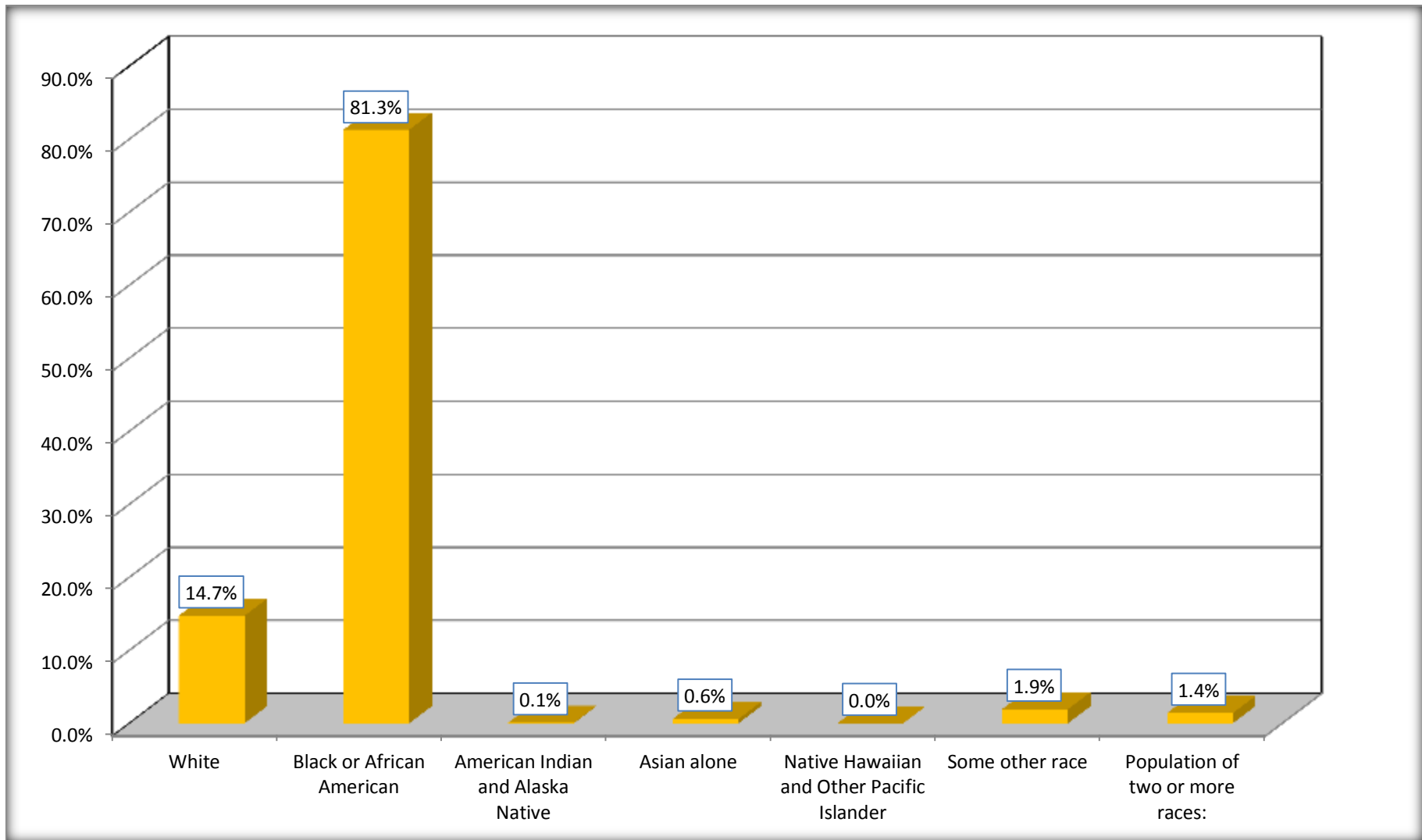

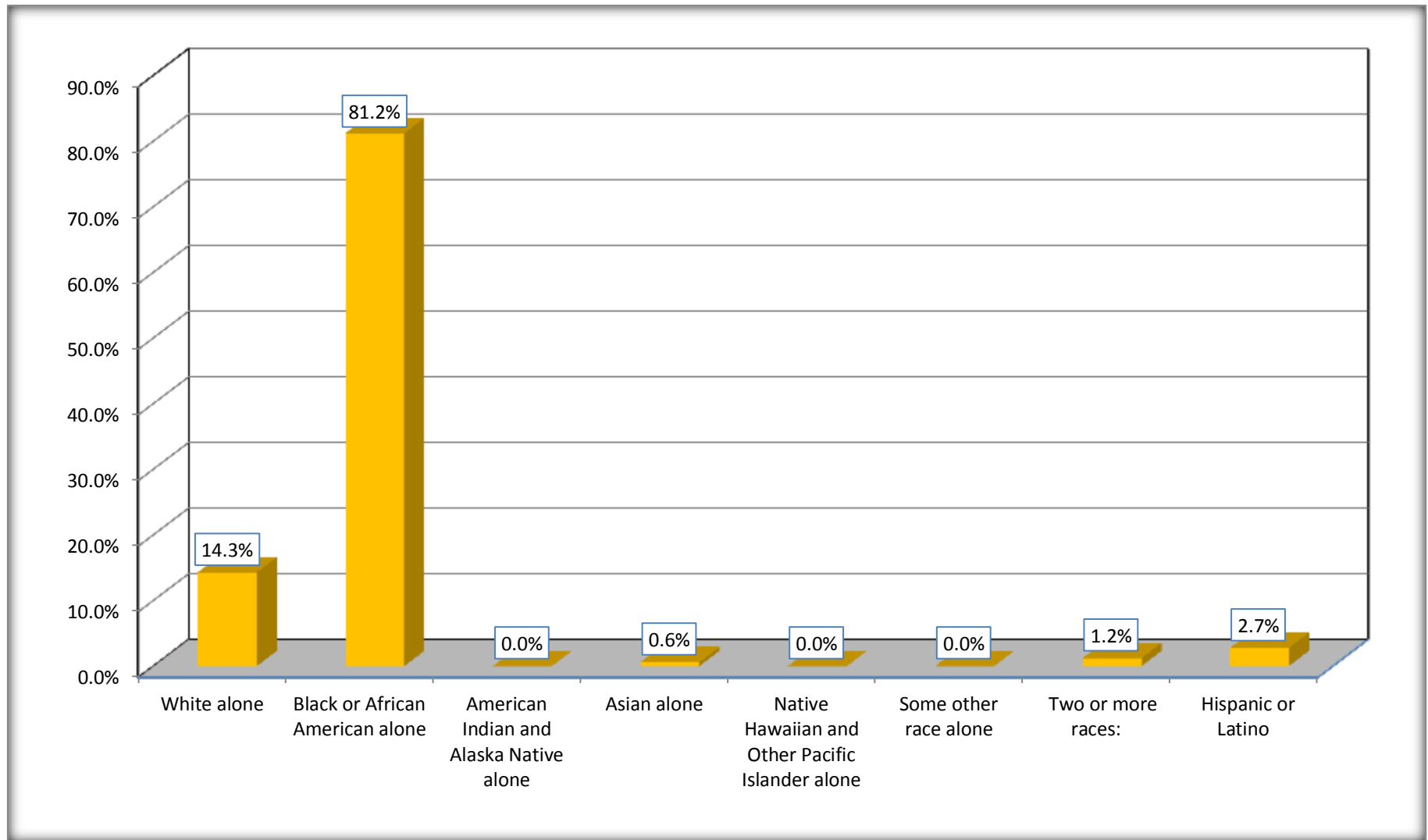
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# Non-Hispanic by Race and Hispanic Population

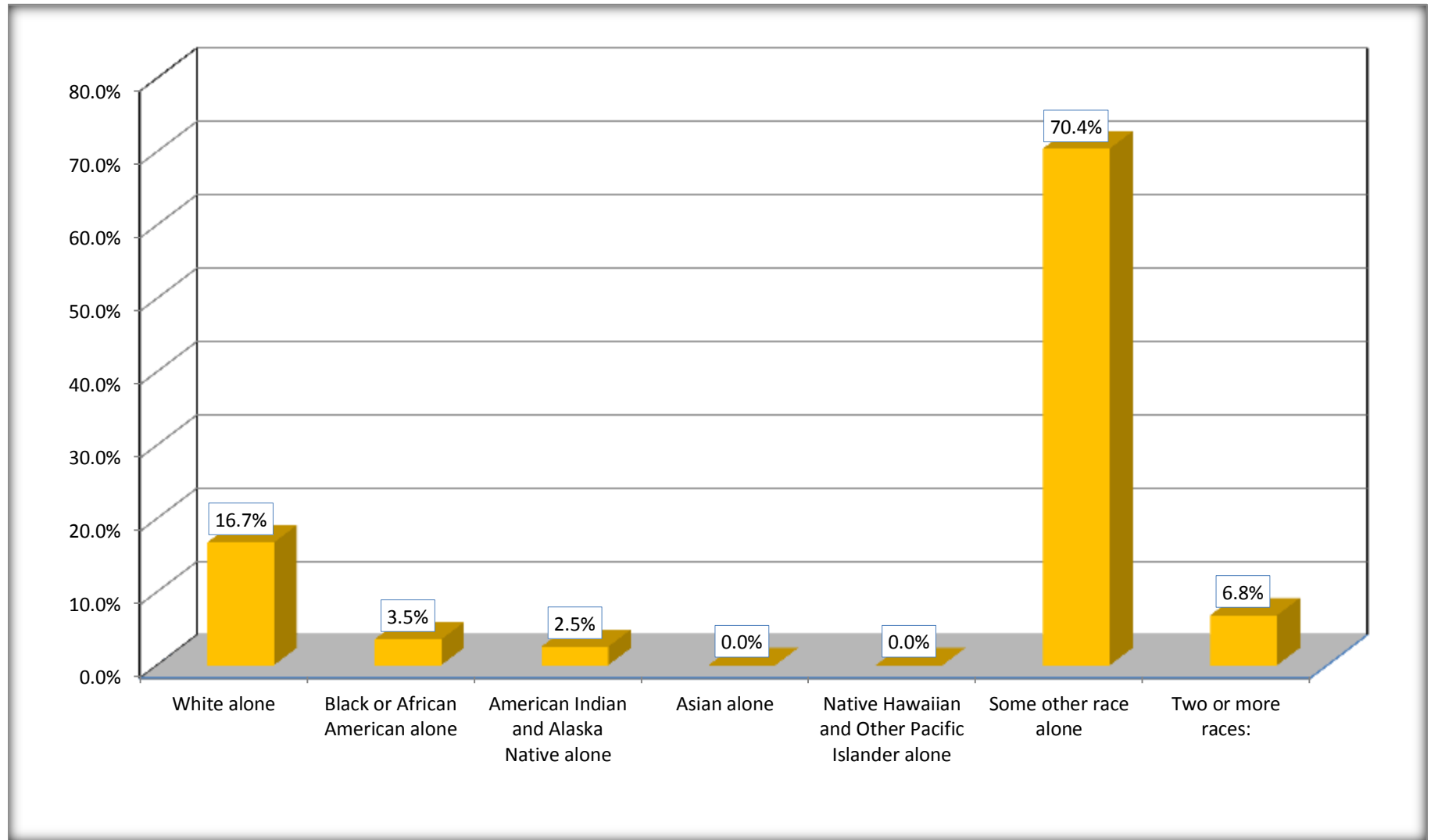
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## Hispanic or Latino Origin by Race

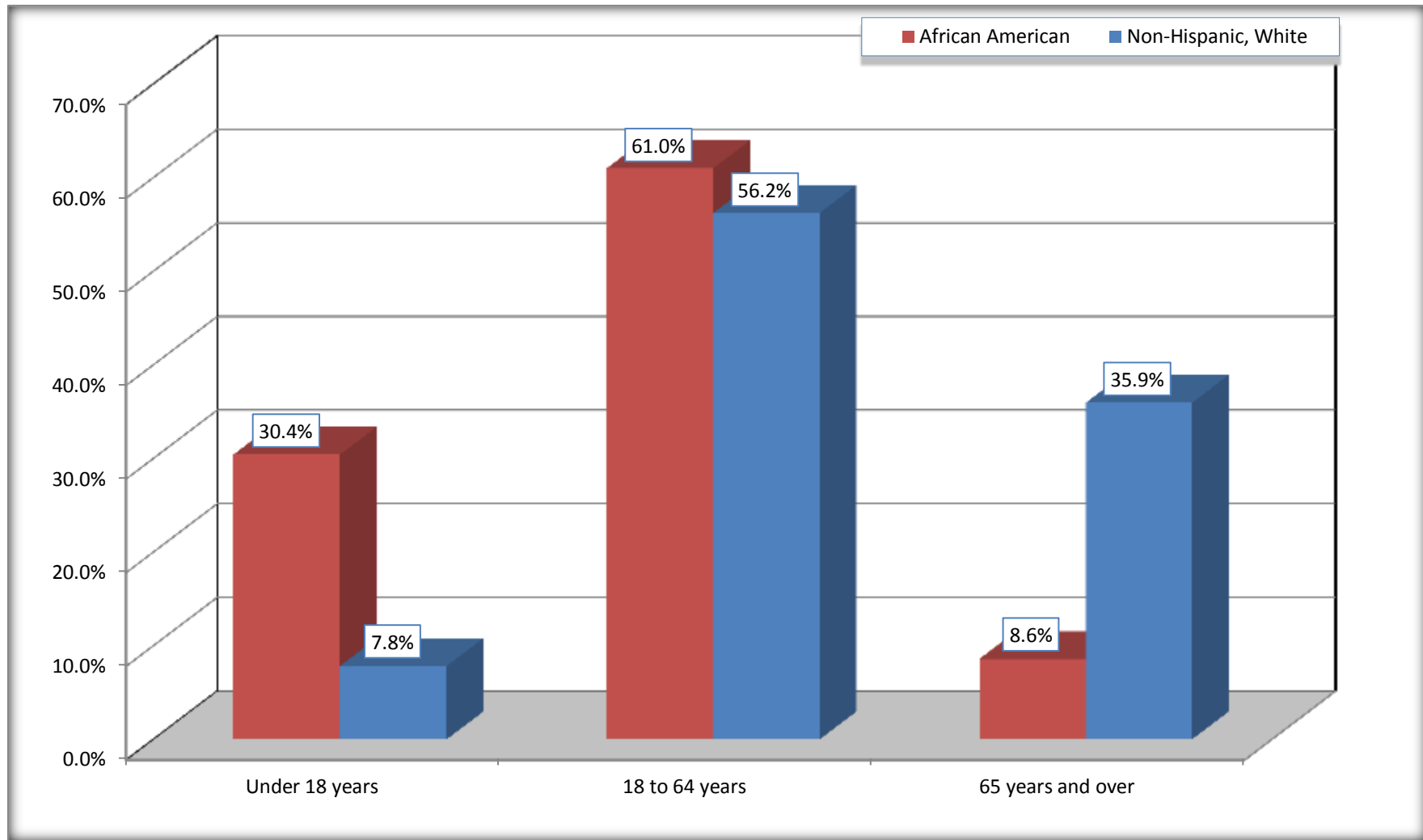
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# Population by Age

