

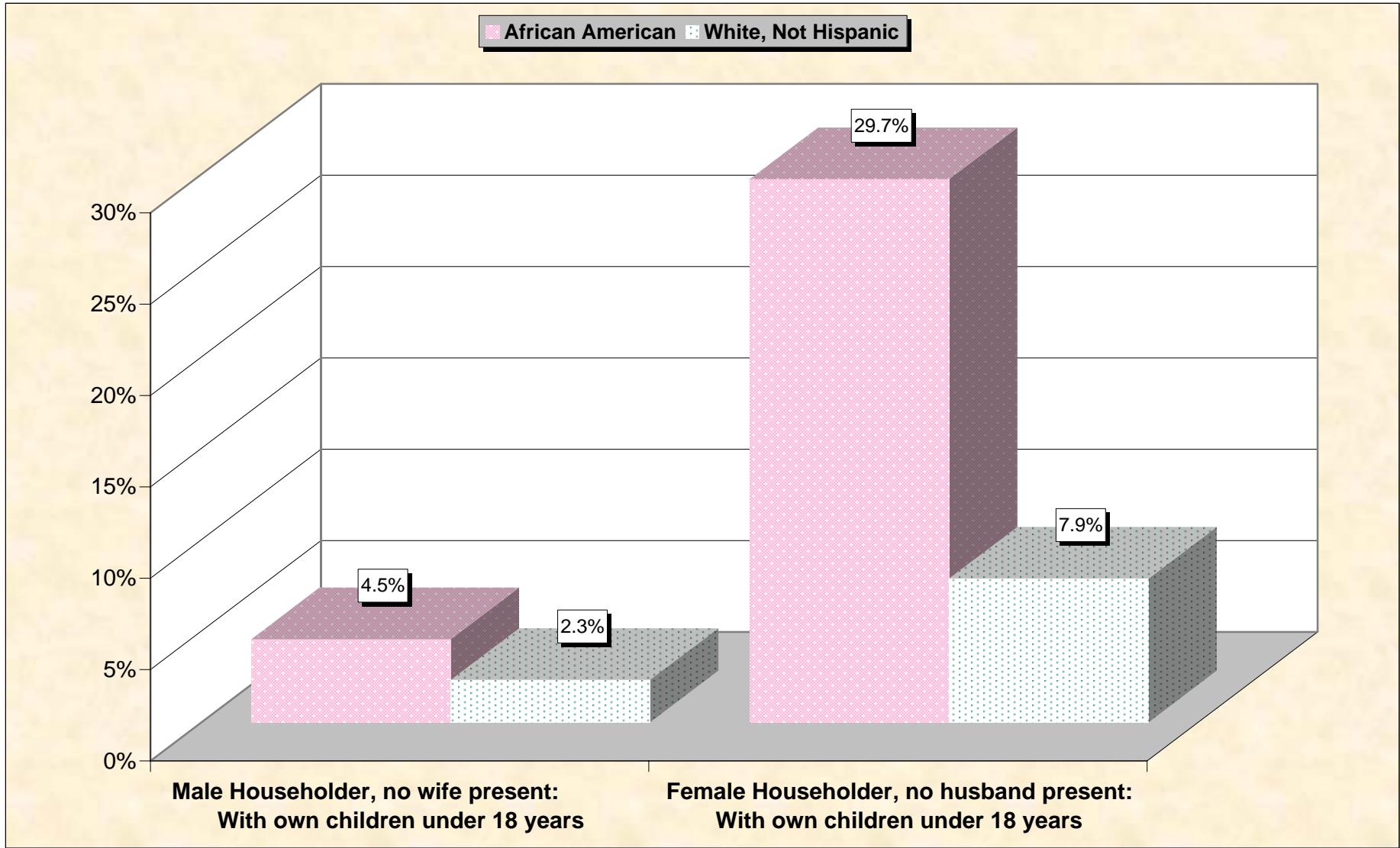

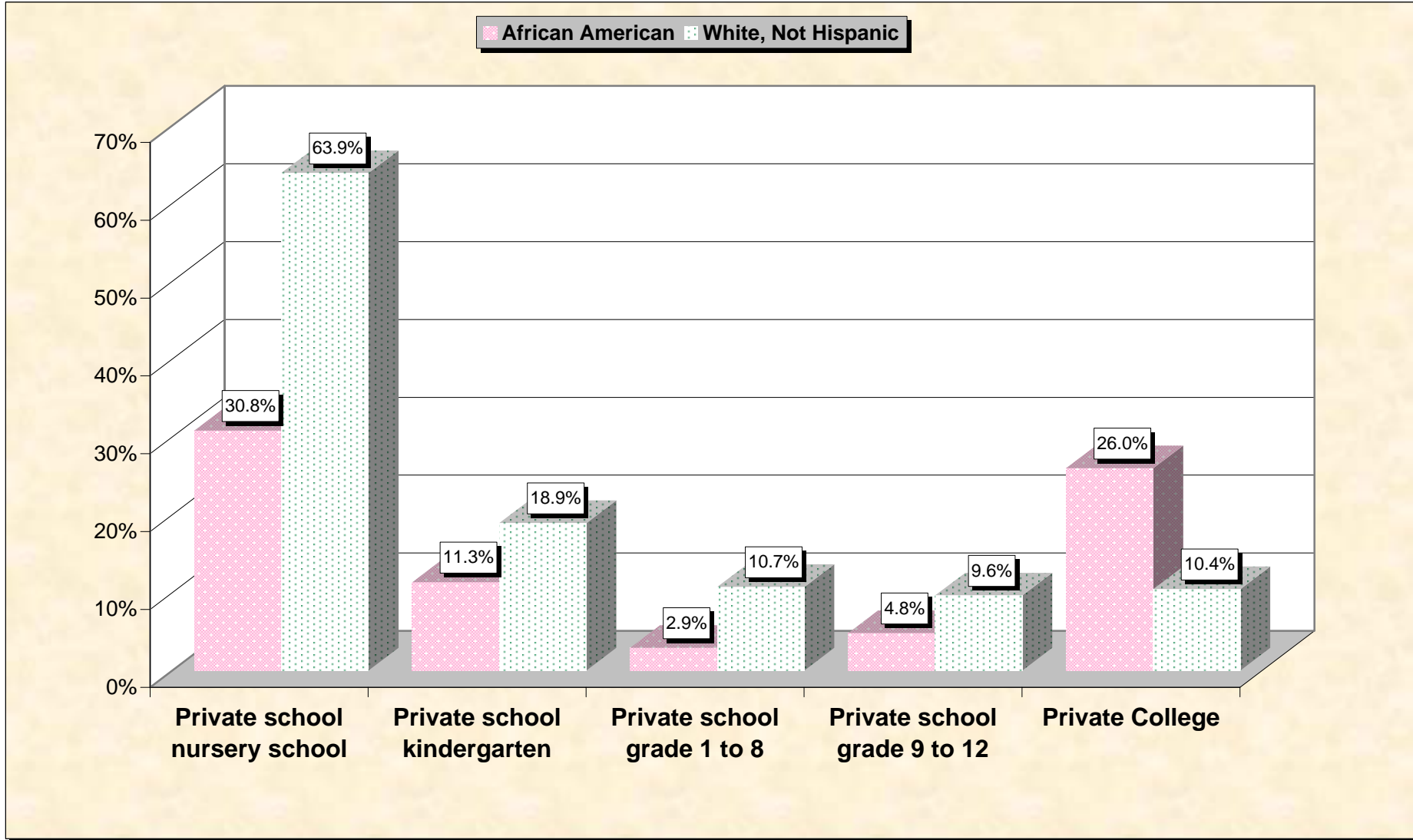

Chart 1 -- Single-Parent Family Households (Householder 15 to 64 years) Columbia, SC MSA; South Carolina



