

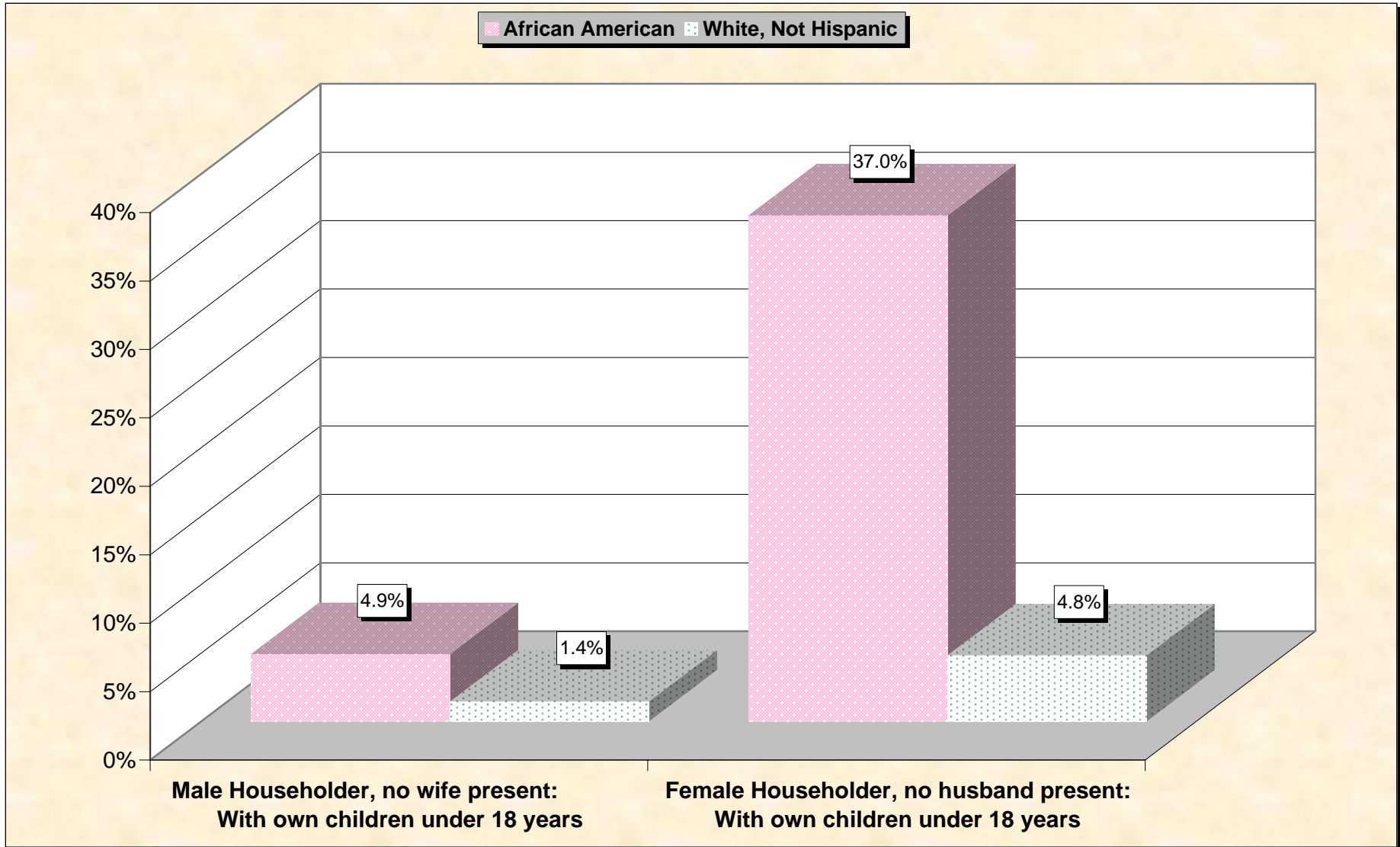

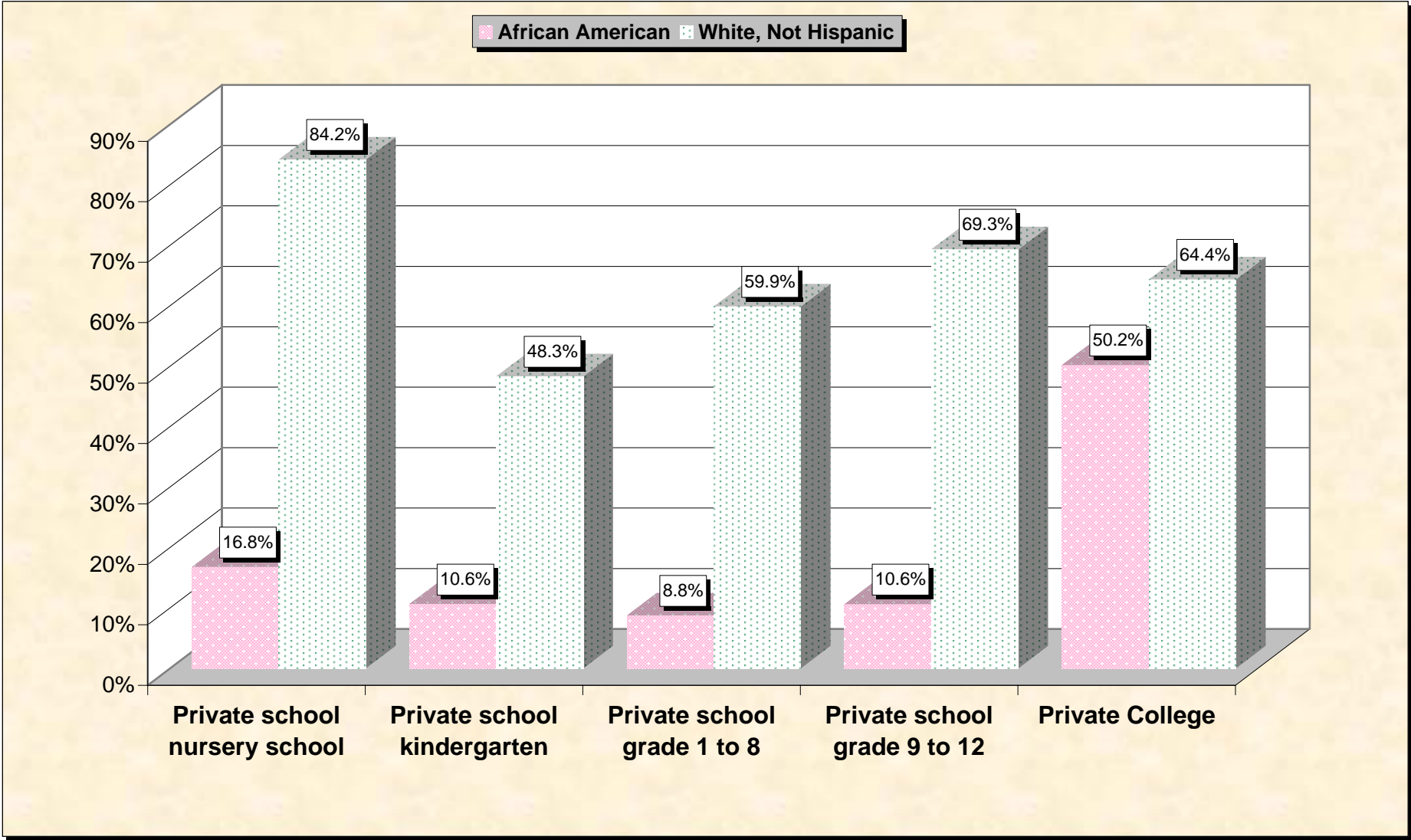

Chart 1 -- Single-Parent Family Households (Householder 15 to 64 years) District of Columbia



