

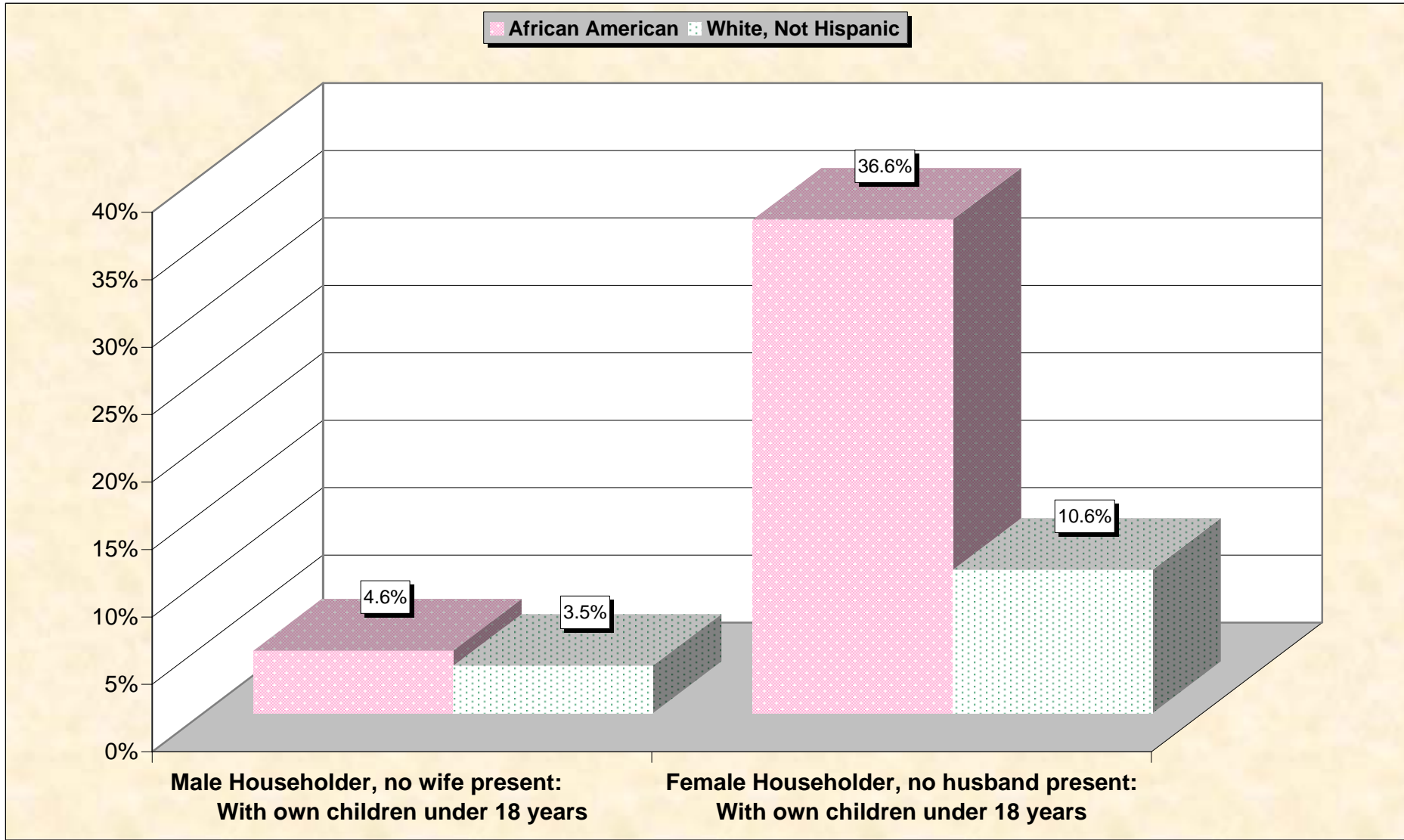

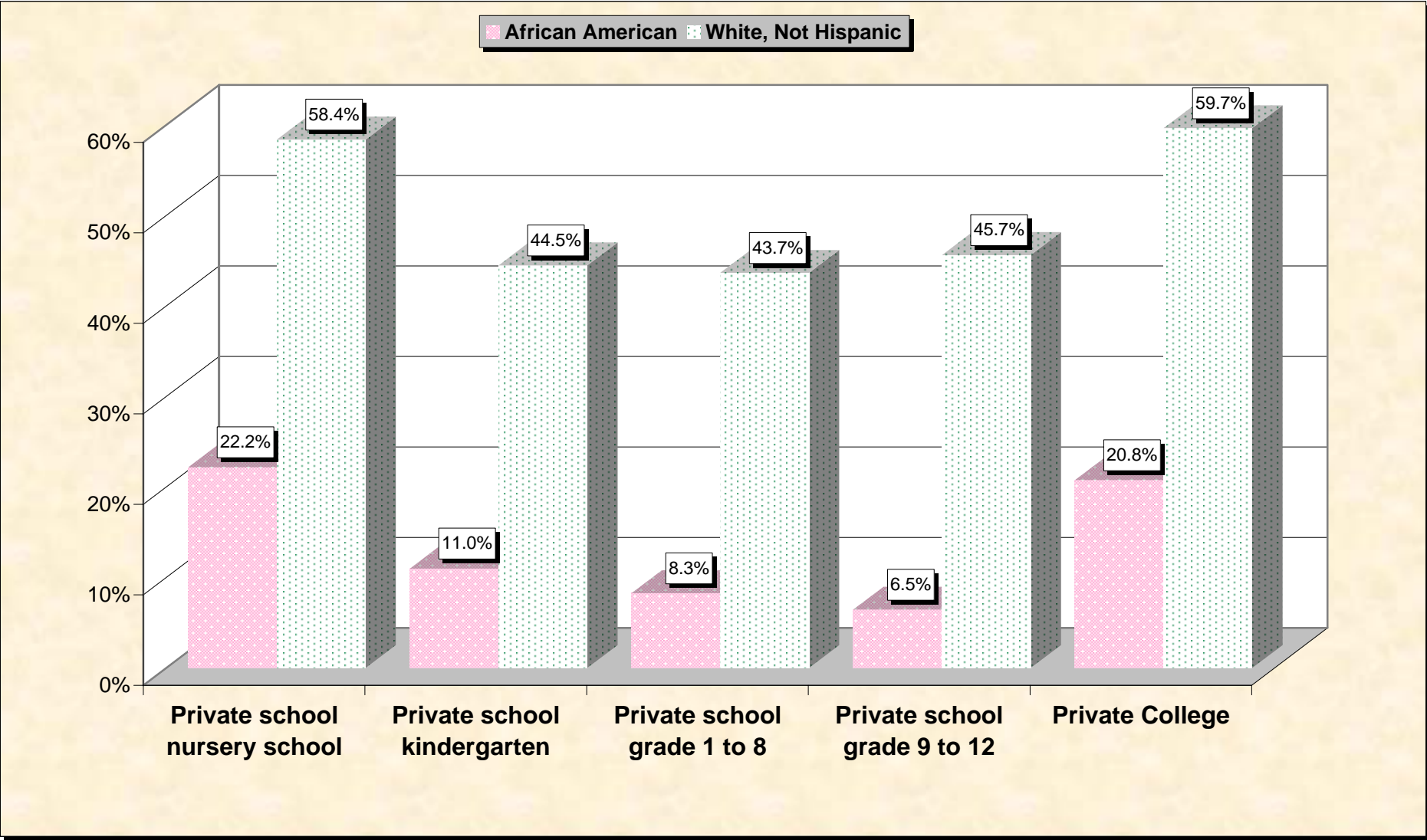

Chart 1 -- Single-Parent Family Households (Householder 15 to 64 years) Baltimore city, Maryland



