

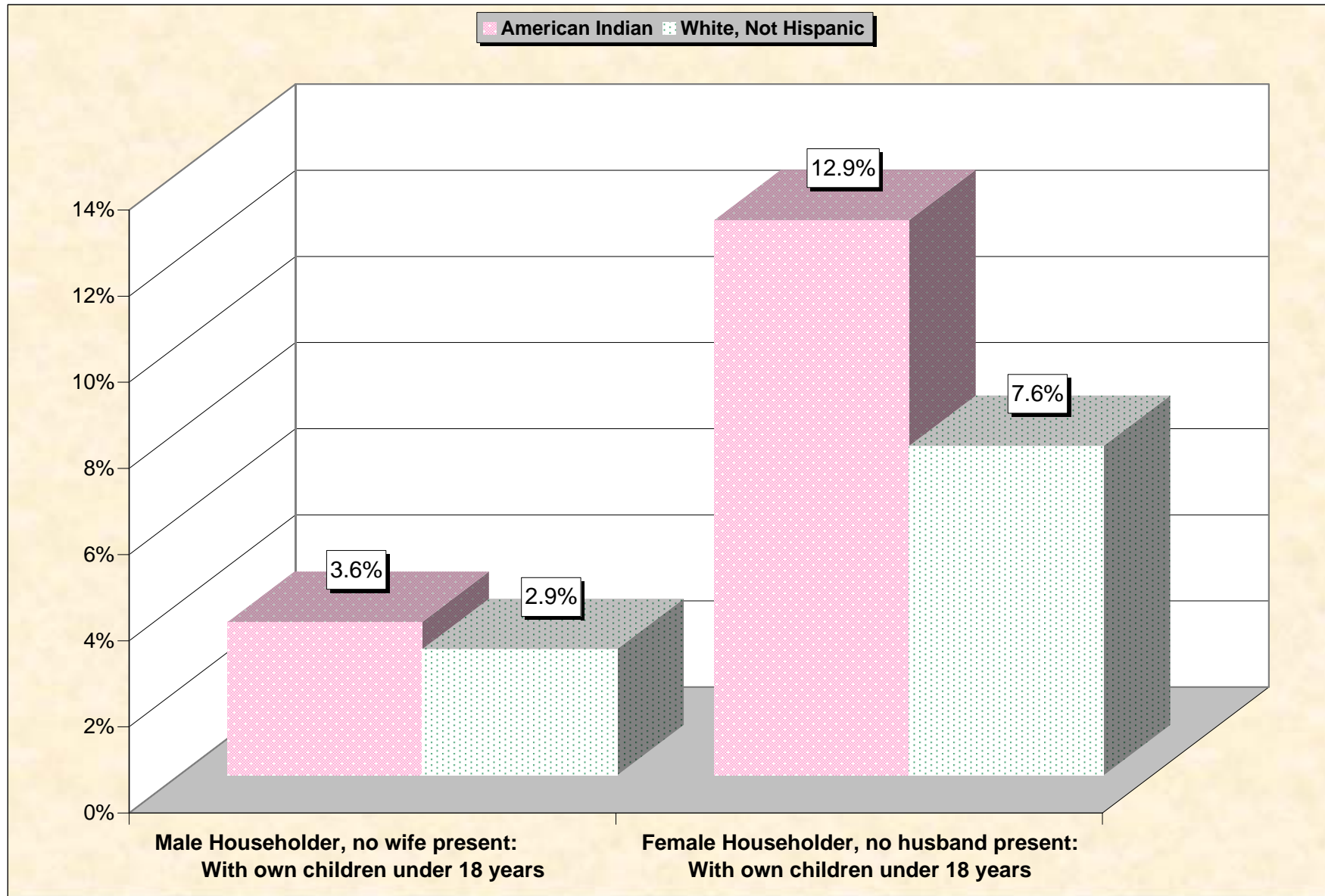

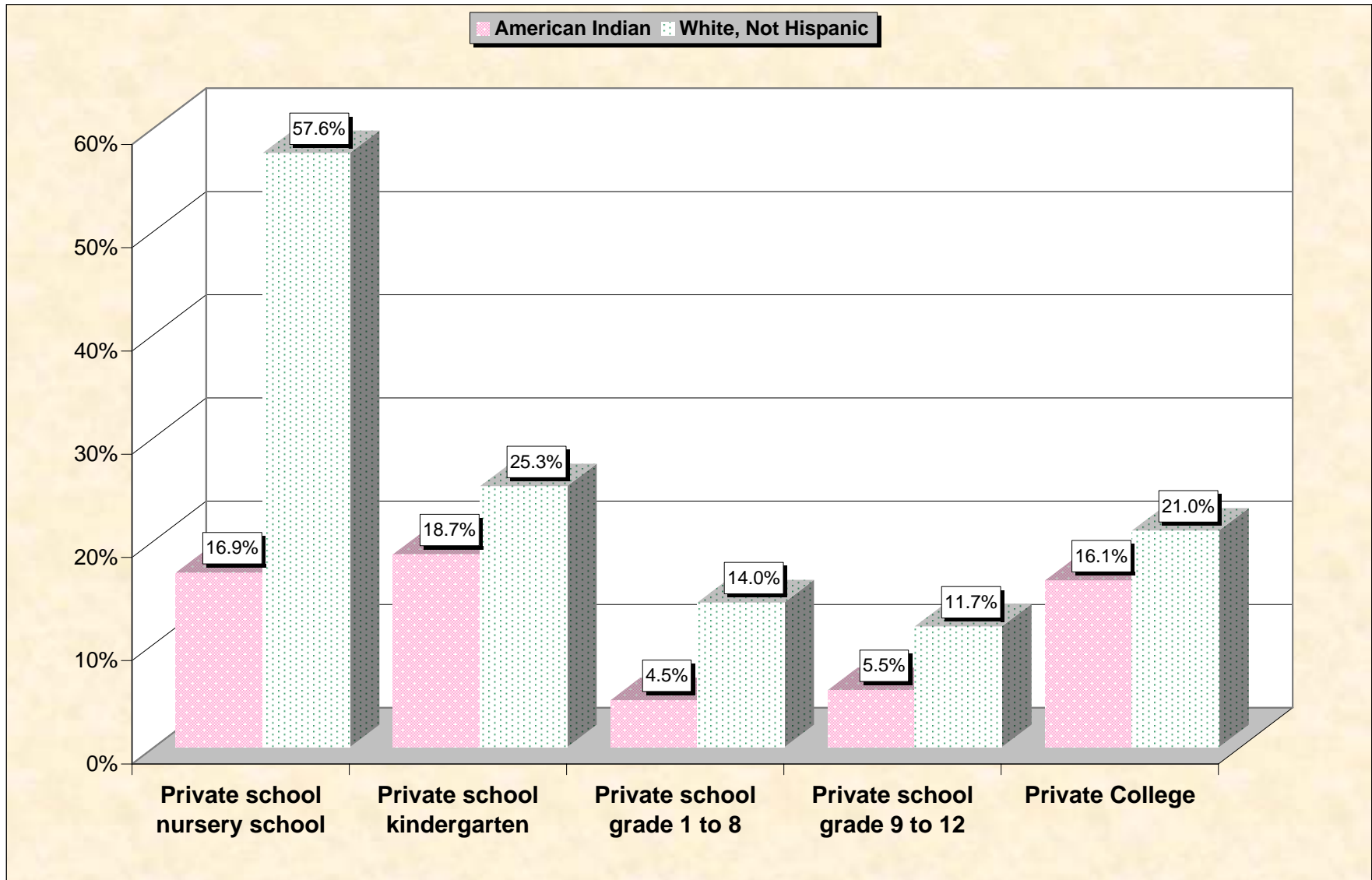

# Chart 1 -- Single-Parent Family Households (Householder 15 to 64 years) South Carolina



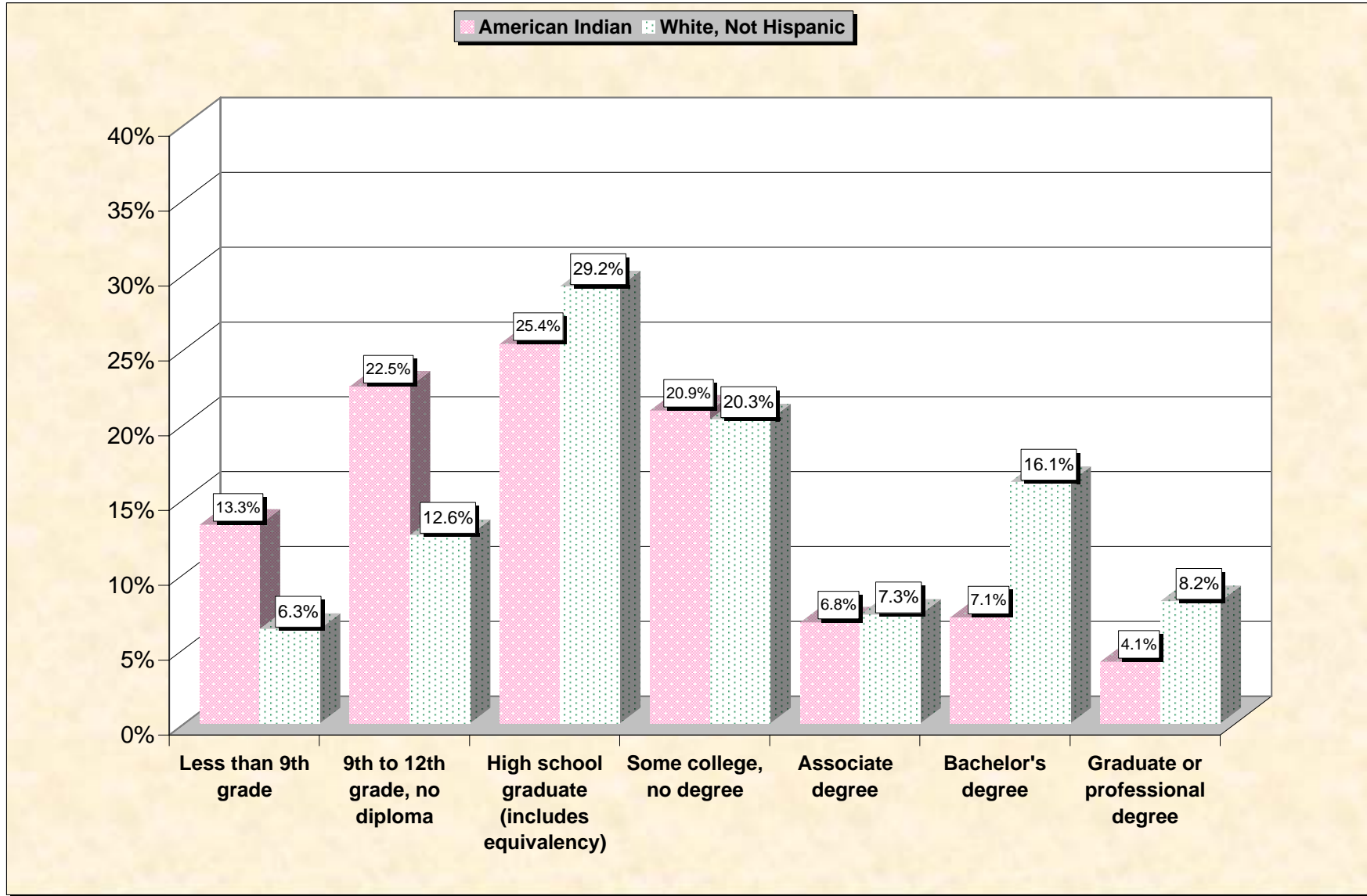

