




# Chart 1 -- Single-Parent Family Households (Householder 15 to 64 years) North Dakota

## Chart 2 -- Private School Enrollment (3 years and over)




# Chart 3 -- Educational Attainment (25 years and over)


**Chart 4 -- Unemployment Rate (Civilian Labor Force)**


# Chart 5 -- Labor Force Participation (Civilian Labor Force) North Dakota


# Chart 6 -- Household Income in 1999 North Dakota

# Chart 7 -- Median Family Income In 1999




# Chart 8 -- Per Capita Income In 1999


# **Chart 9 -- Income in 1999 Below Poverty Level by Age North Dakota**


# Chart 10 -- Median Earnings in 1999



# Chart 11 -- Renter-Occupied Housing North Dakota





# Chart 12 -- Occupants Per Room (Crowding) by Household North Dakota





# Chart 13 -- Lack of Telephone Service by Household North Dakota





# Chart 14 -- Lack of Vehicle By Household North Dakota





# Chart 15 -- Lack of Plumbing By Household North Dakota