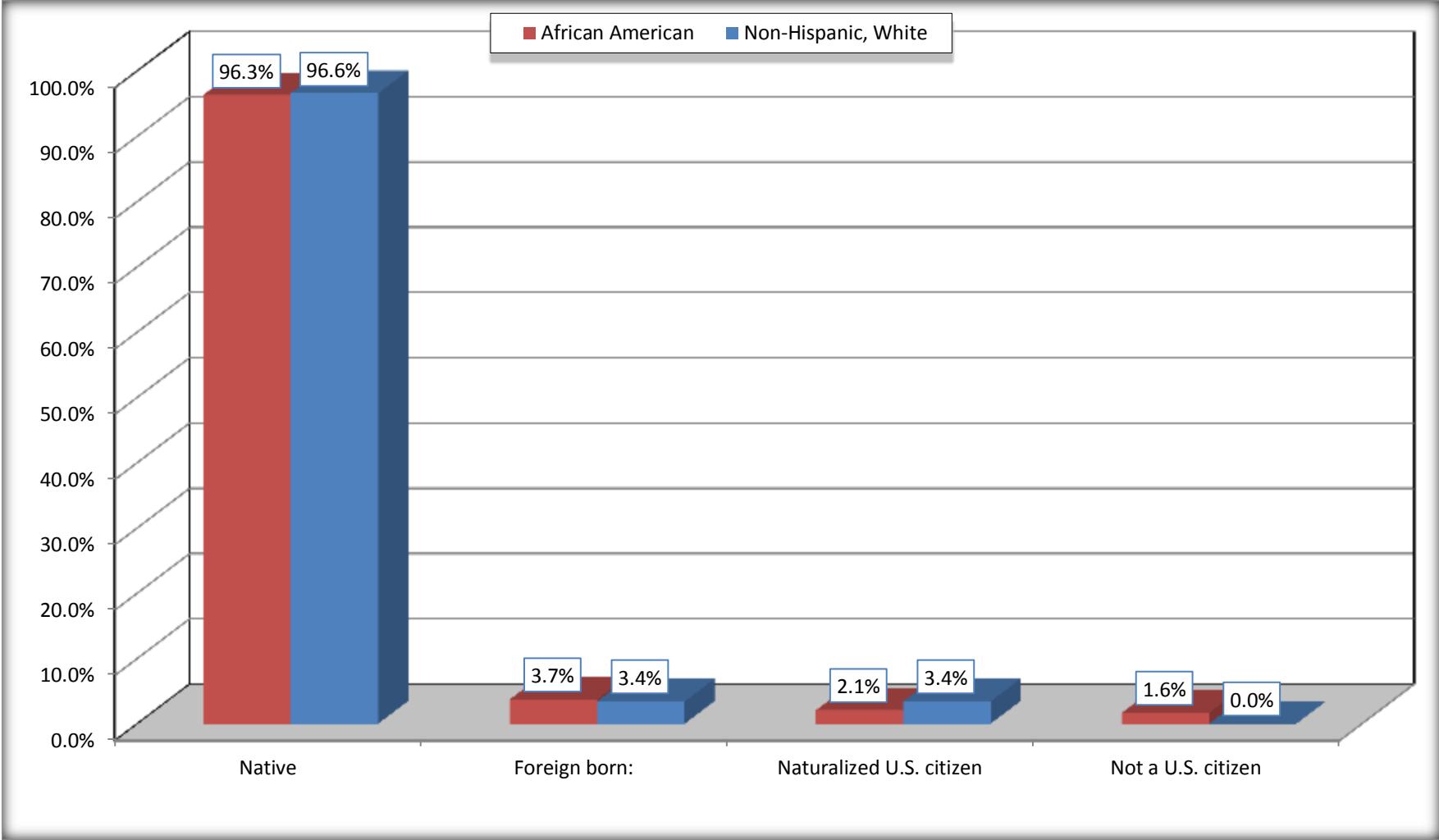

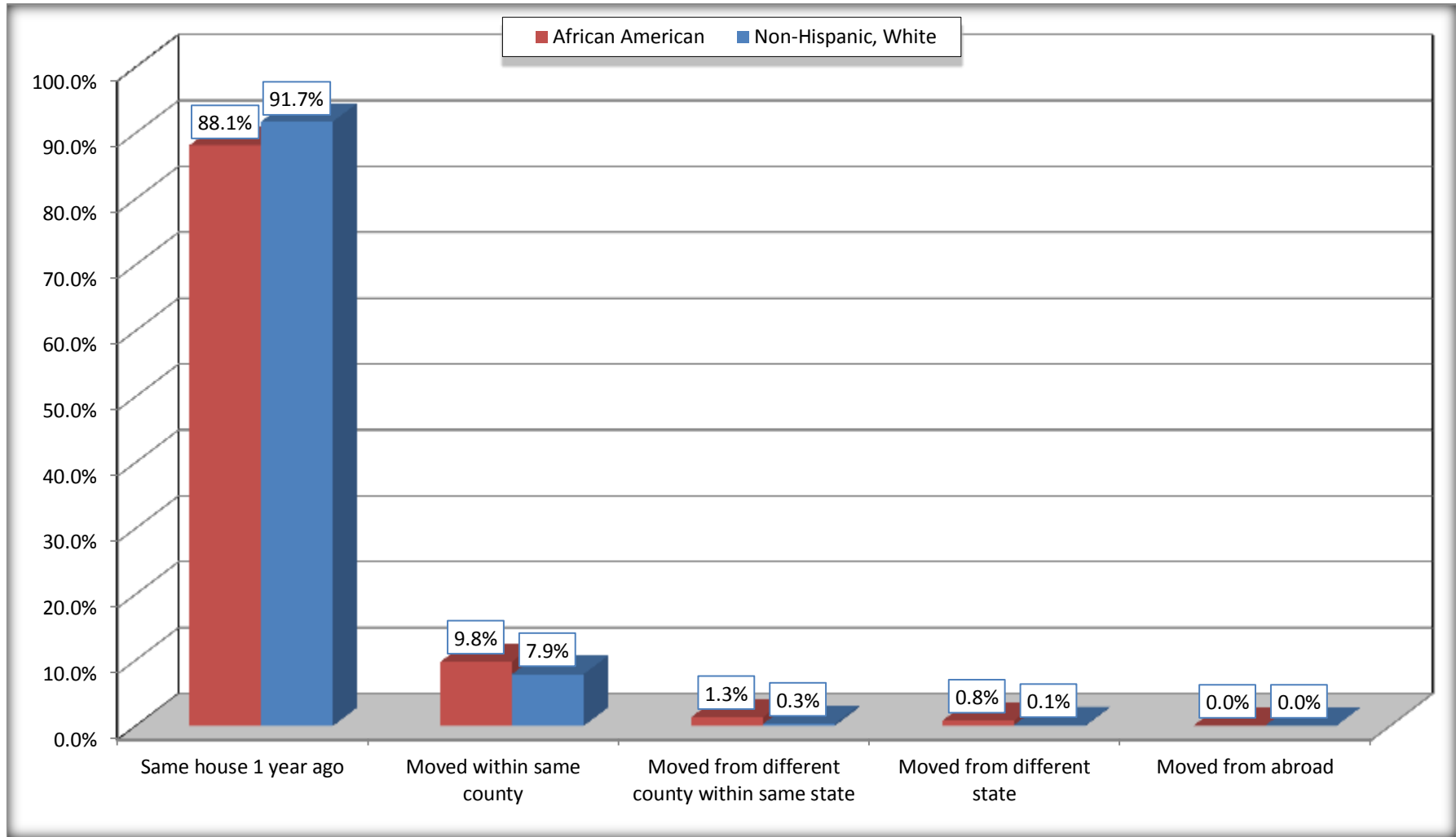

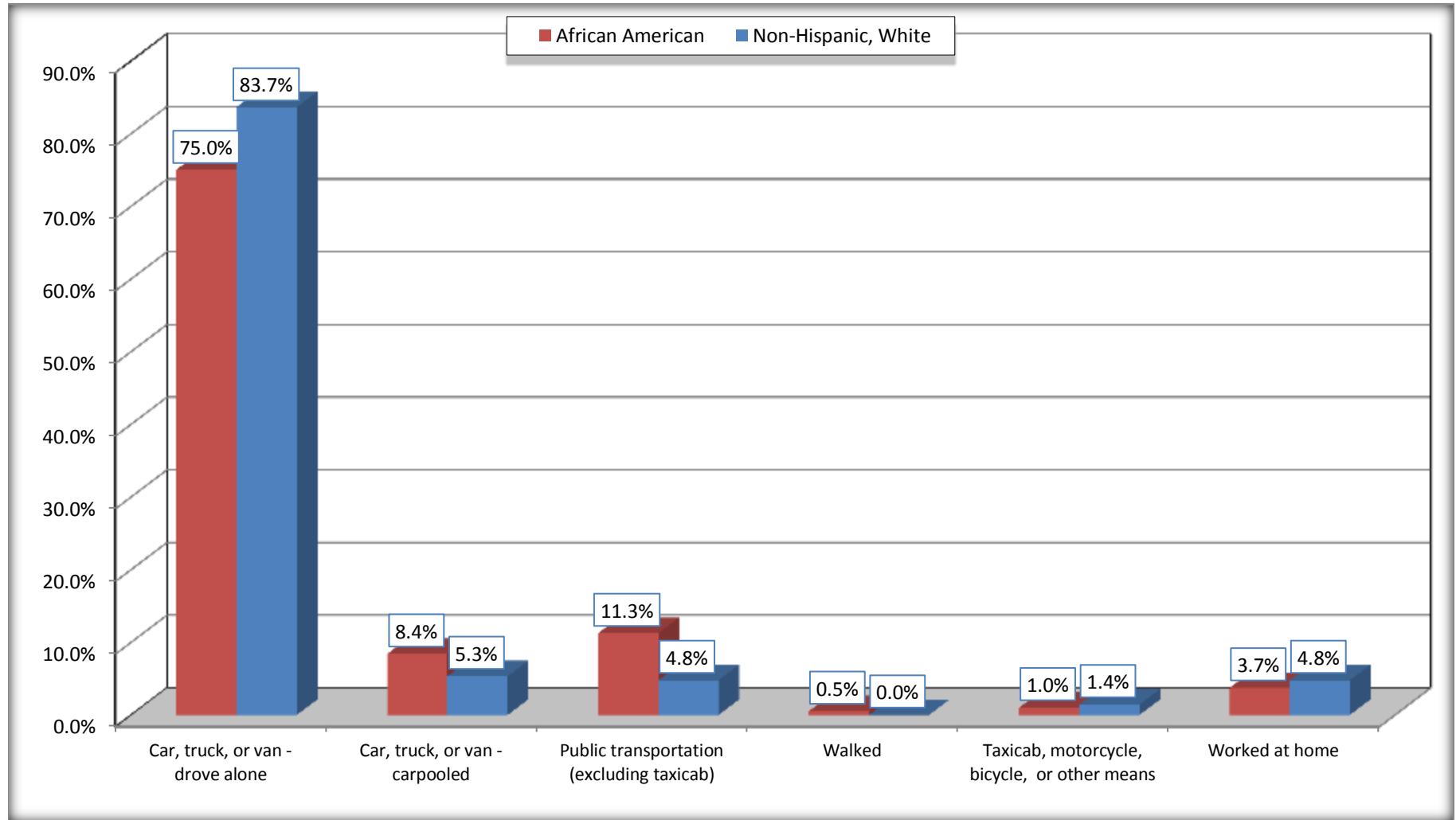

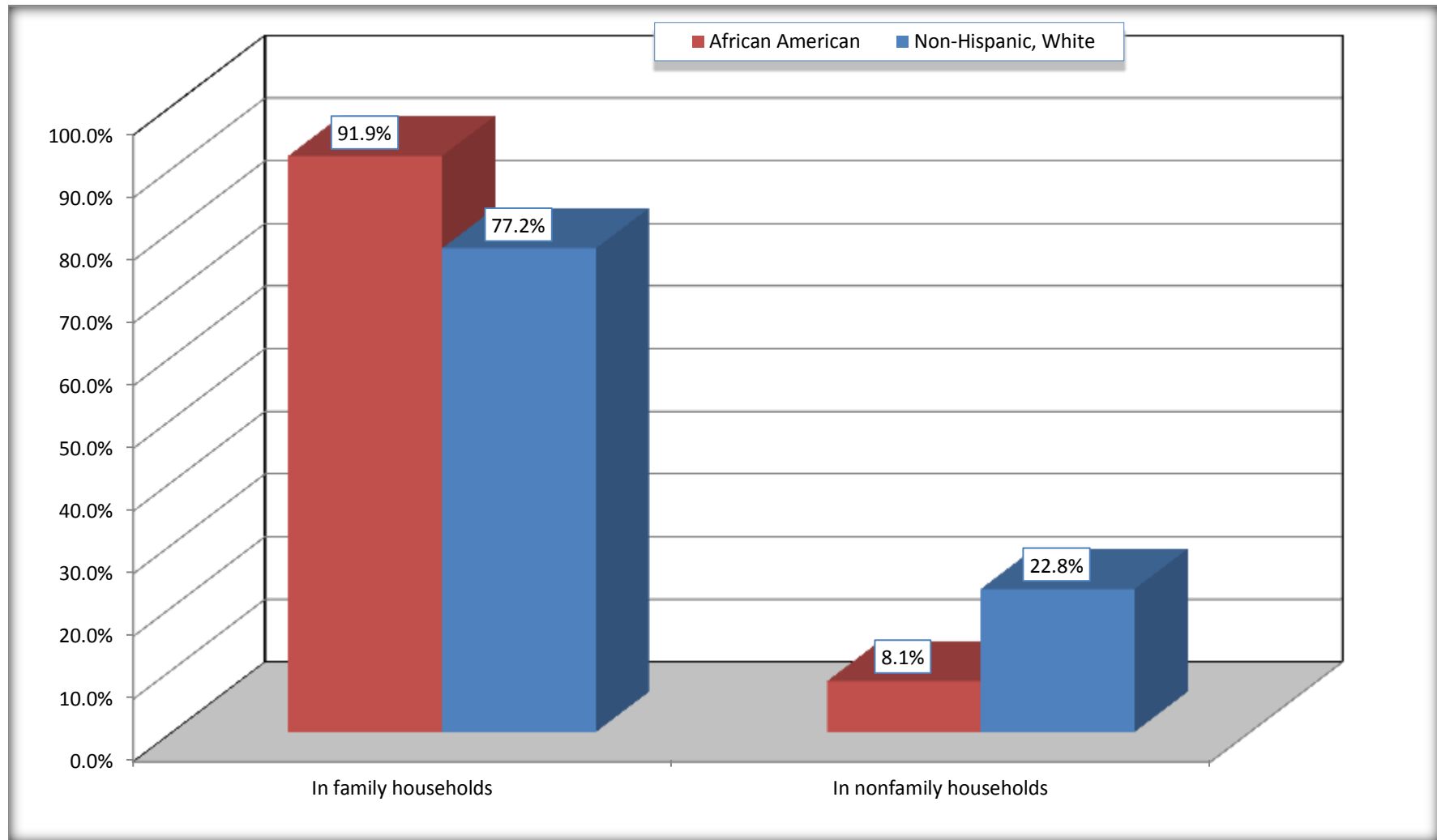

