

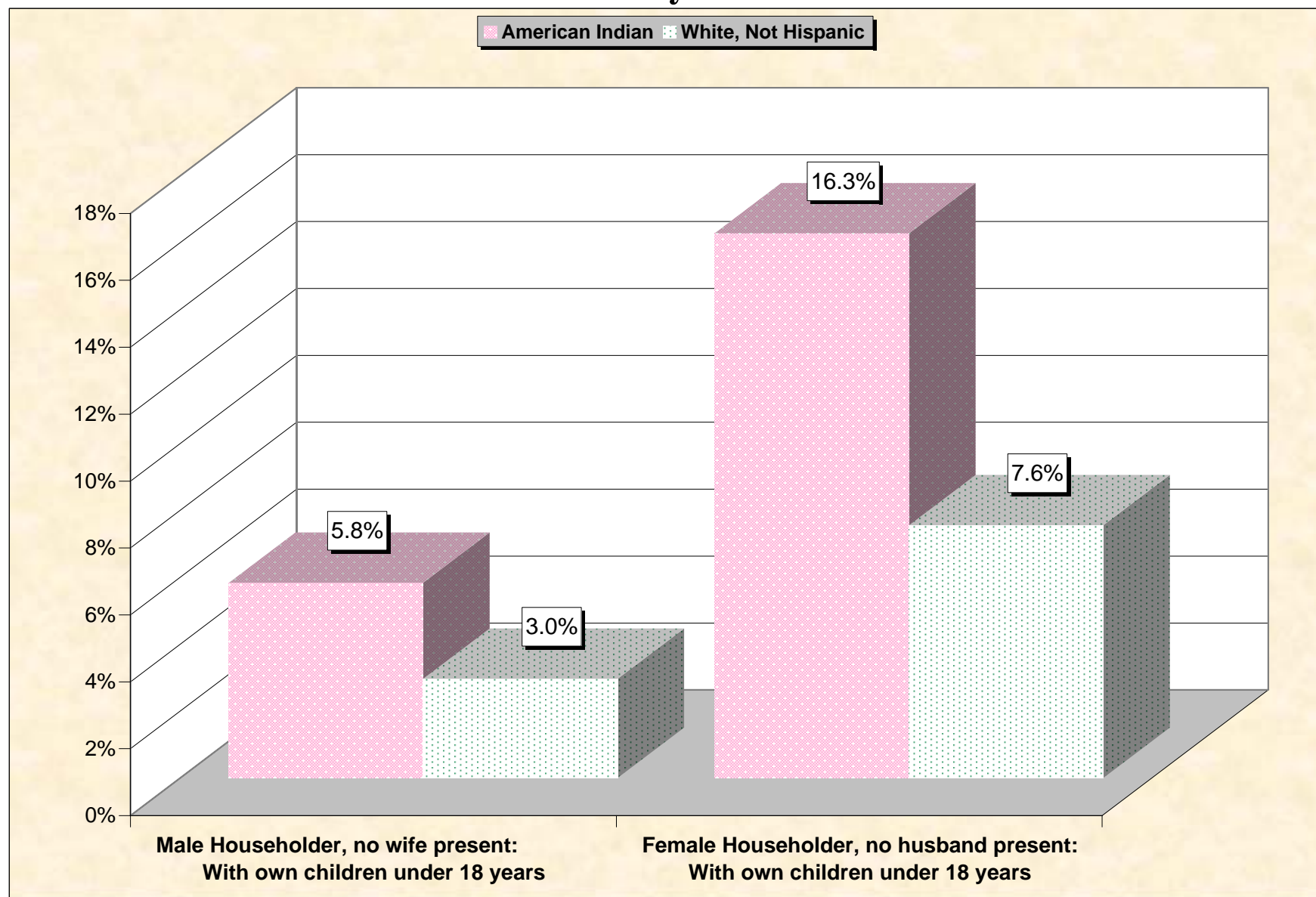

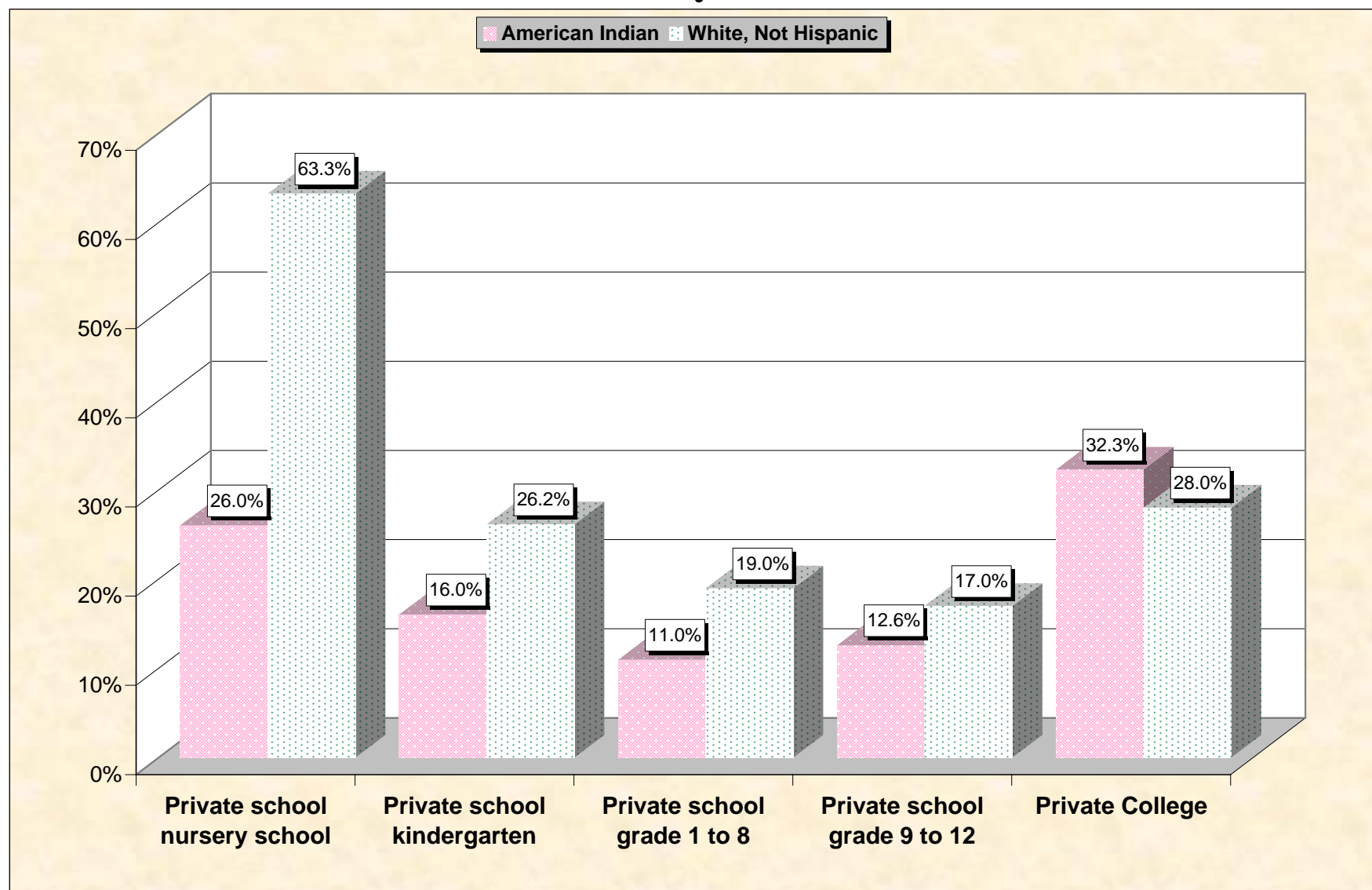
**Chart 1 -- Single-Parent Family Households (Householder 15 to 64 years)