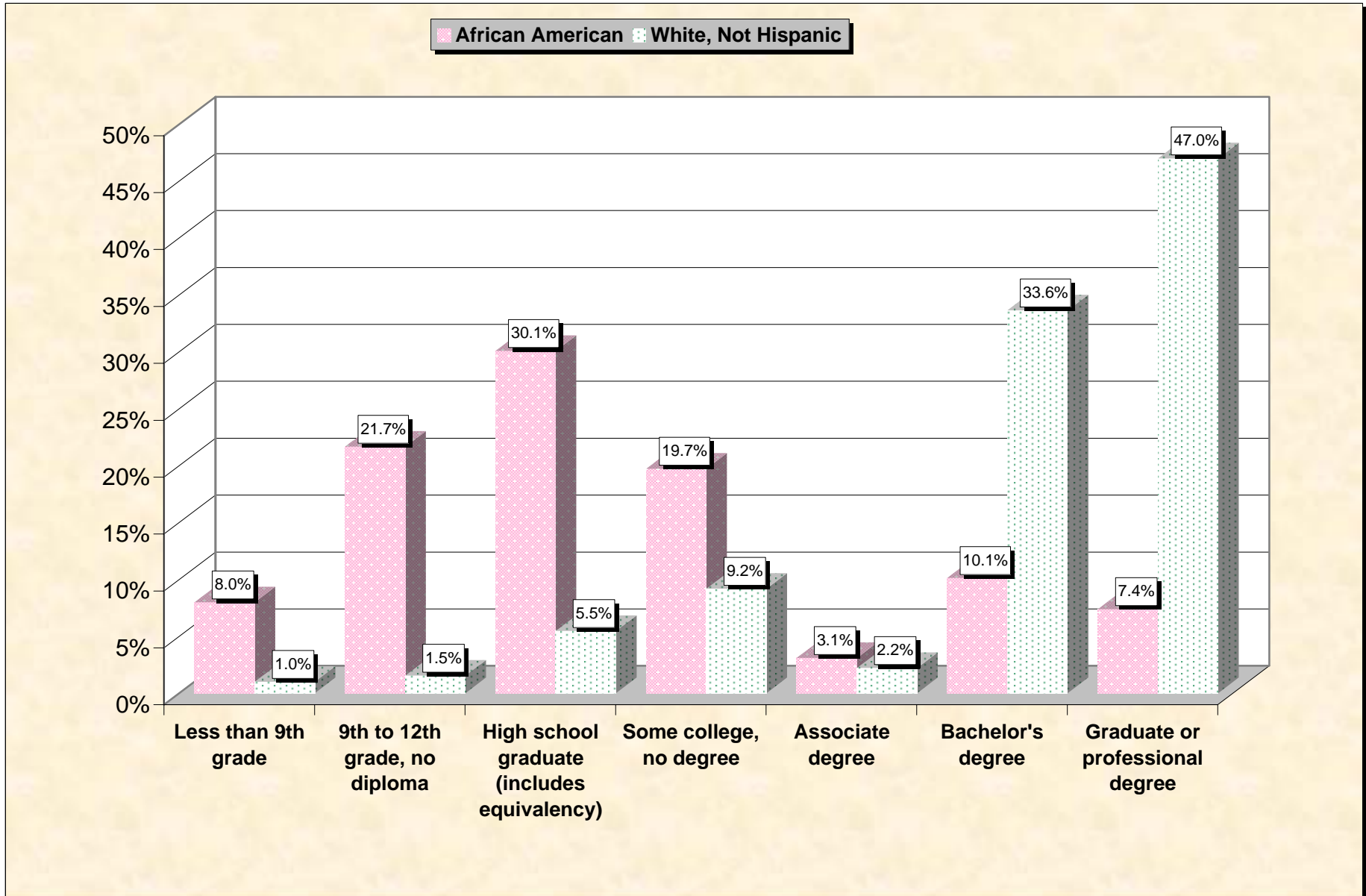

Chart 2 -- Private School Enrollment (3 years and over) District of Columbia



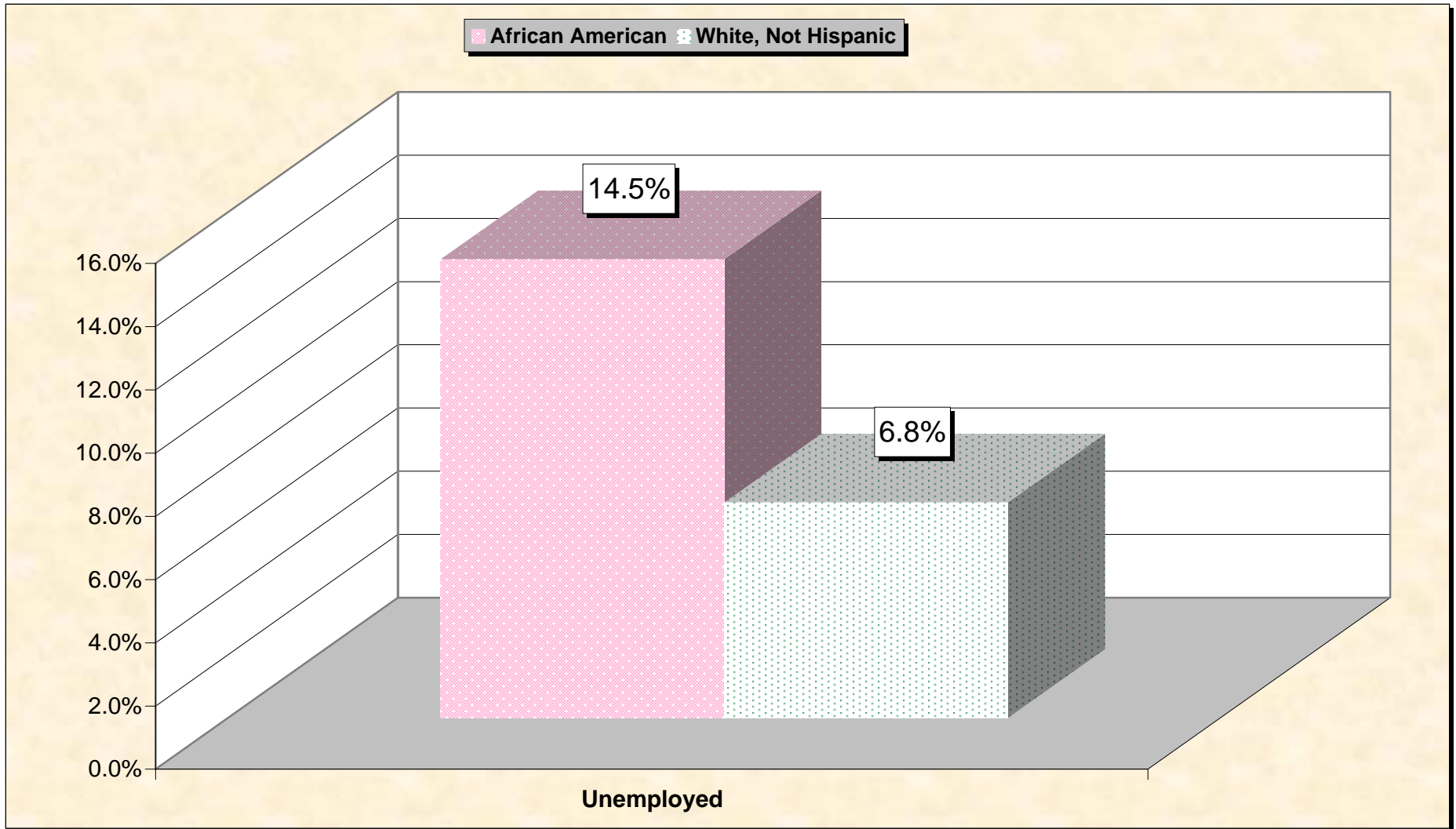

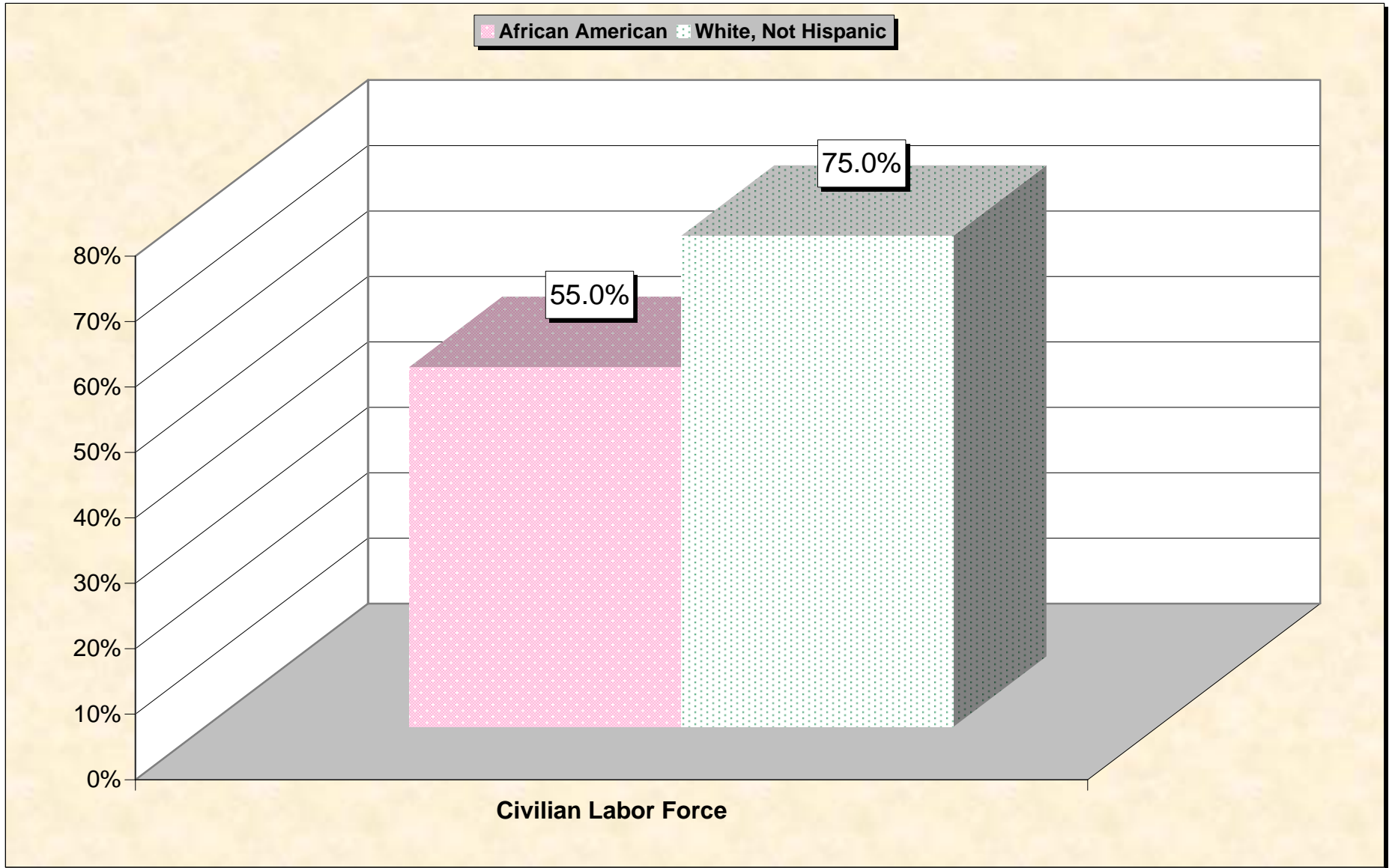
