

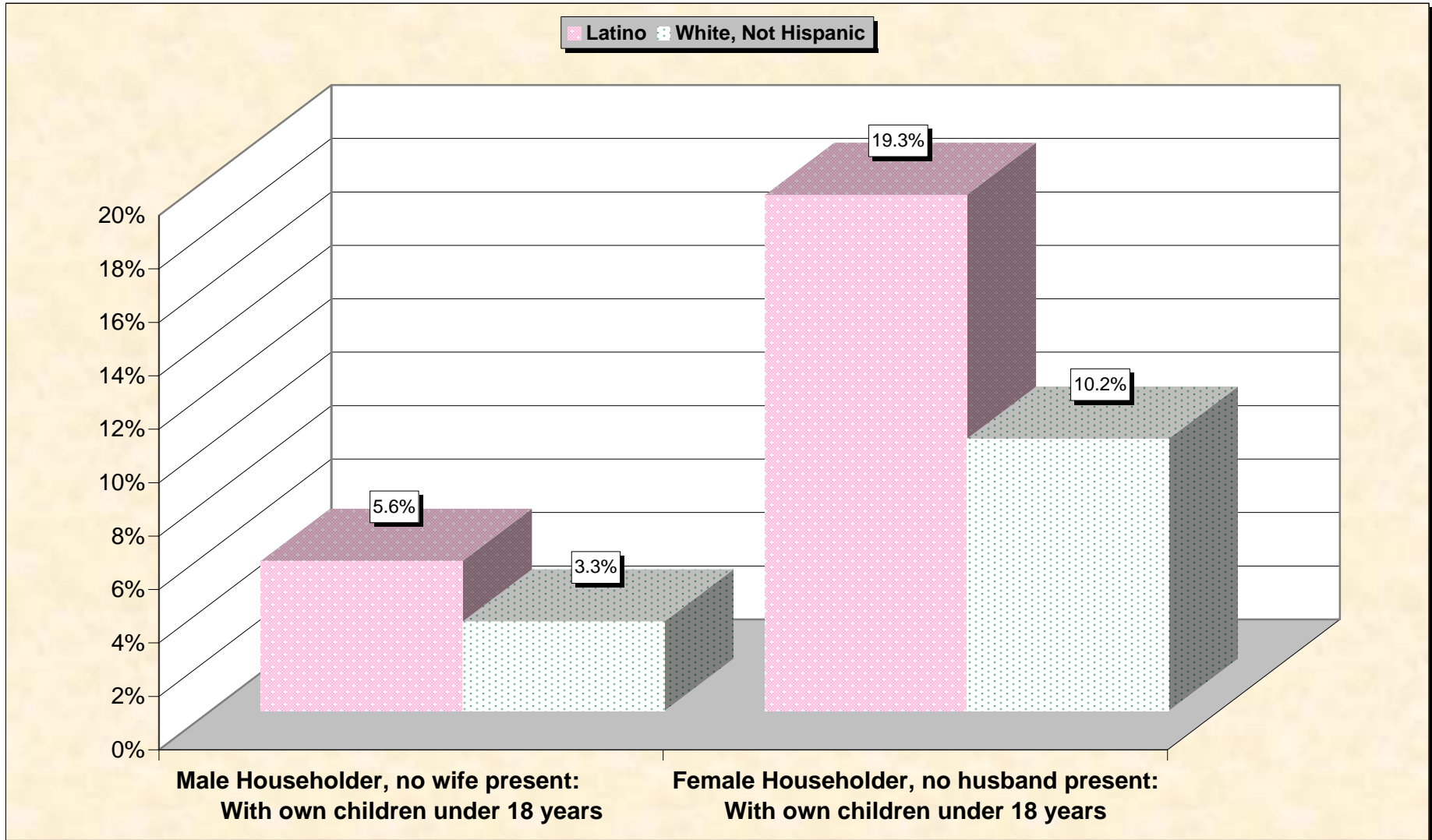

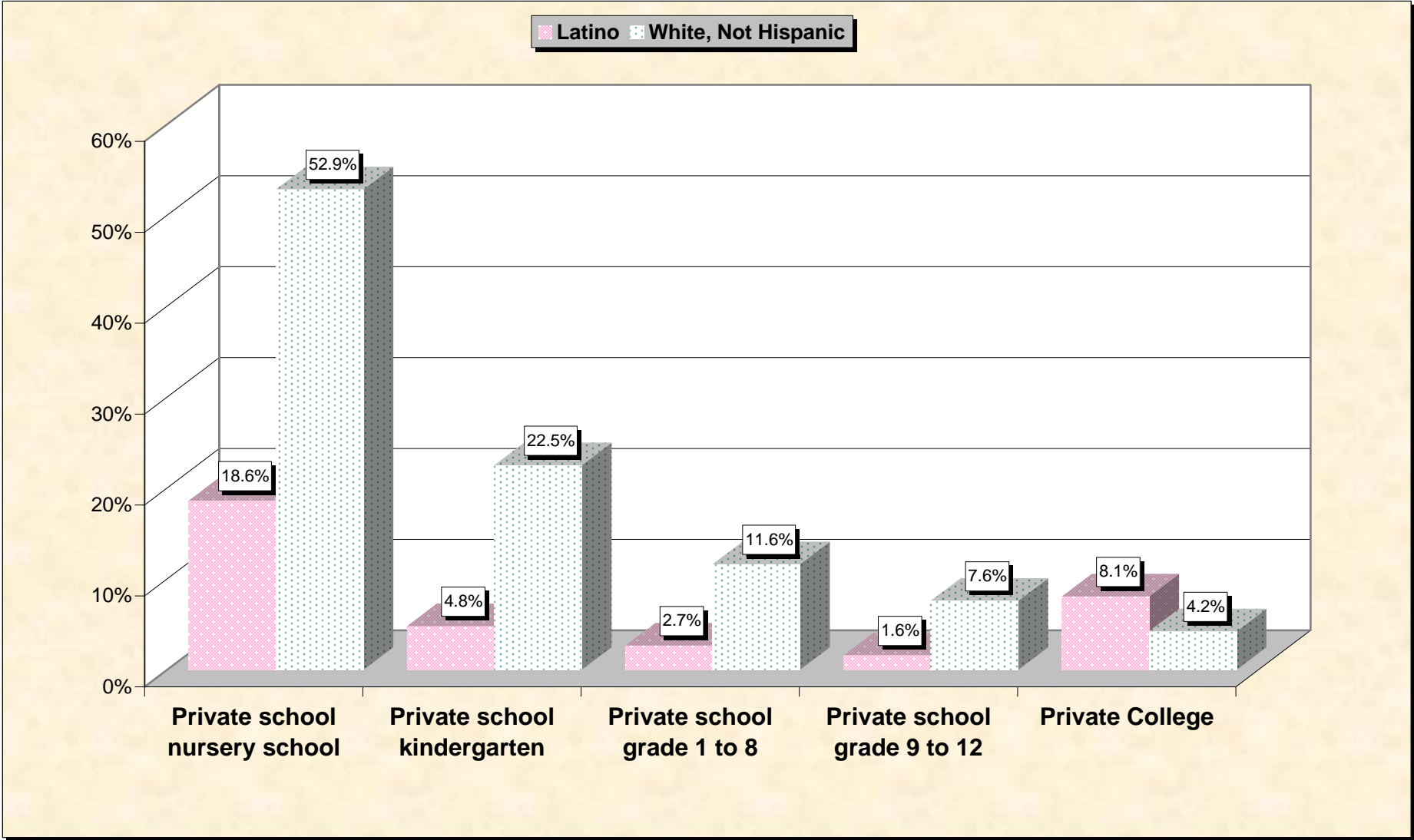
Chart 1 -- Single-Parent Family Households (Householder 15 to 64 years) Dona Ana County, New Mexico