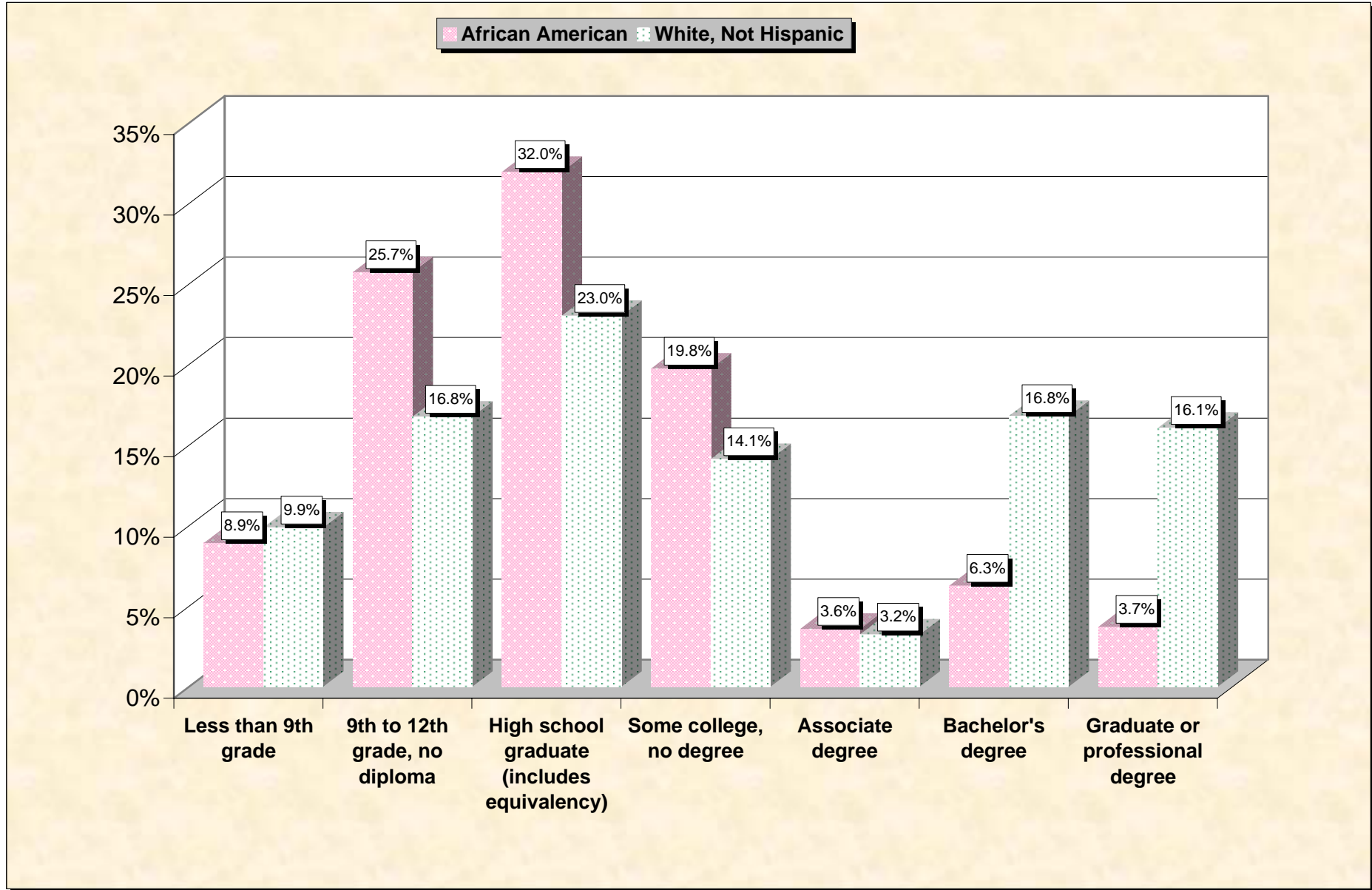

Chart 2 -- Private School Enrollment (3 years and over) Baltimore city, Maryland



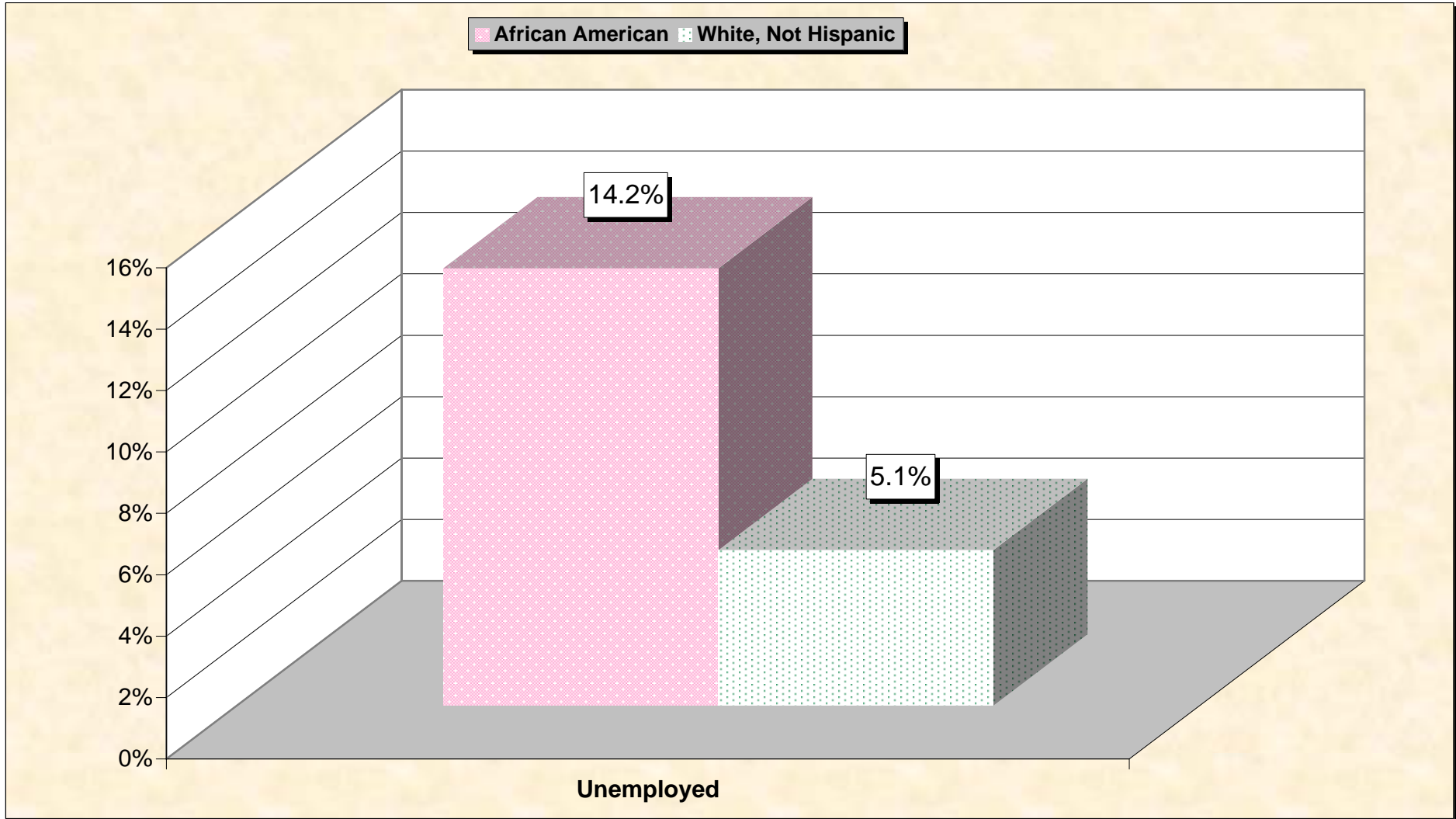

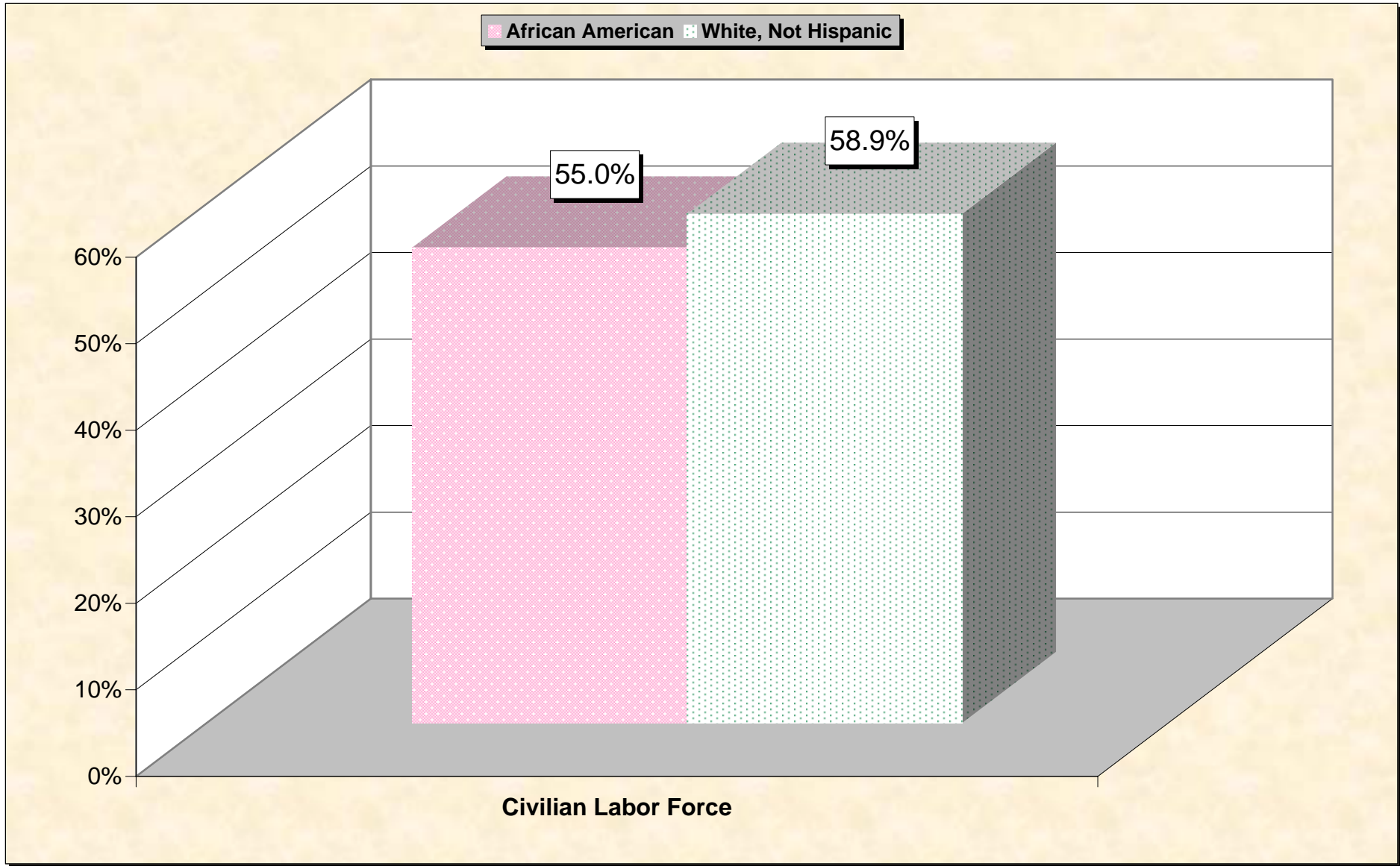
Chart 4 -- Unemployment Rate (Civilian Labor Force) Baltimore city, Maryland

