

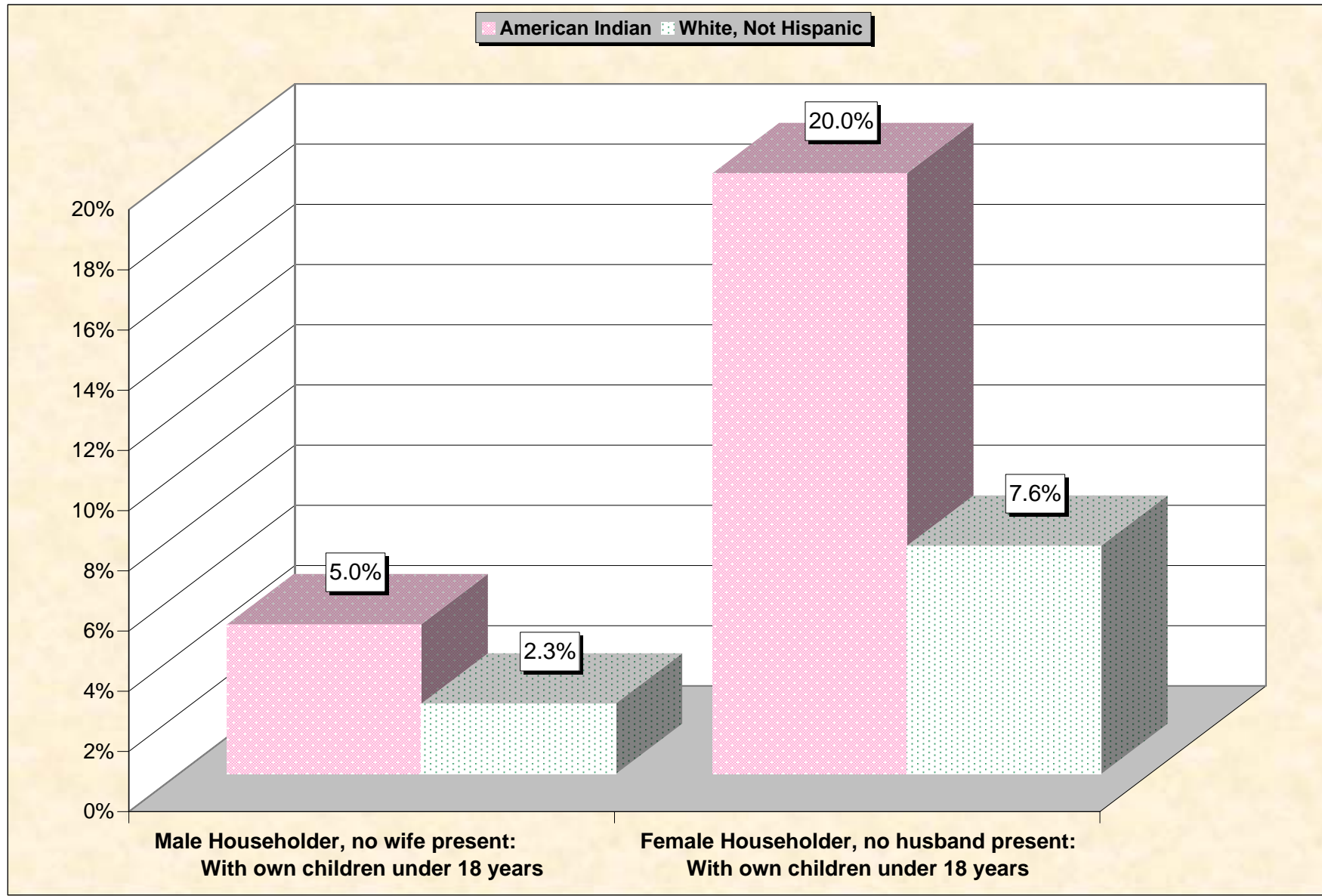

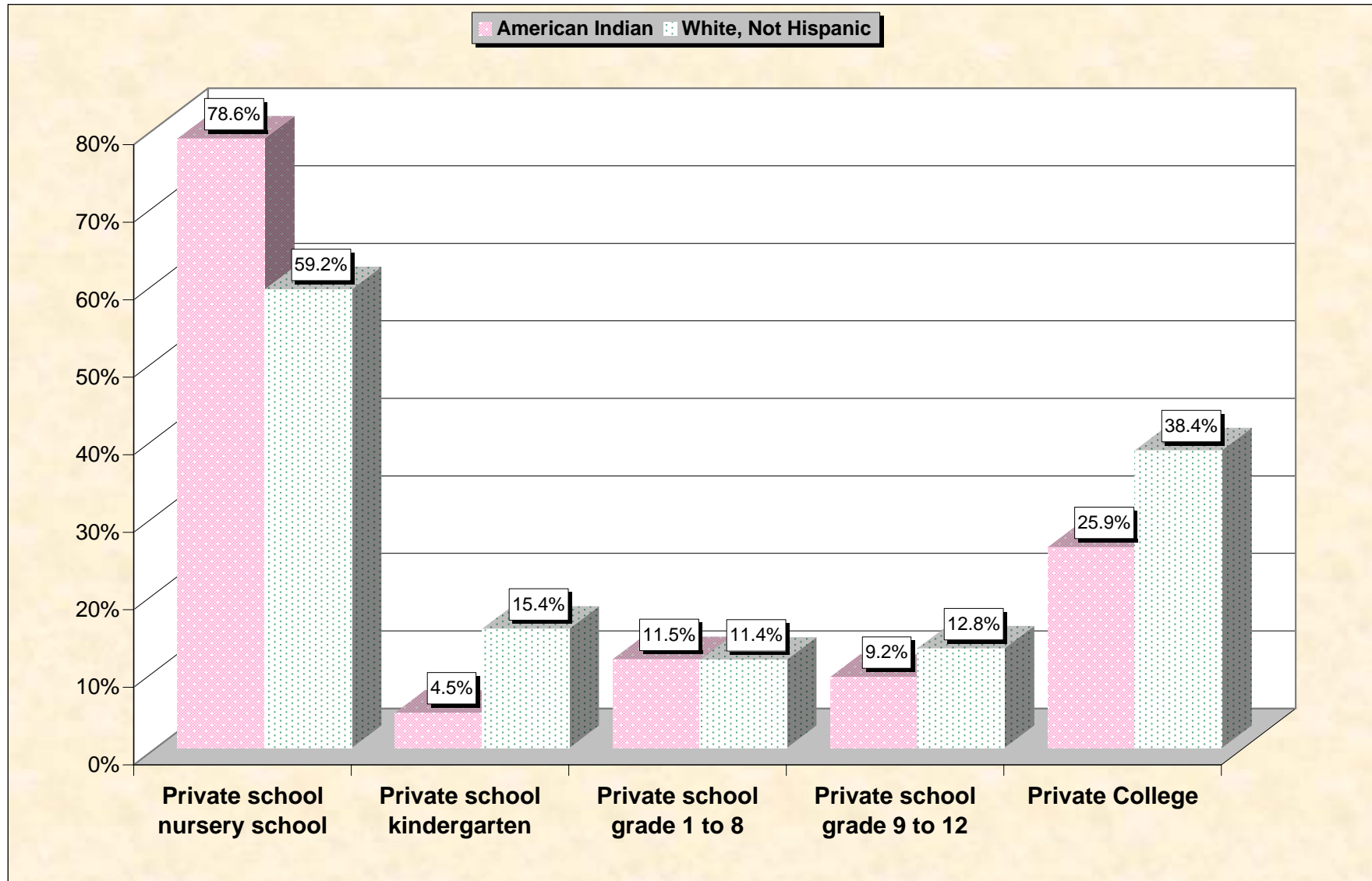

# Chart 1 -- Single-Parent Family Households (Householder 15 to 64 years) Connecticut



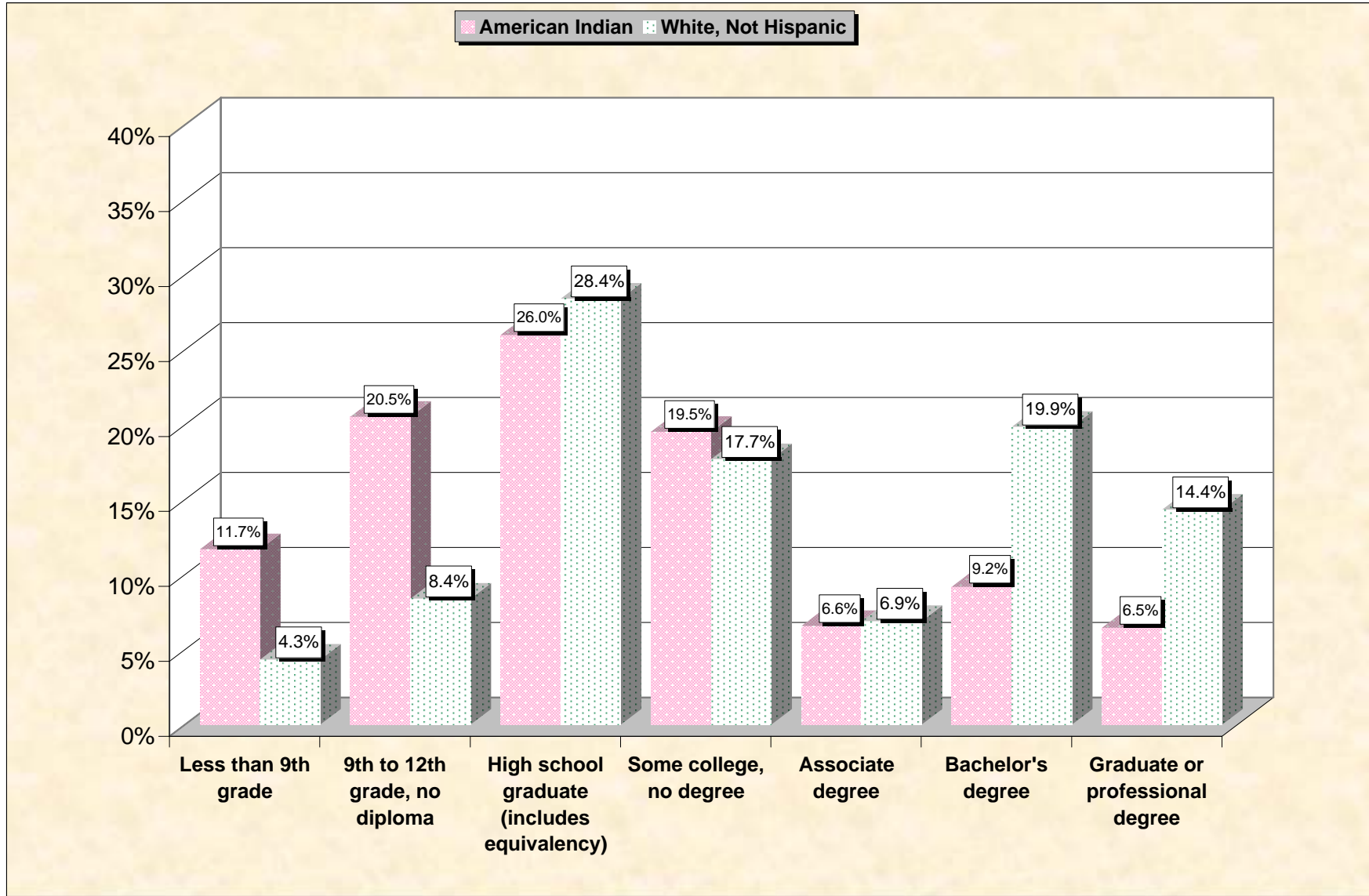