Chart 4 -- Unemployment Rate (Civilian Labor Force) District of Columbia

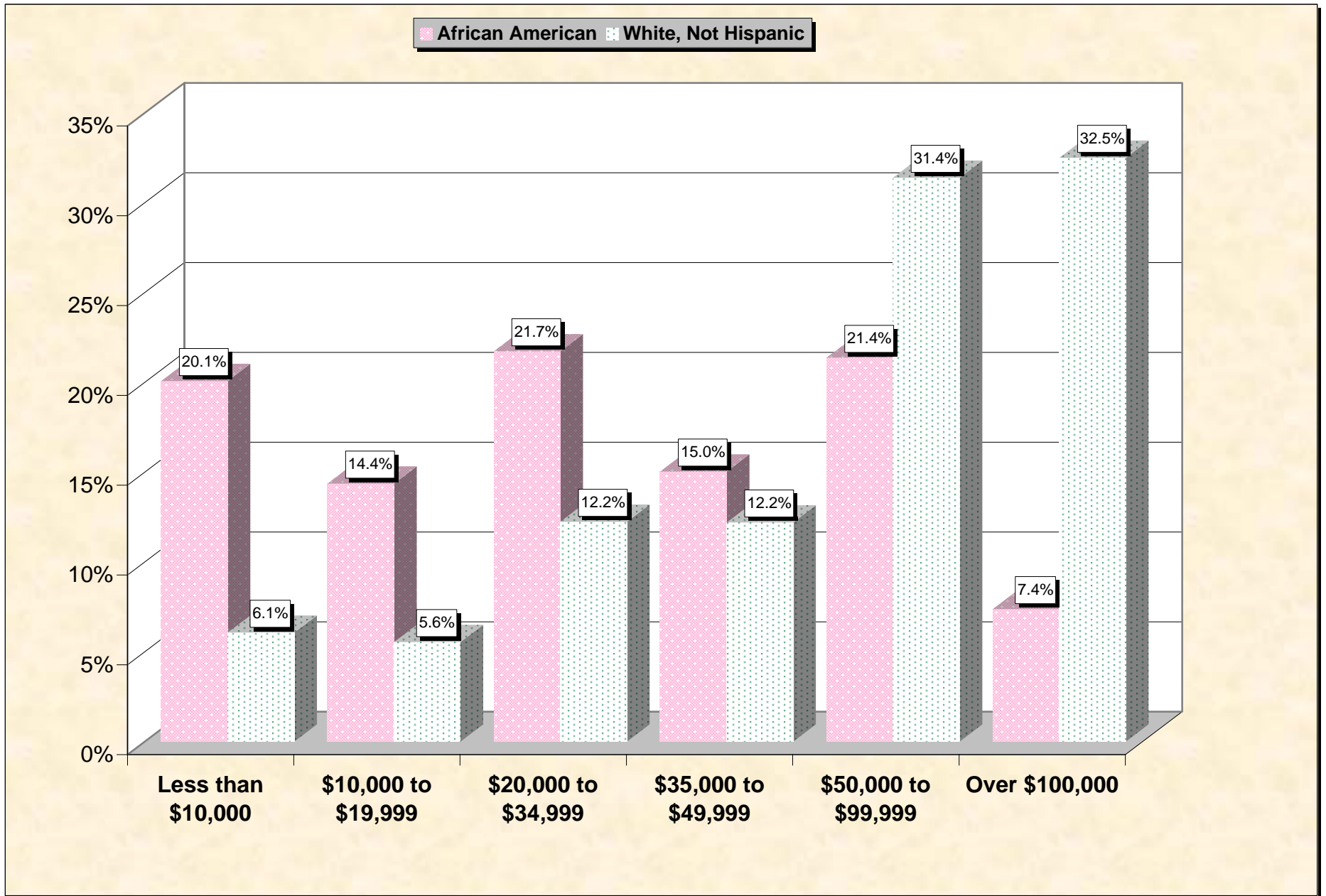
Chart 5 -- Labor Force Participation (Civilian Labor Force) District of Columbia