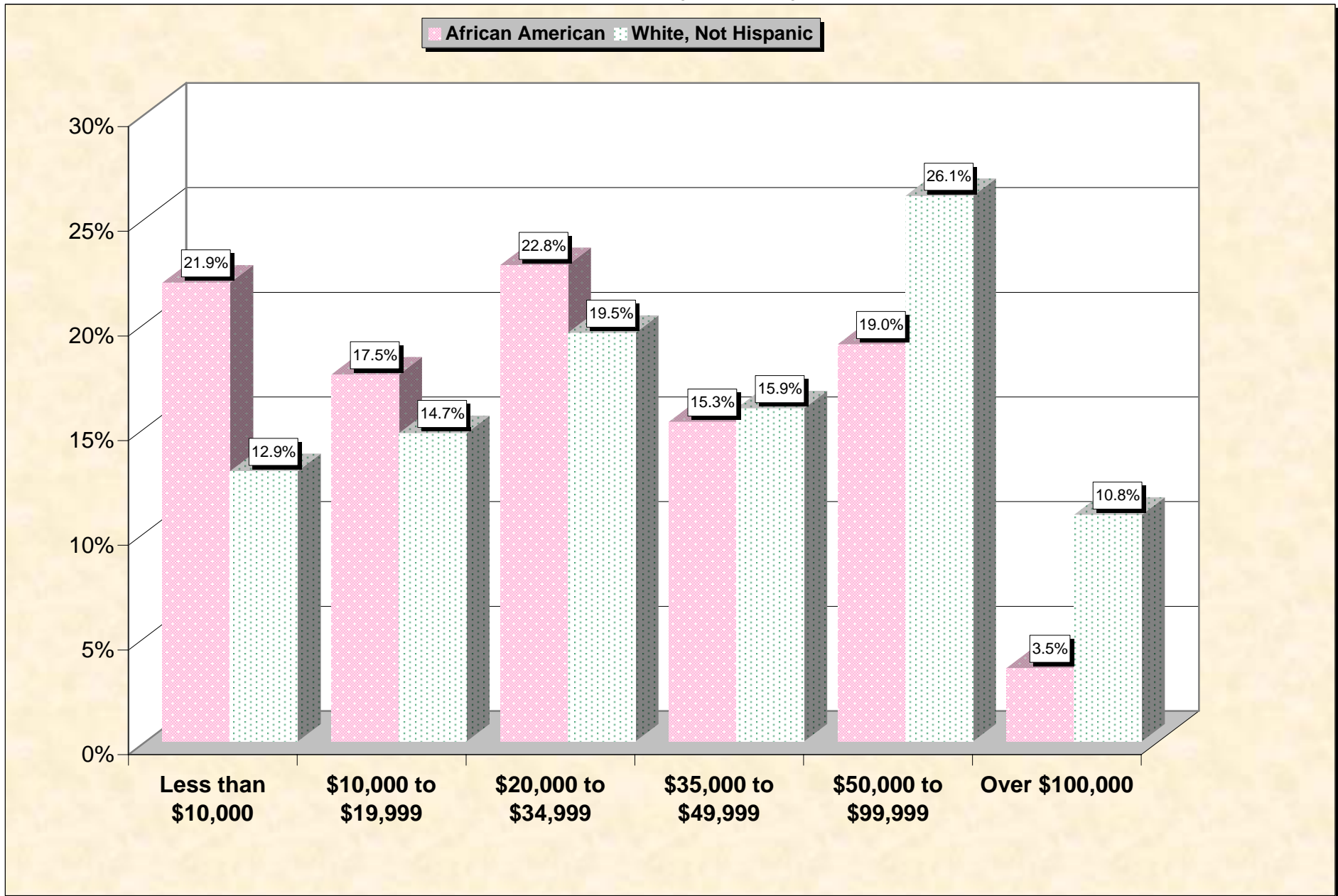
Chart 5 -- Labor Force Participation (Civilian Labor Force) Baltimore city, Maryland

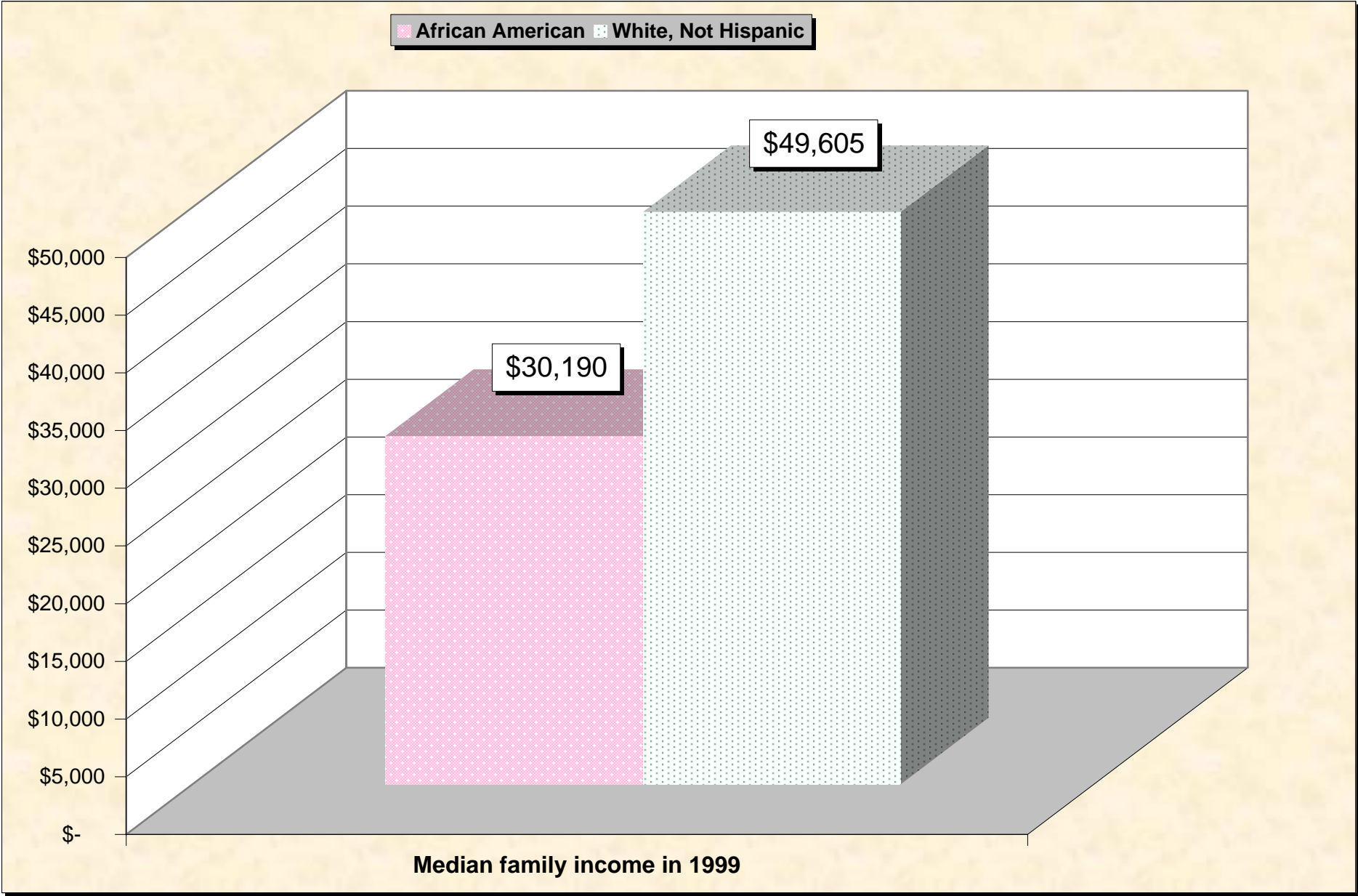
Chart 6 -- Household Income in 1999 Baltimore city, Maryland

