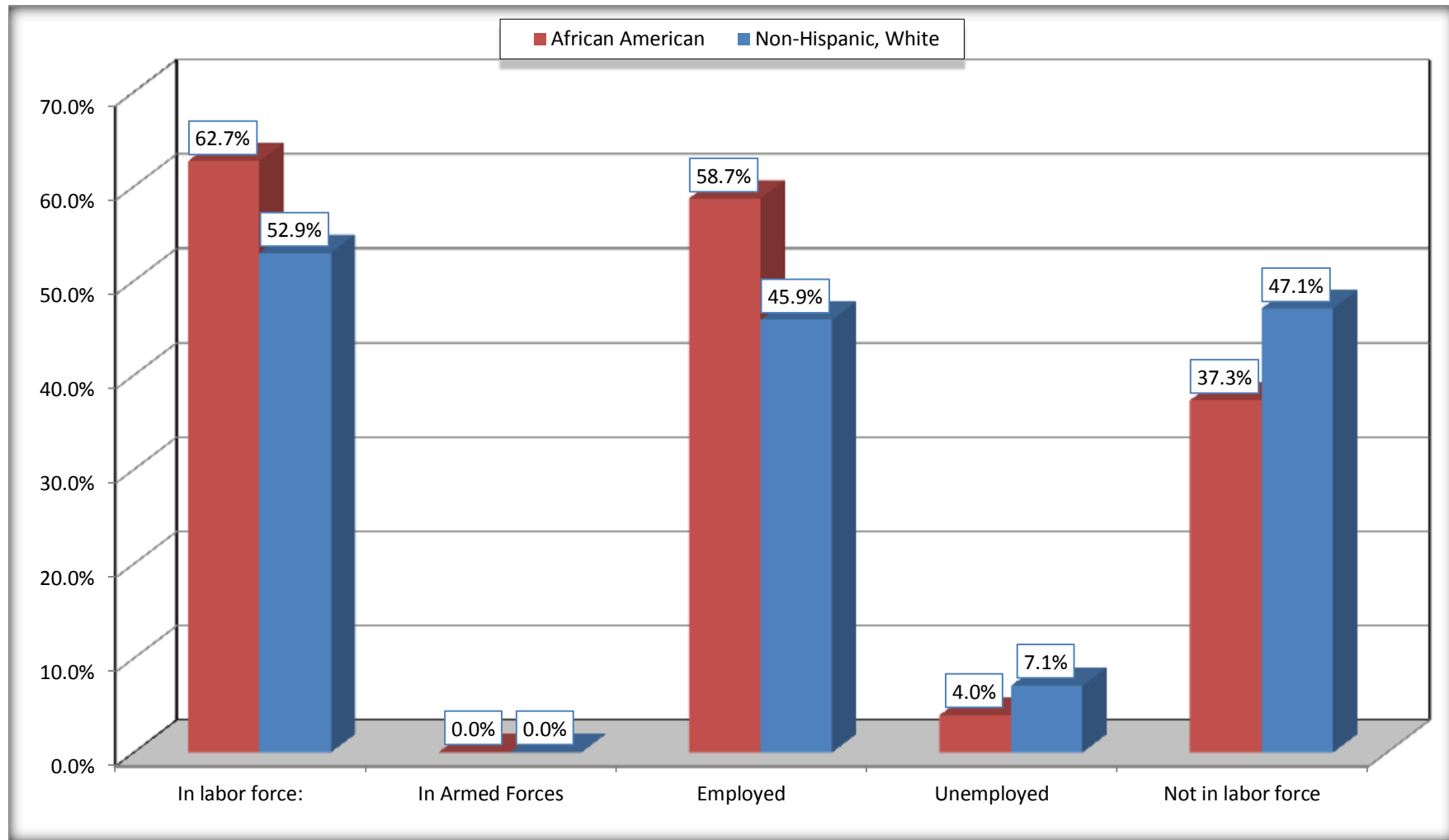