## Chart 2 -- Private School Enrollment (3 years and over)

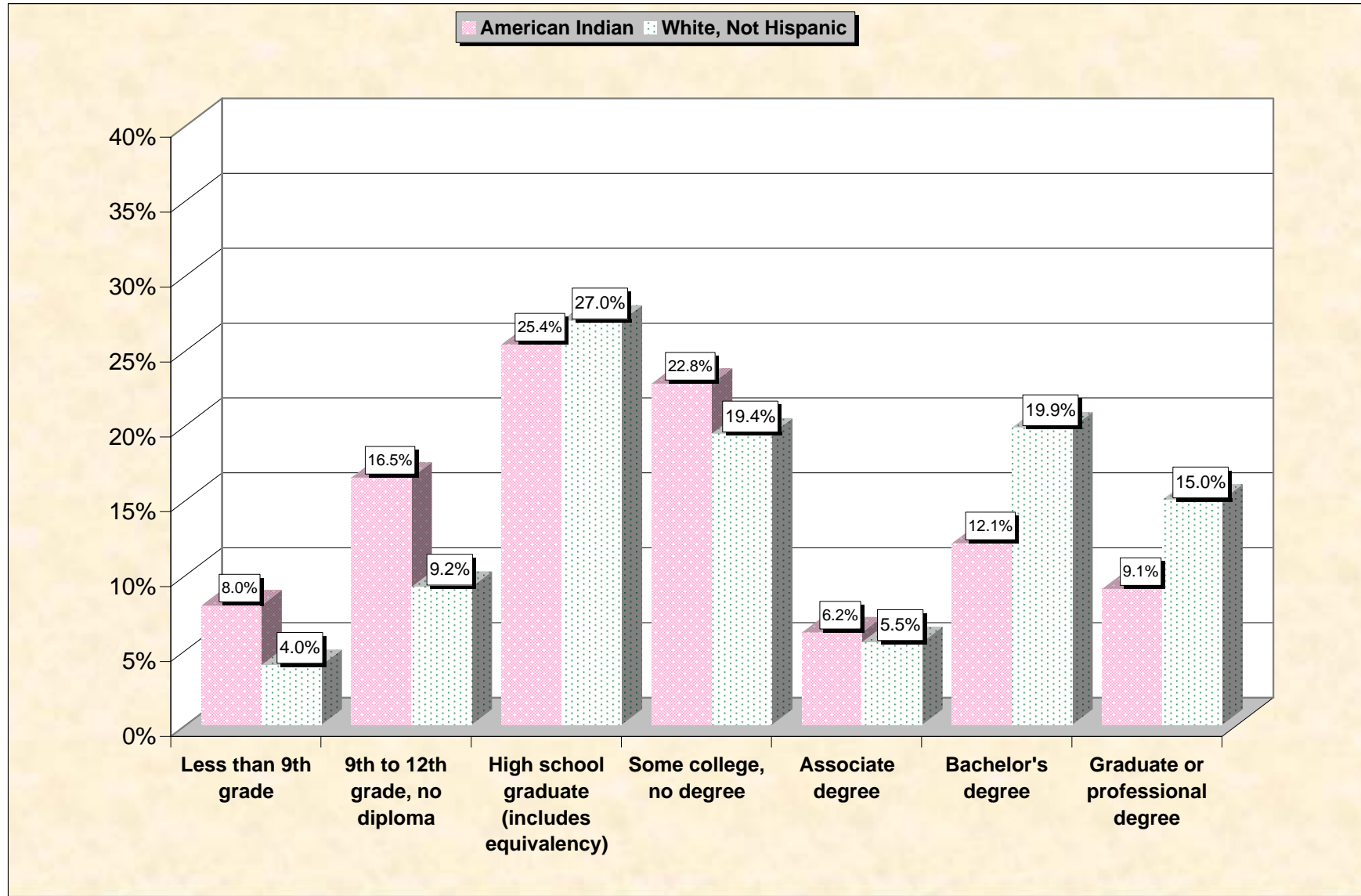

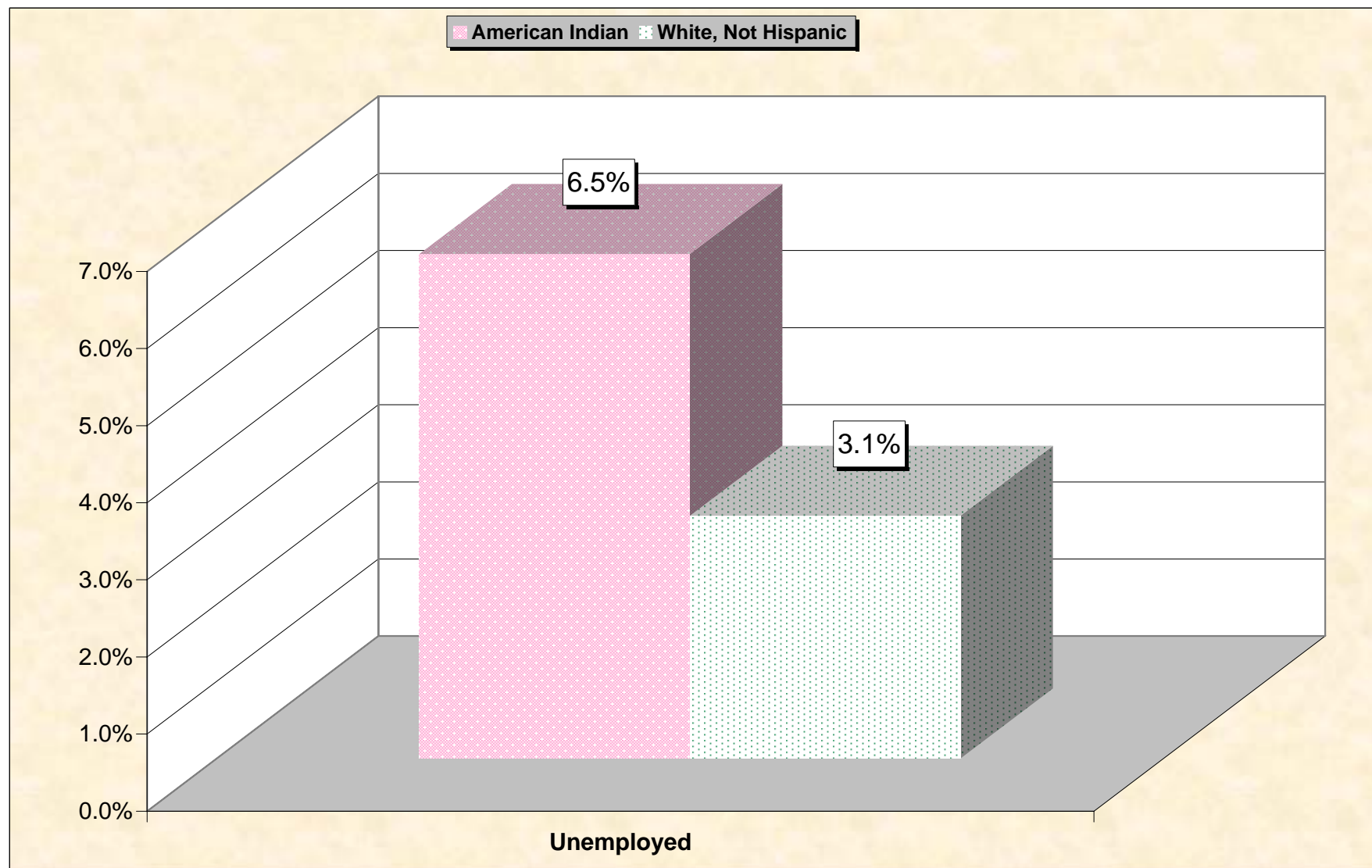
# Chart 3 -- Educational Attainment (25 years and over)