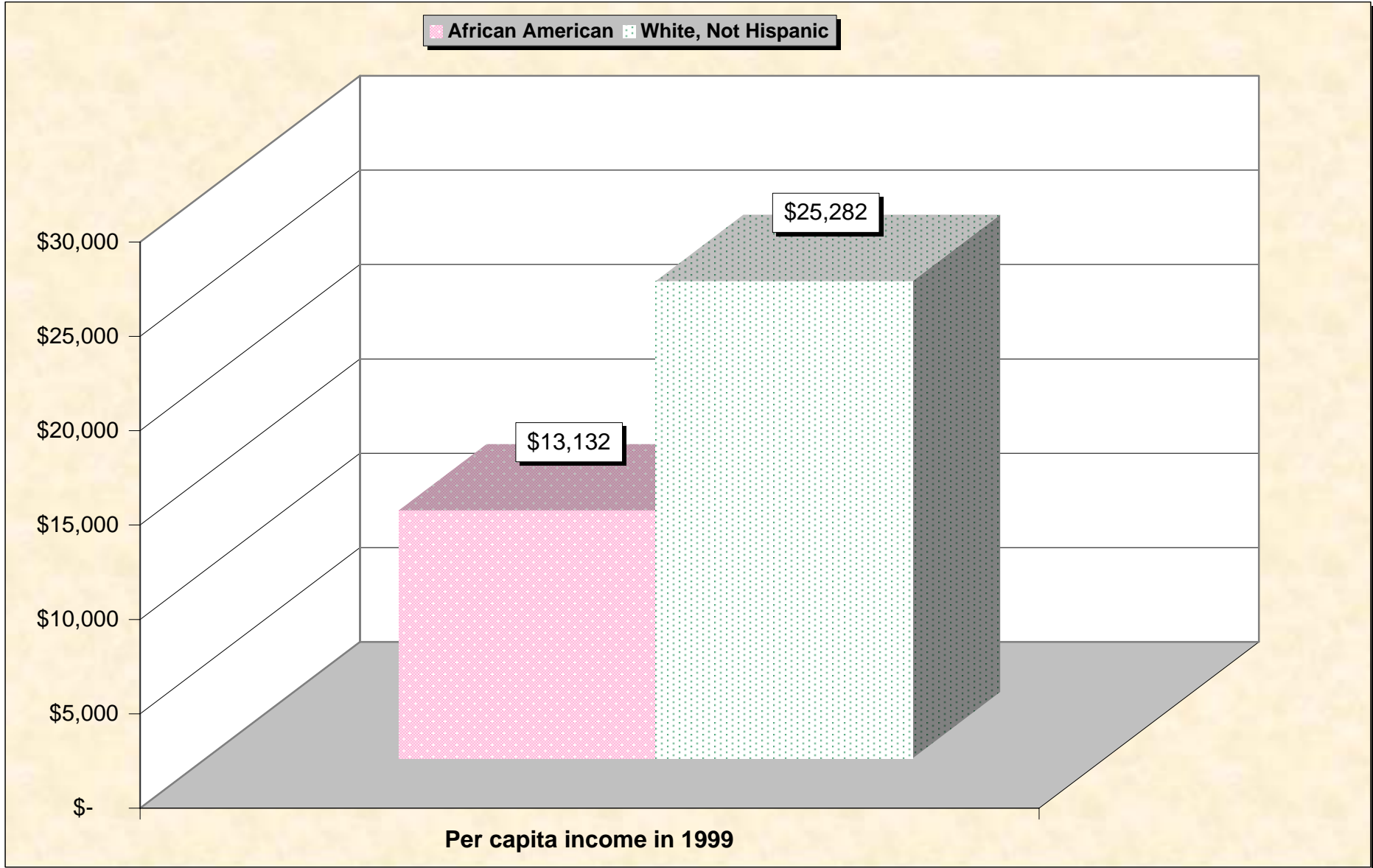
Chart 7 -- Median Family Income In 1999

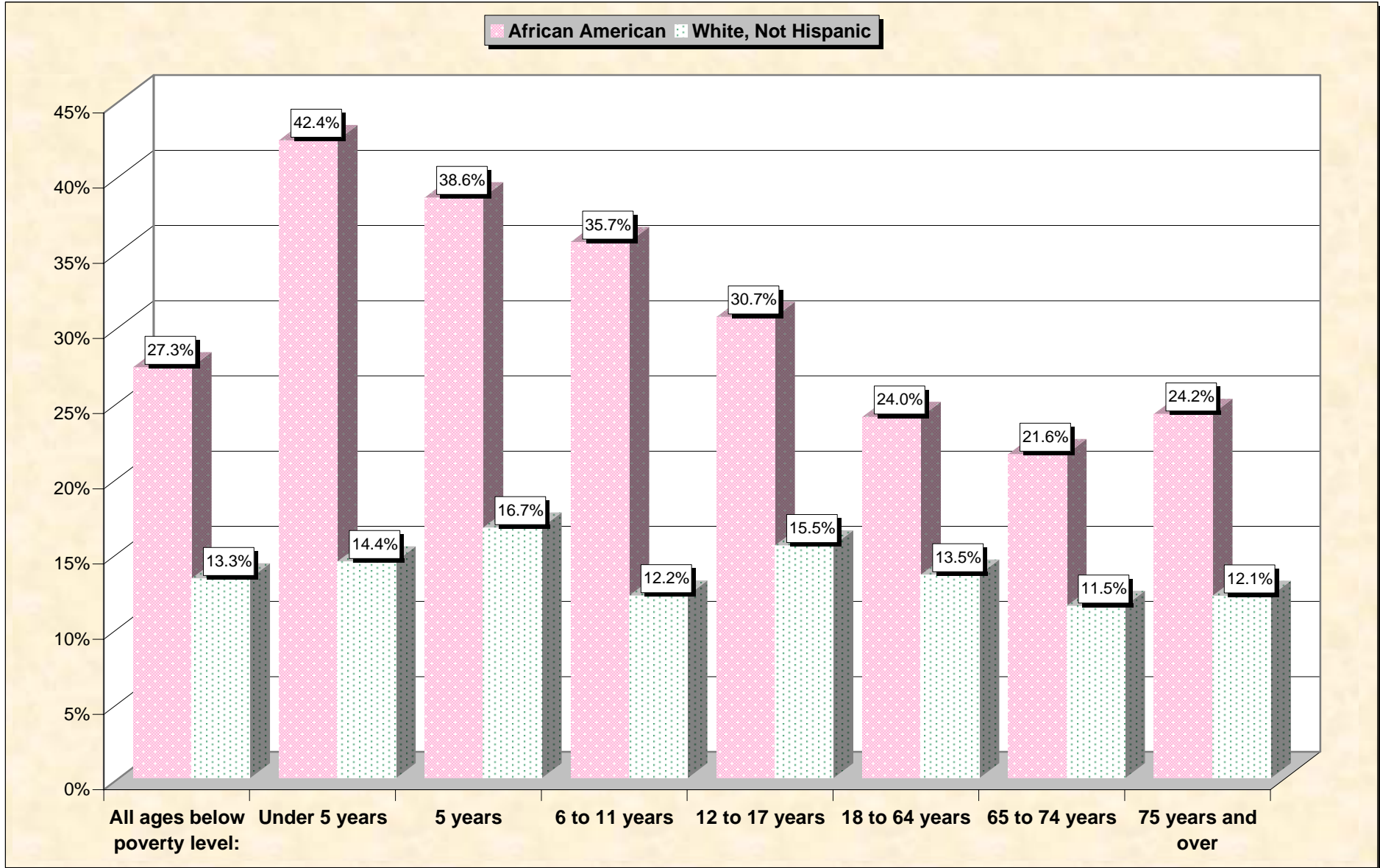

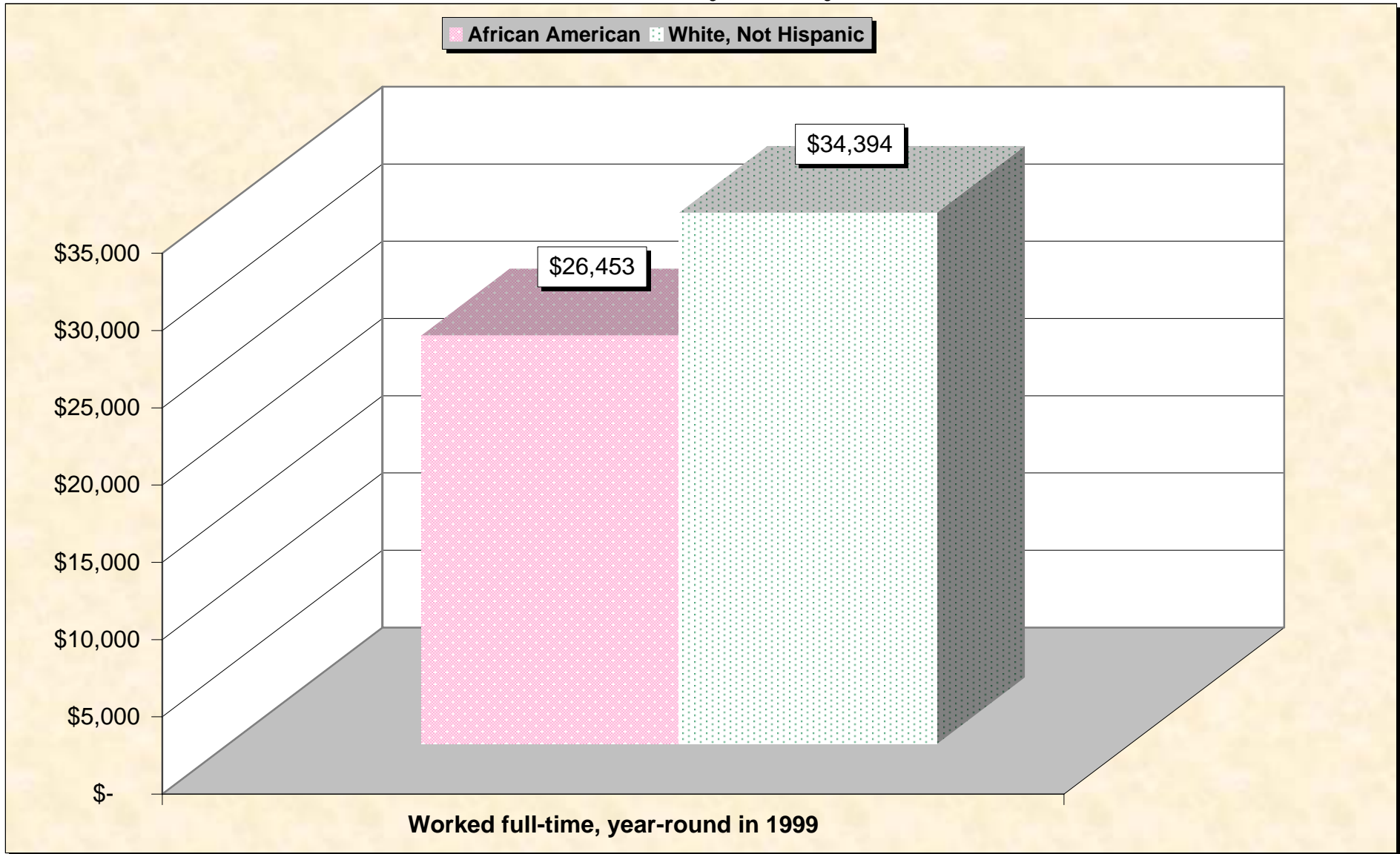
Chart 9 -- Income in 1999 Below Poverty Level by Age Baltimore city, Maryland