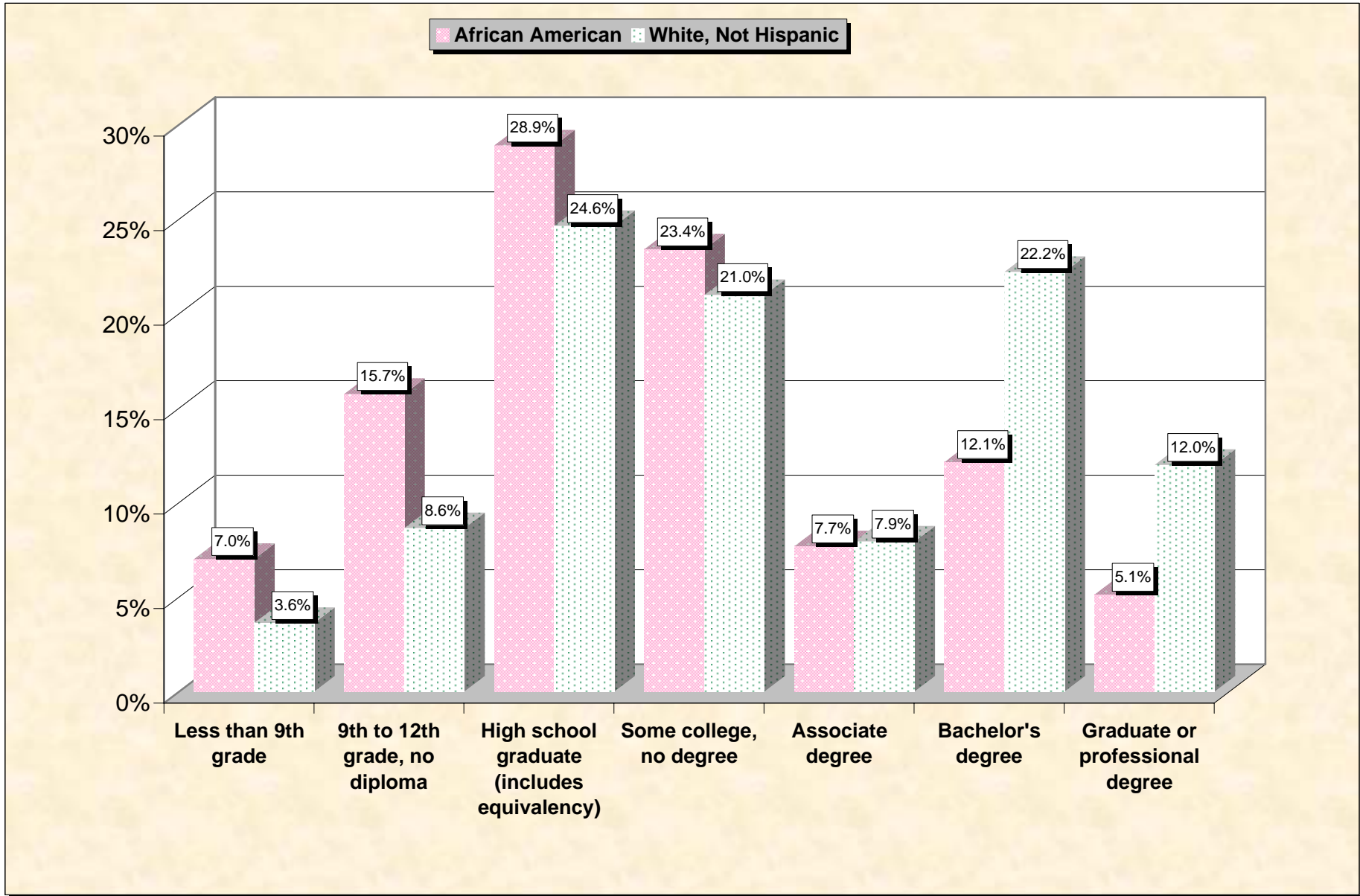

Chart 2 -- Private School Enrollment (3 years and over) Columbia, SC MSA; South Carolina



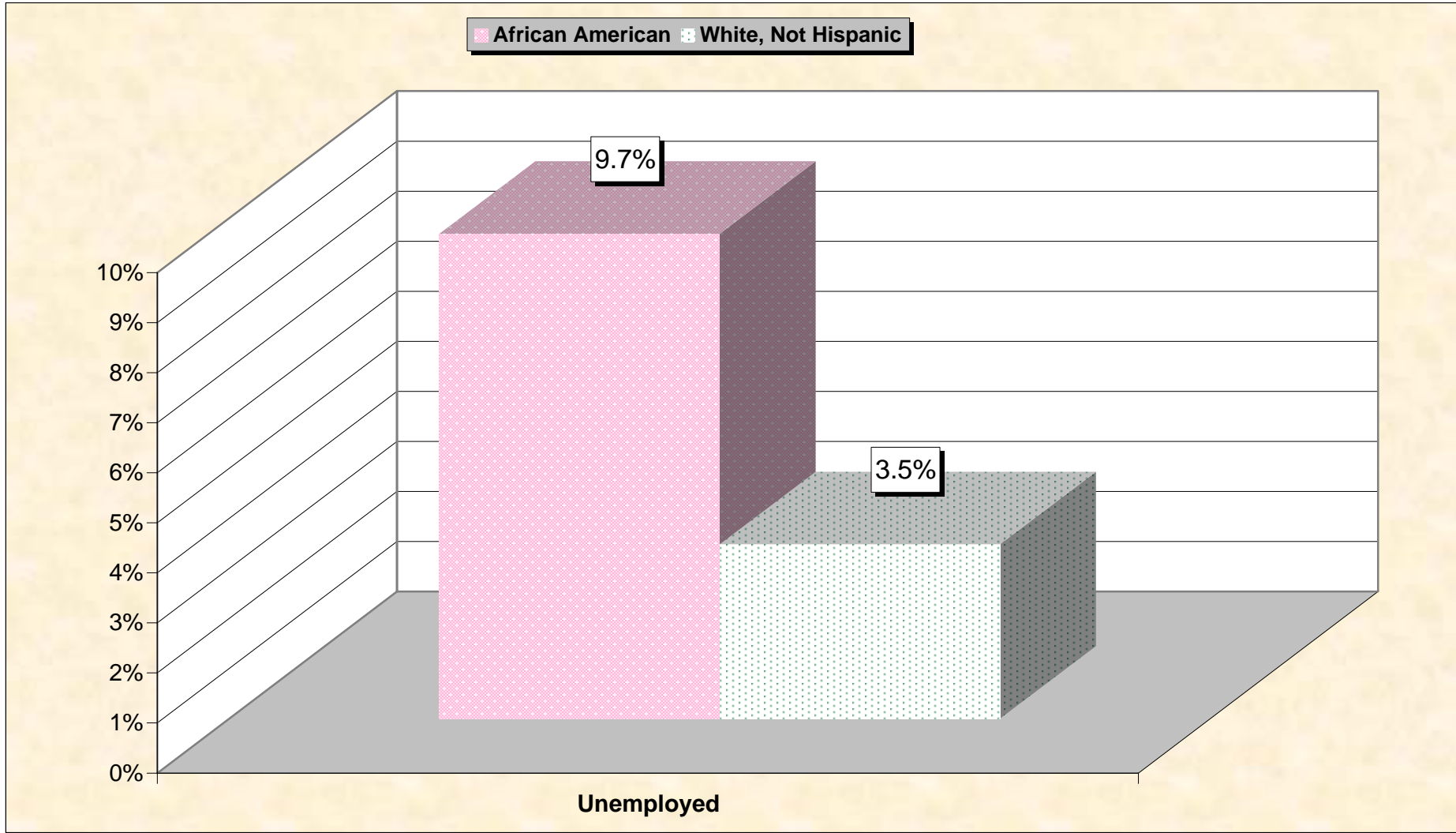

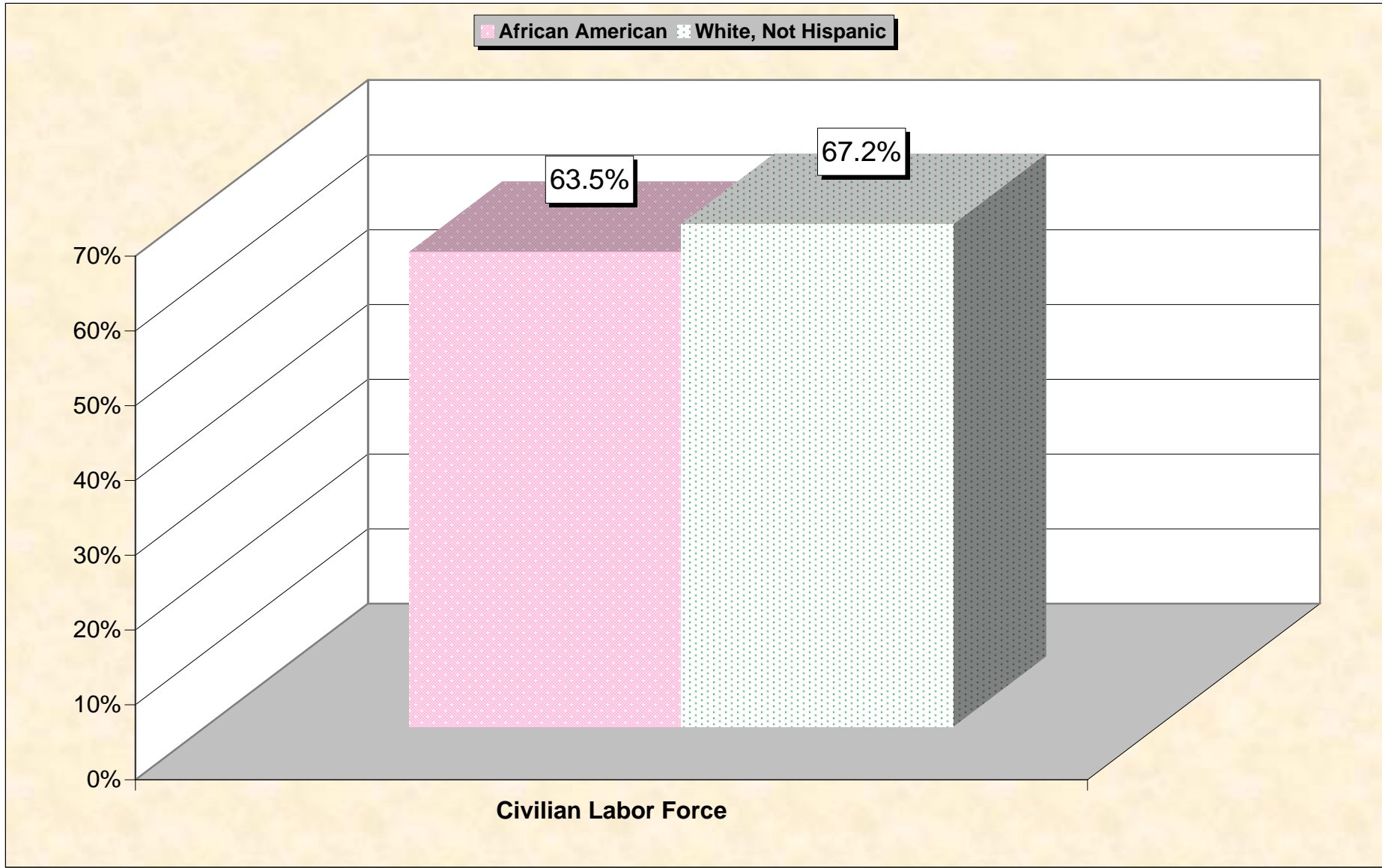
Chart 4 -- Unemployment Rate (Civilian Labor Force) Columbia, SC MSA; South Carolina

