

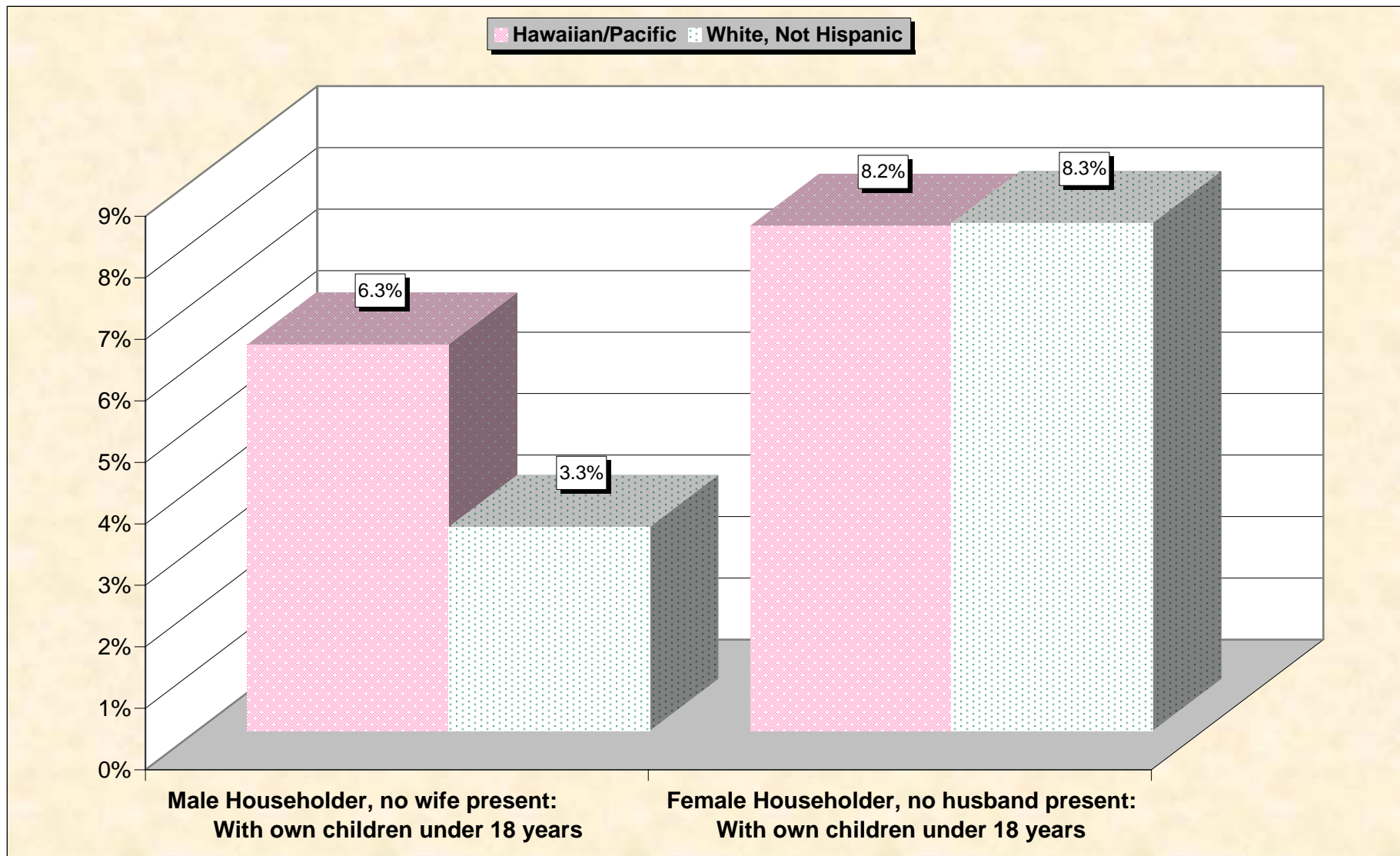

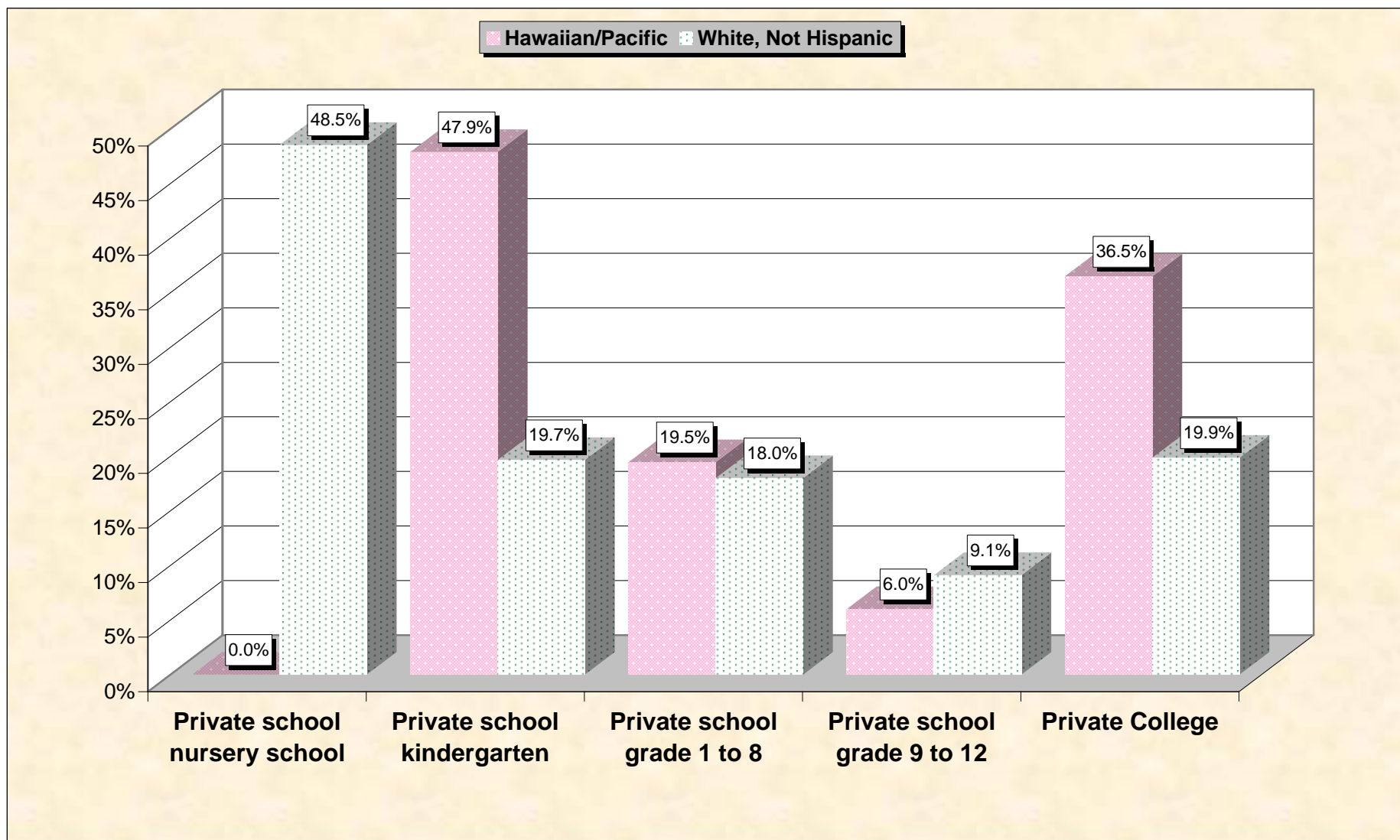

## Chart 2 -- Private School Enrollment (3 years and over)

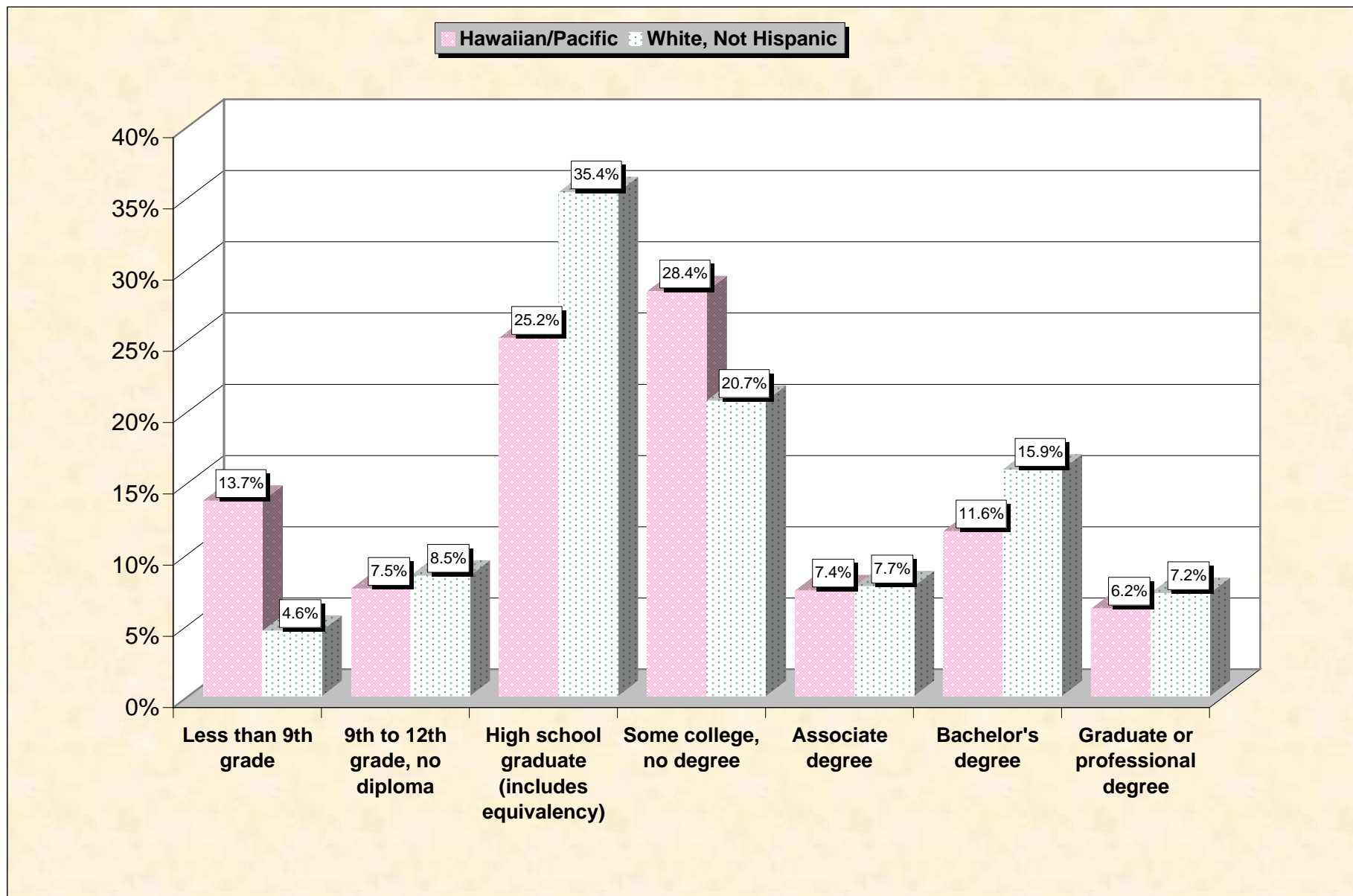

