

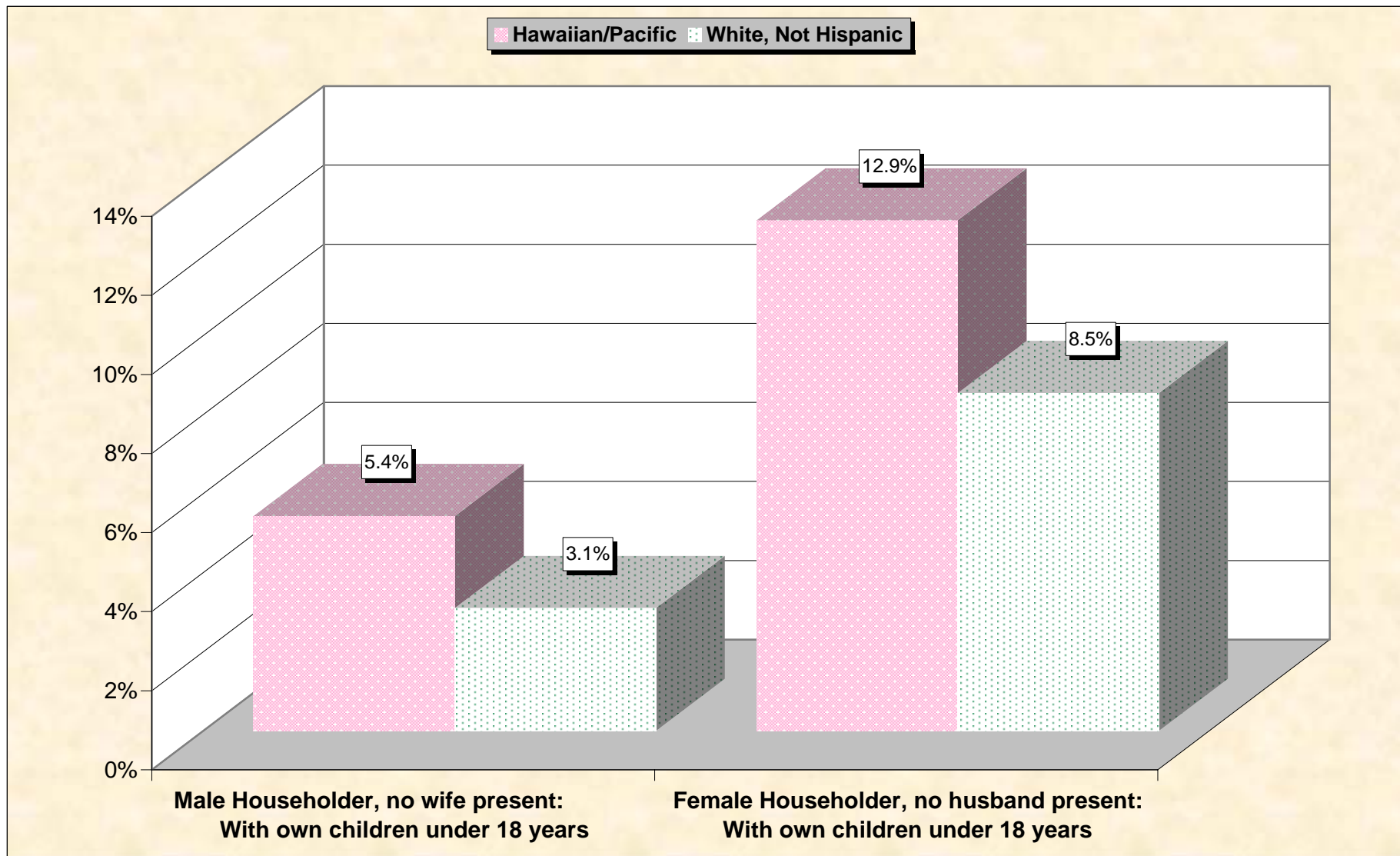

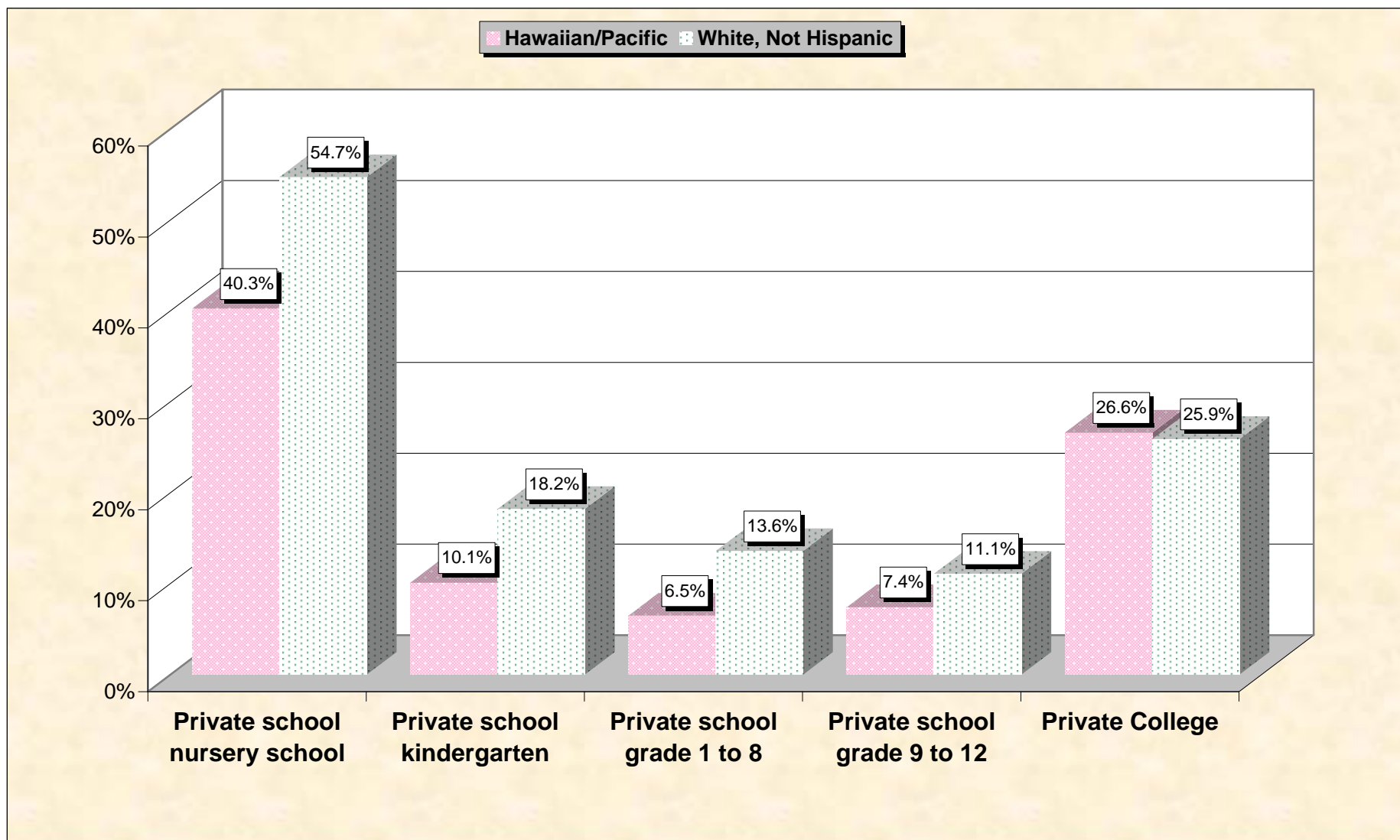
Chart 1 -- Single-Parent Family Households (Householder 15 to 64 years) United States