## Chart 2 -- Private School Enrollment (3 years and over) Connecticut



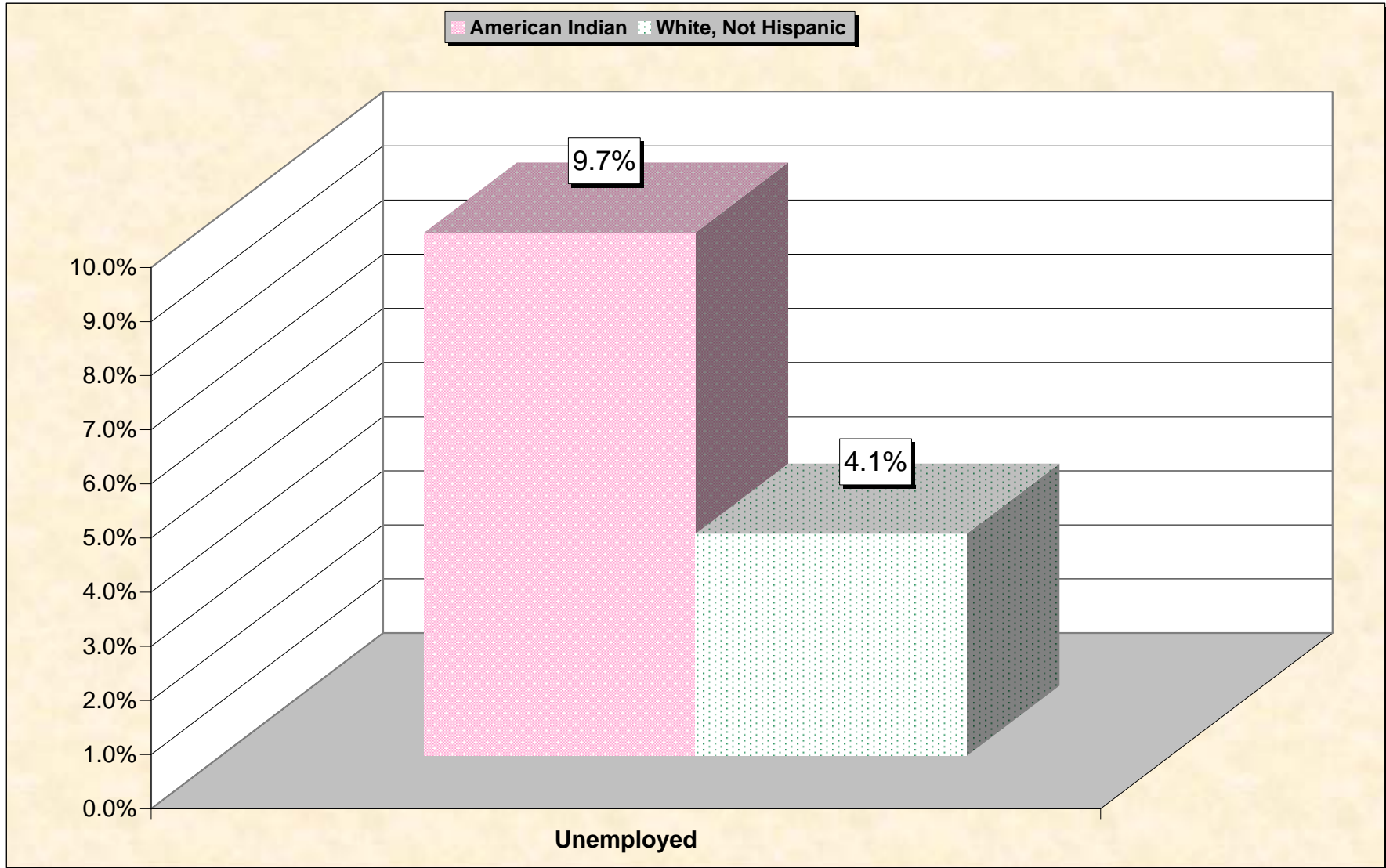

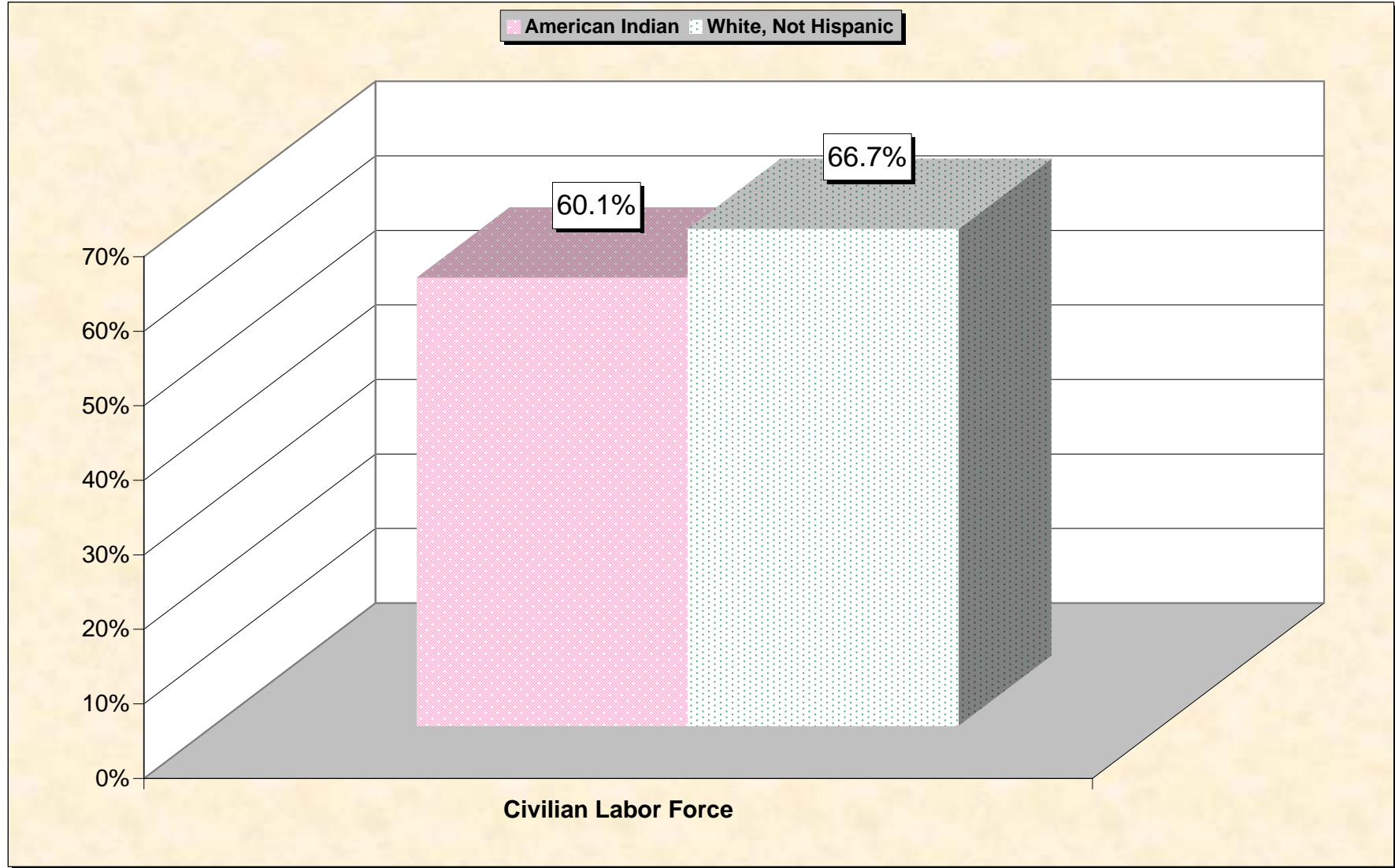
# Chart 4 -- Unemployment Rate (Civilian Labor Force) Connecticut