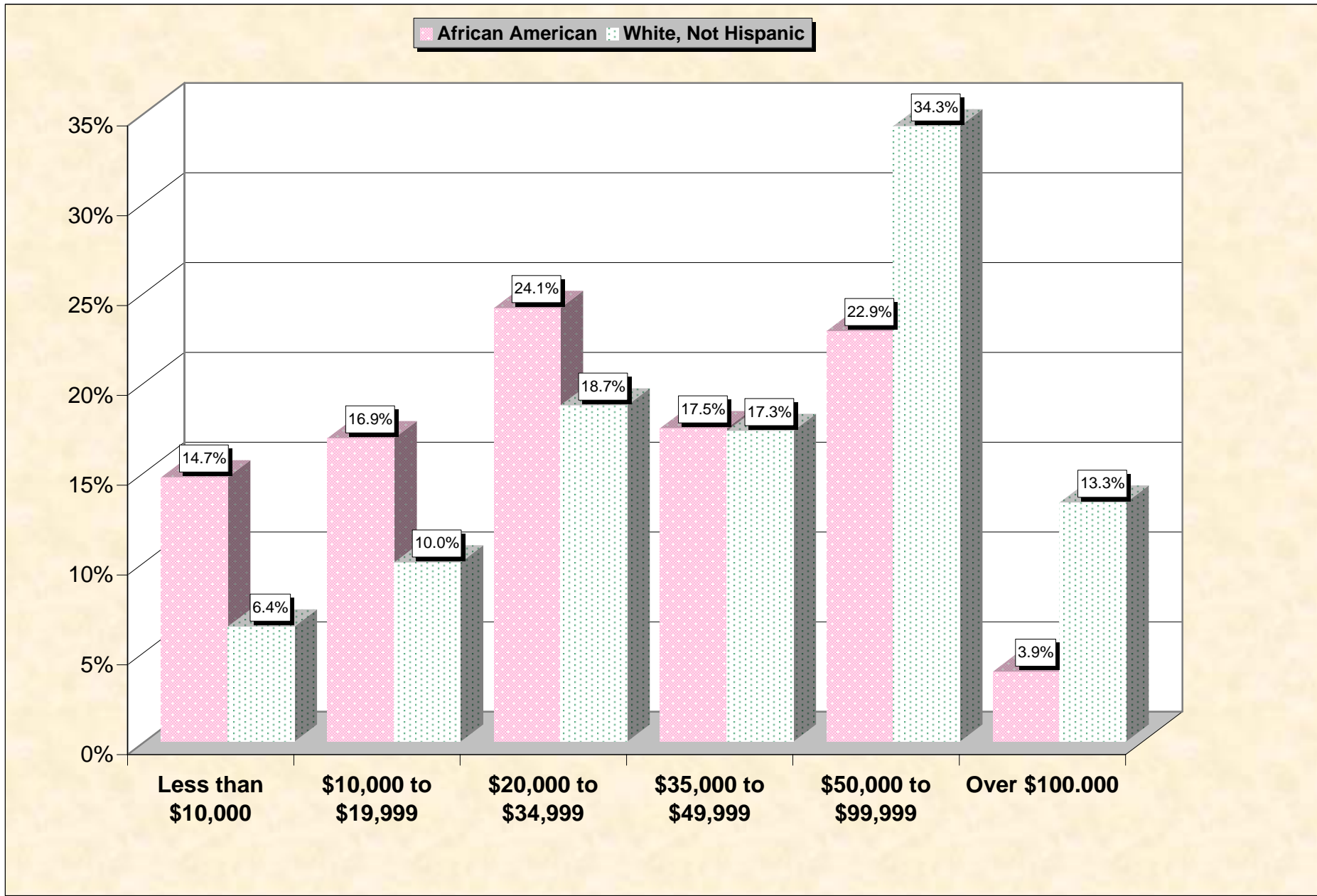
Chart 5 -- Labor Force Participation (Civilian Labor Force) Columbia, SC MSA; South Carolina

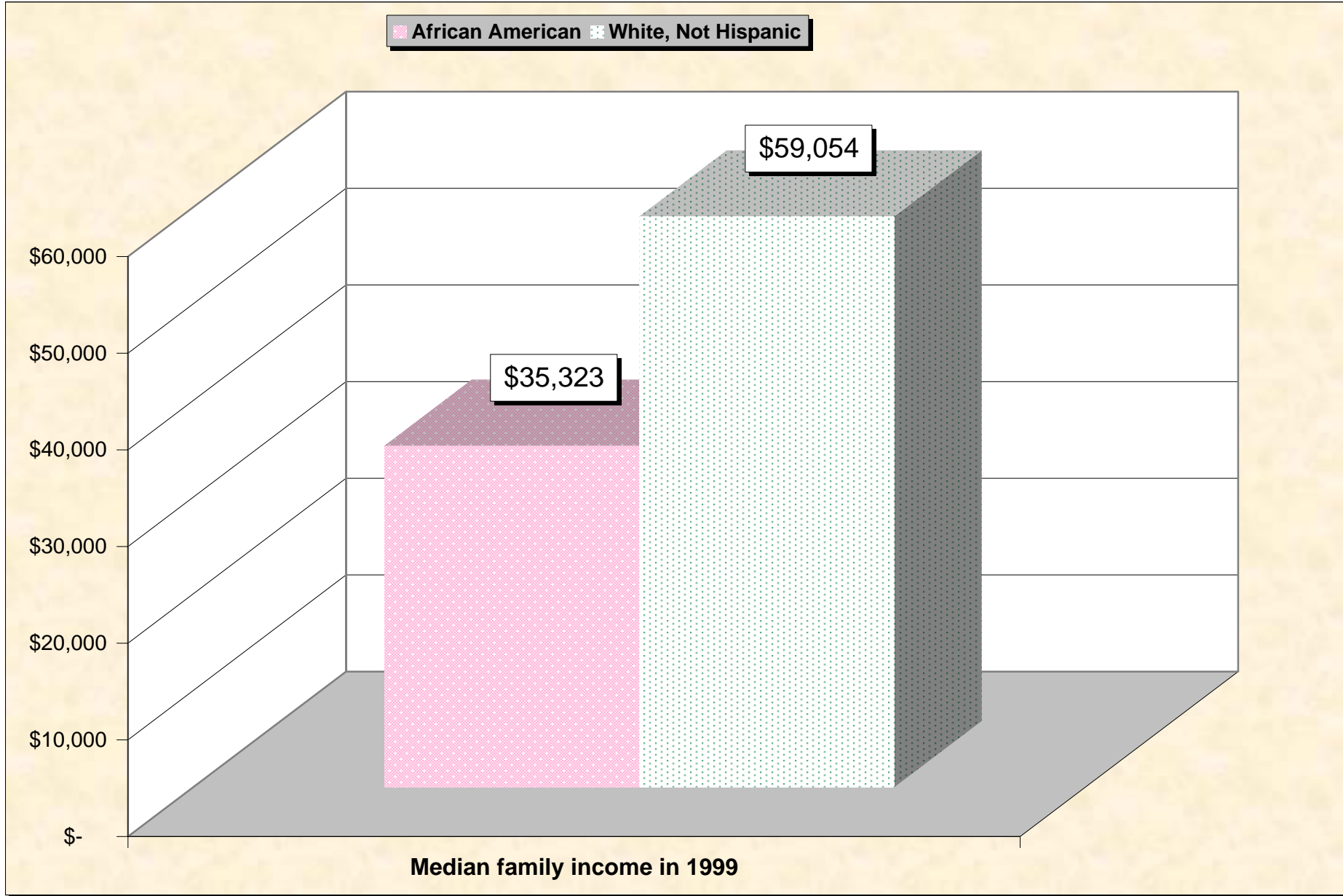
Chart 6 -- Household Income in 1999 Columbia, SC MSA; South Carolina

