


Chart 1 -- Single-Parent Family Households (Householder 15 to 64 years)






**Chart 4 -- Unemployment Rate (Civilian Labor Force) Iowa**


**Chart 5 -- Labor Force Participation (Civilian Labor Force) Iowa**



Chart 6 -- Household Income in 1999 Iowa





Chart 7 -- Median Family Income In 1999 Iowa





Chart 8 -- Per Capita Income In 1999 Iowa





Chart 9 -- Income in 1999 Below Poverty Level by Age Iowa





Chart 10 -- Median Earnings in 1999 Iowa





**Chart 11 -- Renter-Occupied Housing Iowa** 





Chart 12 -- Occupants Per Room (Crowding) by Household Iowa





Chart 13 -- Lack of Telephone Service by Household Iowa





Chart 14 -- Lack of Vehicle By Household Iowa





Chart 15 -- Lack of Plumbing By Household Iowa





Chart 16 -- Gross Rent as a Percentage of Household Income in 1999 Iowa