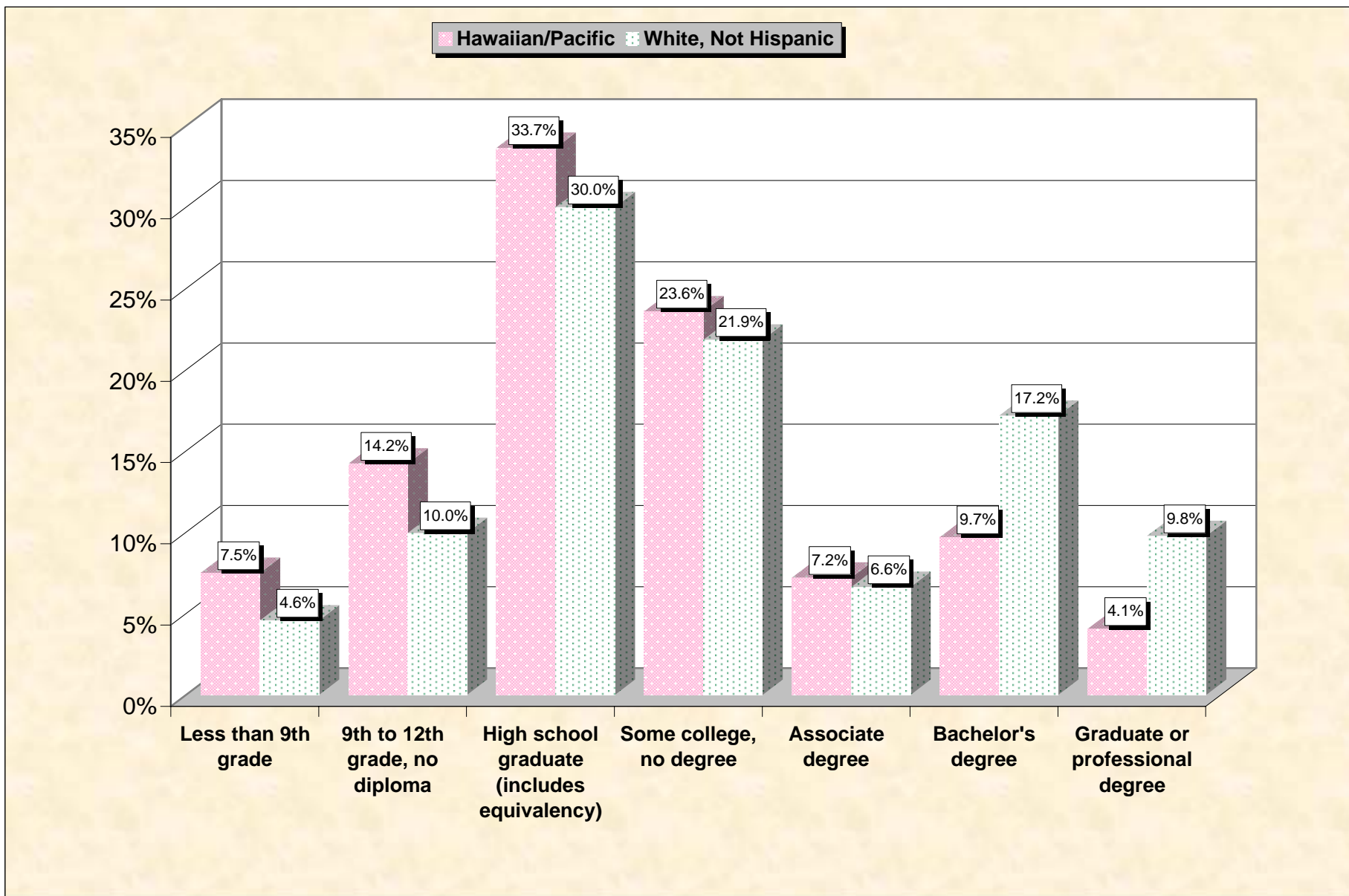
Chart 2 -- Private School Enrollment (3 years and over)

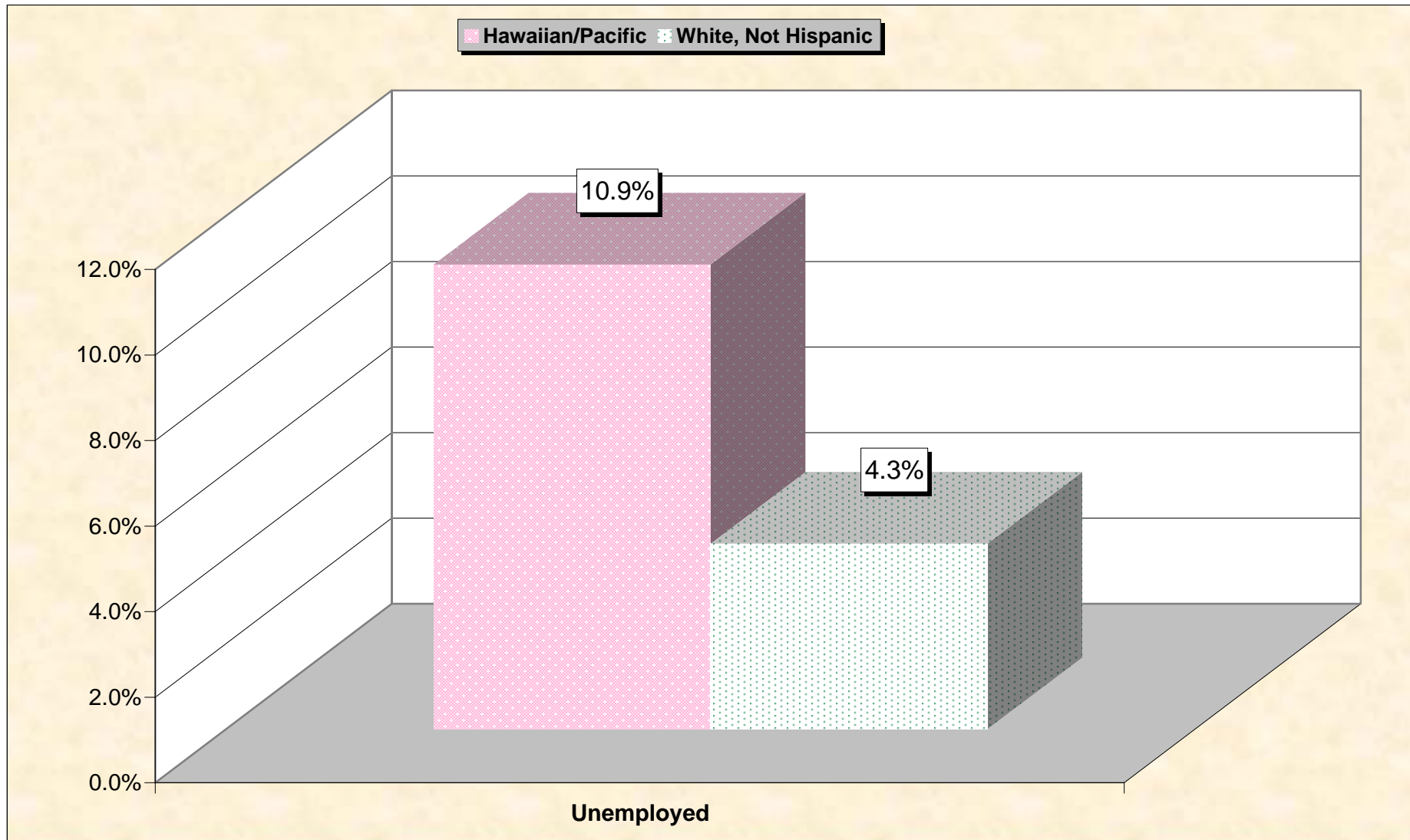

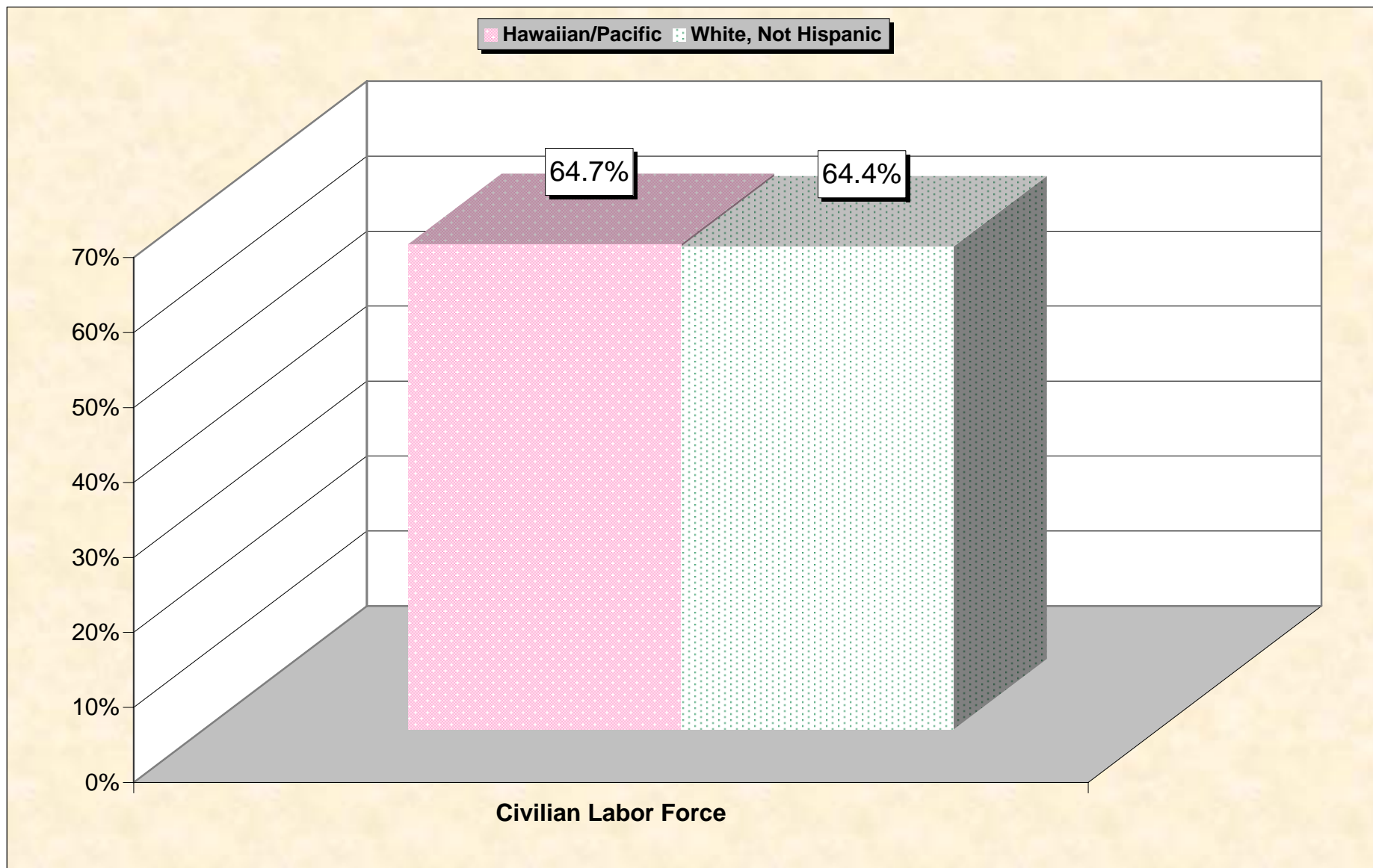
Chart 4 -- Unemployment Rate (Civilian Labor Force) United States