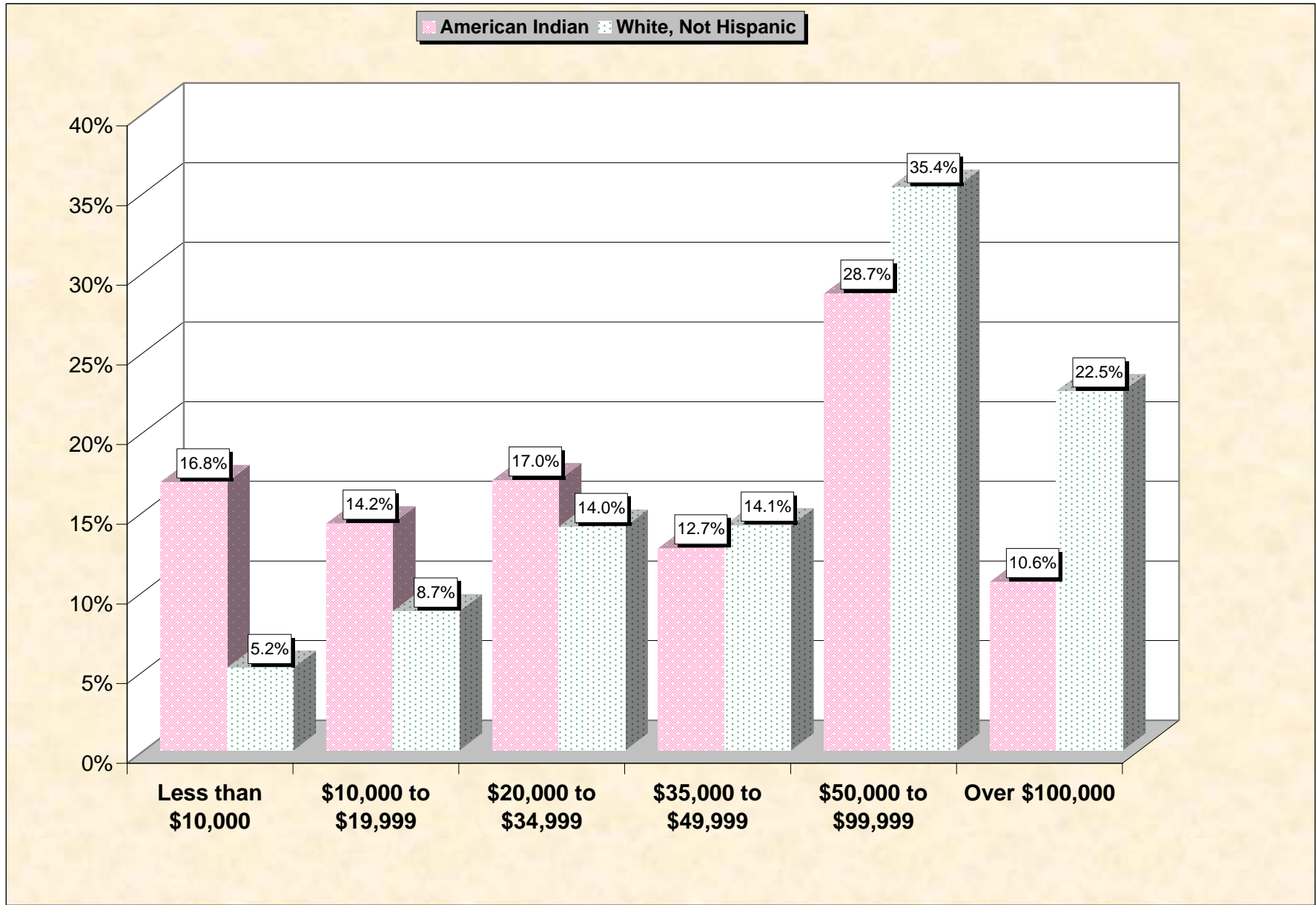
# Chart 5 -- Labor Force Participation (Civilian Labor Force) Connecticut

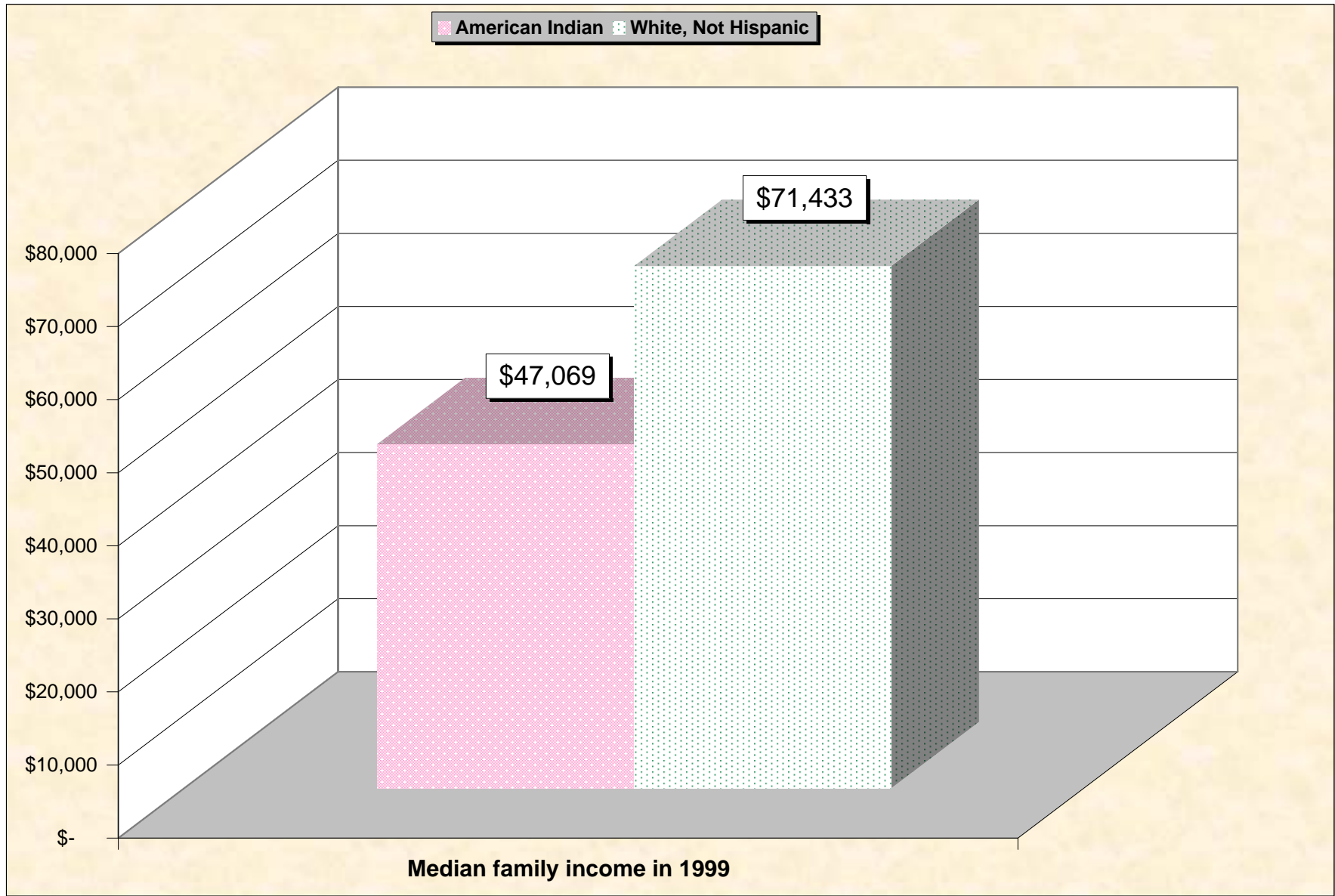
## Chart 6 -- Household Income in 1999 Connecticut