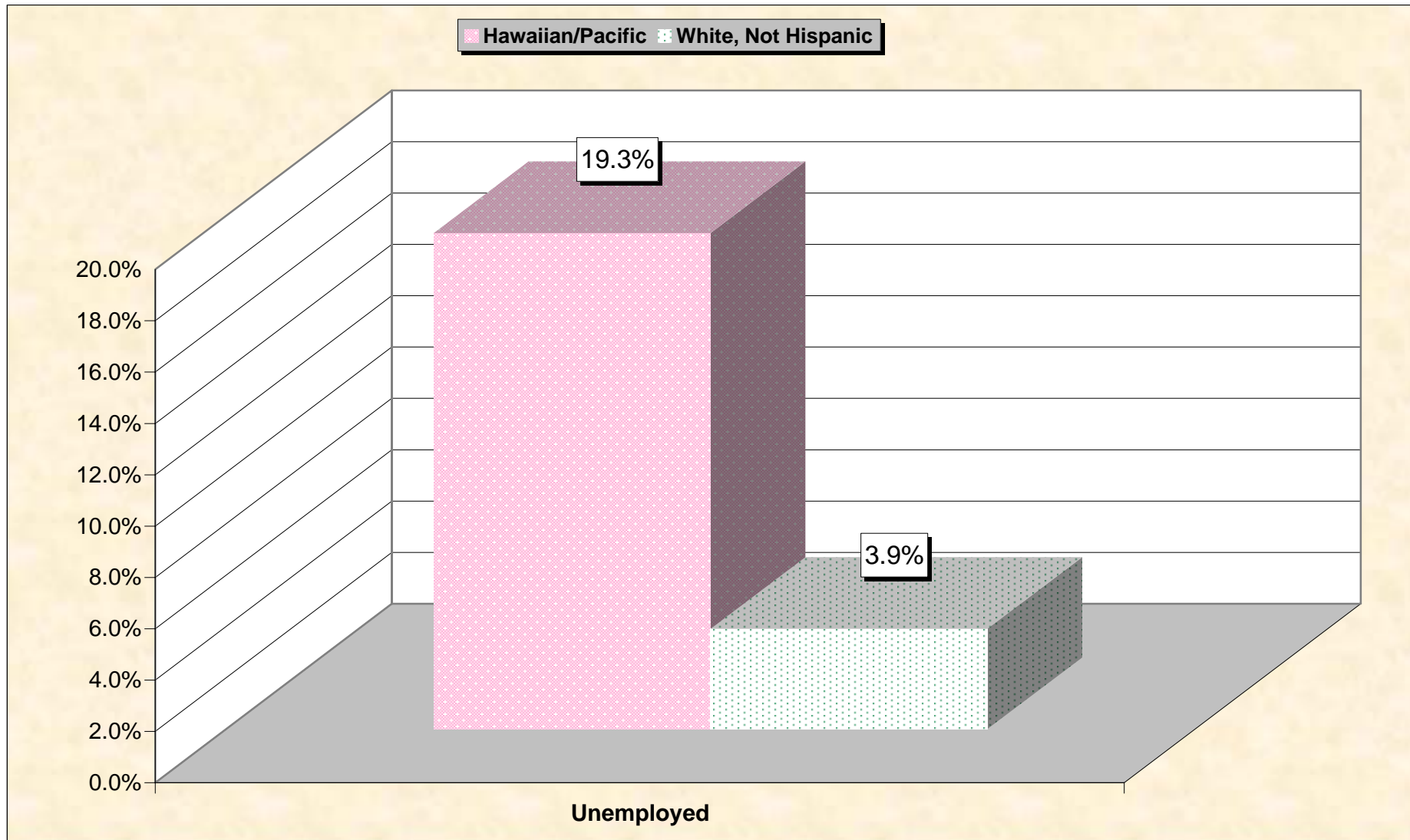
# Chart 3 -- Educational Attainment (25 years and over)

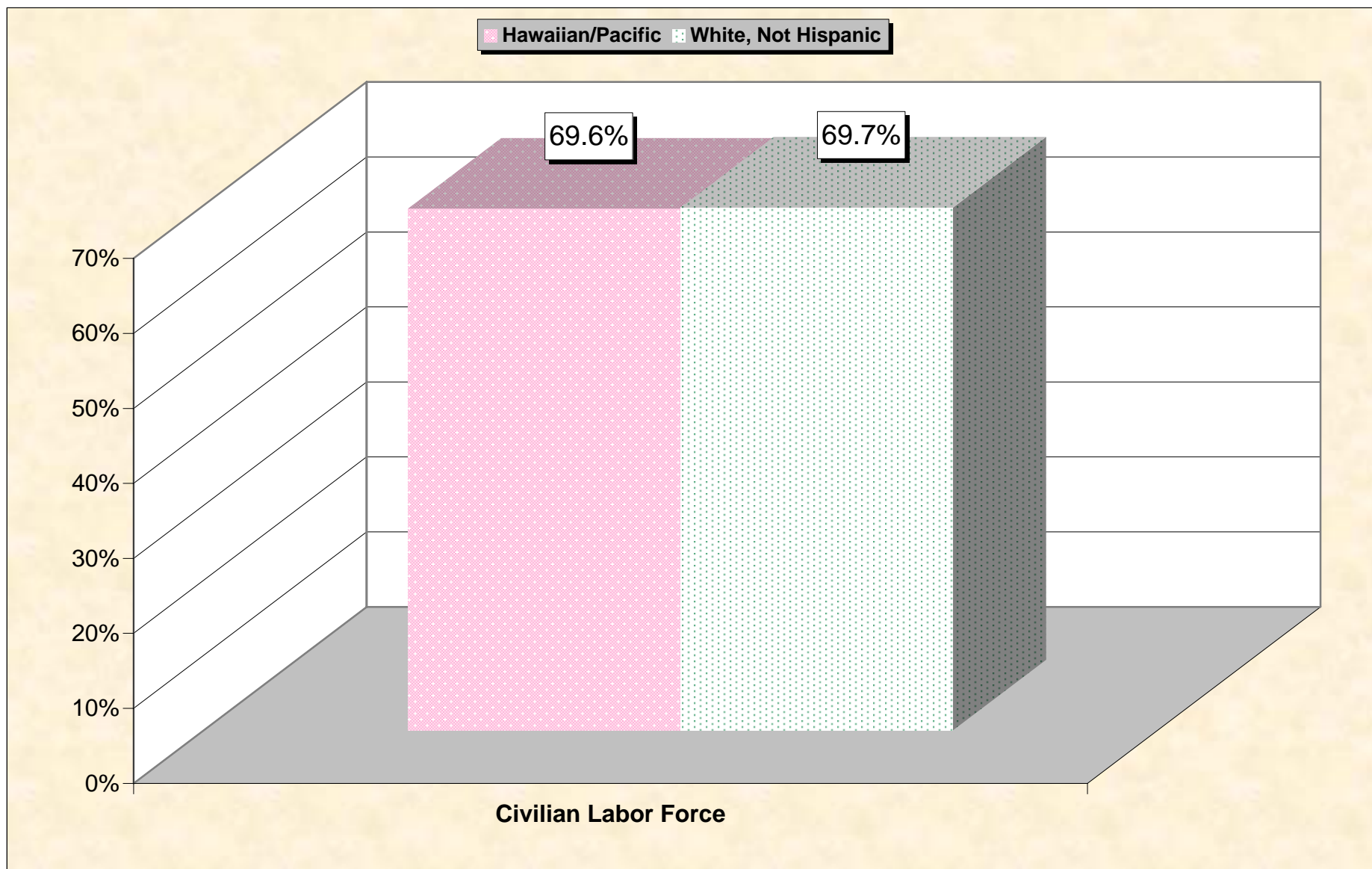
## Chart 4 -- Unemployment Rate (Civilian Labor Force) Wisconsin

