




Chart 2 -- Private School Enrollment (3 years and over) Kansas


Chart 3 -- Educational Attainment (25 years and over)


Chart 4 -- Unemployment Rate (Civilian Labor Force) Kansas


Chart 5 -- Labor Force Participation (Civilian Labor Force) Kansas


Chart 6 -- Household Income in 1999 Kansas

Chart 7 -- Median Family Income In 1999




Chart 8 -- Per Capita Income In 1999


Chart 9 -- Income in 1999 Below Poverty Level by Age Kansas


Chart 10 -- Median Earnings in 1999


Chart 11 -- Renter-Occupied Housing Kansas


Chart 12 -- Occupants Per Room (Crowding) by Household



Chart 13 -- Lack of Telephone Service by Household Kansas





Chart 14 -- Lack of Vehicle By Household Kansas





Chart 15 -- Lack of Plumbing By Household Kansas





Chart 16 -- Gross Rent as a Percentage of Household Income in 1999 Kansas