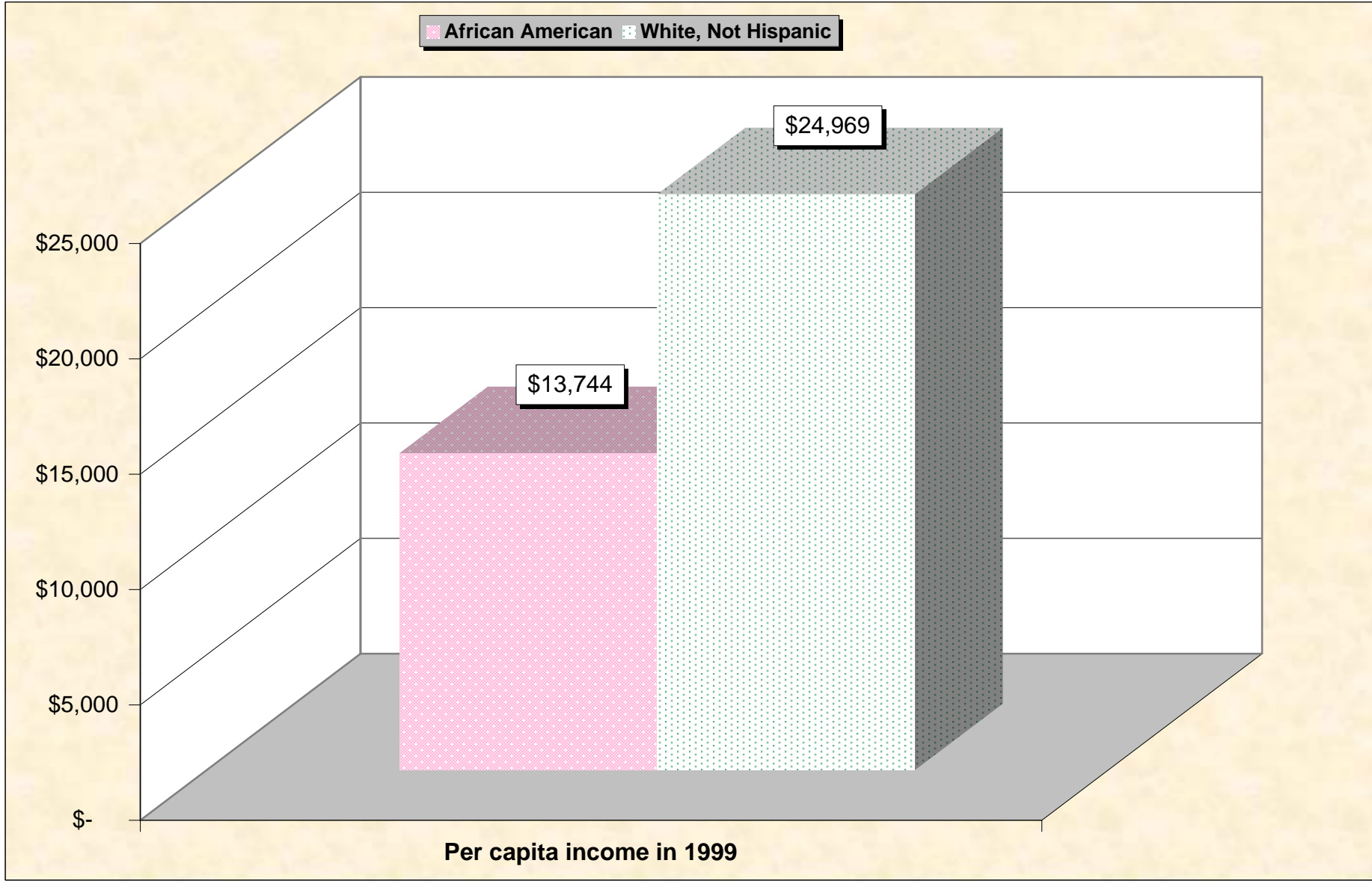
Chart 7 -- Median Family Income In 1999

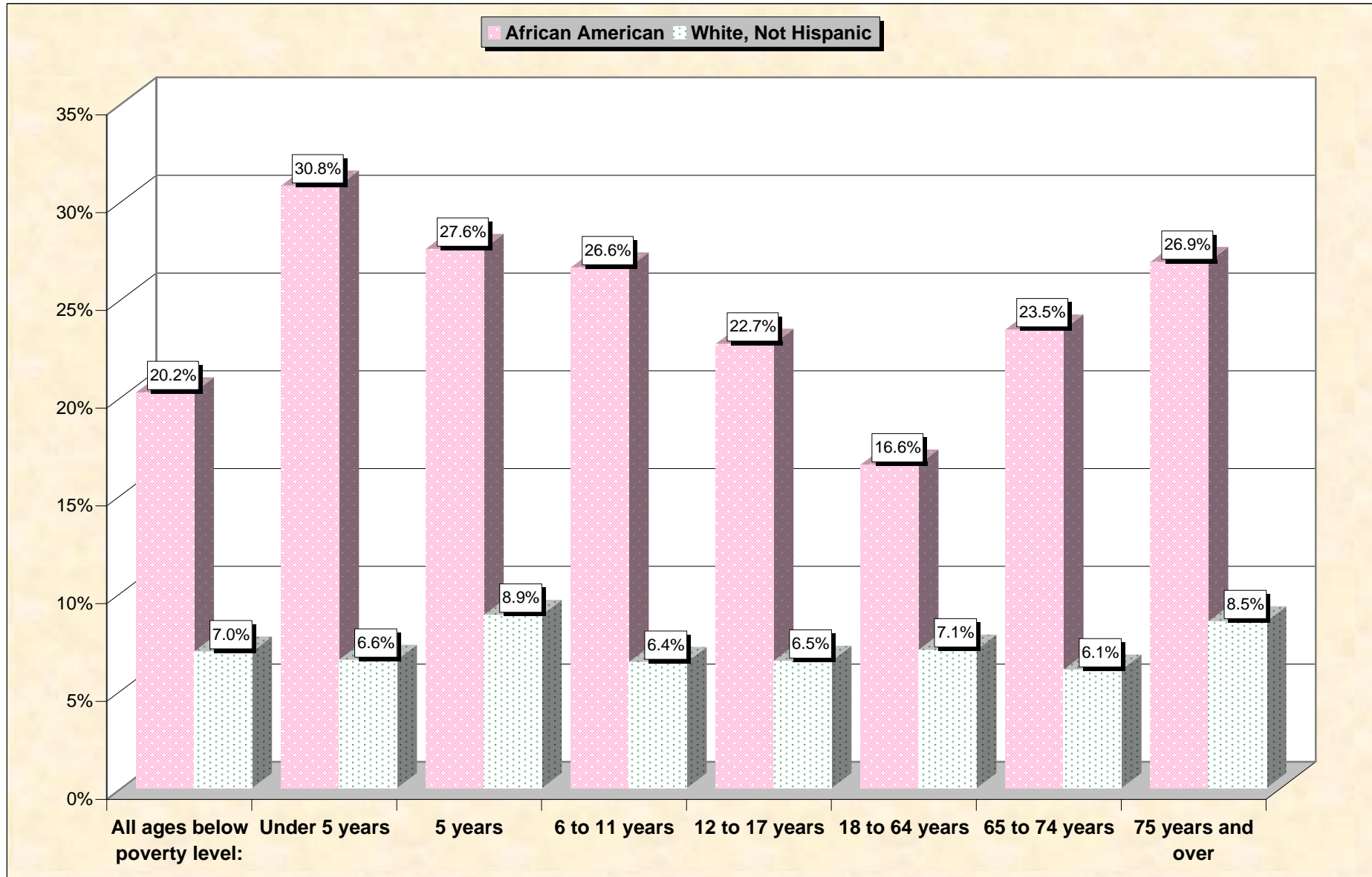

Chart 8 -- Per Capita Income In 1999 Columbia, SC MSA; South Carolina



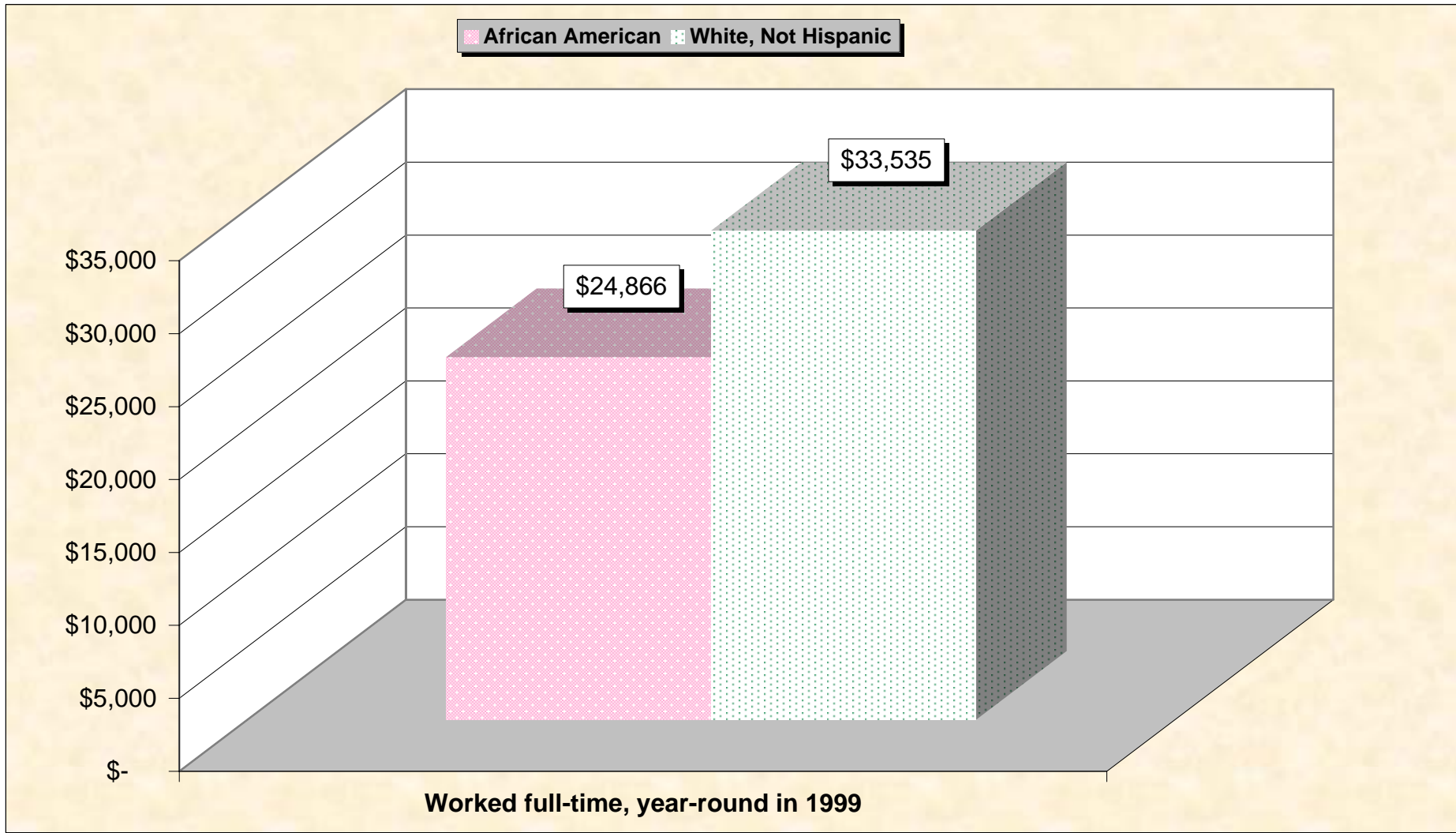

Chart 9 -- Income in 1999 Below Poverty Level by Age Columbia, SC MSA; South Carolina



