

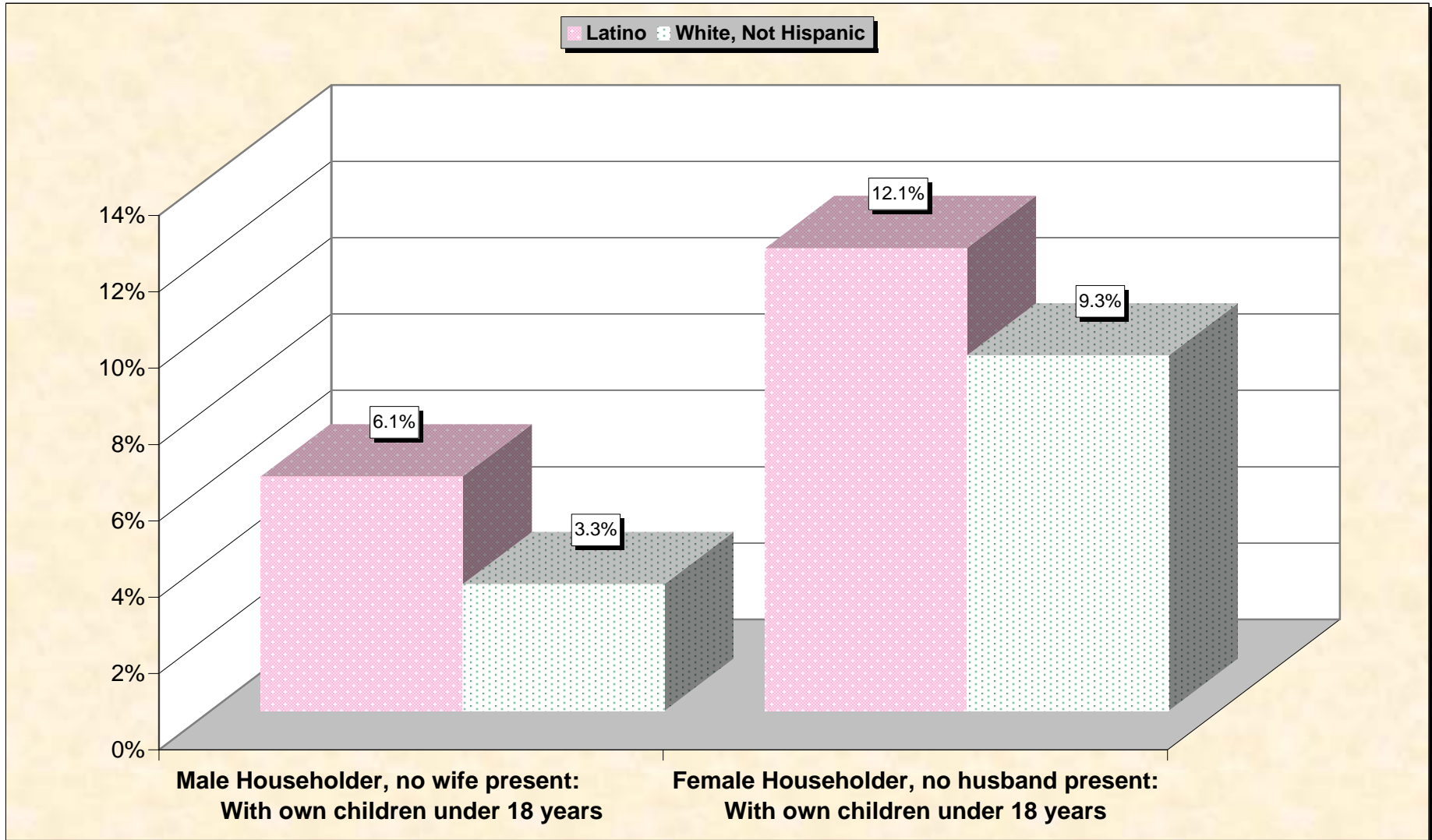

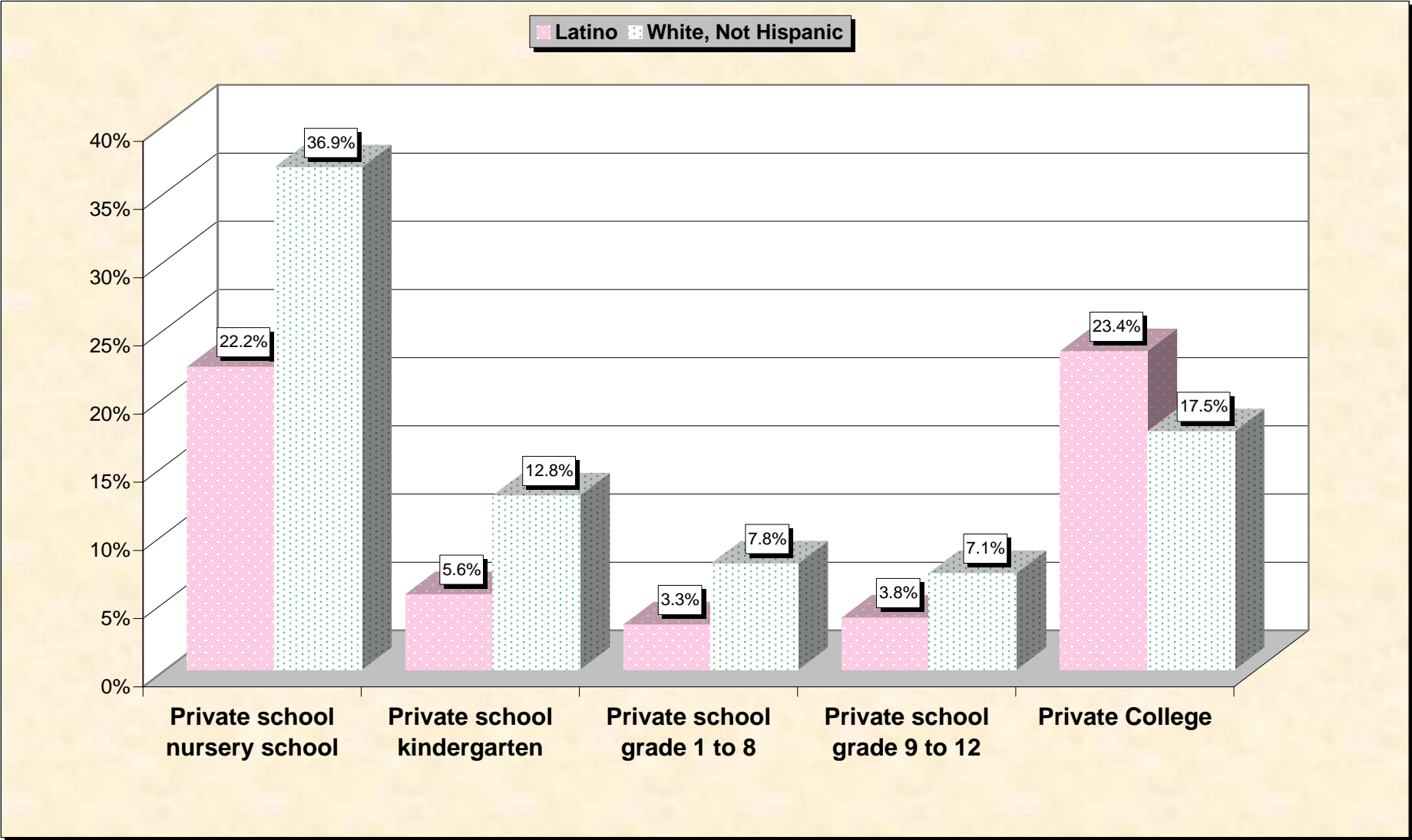

# Chart 1 -- Single-Parent Family Households (Householder 15 to 64 years) Oklahoma