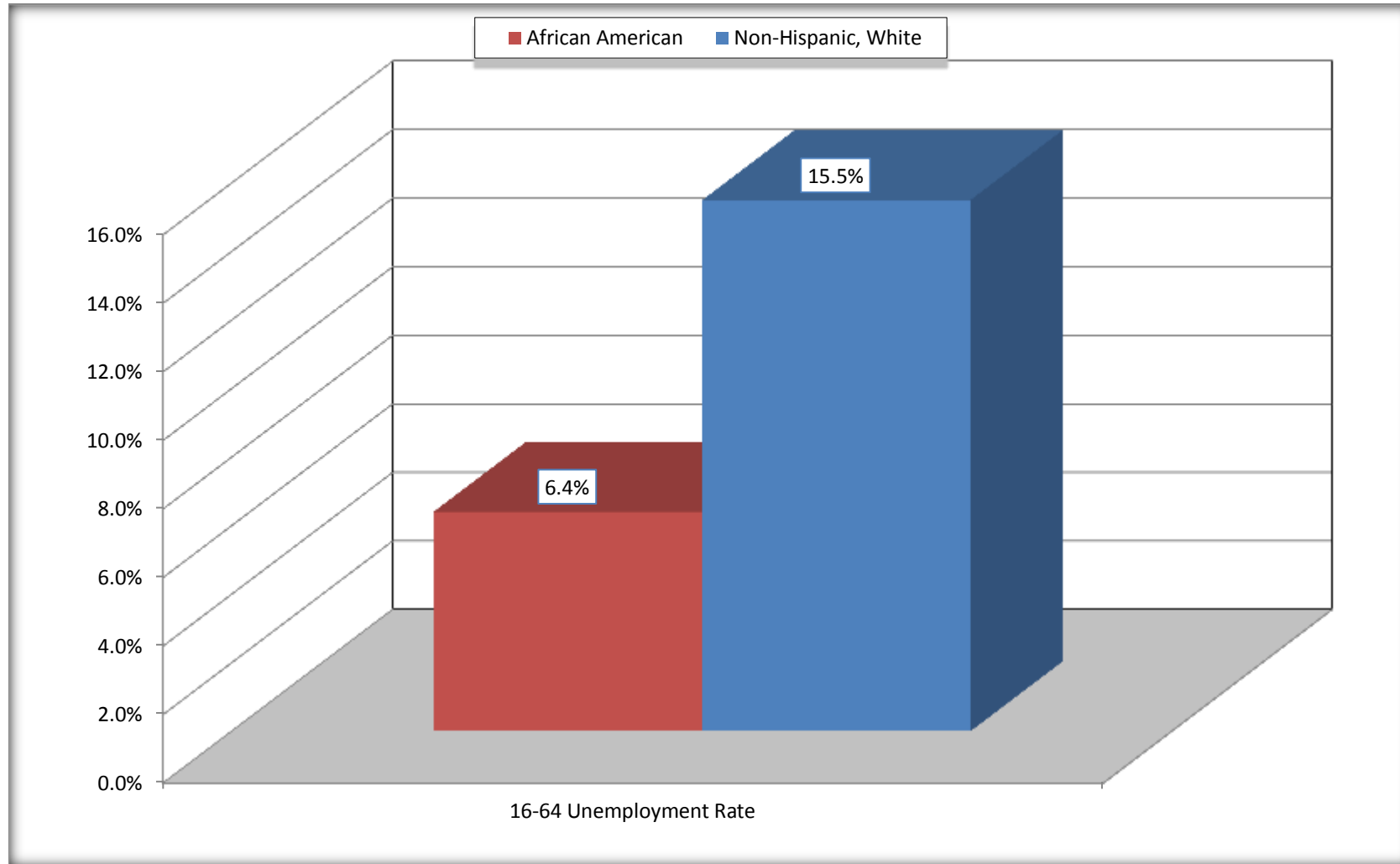