## Chart 2 -- Private School Enrollment (3 years and over) South Carolina



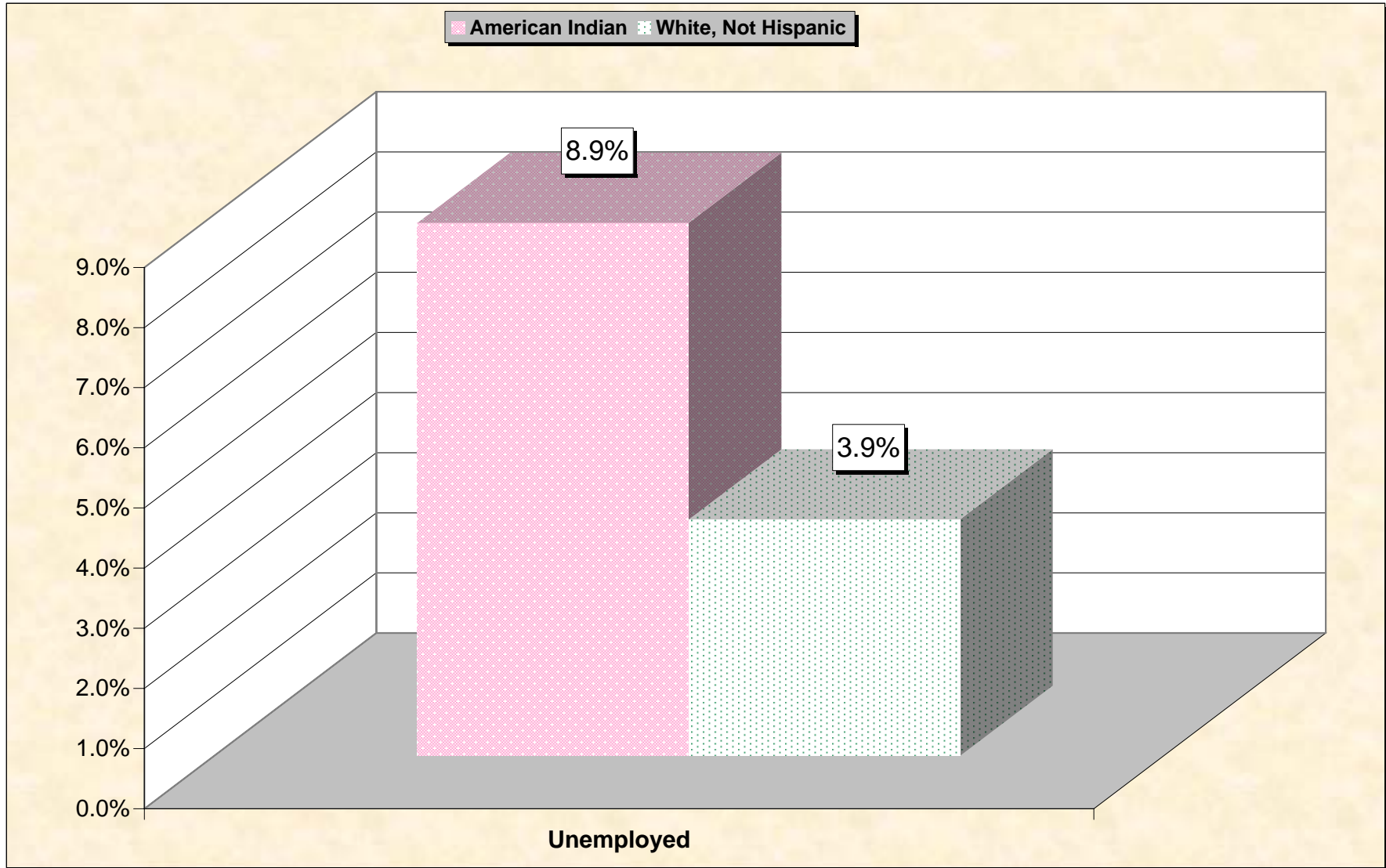

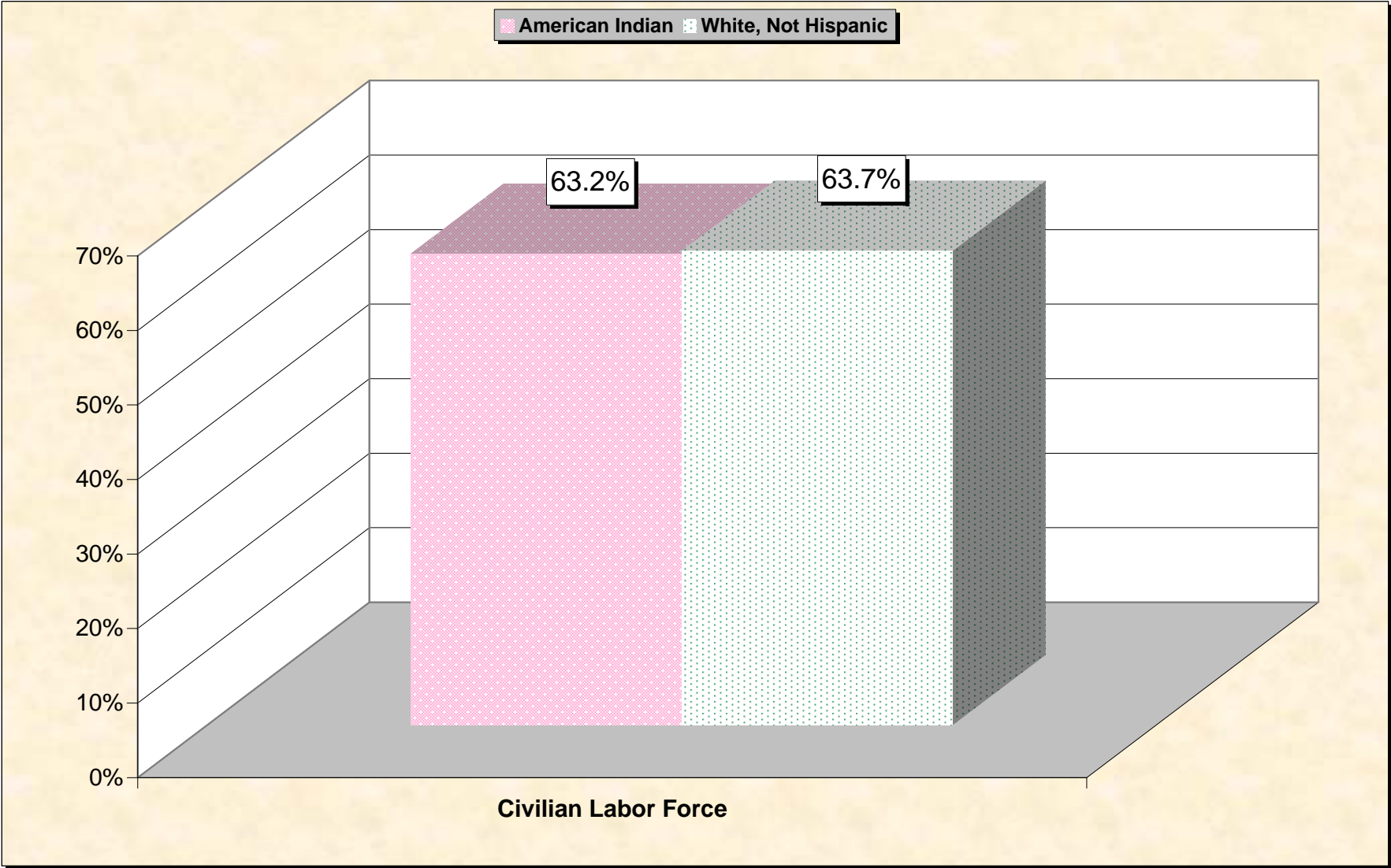
# Chart 4 -- Unemployment Rate (Civilian Labor Force) South Carolina

