



Chart 1 -- Single-Parent Family Households (Householder 15 to 64 years) Charleston--North Charleston, SC MSA





Chart 2 -- Private School Enrollment (3 years and over) Charleston--North Charleston, SC MSA






Chart 4 -- Unemployment Rate (Civilian Labor Force) Charleston--North Charleston, SC MSA


Chart 5 -- Labor Force Participation (Civilian Labor Force) Charleston--North Charleston, SC MSA



Chart 8 -- Per Capita Income In 1999 Charleston--North Charleston, SC MSA






Chart 9 -- Income in 1999 Below Poverty Level by Age Charleston--North Charleston, SC MSA





Chart 10 -- Median Earnings in 1999 Charleston--North Charleston, SC MSA





Chart 11 -- Renter-Occupied Housing Charleston--North Charleston, SC MSA





Chart 12 -- Occupants Per Room (Crowding) by Household Charleston--North Charleston, SC MSA





Chart 13 -- Lack of Telephone Service by Household Charleston--North Charleston, SC MSA





Chart 14 -- Lack of Vehicle By Household Charleston--North Charleston, SC MSA





Chart 15 -- Lack of Plumbing By Household Charleston--North Charleston, SC MSA





Chart 16 -- Gross Rent as a Percentage of Household Income in 1999 Charleston--North Charleston, SC MSA