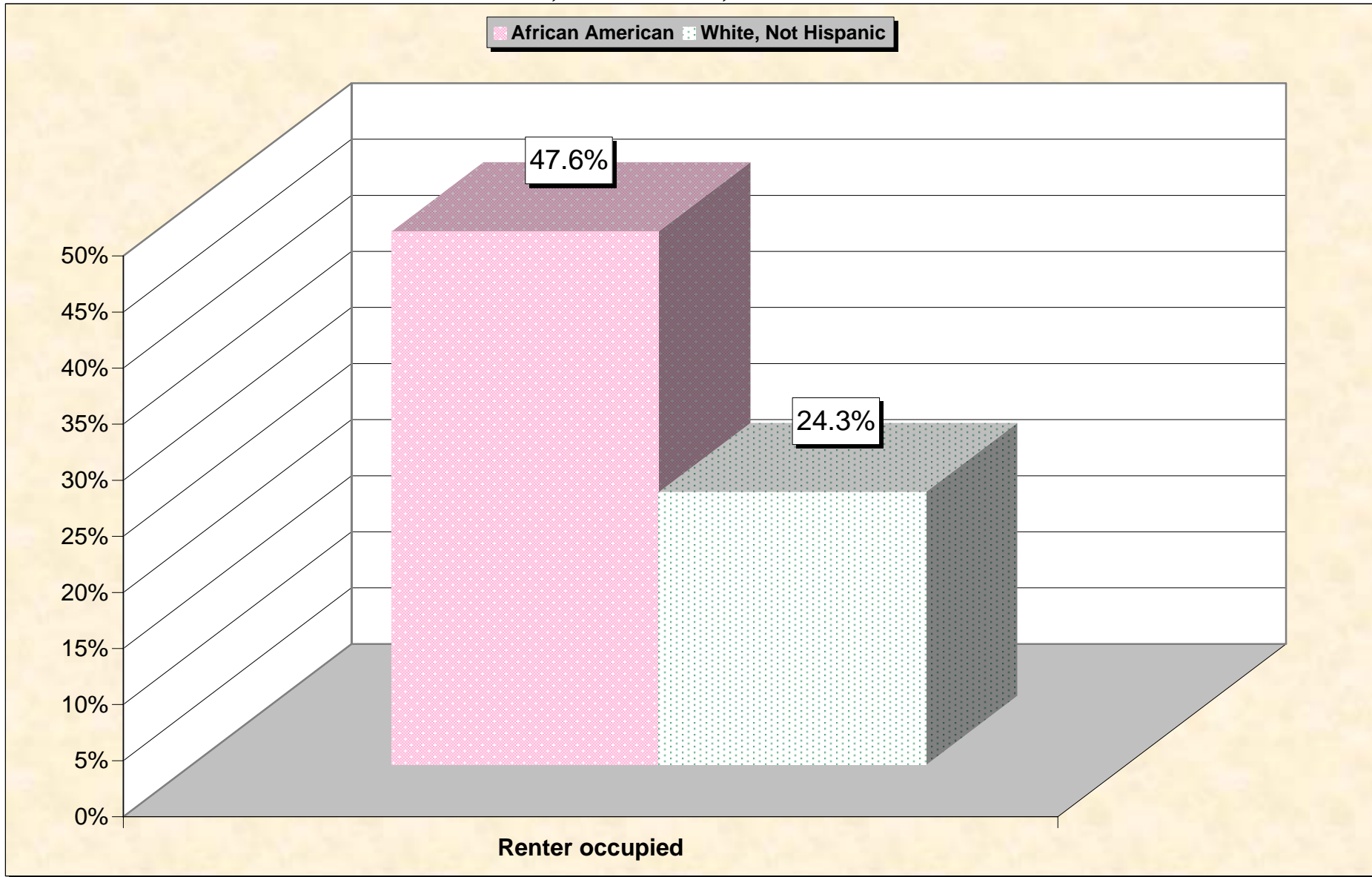

Chart 10 -- Median Earnings in 1999 Columbia, SC MSA; South Carolina



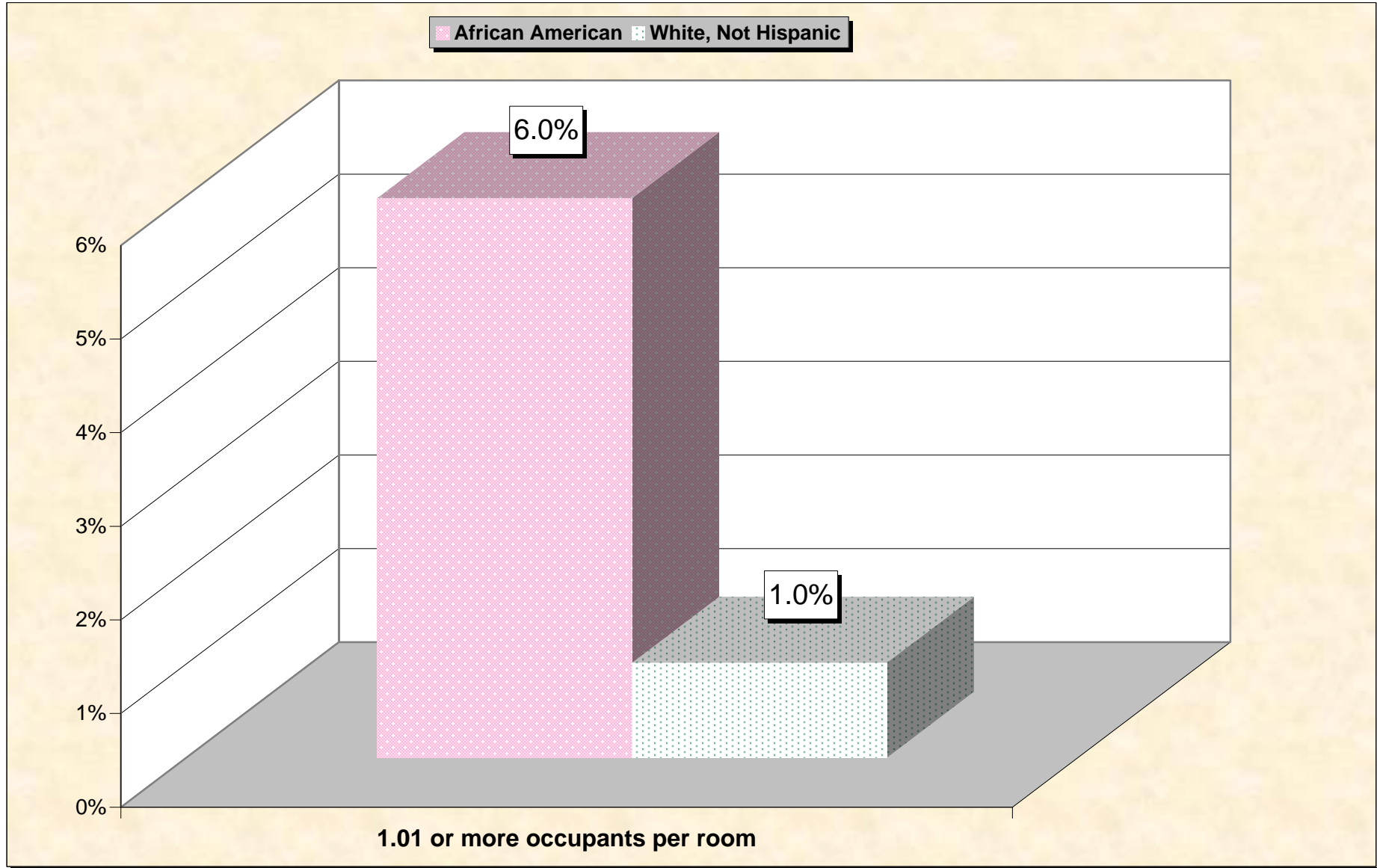