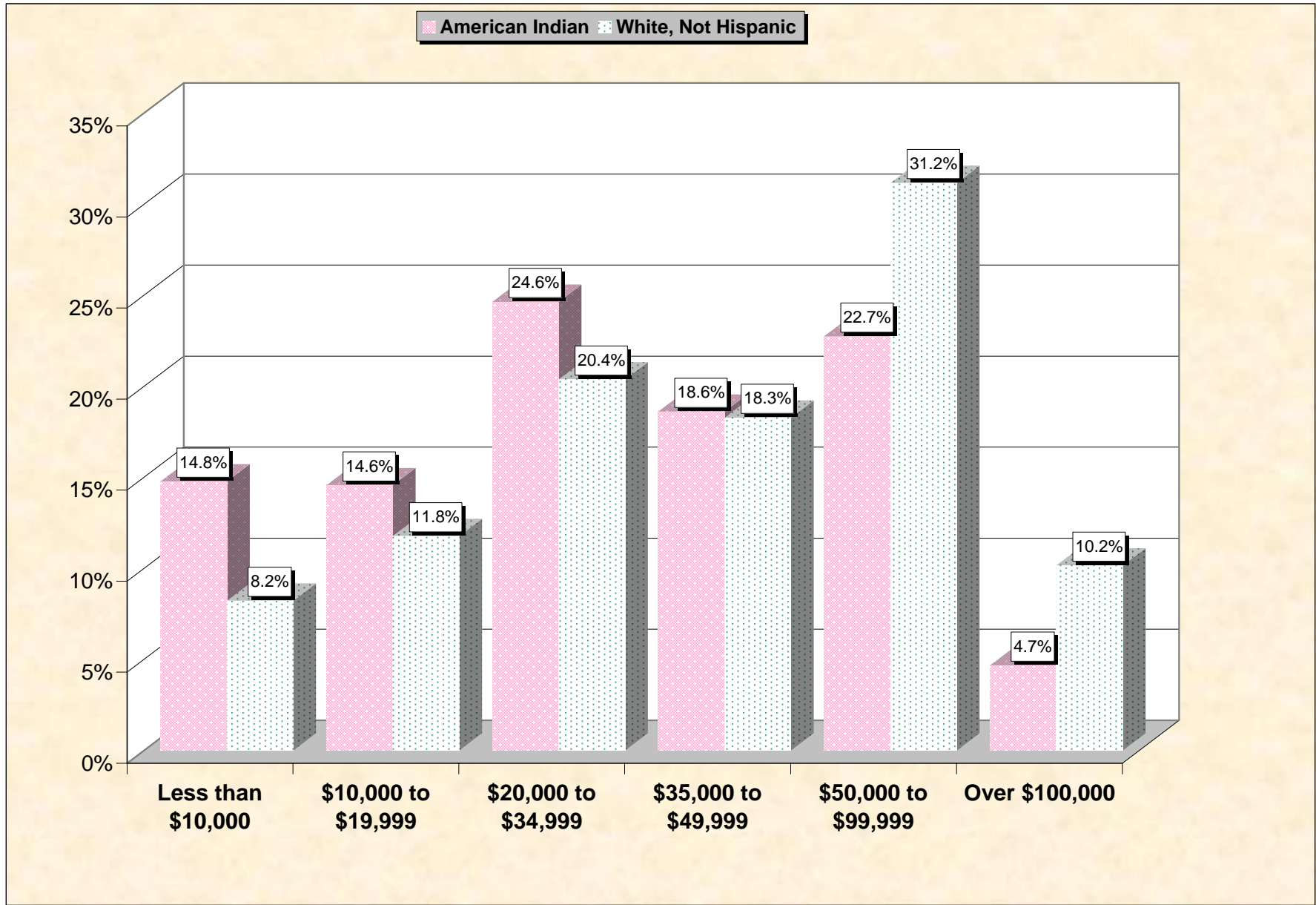
# Chart 5 -- Labor Force Participation (Civilian Labor Force) South Carolina

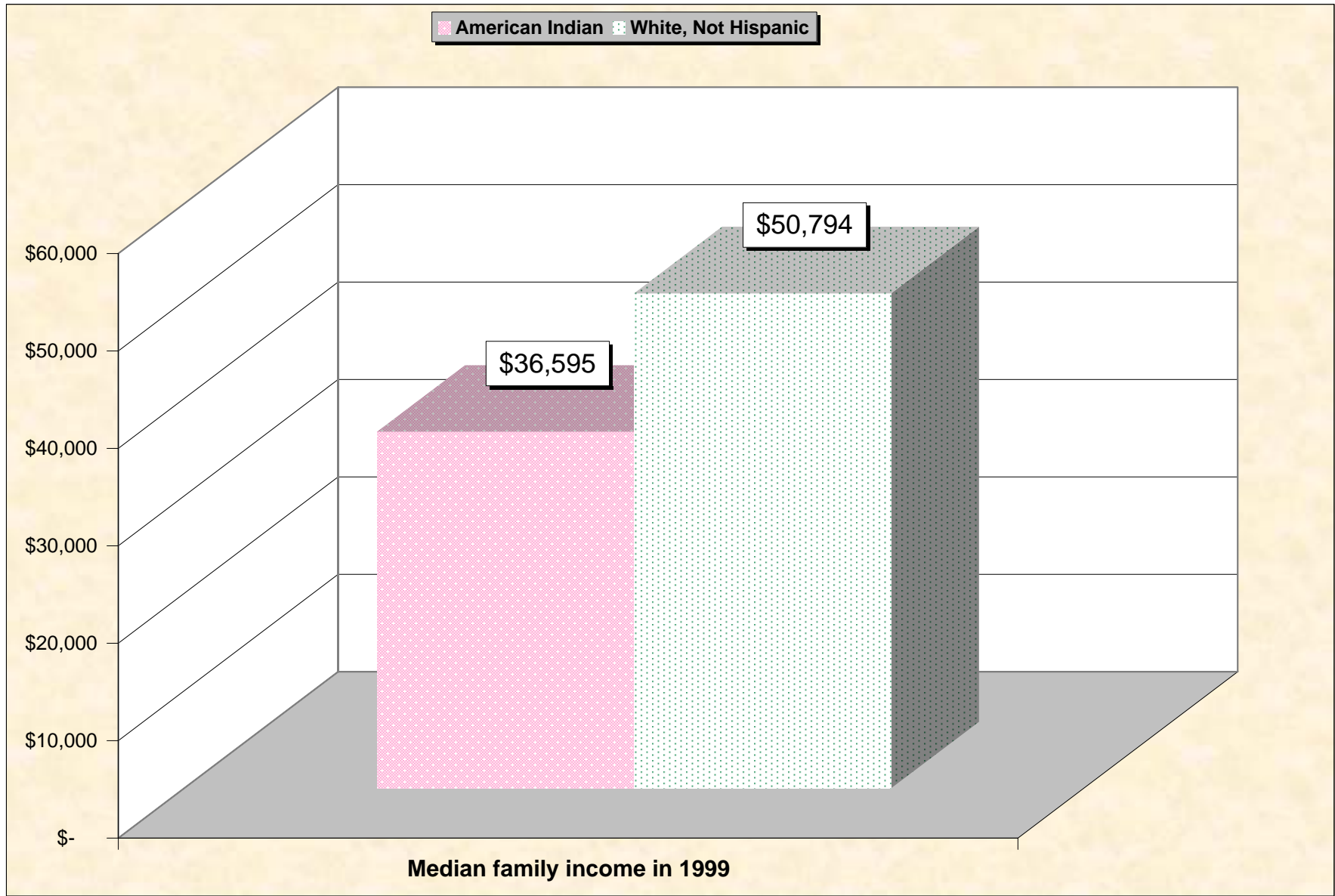
## Chart 6 -- Household Income in 1999 South Carolina