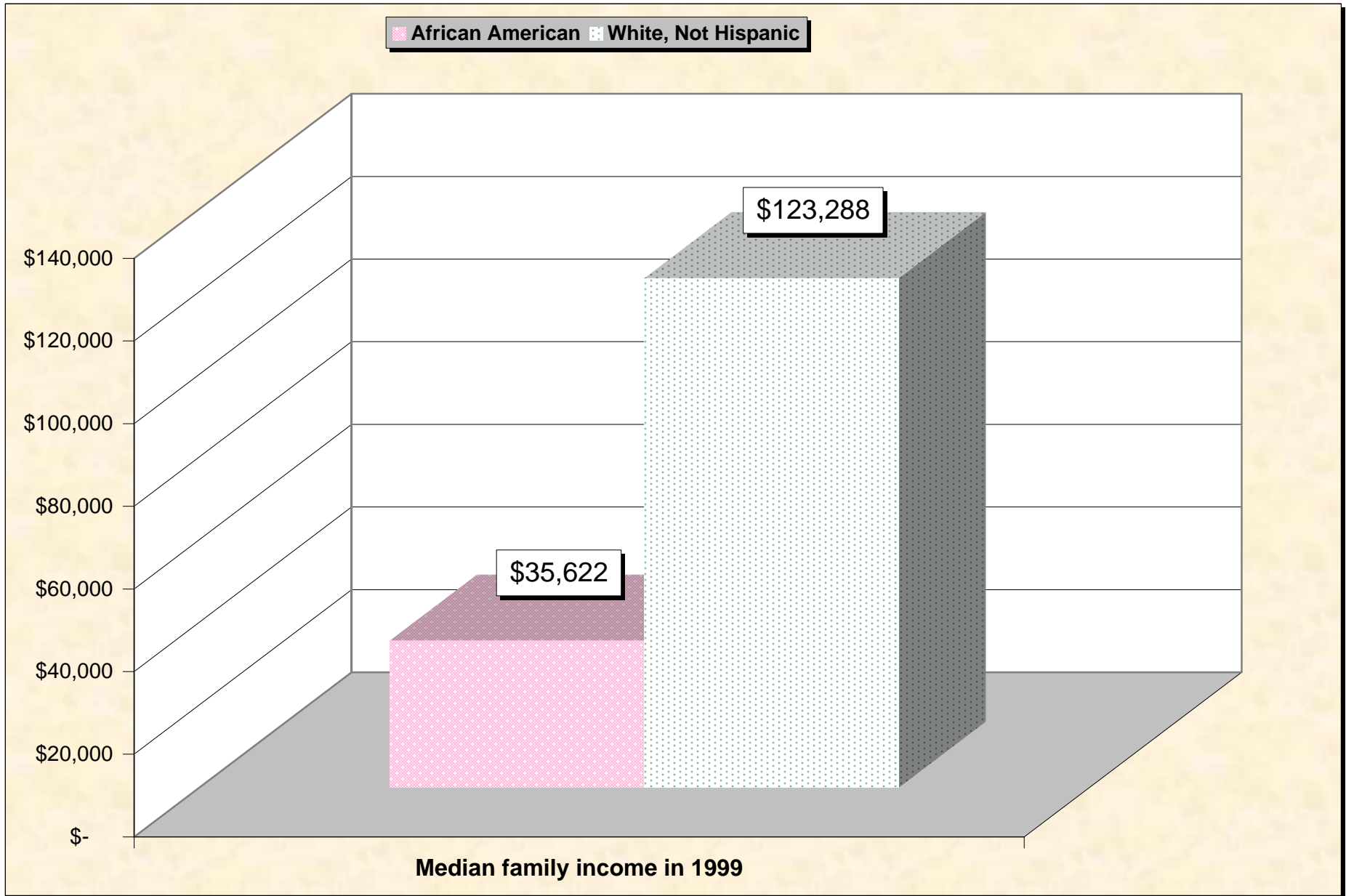
Chart 6 -- Household Income in 1999 District of Columbia