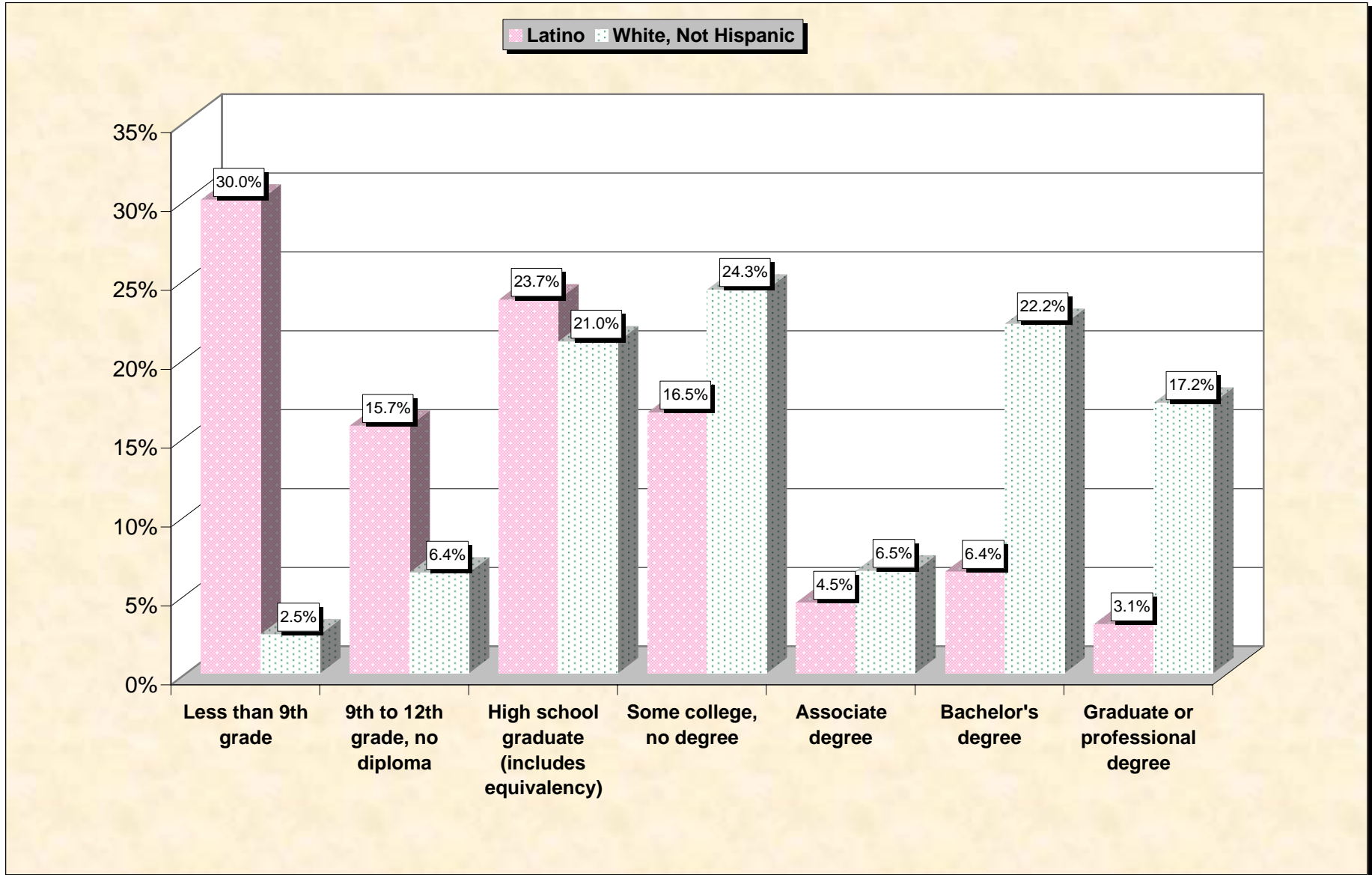
Chart 2 -- Private School Enrollment (3 years and over)

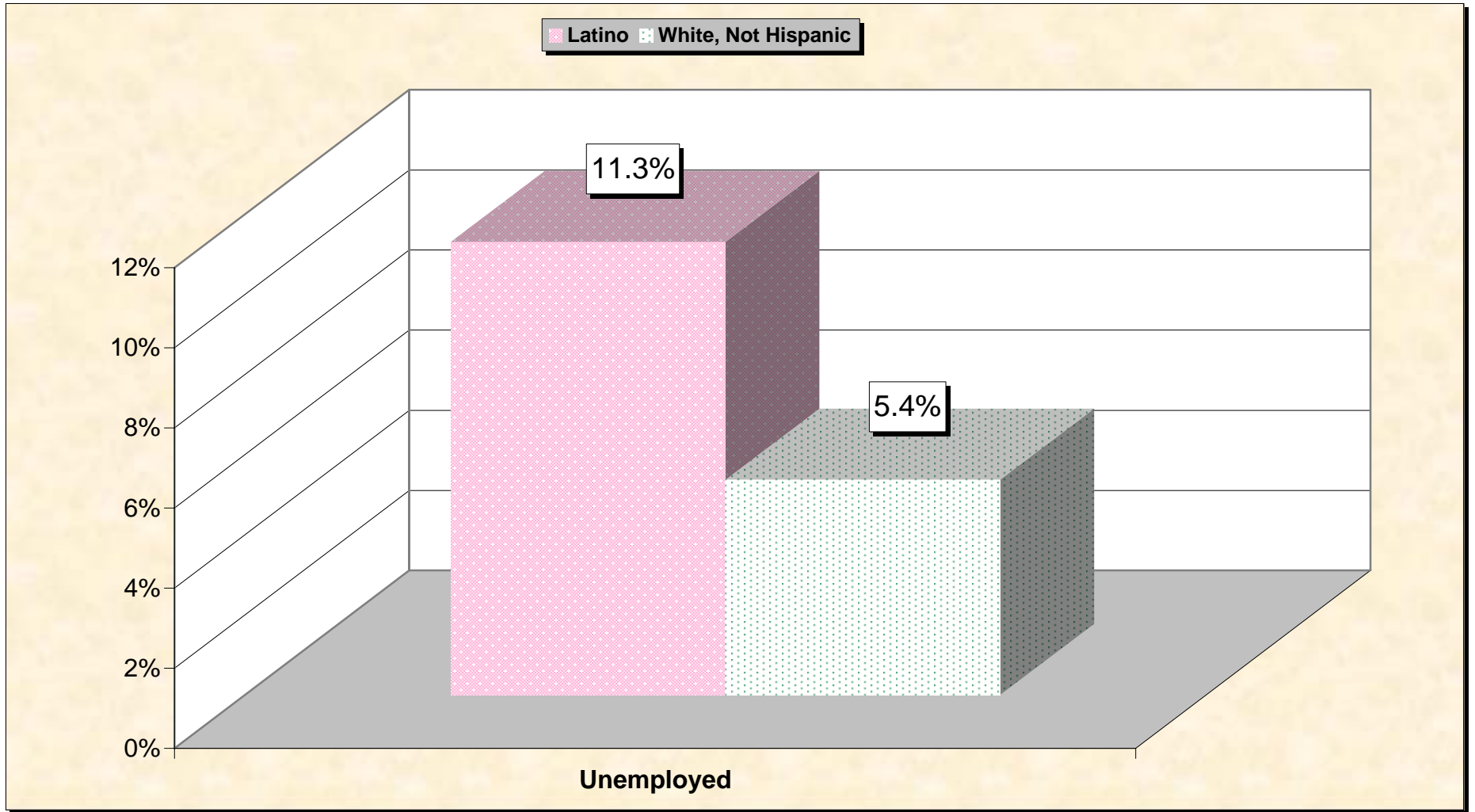

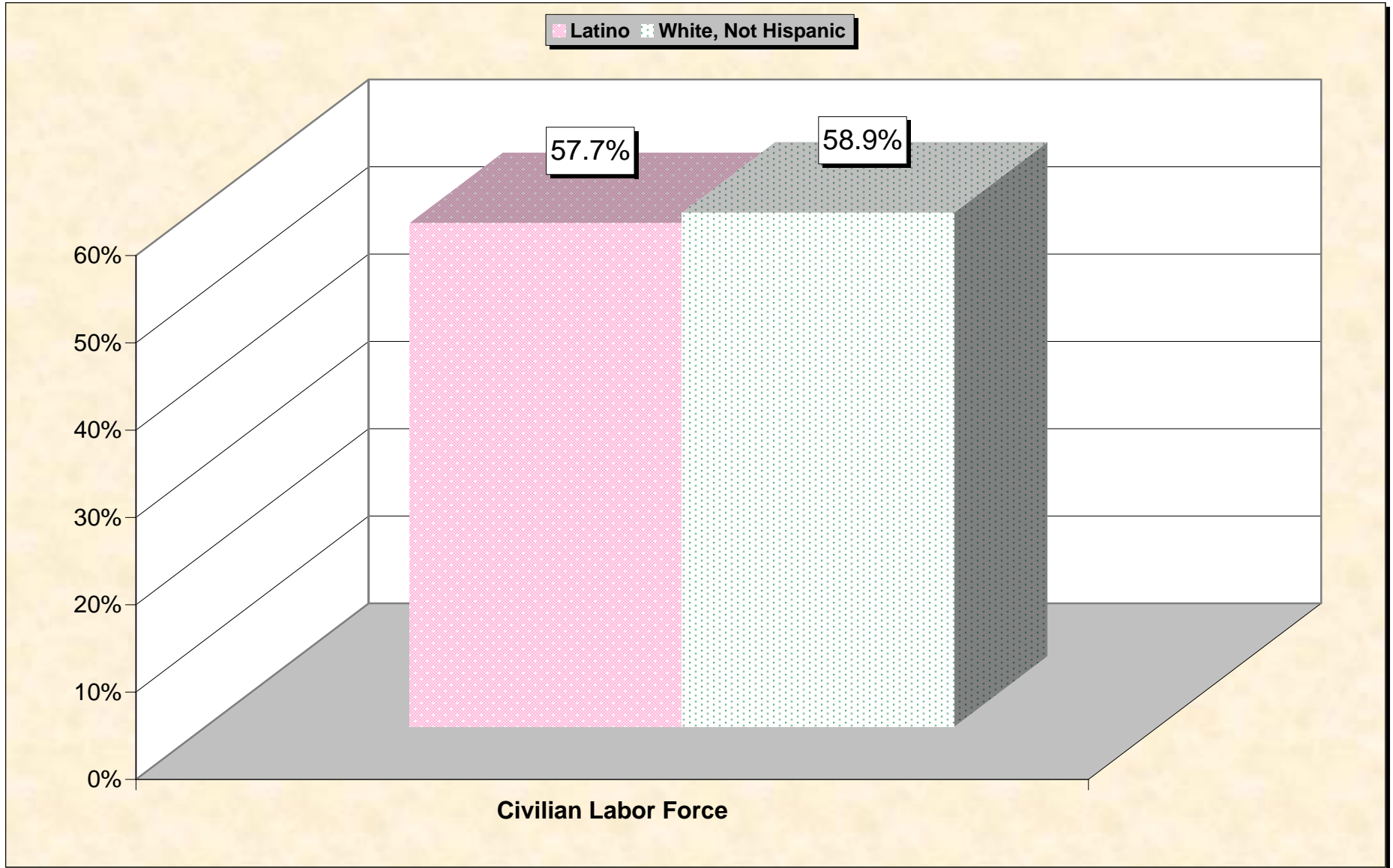
Chart 4 -- Unemployment Rate (Civilian Labor Force) Dona Ana County, New Mexico

