


Chart 1 -- Single-Parent Family Households (Householder 15 to 64 years)






Chart 4 -- Unemployment Rate (Civilian Labor Force)


Chart 5 -- Labor Force Participation (Civilian Labor Force)



Chart 6 -- Household Income in 1999 Minnesota





Chart 7 -- Median Family Income In 1999 Minnesota





Chart 8 -- Per Capita Income In 1999 Minnesota





Chart 9 -- Income in 1999 Below Poverty Level by Age Minnesota





Chart 10 -- Median Earnings in 1999 Minnesota





Chart 11 -- Renter-Occupied Housing Minnesota





Chart 12 -- Occupants Per Room (Crowding) by Household Minnesota





Chart 13 -- Lack of Telephone Service by Household Minnesota





Chart 14 -- Lack of Vehicle By Household Minnesota





Chart 15 -- Lack of Plumbing By Household Minnesota





Chart 16 -- Gross Rent as a Percentage of Household Income in 1999 Minnesota