Chart 11 -- Renter-Occupied Housing Columbia, SC MSA; South Carolina



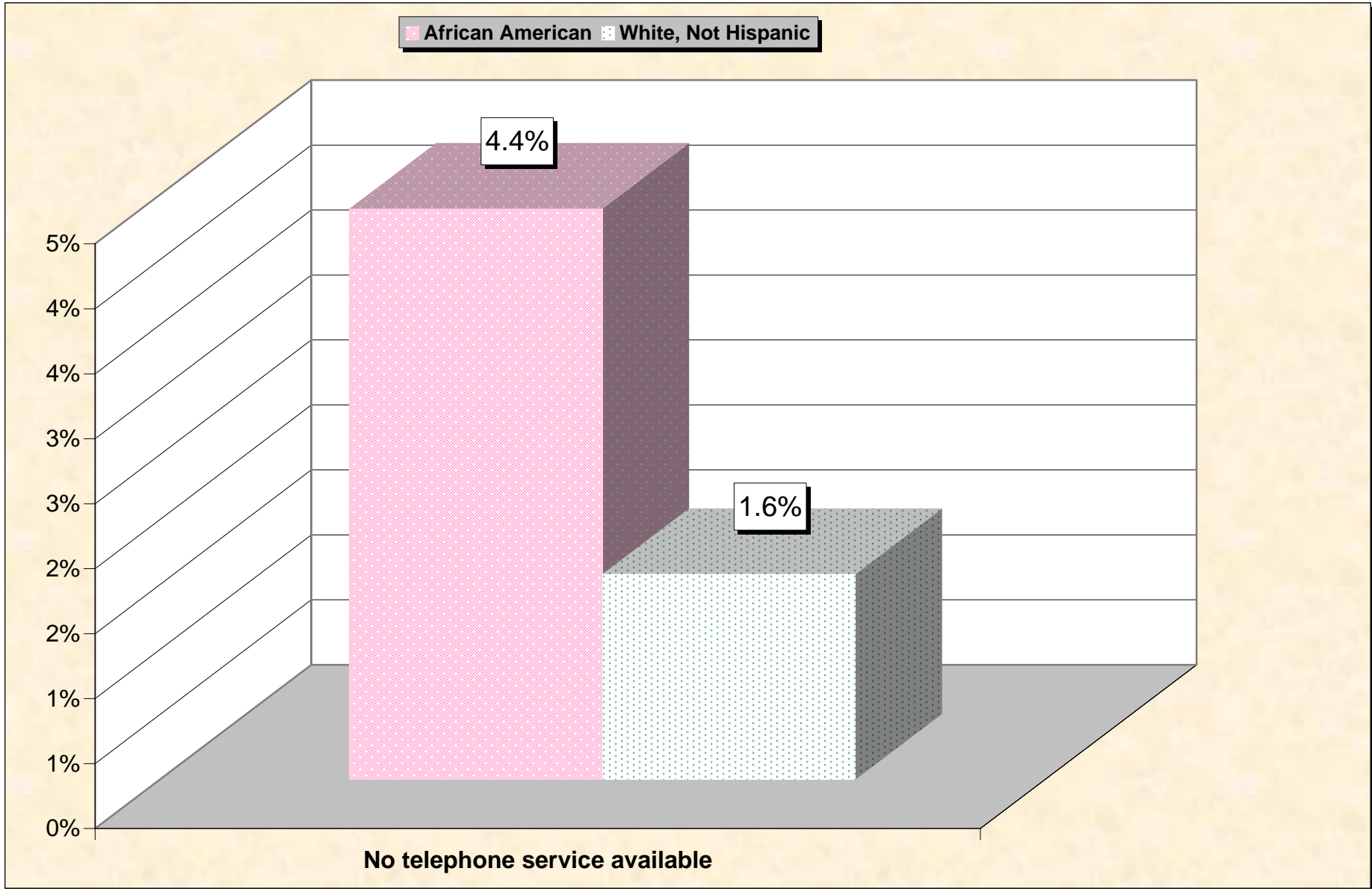

Chart 12 -- Occupants Per Room (Crowding) by Household Columbia, SC MSA; South Carolina