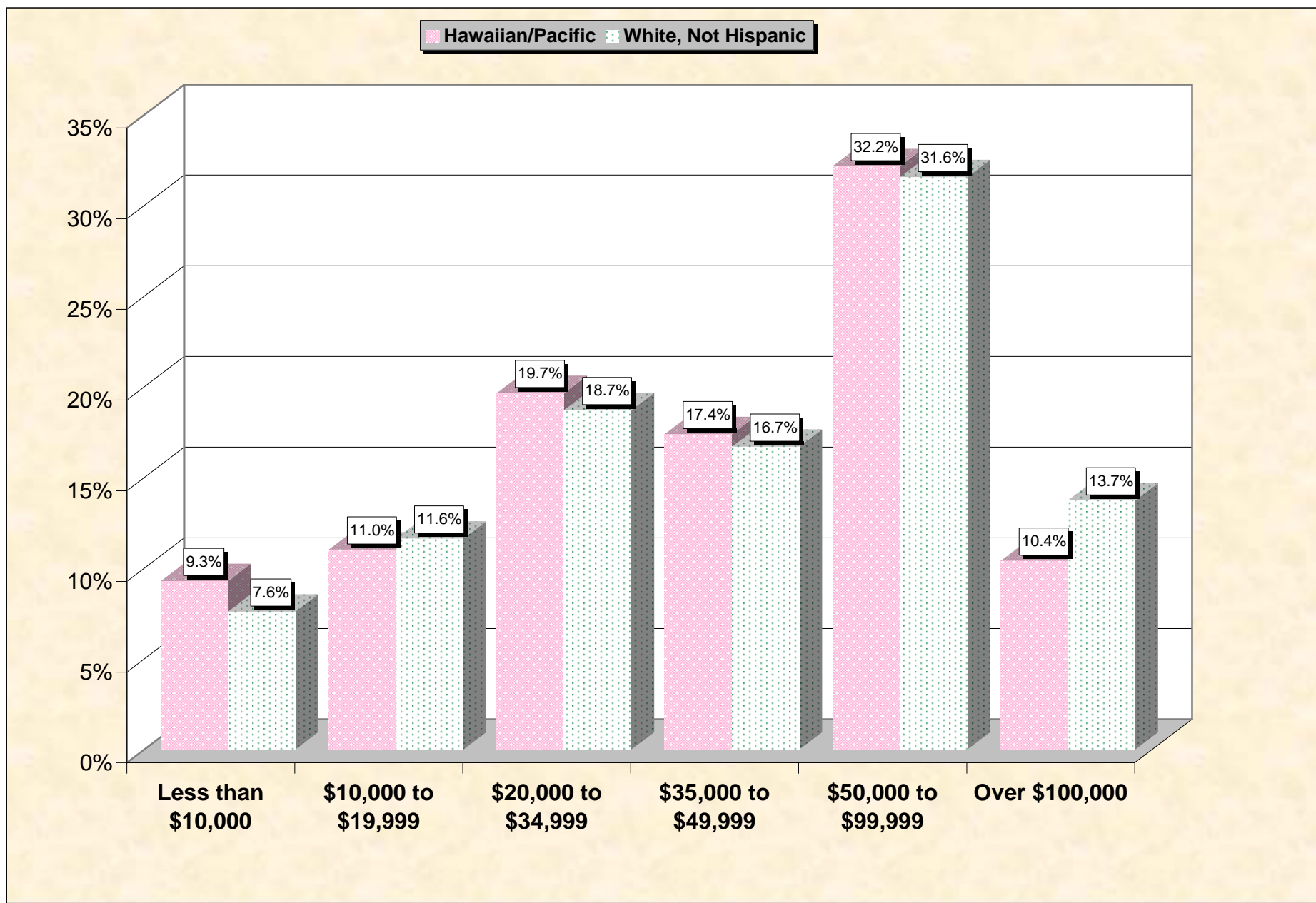
Chart 5 -- Labor Force Participation (Civilian Labor Force) United States