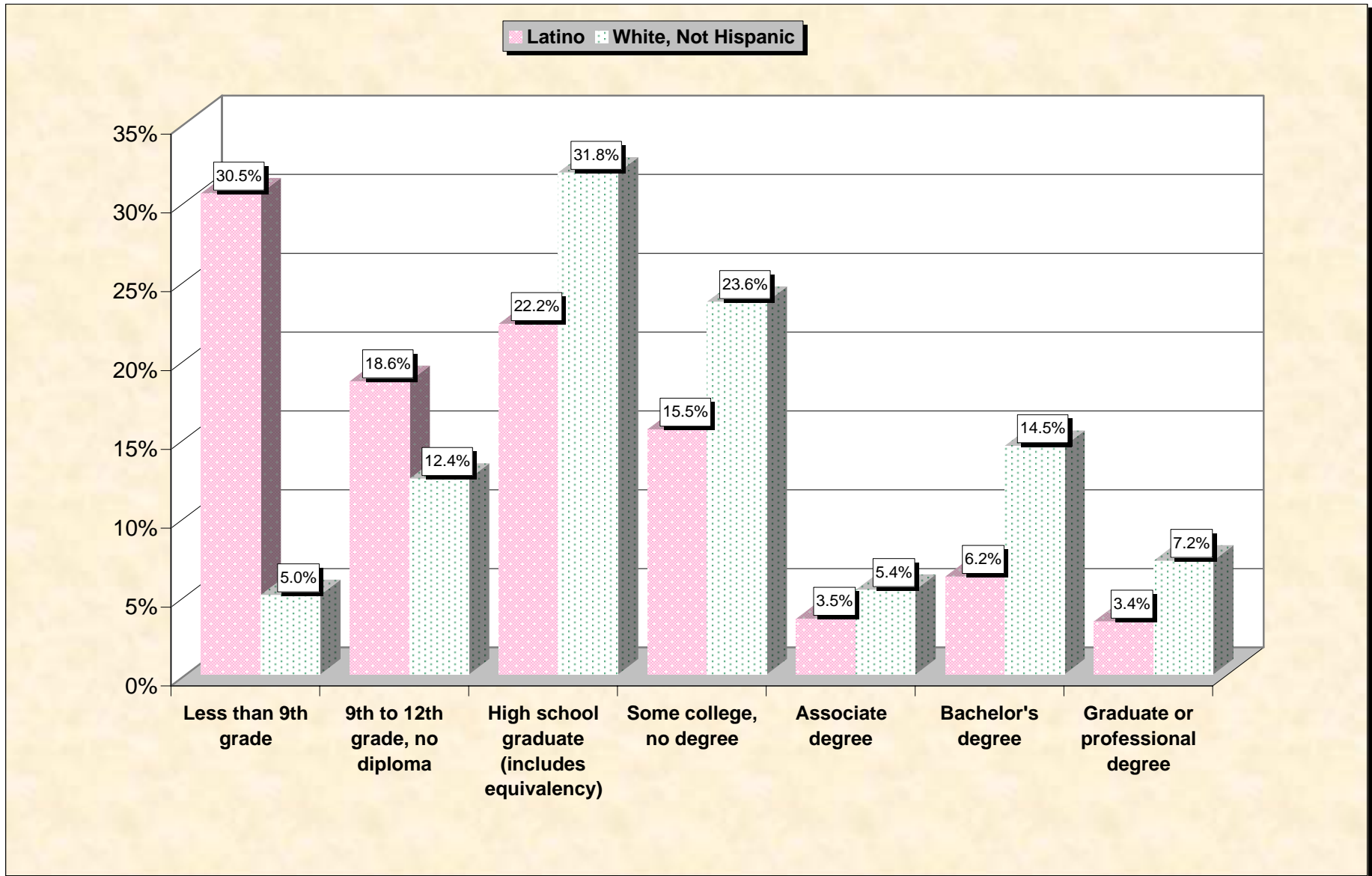

# Chart 2 -- Private School Enrollment (3 years and over) Oklahoma



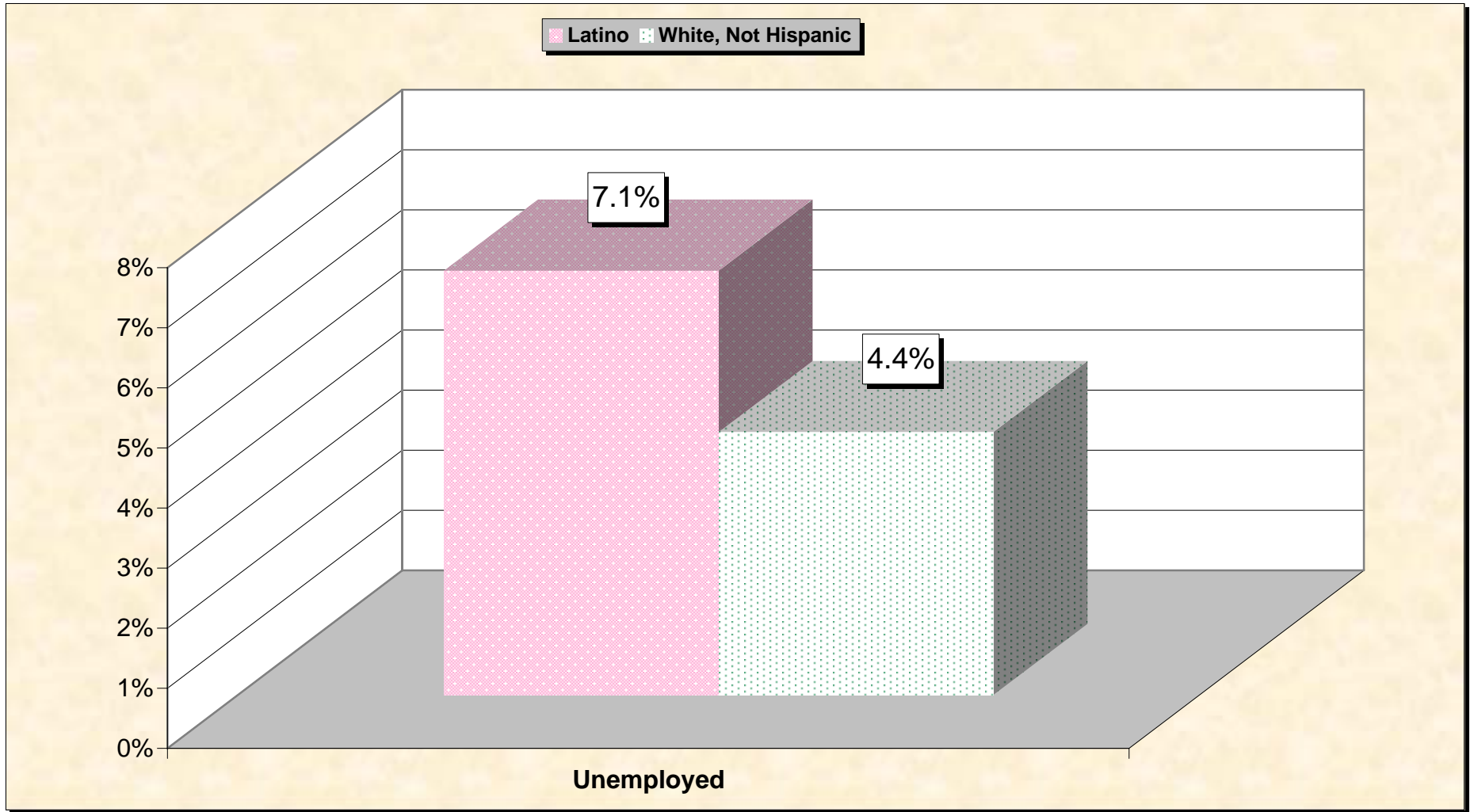

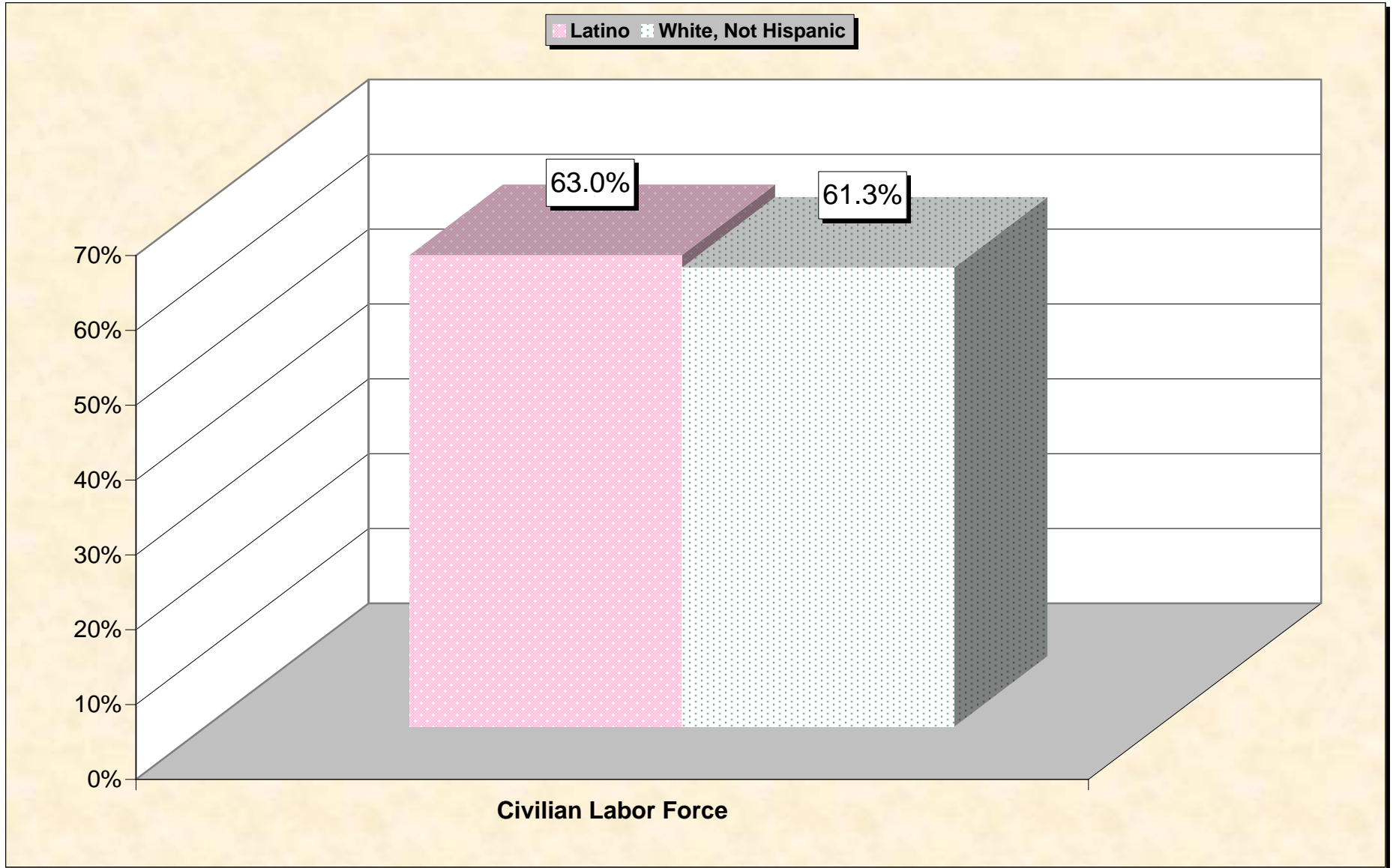