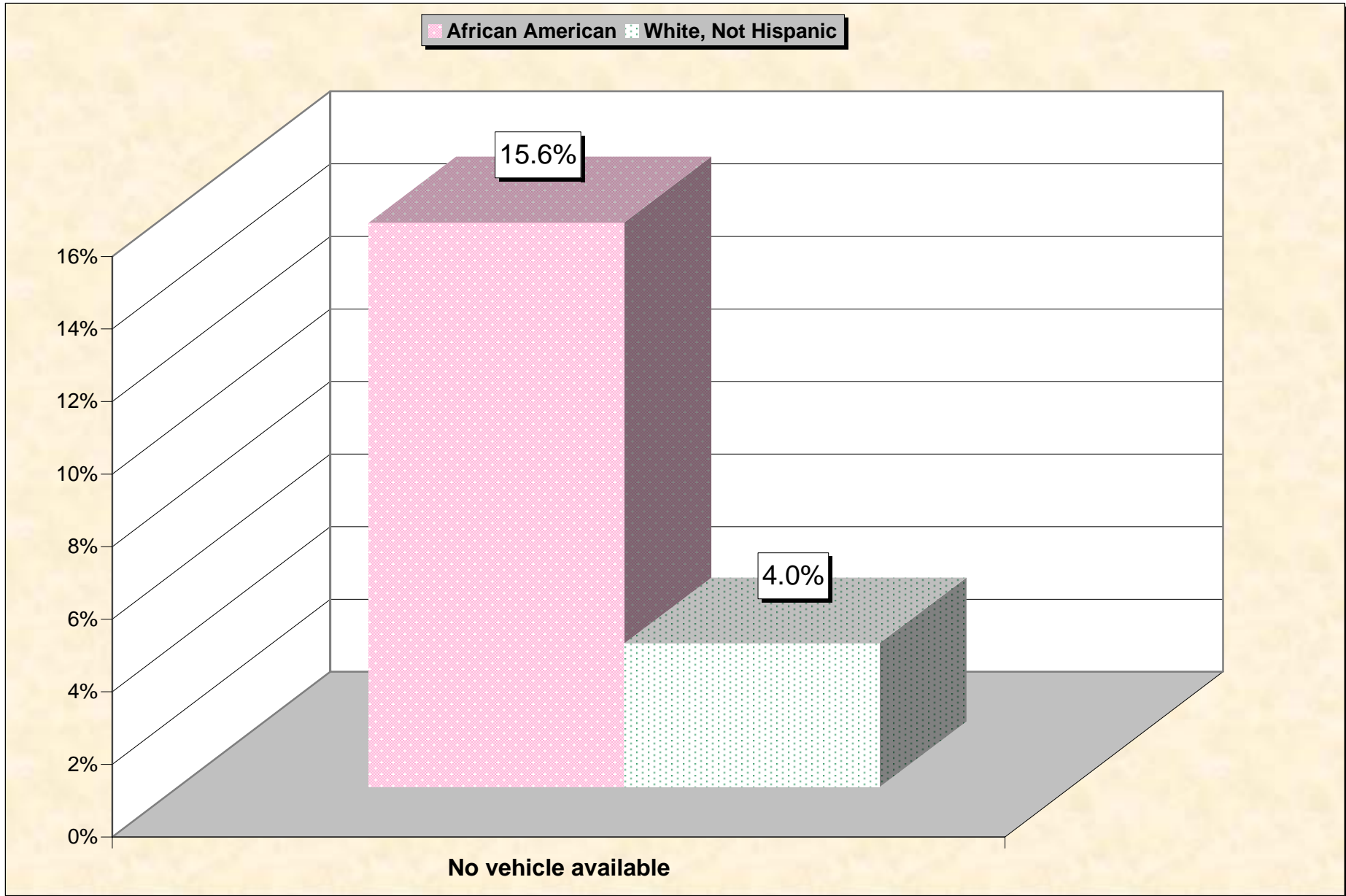

Chart 13 -- Lack of Telephone Service by Household Columbia, SC MSA; South Carolina



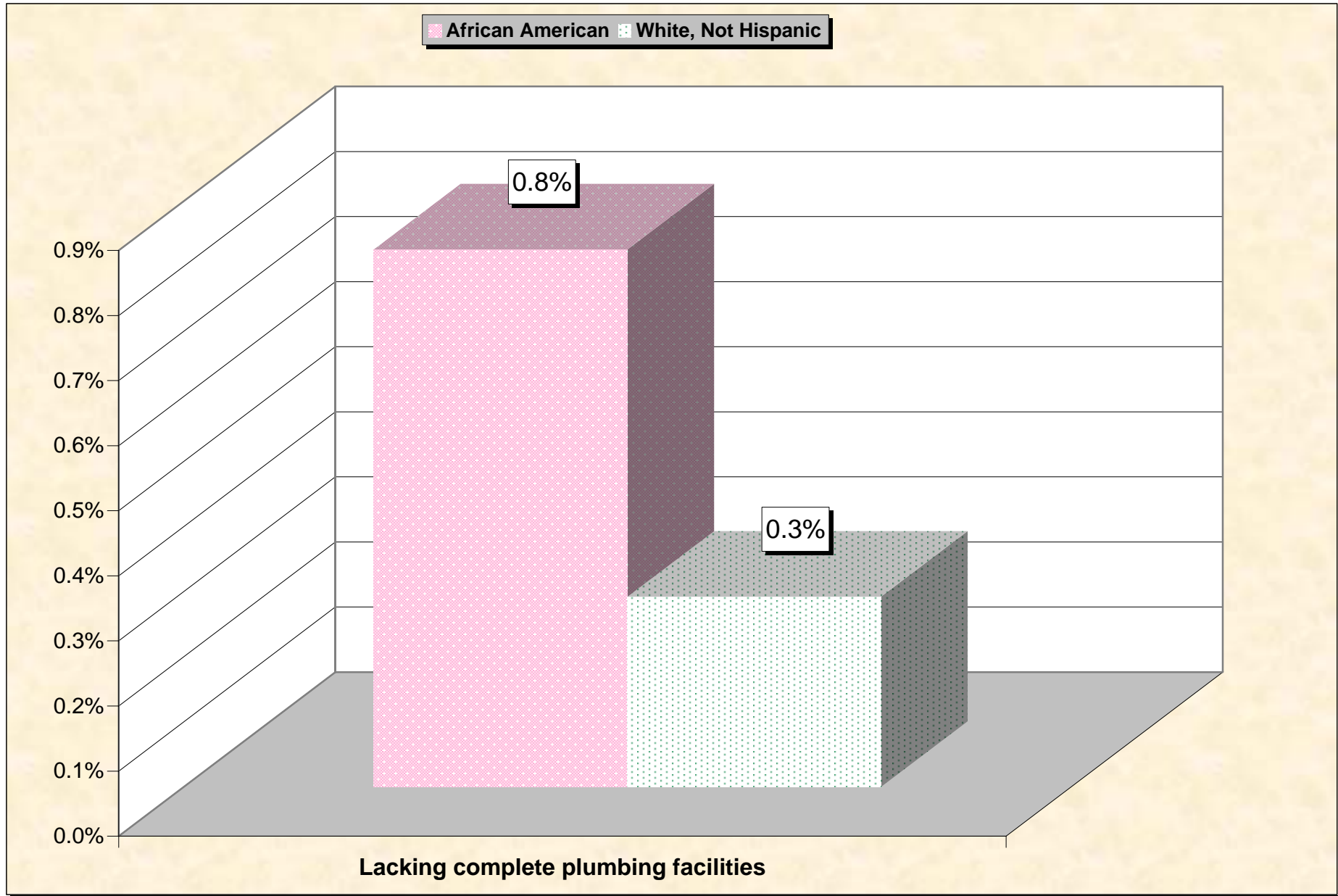

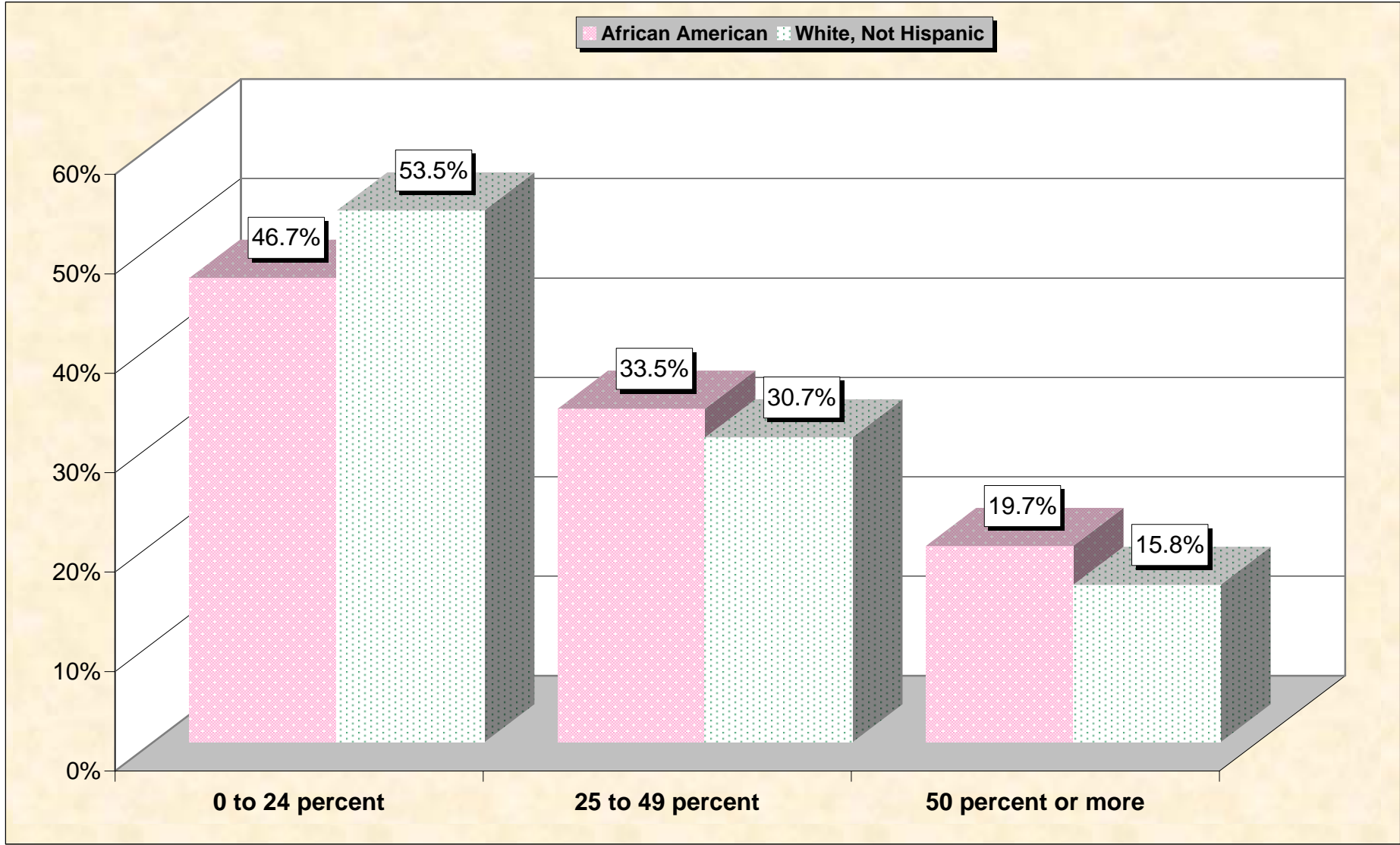
Chart 15 -- Lack of Plumbing By Household Columbia, SC MSA; South Carolina