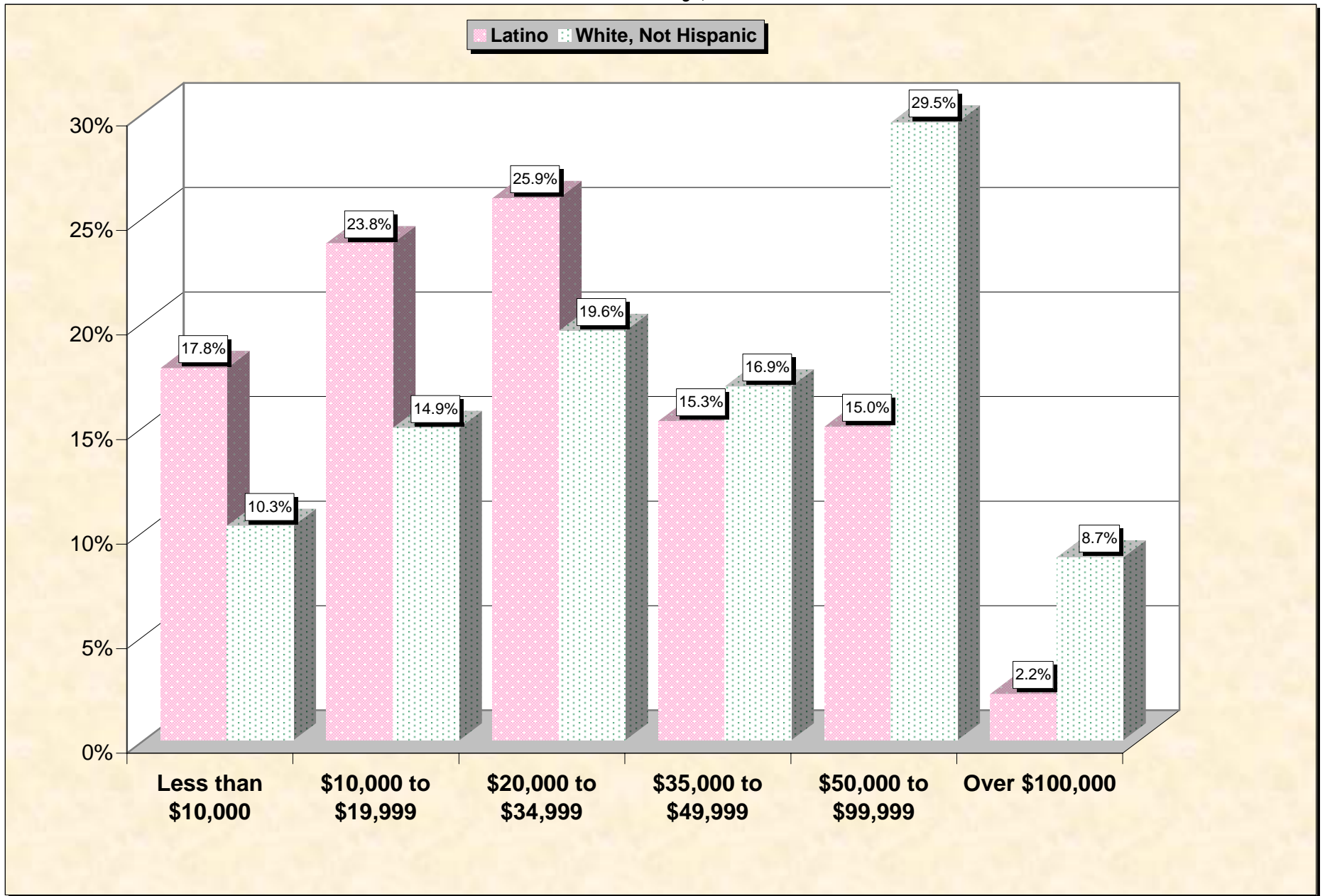
Chart 5 -- Labor Force Participation (Civilian Labor Force) Dona Ana County, New Mexico

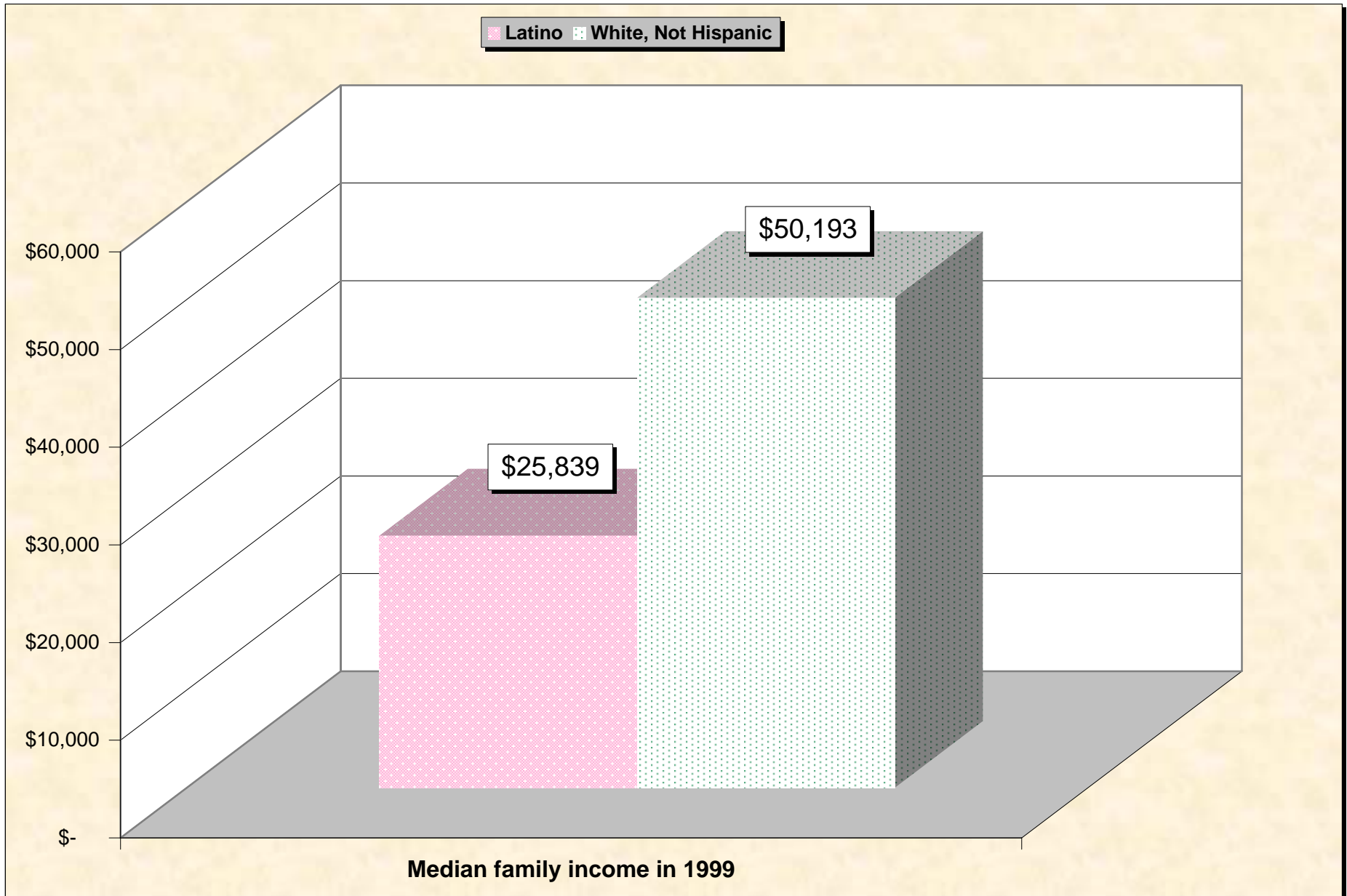
Chart 6 -- Household Income in 1999 Dona Ana County, New Mexico