# Chart 4 -- Unemployment Rate (Civilian Labor Force) Oklahoma

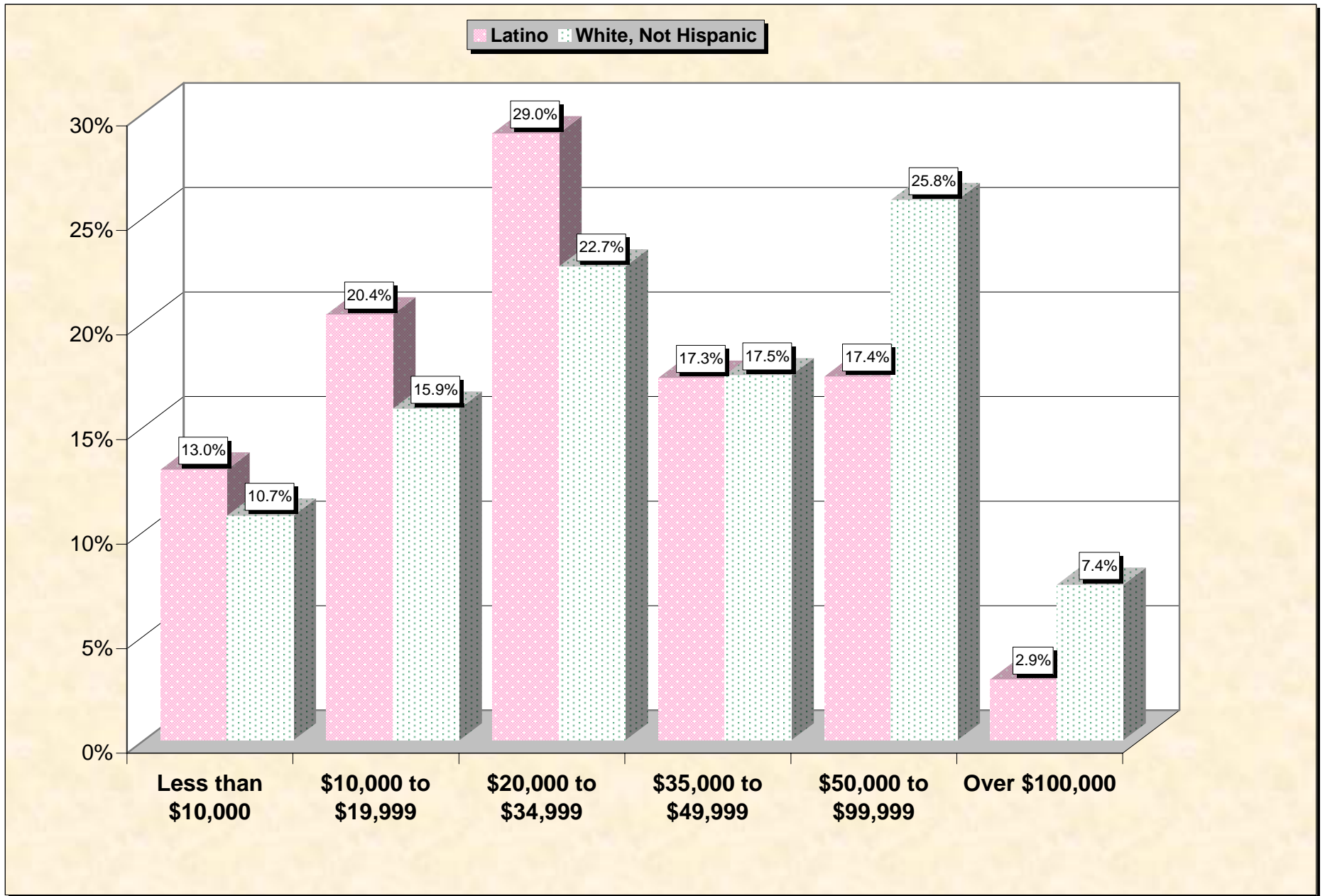
# Chart 5 -- Labor Force Participation (Civilian Labor Force) Oklahoma

