


Chart 1 -- Single-Parent Family Households (Householder 15 to 64 years)






**Chart 4 -- Unemployment Rate (Civilian Labor Force) Connecticut**


**Chart 5 -- Labor Force Participation (Civilian Labor Force) Connecticut**



Chart 6 -- Household Income in 1999 Connecticut





**Chart 7 -- Median Family Income In 1999 Connecticut** 





Chart 8 -- Per Capita Income In 1999 Connecticut





Chart 9 -- Income in 1999 Below Poverty Level by Age Connecticut





## Chart 10 -- Median Earnings in 1999 Connecticut





# **Chart 11 -- Renter-Occupied Housing Connecticut**





Chart 12 -- Occupants Per Room (Crowding) by Household Connecticut





Chart 13 -- Lack of Telephone Service by Household Connecticut





# Chart 14 -- Lack of Vehicle By Household Connecticut





# Chart 15 -- Lack of Plumbing By Household Connecticut





Chart 16 -- Gross Rent as a Percentage of Household Income in 1999 Connecticut