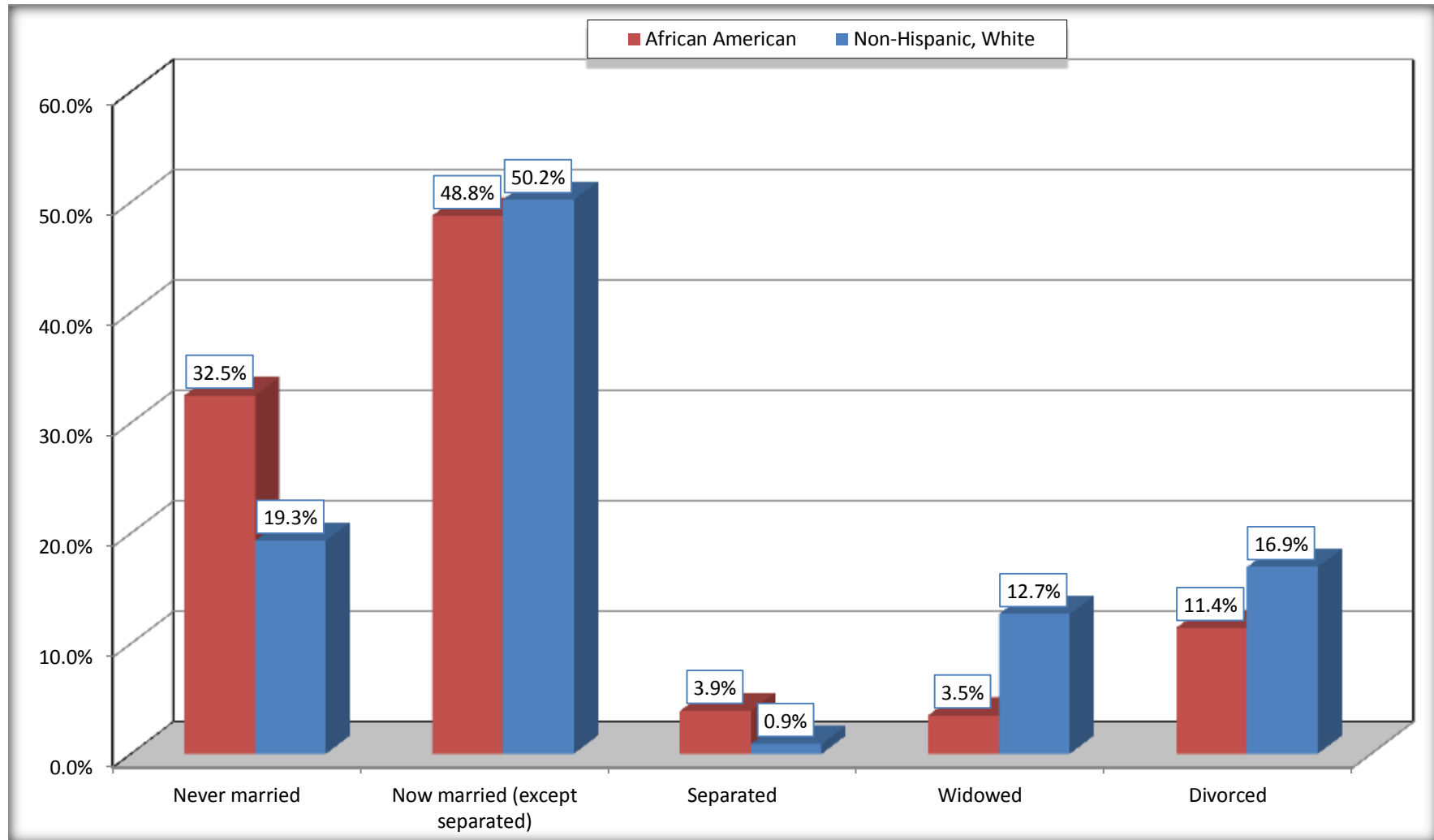

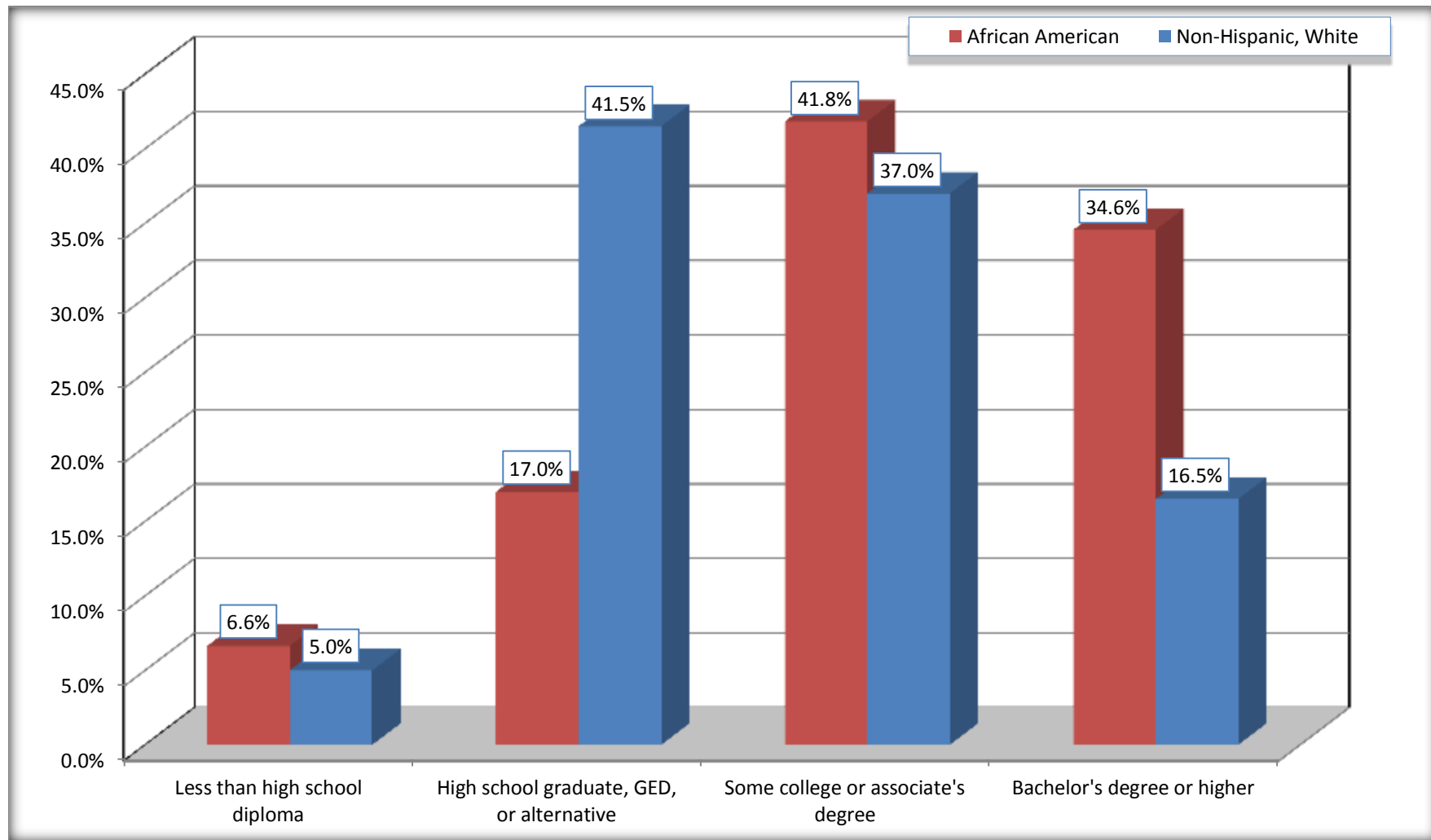
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# Educational Attainment for the Population 25 Years and Older