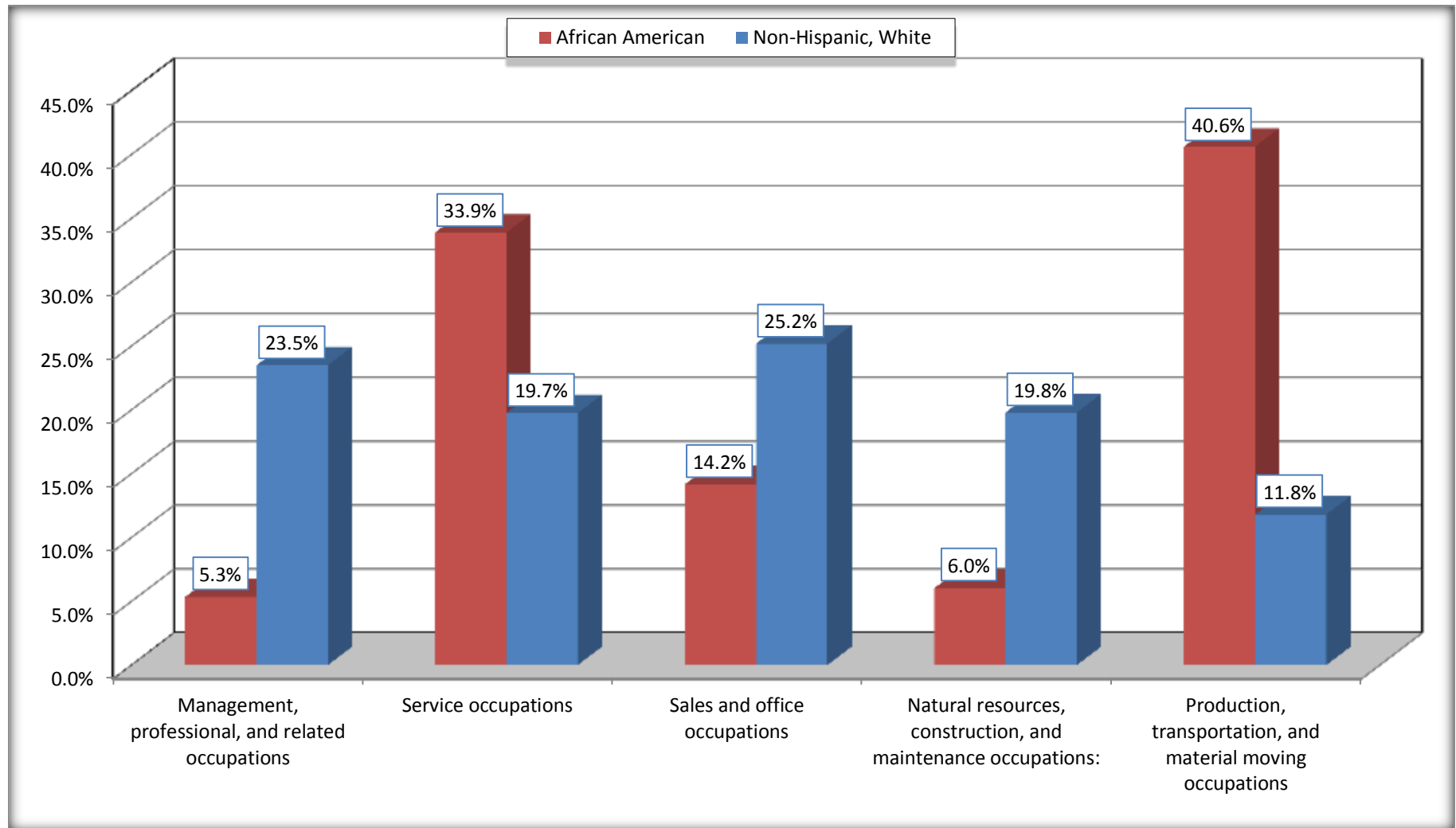