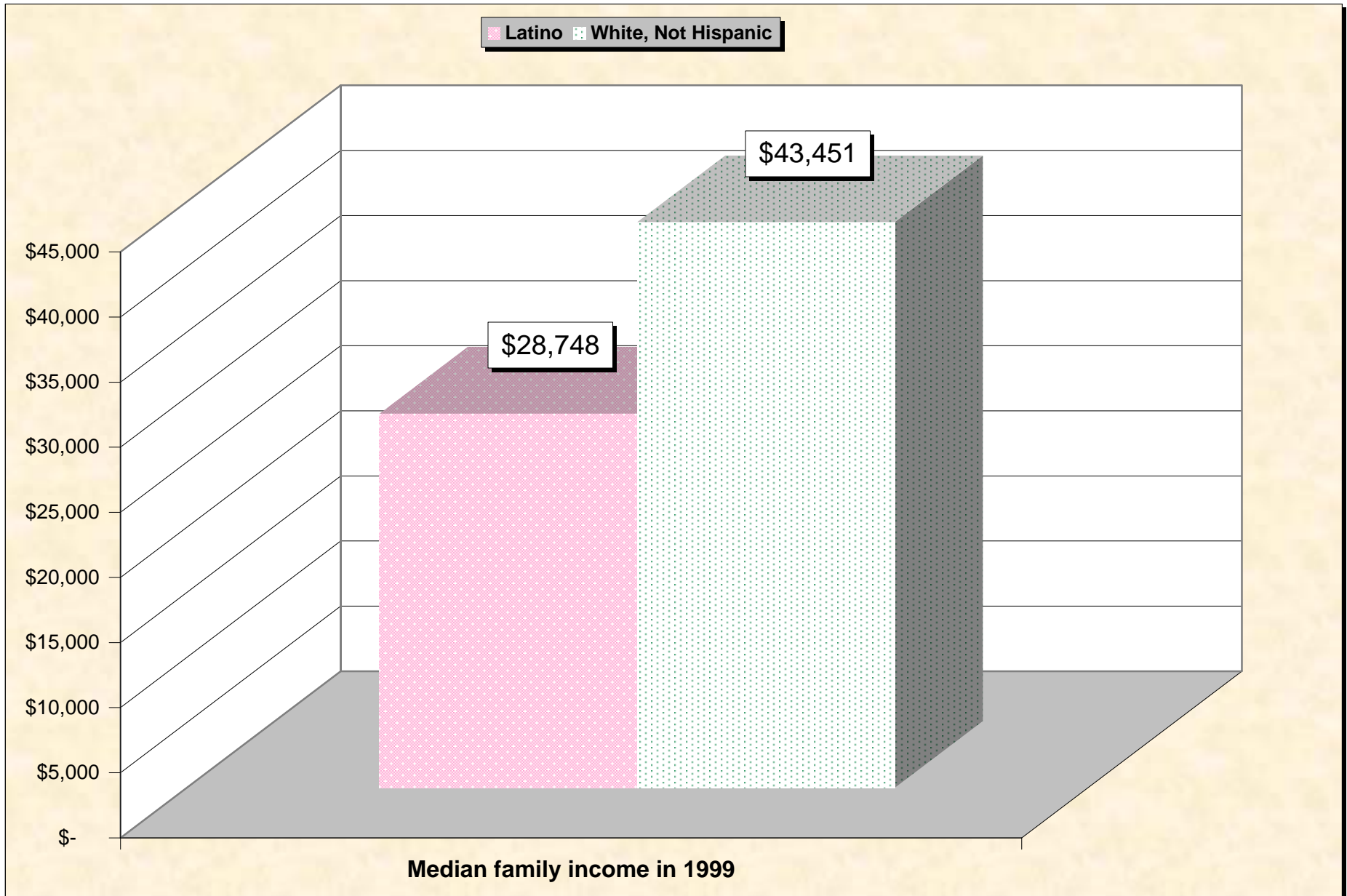

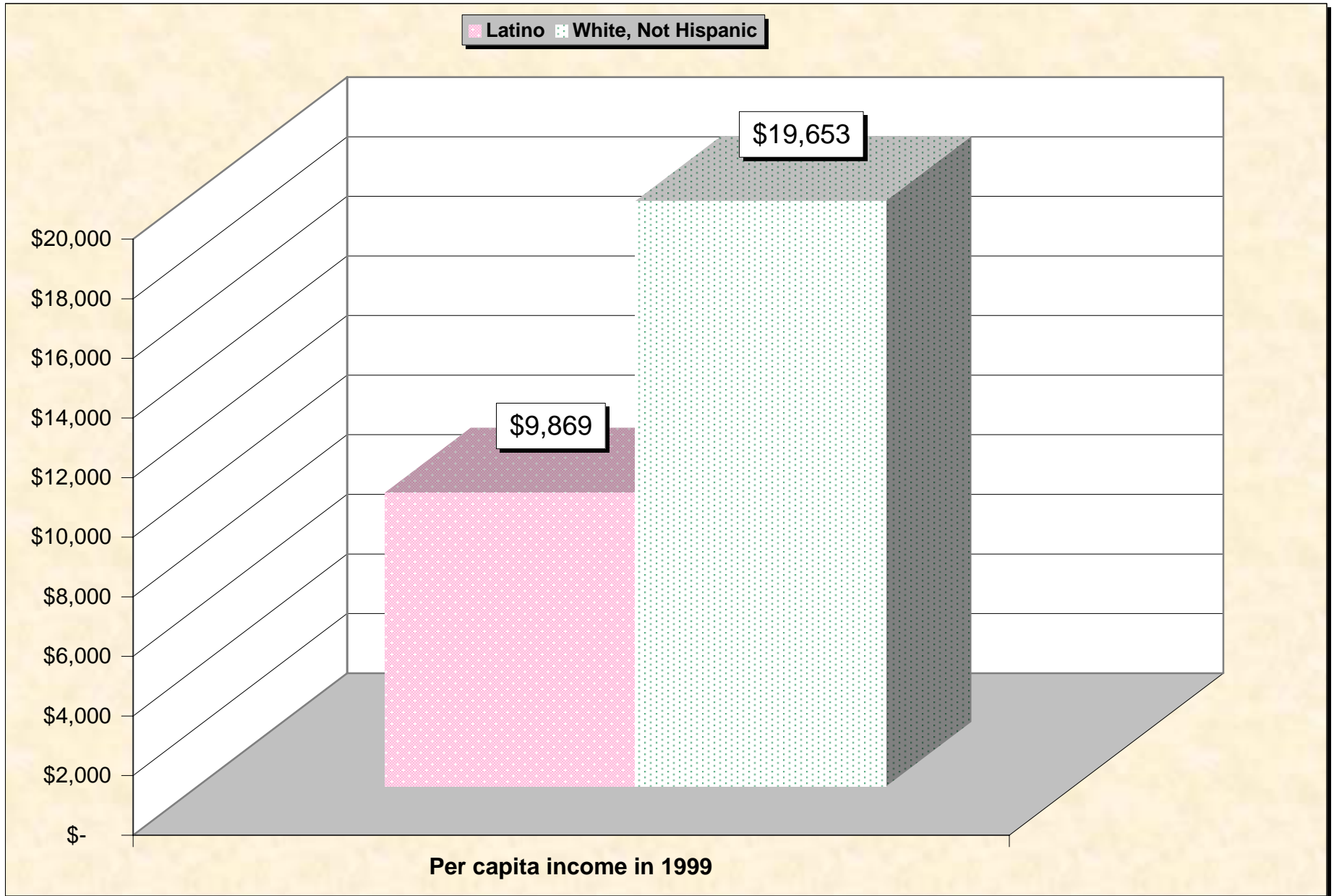
# Chart 7 -- Median Family Income In 1999 Oklahoma