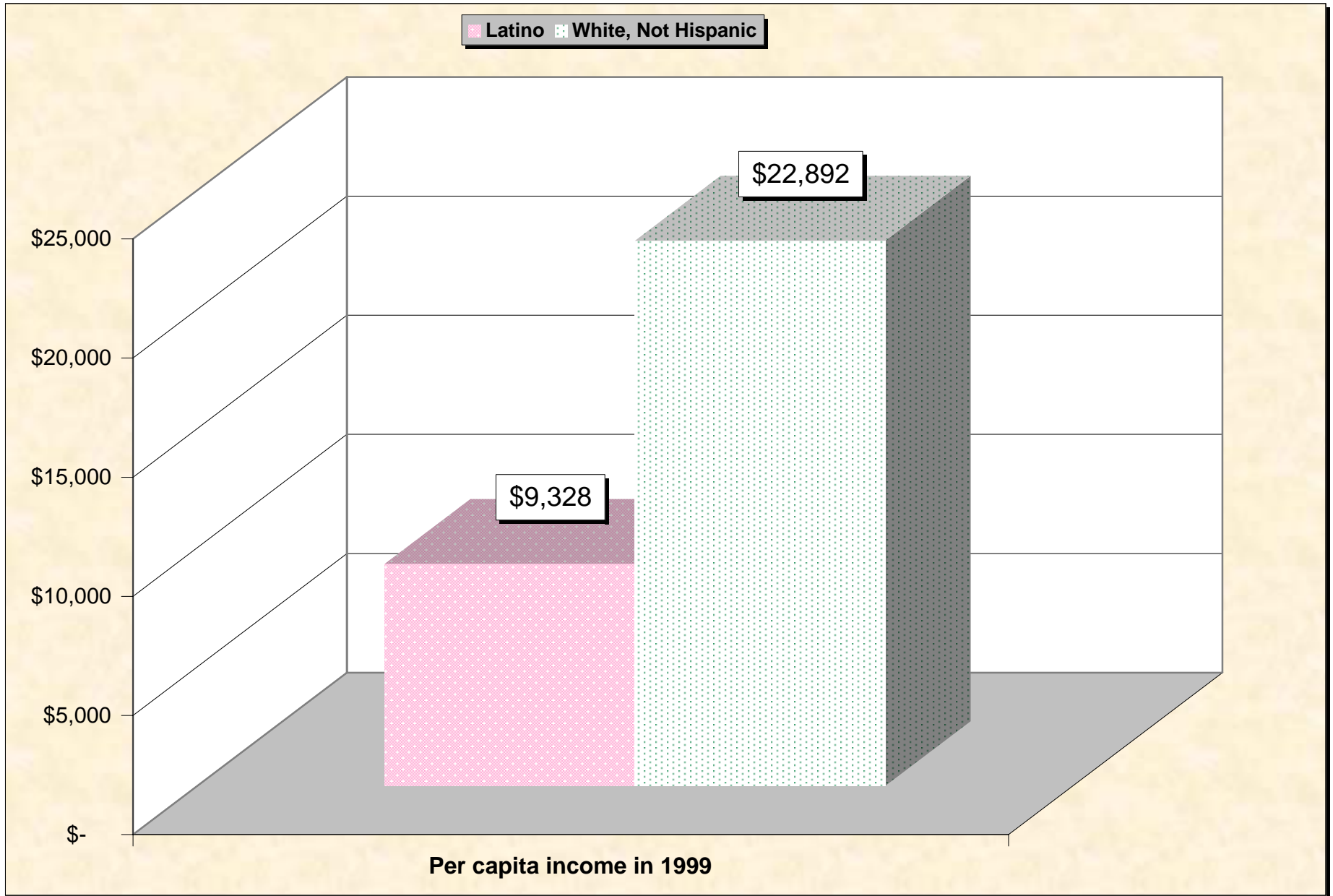
Chart 7 -- Median Family Income In 1999

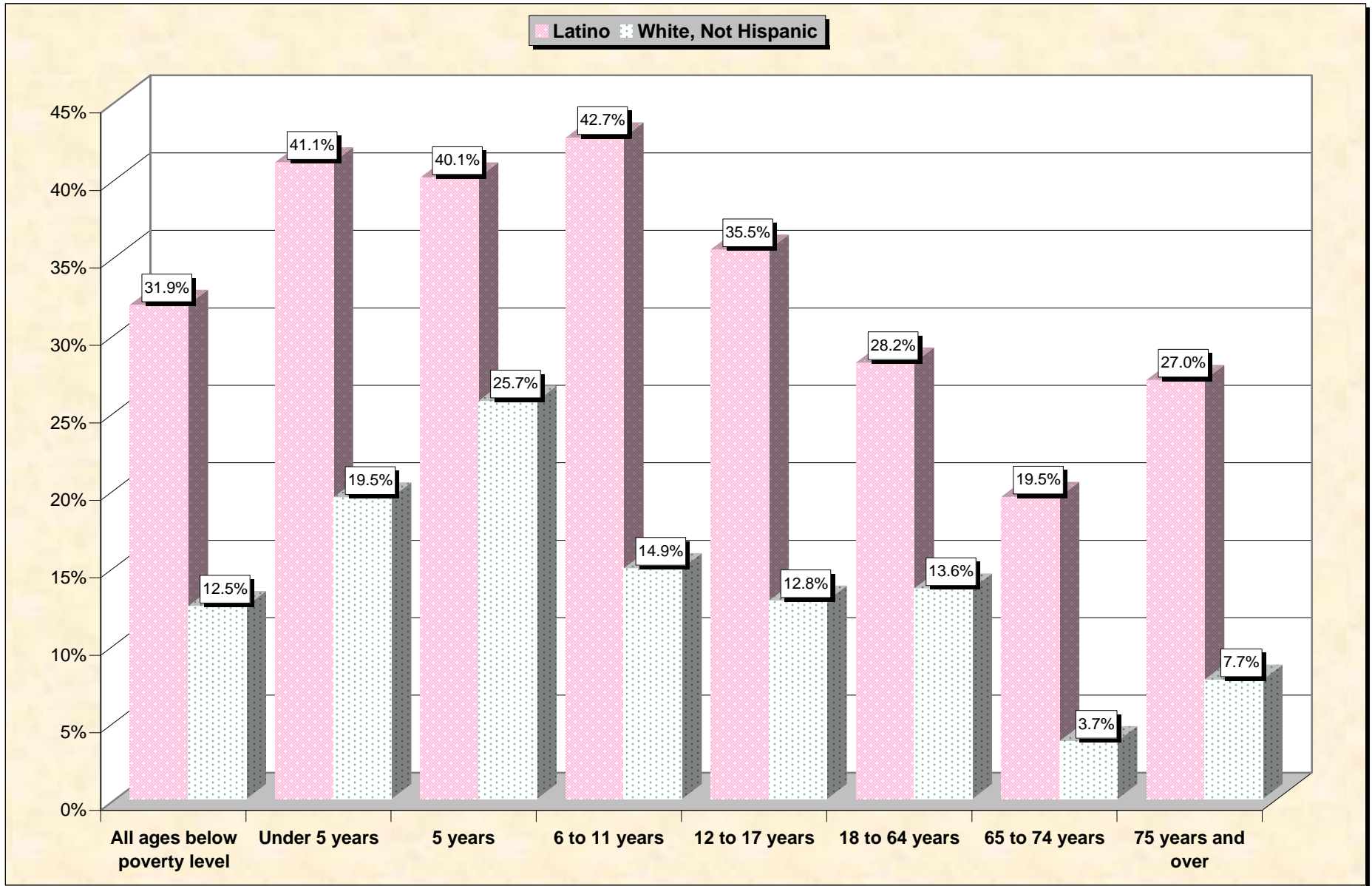

Chart 8 -- Per Capita Income In 1999 Dona Ana County, New Mexico



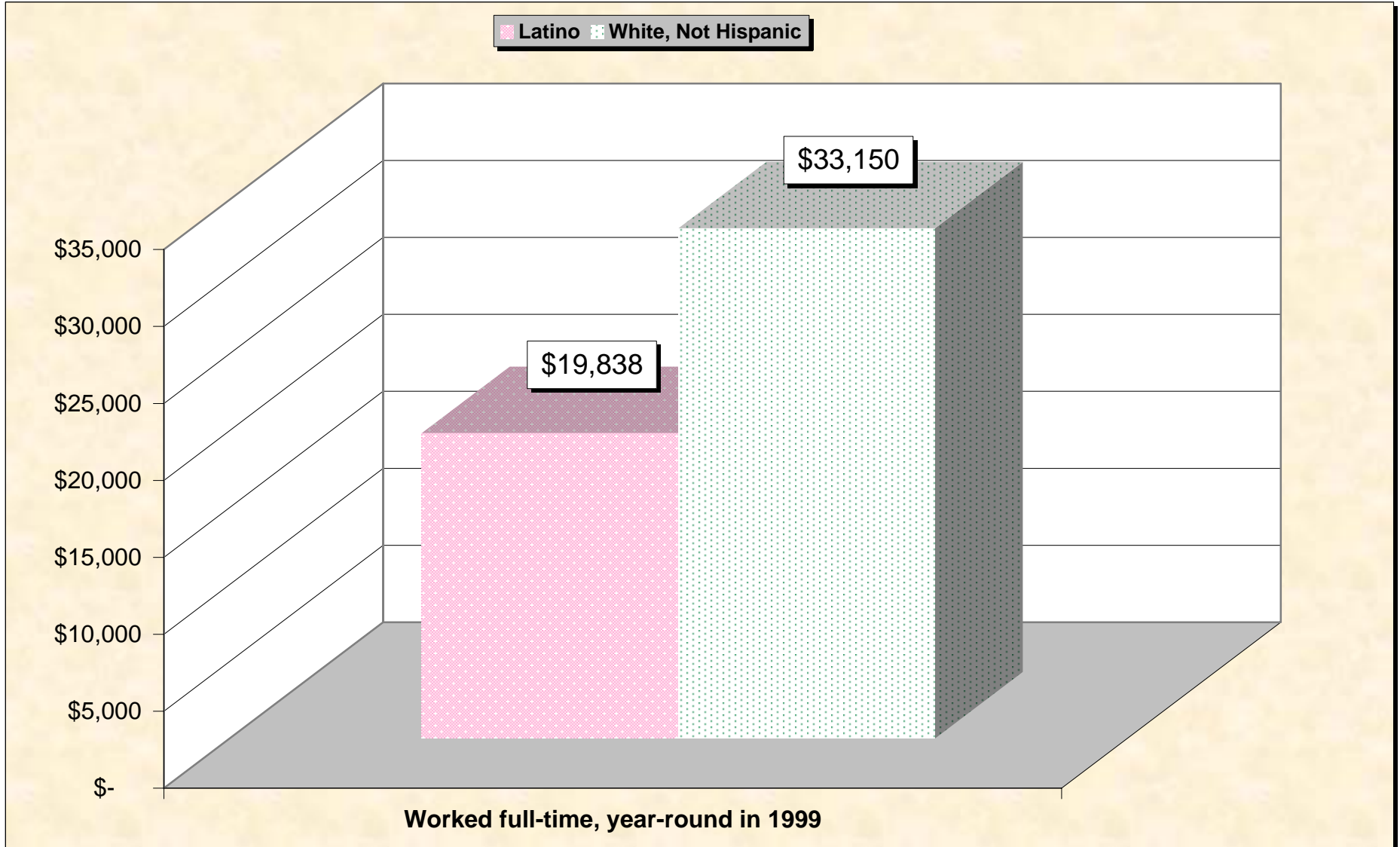