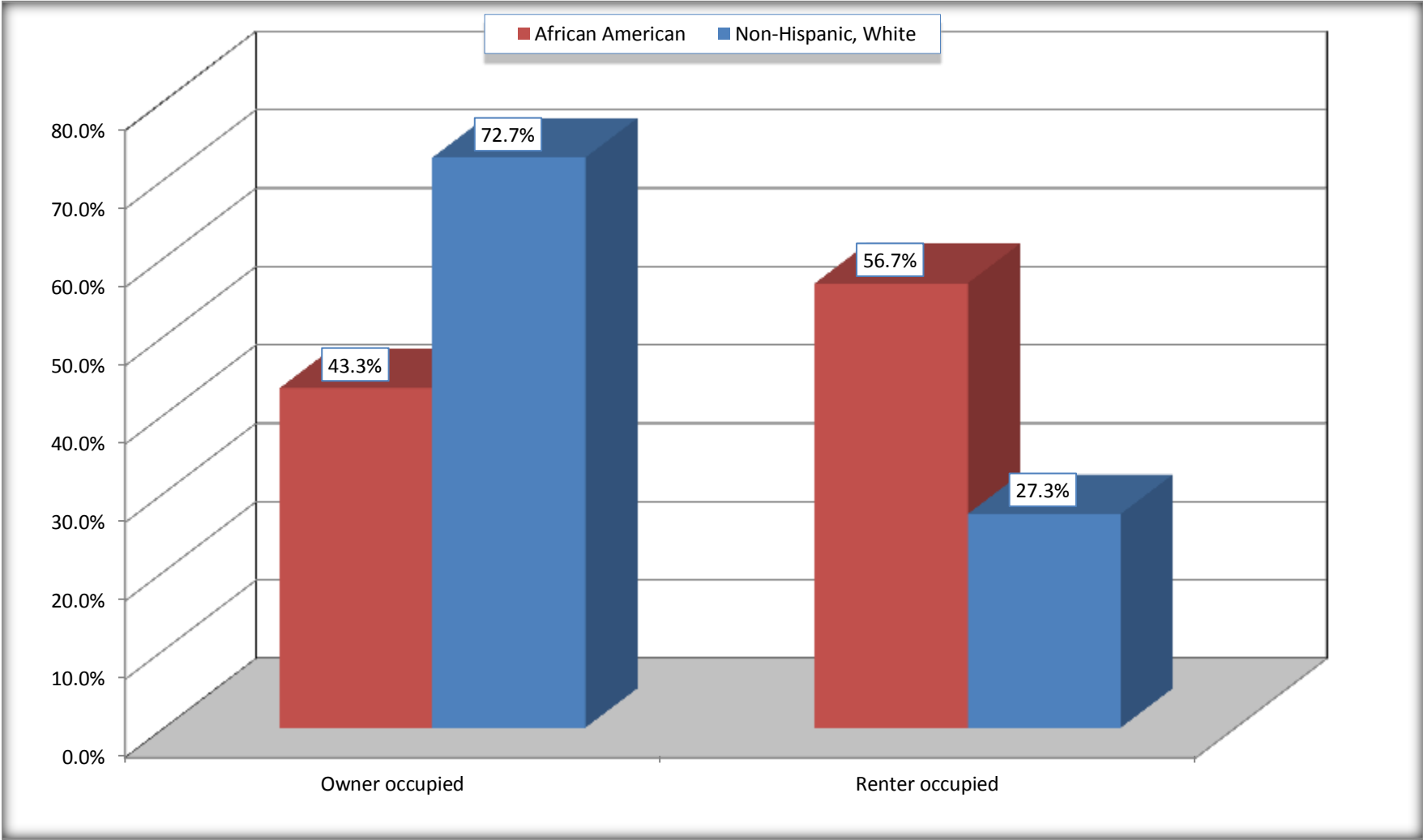