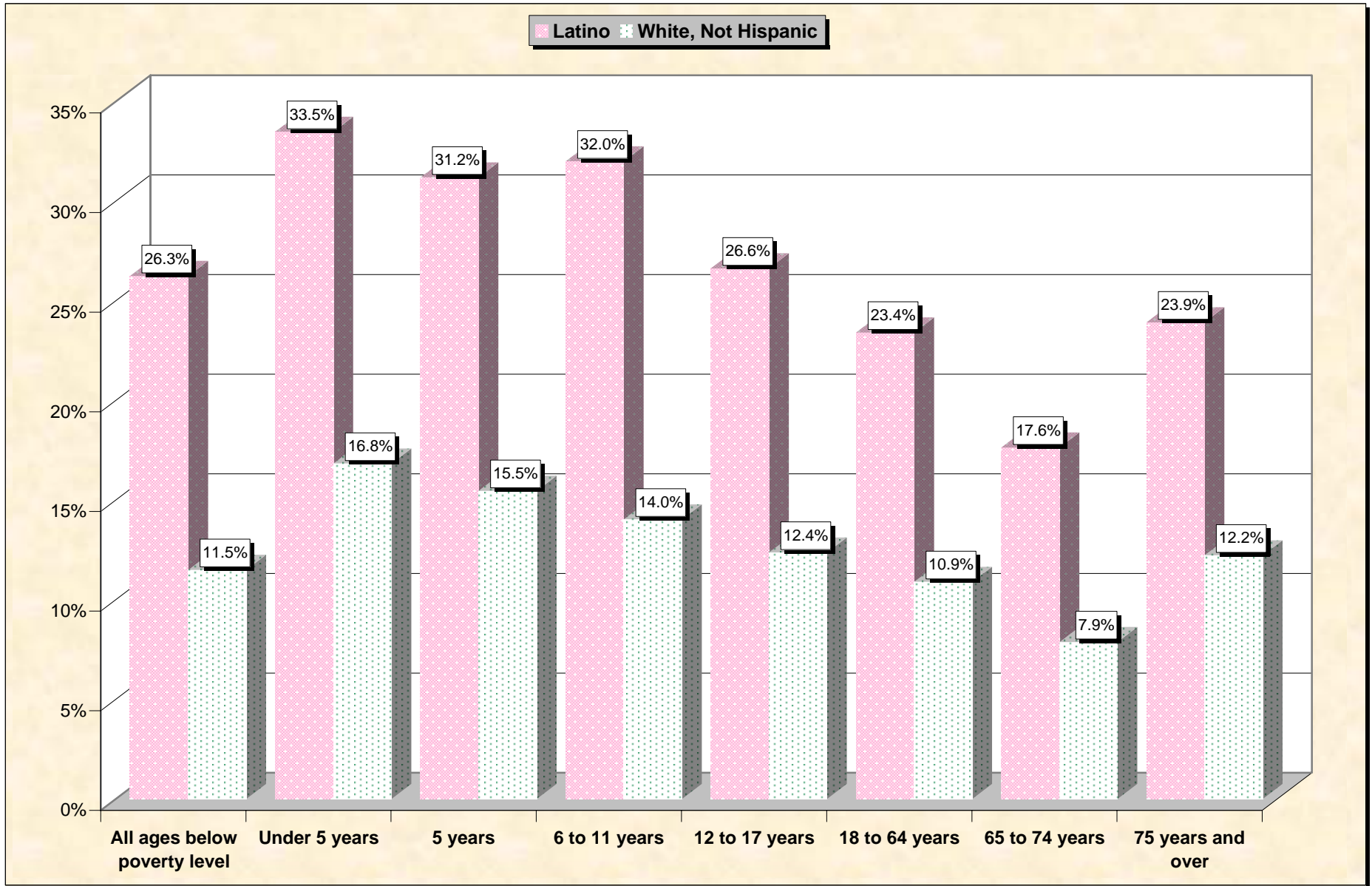


# Chart 8 -- Per Capita Income In 1999 Oklahoma



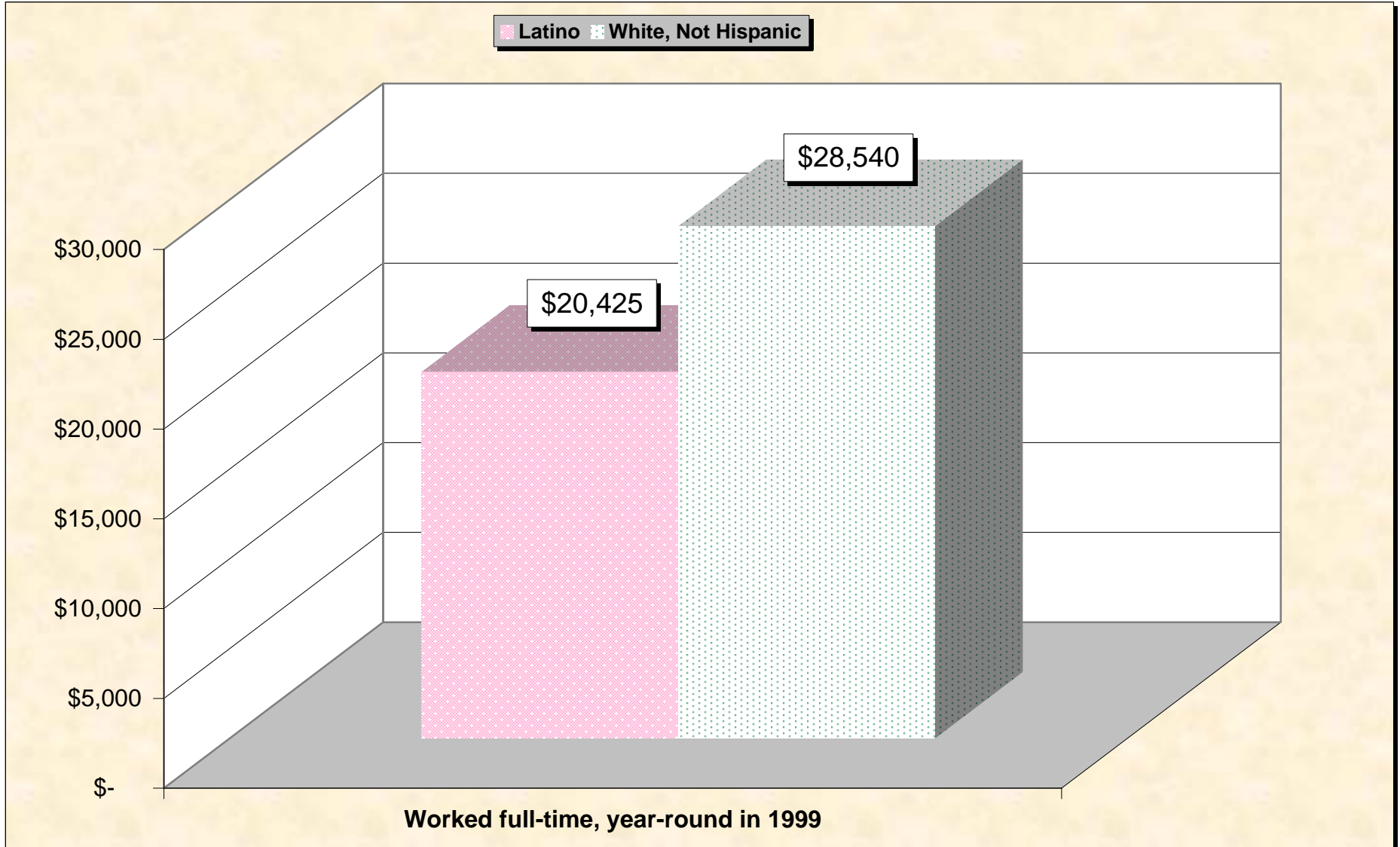

## Chart 9 -- Income in 1999 Below Poverty Level