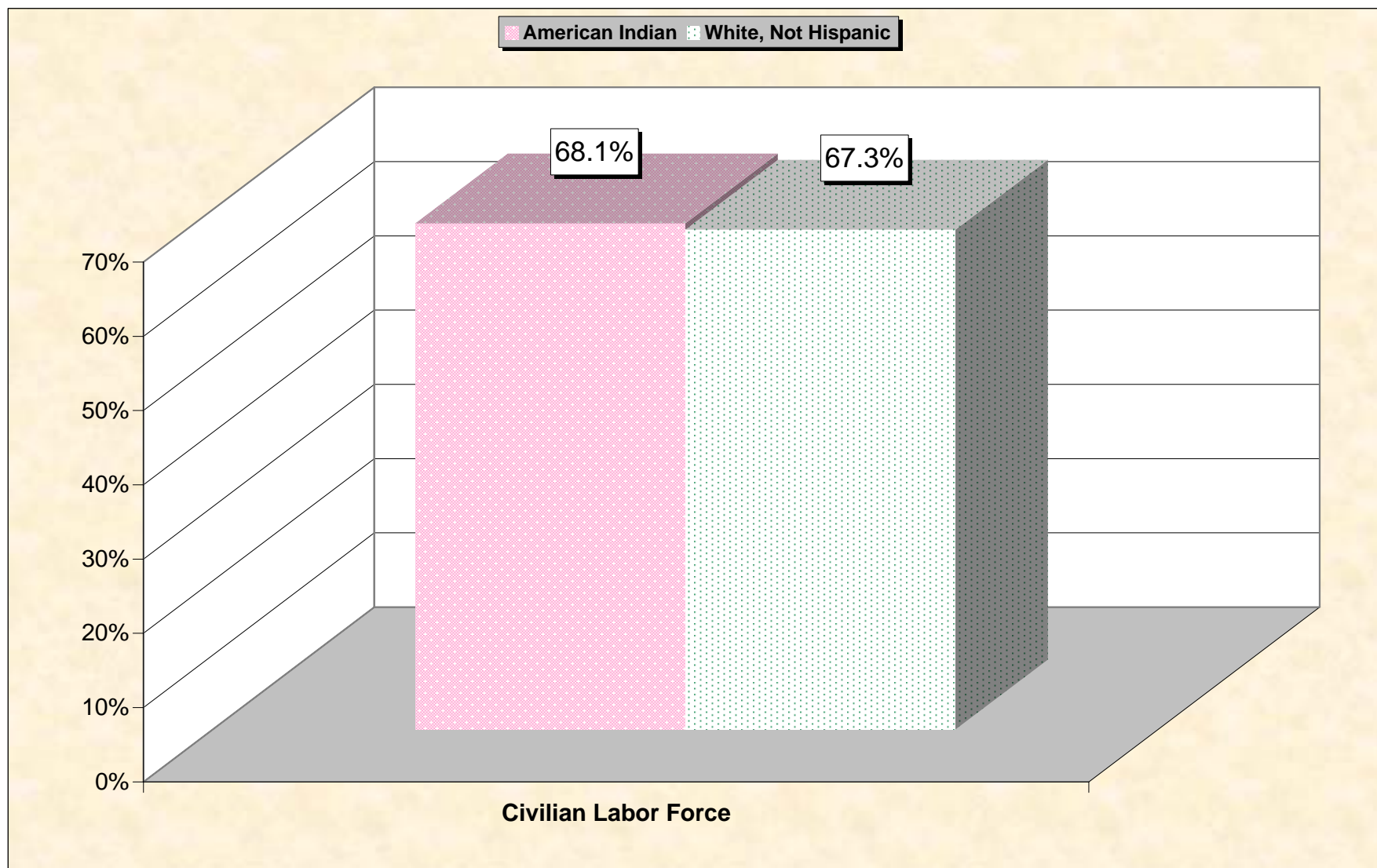
## Chart 4 -- Unemployment Rate (Civilian Labor Force) Maryland

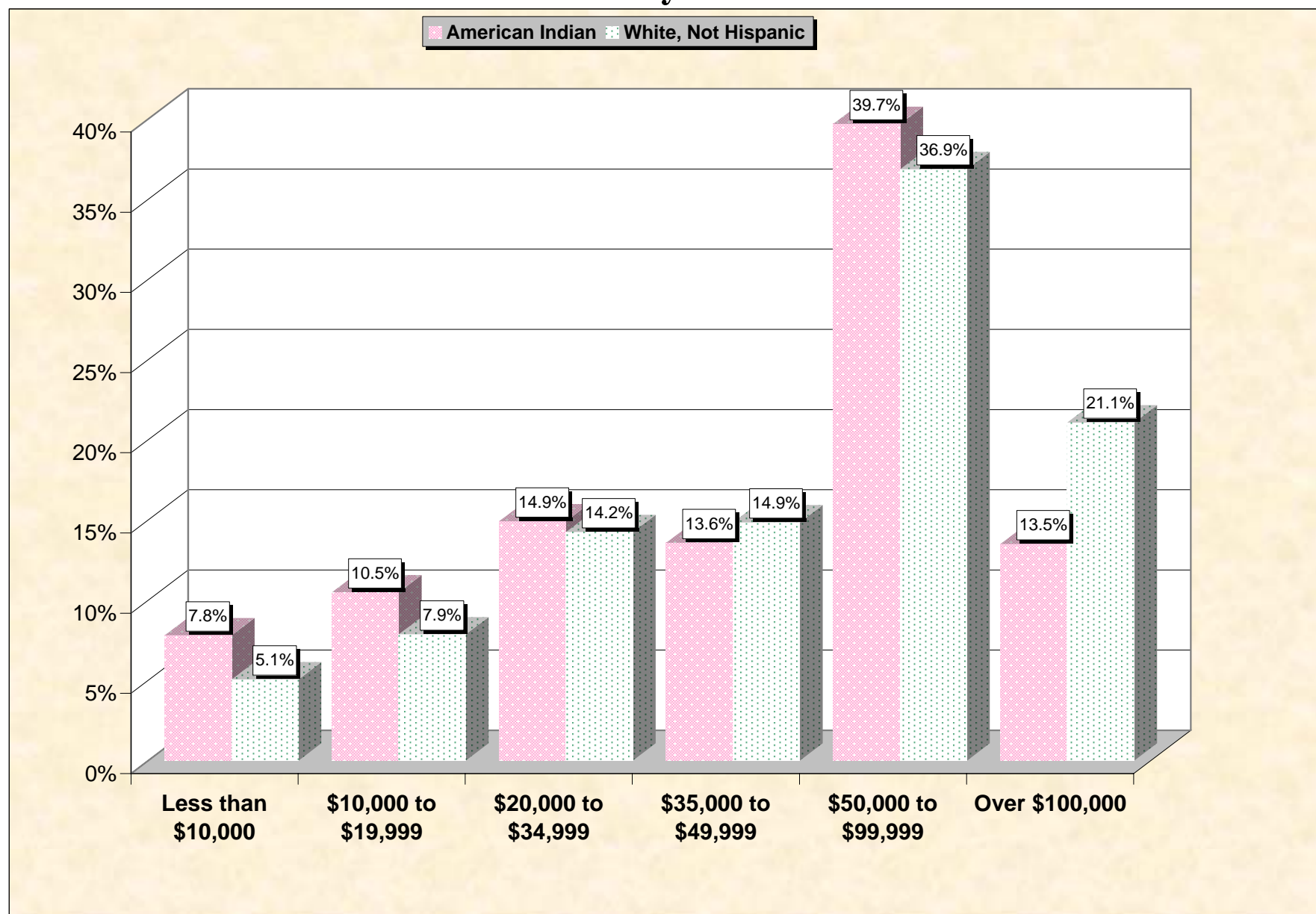
**Chart 5 -- Labor Force Participation (Civilian Labor Force)