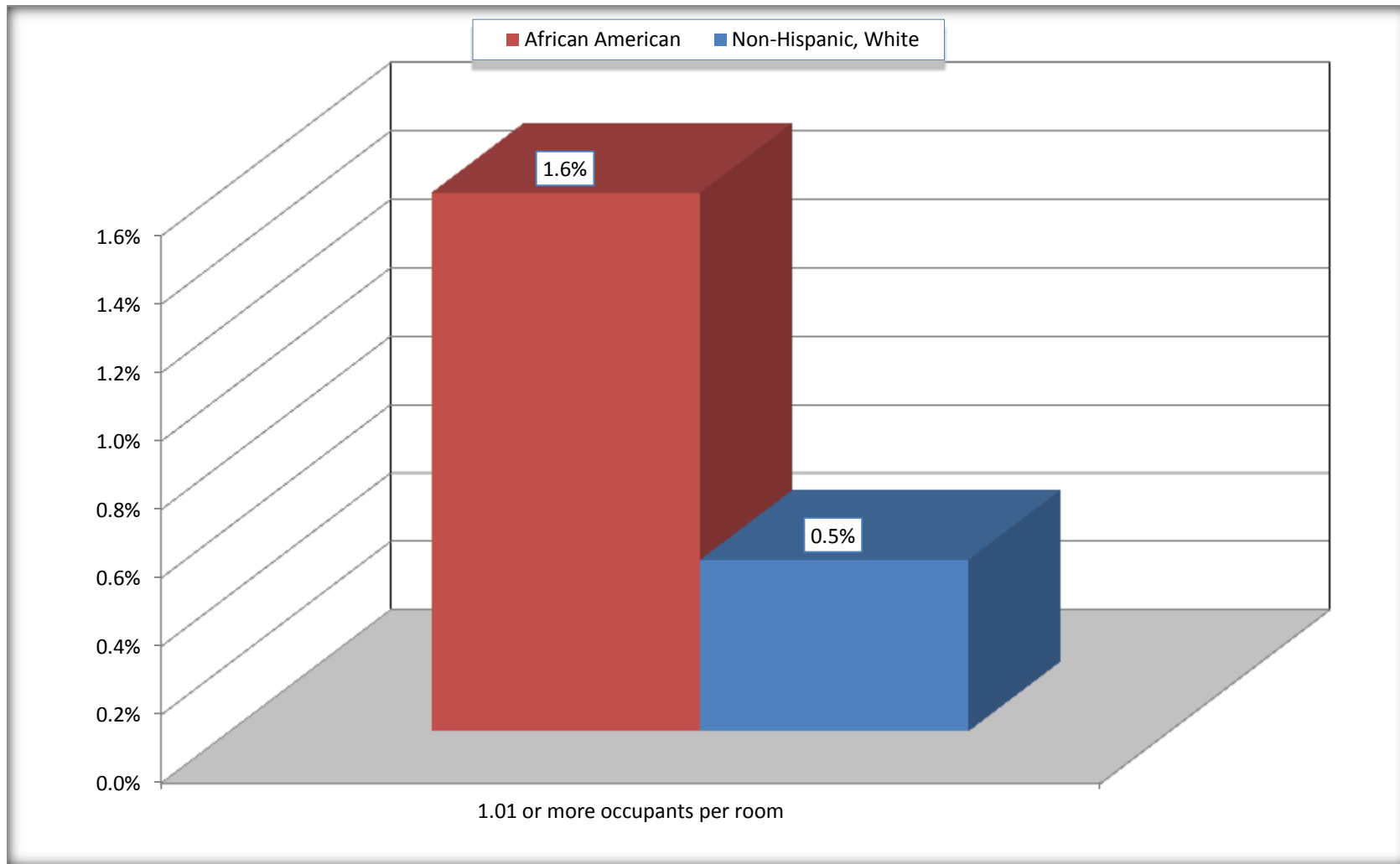