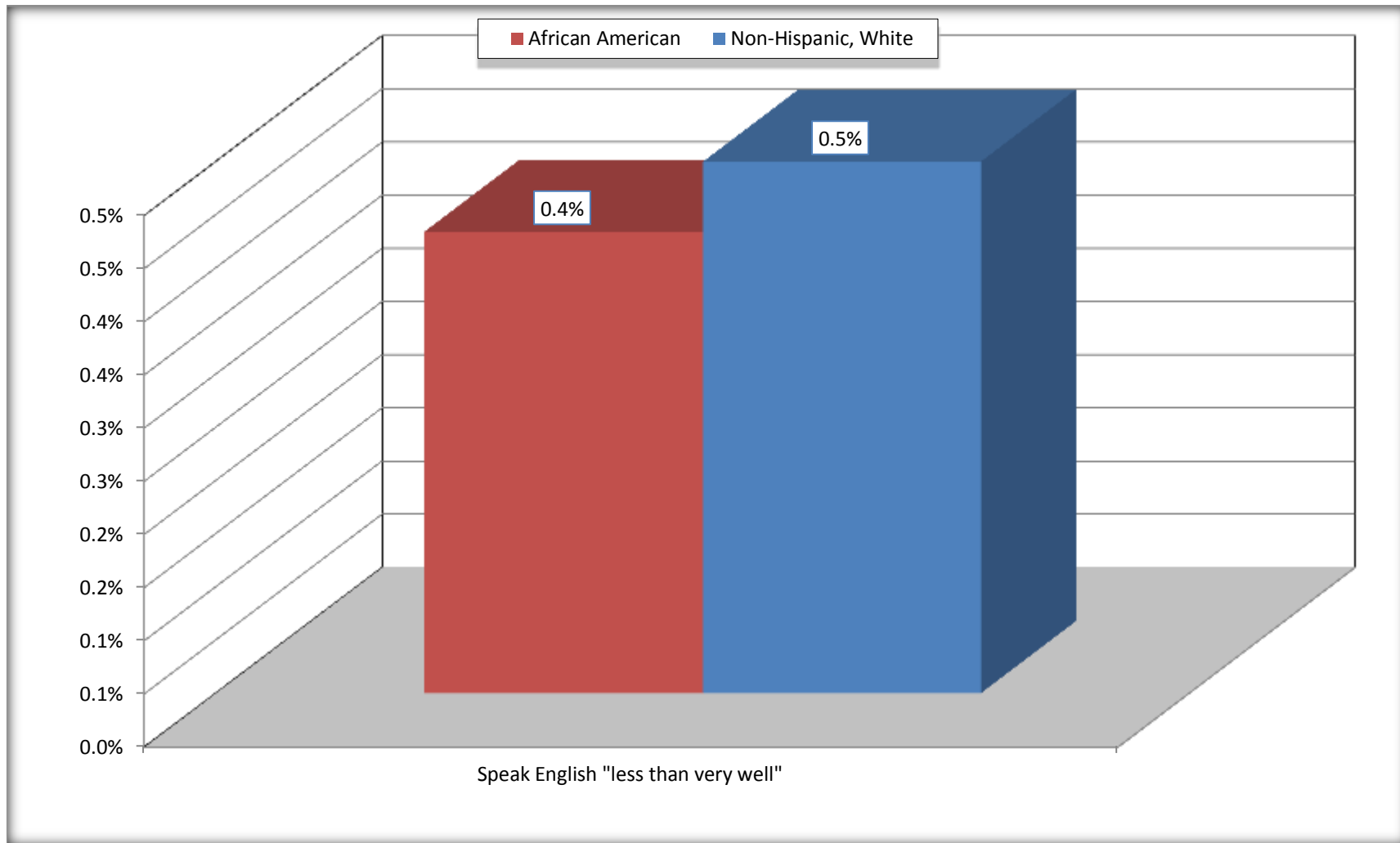

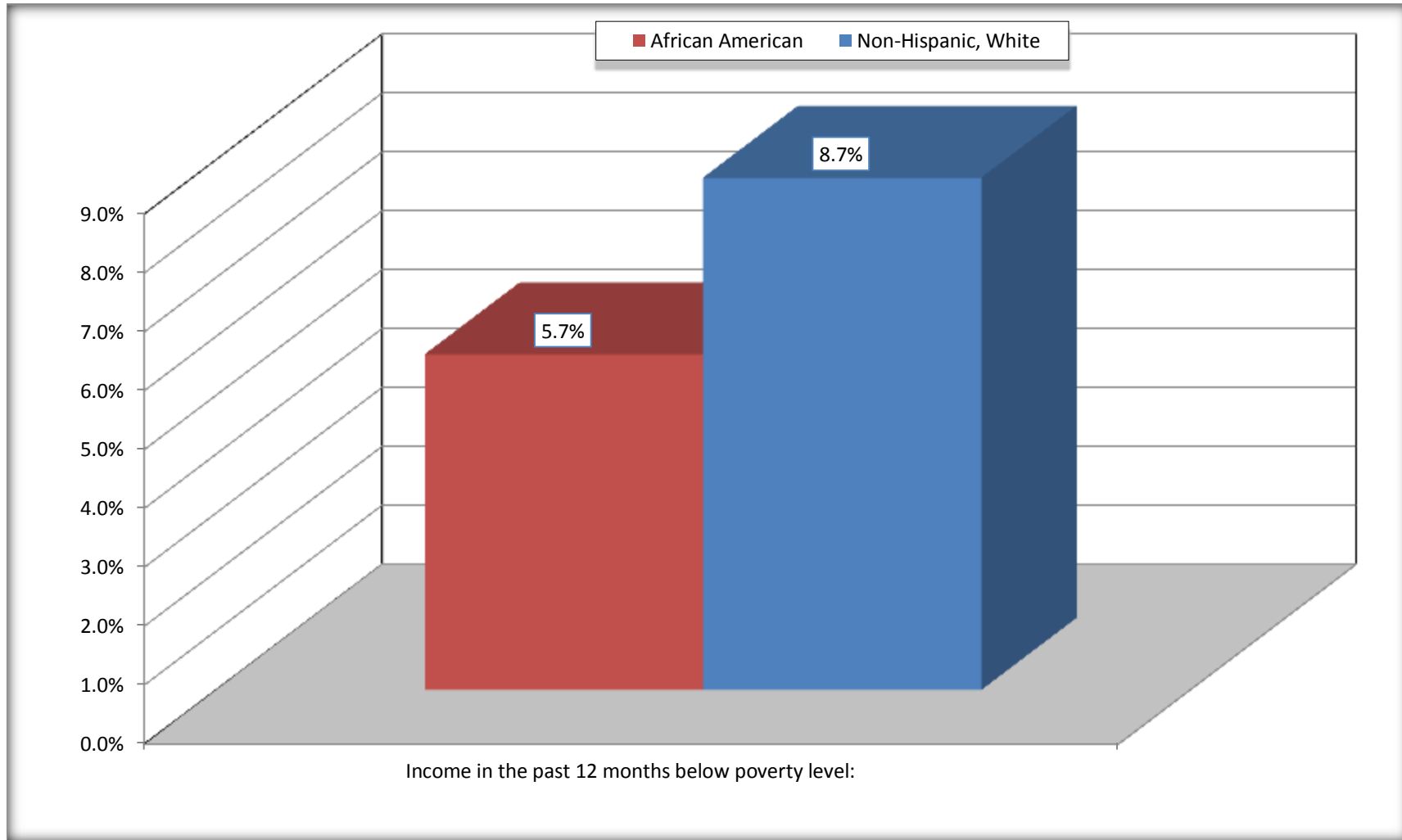

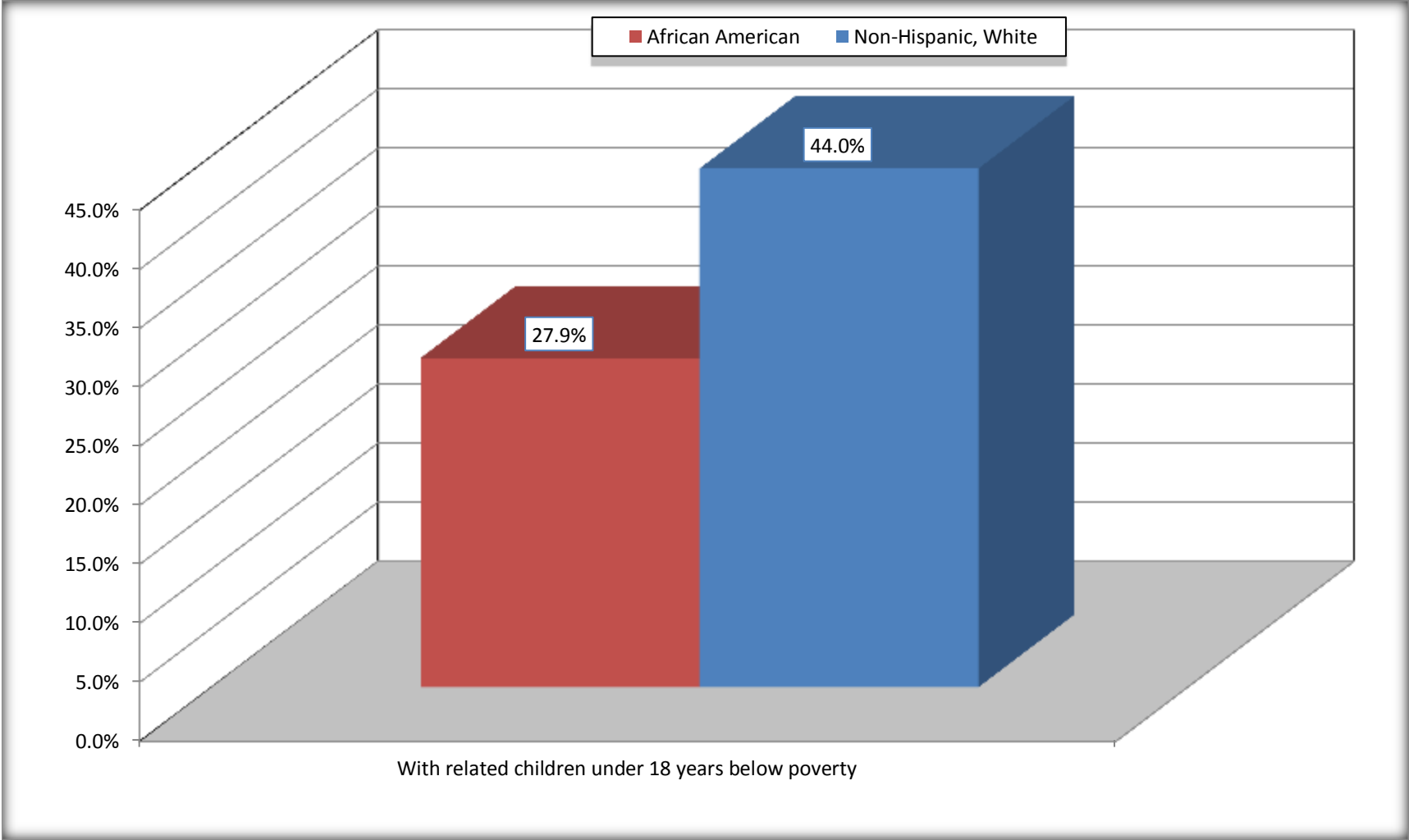

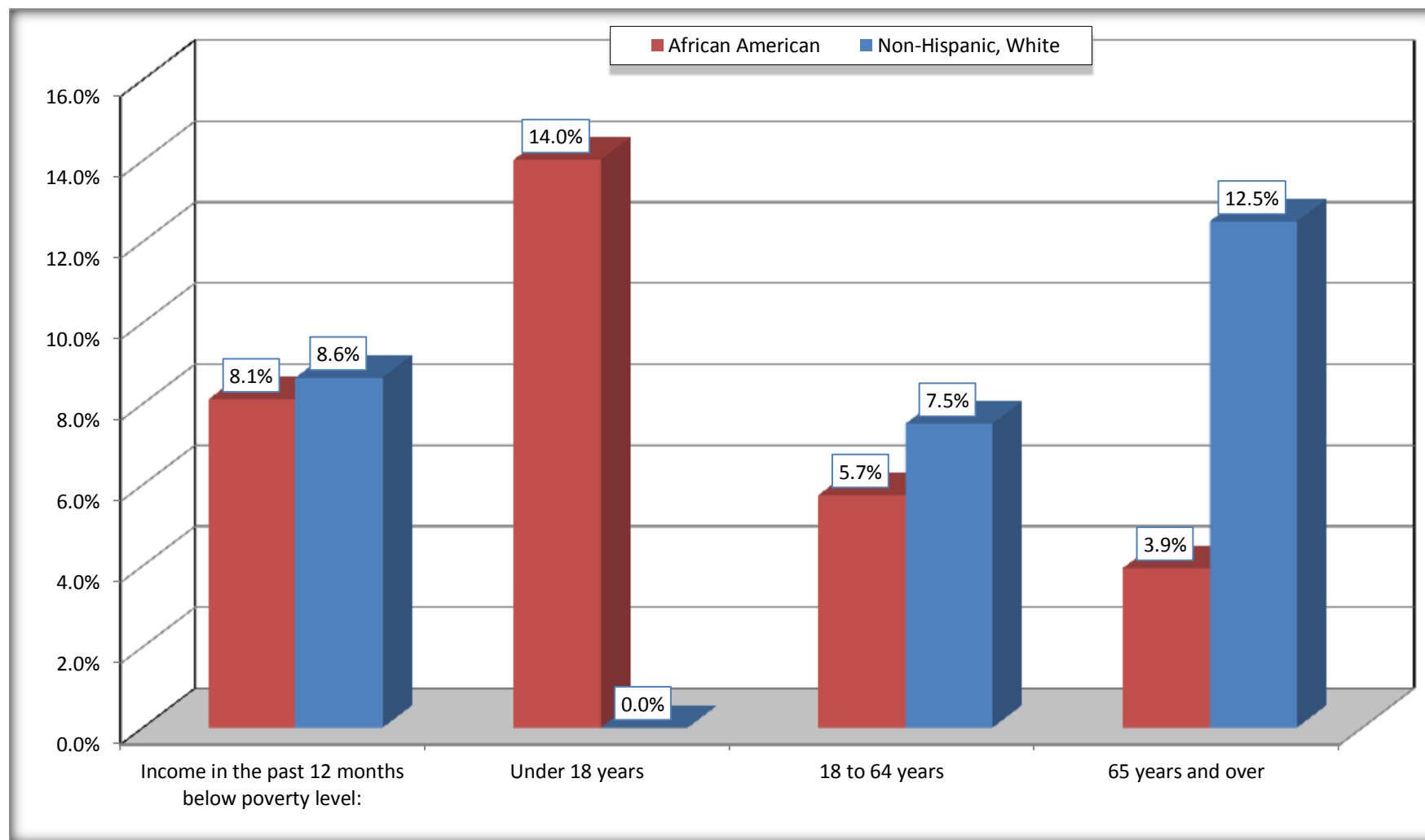