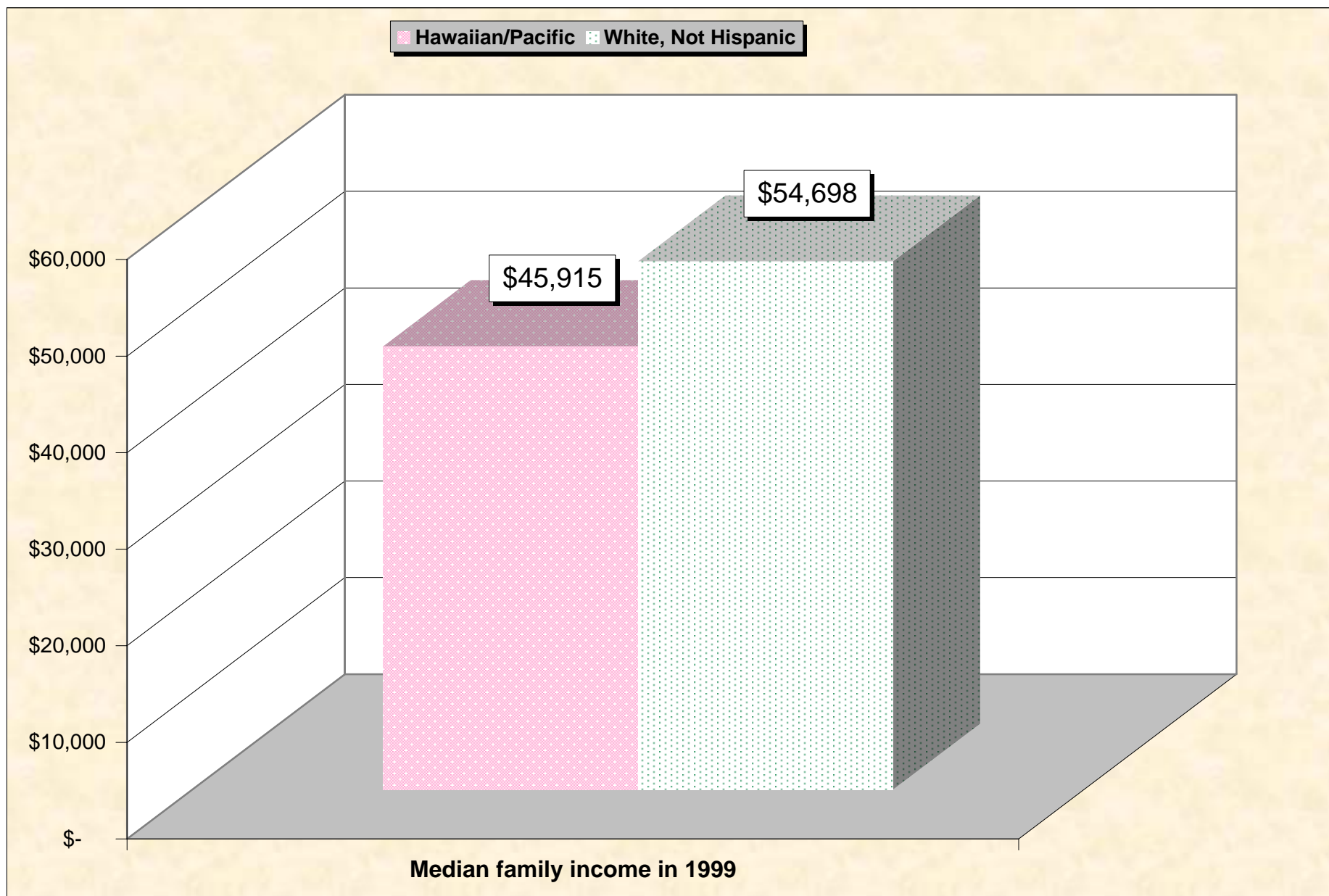

Chart 6 -- Household Income in 1999 United States



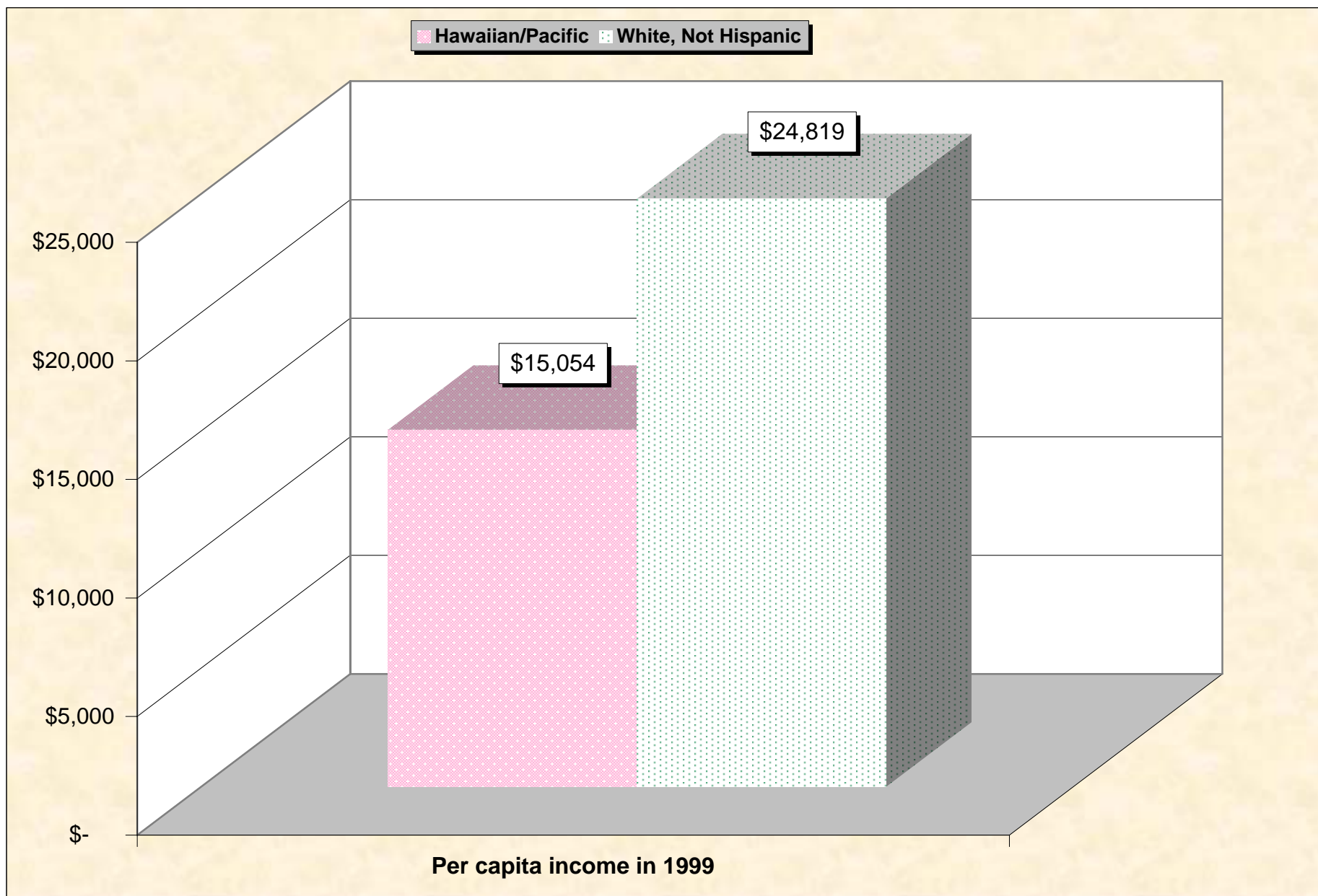

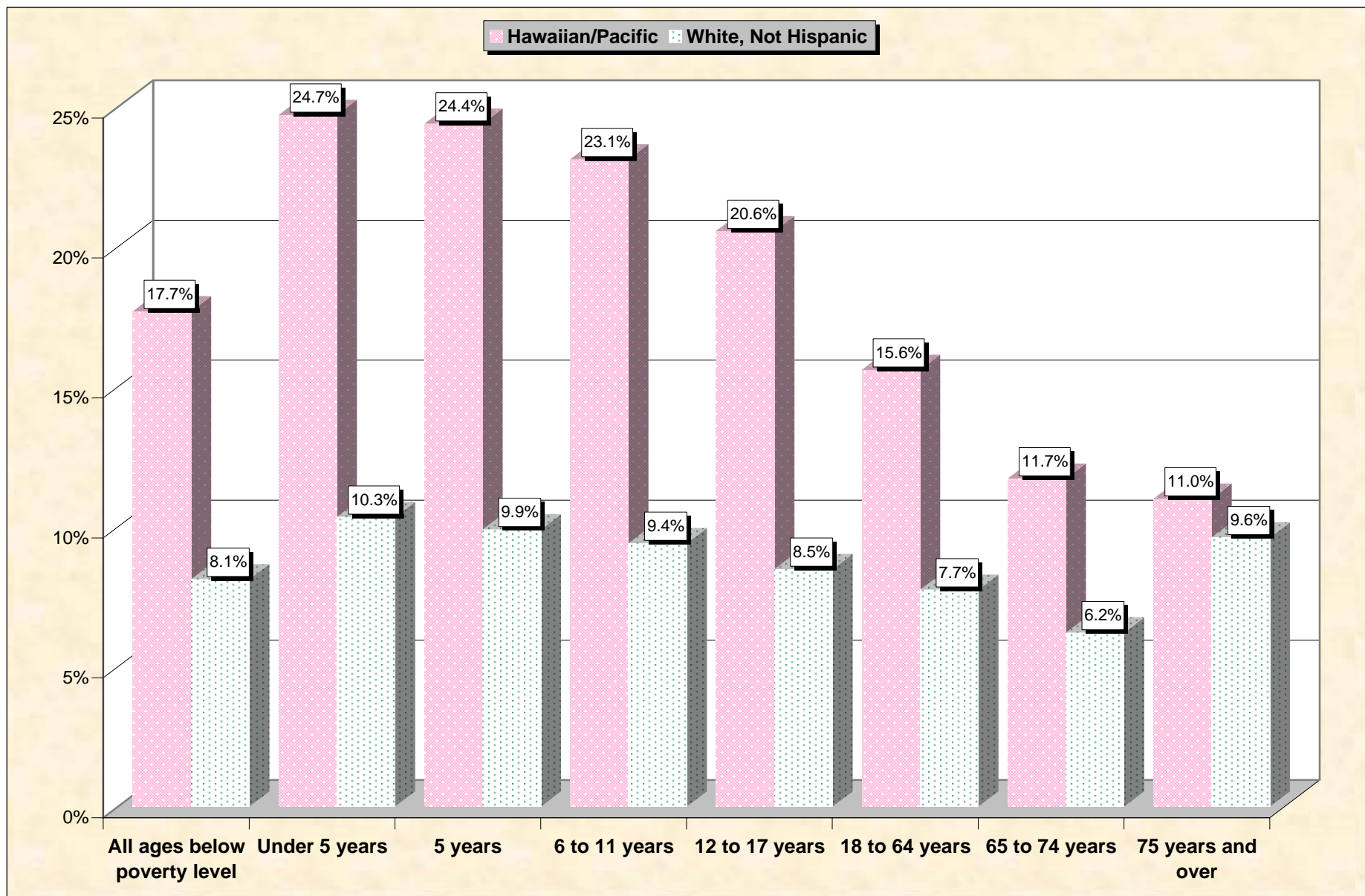

Chart 8 -- Per Capita Income In 1999 United States