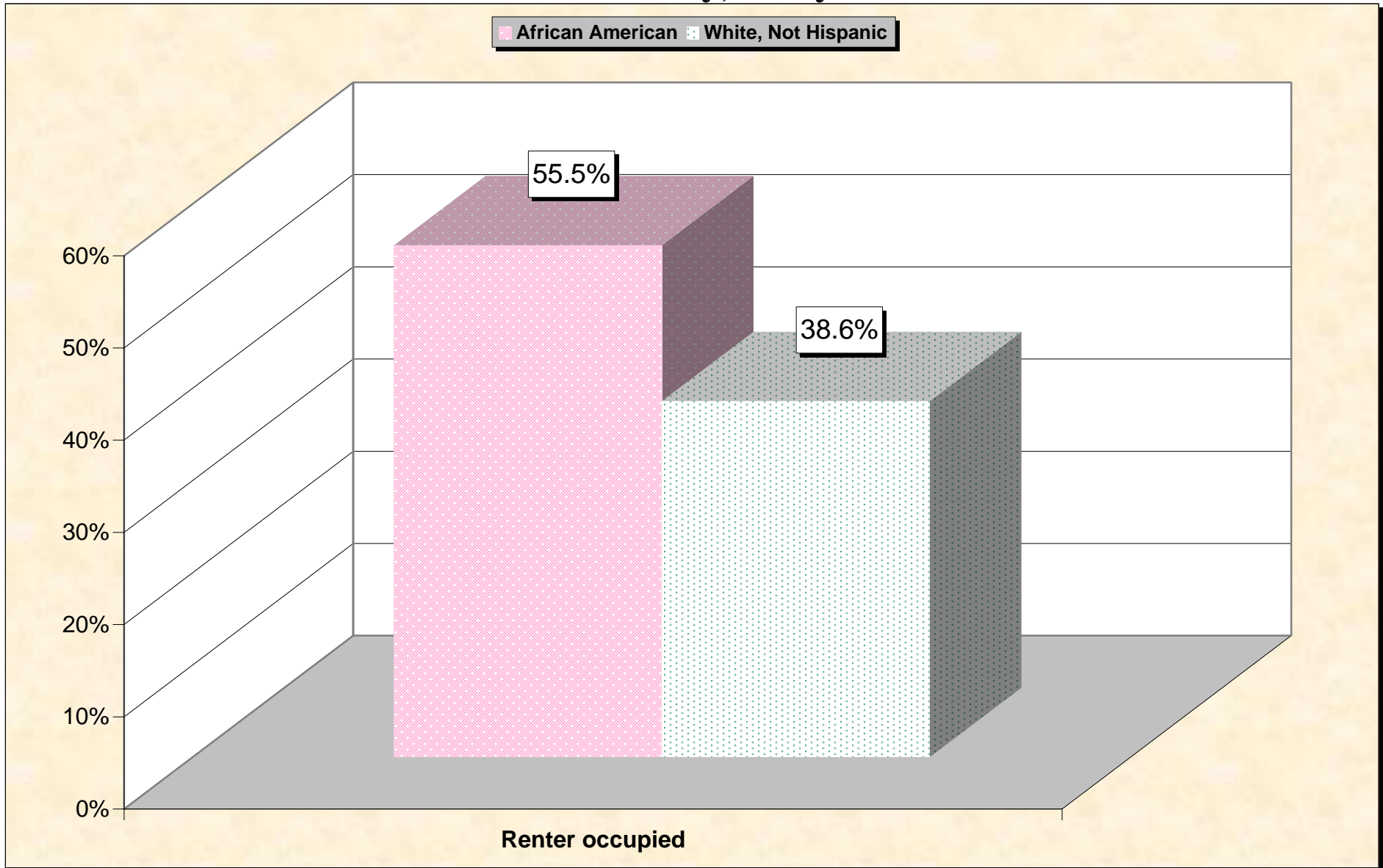
Chart 10 -- Median Earnings in 1999

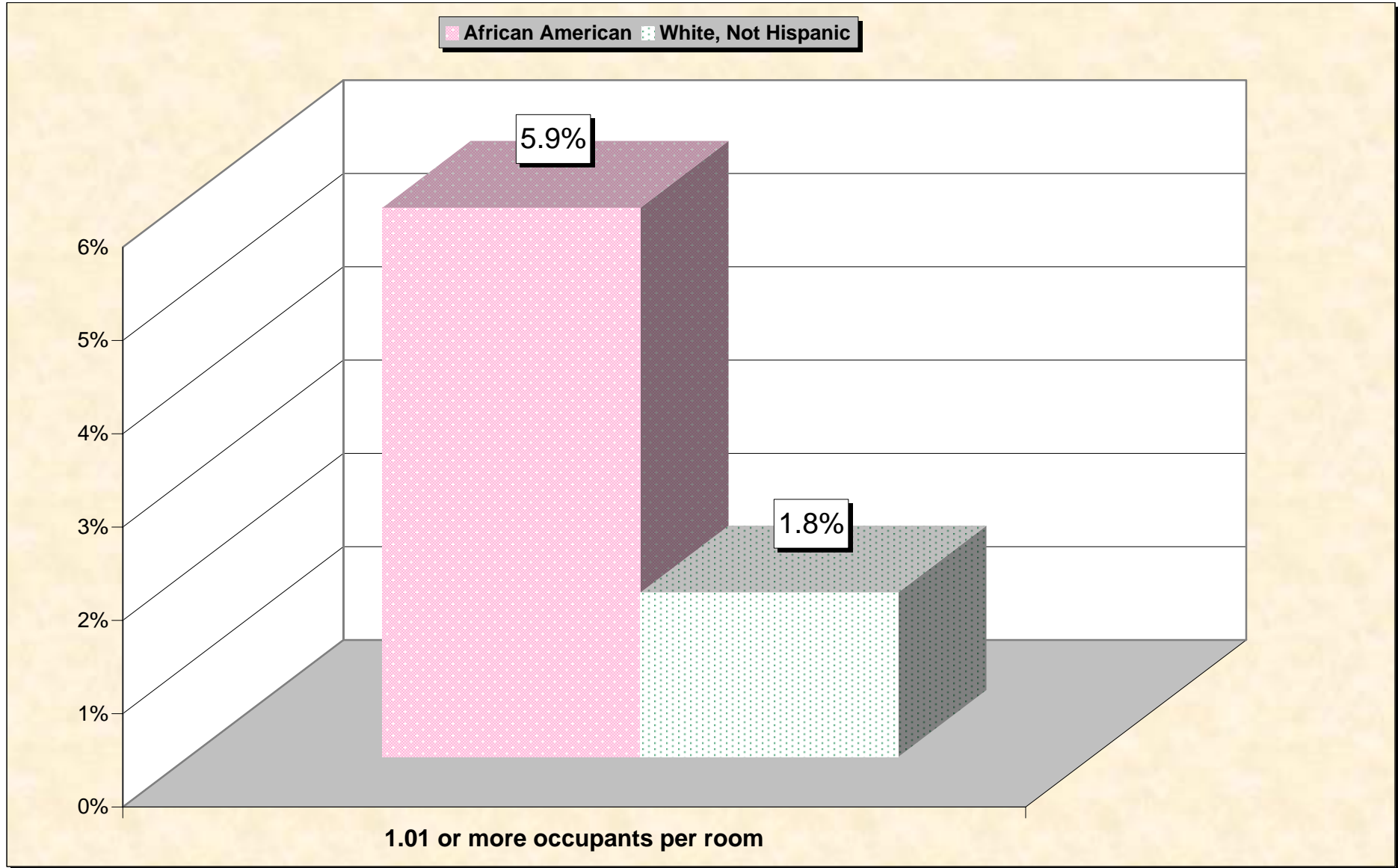

Chart 11 -- Renter-Occupied Housing Baltimore city, Maryland



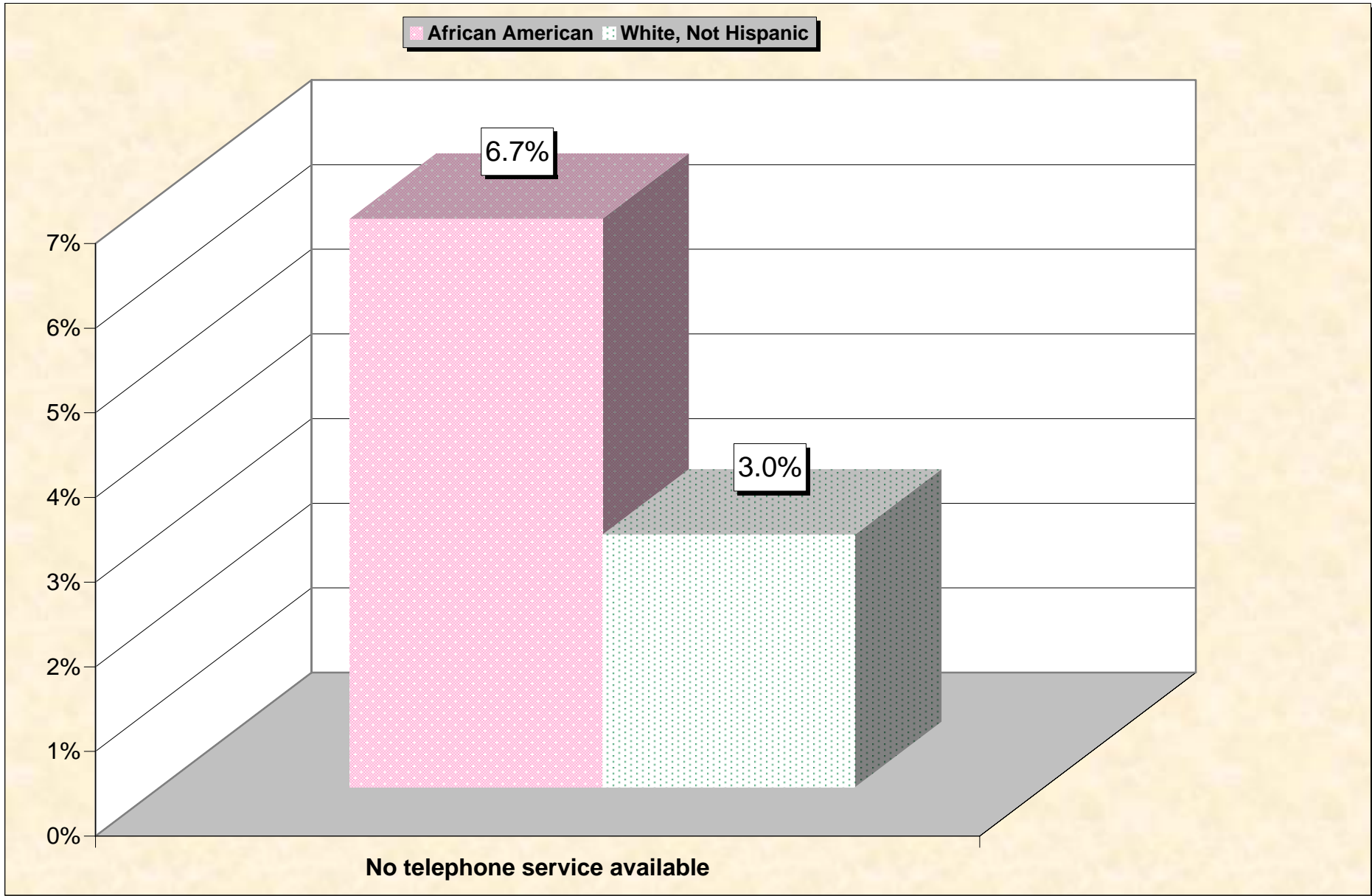