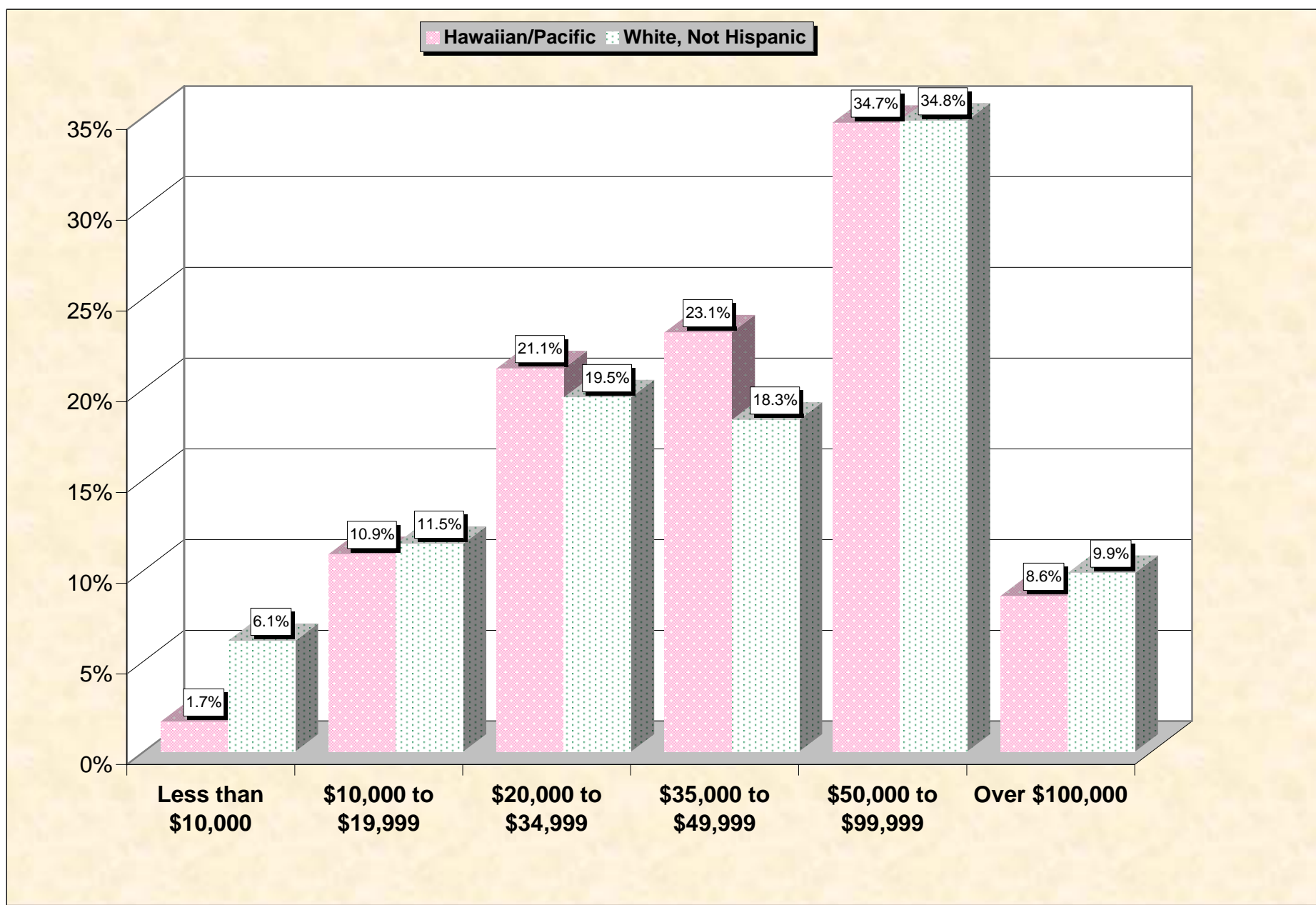
**Chart 5 -- Labor Force Participation (Civilian Labor Force)

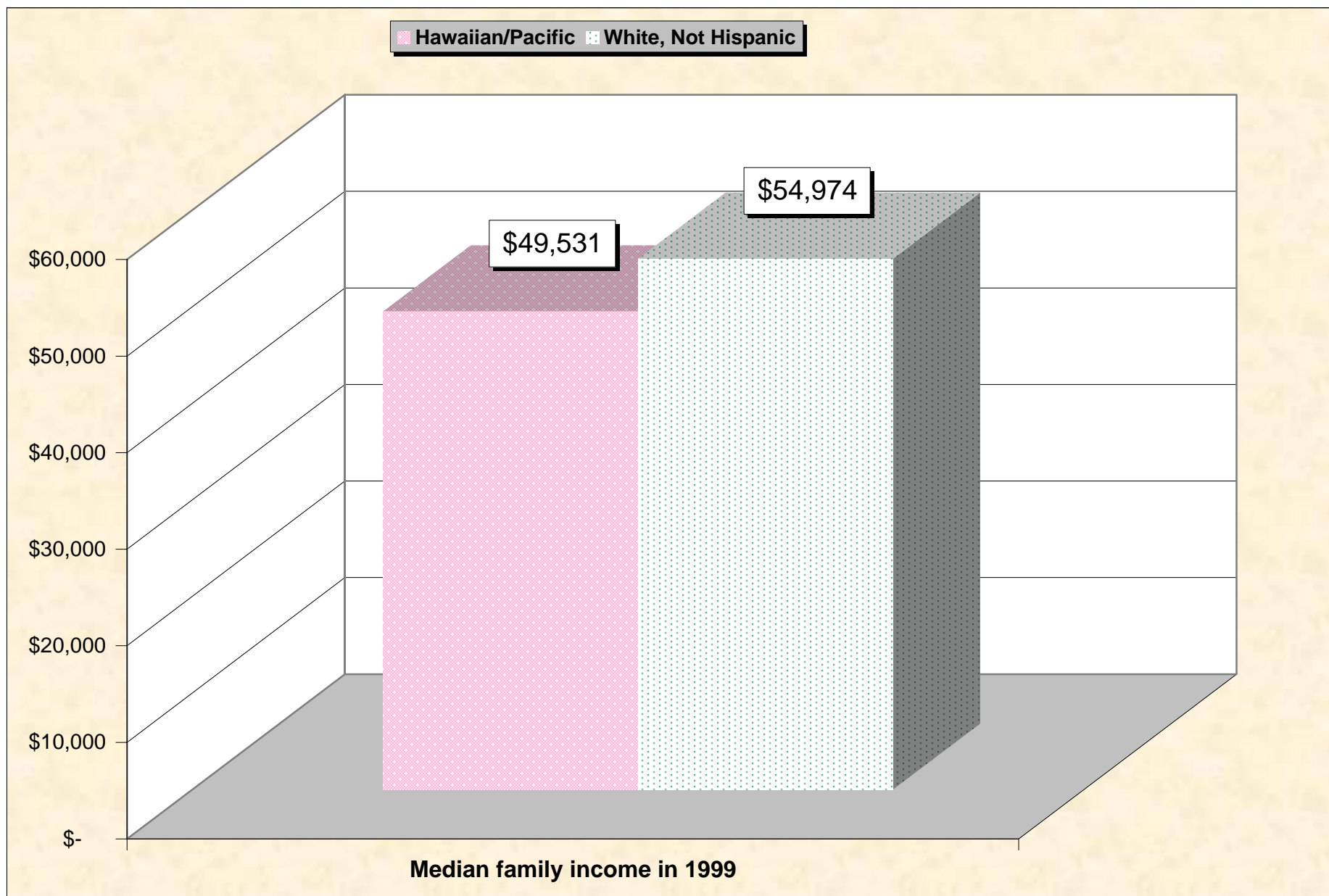
# Chart 6 -- Household Income in 1999 Wisconsin