Chart 9 -- Income in 1999 Below Poverty Level by Age Dona Ana County, New Mexico



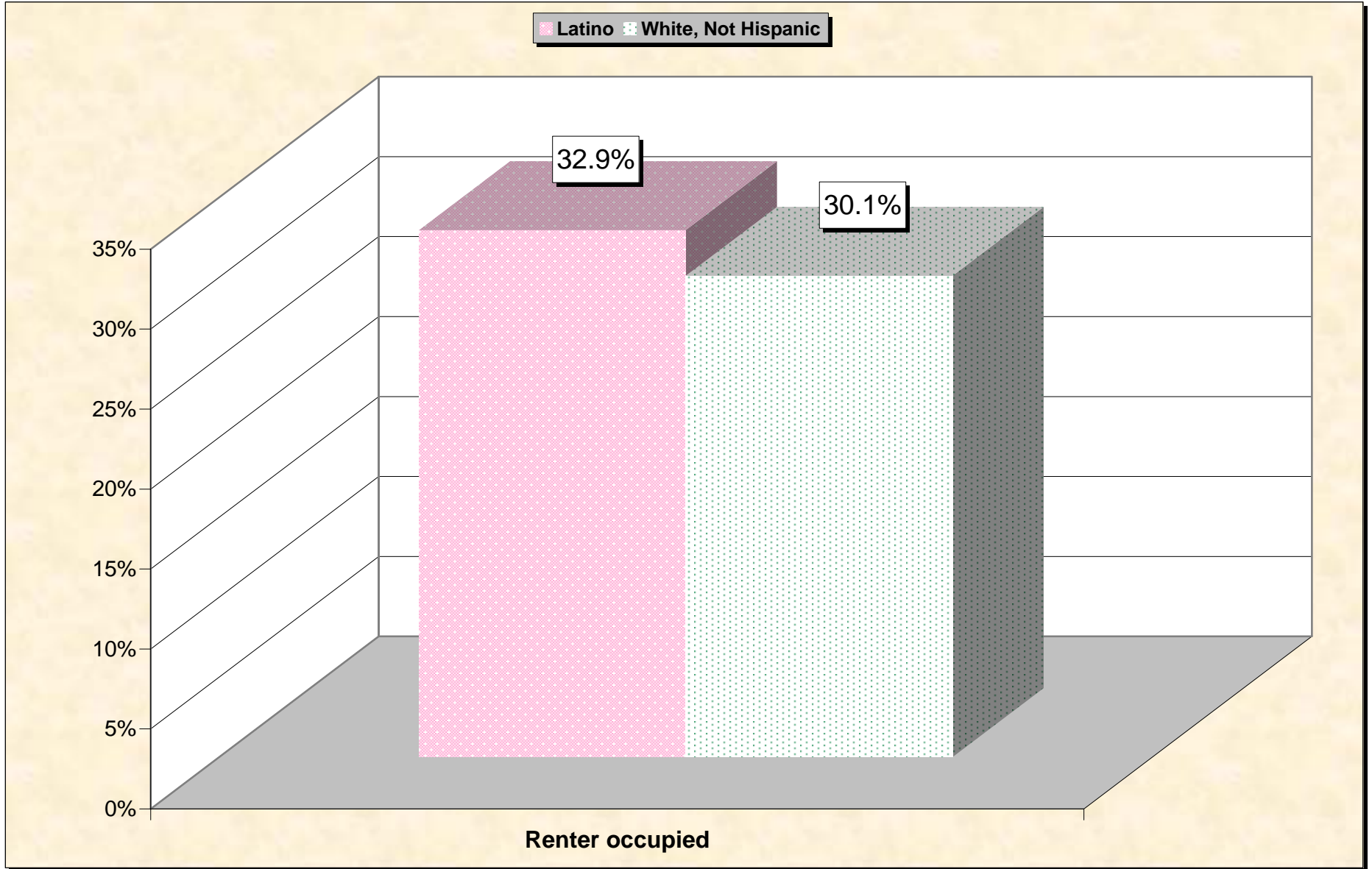

Chart 10 -- Median Earnings in 1999 Dona Ana County, New Mexico



