






# **Chart 2 -- Private School Enrollment (3 years and over)** **Texas**


# Chart 3 -- Educational Attainment (25 years and over)


# Chart 4 -- Unemployment Rate (Civilian Labor Force) Texas


## Chart 5 -- Labor Force Participation (Civilian Labor Force) Texas



# Chart 6 -- Household Income in 1999 Texas





# Chart 7 -- Median Family Income In 1999 Texas






# Chart 9 -- Income in 1999 Below Poverty Level by Age Texas


# Chart 10 -- Median Earnings in 1999



# Chart 11 -- Renter-Occupied Housing Texas





# Chart 12 -- Occupants Per Room (Crowding) by Household Texas





# Chart 13 -- Lack of Telephone Service by Household Texas





# Chart 14 -- Lack of Vehicle By Household Texas





# Chart 15 -- Lack of Plumbing By Household Texas