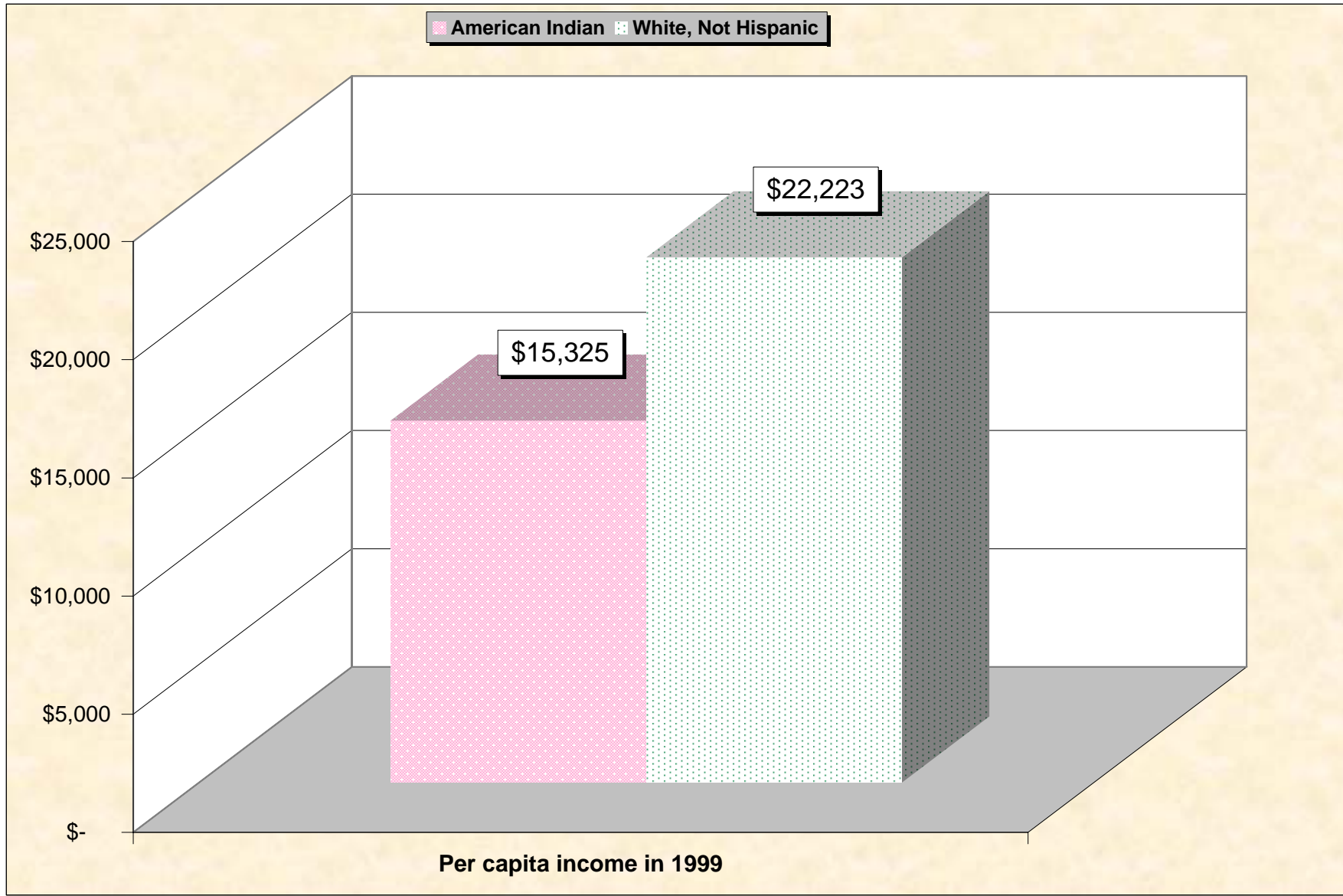
# Chart 7 -- Median Family Income In 1999