by Age Oklahoma



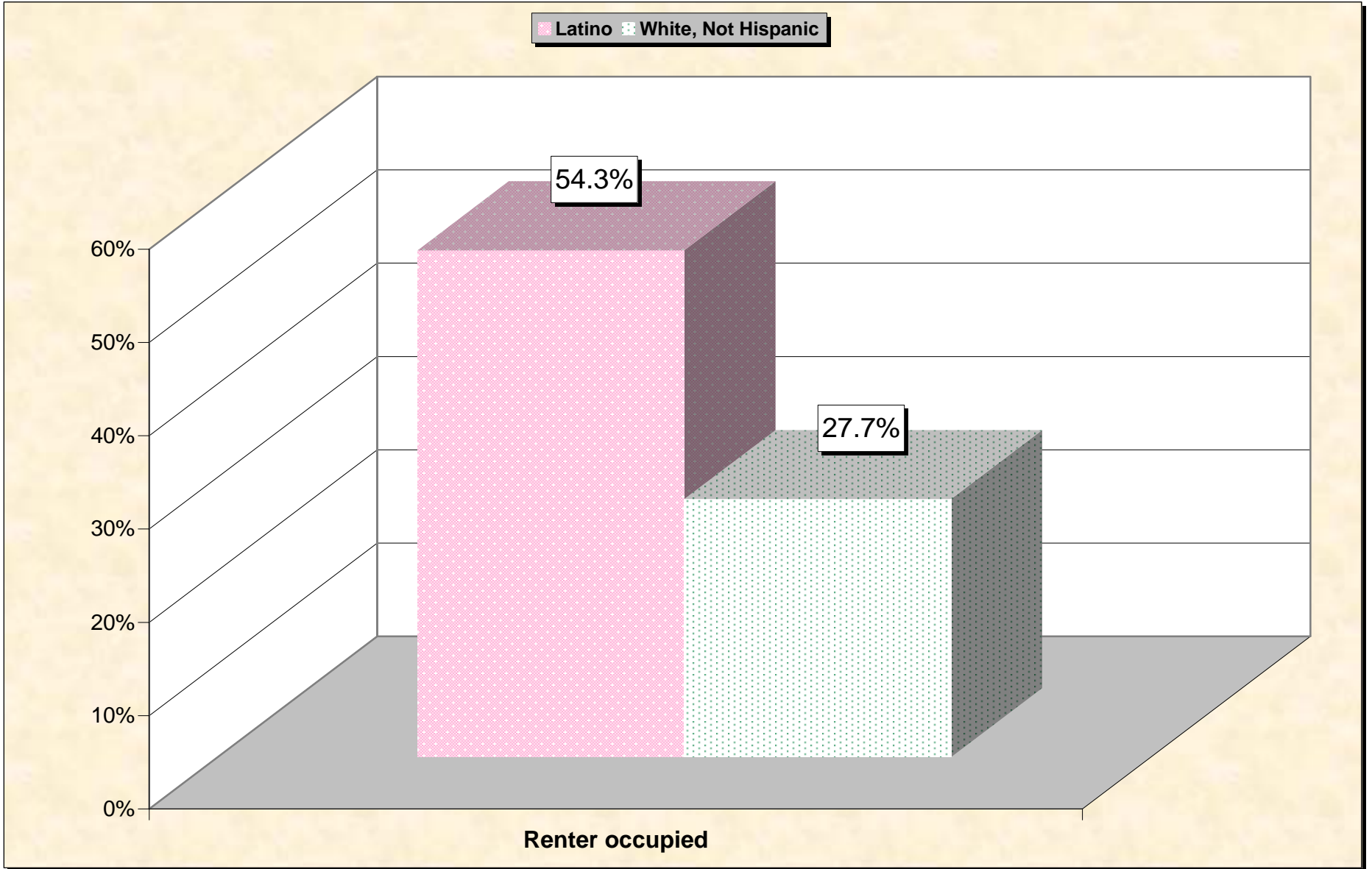

# Chart 10 -- Median Earnings in 1999 Oklahoma



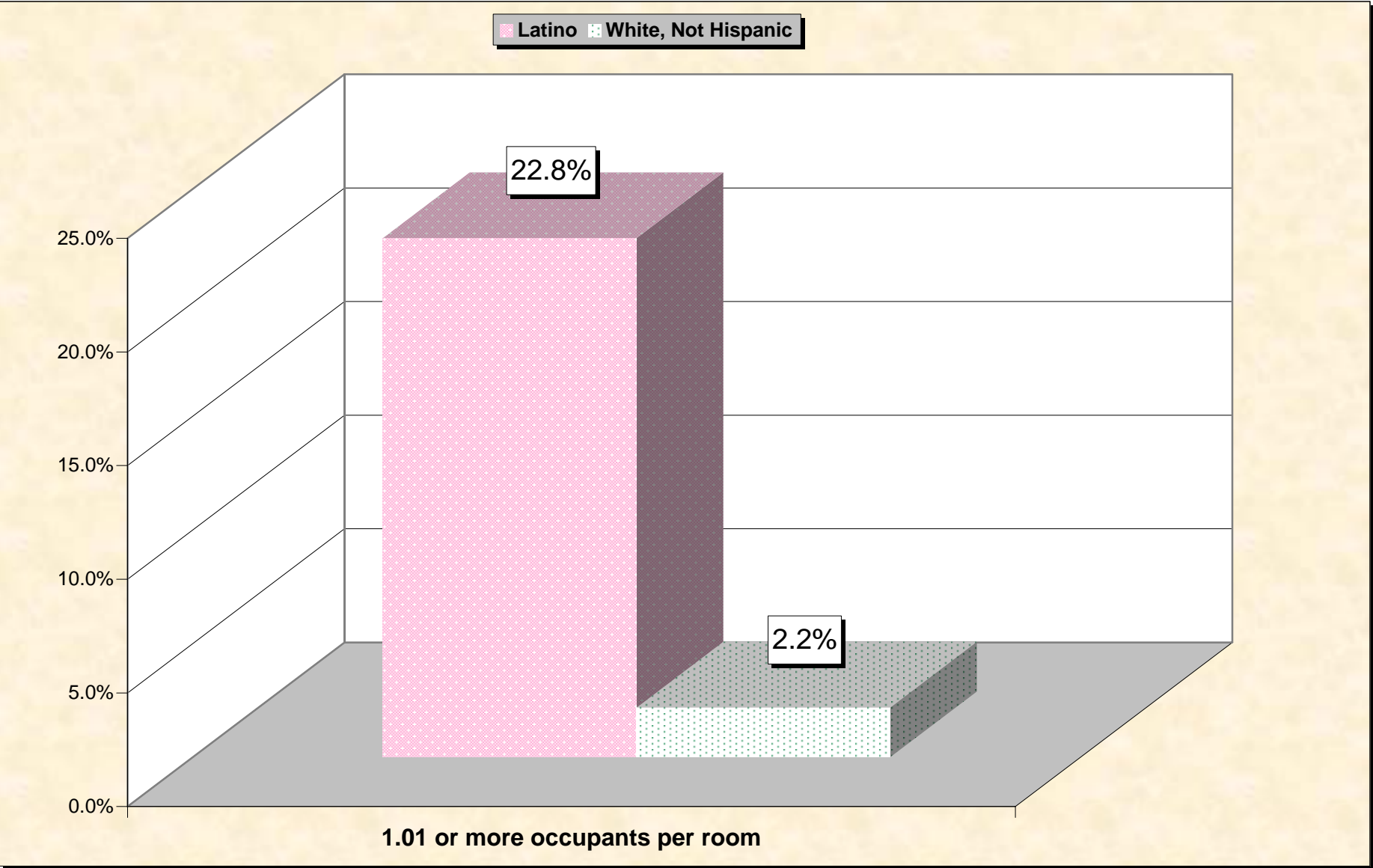

# Chart 11 -- Renter-Occupied