# Chart 7 -- Median Family Income In 1999

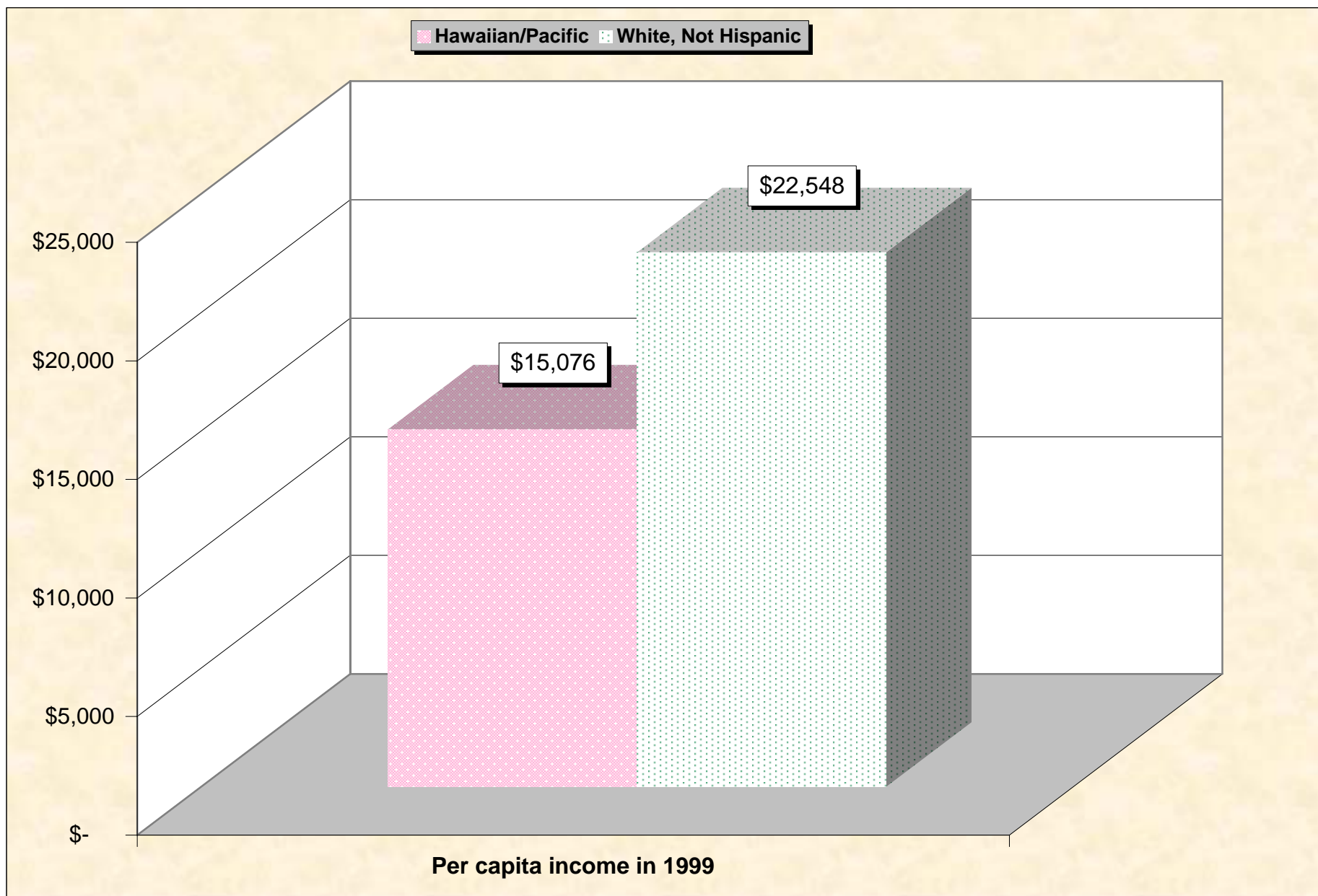

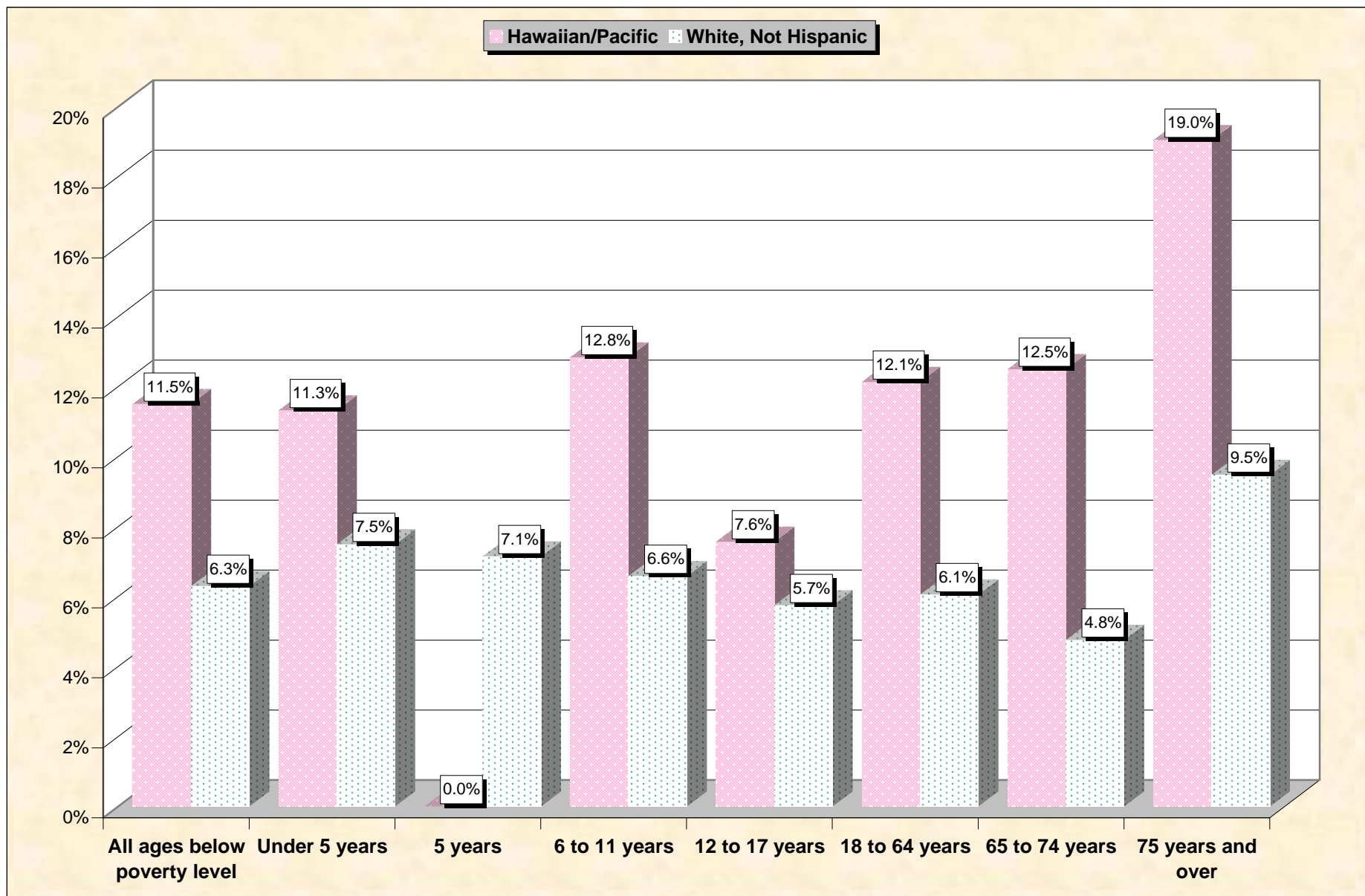


# Chart 8 -- Per Capita Income In 1999 Wisconsin

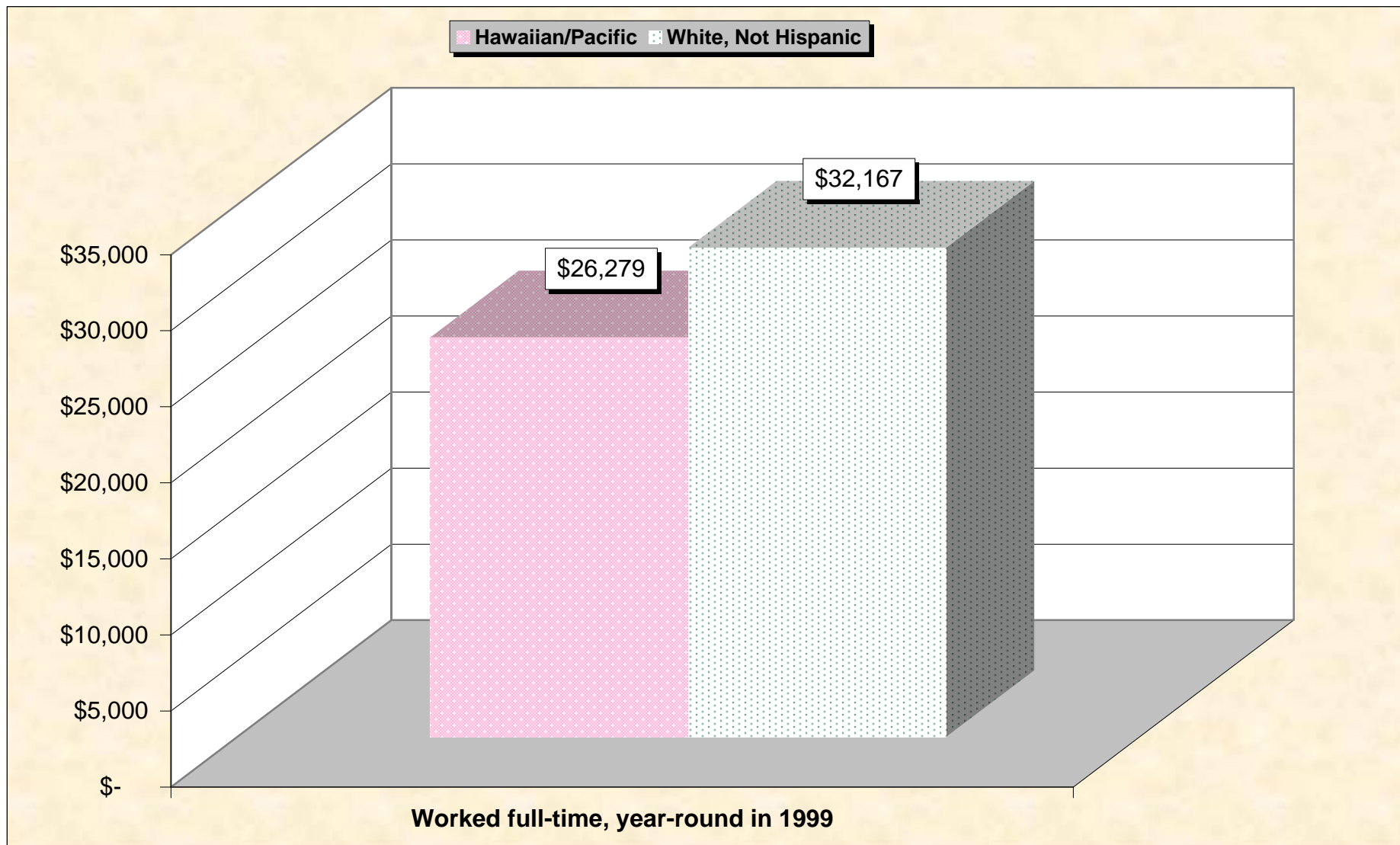
# **Chart 9 -- Income in 1999 Below Poverty Level by Age Wisconsin**