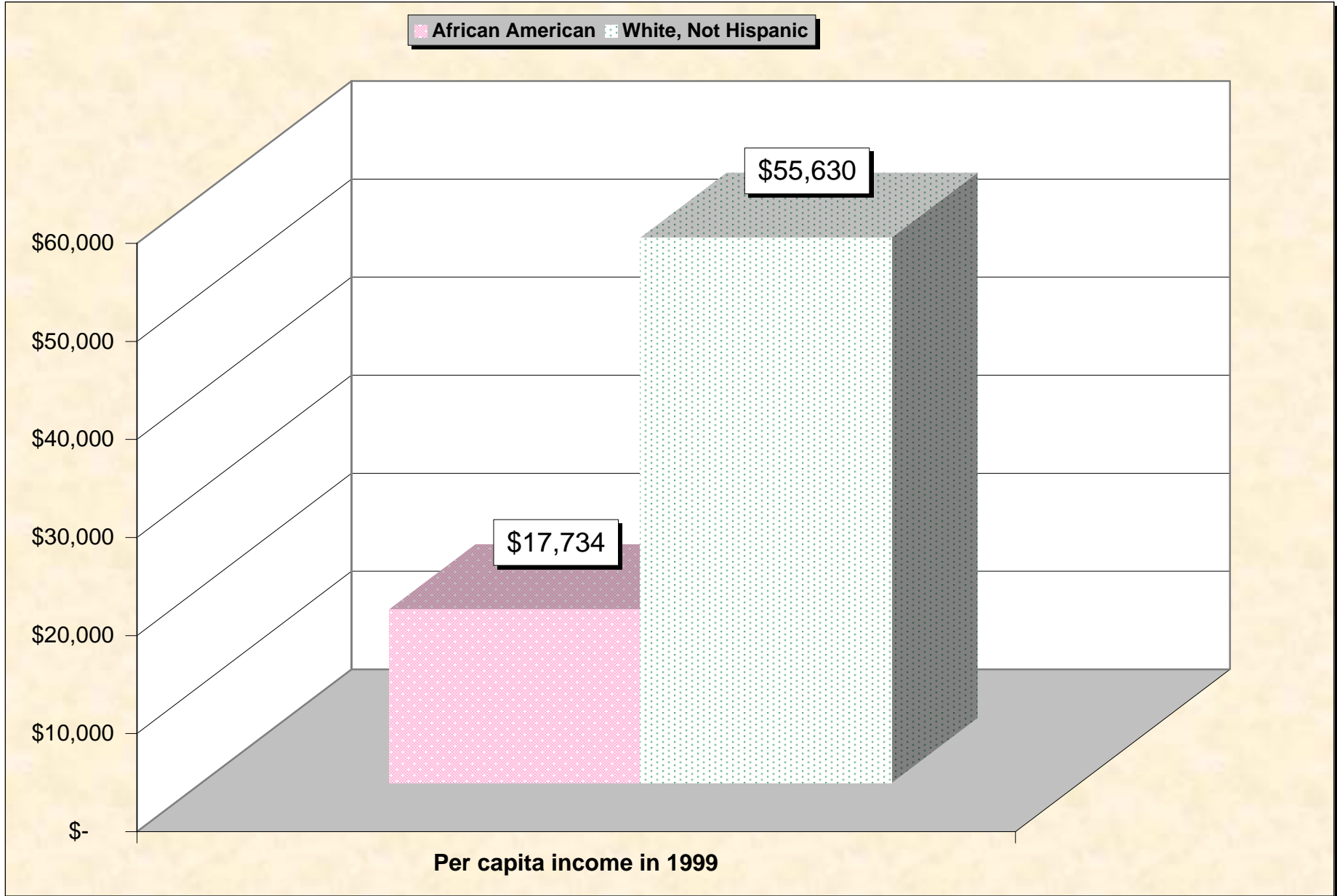
Chart 7 -- Median Family Income In 1999

Chart 8 -- Per Capita Income In 1999 District of Columbia



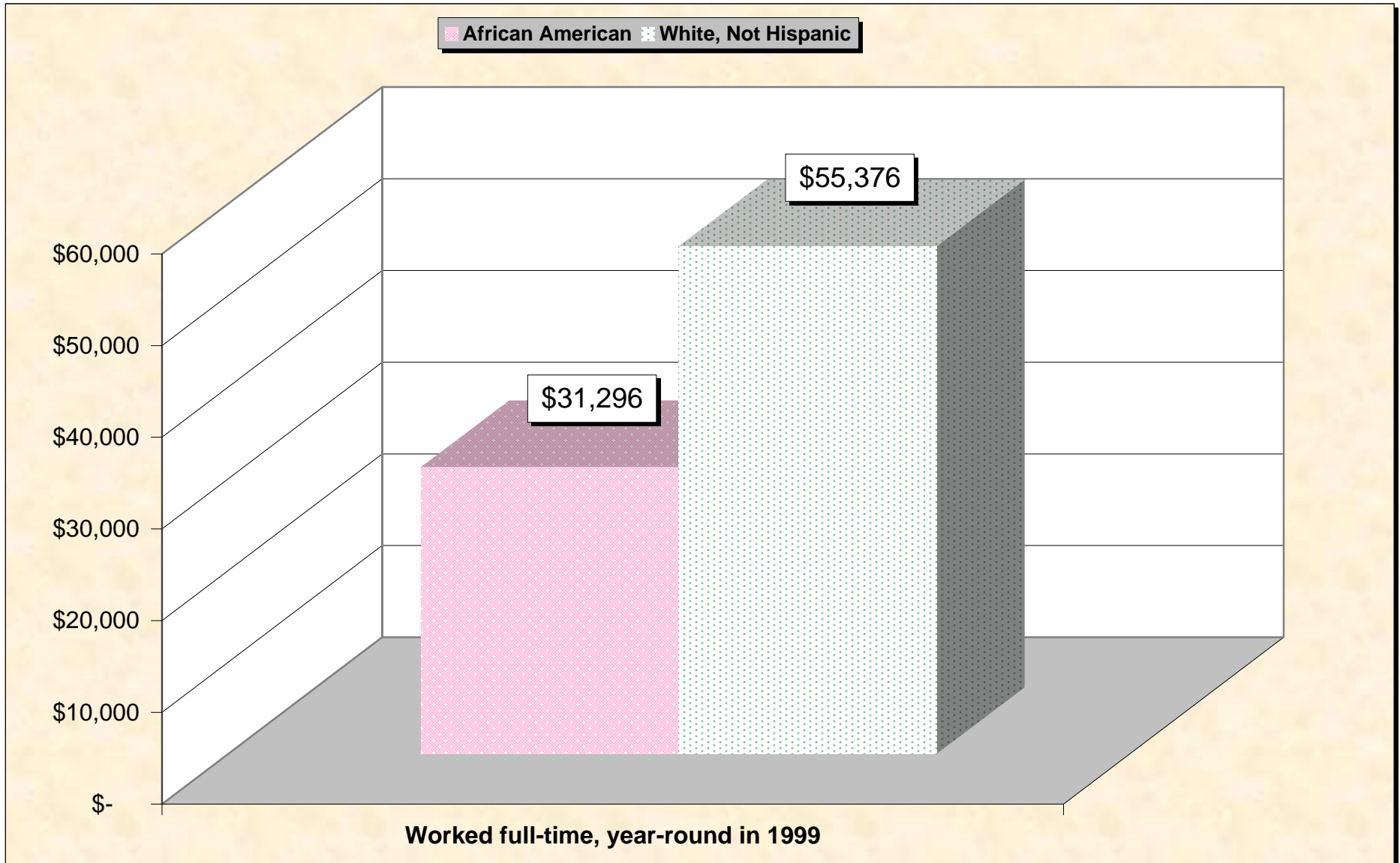

Chart 9 -- Income in 1999 Below Poverty Level by Age District of Columbia