Chart 12 -- Occupants Per Room (Crowding) by Household Baltimore city, Maryland



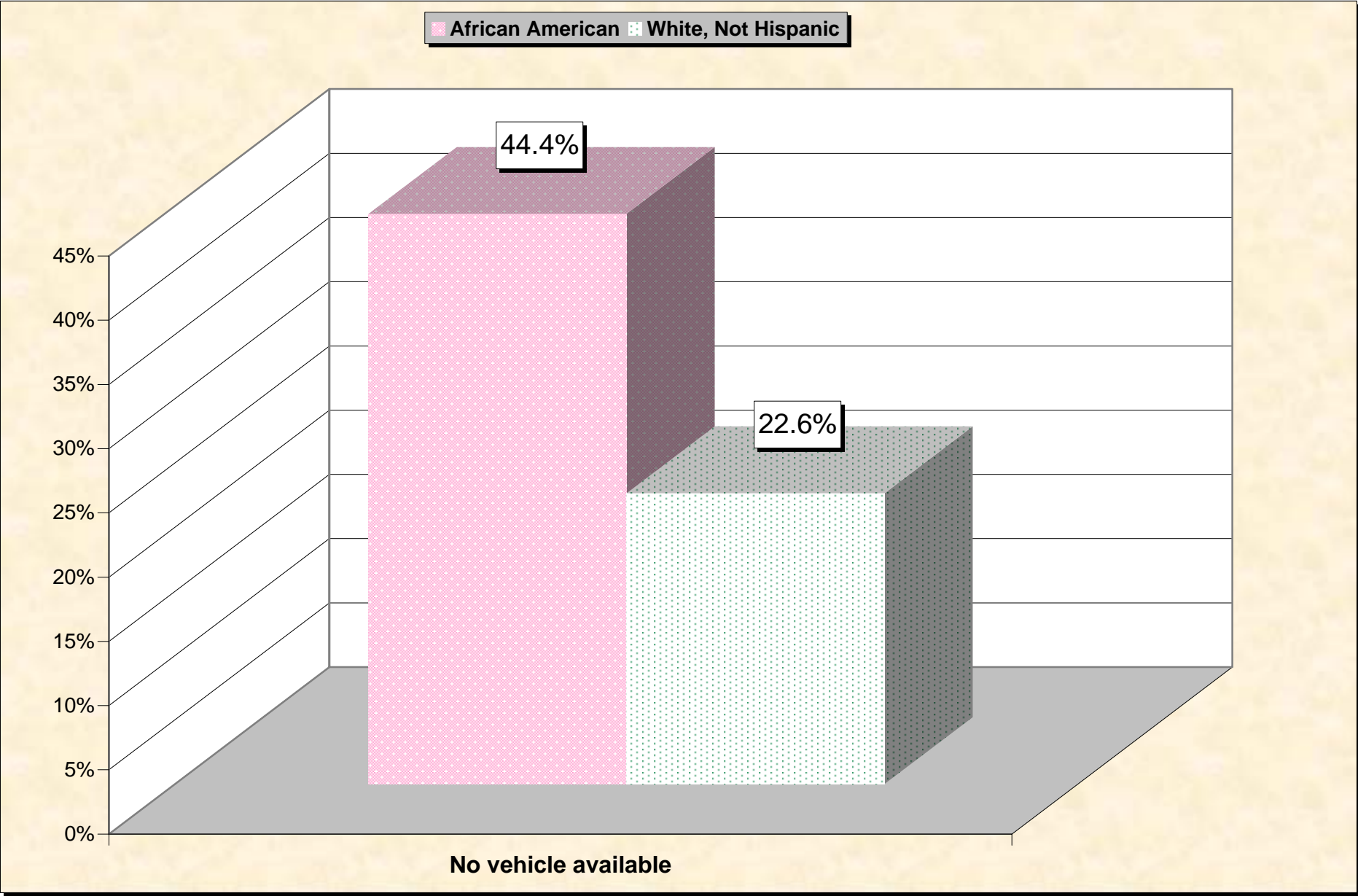

Chart 13 -- Lack of Telephone Service by Household Baltimore city, Maryland