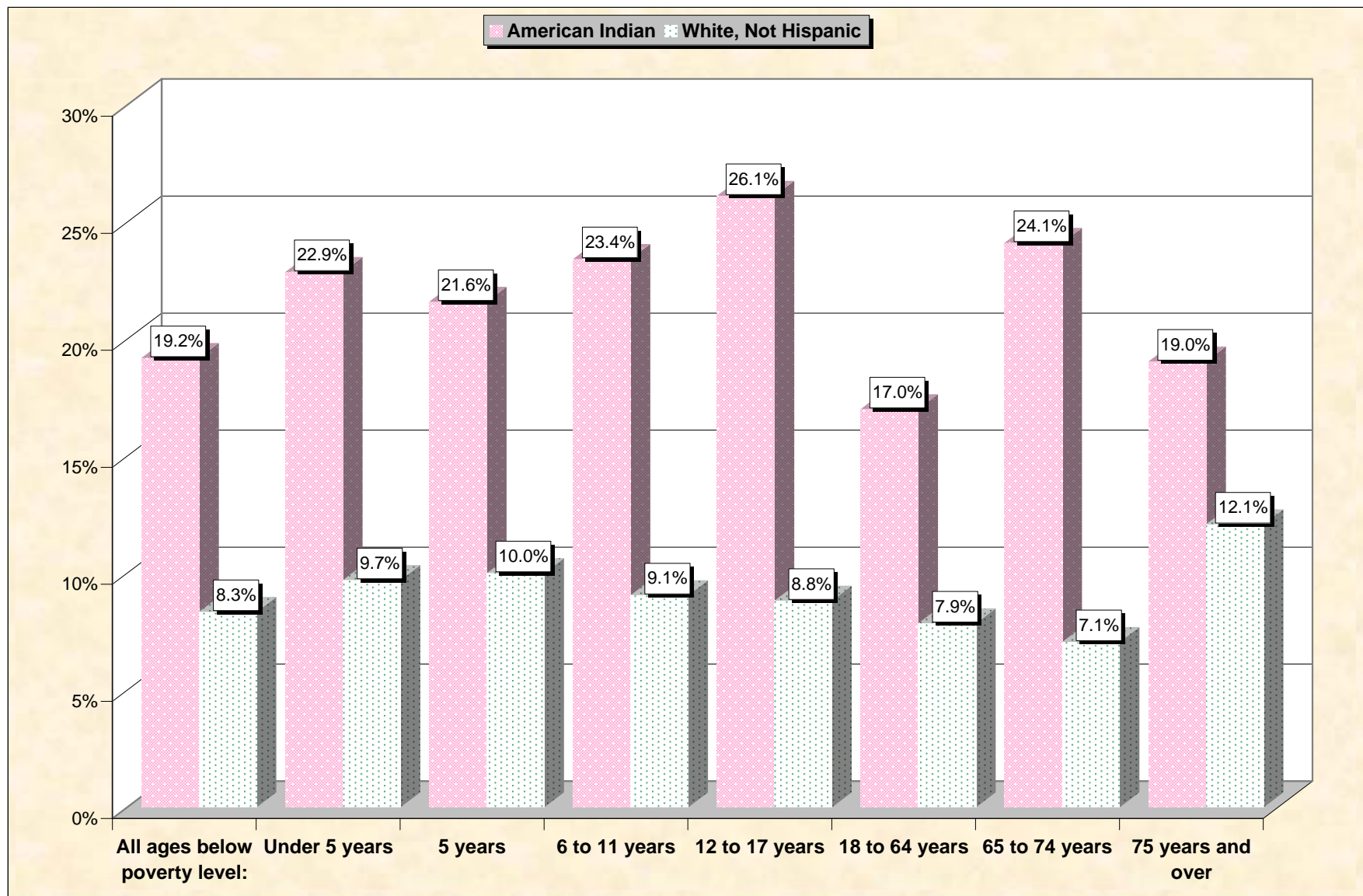

# Chart 8 -- Per Capita Income In 1999 South Carolina



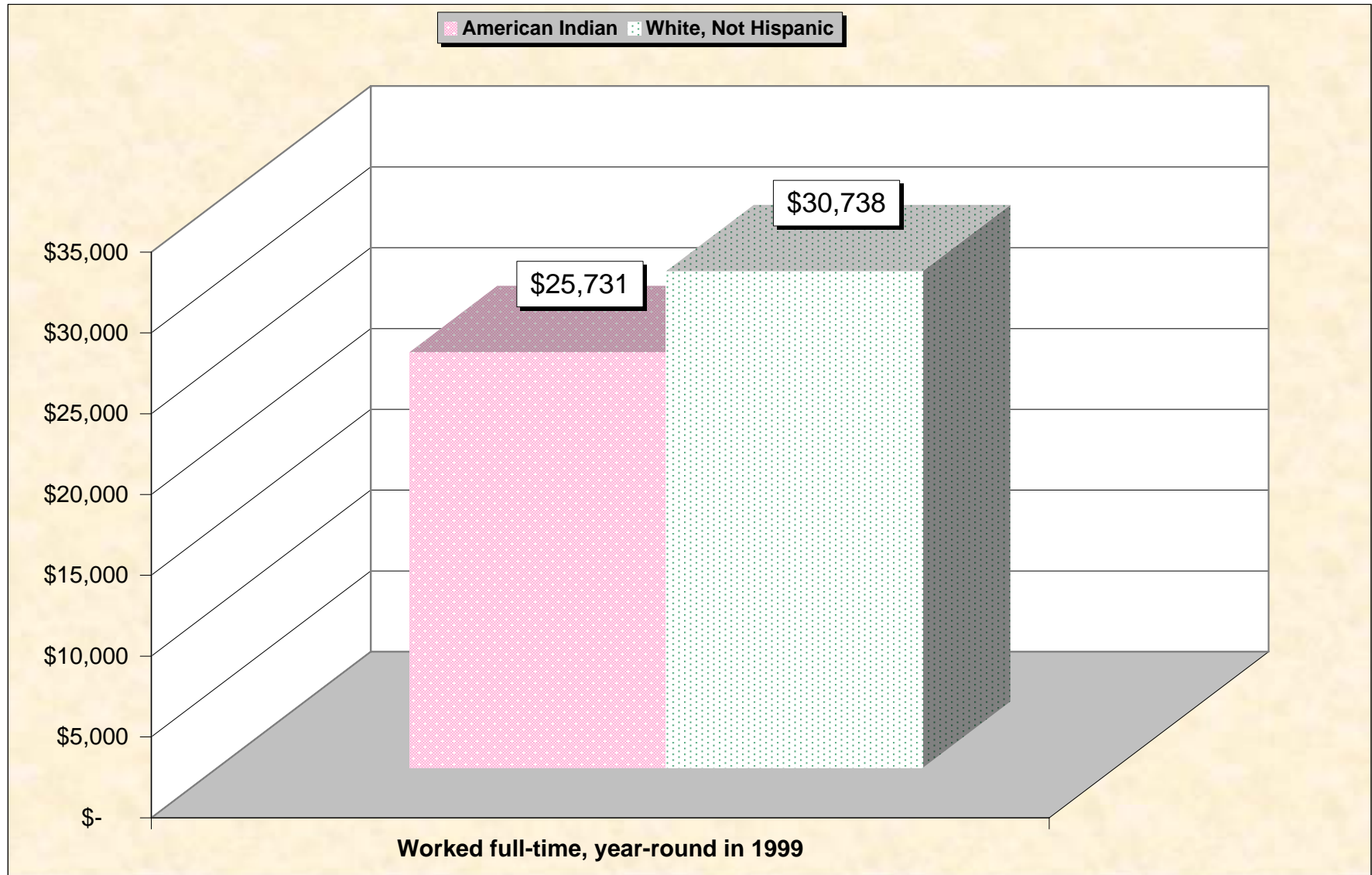

## Chart 9 -- Income in 1999 Below Poverty Level by Age South Carolina



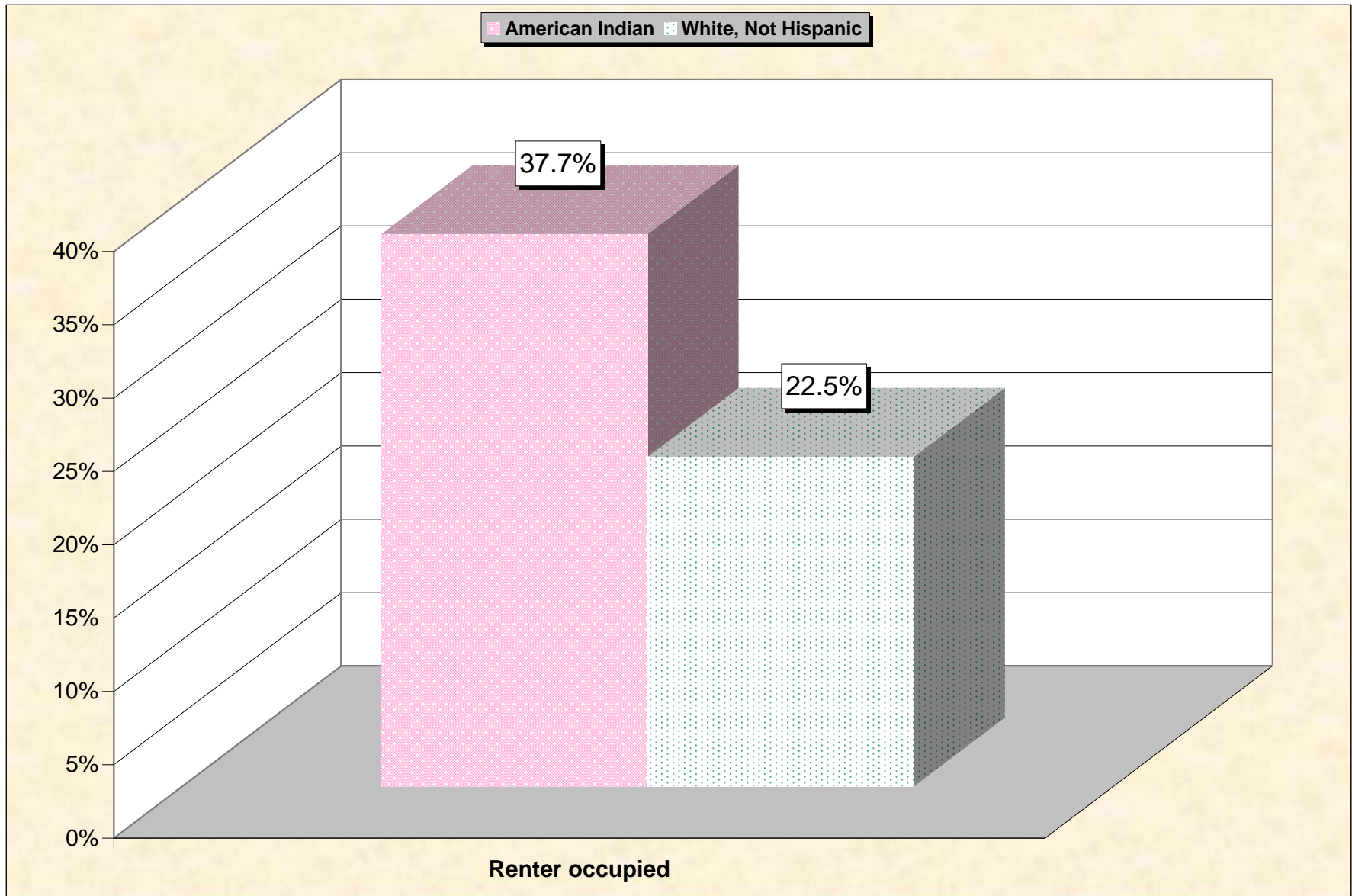

