





Chart 2 -- Private School Enrollment (3 years and over) Washington--Baltimore, DC--MD--VA--WV CMSA






Chart 4 -- Unemployment Rate (Civilian Labor Force) Washington--Baltimore, DC--MD--VA--WV CMSA


Chart 5 -- Labor Force Participation (Civilian Labor Force)



Chart 6 -- Household Income in 1999 Washington--Baltimore, DC--MD--VA--WV CMSA





Chart 7 -- Median Family Income In 1999 Washington--Baltimore, DC--MD--VA--WV CMSA





Chart 8 -- Per Capita Income In 1999 Washington--Baltimore, DC--MD--VA--WV CMSA





Chart 9 -- Income in 1999 Below Poverty Level by Age Washington--Baltimore, DC--MD--VA--WV CMSA





Chart 10 -- Median Earnings in 1999 Washington--Baltimore, DC--MD--VA--WV CMSA





Chart 11 -- Renter-Occupied Housing Washington--Baltimore, DC--MD--VA--WV CMSA





Chart 12 -- Occupants Per Room (Crowding) by Household Washington--Baltimore, DC--MD--VA--WV CMSA





Chart 13 -- Lack of Telephone Service by Household Washington--Baltimore, DC--MD--VA--WV CMSA





Chart 14 -- Lack of Vehicle By Household Washington--Baltimore, DC--MD--VA--WV CMSA





Chart 15 -- Lack of Plumbing By Household Washington--Baltimore, DC--MD--VA--WV CMSA





Chart 16 -- Gross Rent as a Percentage of Household Income in 1999 Washington--Baltimore, DC--MD--VA--WV CMSA




