








Chart 4 -- Unemployment Rate (Civilian Labor Force)


Chart 5 -- Labor Force Participation (Civilian Labor Force)



Chart 6 -- Household Income in 1999 Wyoming







Chart 8 -- Per Capita Income In 1999 Wyoming







Chart 10 -- Median Earnings in 1999 Wyoming





Chart 11 -- Renter-Occupied Housing Wyoming





Chart 12 -- Occupants Per Room (Crowding) by Household Wyoming





Chart 13 -- Lack of Telephone Service by Household Wyoming





Chart 14 -- Lack of Vehicle By Household Wyoming





Chart 15 -- Lack of Plumbing By Household Wyoming





Chart 16 -- Gross Rent as a Percentage of Household Income in 1999 Wyoming