# Chart 10 -- Median Earnings in 1999 South Carolina



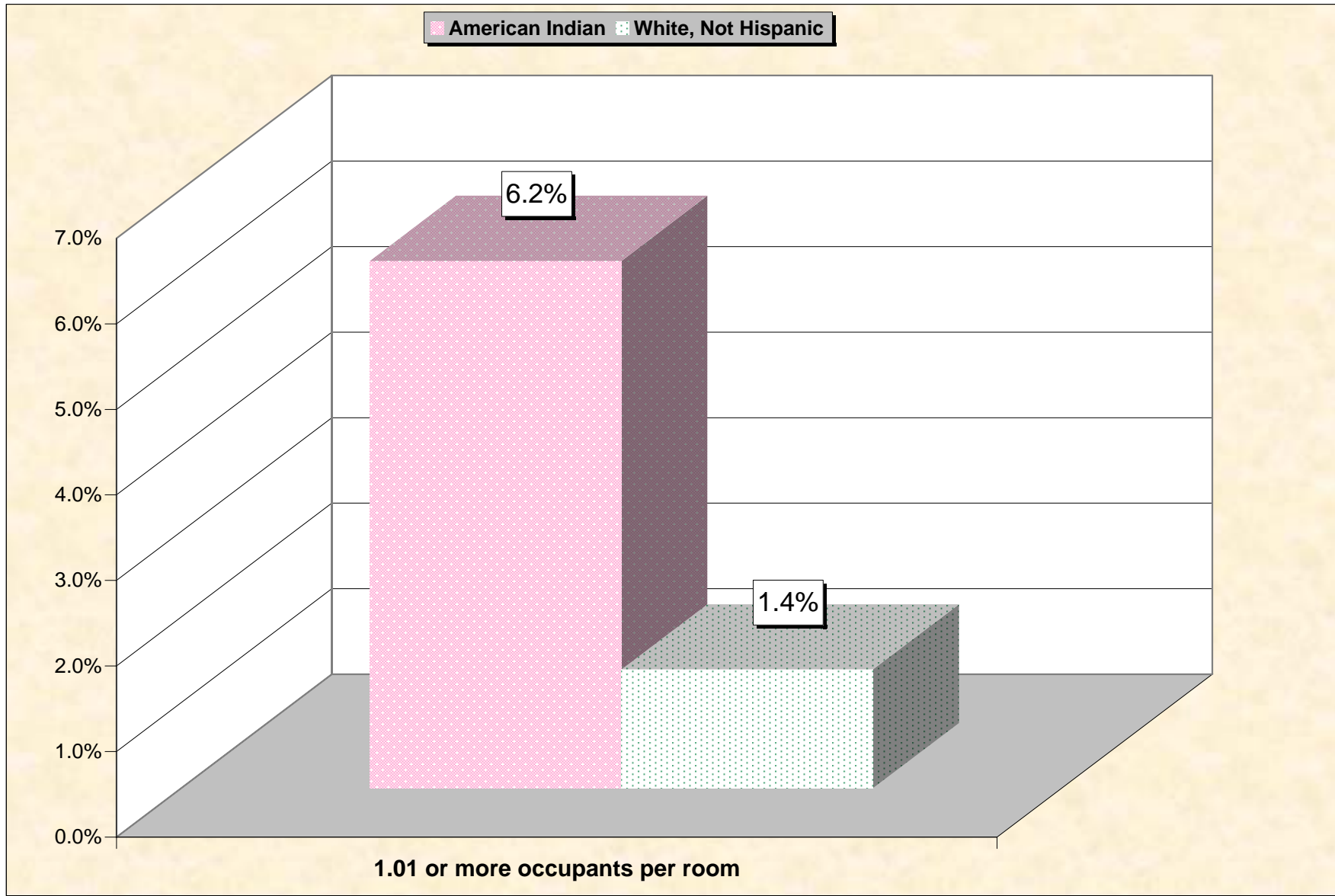

# Chart 11 -- Renter-Occupied Housing South Carolina



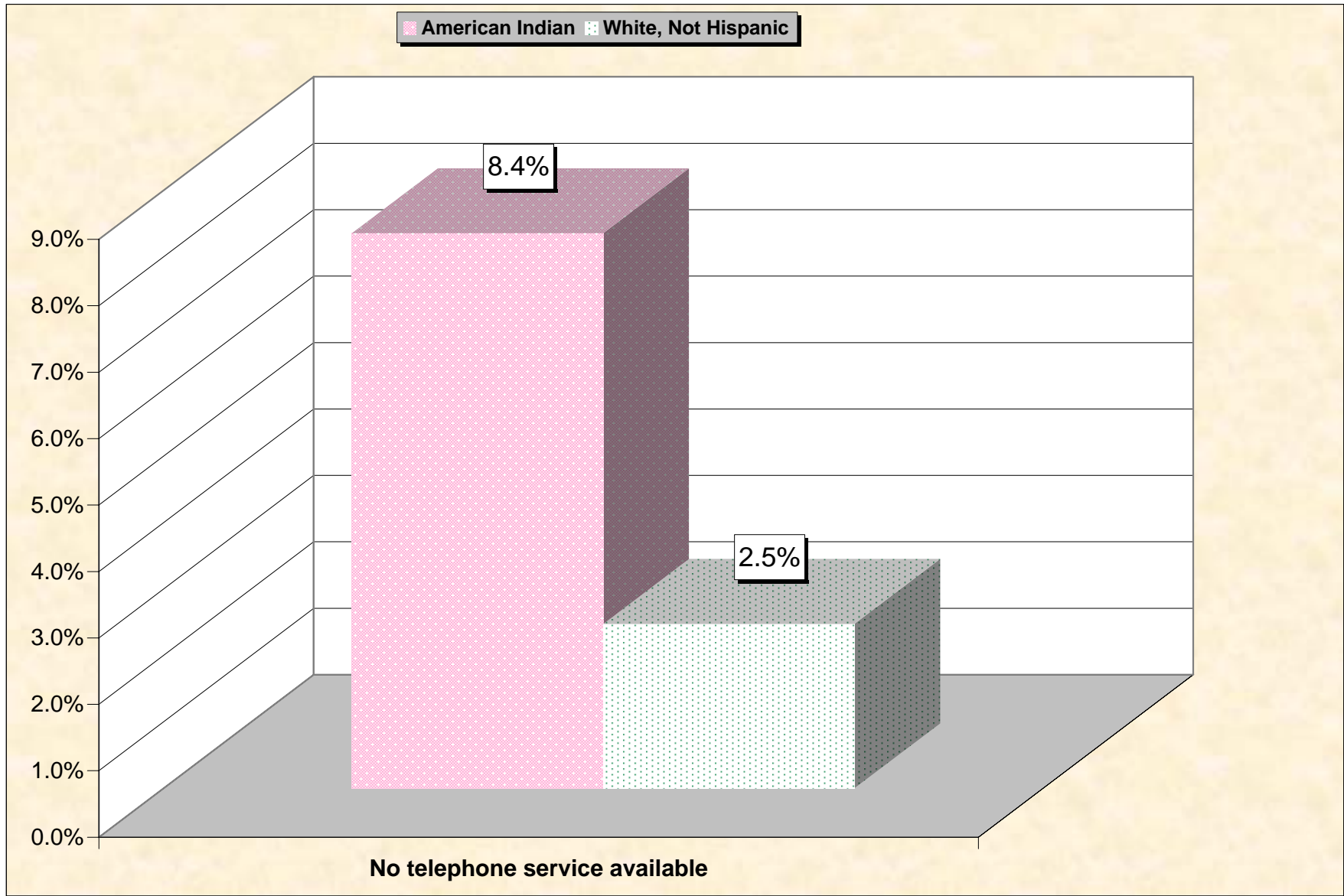

## Chart 12 -- Occupants Per Room (Crowding) by Household