# Chart 7 -- Median Family Income In 1999

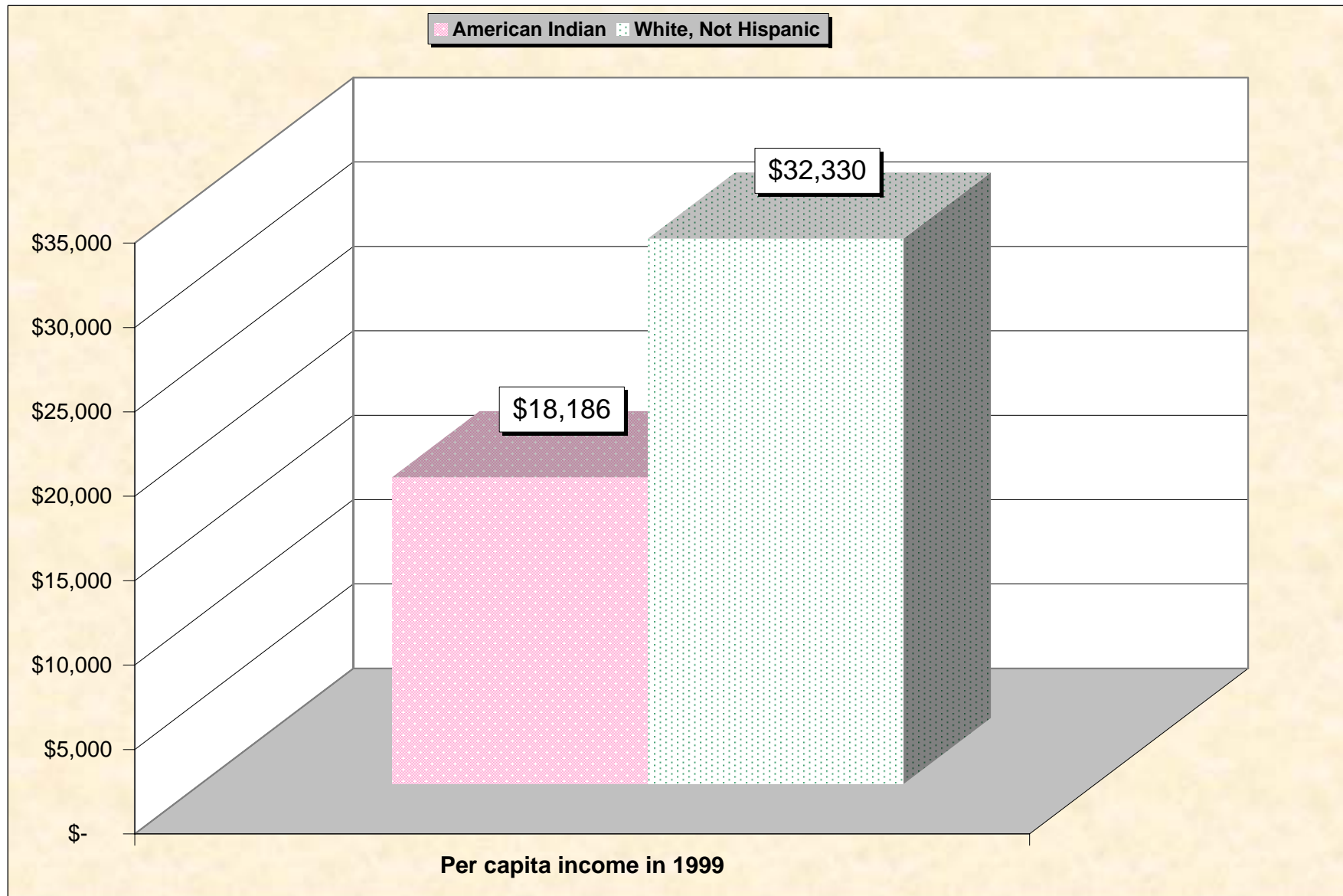

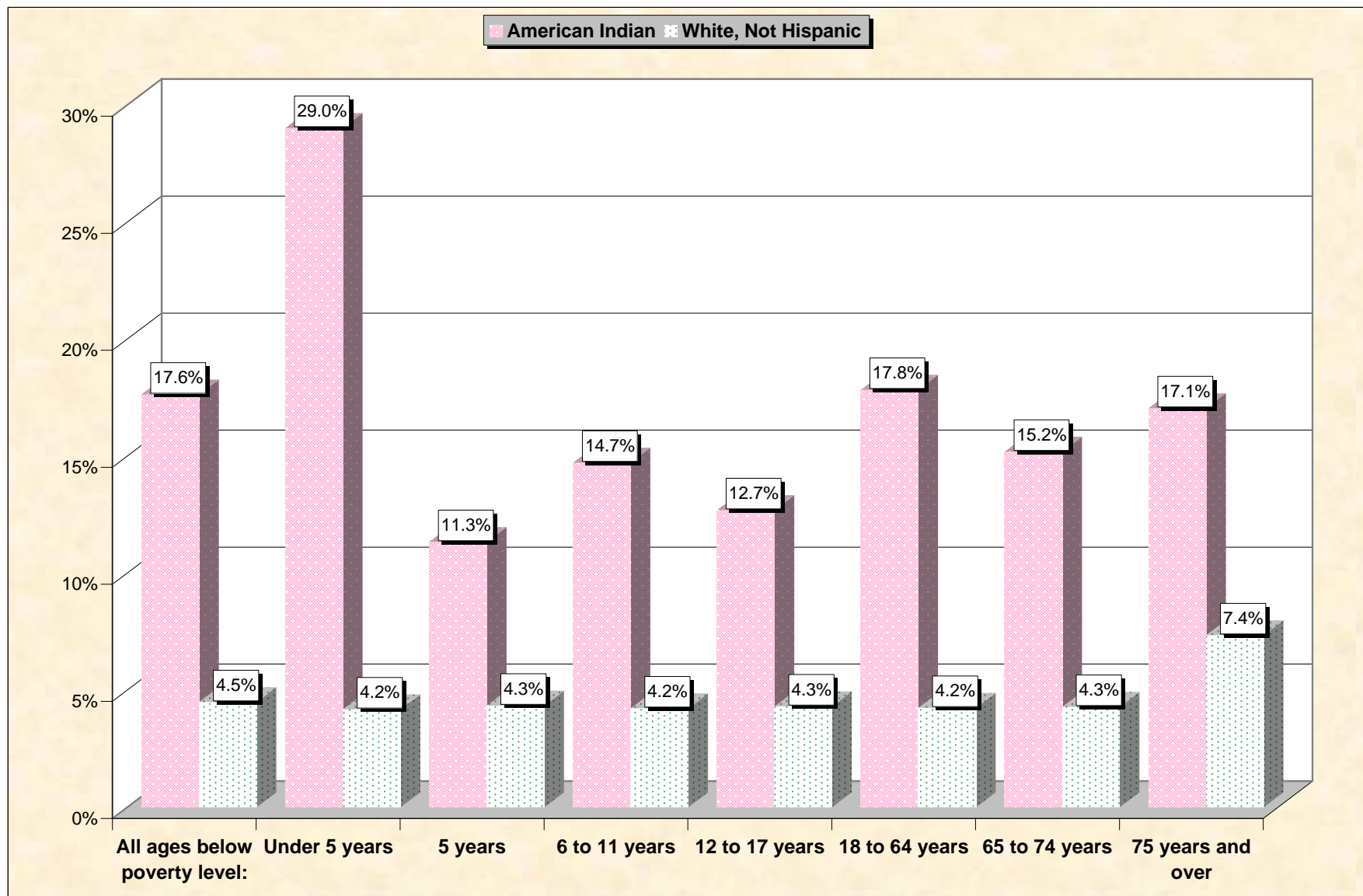


# Chart 8 -- Per Capita Income In 1999 Connecticut



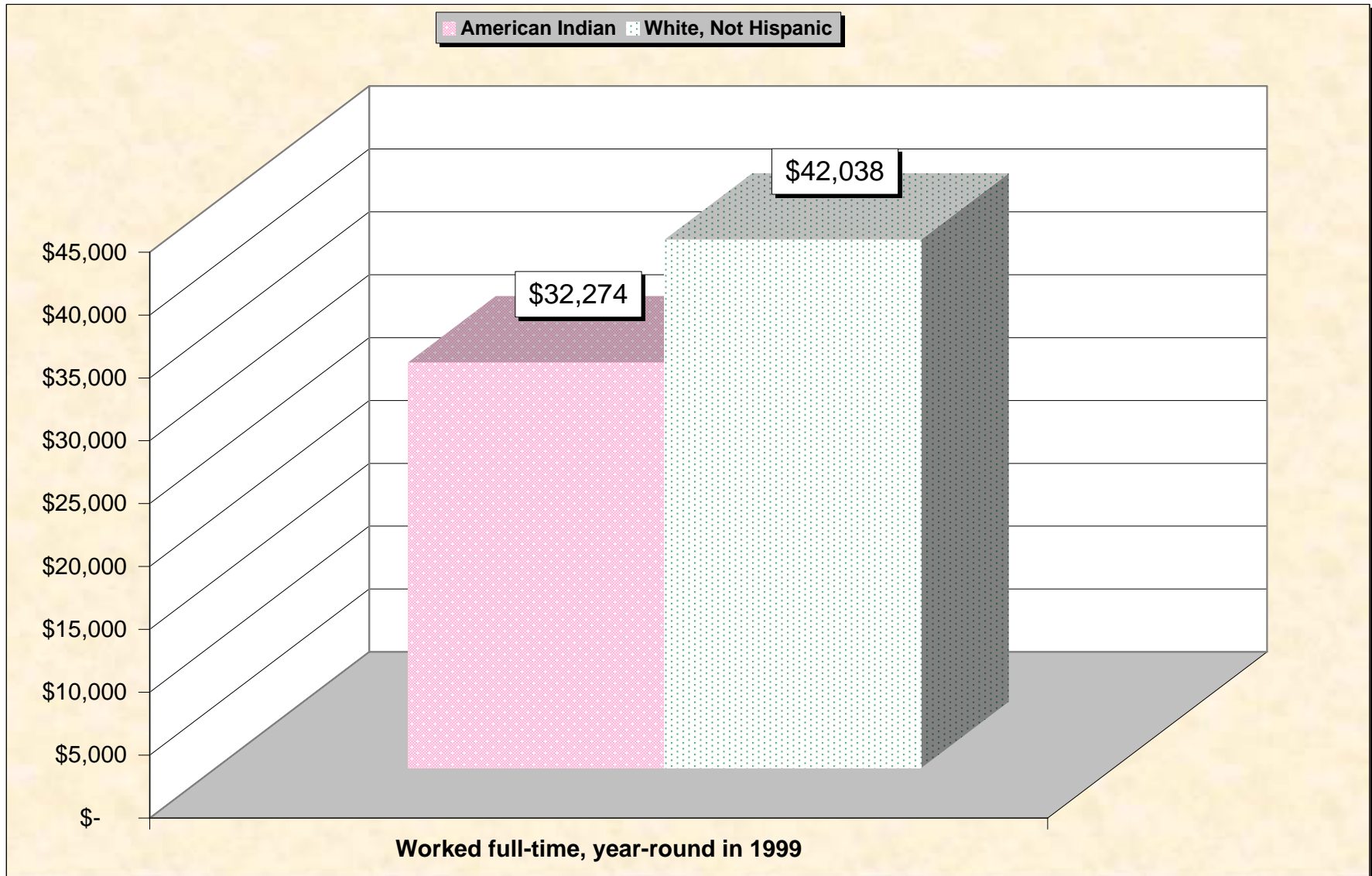