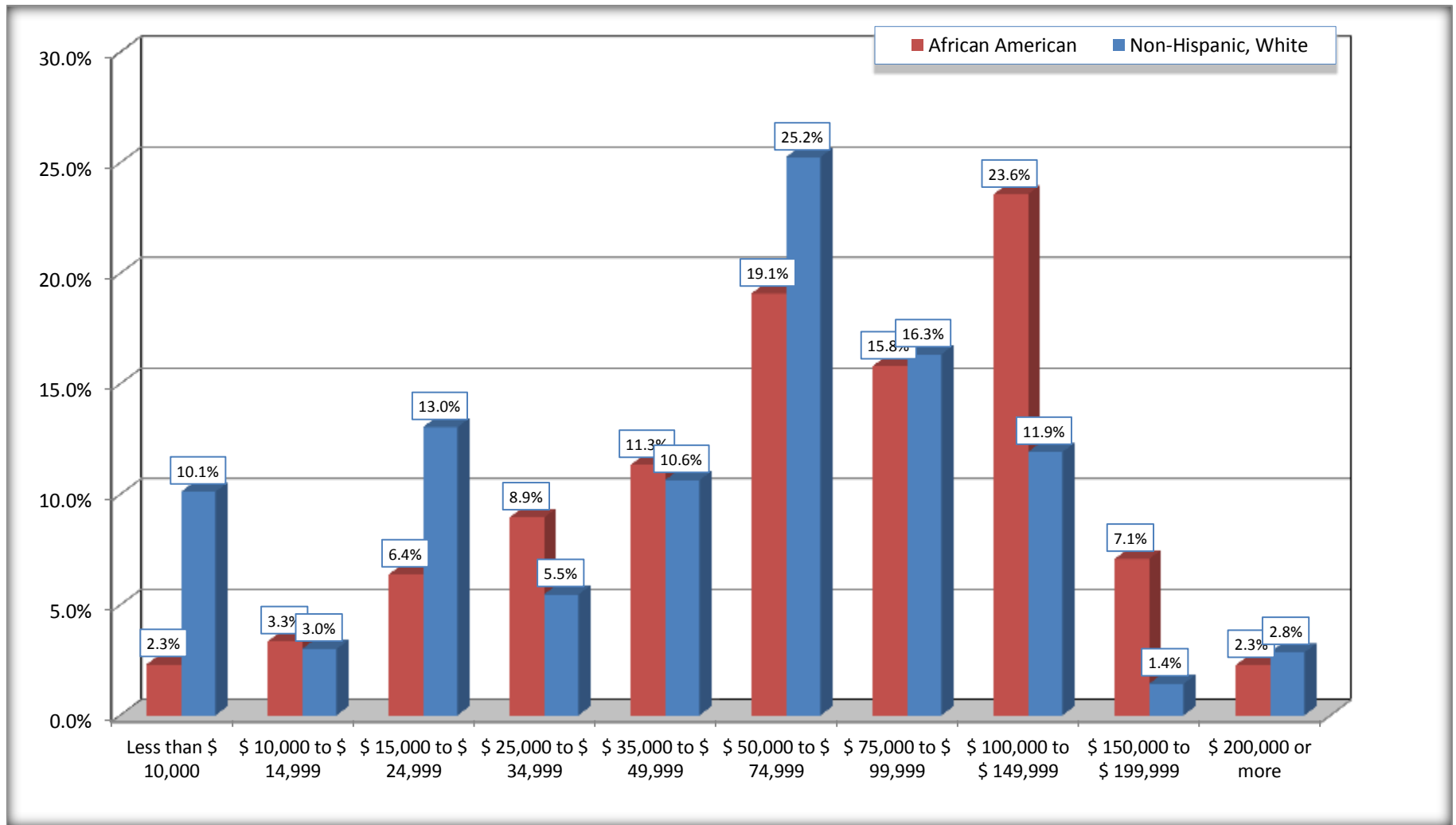

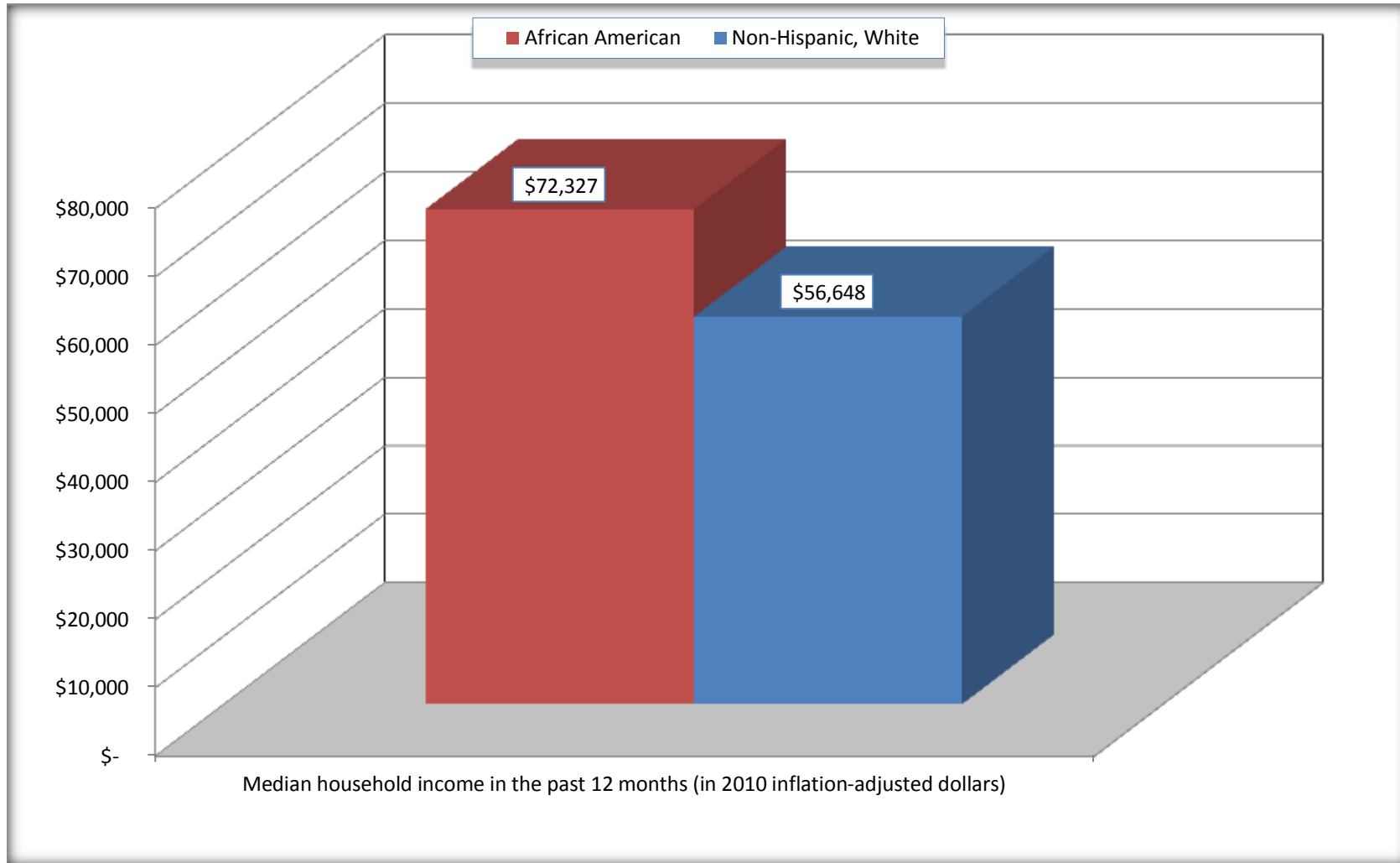

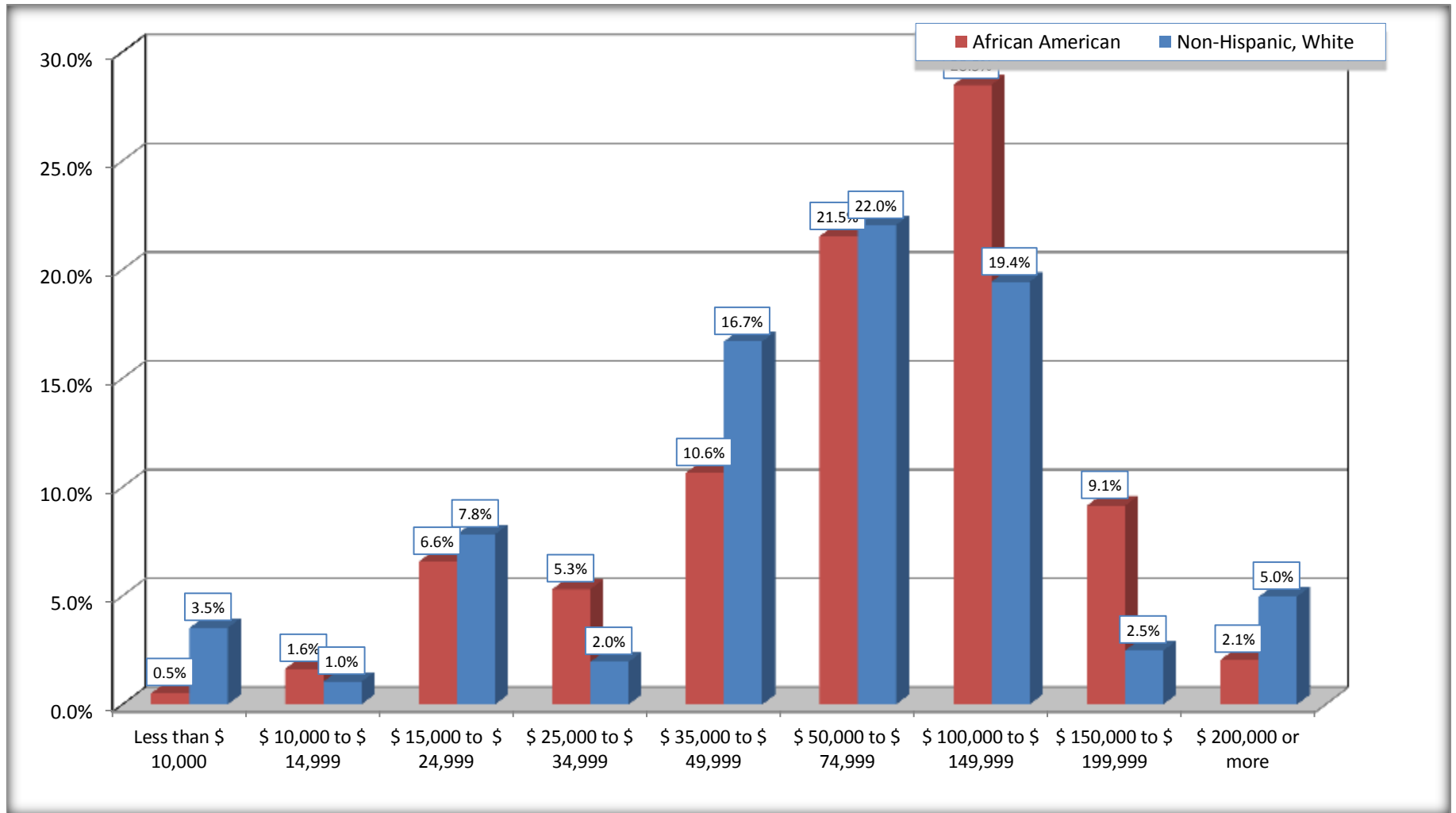

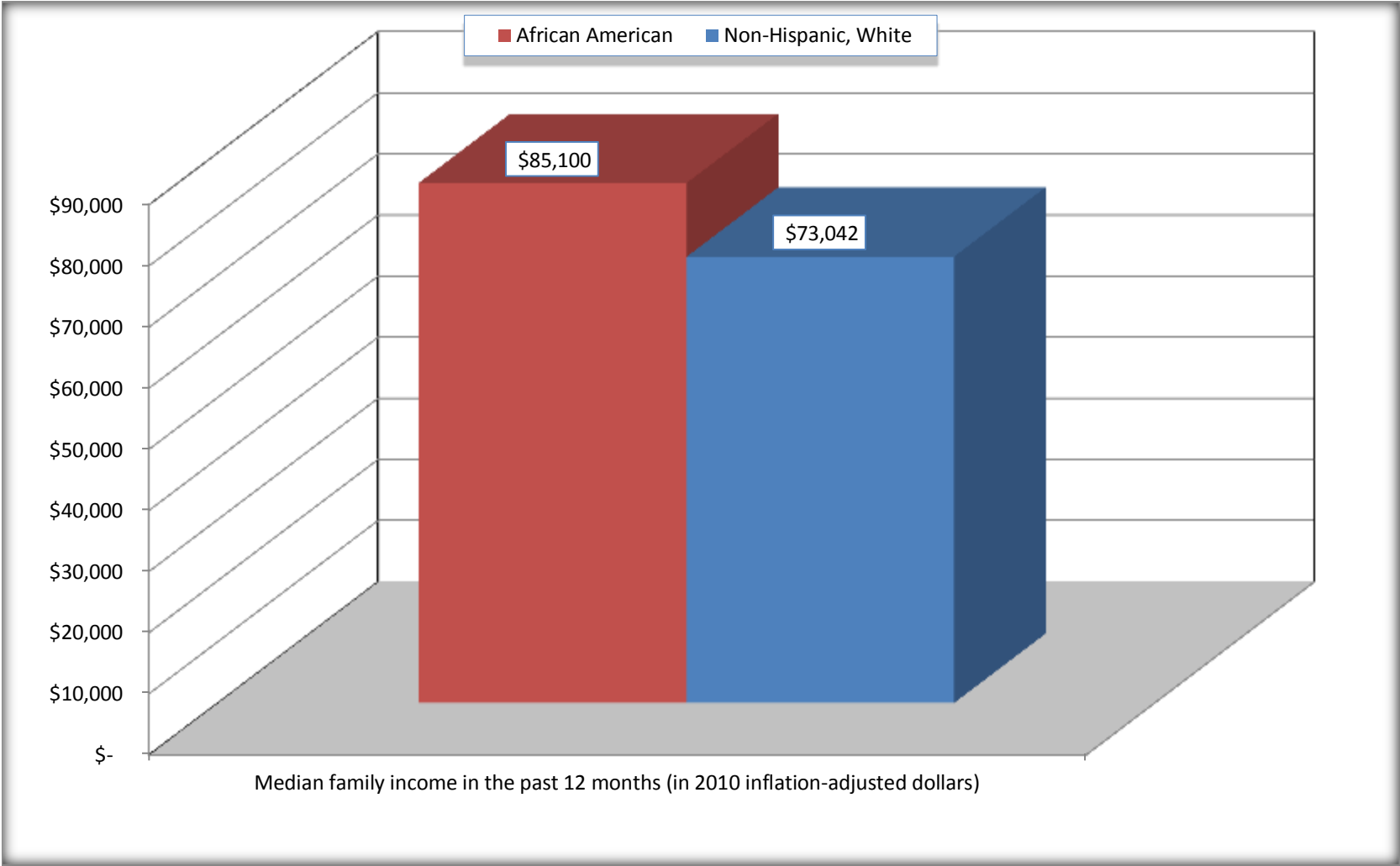