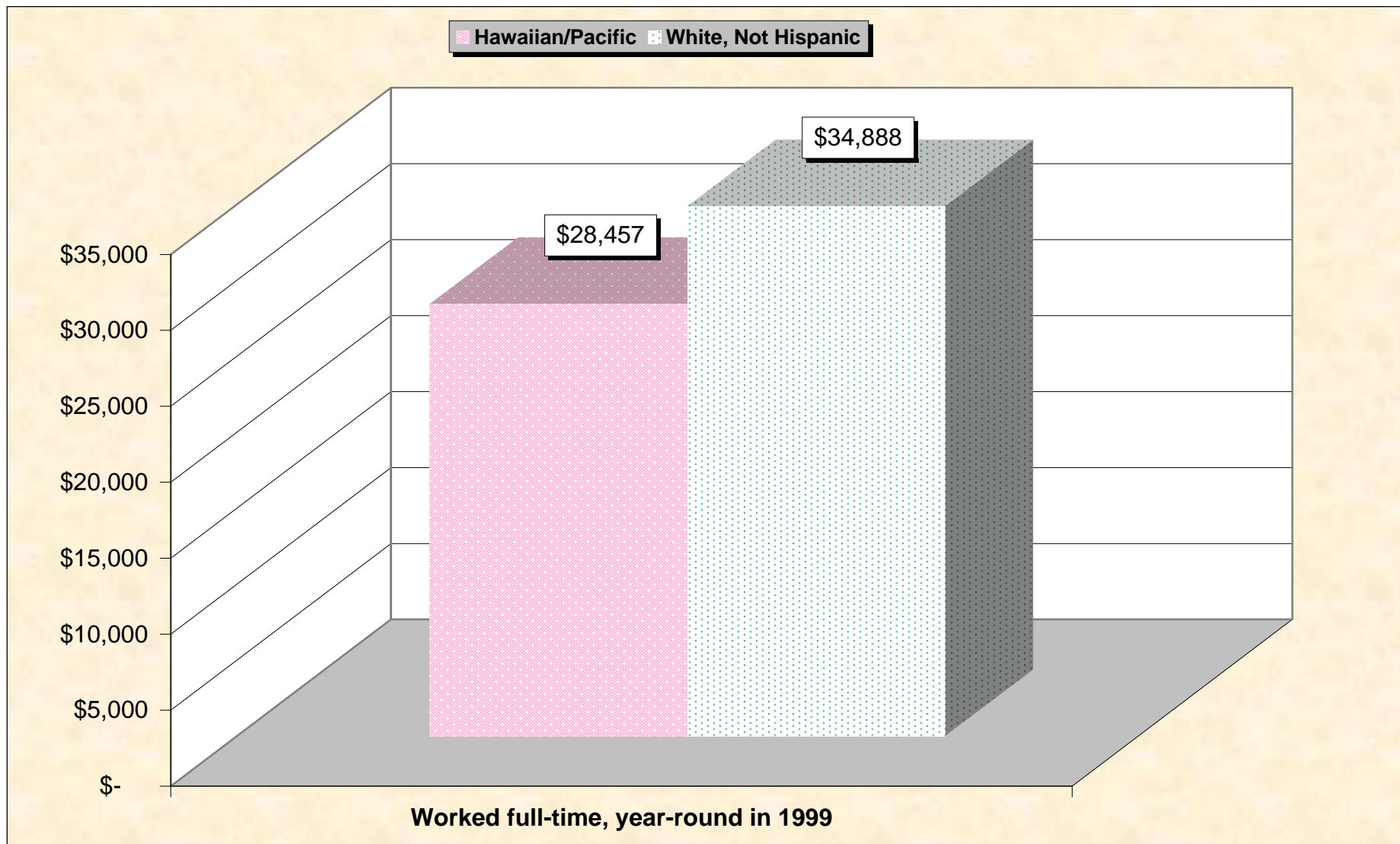

Chart 9 -- Income in 1999 Below Poverty Level by Age United States



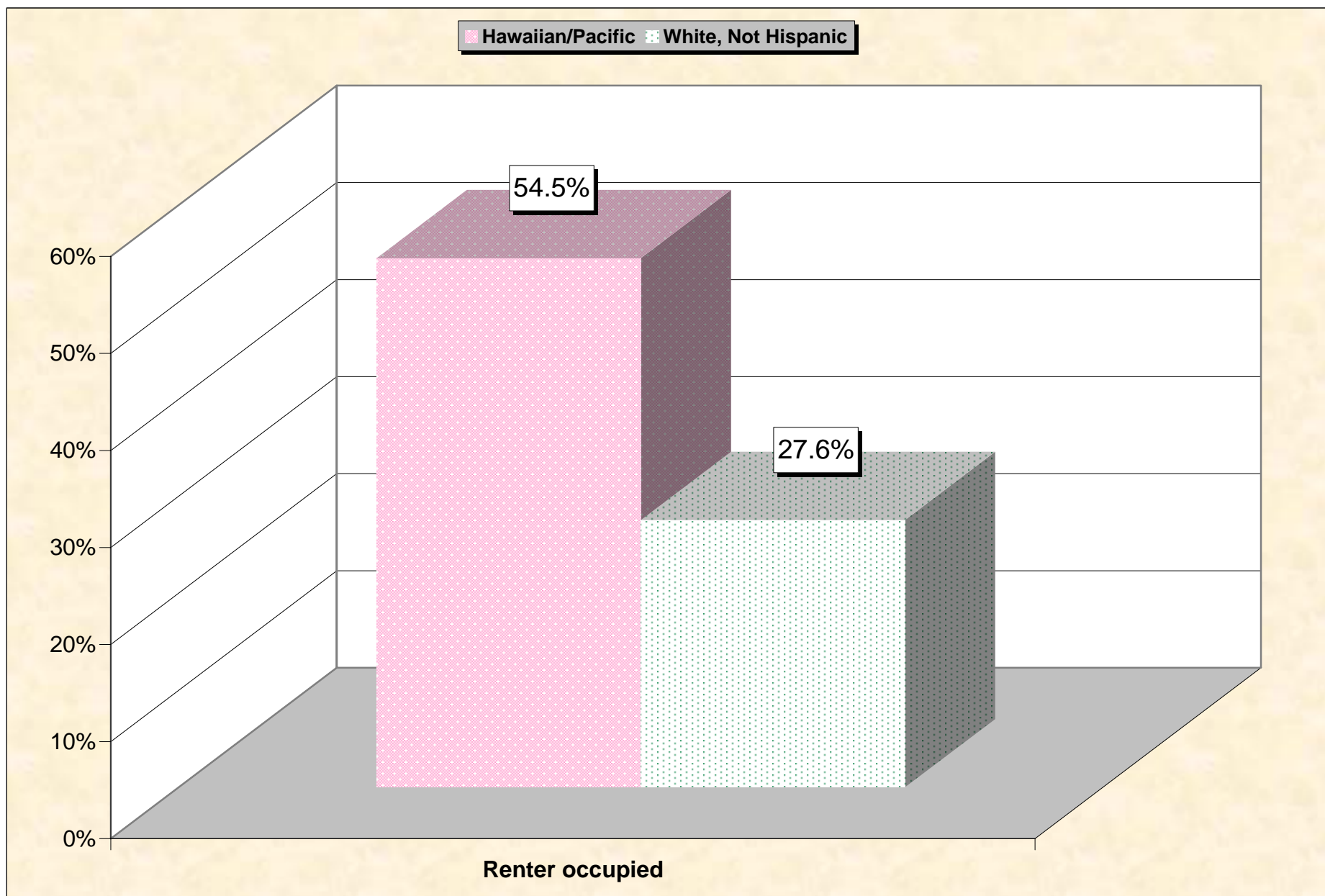

Chart 10 -- Median Earnings in 1999 United States