## Chart 9 -- Income in 1999 Below Poverty Level by Age Connecticut



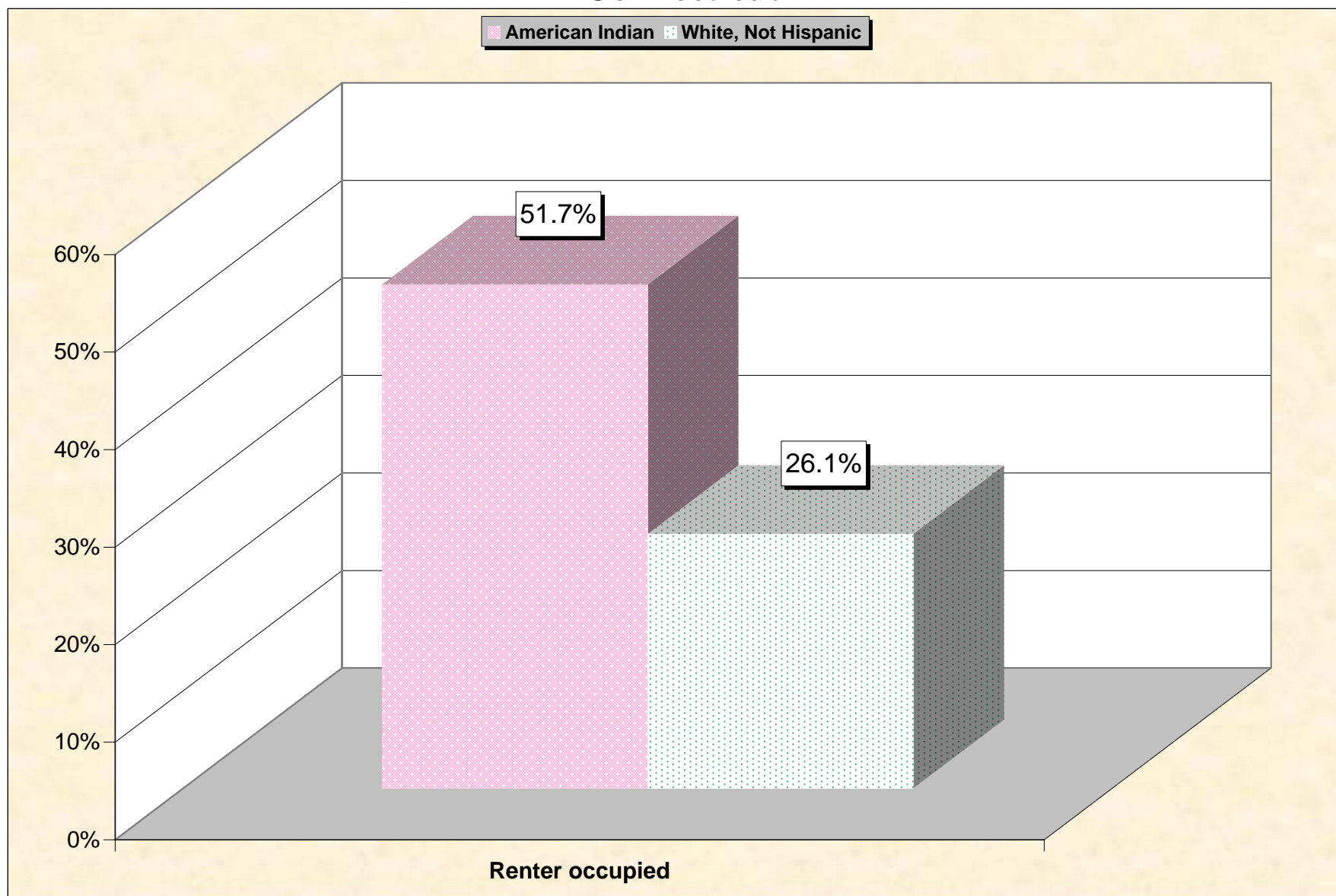

# Chart 10 -- Median Earnings in 1999 Connecticut



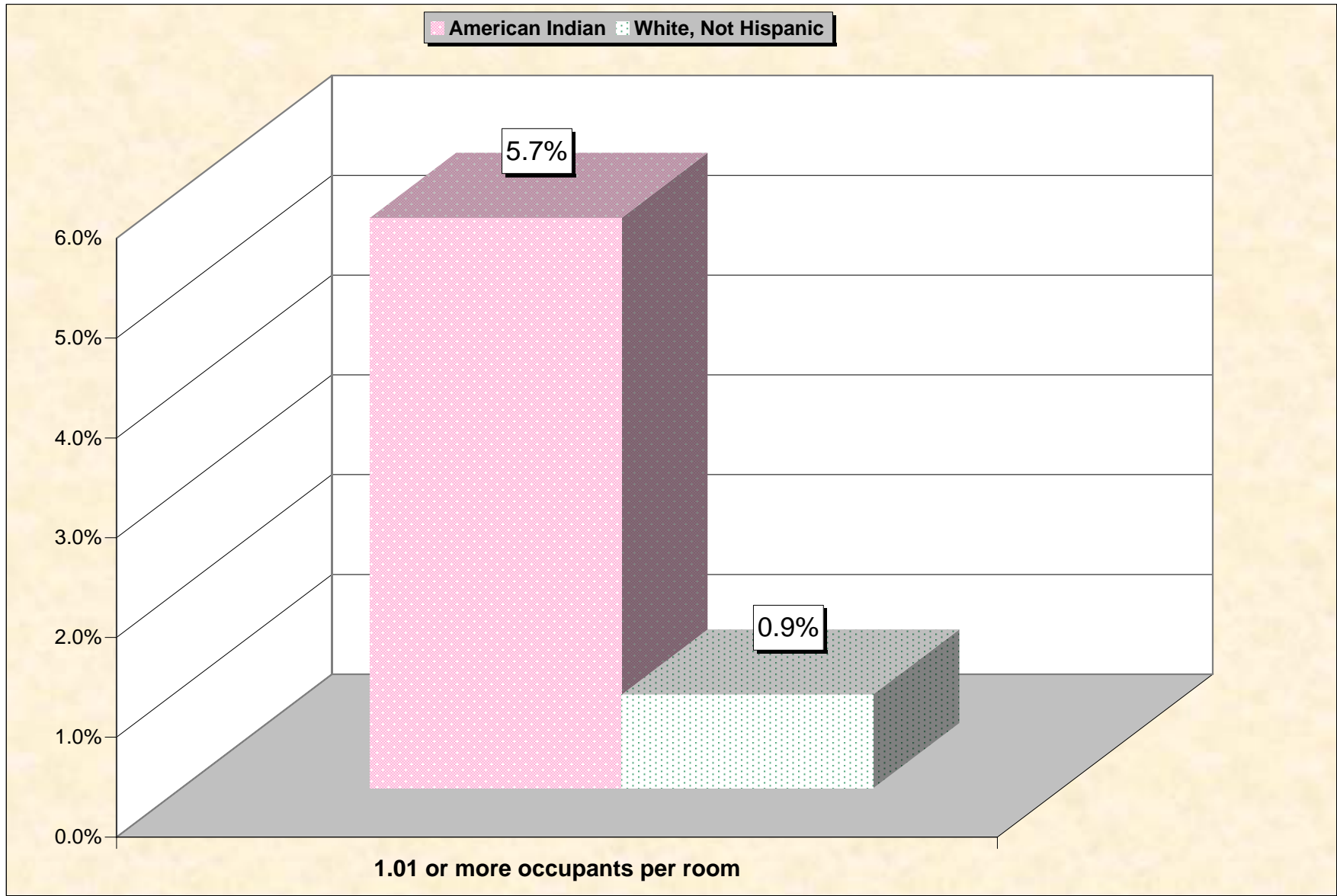

