



# Chart 1 -- Single-Parent Family Households (Householder 15 to 64 years) Maine





### Chart 2 -- Private School Enrollment (3 years and over) Maine






# Chart 4 -- Unemployment Rate (Civilian Labor Force) Maine


# **Chart 5 -- Labor Force Participation (Civilian Labor Force) Maine**


### Chart 6 -- Household Income in 1999 Maine


# **Chart 7 -- Median Family Income In 1999**




# Chart 9 -- Income in 1999 Below Poverty Level by Age Maine

# Chart 10 -- Median Earnings in 1999




# **Chart 11 -- Renter-Occupied Housing**



# Chart 12 -- Occupants Per Room (Crowding) by Household Maine






# Chart 14 -- Lack of Vehicle By Household Maine


# **Chart 15 -- Lack of Plumbing By Household**



# Chart 16 -- Gross Rent as a Percentage of Household Income in 1999 Maine