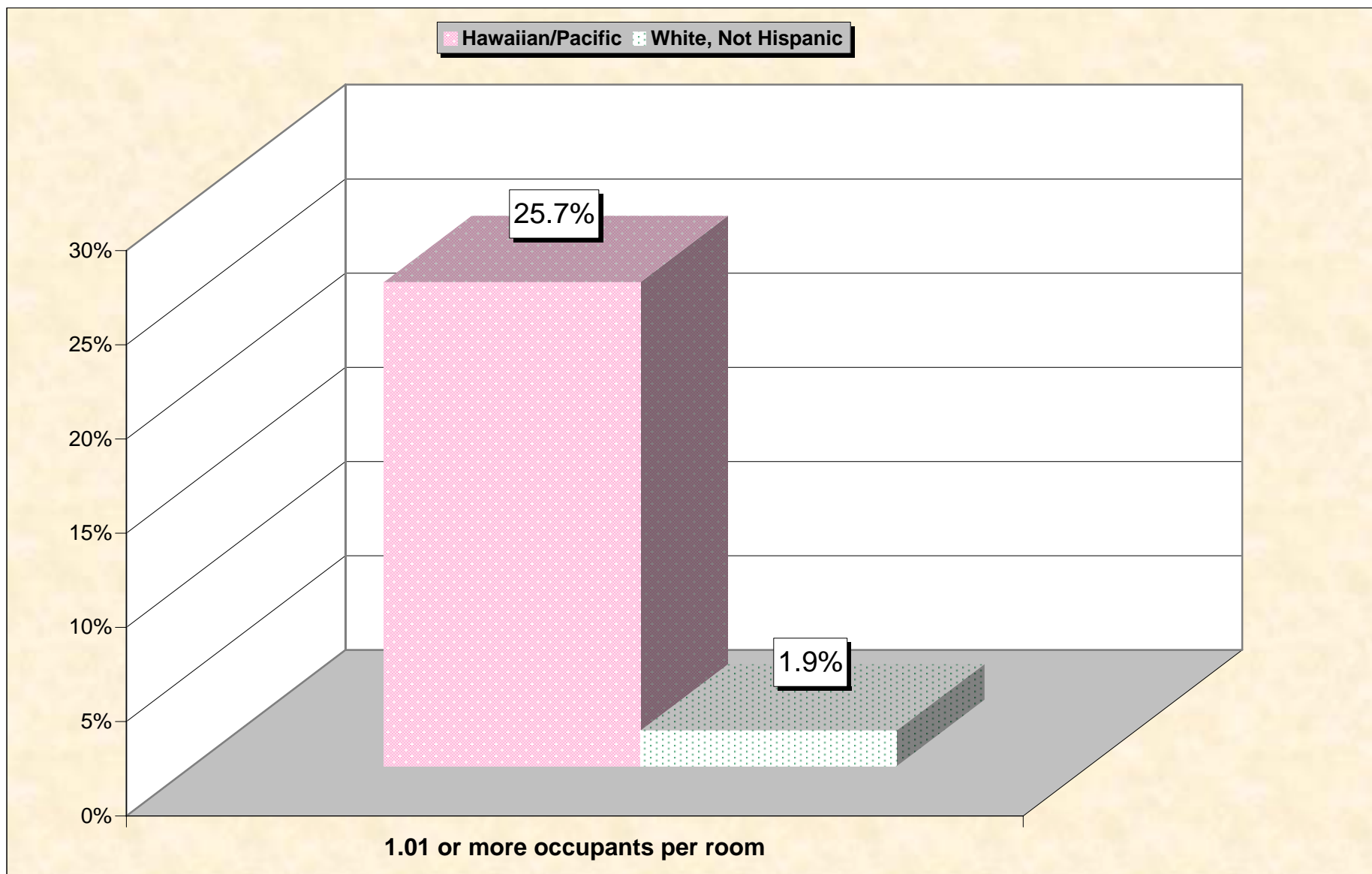

Chart 11 -- Renter-Occupied Housing United States



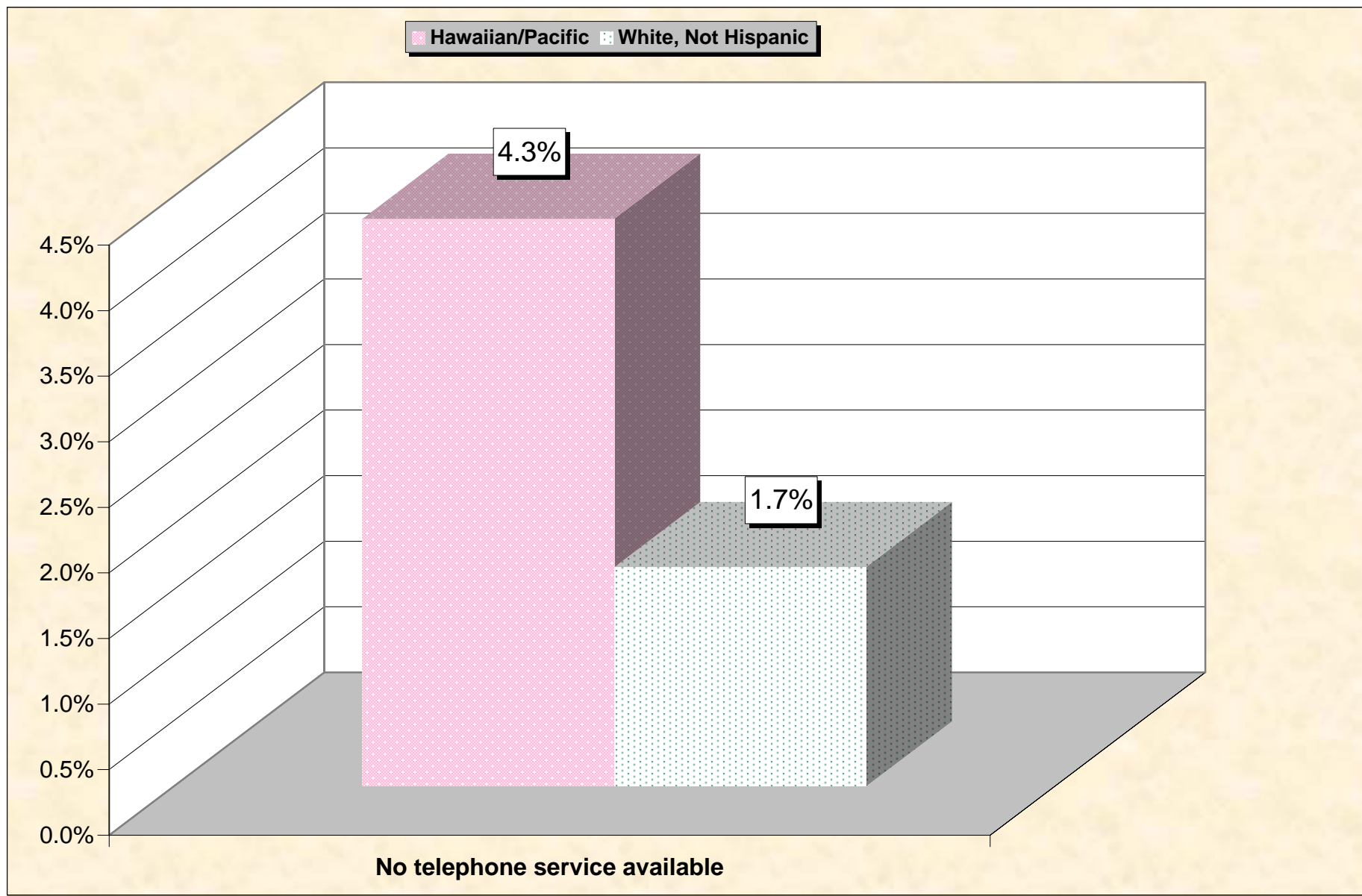

Chart 12 -- Occupants Per Room (Crowding) by Household United States