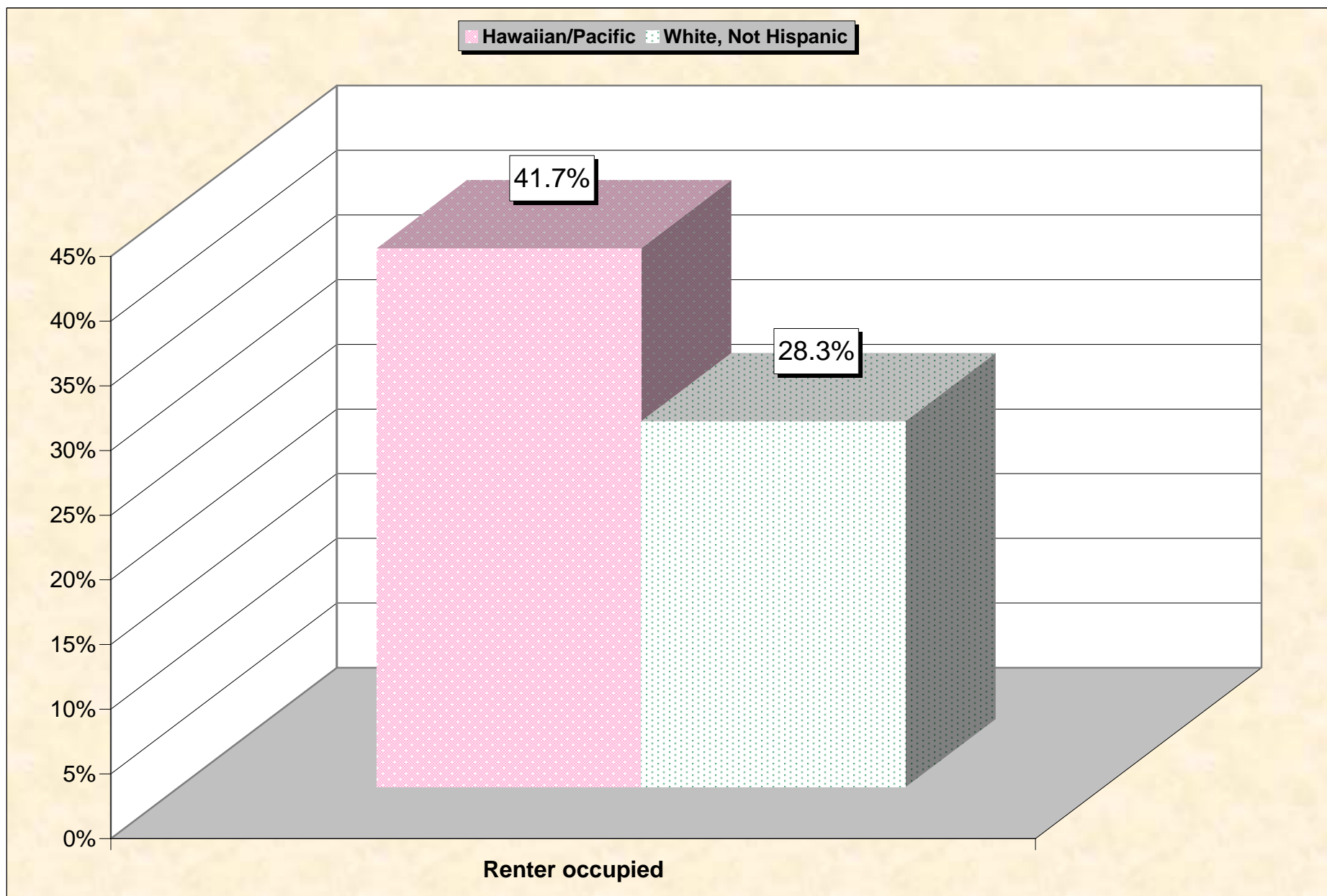
# Chart 10 -- Median Earnings in 1999

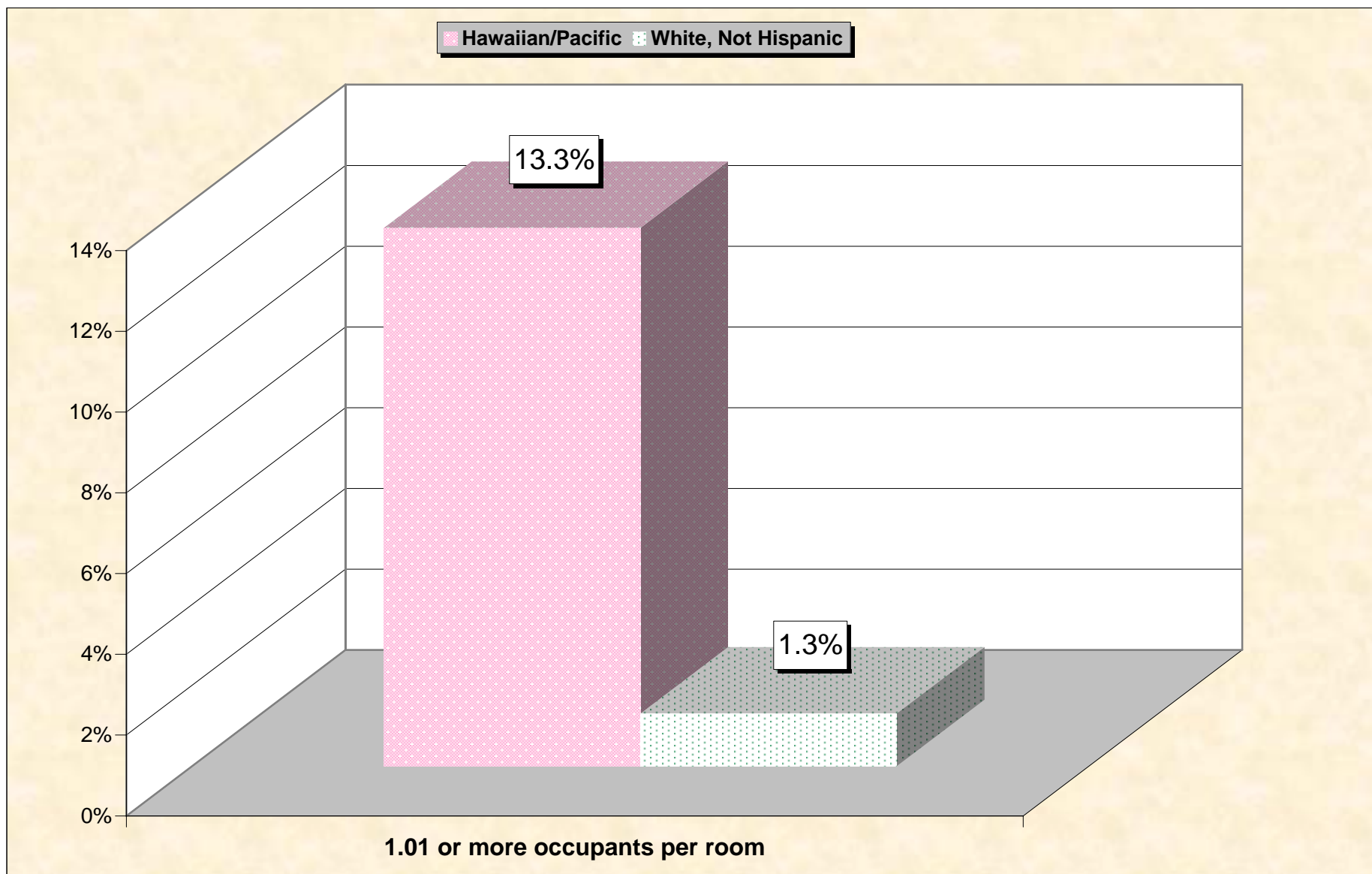

# Chart 11 -- Renter-Occupied Housing Wisconsin