Housing Oklahoma



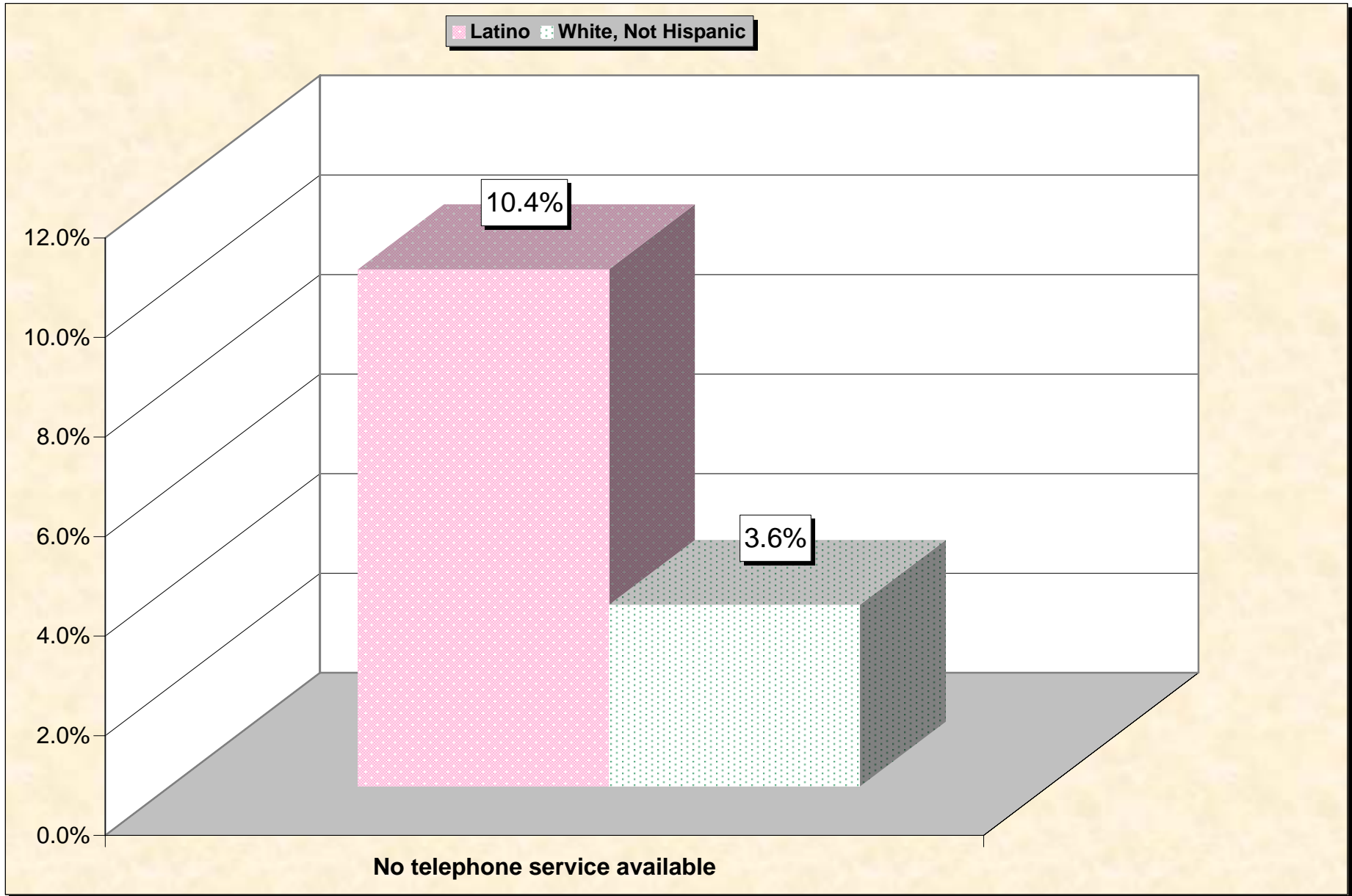

# Chart 12 -- Occupants Per Room (Crowding) by Household Oklahoma



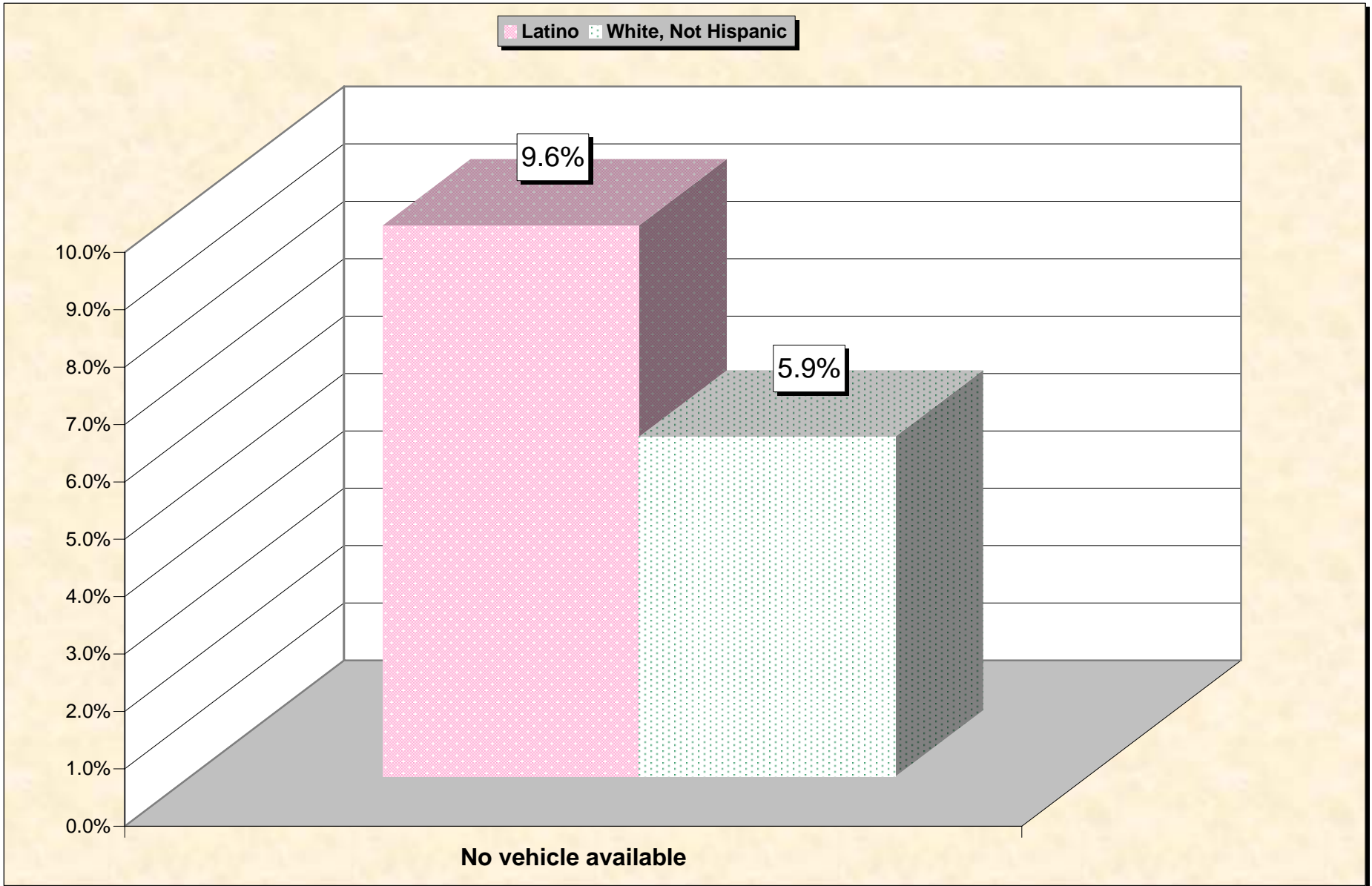