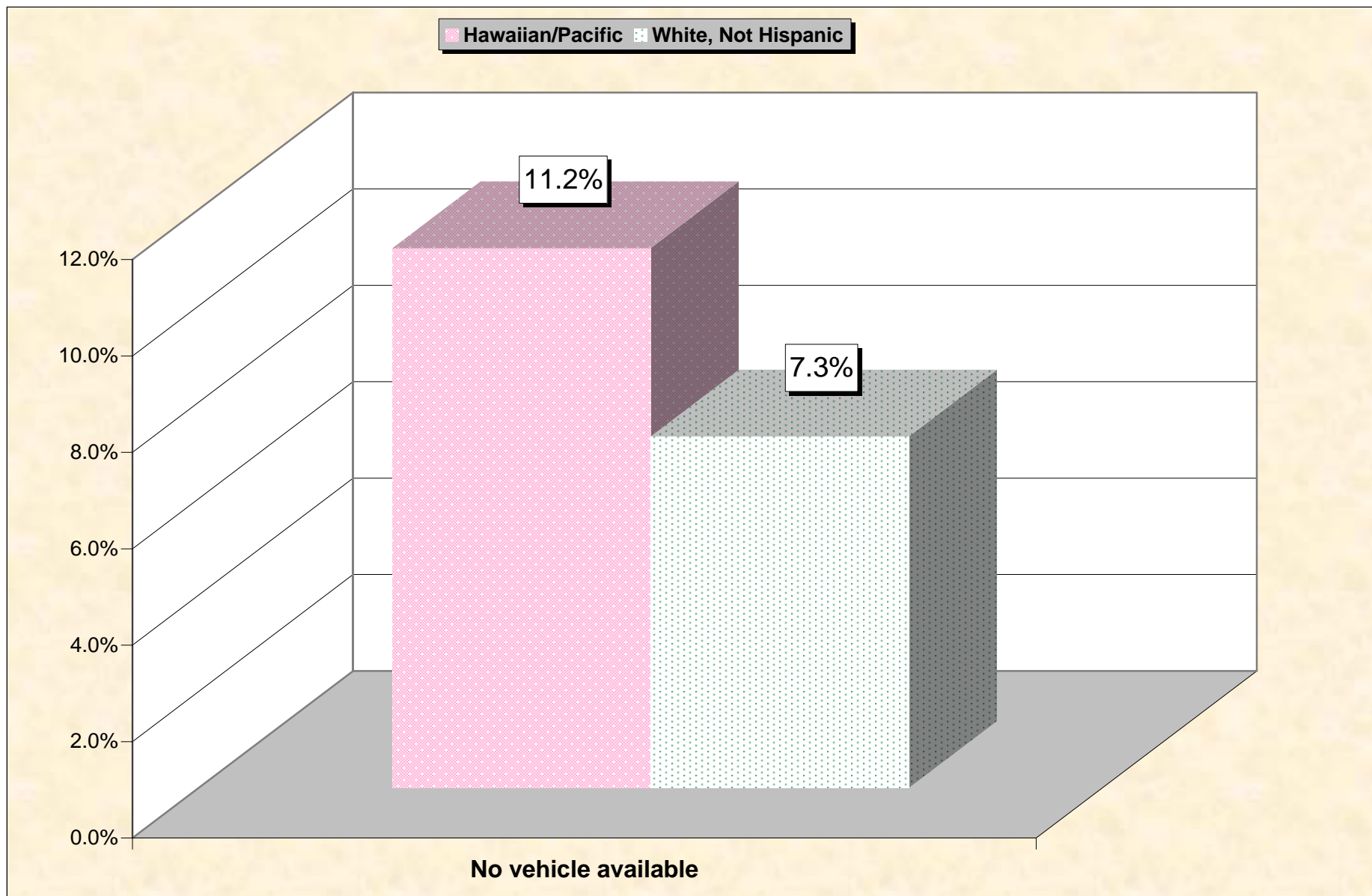

Chart 13 -- Lack of Telephone Service by Household United States



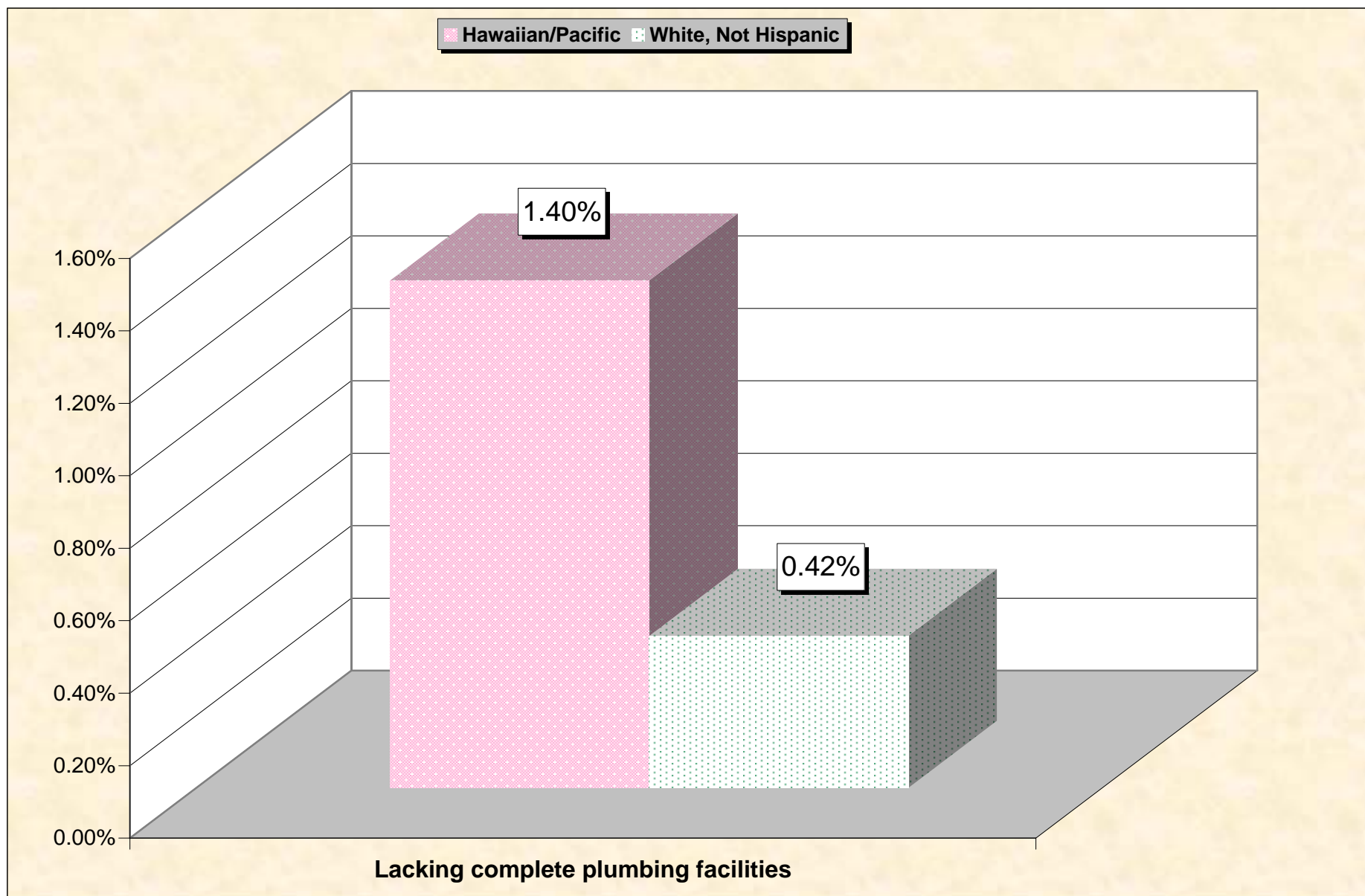

Chart 14 -- Lack of Vehicle By Household United States