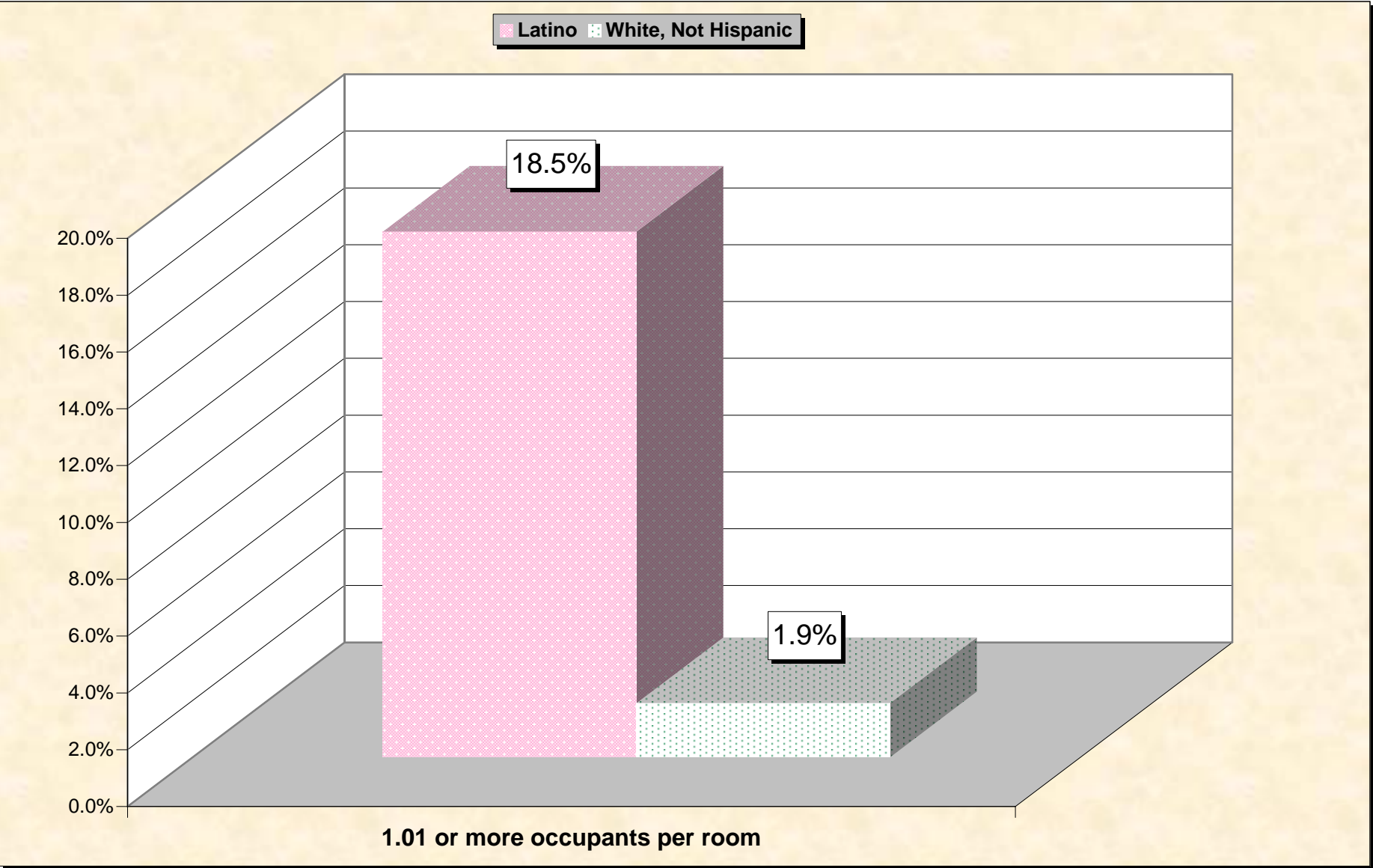

Chart 11 -- Renter-Occupied Housing Dona Ana County, New Mexico



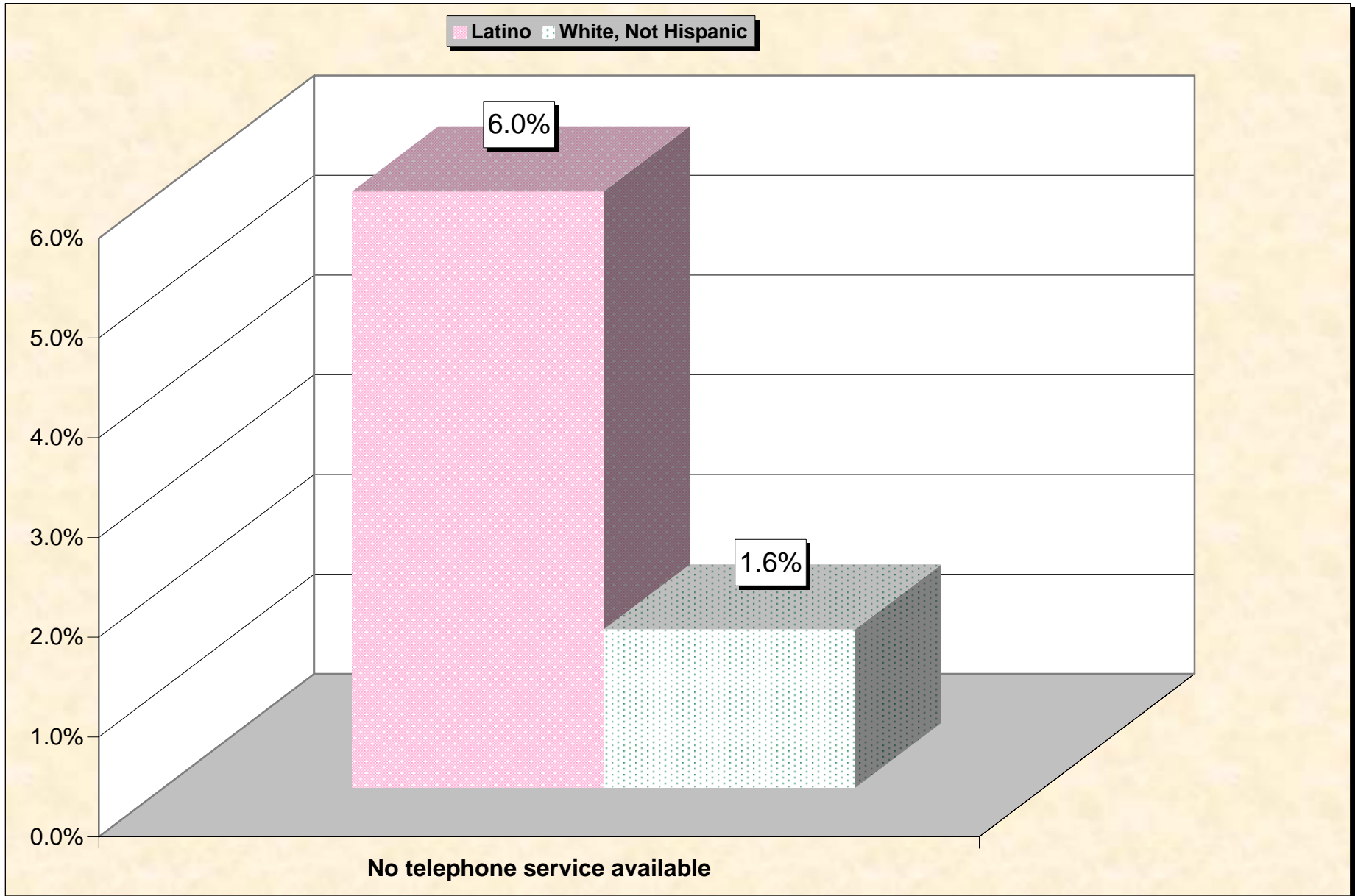

Chart 12 -- Occupants Per Room (Crowding) by Household Dona Ana County, New Mexico