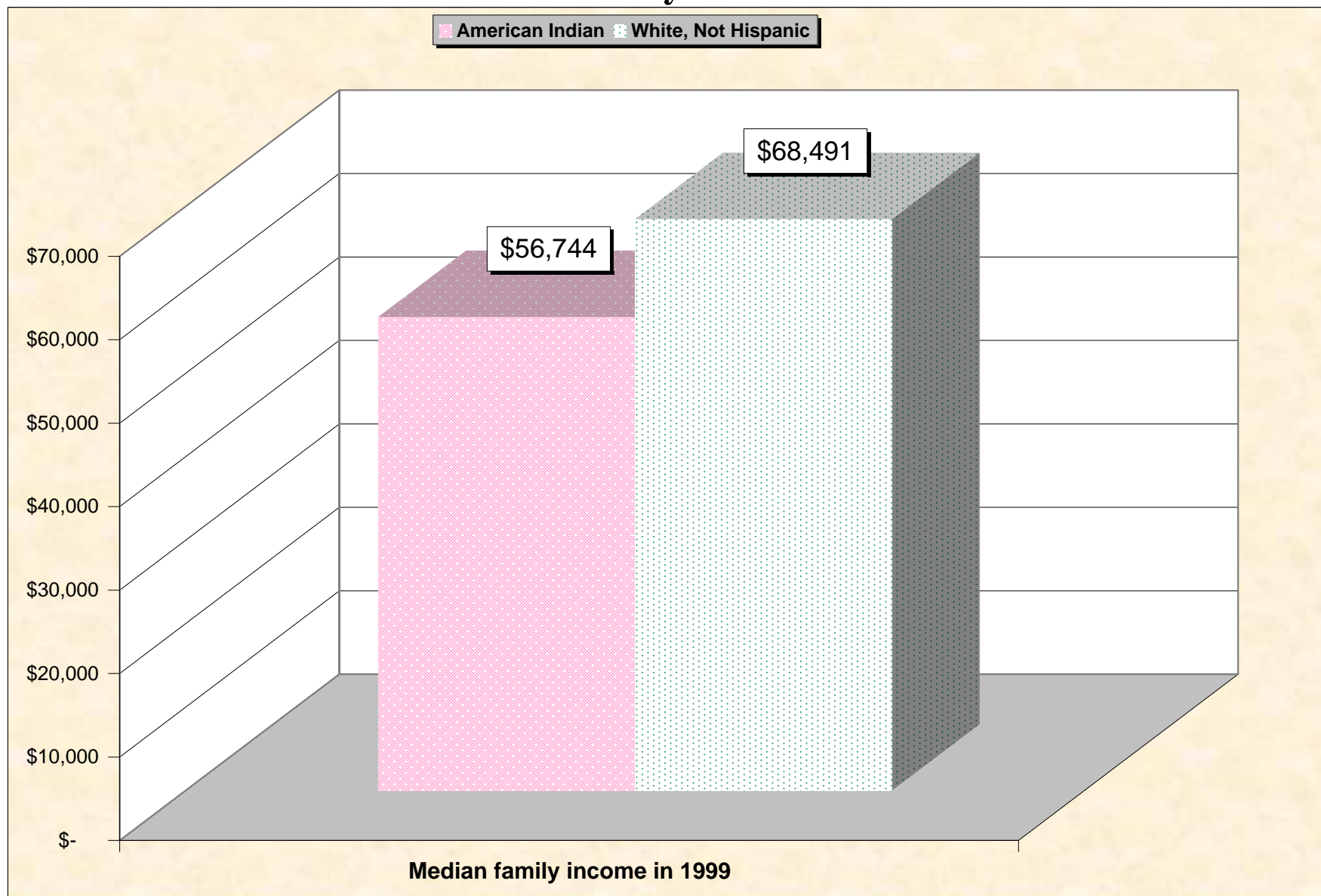

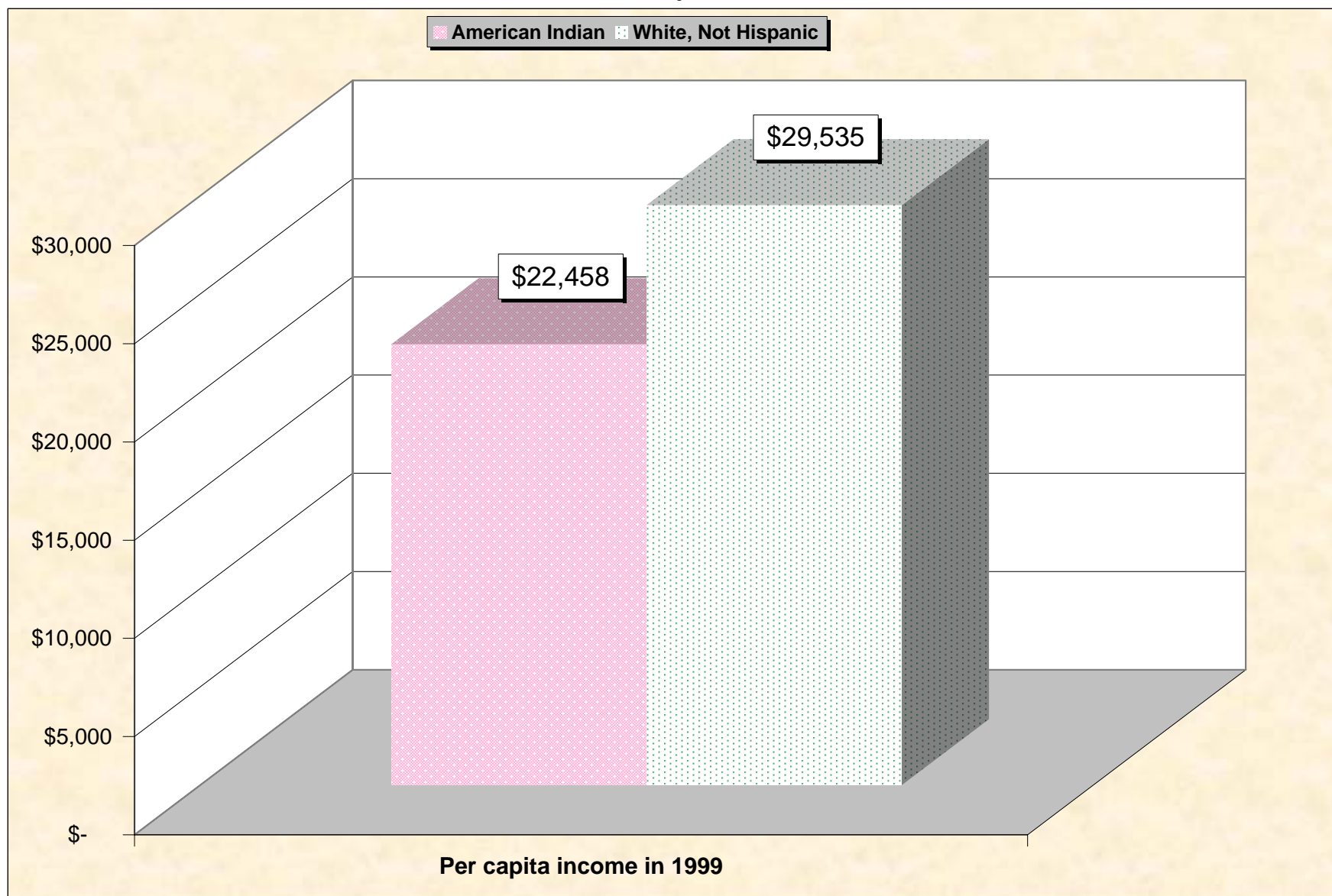
**Chart 7 -- Median Family Income In 1999**

