




**Chart 1 -- Single-Parent Family Households (Householder 15 to 64 years)

Chart 2 -- Private School Enrollment (3 years and over)




Chart 3 -- Educational Attainment (25 years and over)


Chart 4 -- Unemployment Rate (Civilian Labor Force)


Chart 5 -- Labor Force Participation (Civilian Labor Force) Atlanta, GA MSA


Chart 6 -- Household Income in 1999 **Atlanta, GA MSA**

Chart 7 -- Median Family Income In 1999




Chart 8 -- Per Capita Income In 1999



Chart 9 -- Income in 1999 Below Poverty Level by Age Atlanta, GA MSA







Chart 11 -- Renter-Occupied Housing Atlanta, GA MSA





Chart 12 -- Occupants Per Room (Crowding) by Household Atlanta, GA MSA











Atlanta, GA MSA