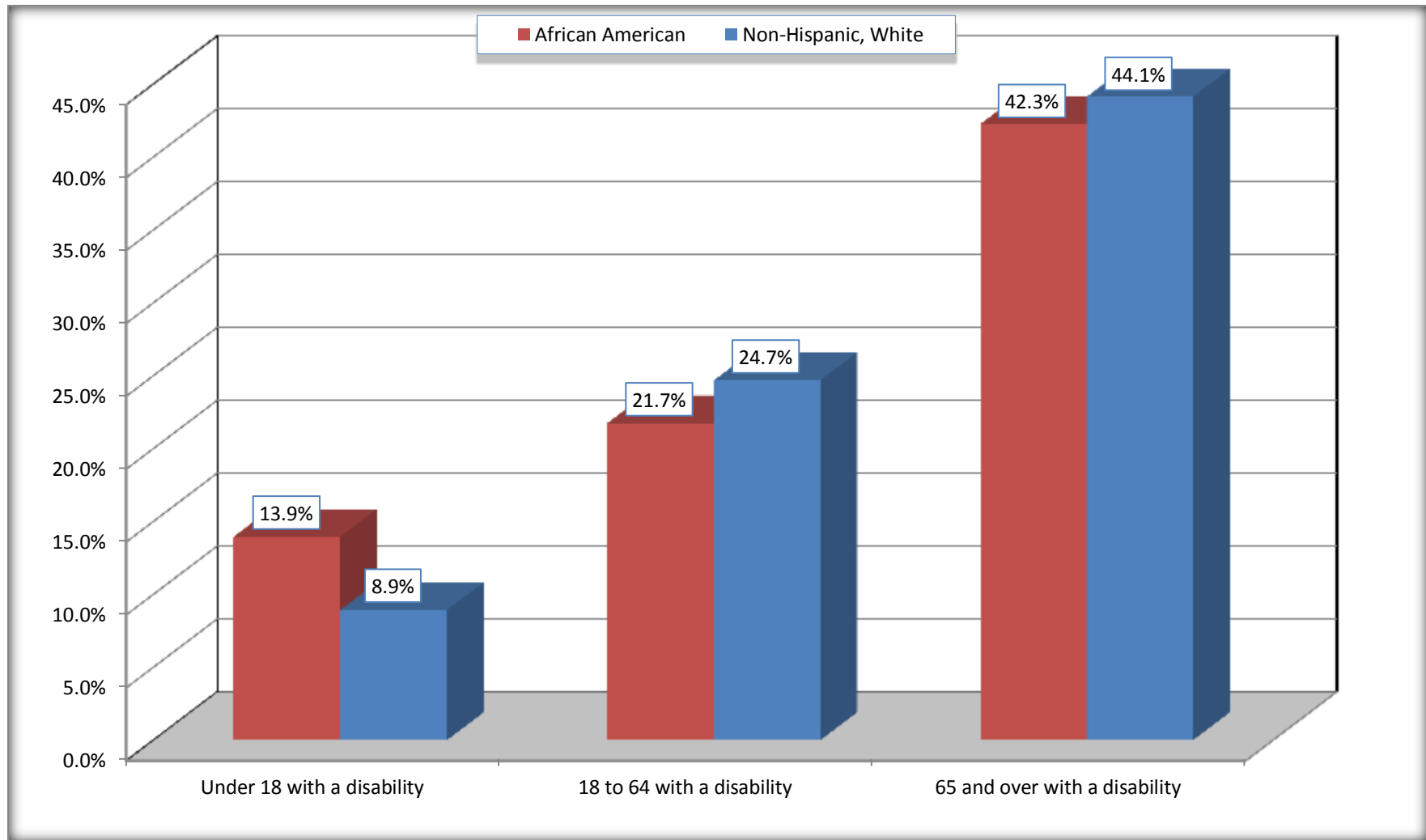