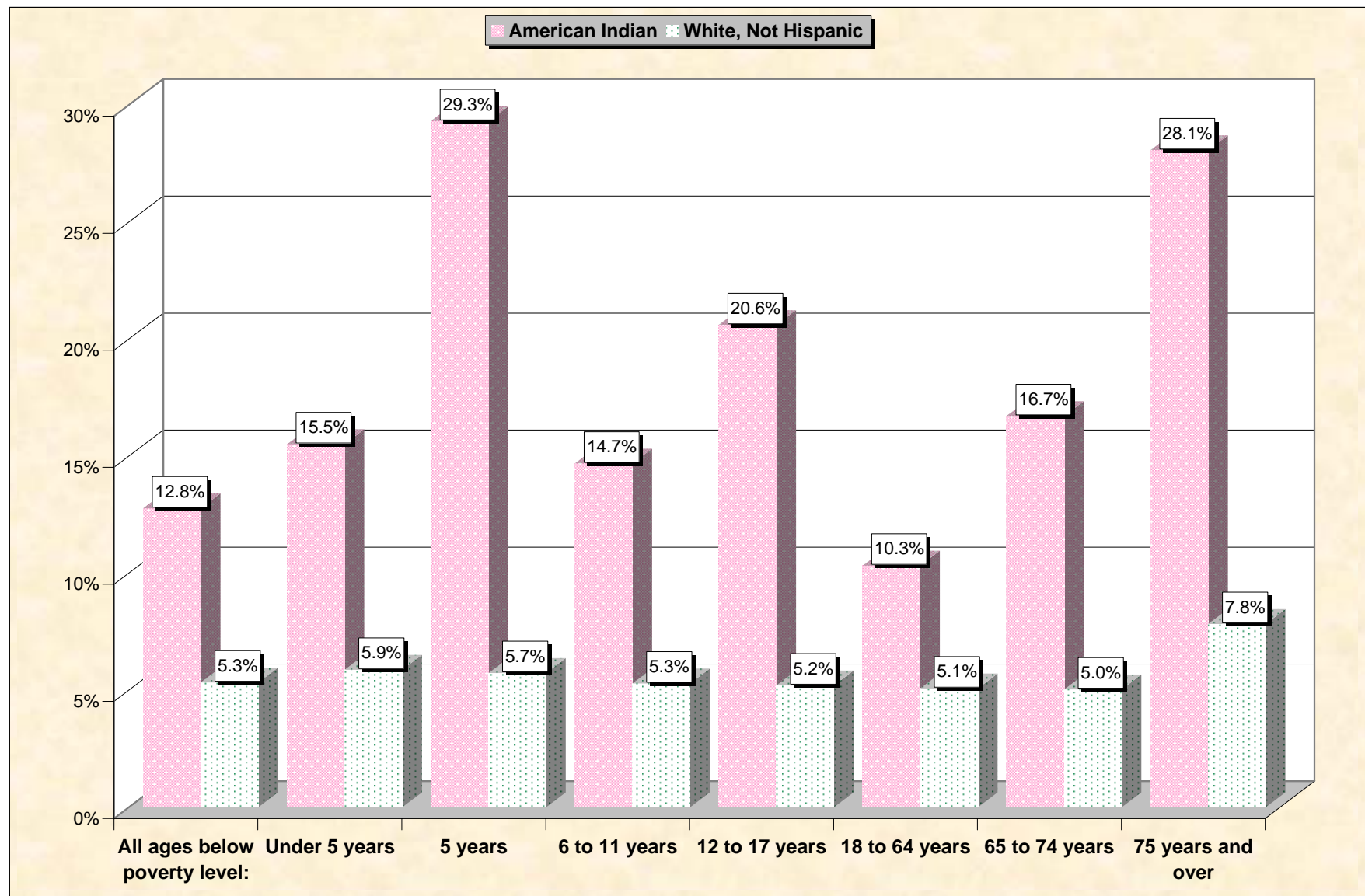


# Chart 8 -- Per Capita Income In 1999 Maryland



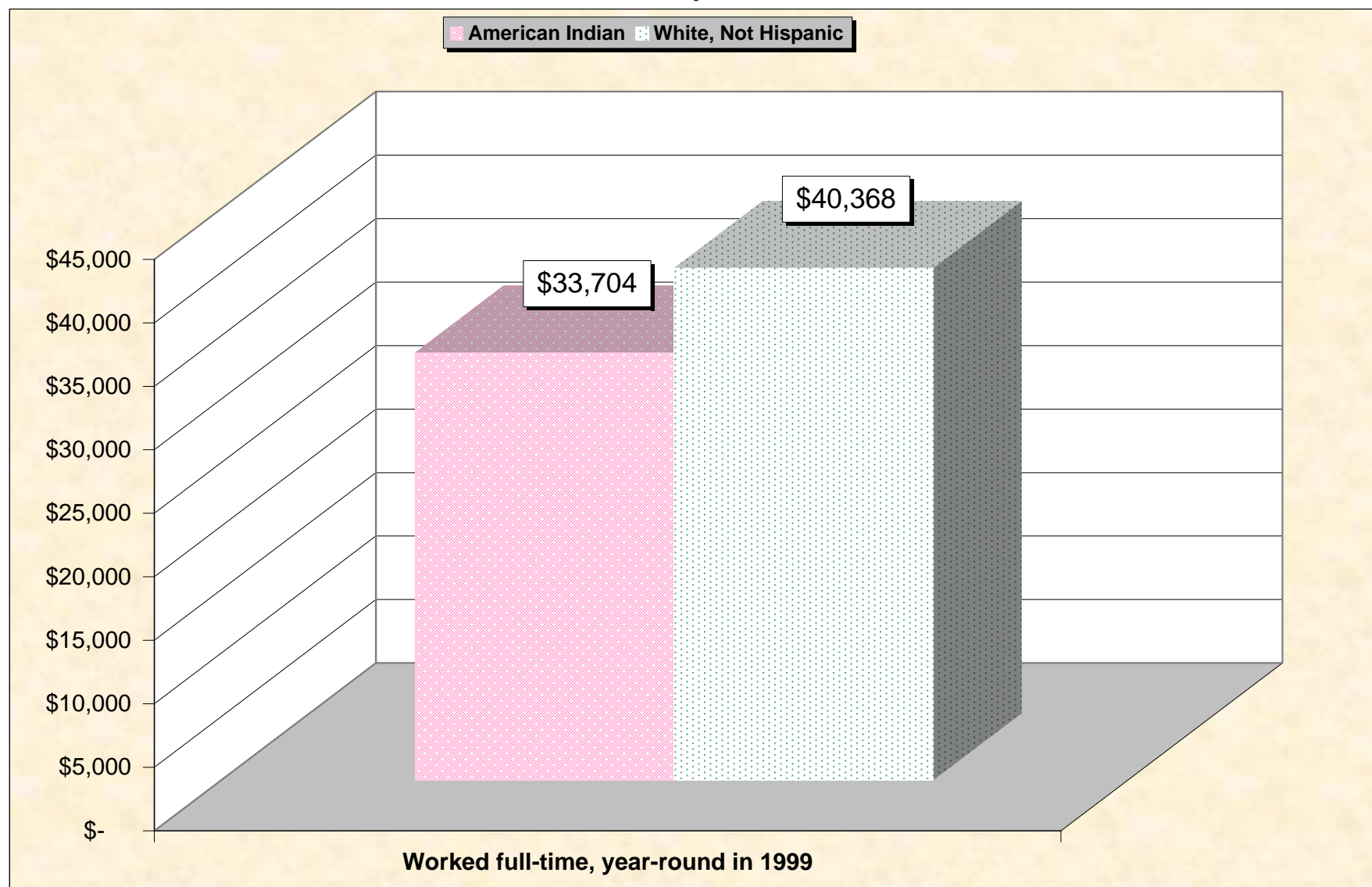

# **Chart 9 -- Income in 1999 Below Poverty Level by Age Maryland**



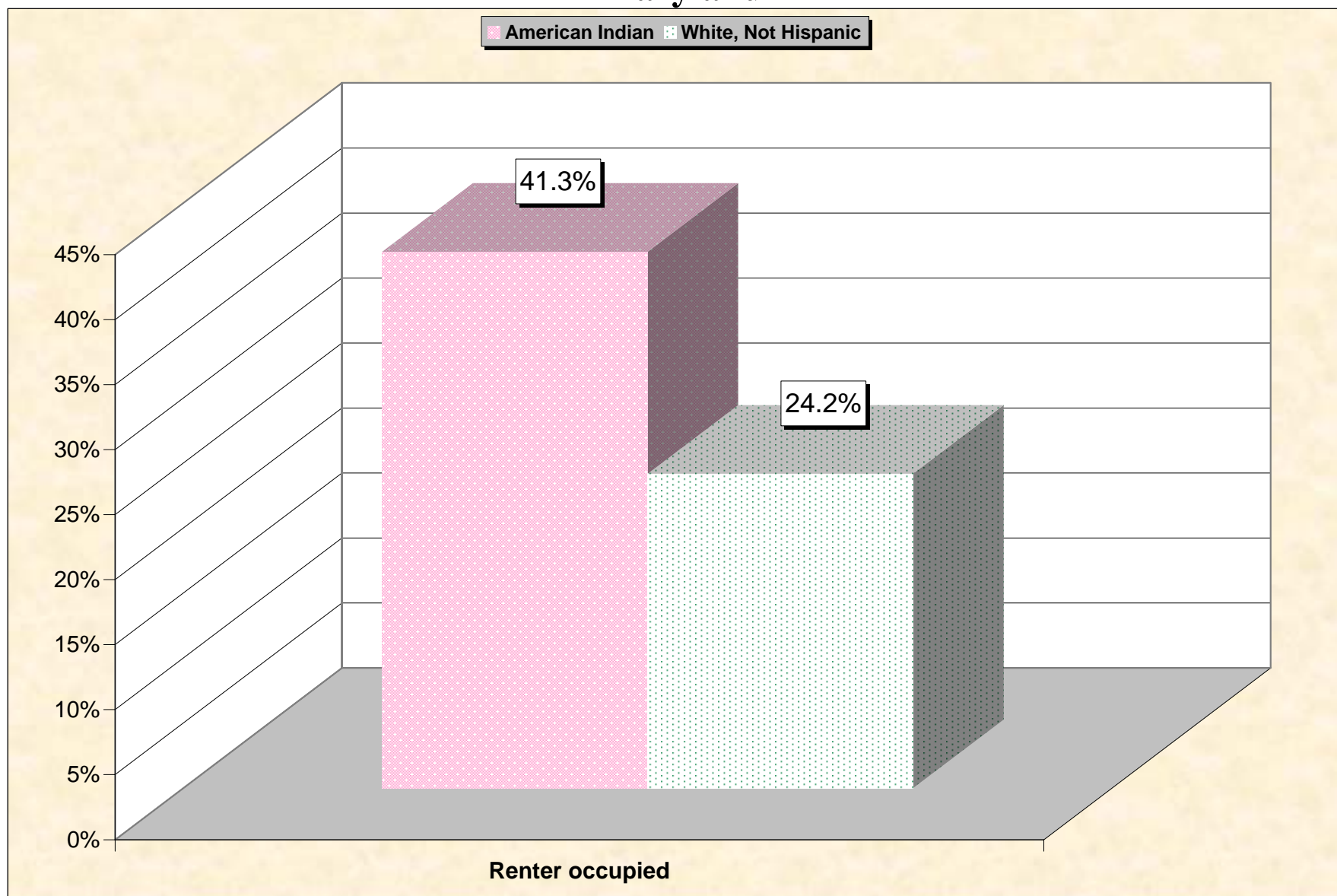