# Chart 11 -- Renter-Occupied Housing Connecticut



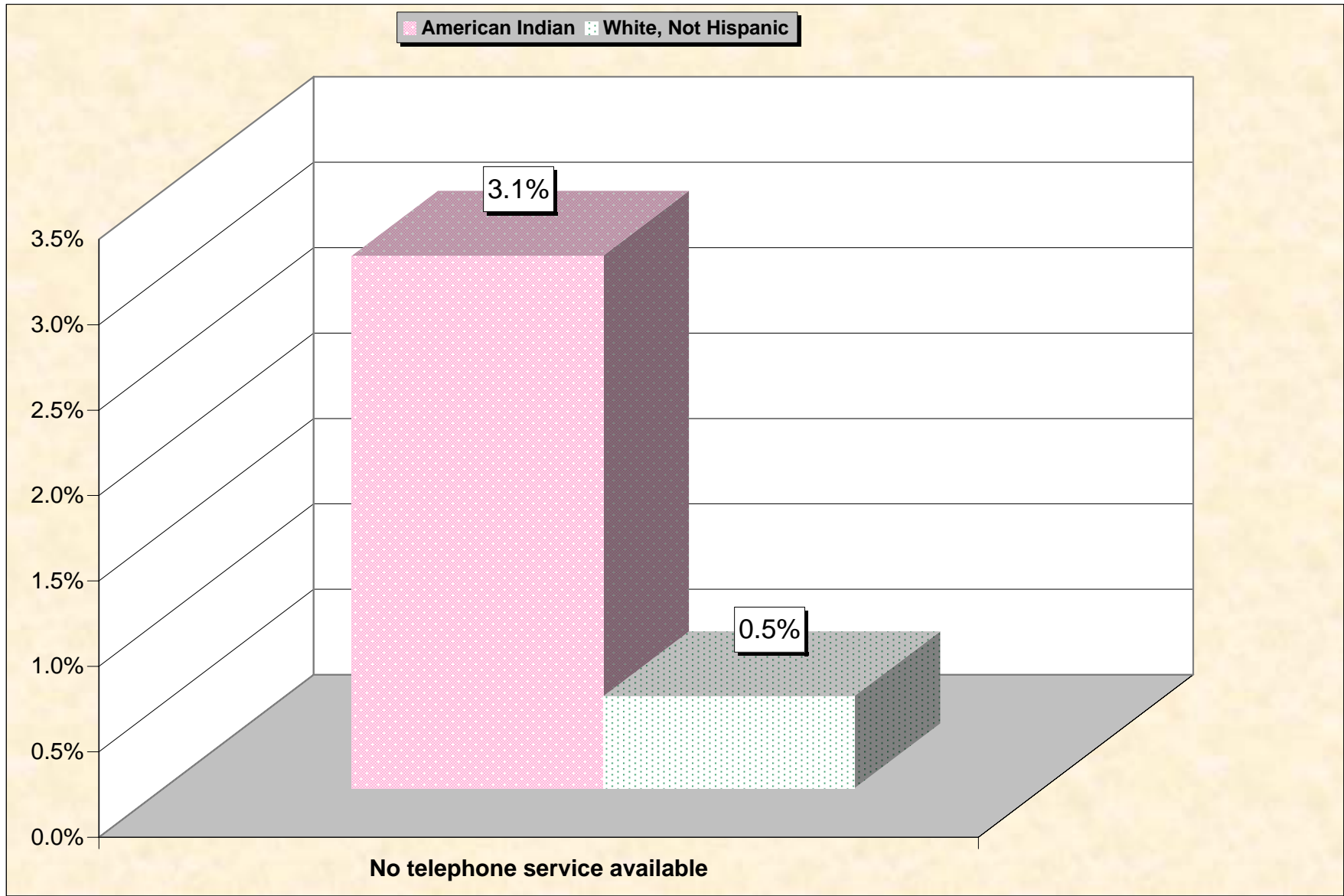

# Chart 12 -- Occupants Per Room (Crowding) by Household Connecticut



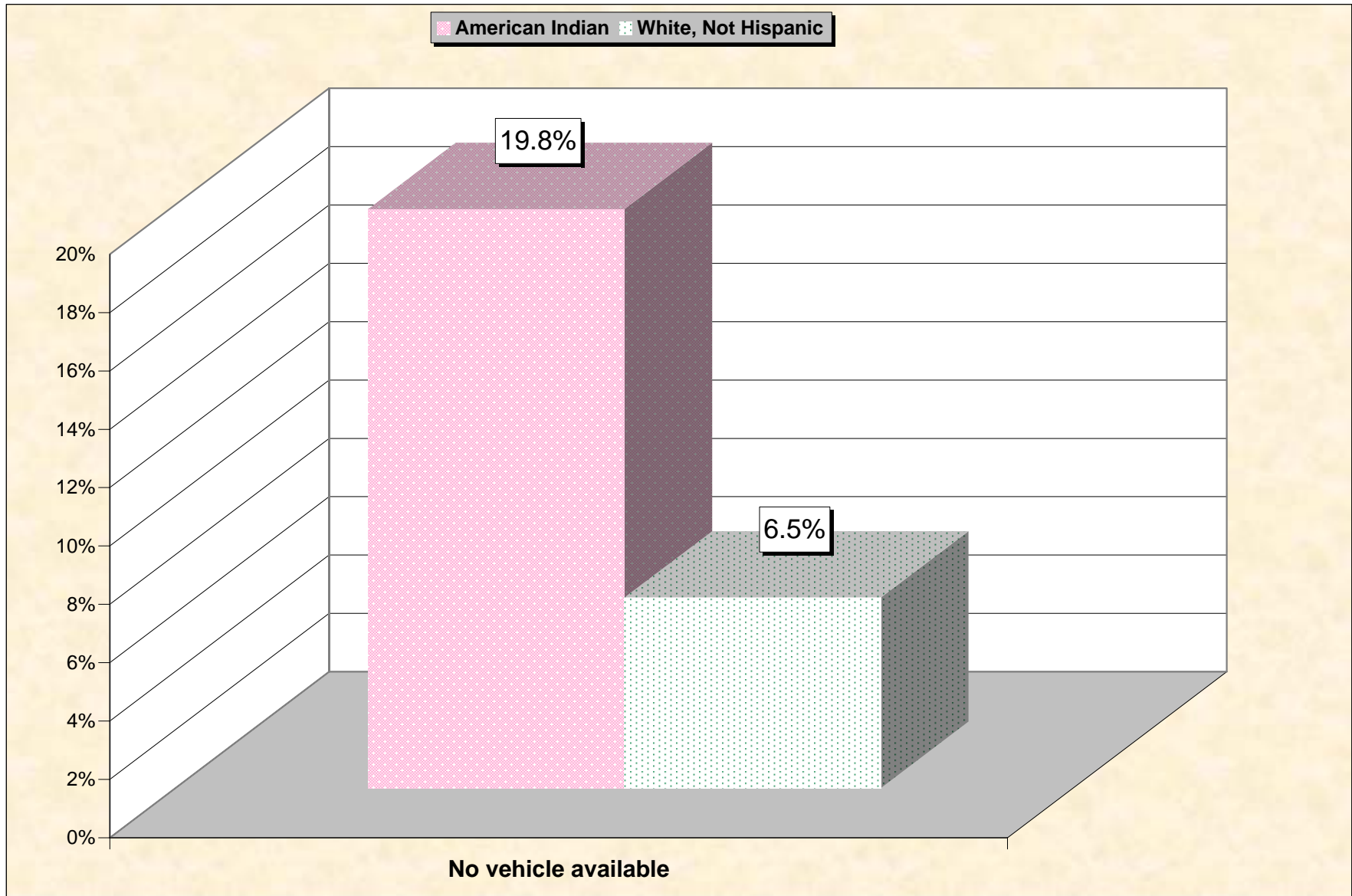

