



Chart 1 -- Single-Parent Family Households (Householder 15 to 64 years) Idaho





Chart 2 -- Private School Enrollment (3 years and over) Idaho






Chart 4 -- Unemployment Rate (Civilian Labor Force) Idaho


Chart 5 -- Labor Force Participation (Civilian Labor Force) Idaho




Chart 7 -- Median Family Income In 1999 Idaho


Chart 8 -- Per Capita Income In 1999







Chart 9 -- Income in 1999 Below Poverty Level by Age Idaho





Chart 10 -- Median Earnings in 1999 Idaho





Chart 11 -- Renter-Occupied Housing Idaho





Chart 12 -- Occupants Per Room (Crowding) by Household





Chart 13 -- Lack of Telephone Service by Household Idaho





Chart 14 -- Lack of Vehicle By Household Idaho





Chart 15 -- Lack of Plumbing By Household Idaho





Chart 16 -- Gross Rent as a Percentage of Household Income in 1999 Idaho