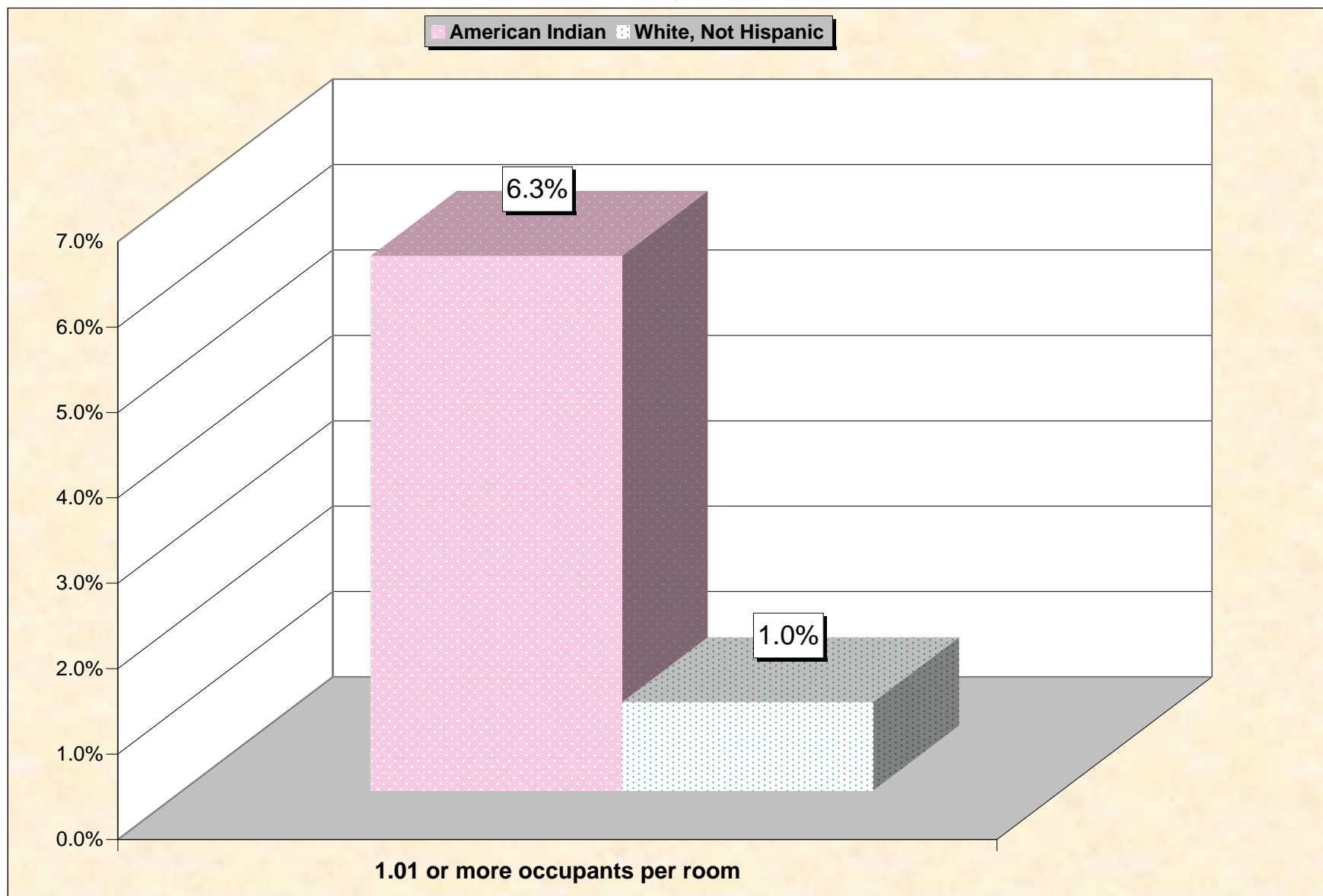

# Chart 11 -- Renter-Occupied Housing Maryland



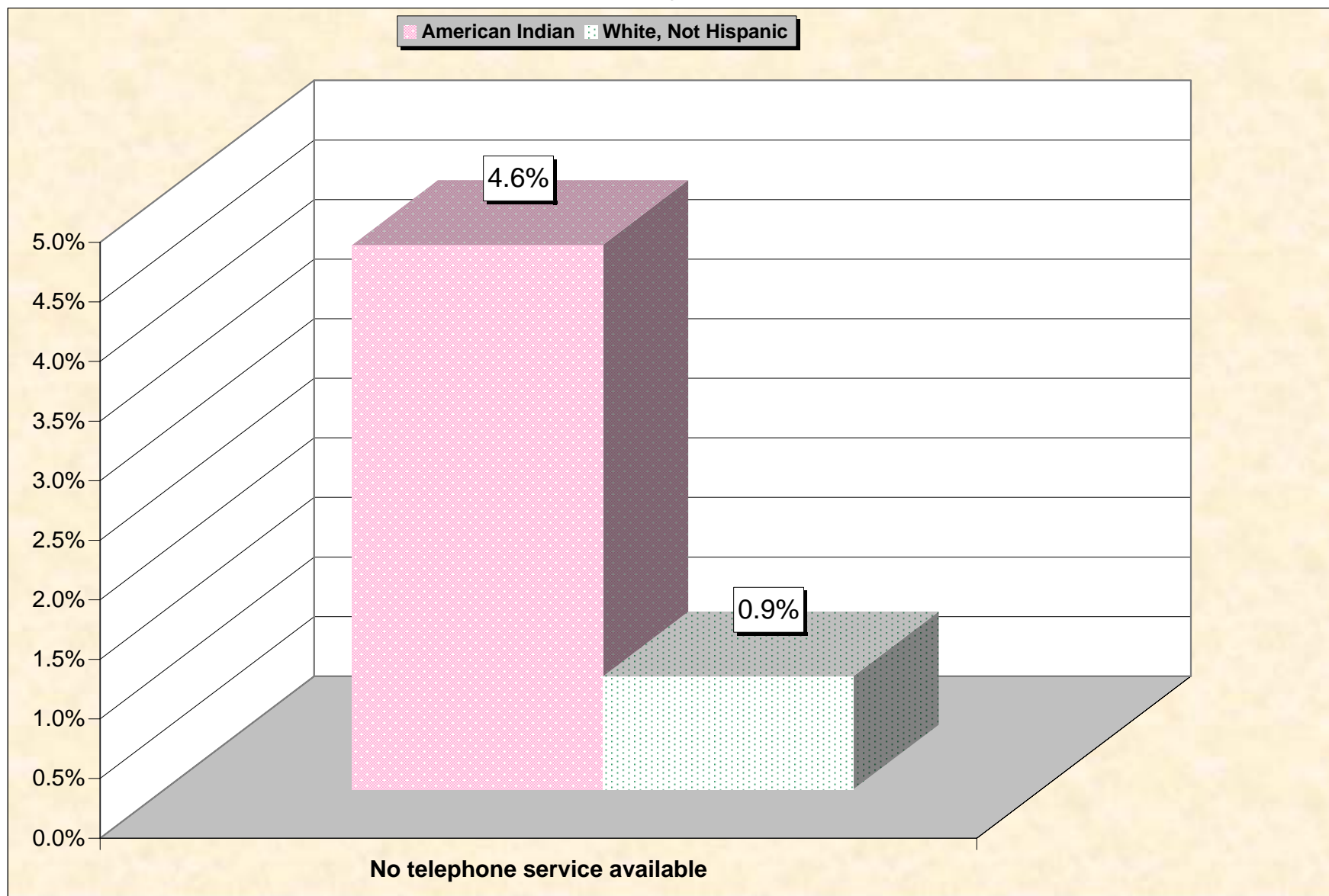

# Chart 12 -- Occupants Per Room (Crowding) by Household Maryland



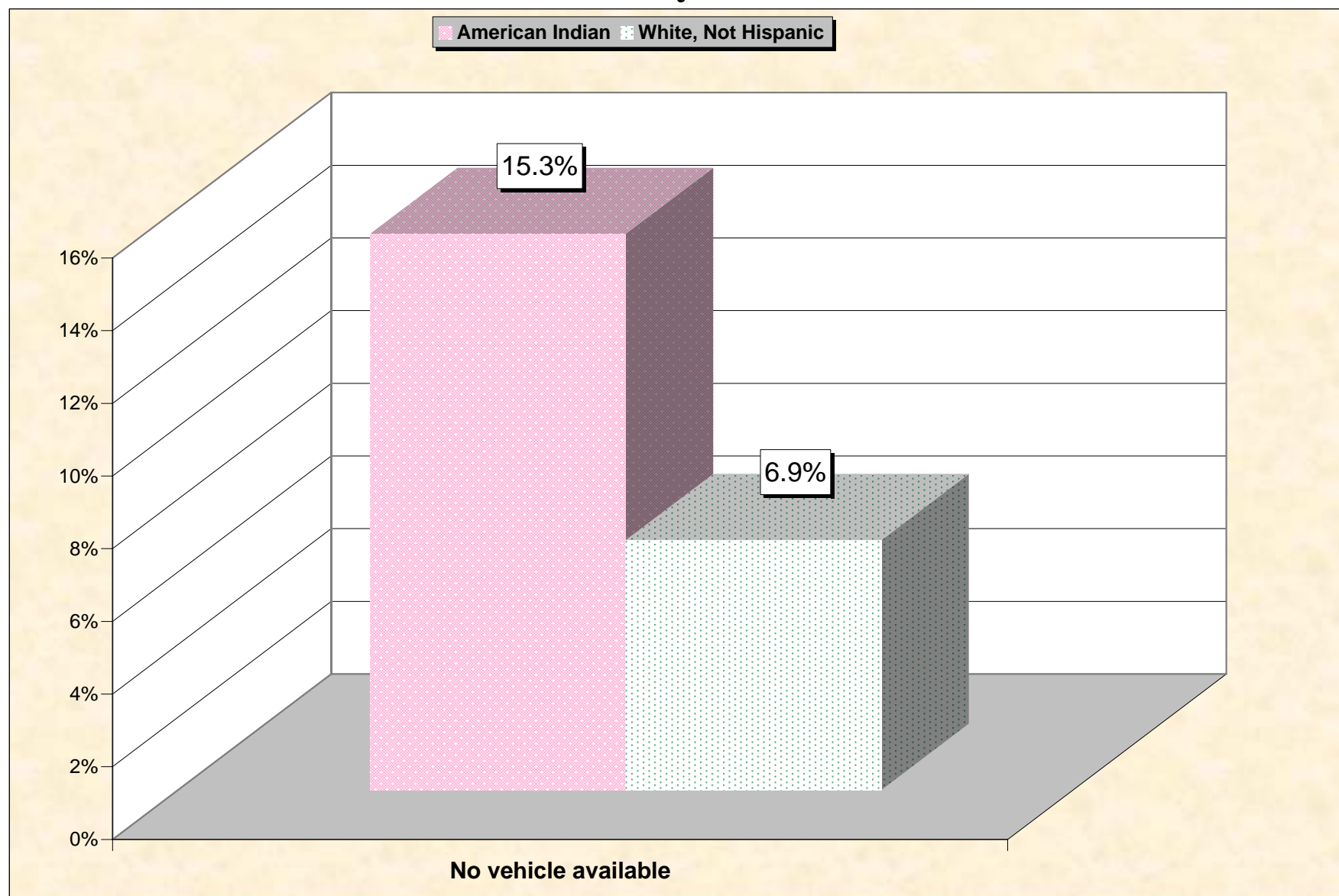