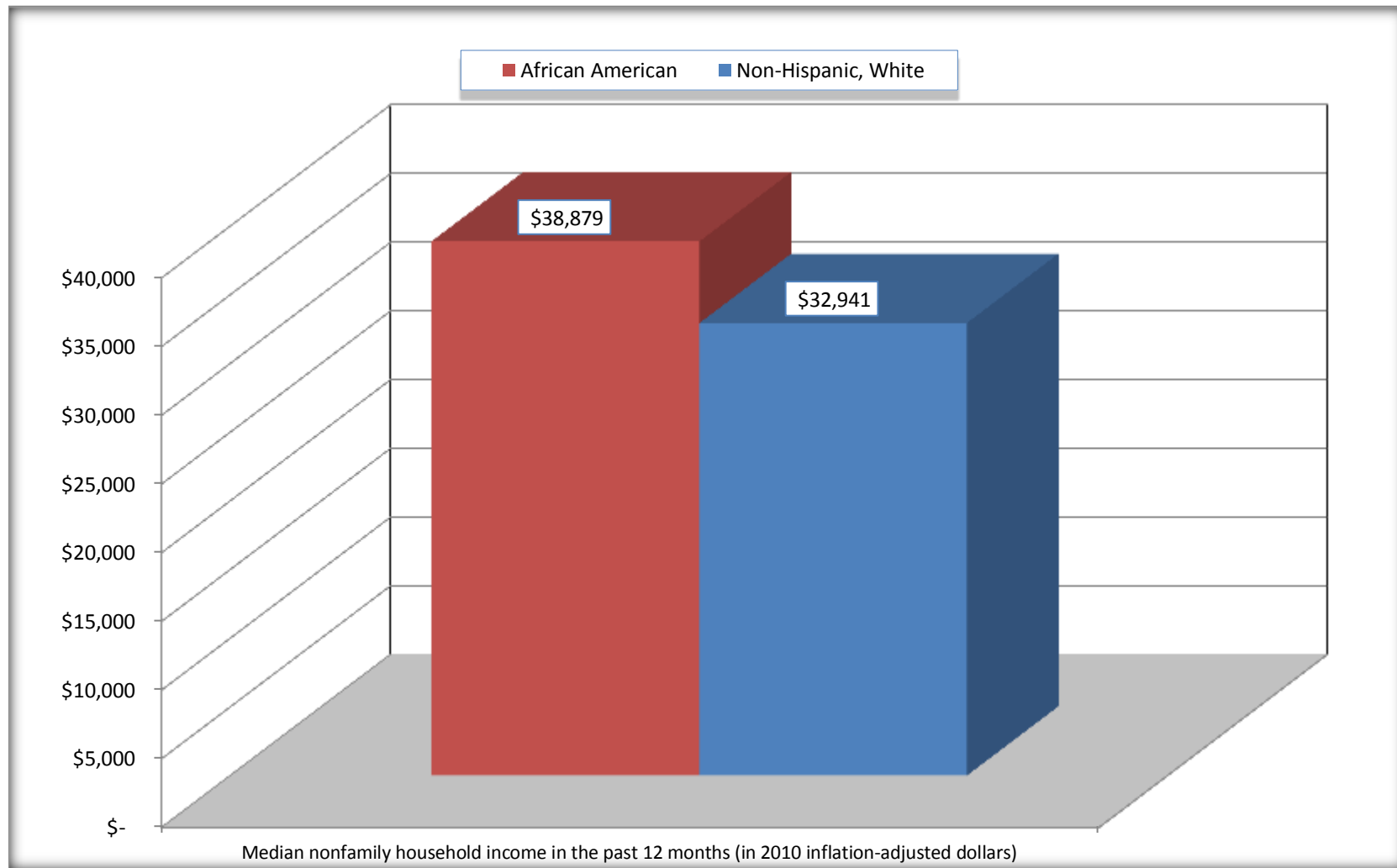

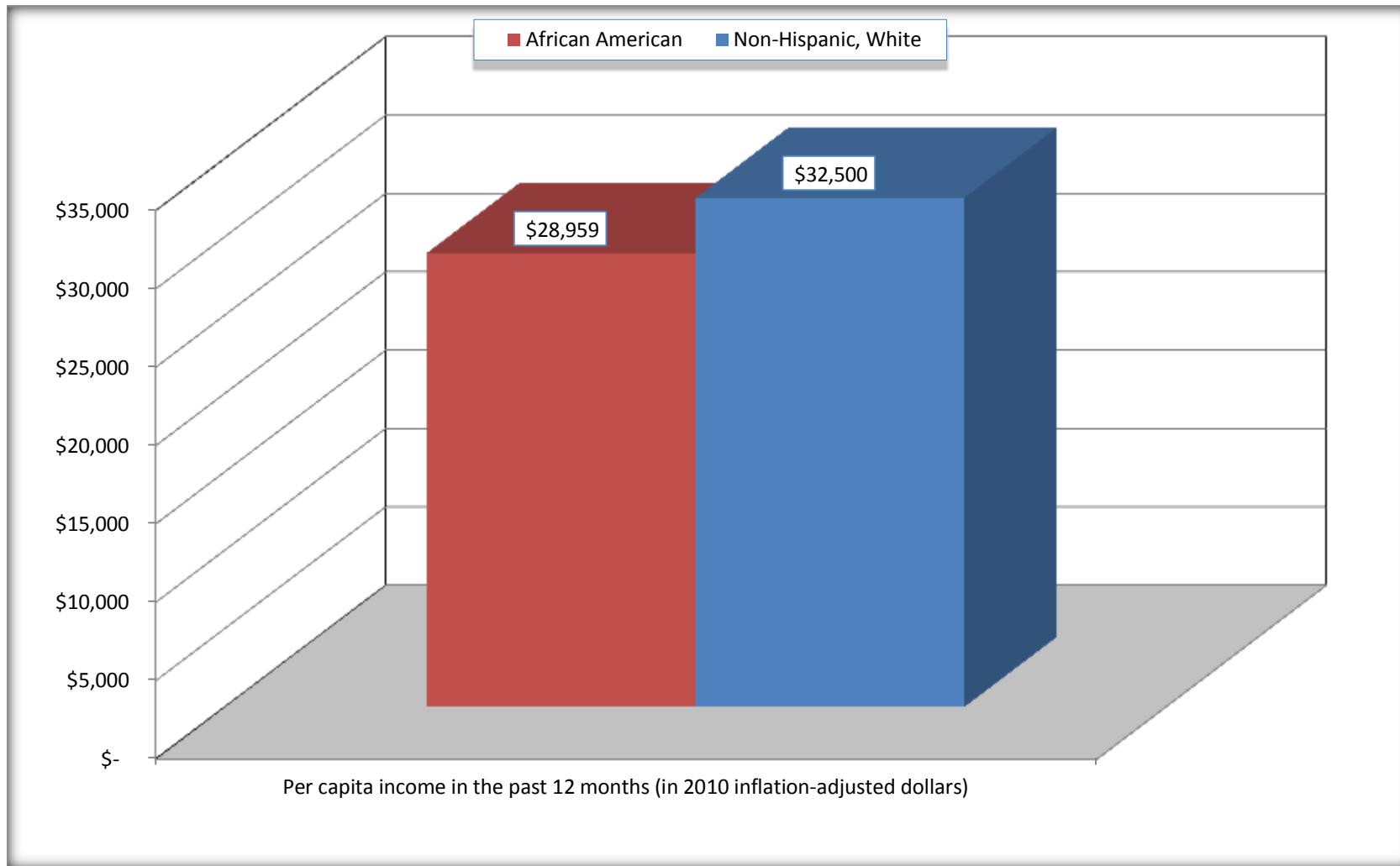

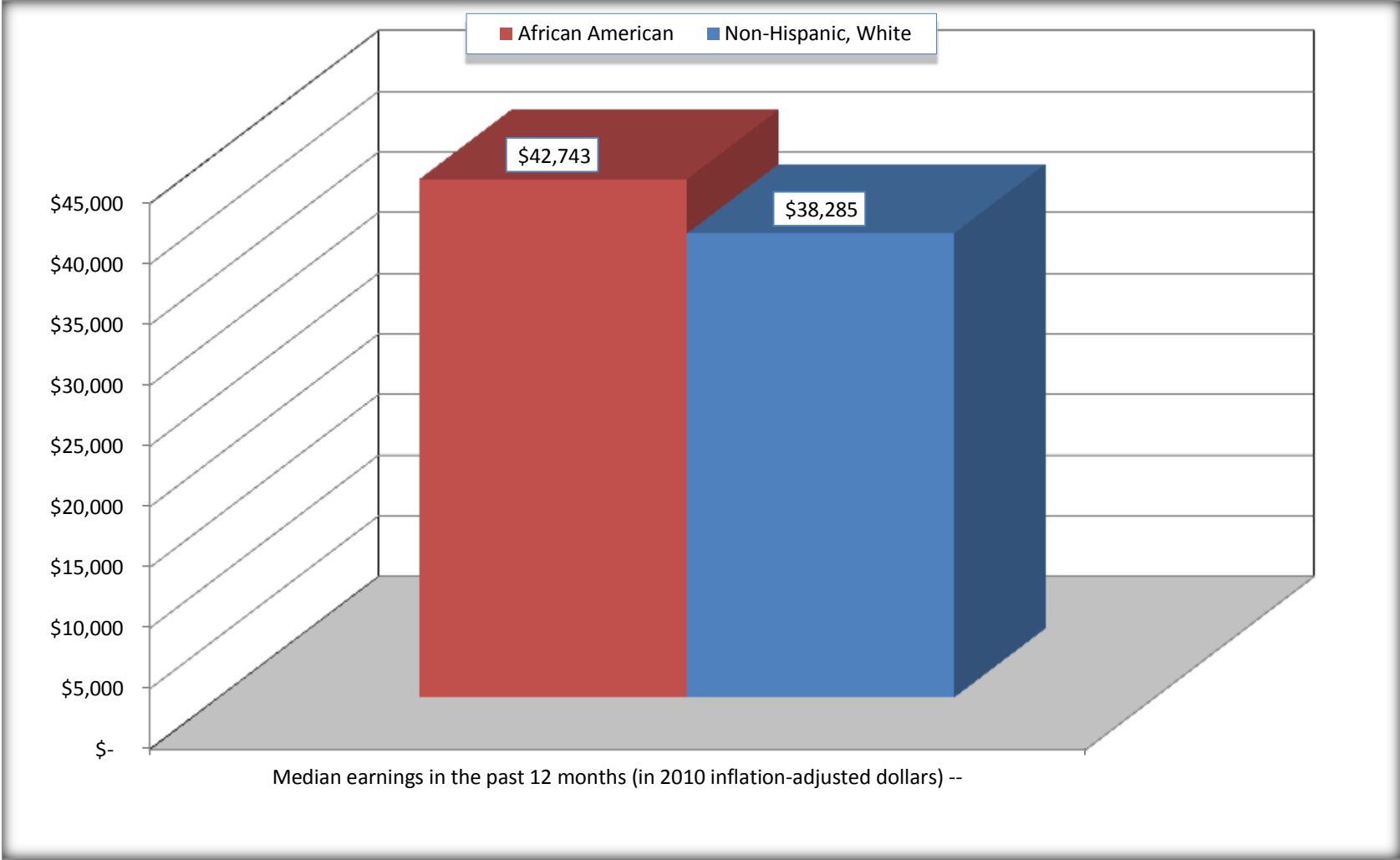

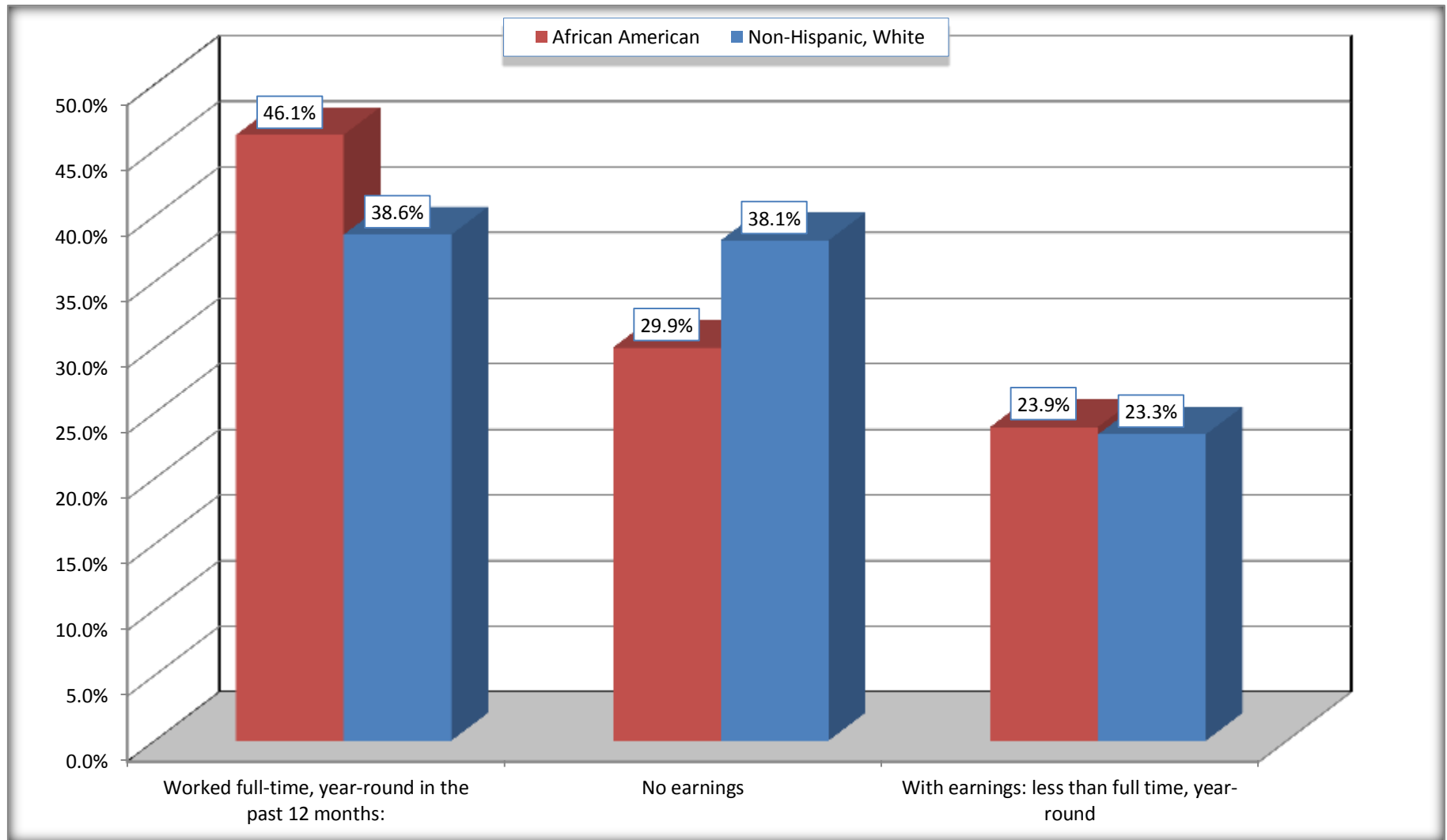

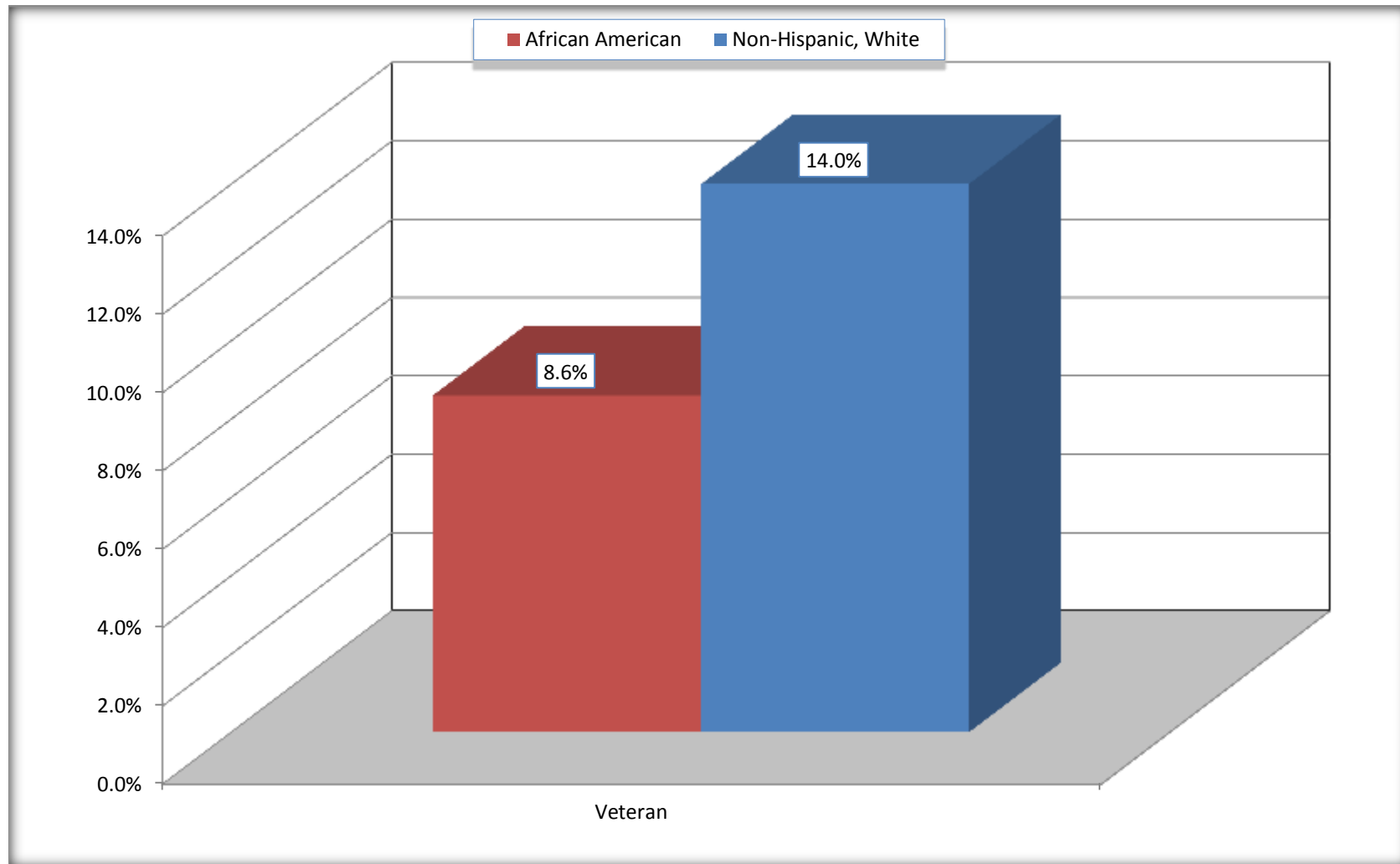