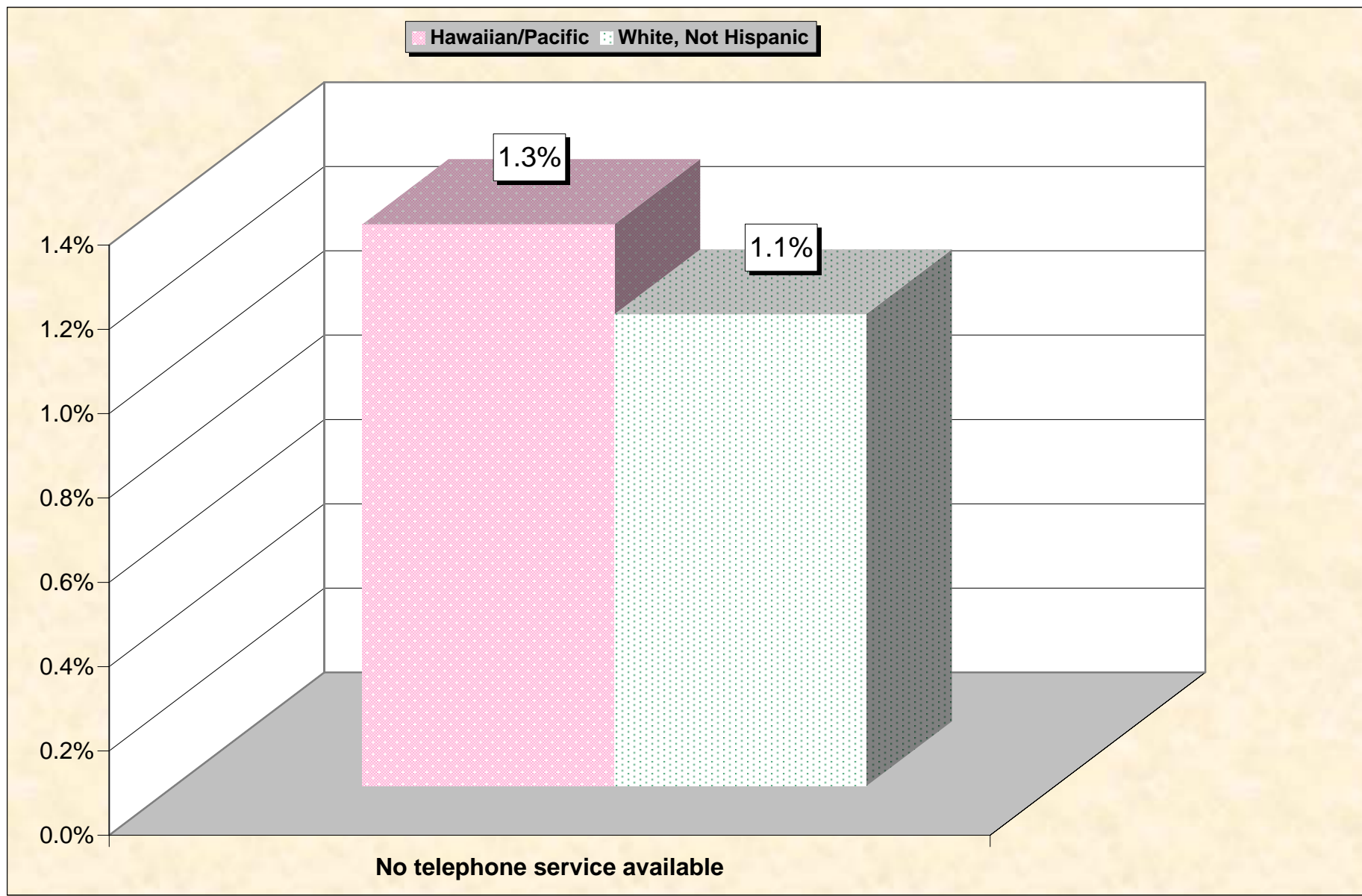

# Chart 12 -- Occupants Per Room (Crowding) by Household Wisconsin



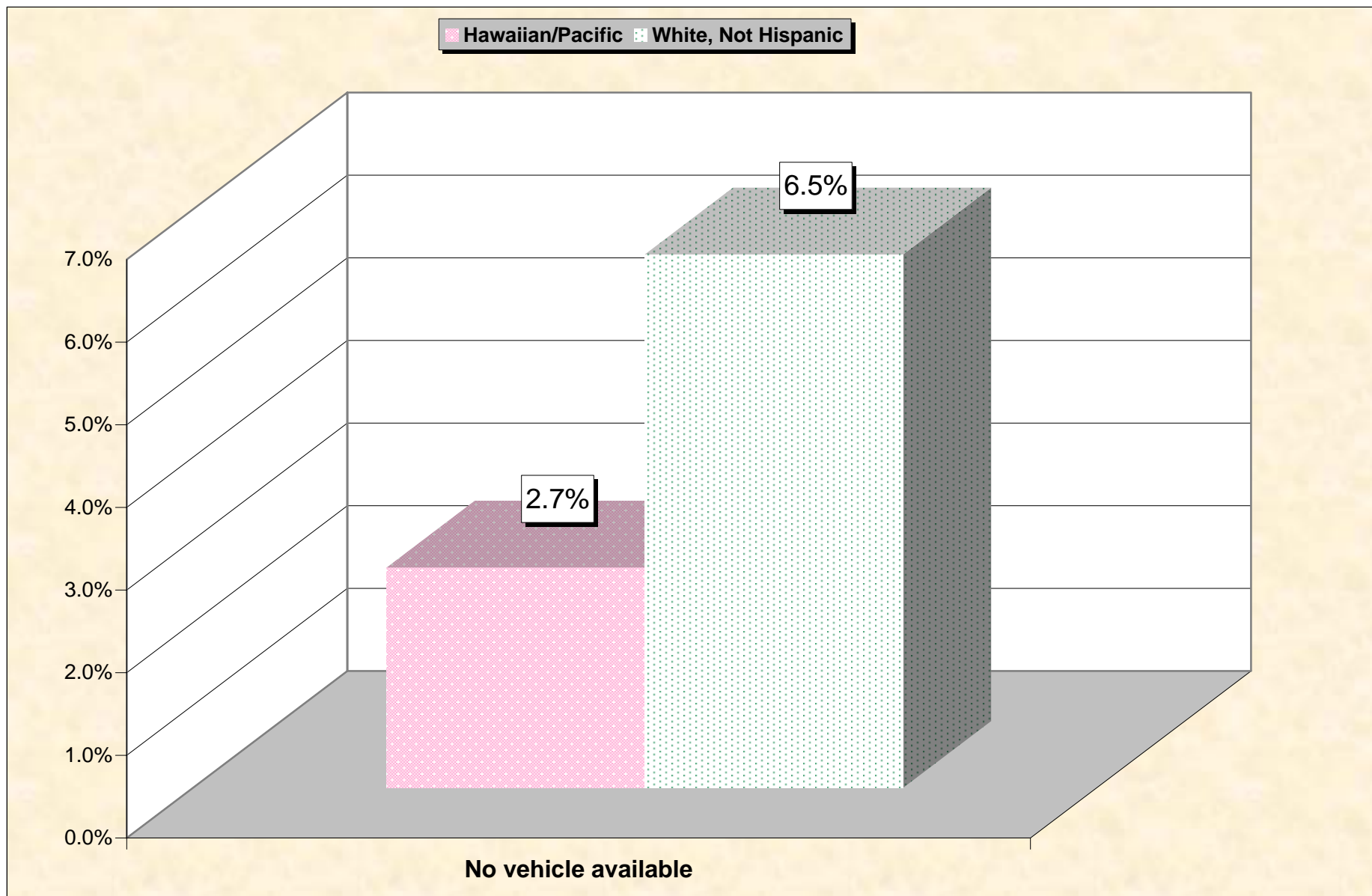

# Chart 13 -- Lack of