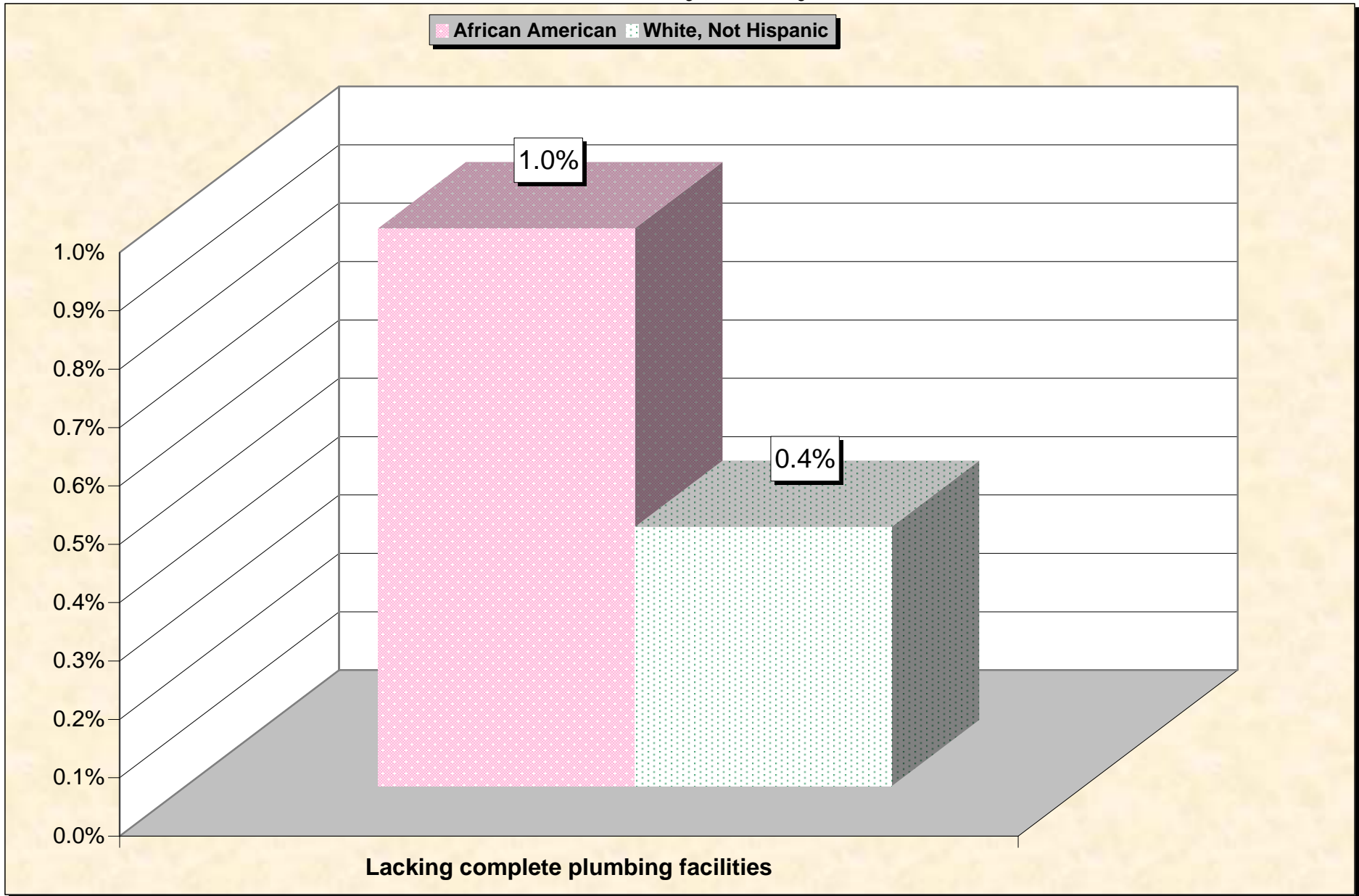

Chart 14 -- Lack of Vehicle By Household Baltimore city, Maryland



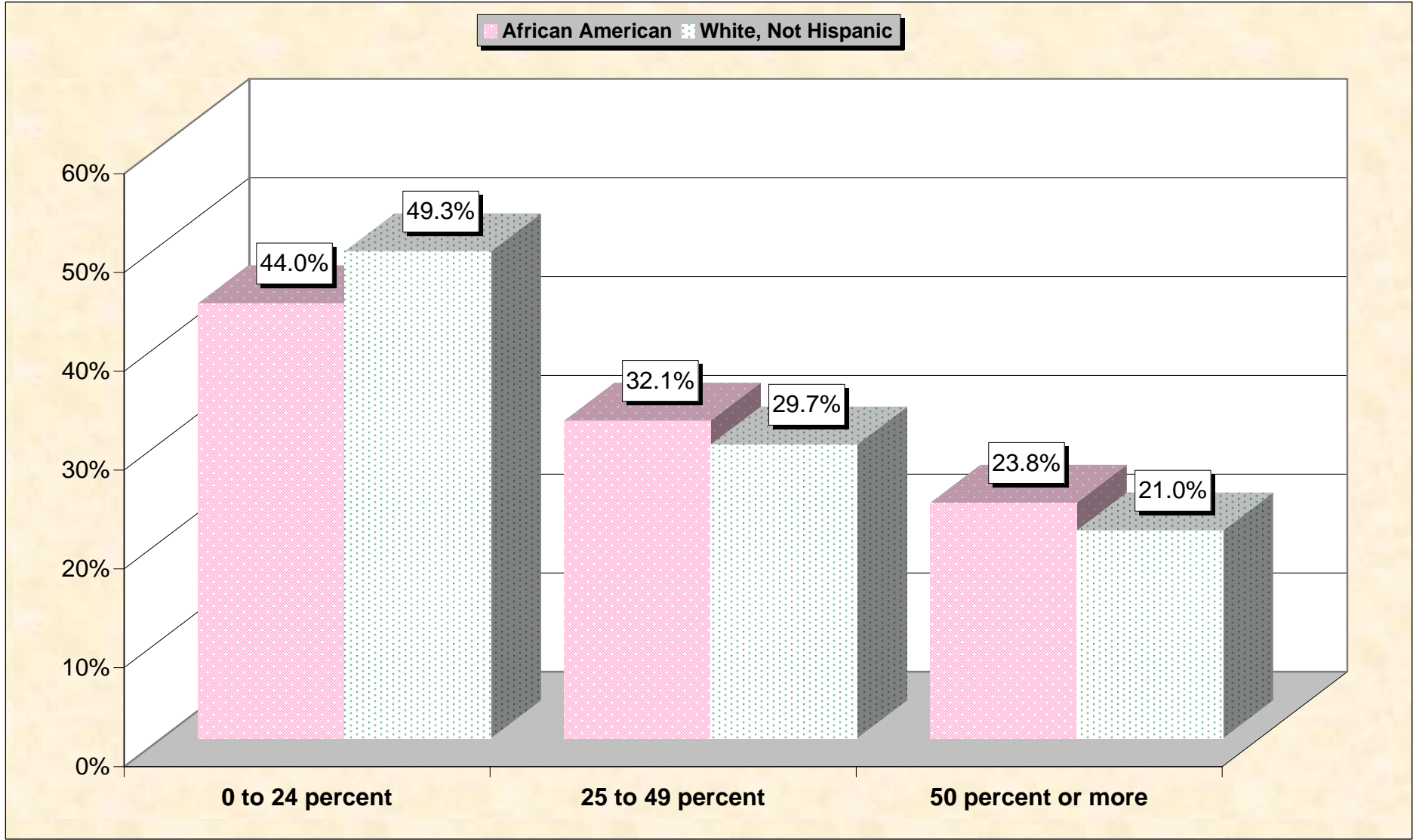

Chart 15 -- Lack of Plumbing By Household Baltimore city, Maryland