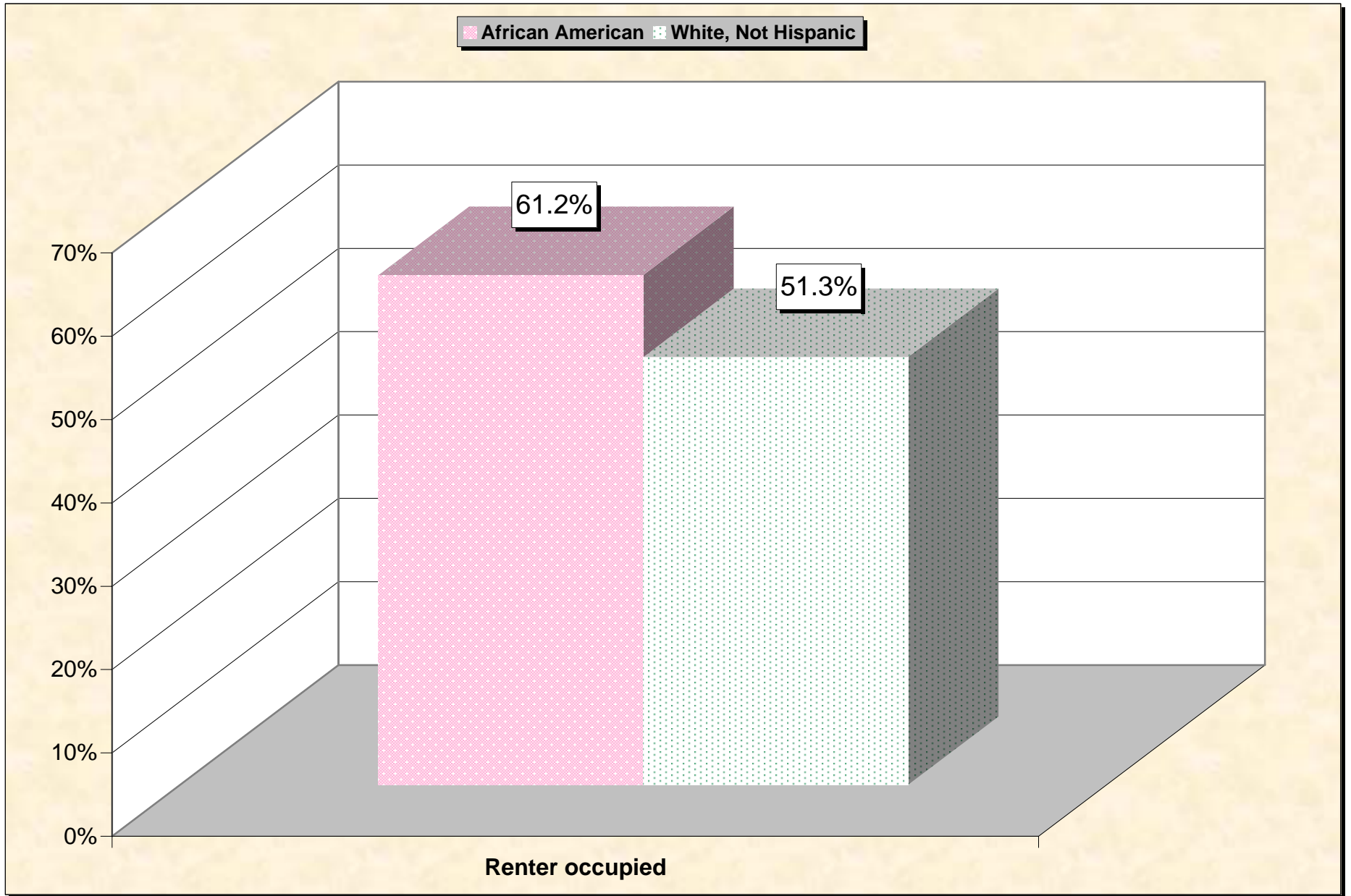

Chart 10 -- Median Earnings in 1999 District of Columbia



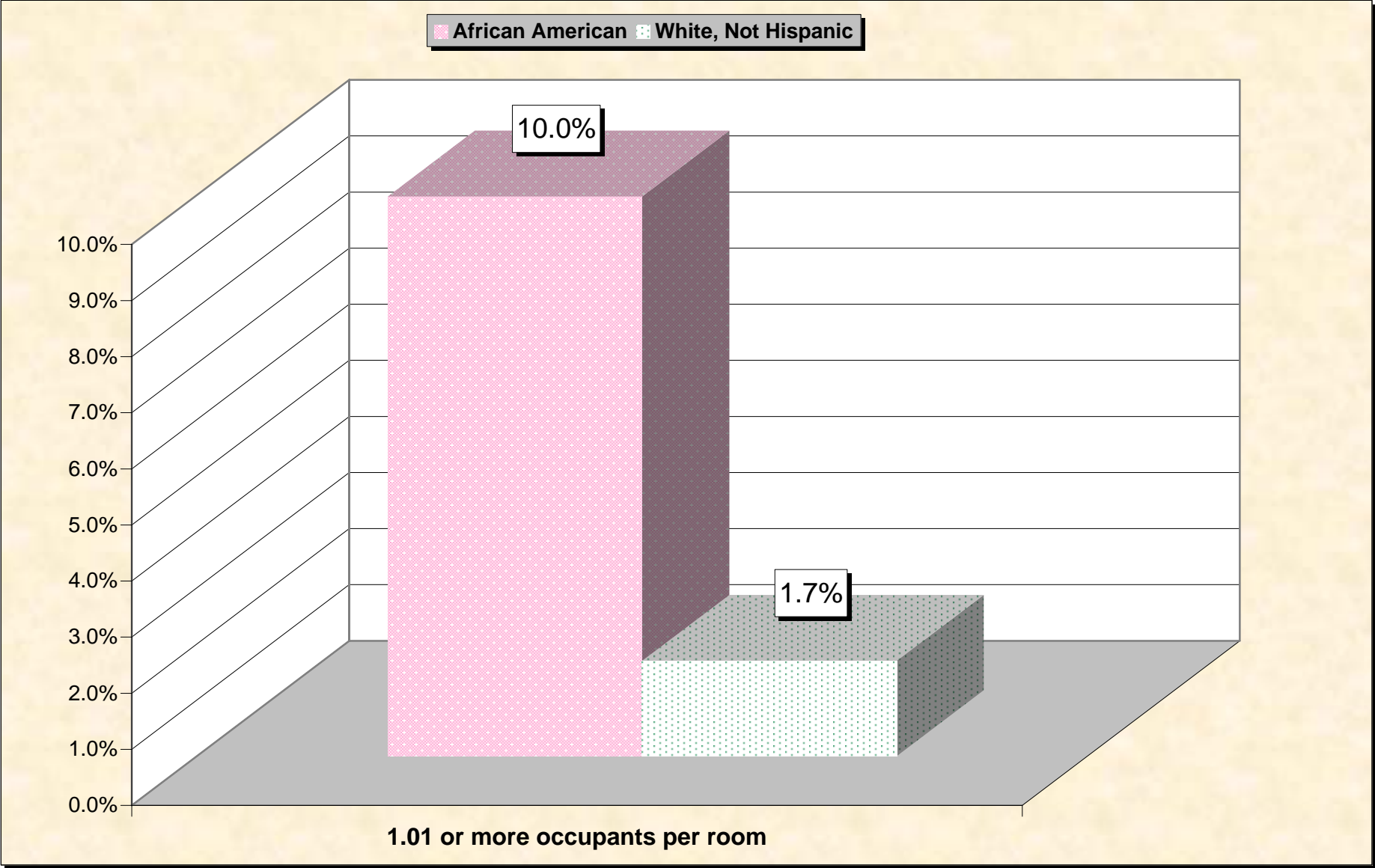

Chart 11 -- Renter-Occupied Housing District of Columbia



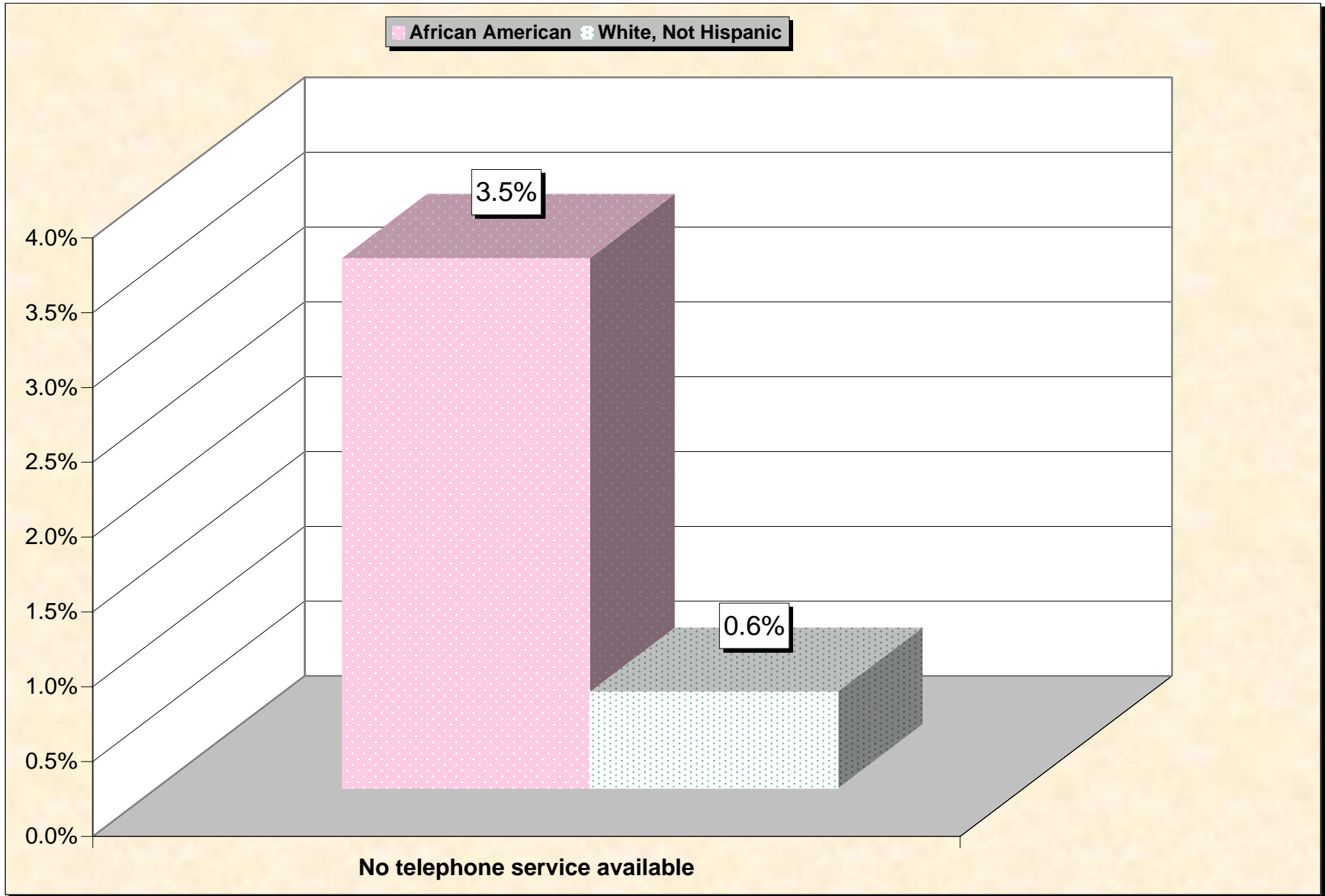