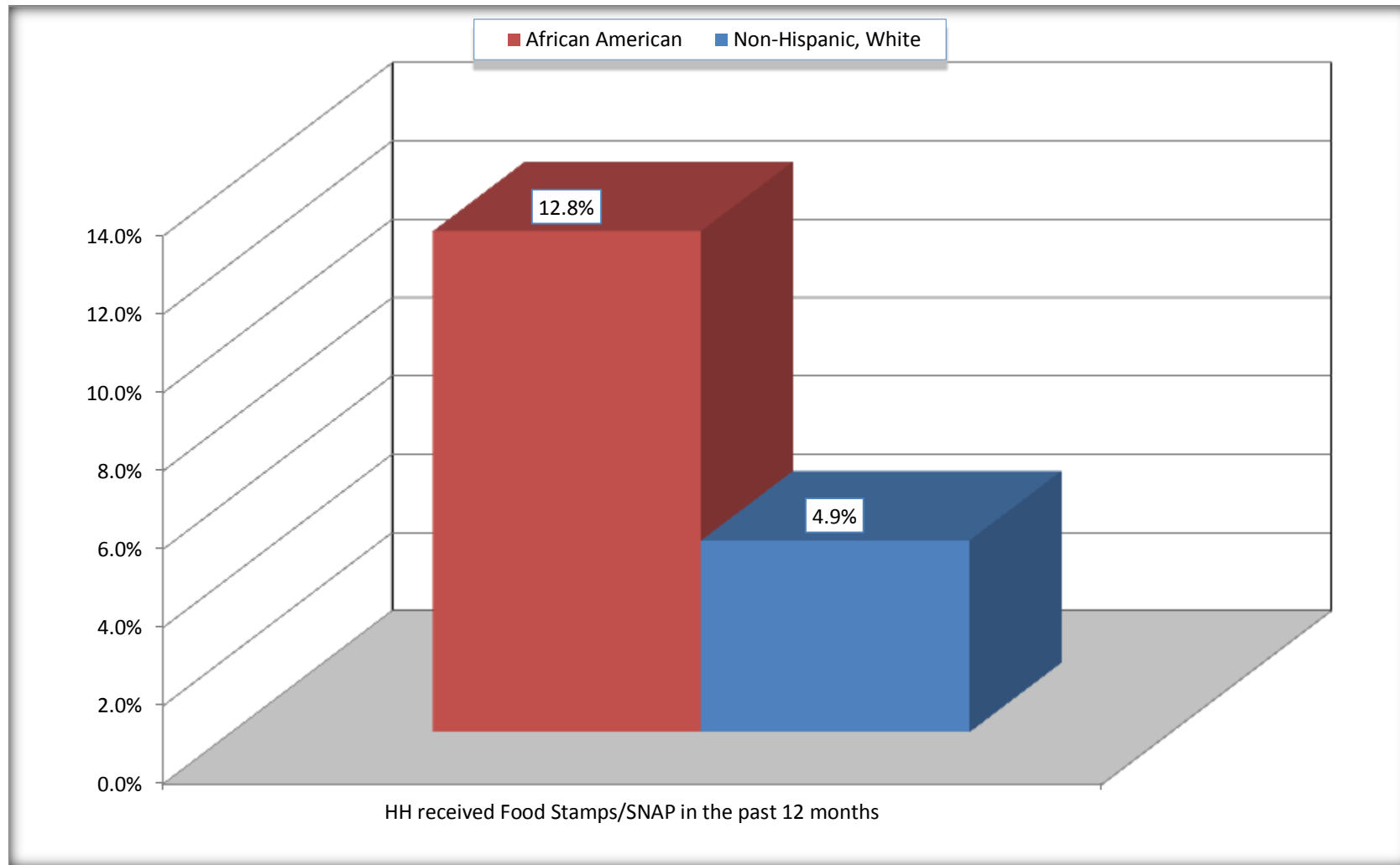

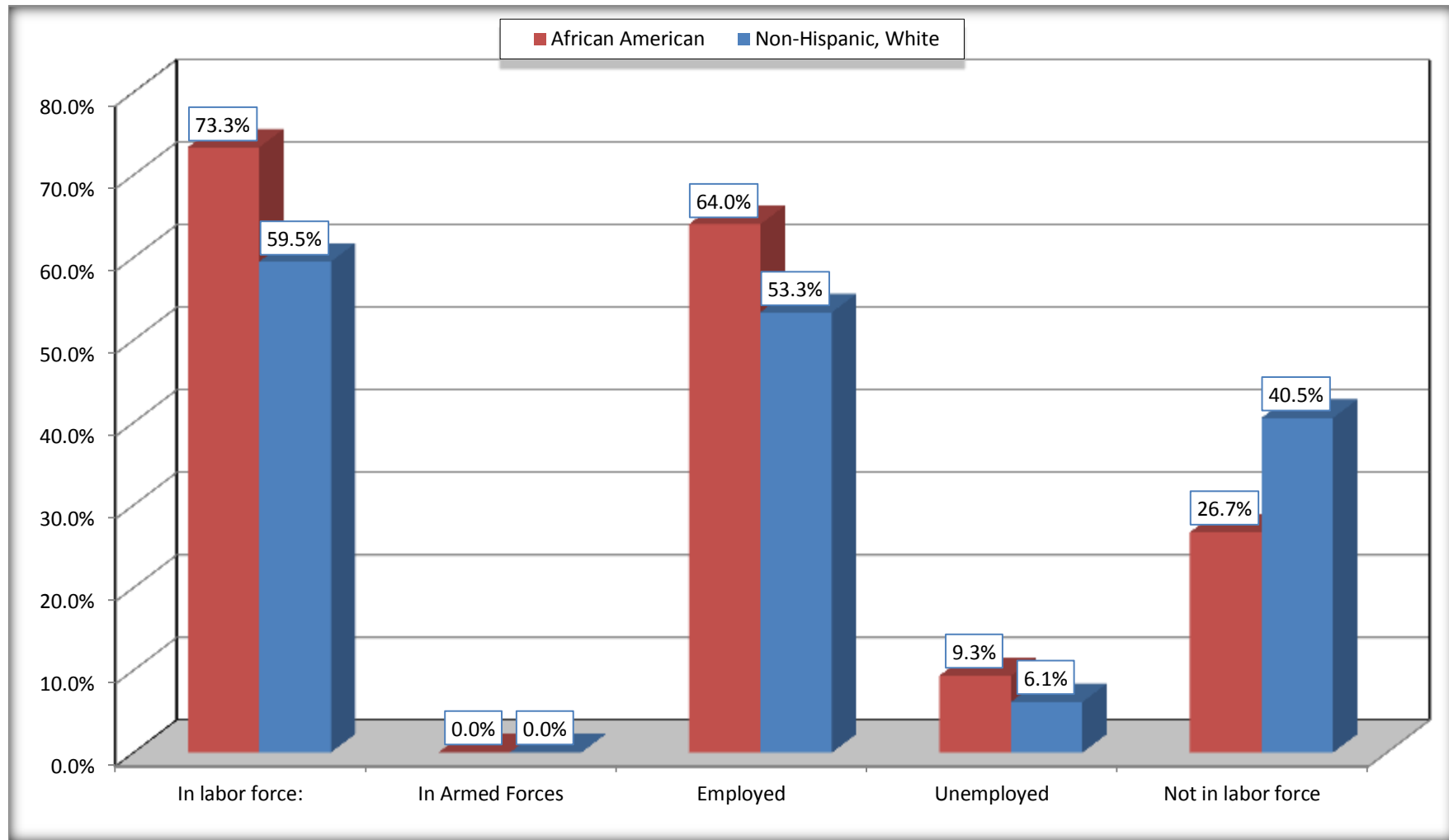

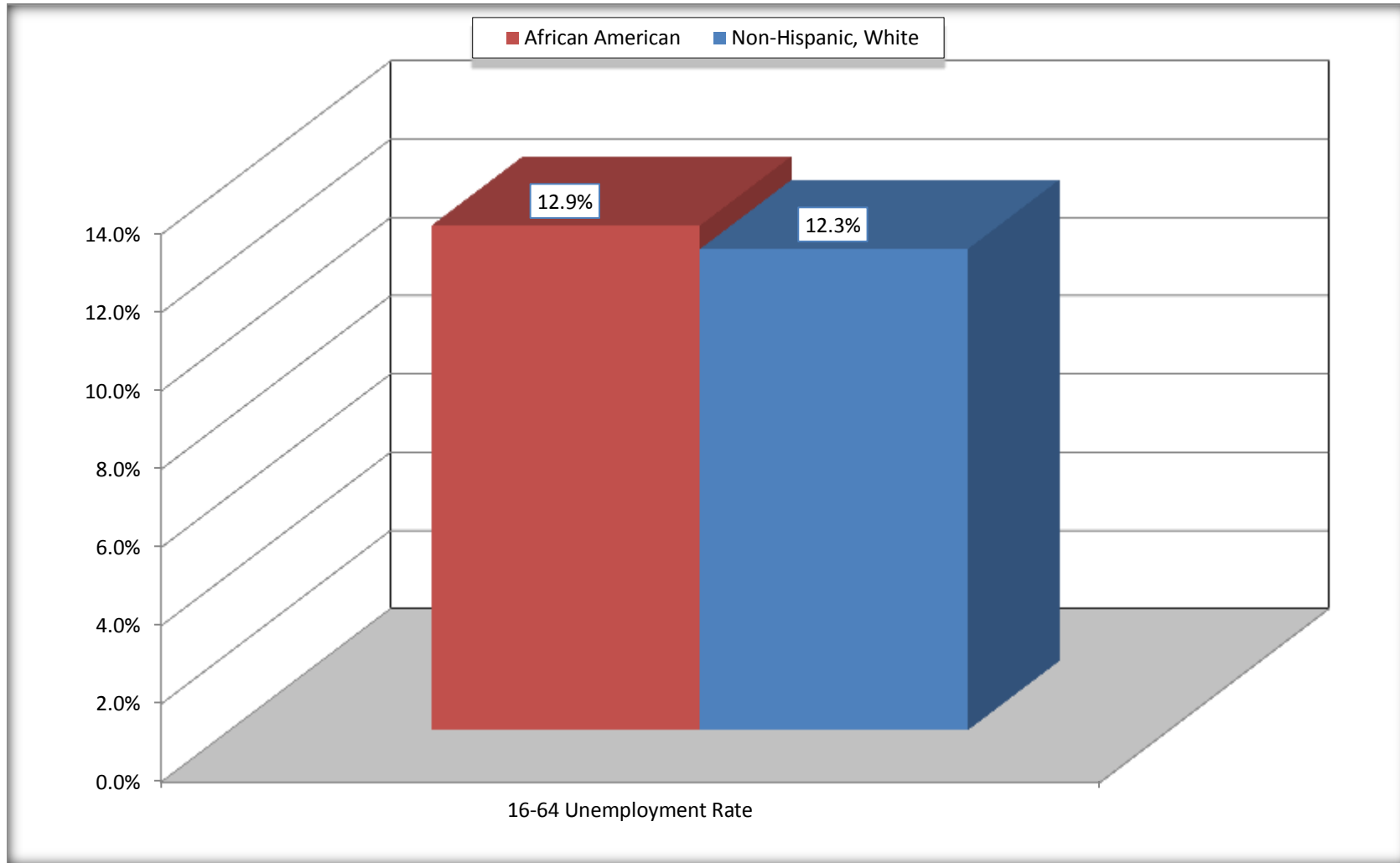

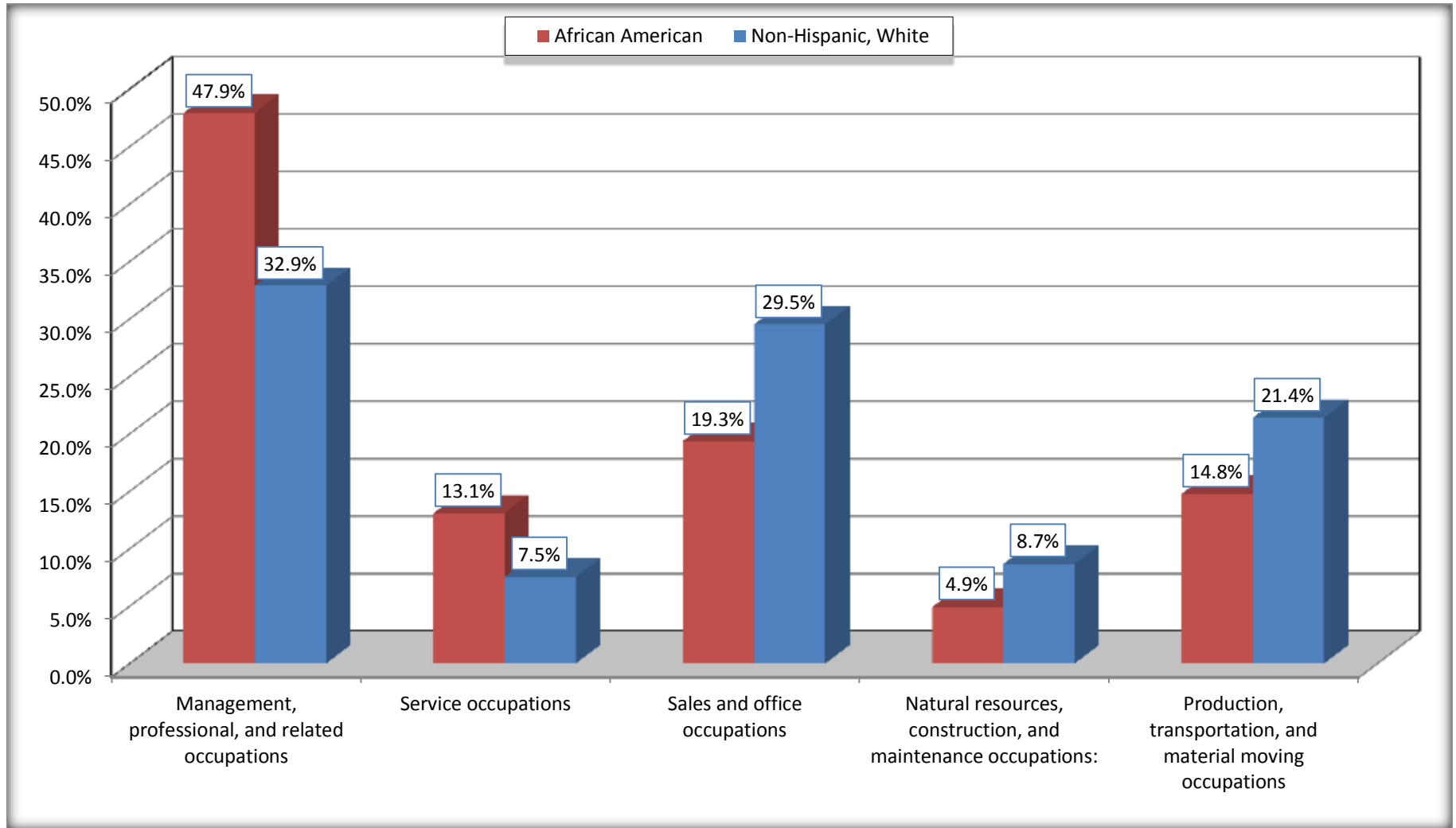