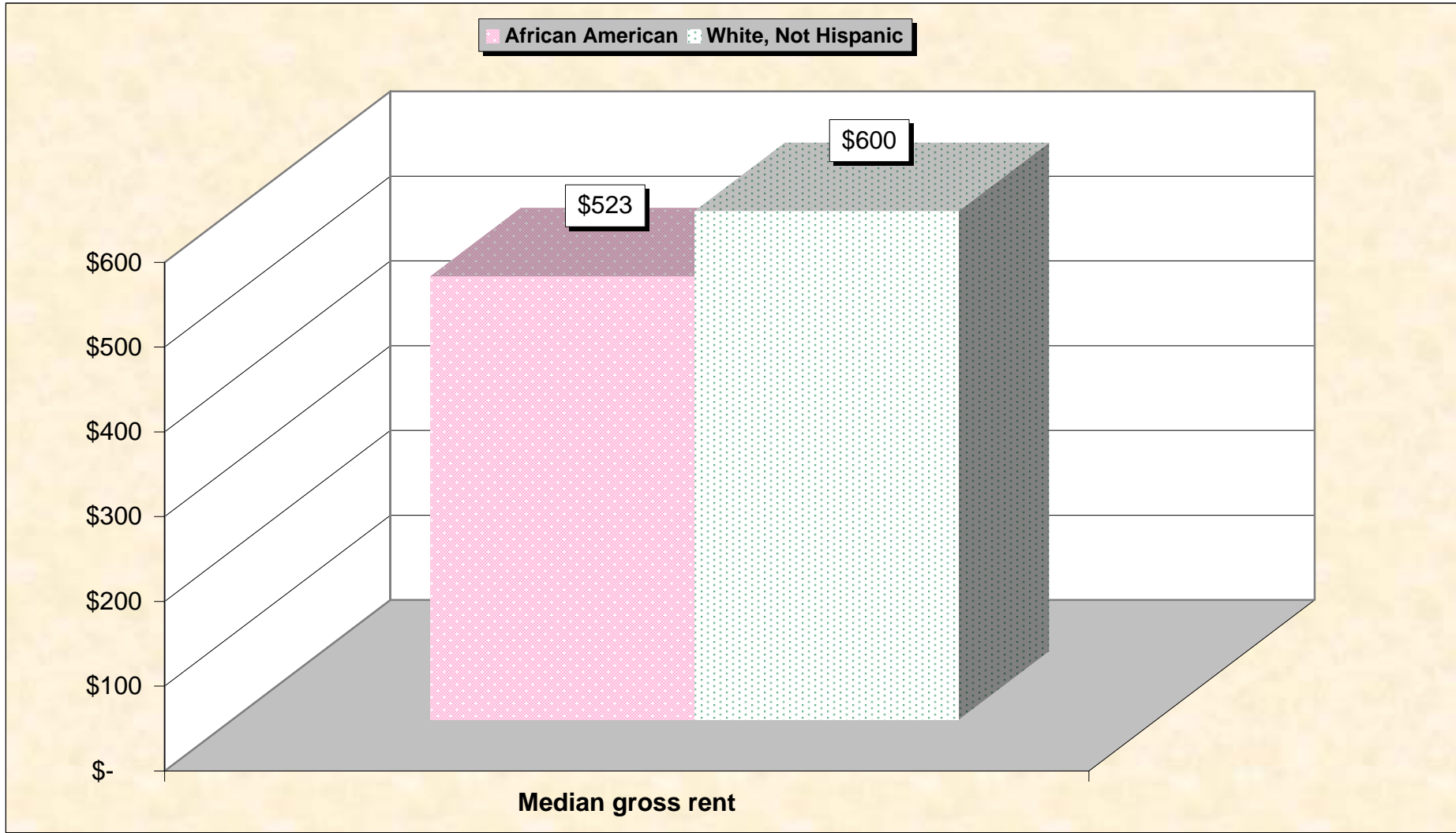
Chart 16 -- Gross Rent as a Percentage of Household Income in 1999

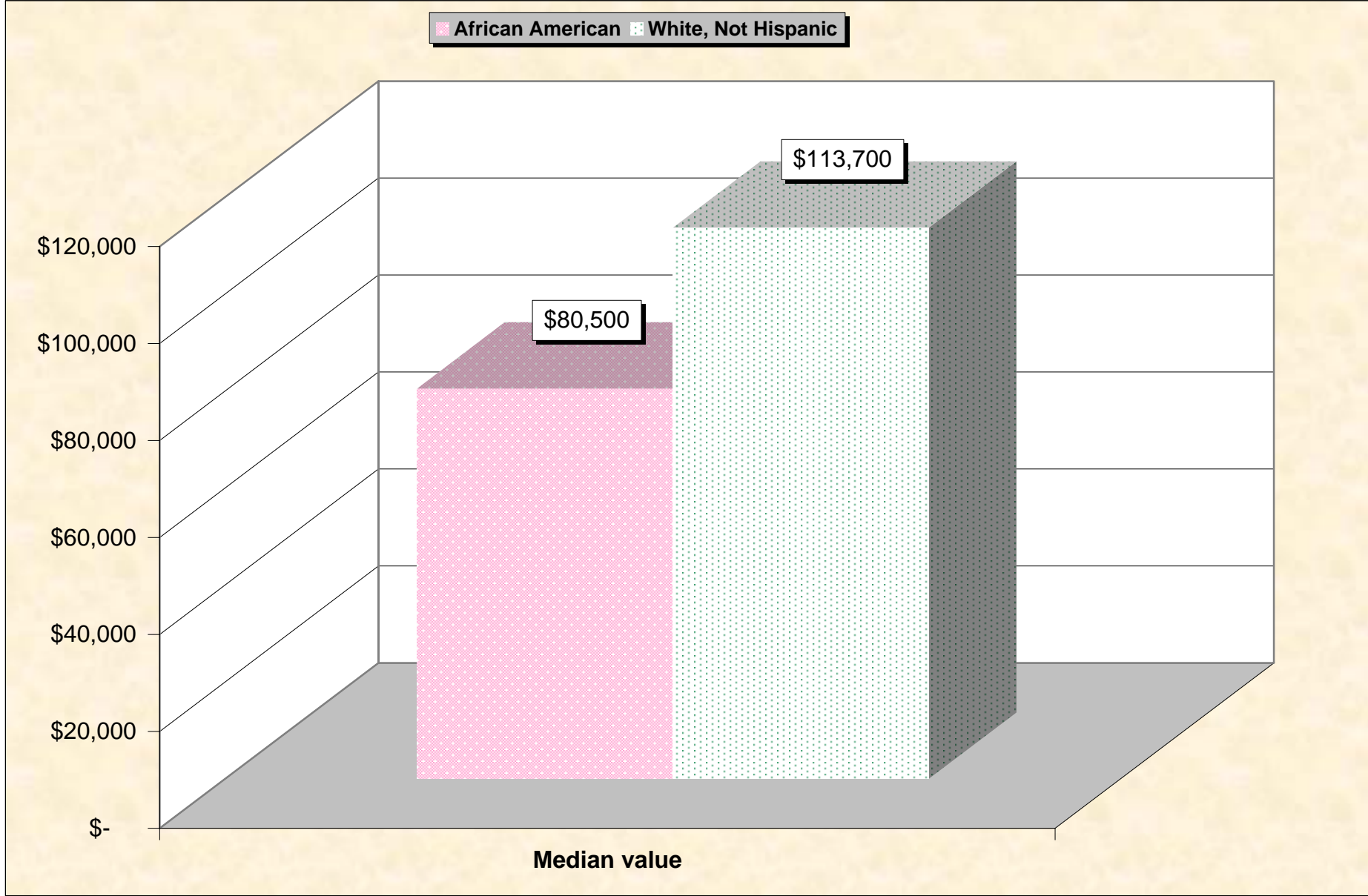