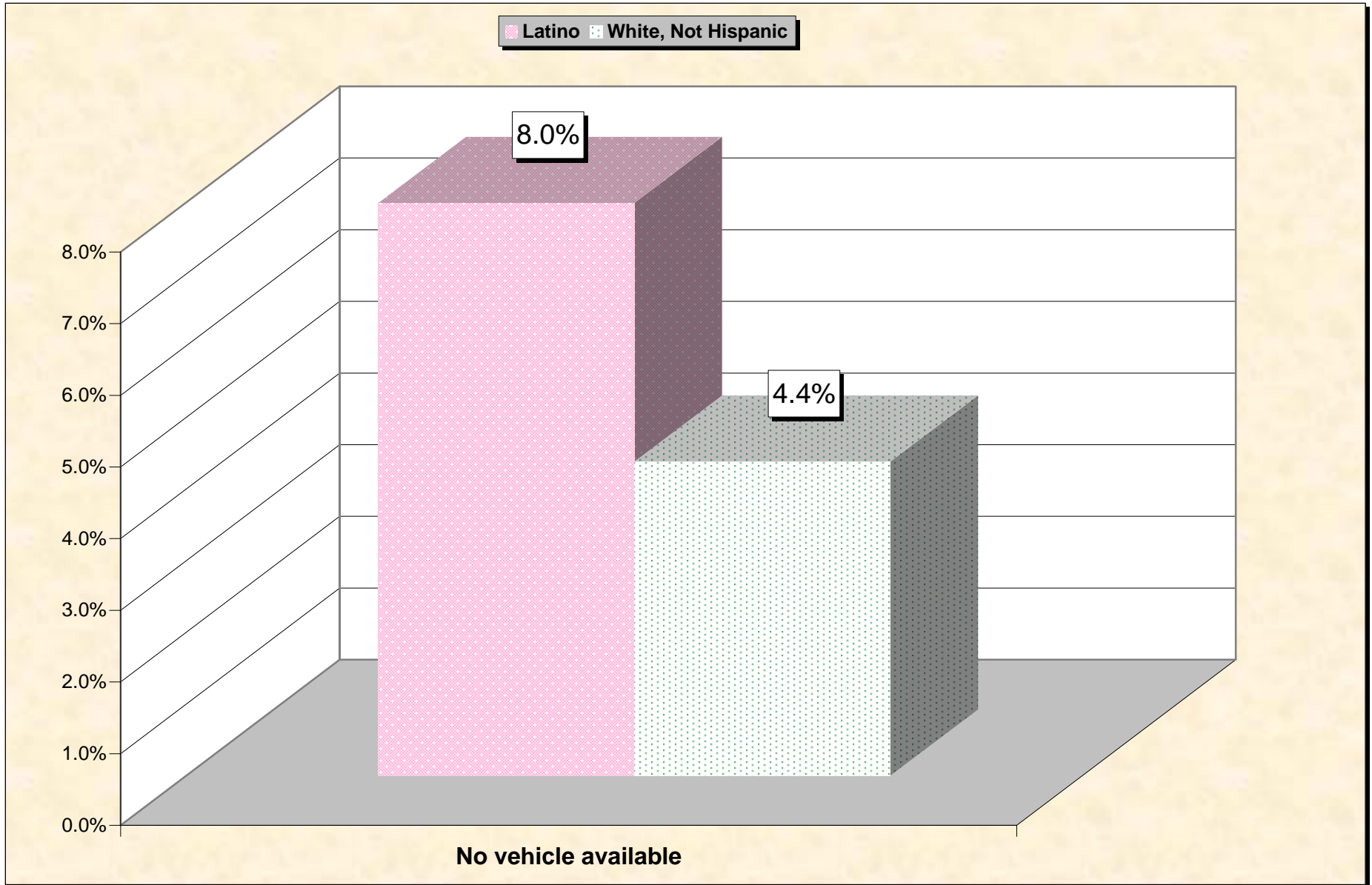

Chart 13 -- Lack of Telephone Service by Household Dona Ana County, New Mexico



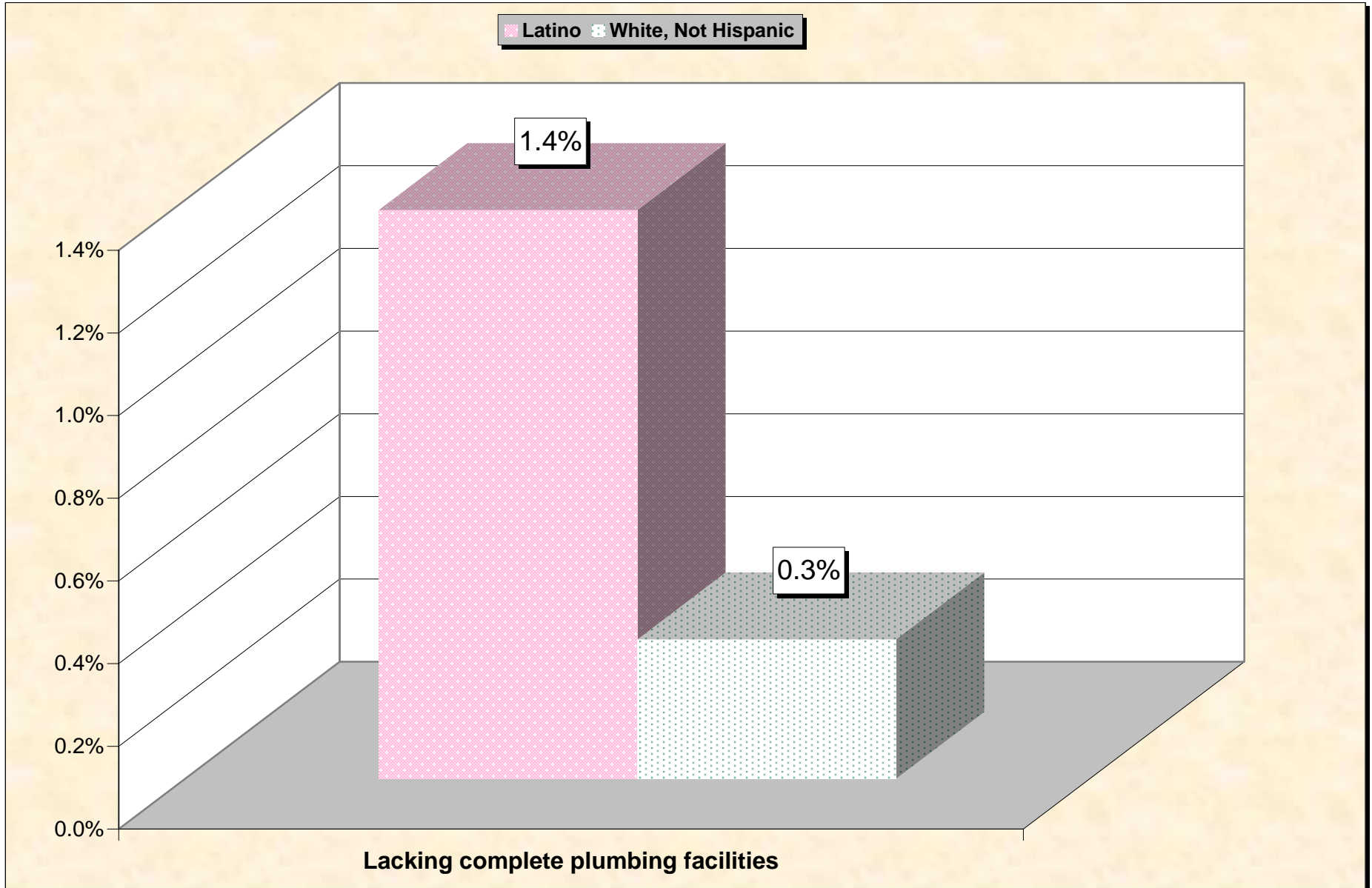

Chart 14 -- Lack of Vehicle By Household Dona Ana County, New Mexico



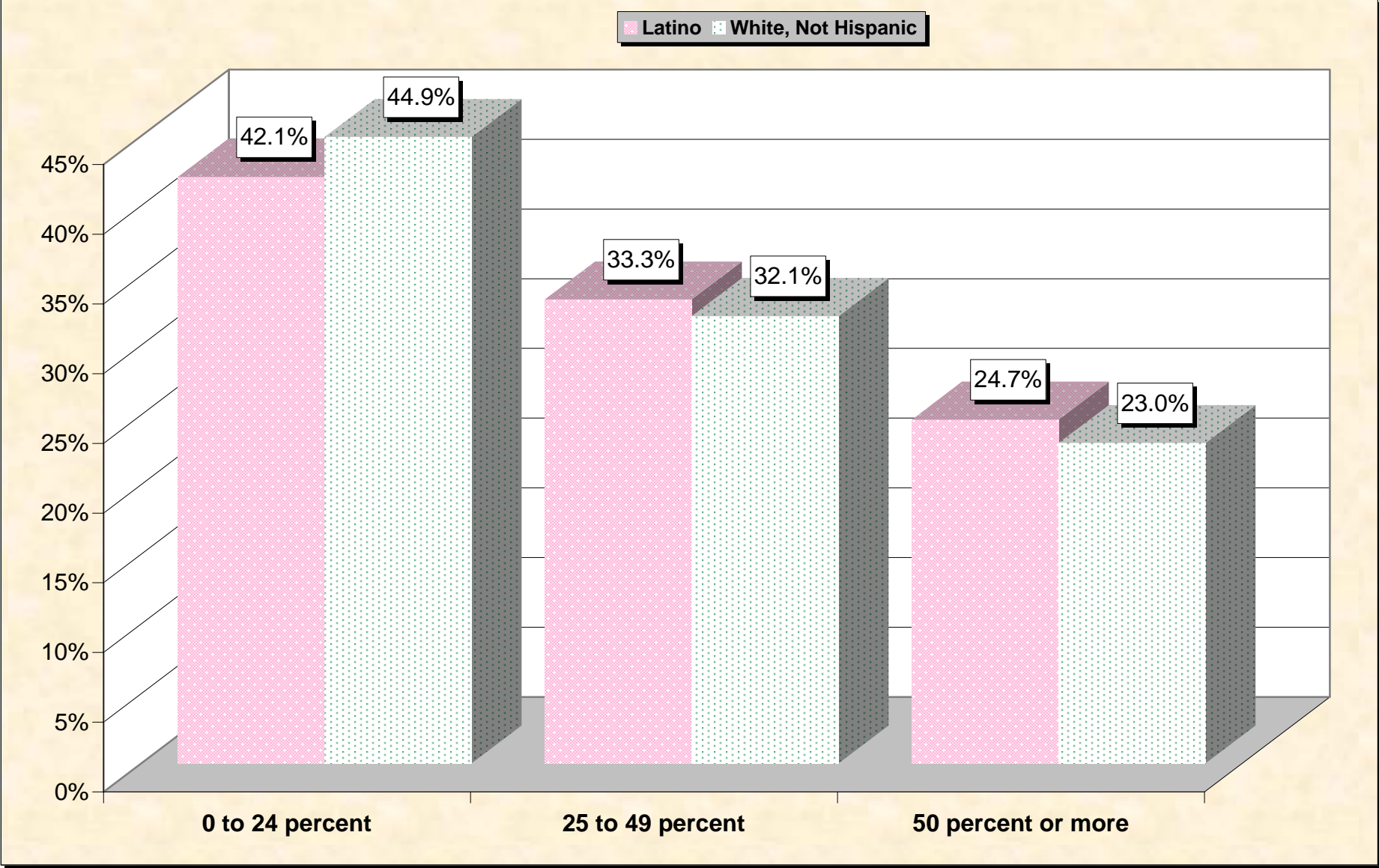

