


Chart 1 -- Single-Parent Family Households (Householder 15 to 64 years)






Chart 4 -- Unemployment Rate (Civilian Labor Force)


Chart 5 -- Labor Force Participation (Civilian Labor Force)



# Chart 6 -- Household Income in 1999 District of Columbia







# Chart 8 -- Per Capita Income In 1999 District of Columbia





Chart 9 -- Income in 1999 Below Poverty Level by Age District of Columbia





# Chart 10 -- Median Earnings in 1999 District of Columbia





# Chart 11 -- Renter-Occupied Housing District of Columbia





Chart 12 -- Occupants Per Room (Crowding) by Household District of Columbia





# Chart 13 -- Lack of Telephone Service by Household District of Columbia





# Chart 14 -- Lack of Vehicle By Household District of Columbia





District of Columbia