Chart 12 -- Occupants Per Room (Crowding) by Household District of Columbia



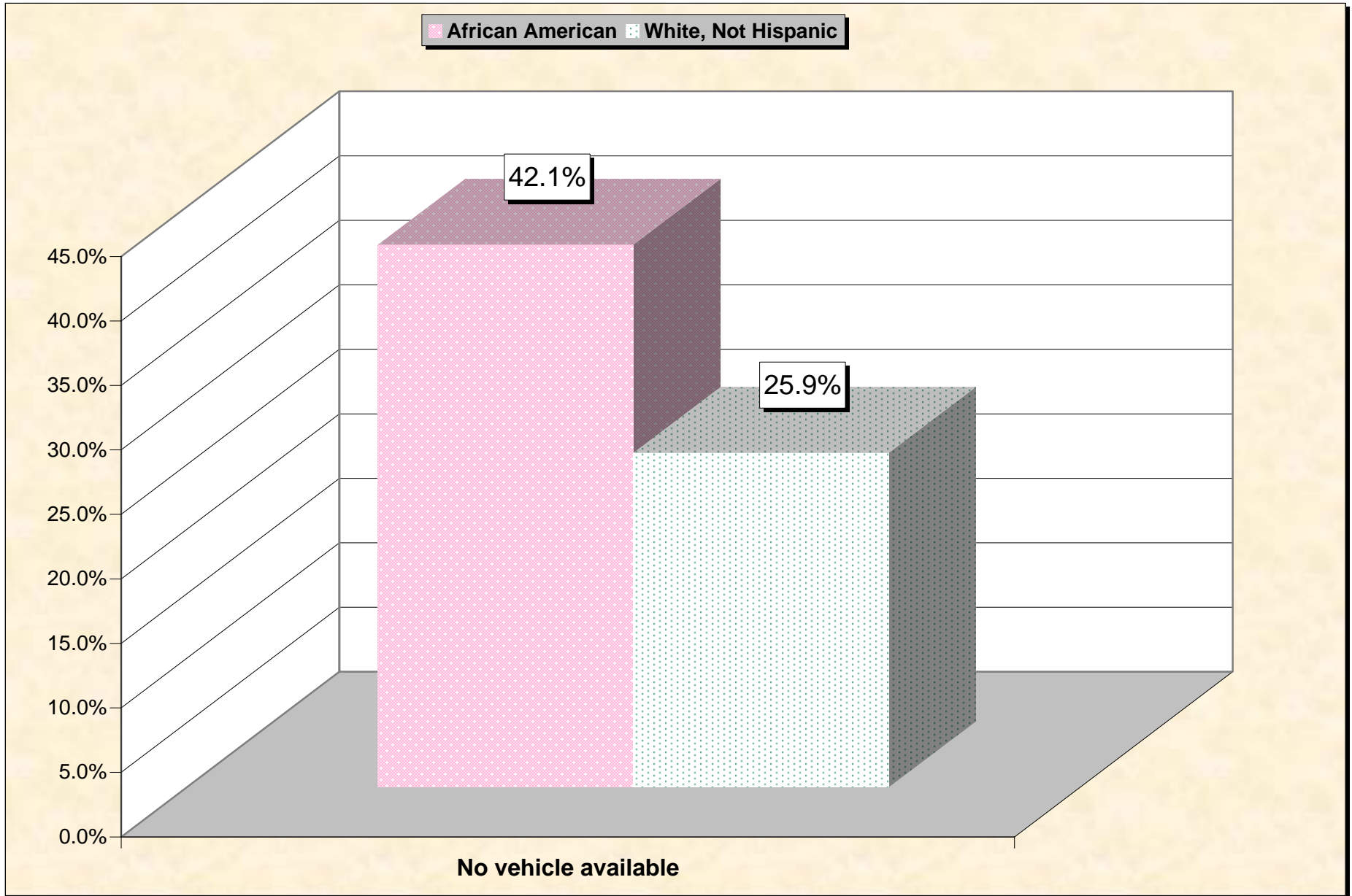

Chart 13 -- Lack of Telephone Service by Household District of Columbia



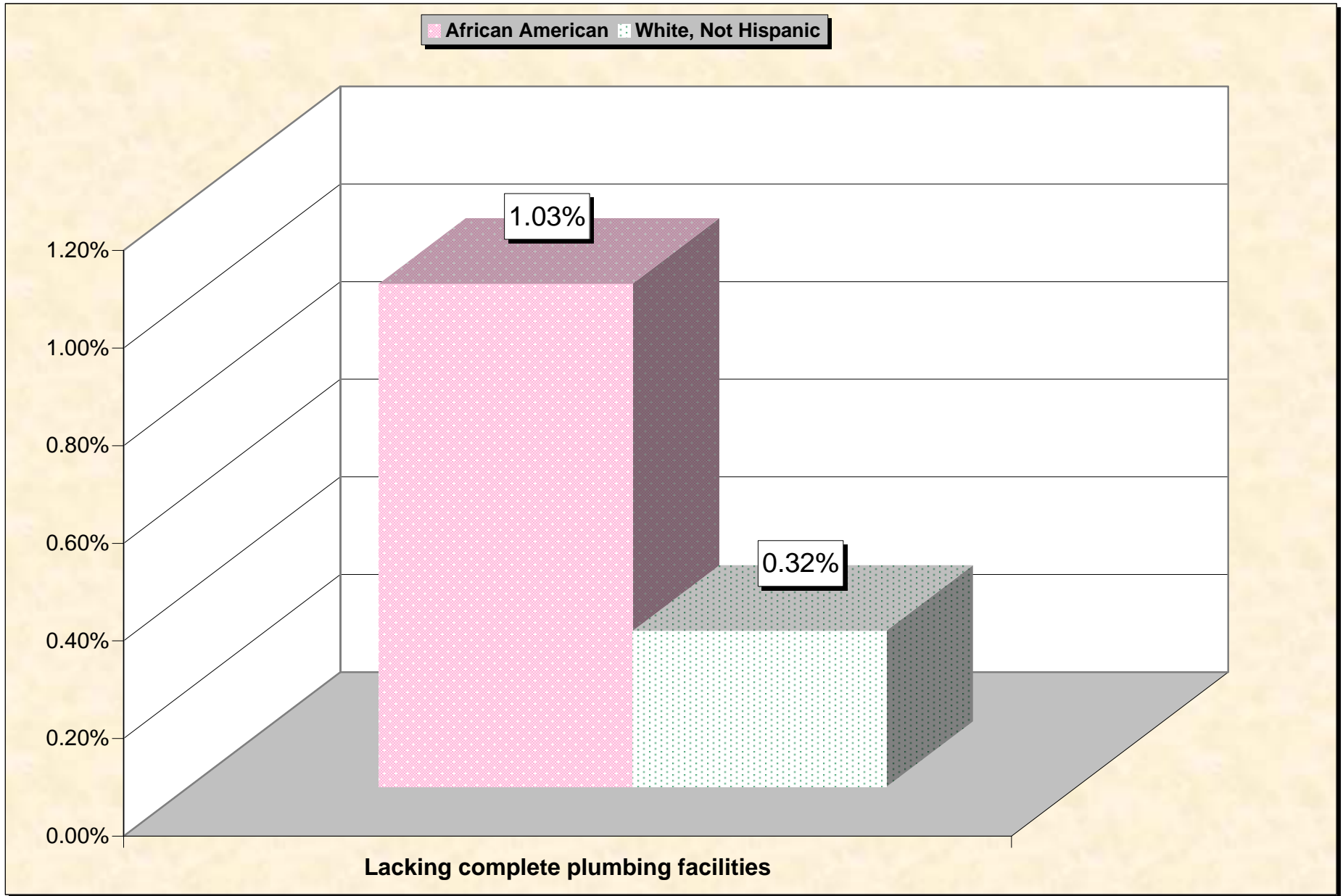

Chart 14 -- Lack of Vehicle By Household District of Columbia