# Chart 13 -- Lack of Telephone Service by Household Maryland



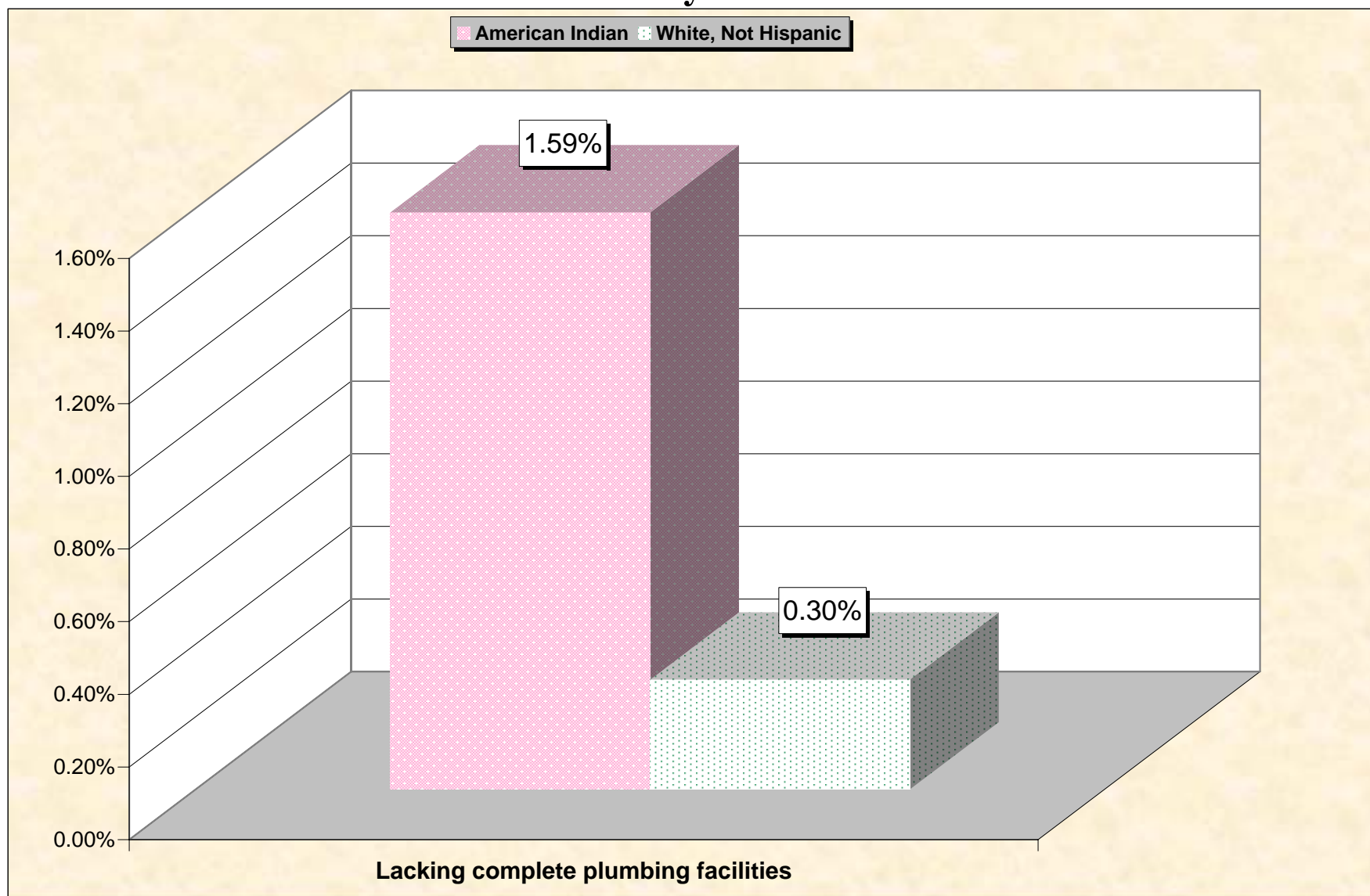

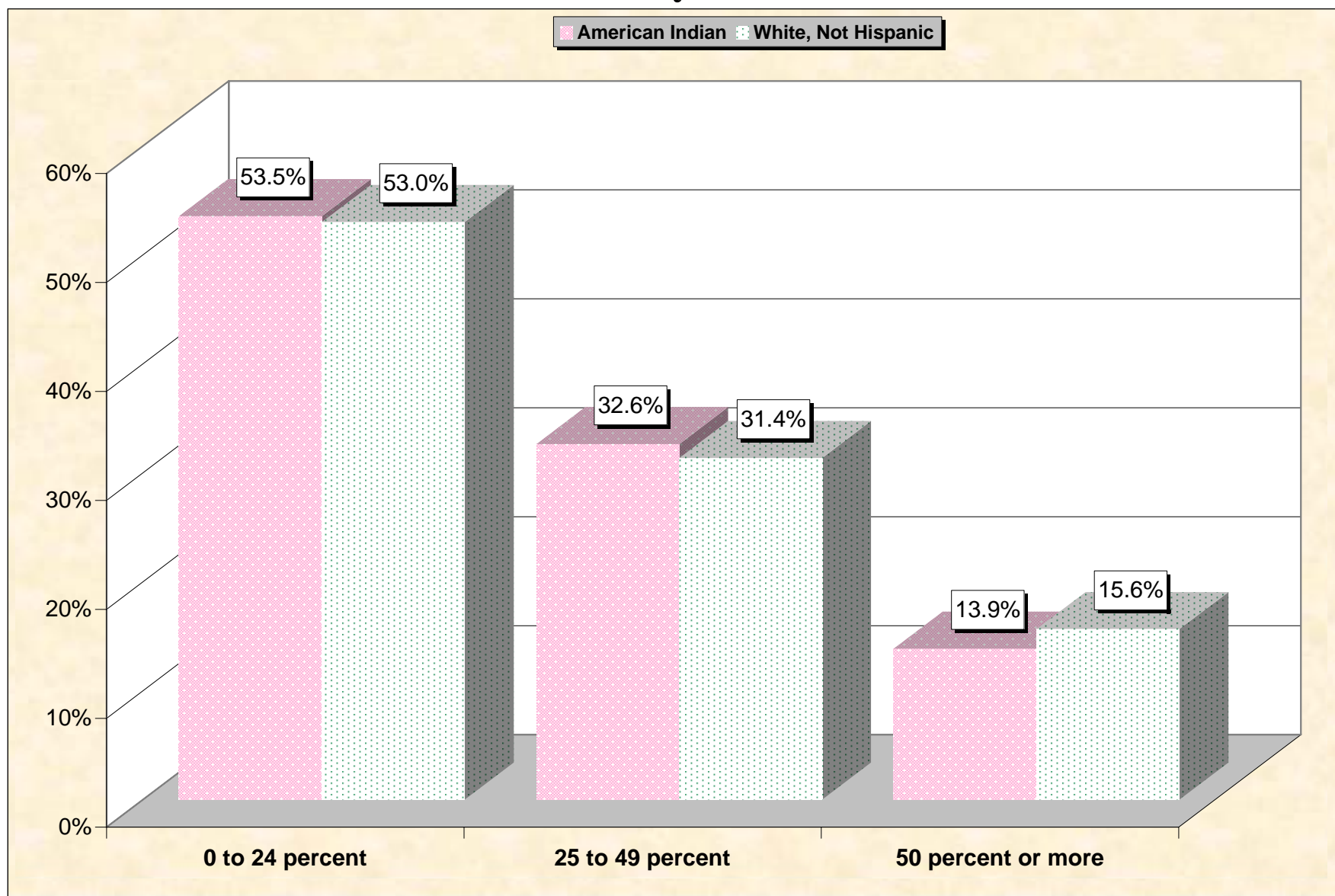
# Chart 15 -- Lack of Plumbing By Household Maryland