South Carolina



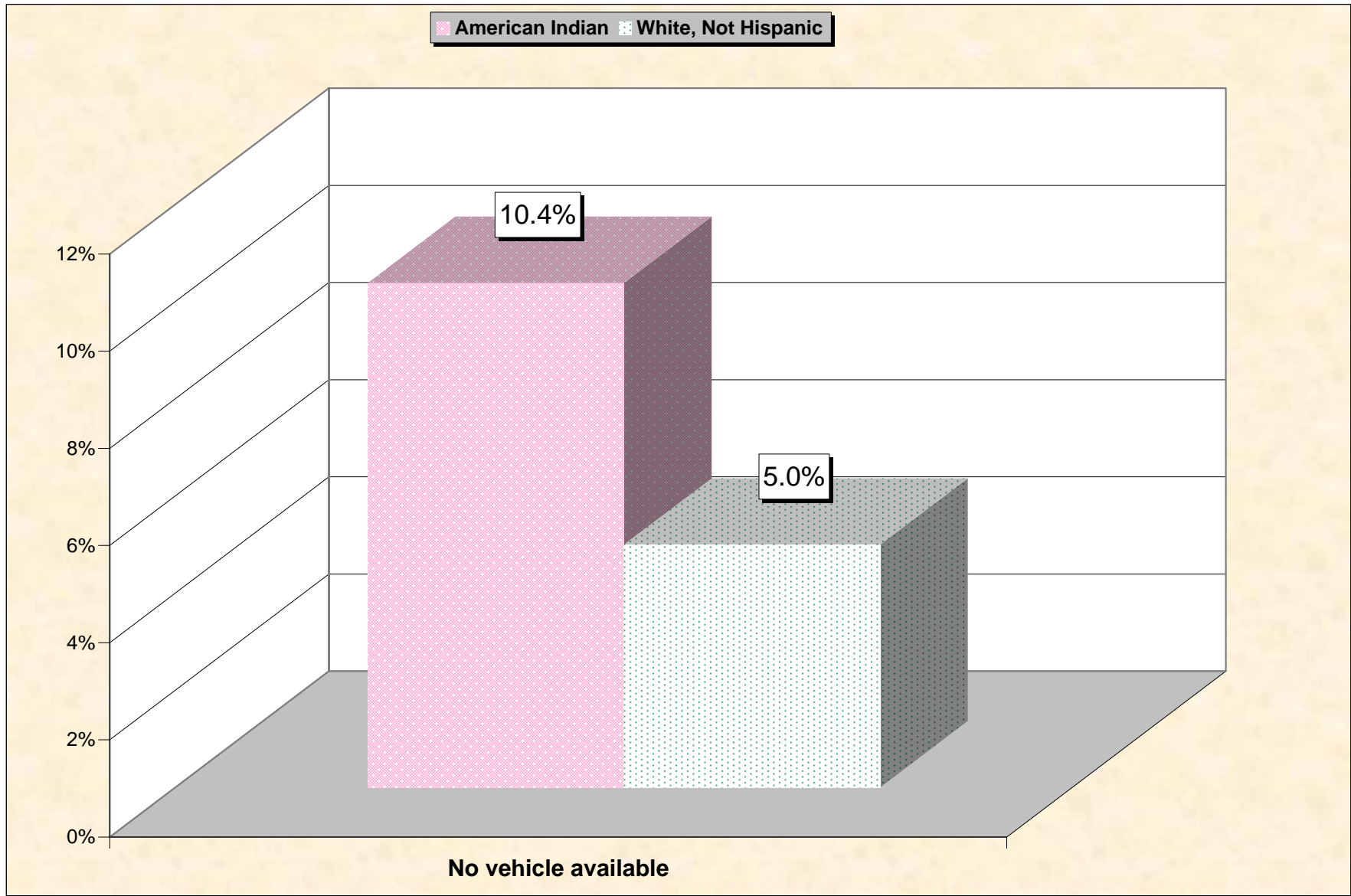

# Chart 13 -- Lack of Telephone Service by Household South Carolina



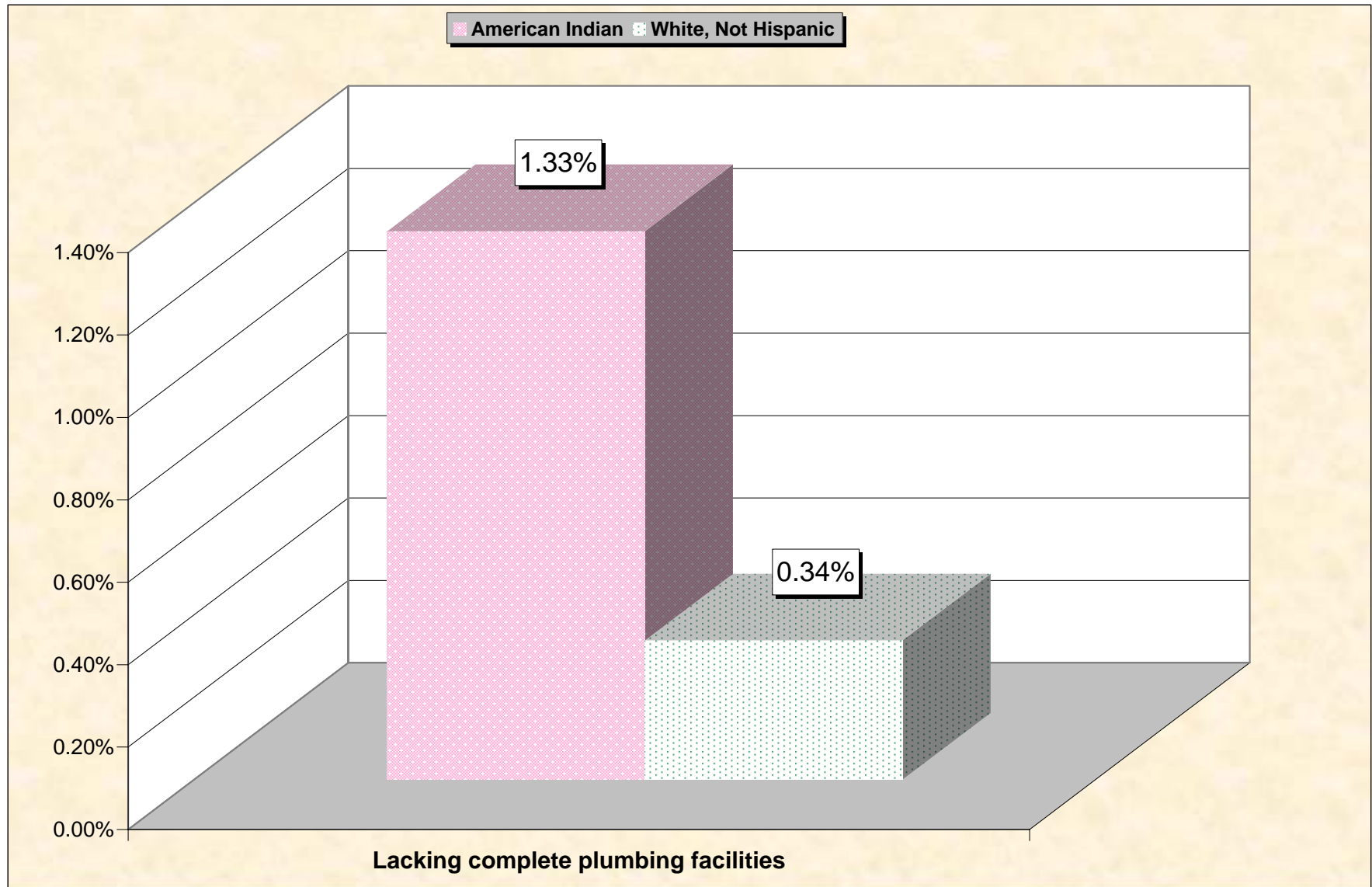

# Chart 14 -- Lack of Vehicle By Household South Carolina



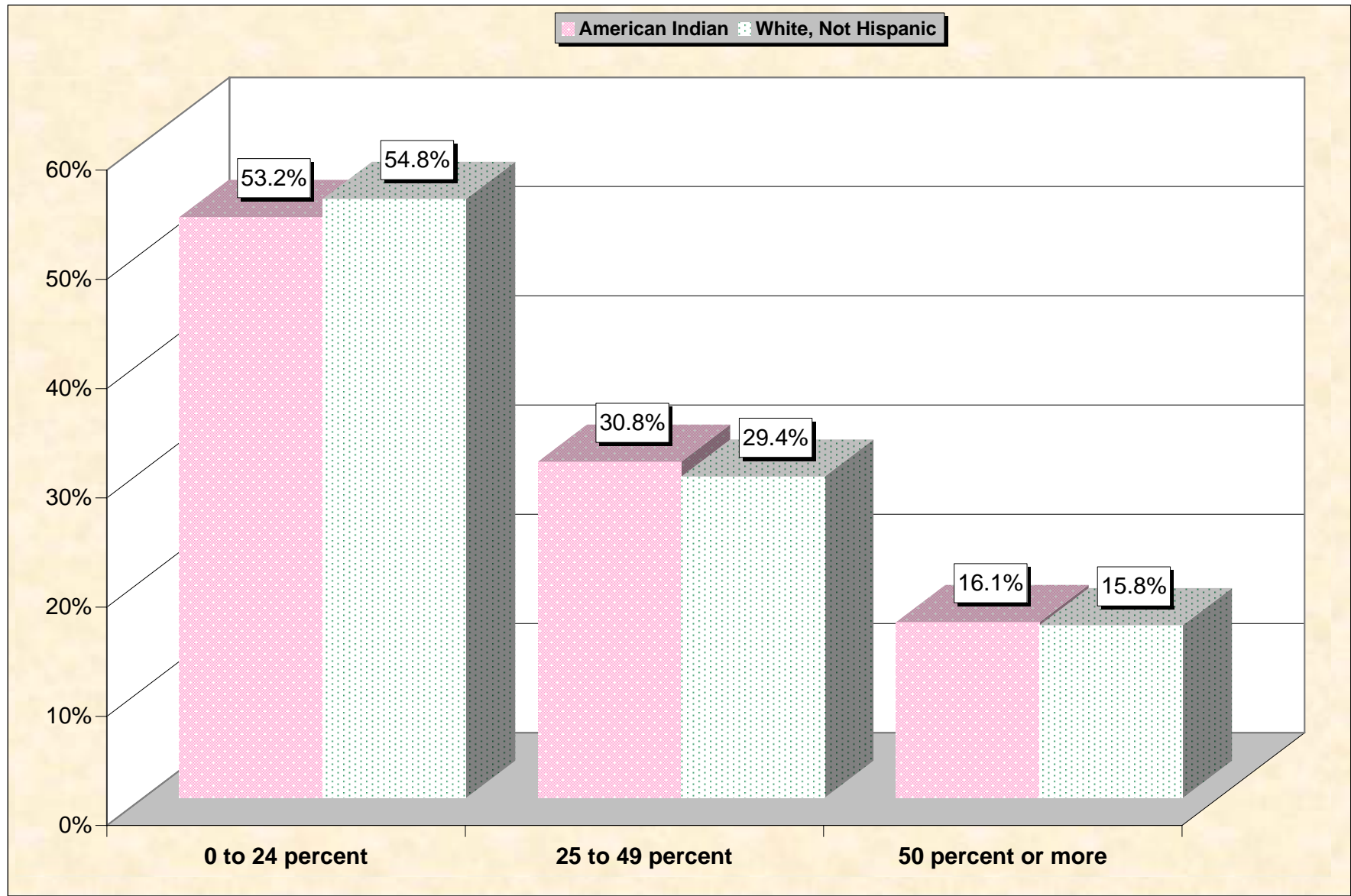