Chart 15 -- Lack of Plumbing By Household Dona Ana County, New Mexico



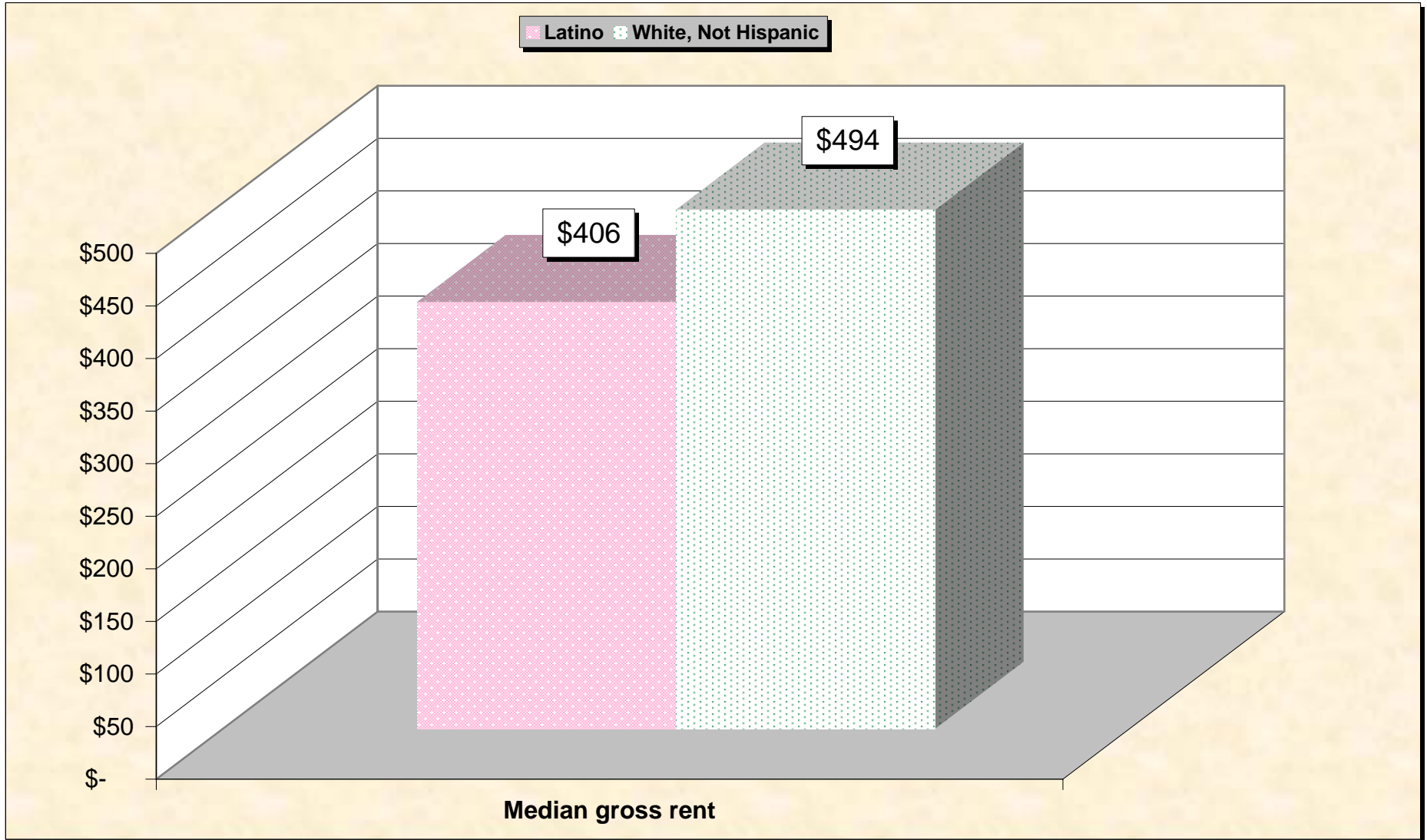

Chart 16 -- Gross Rent as a Percentage of Household Income in 1999 Dona Ana County, New Mexico



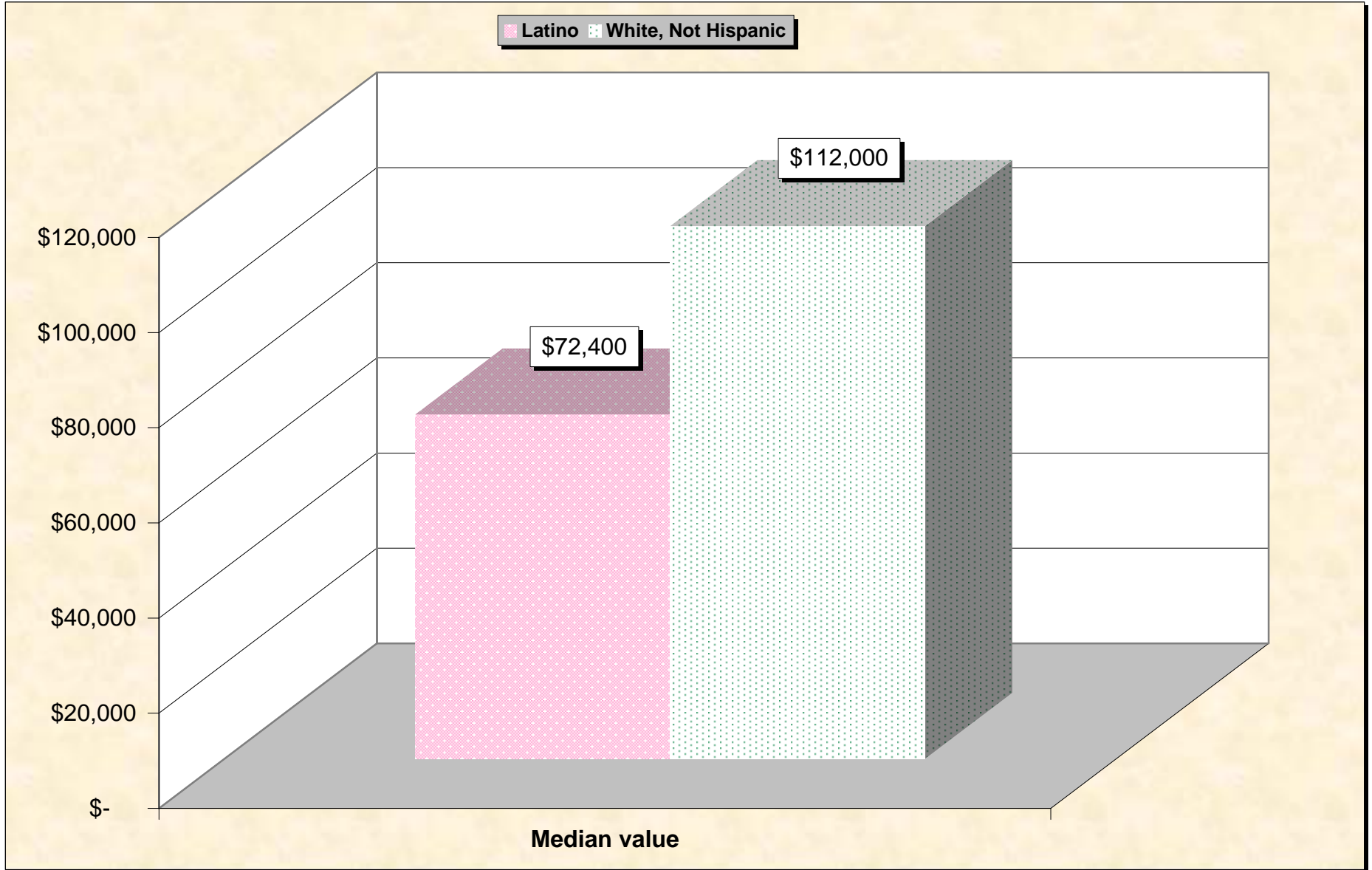