# Chart 13 -- Lack of Telephone Service by Household Connecticut



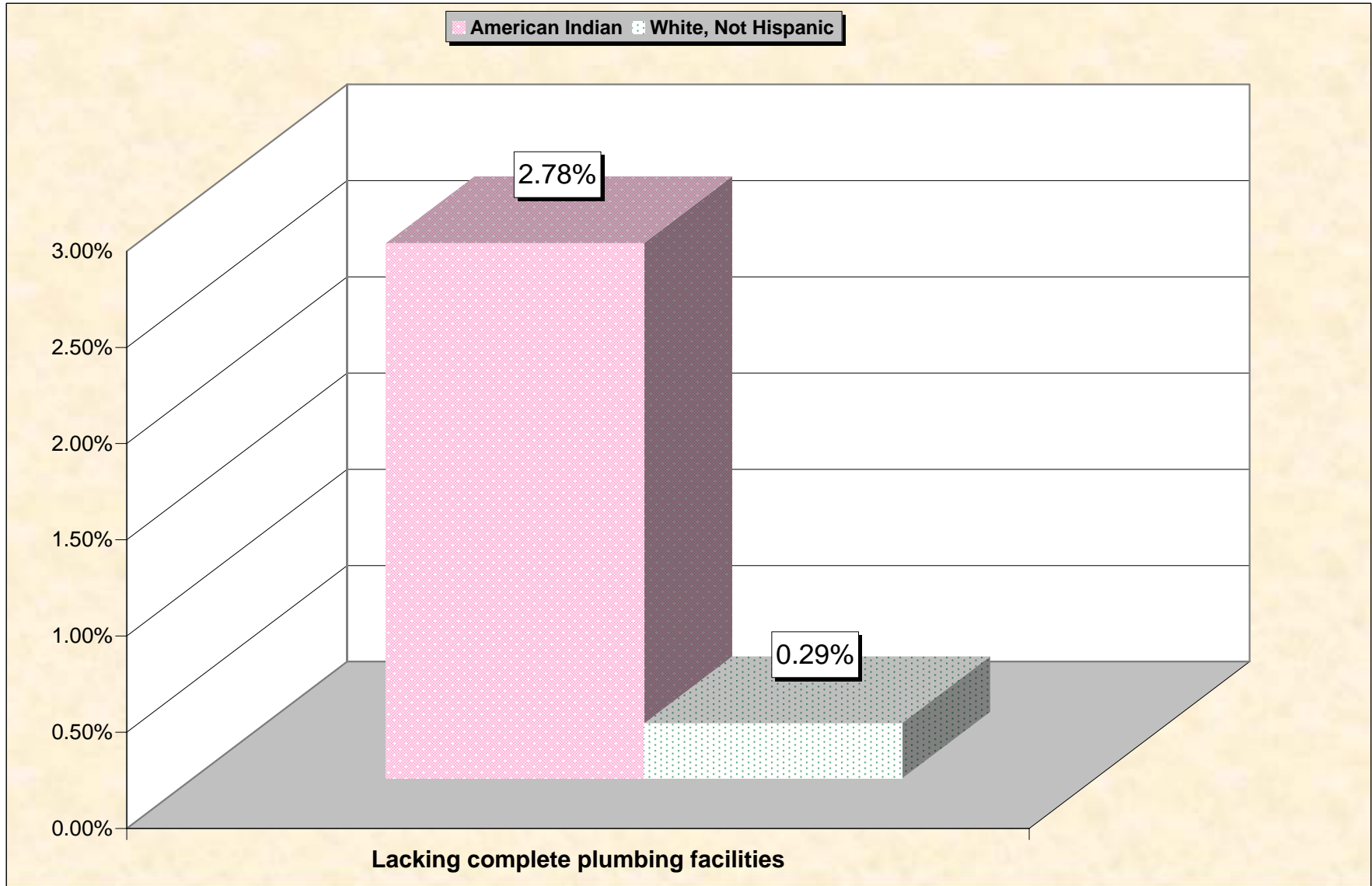

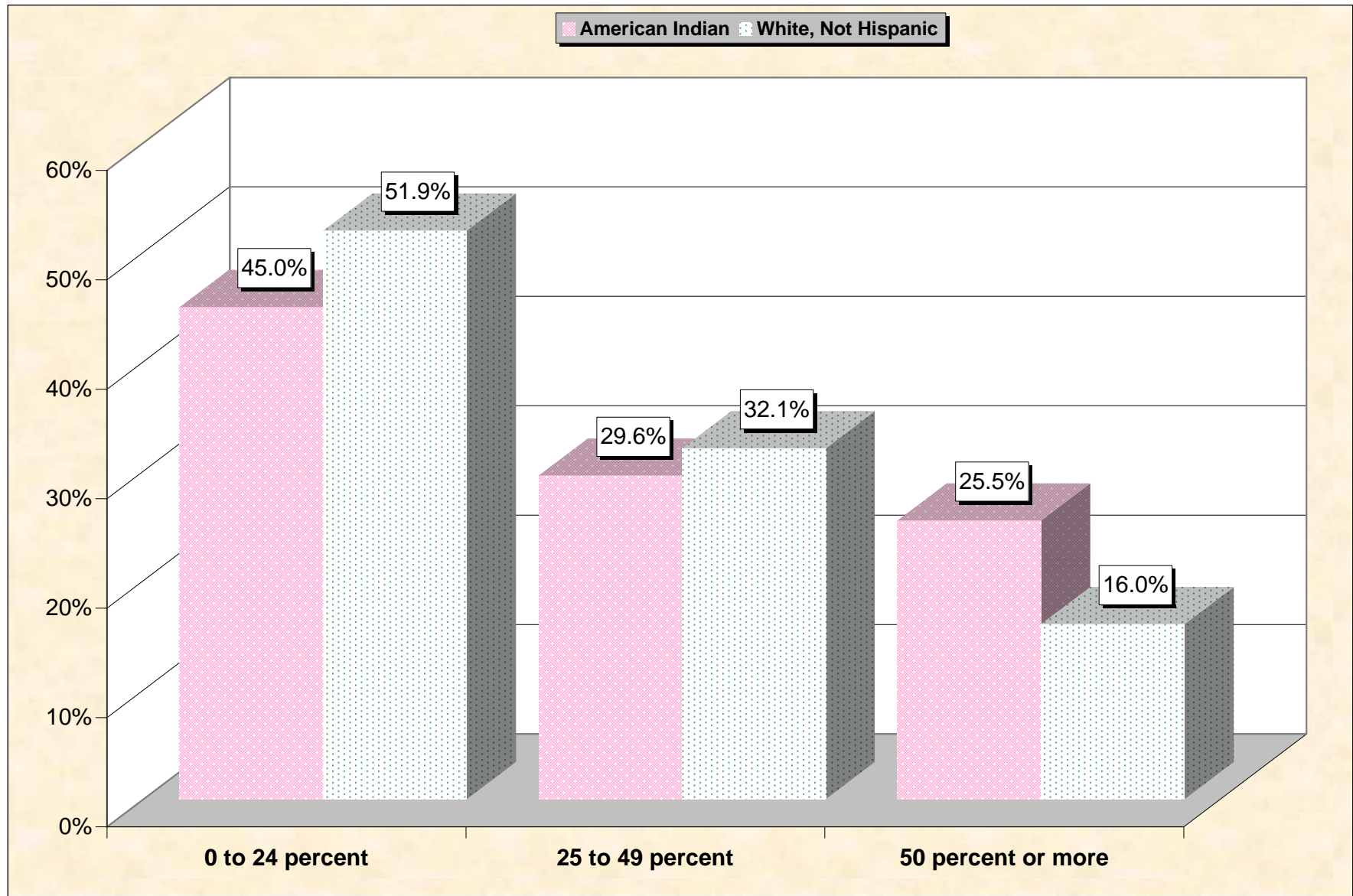
# Chart 15 -- Lack of Plumbing By Household Connecticut

