




# Chart 1 -- Single-Parent Family Households (Householder 15 to 64 years) Minnesota






# Chart 4 -- Unemployment Rate (Civilian Labor Force) Minnesota


# Chart 5 -- Labor Force Participation (Civilian Labor Force) Minnesota



## Chart 6 -- Household Income in 1999 Minnesota





# Chart 7 -- Median Family Income In 1999 Minnesota





# Chart 8 -- Per Capita Income In 1999 Minnesota





# Chart 9 -- Income in 1999 Below Poverty Level by Age Minnesota





# Chart 10 -- Median Earnings in 1999 Minnesota





# Chart 11 -- Renter-Occupied Housing Minnesota





# Chart 12 -- Occupants Per Room (Crowding) by Household Minnesota





# Chart 13 -- Lack of Telephone Service by Household Minnesota





# Chart 14 -- Lack of Vehicle By Household Minnesota





# Chart 15 -- Lack of Plumbing By Household Minnesota





# Chart 16 -- Gross Rent as a Percentage of Household Income in 1999 Minnesota




