


Chart 1 -- Single-Parent Family Households (Householder 15 to 64 years)






Chart 4 -- Unemployment Rate (Civilian Labor Force)


Chart 5 -- Labor Force Participation (Civilian Labor Force)



Chart 6 -- Household Income in 1999 Puerto Rico







Chart 8 -- Per Capita Income In 1999 Puerto Rico





Chart 9 -- Income in 1999 Below Poverty Level by Age Puerto Rico





Chart 10 -- Median Earnings in 1999 Puerto Rico





Chart 11 -- Renter-Occupied Housing Puerto Rico





Chart 12 -- Occupants Per Room (Crowding) by Household Puerto Rico





Chart 13 -- Lack of Telephone Service by Household Puerto Rico





Chart 14 -- Lack of Vehicle By Household Puerto Rico





Chart 15 -- Lack of Plumbing By Household Puerto Rico






