



Chart 1 -- Single-Parent Family Households (Householder 15 to 64 years) Limestone County, Alabama





Chart 2 -- Private School Enrollment (3 years and over) Limestone County, Alabama






Chart 4 -- Unemployment Rate (Civilian Labor Force) Limestone County, Alabama


Chart 5 -- Labor Force Participation (Civilian Labor Force) Limestone County, Alabama



Chart 6 -- Household Income in 1999 Limestone County, Alabama





Chart 7 -- Median Family Income In 1999 Limestone County, Alabama





Chart 8 -- Per Capita Income In 1999 Limestone County, Alabama





Chart 9 -- Income in 1999 Below Poverty Level by Age Limestone County, Alabama





Chart 10 -- Median Earnings in 1999 Limestone County, Alabama





Chart 11 -- Renter-Occupied Housing Limestone County, Alabama





Chart 12 -- Occupants Per Room (Crowding) by Household Limestone County, Alabama





Chart 13 -- Lack of Telephone Service by Household Limestone County, Alabama





Chart 14 -- Lack of Vehicle By Household Limestone County, Alabama





Chart 15 -- Lack of Plumbing By Household Limestone County, Alabama





Chart 16 -- Gross Rent as a Percentage of Household Income in 1999 Limestone County, Alabama