Telephone Service by Household Wisconsin



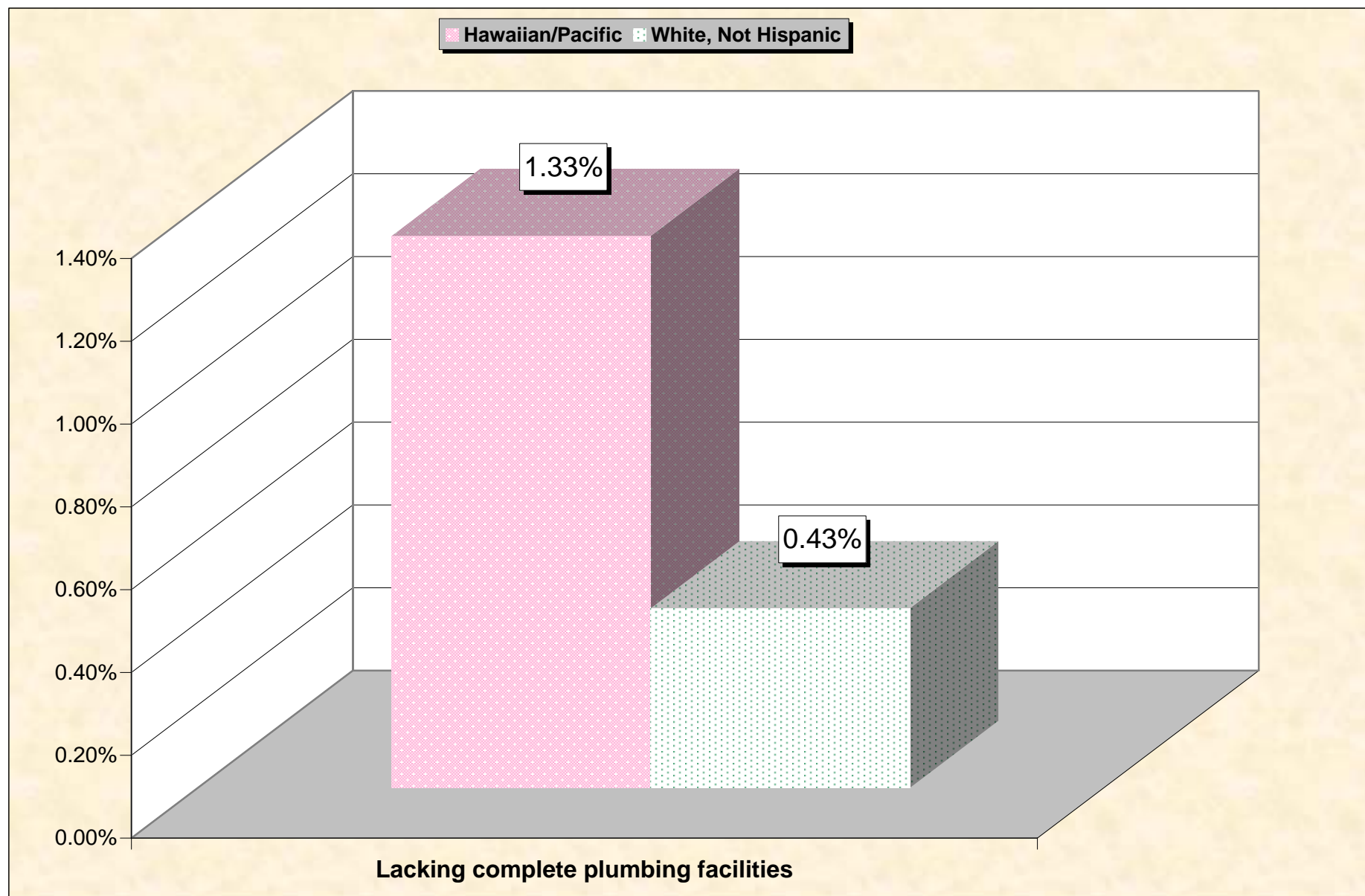

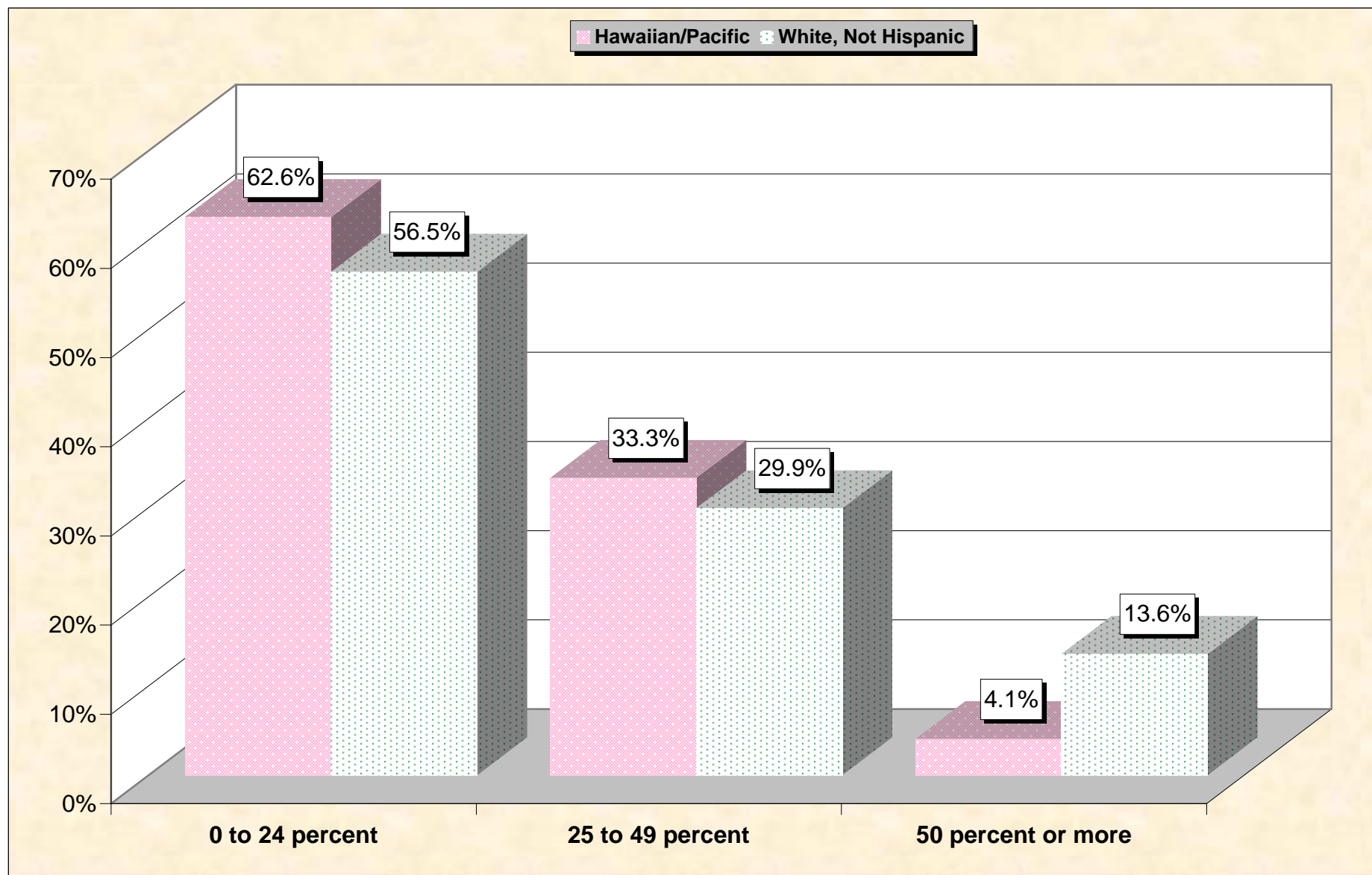
# Chart 15 -- Lack of Plumbing By Household Wisconsin