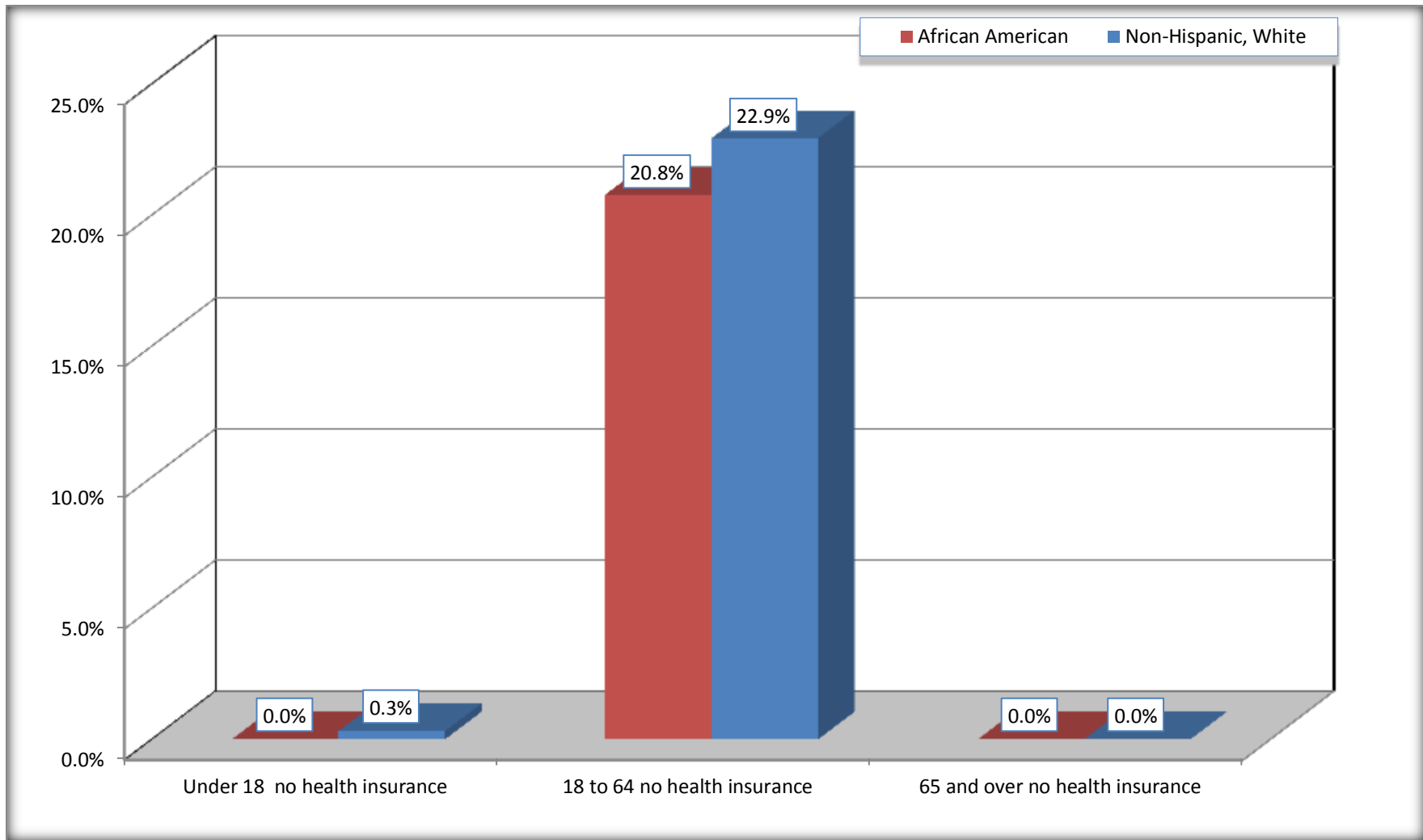
