





Chart 2 -- Private School Enrollment (3 years and over) Hawaii County, Hawaii






Chart 4 -- Unemployment Rate (Civilian Labor Force) Hawaii County, Hawaii


Chart 5 -- Labor Force Participation (Civilian Labor Force)



Chart 6 -- Household Income in 1999 Hawaii County, Hawaii





Chart 7 -- Median Family Income In 1999 Hawaii County, Hawaii





Chart 8 -- Per Capita Income In 1999 Hawaii County, Hawaii





Chart 9 -- Income in 1999 Below Poverty Level by Age Hawaii County, Hawaii





Chart 10 -- Median Earnings in 1999 Hawaii County, Hawaii





Chart 11 -- Renter-Occupied Housing Hawaii County, Hawaii





Chart 12 -- Occupants Per Room (Crowding) by Household Hawaii County, Hawaii





Chart 13 -- Lack of Telephone Service by Household Hawaii County, Hawaii





Chart 14 -- Lack of Vehicle By Household Hawaii County, Hawaii





Chart 15 -- Lack of Plumbing By Household Hawaii County, Hawaii





Chart 16 -- Gross Rent as a Percentage of Household Income in 1999 Hawaii County, Hawaii