# Chart 15 -- Lack of Plumbing By Household South Carolina



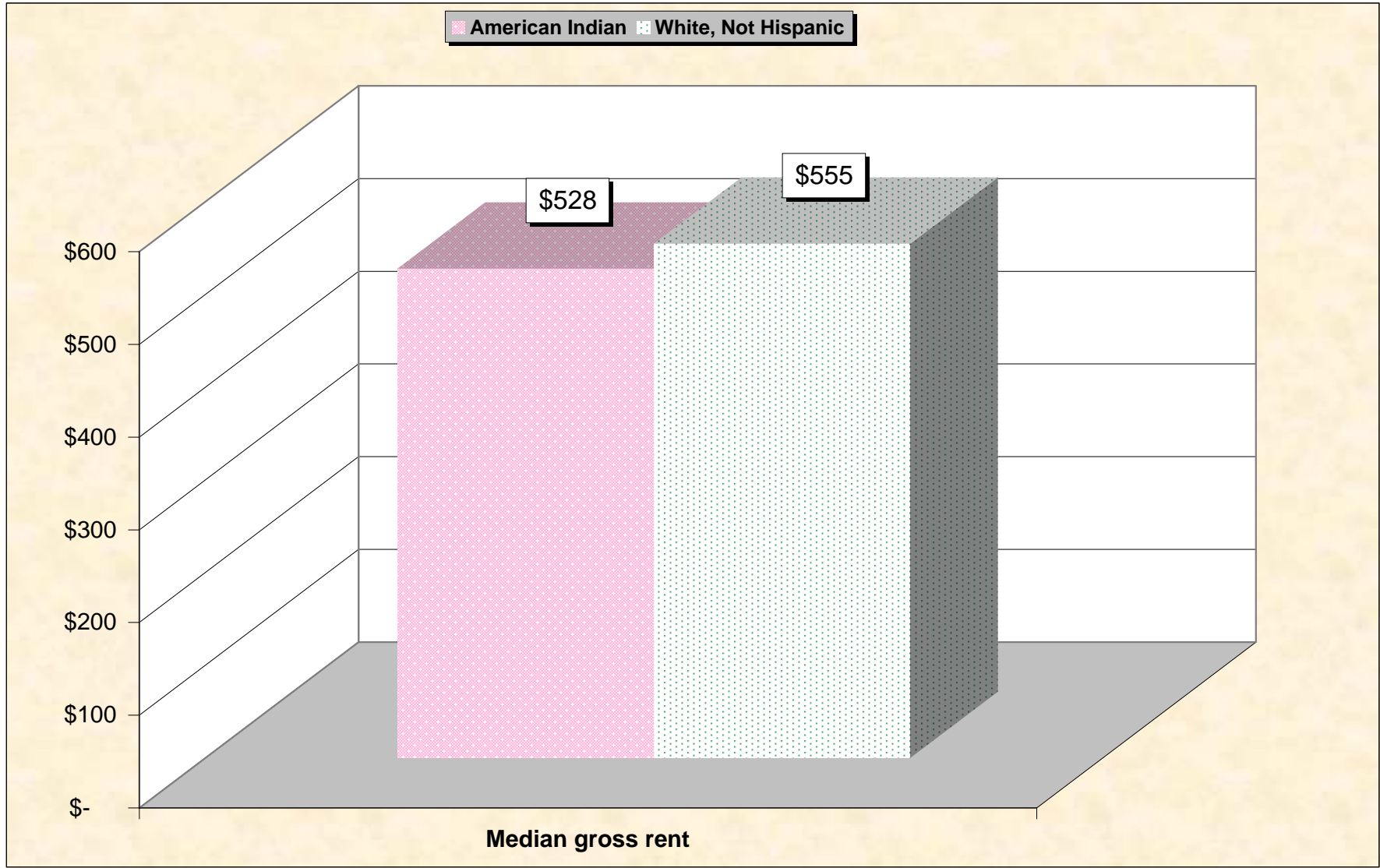

# Chart 16 -- Gross Rent as a Percentage of Household Income in 1999 South Carolina



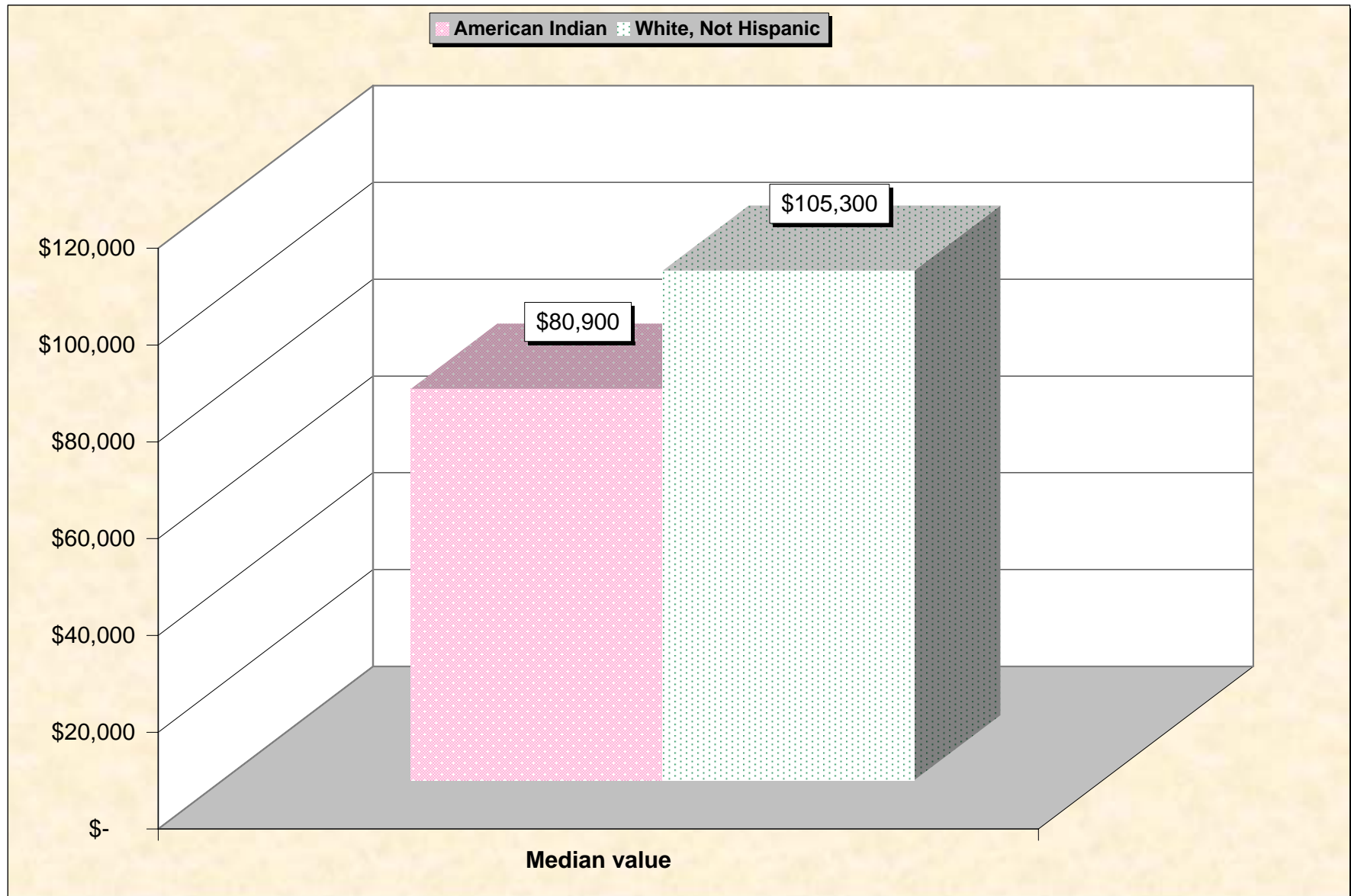