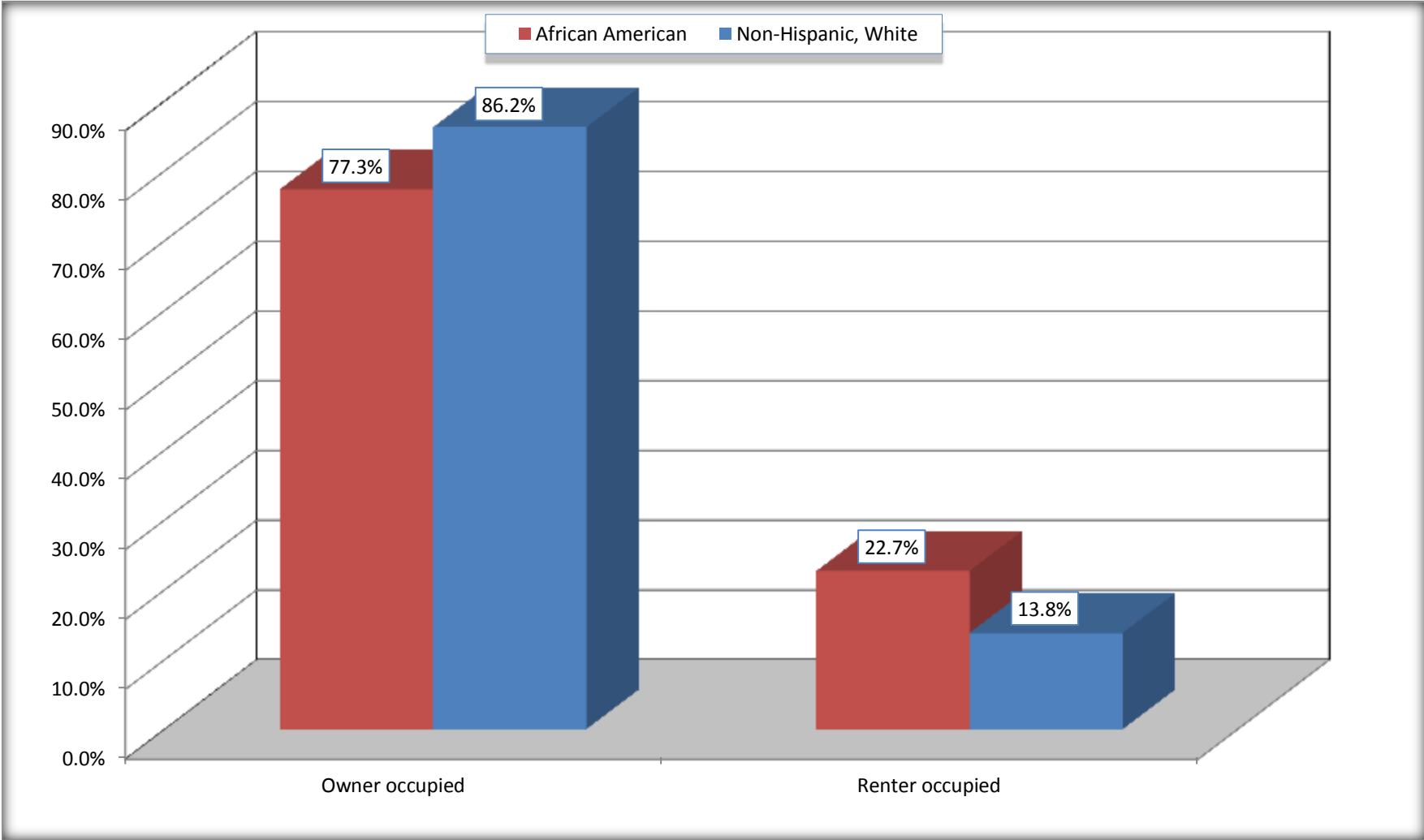

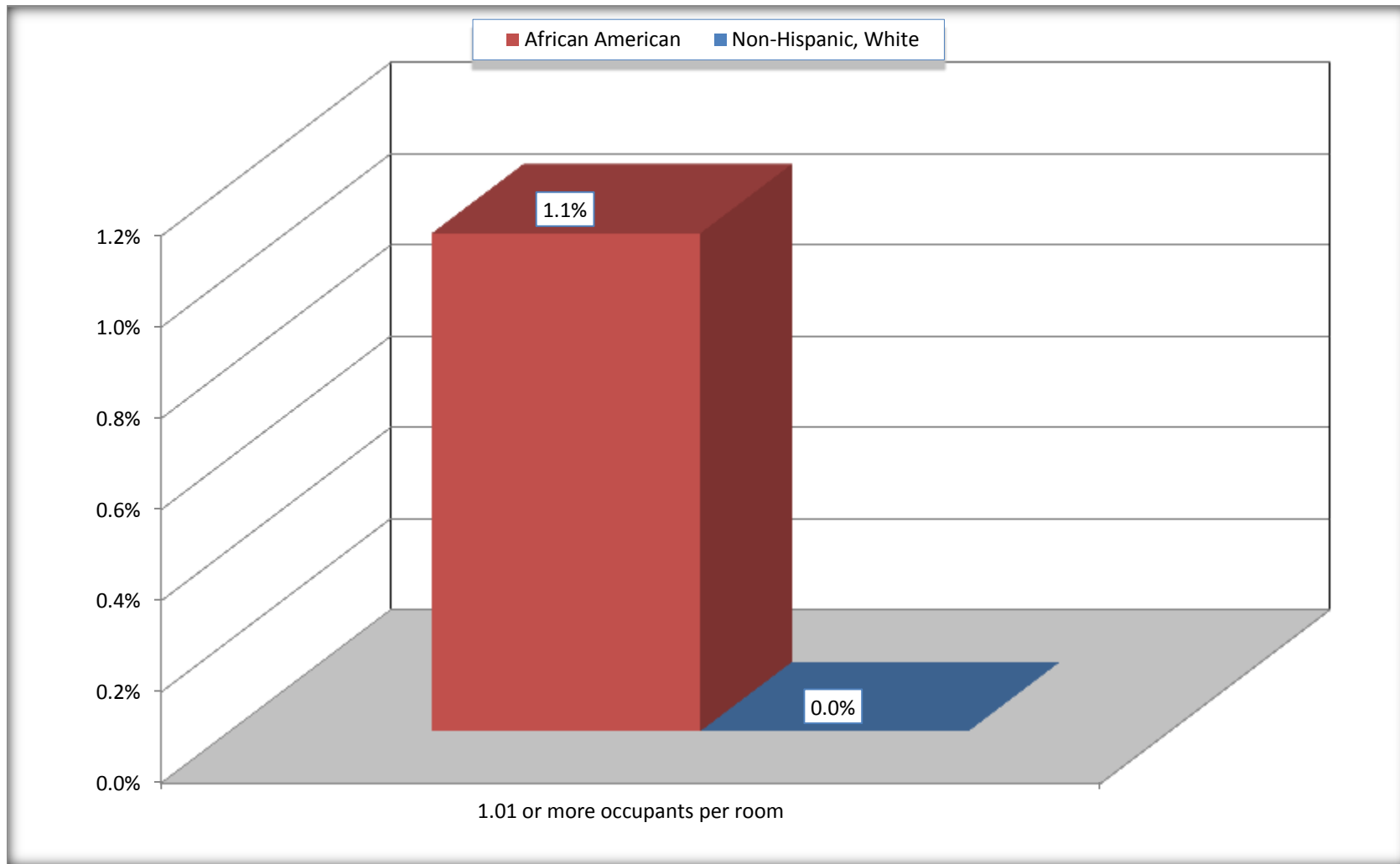

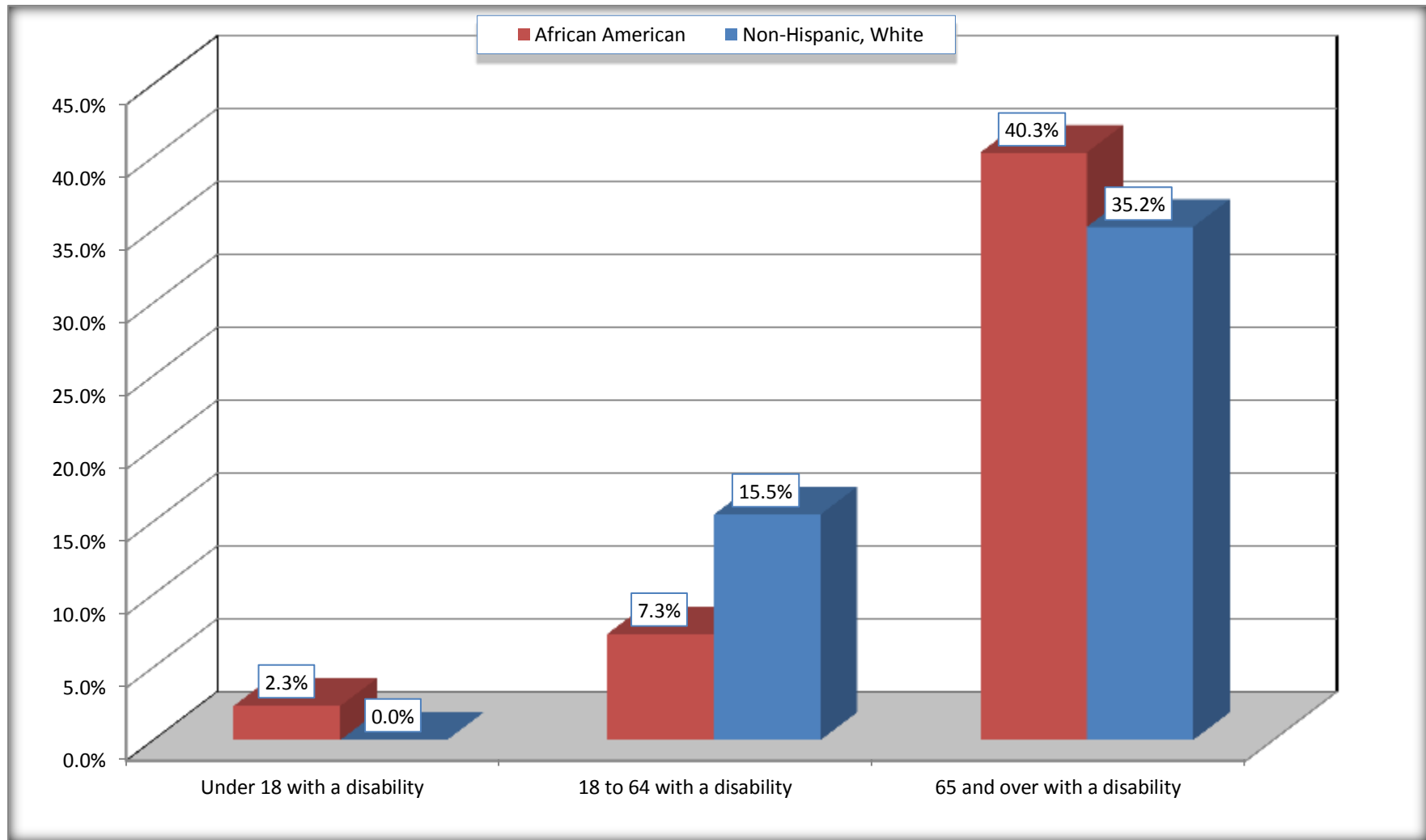

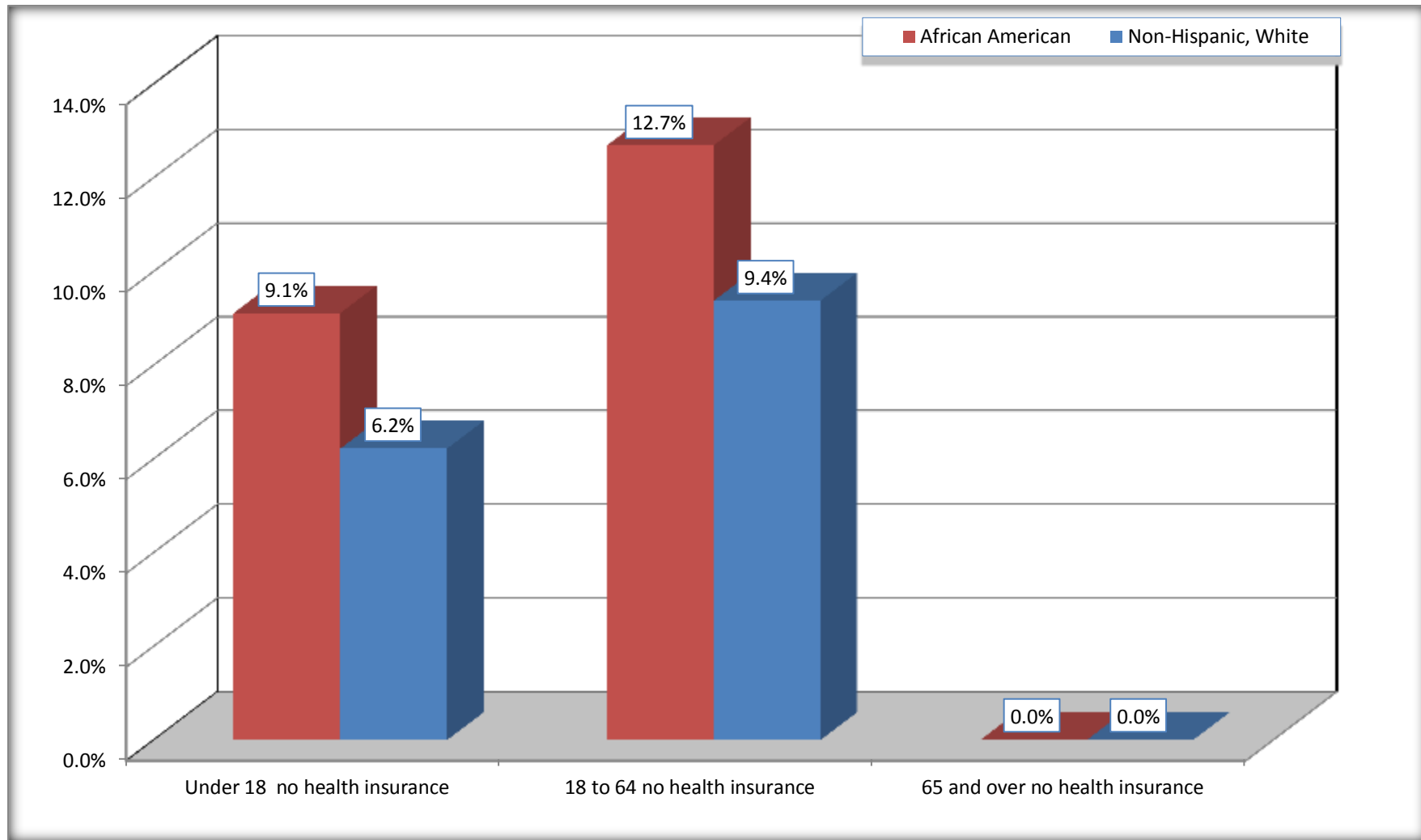