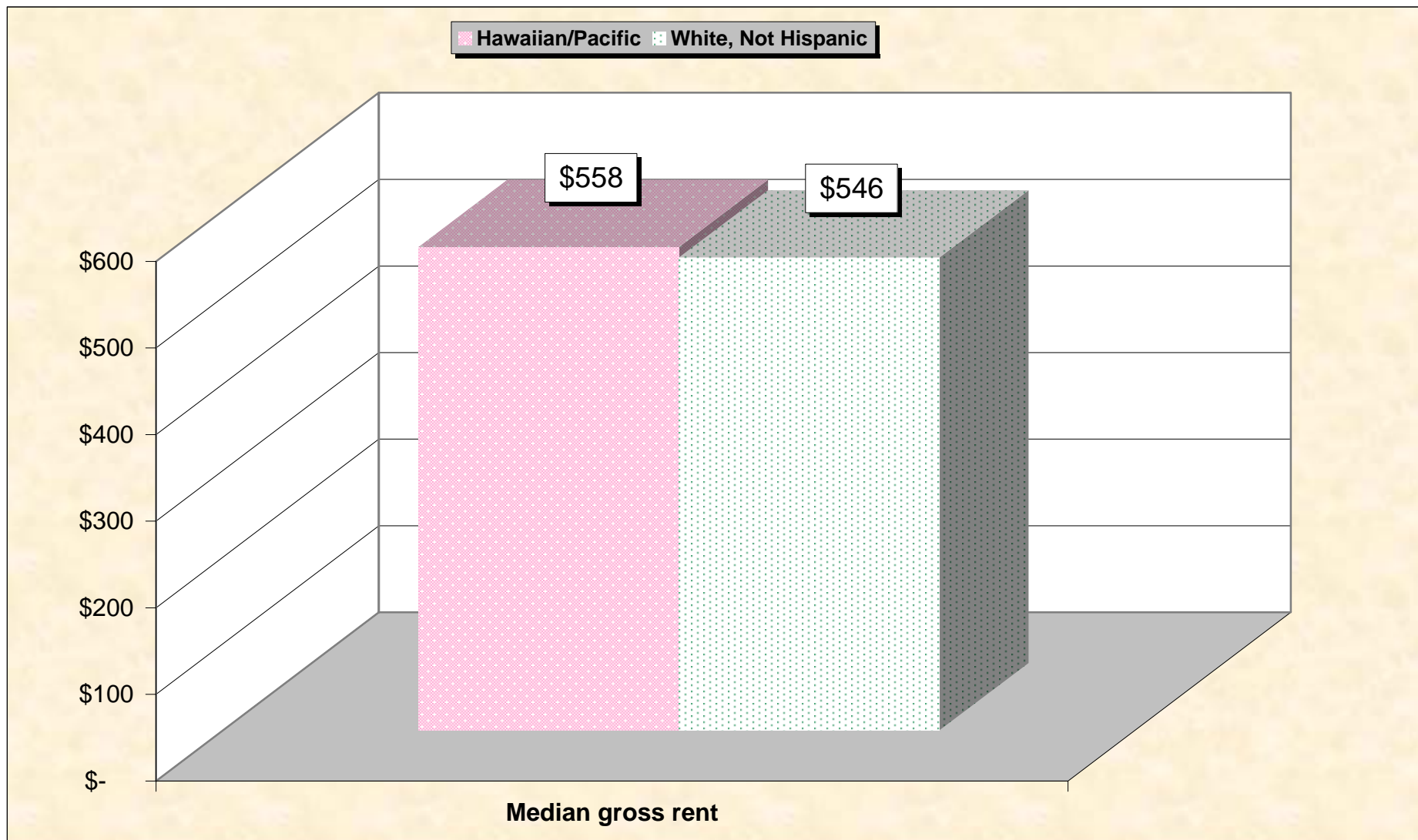


**Chart 16 -- Gross Rent as a Percentage of Household Income in 1999**

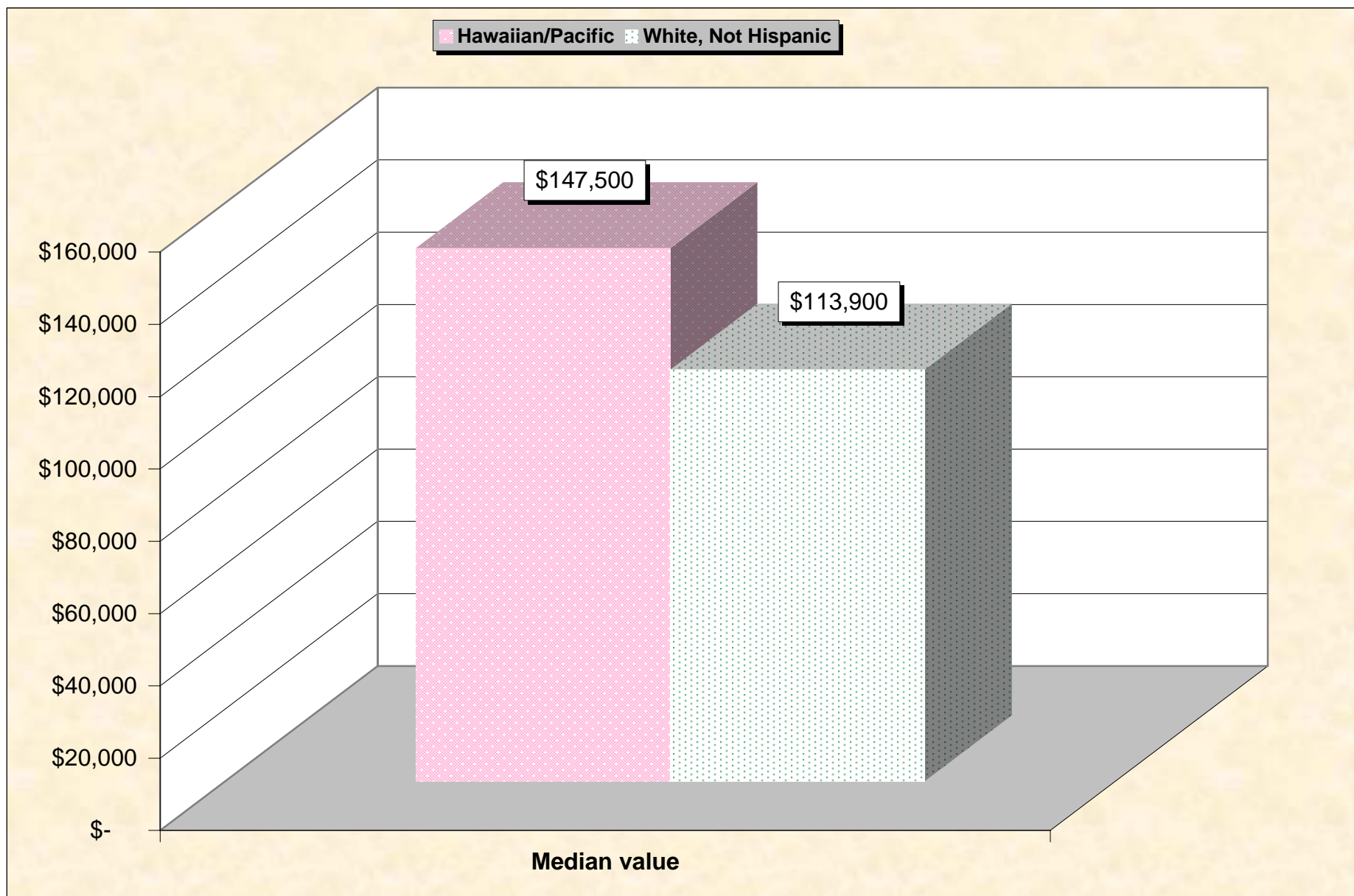