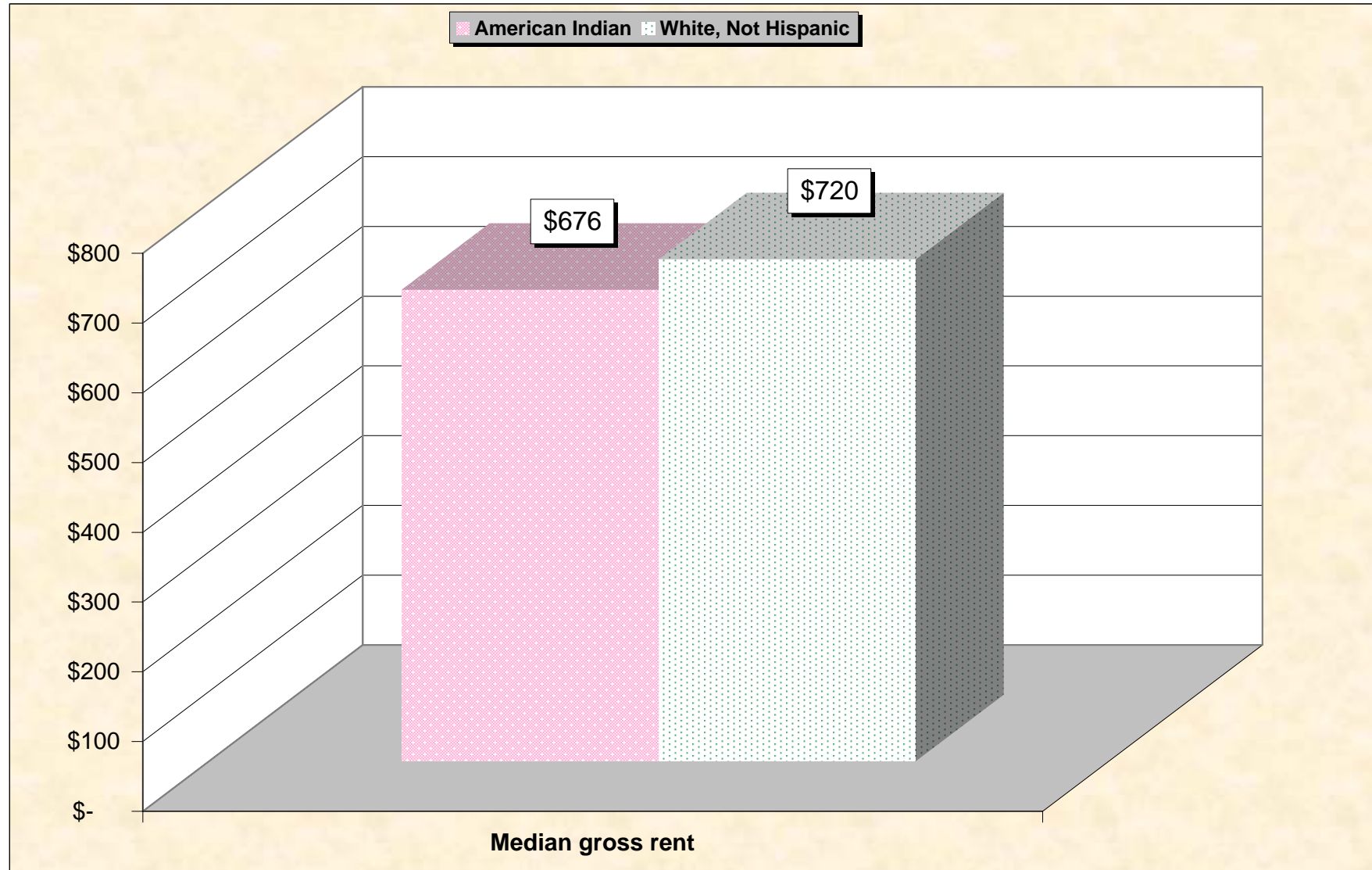


**Chart 16 -- Gross Rent as a Percentage of Household Income in 1999

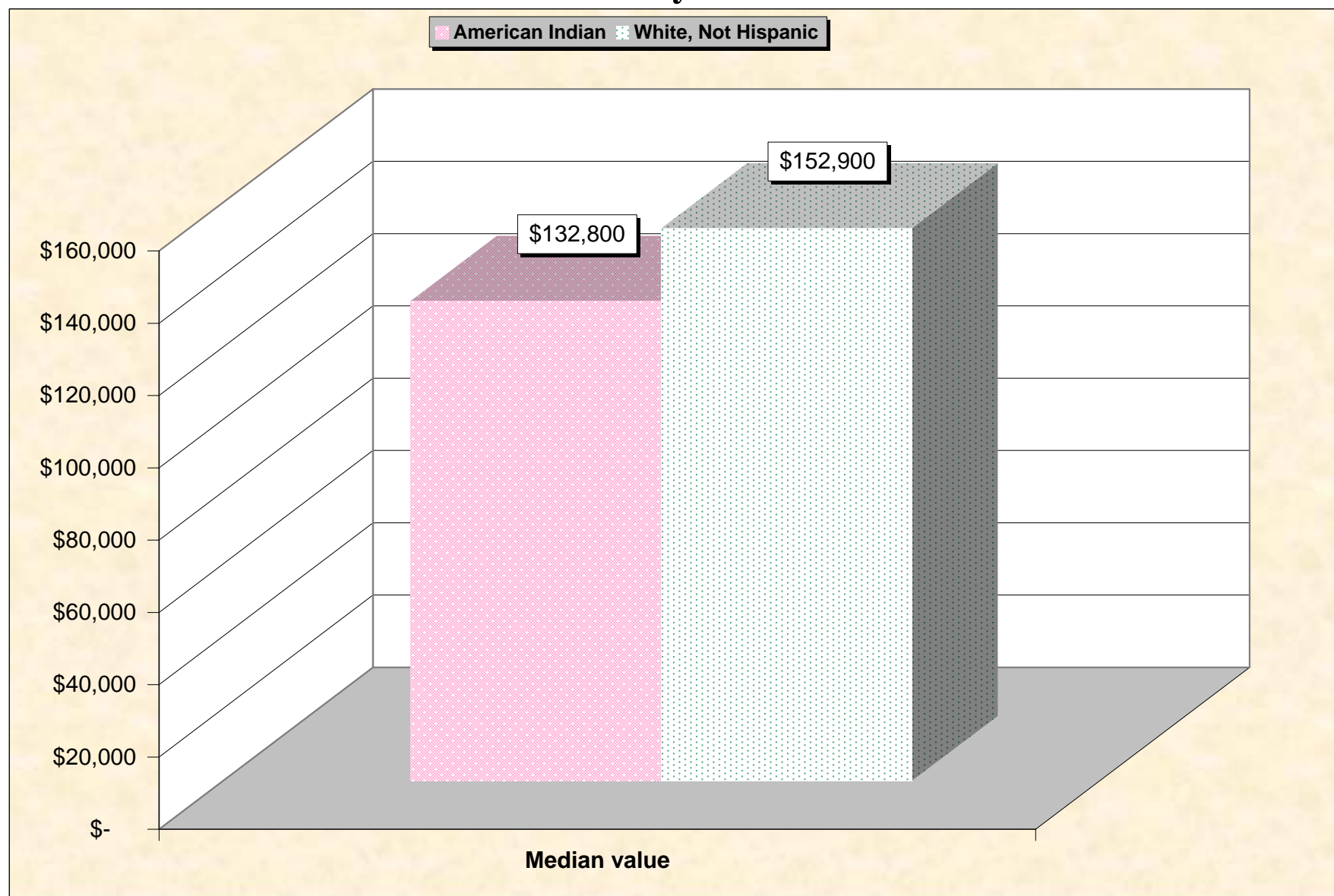