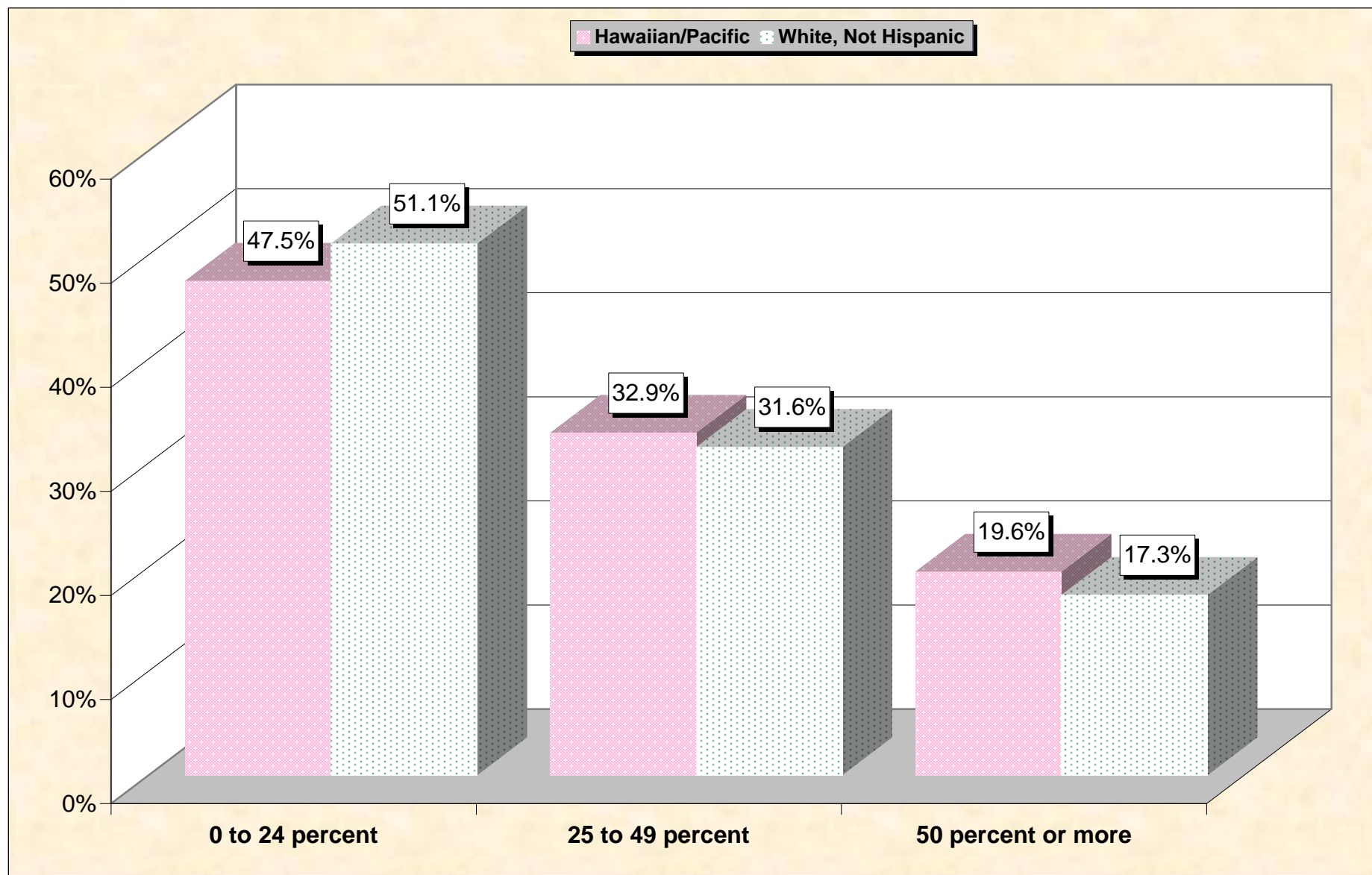

Chart 15 -- Lack of Plumbing By Household United States



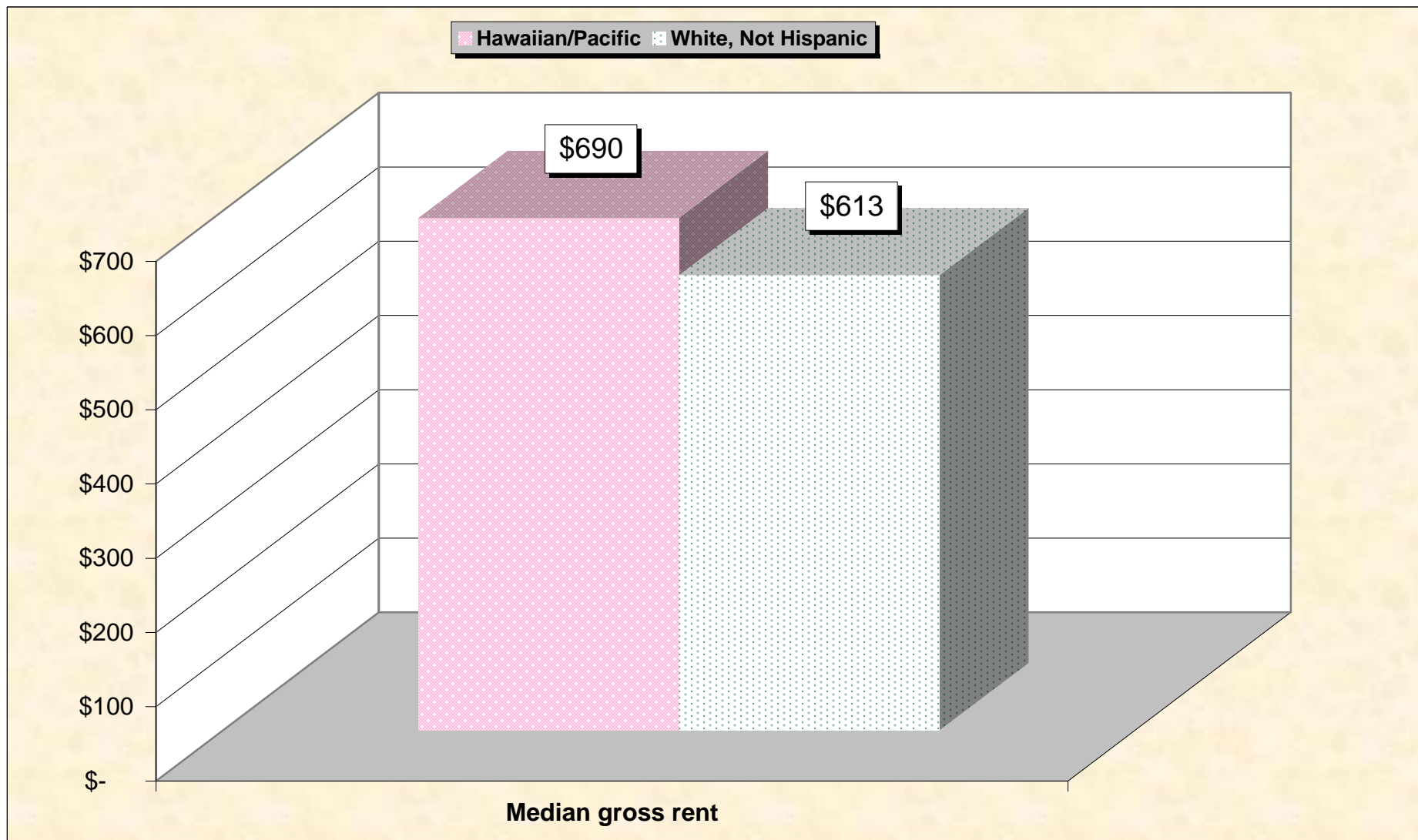

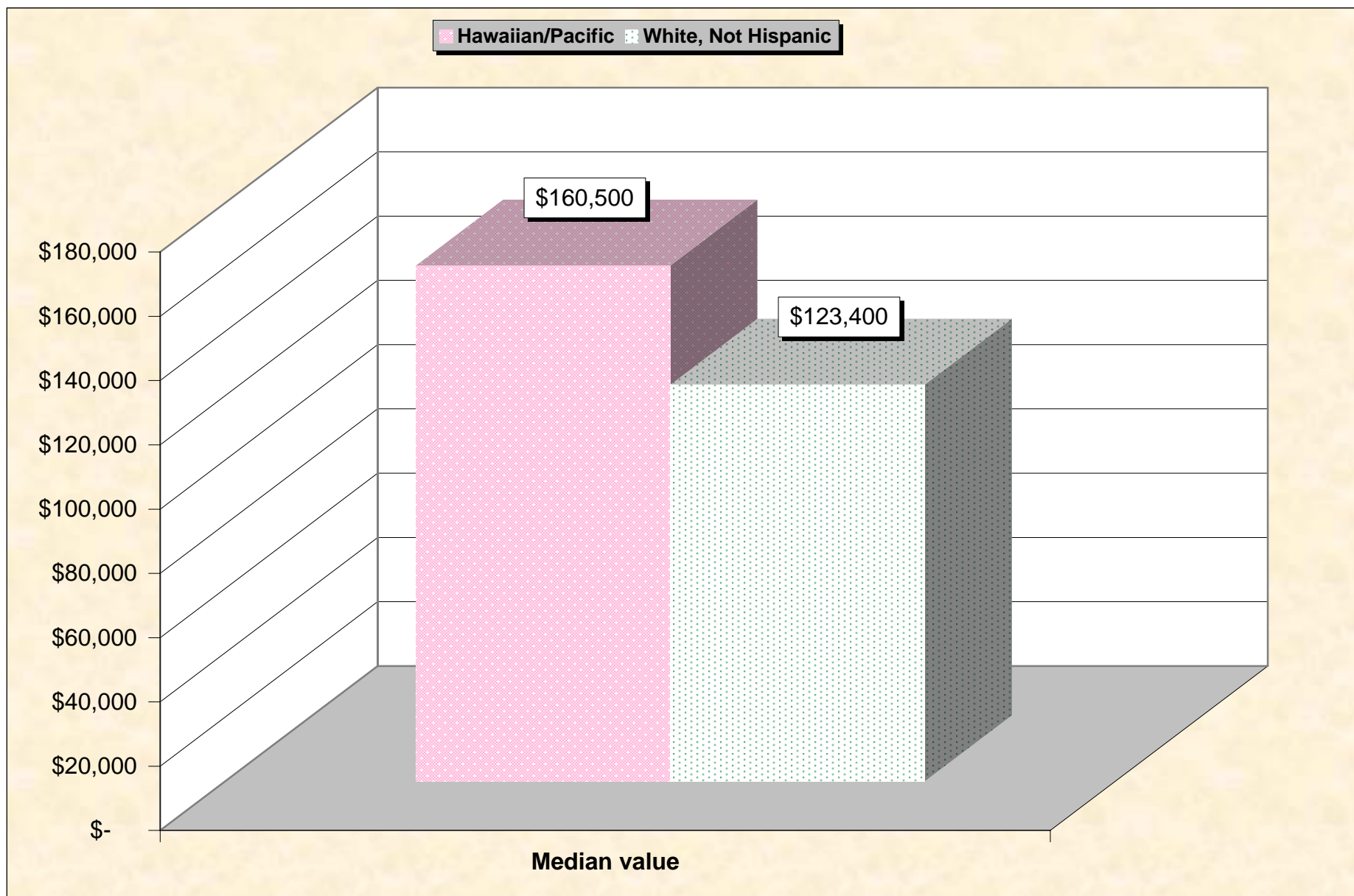