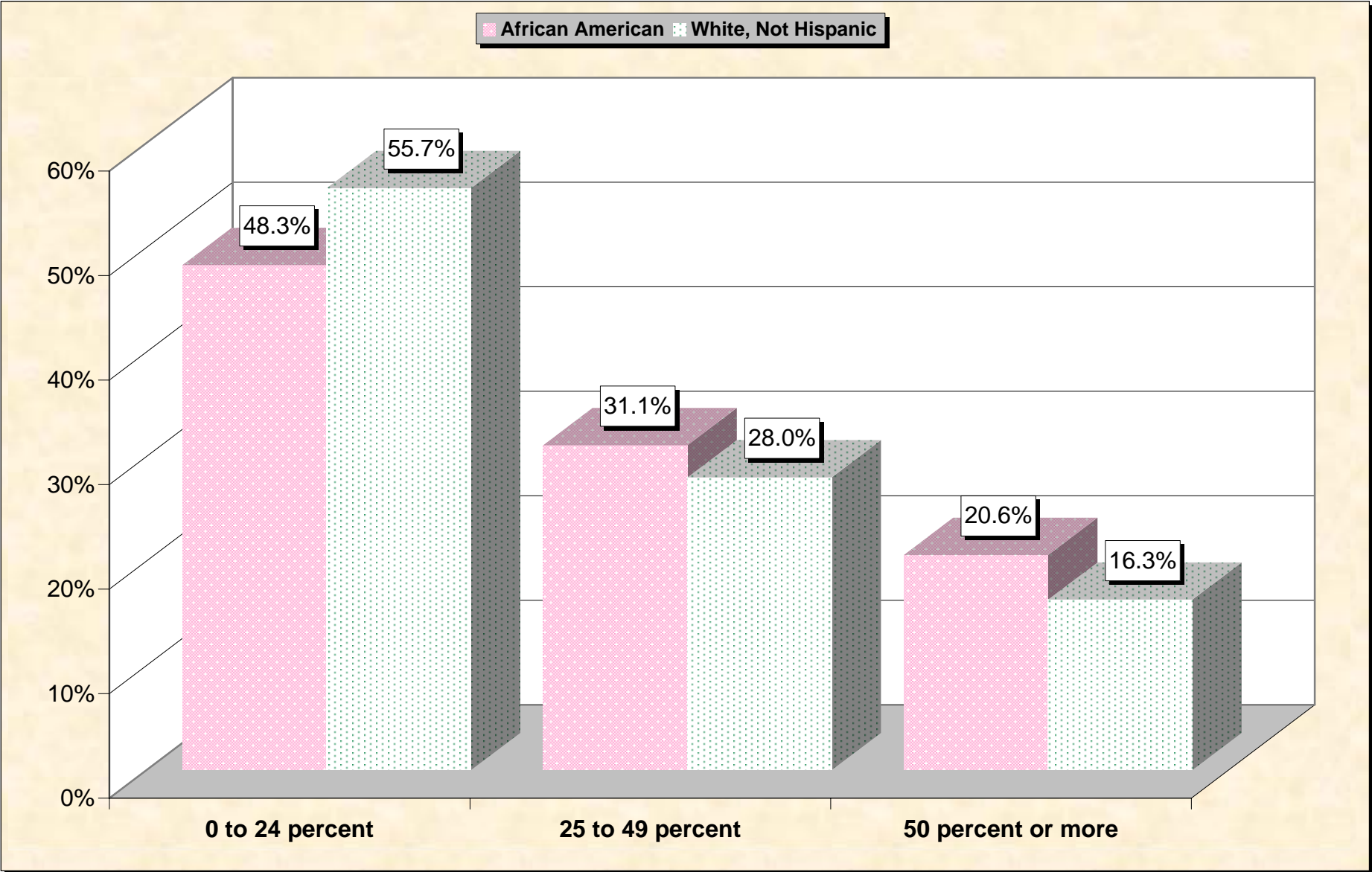

Chart 15 -- Lack of Plumbing By Household District of Columbia



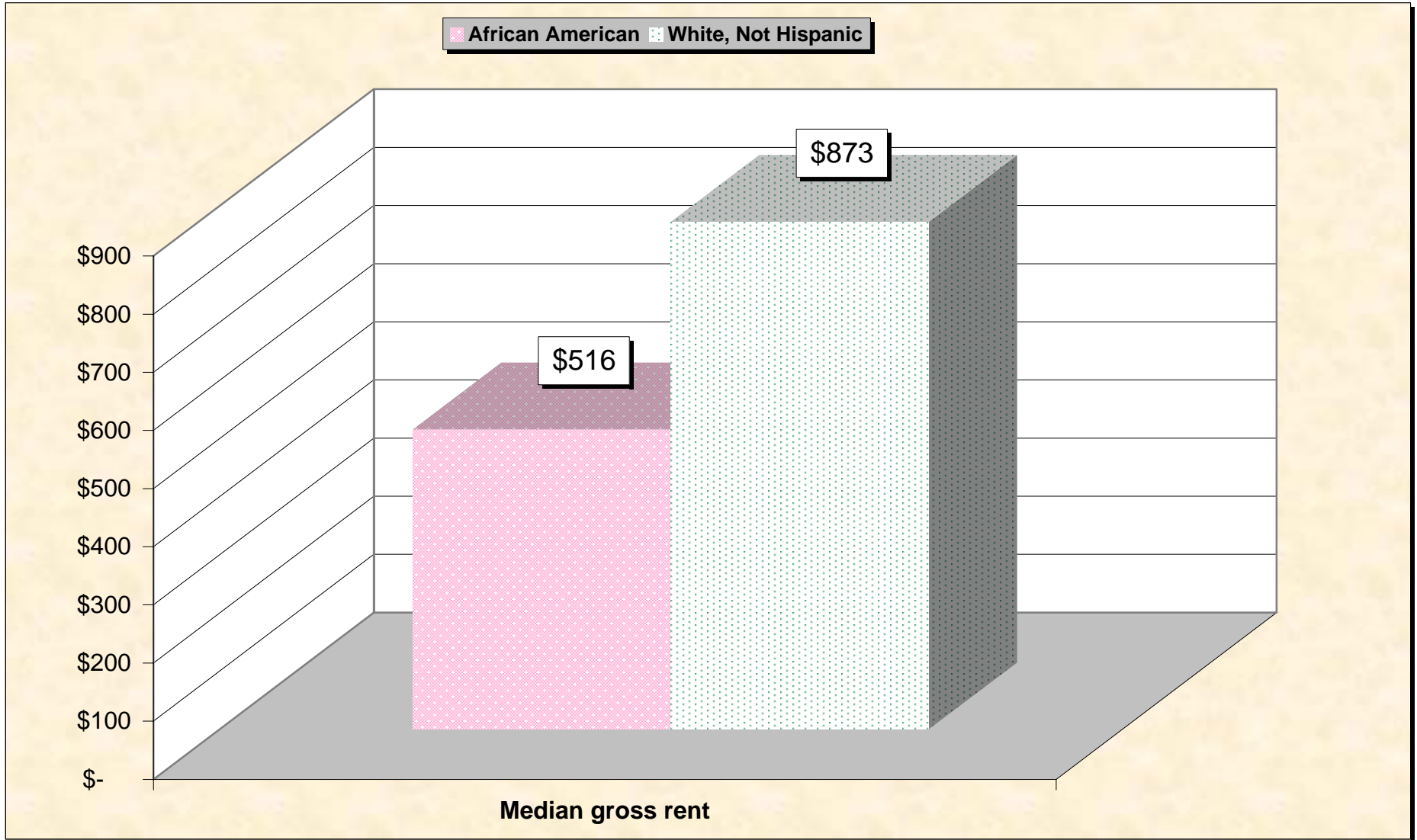

Chart 16 -- Gross Rent as a Percentage of Household Income in 1999 District of Columbia



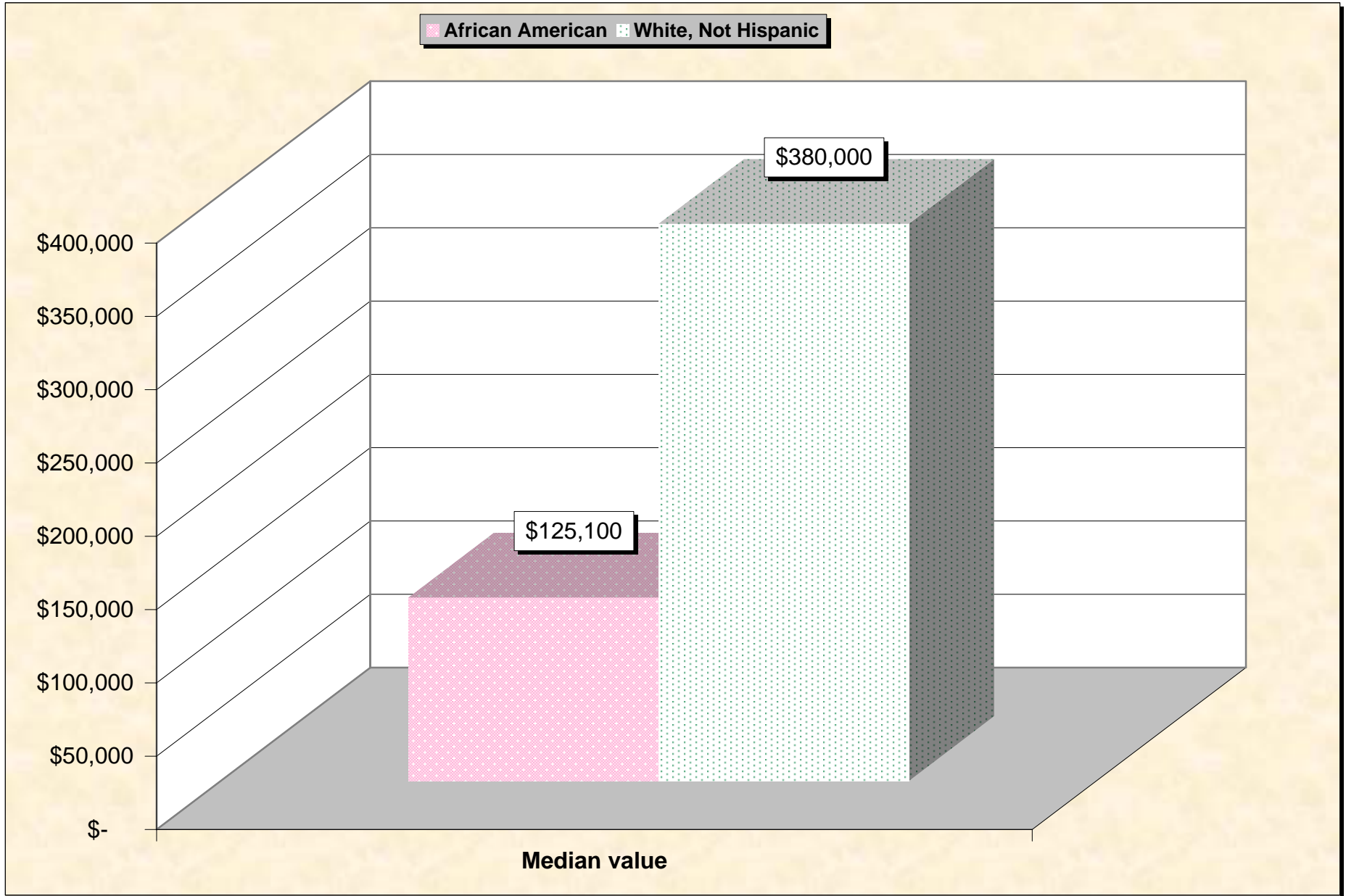