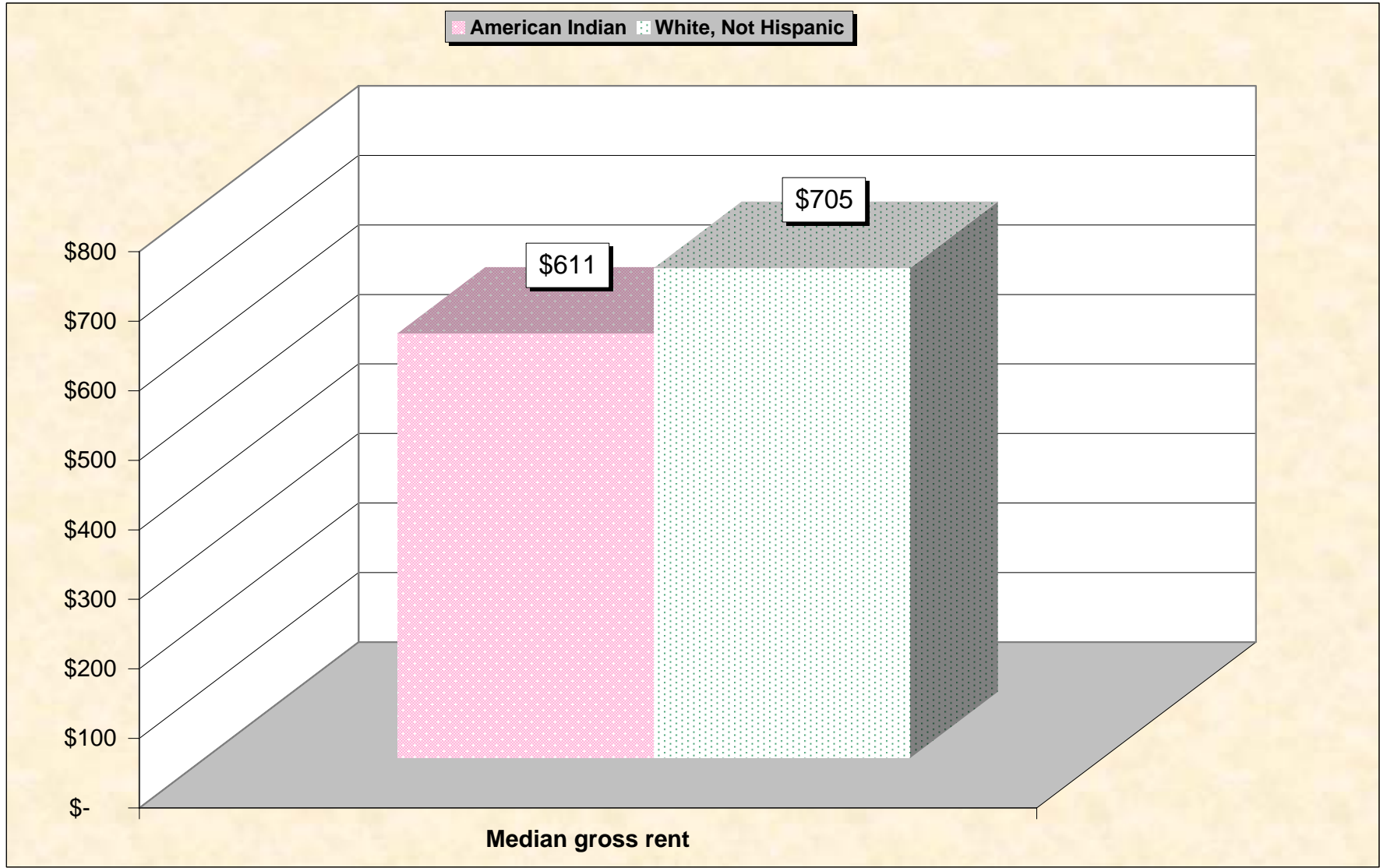


# Chart 16 -- Gross Rent as a Percentage of Household Income in 1999 Connecticut



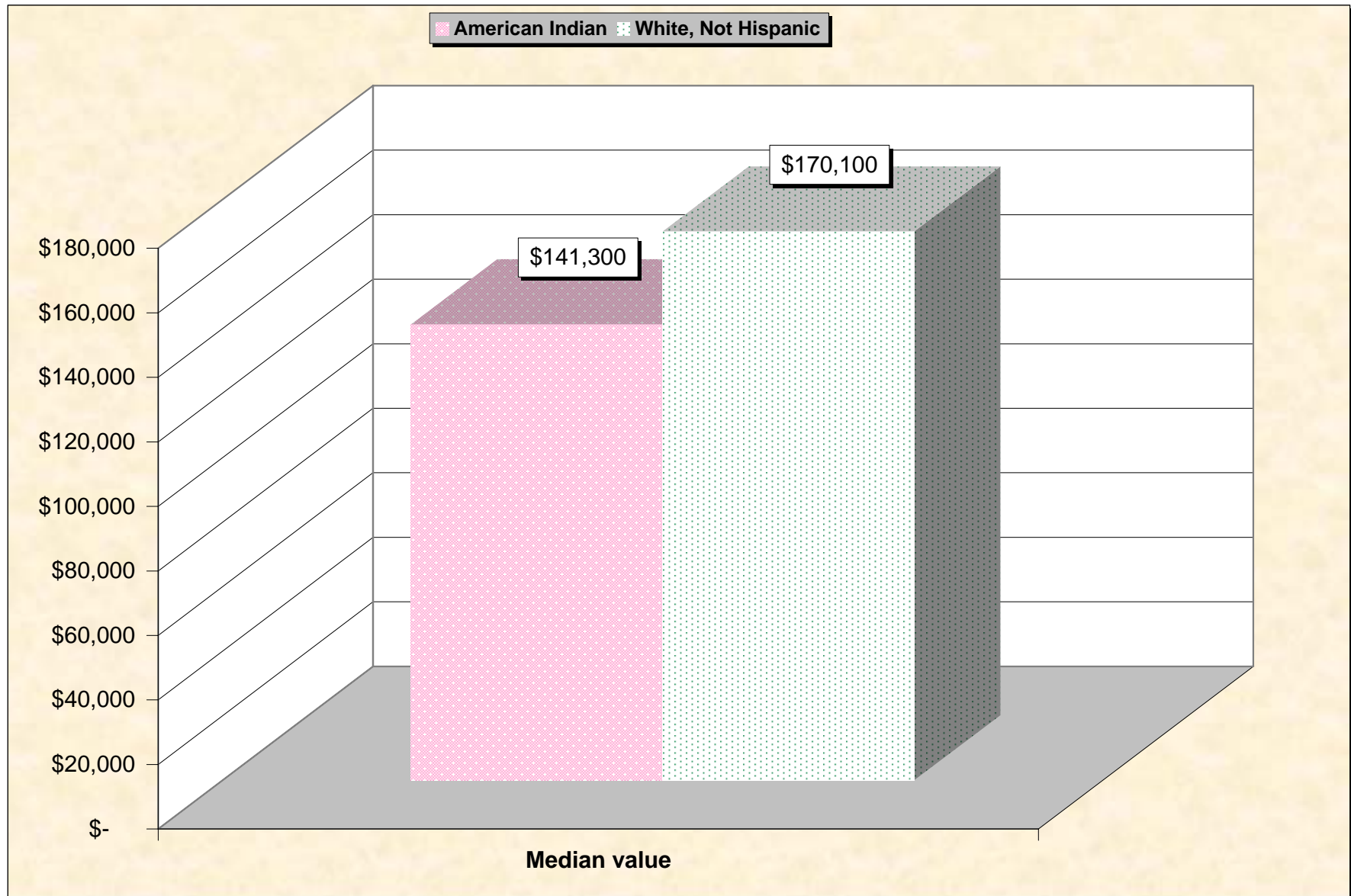