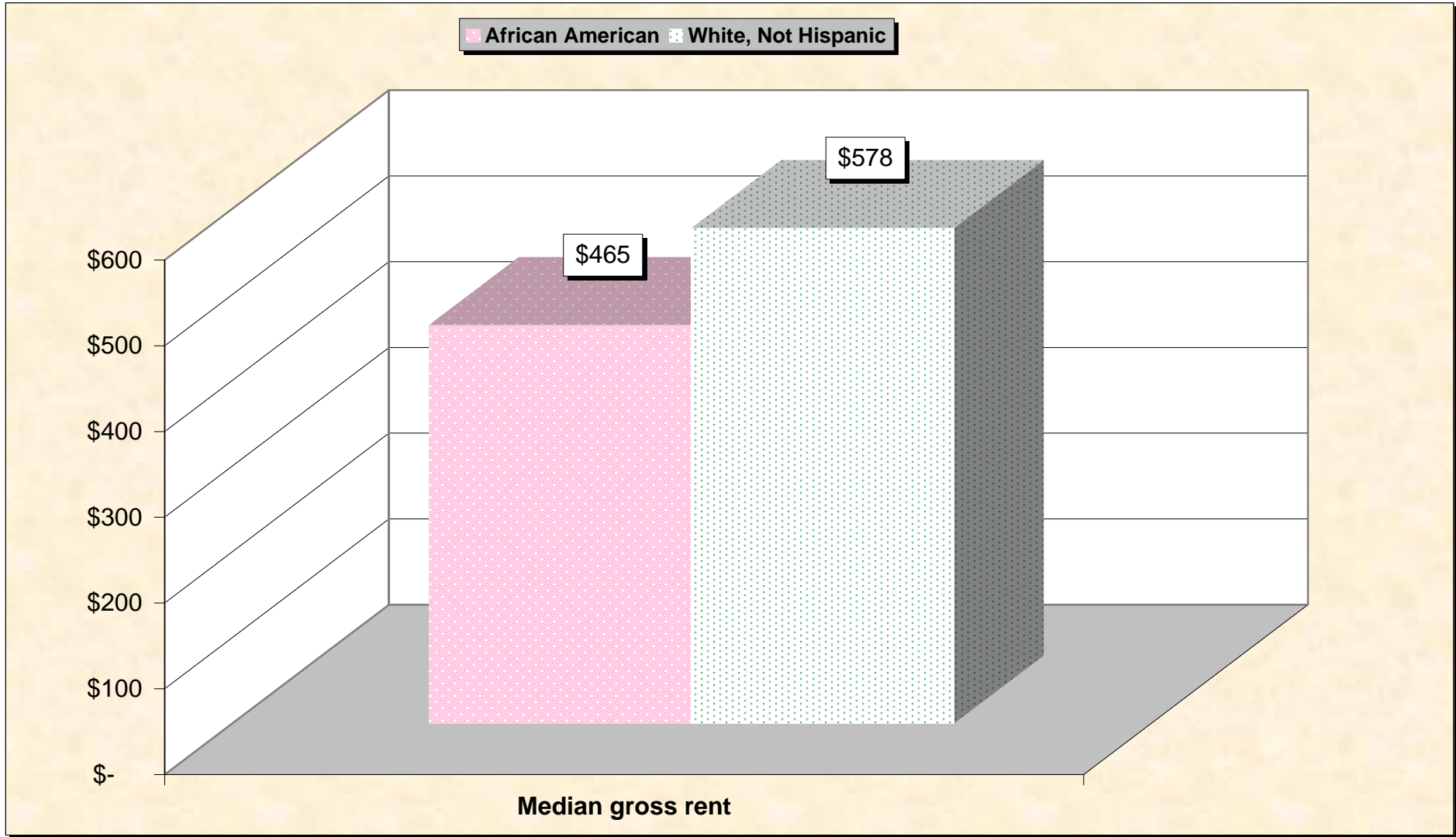

Chart 16 -- Gross Rent as a Percentage of Household Income in 1999 Baltimore city, Maryland



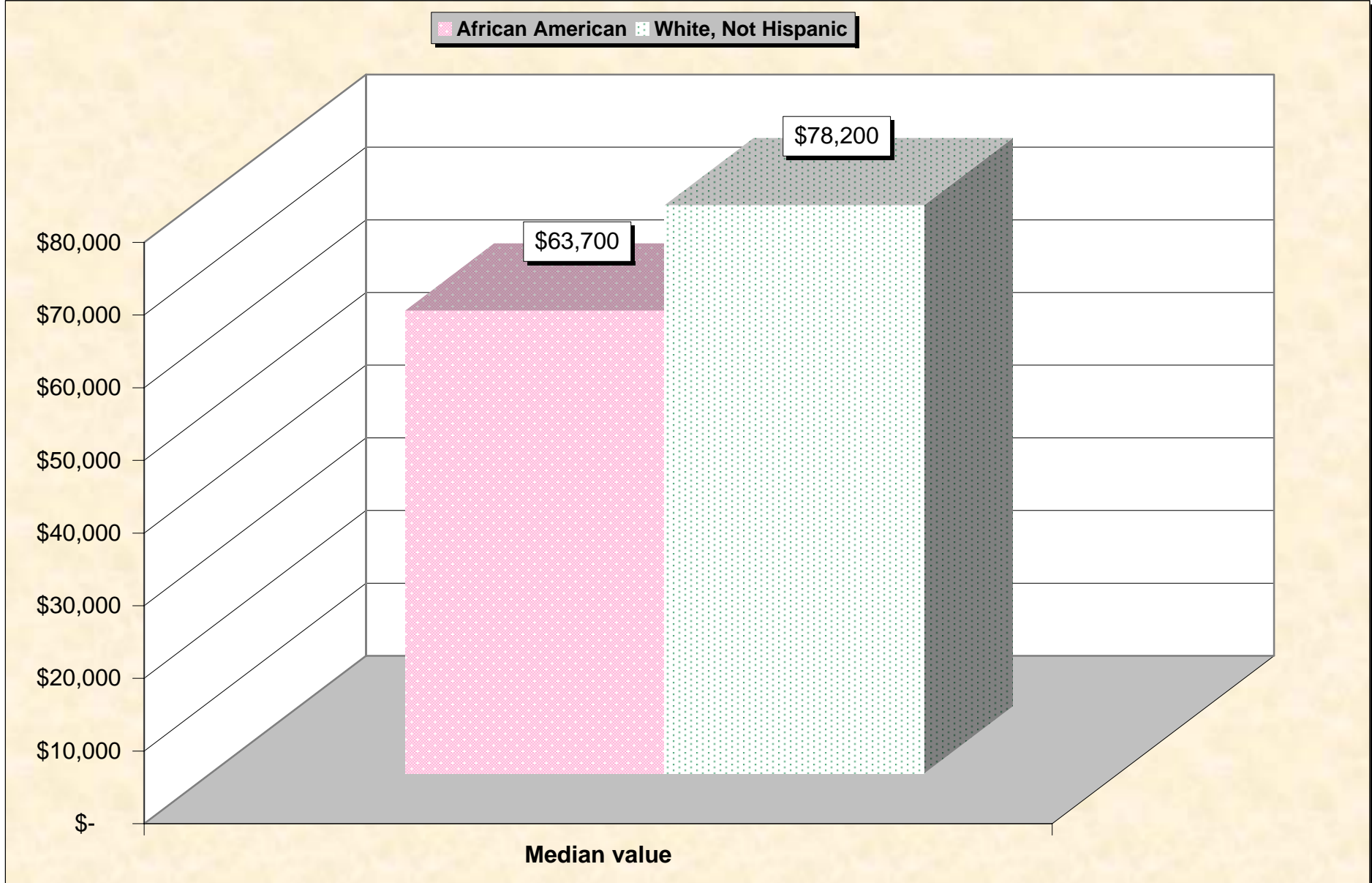