# Chart 13 -- Lack of Telephone Service by Household Oklahoma



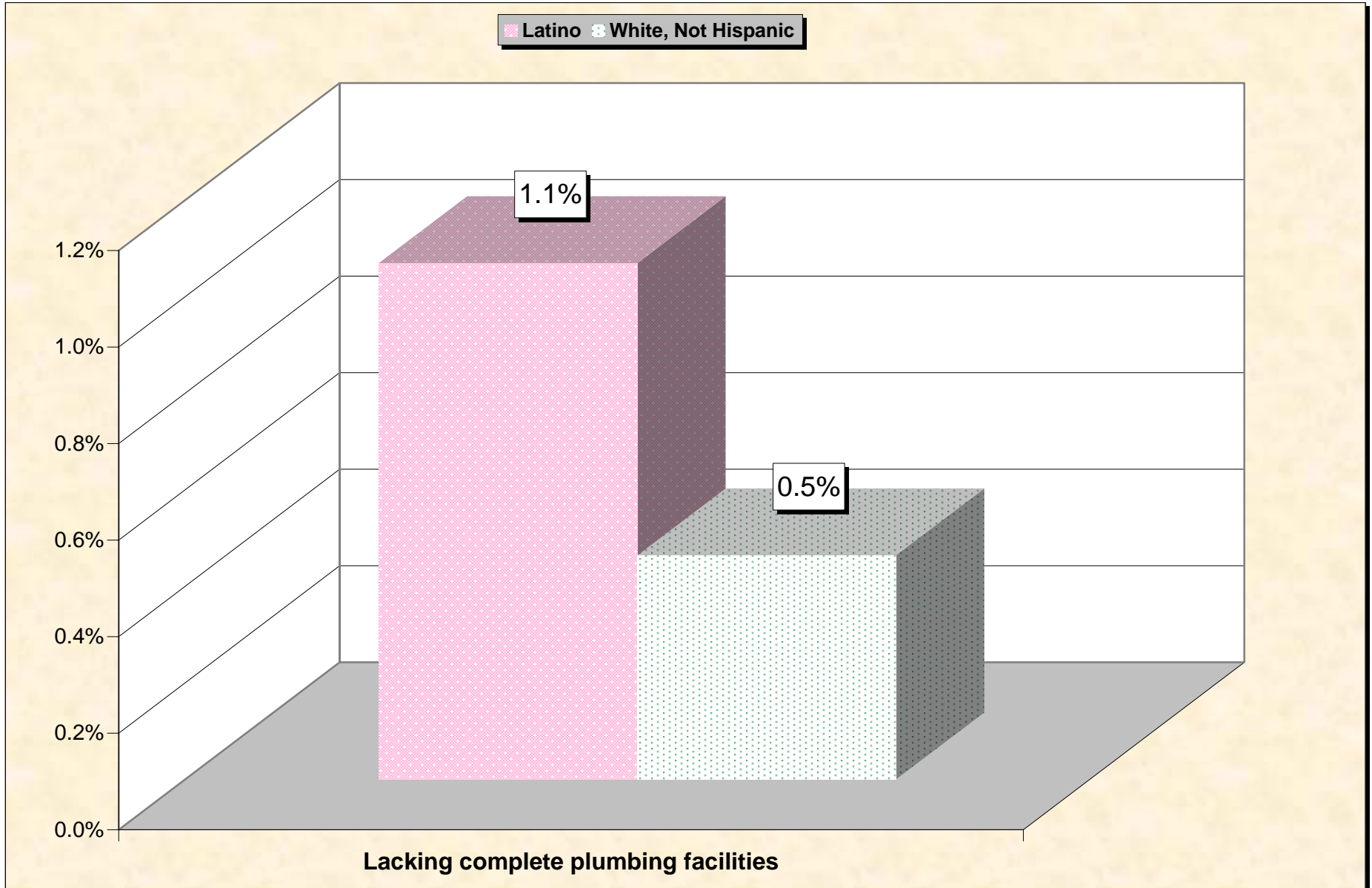

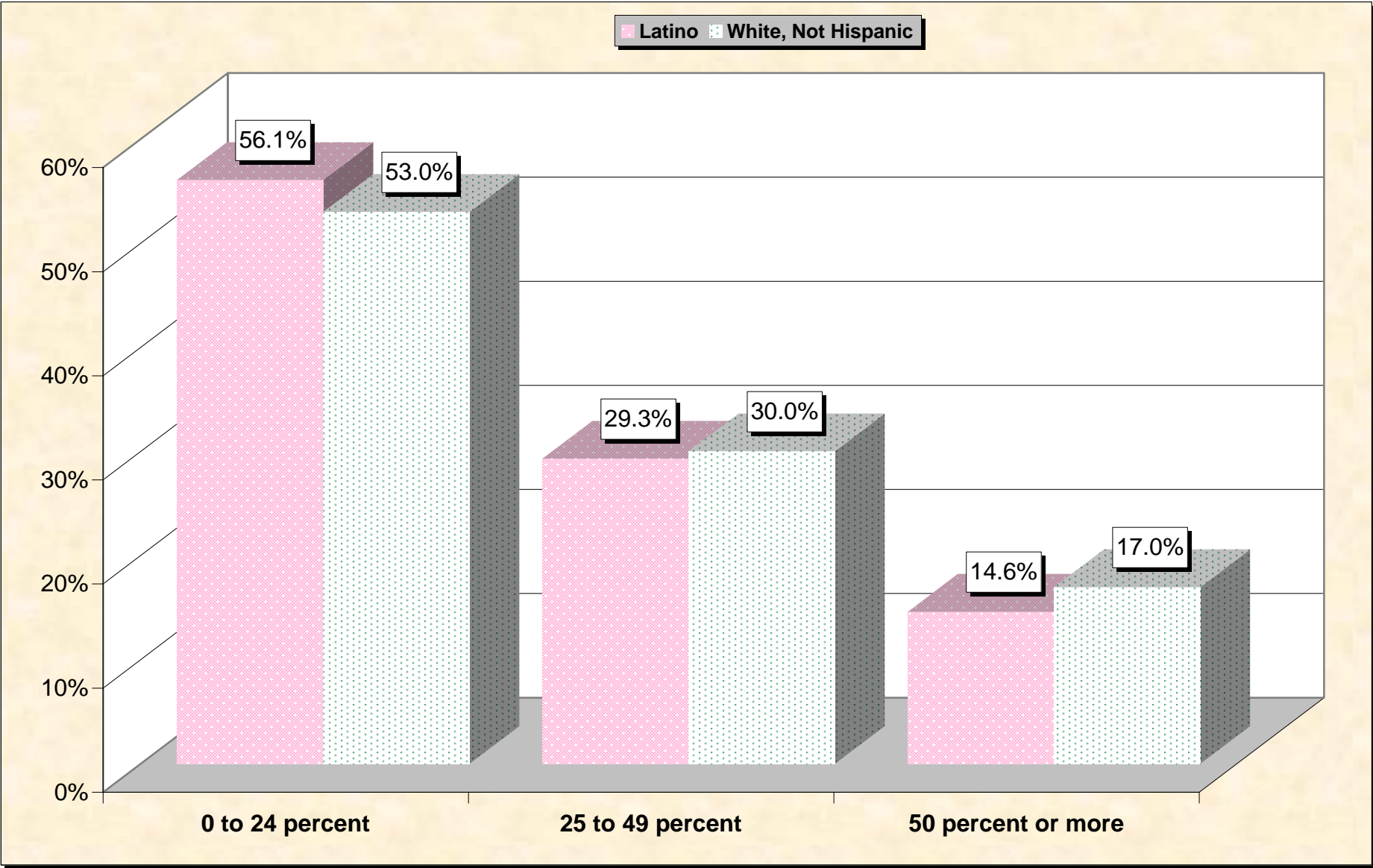
# Chart 15 -- Lack of Plumbing By Household Oklahoma

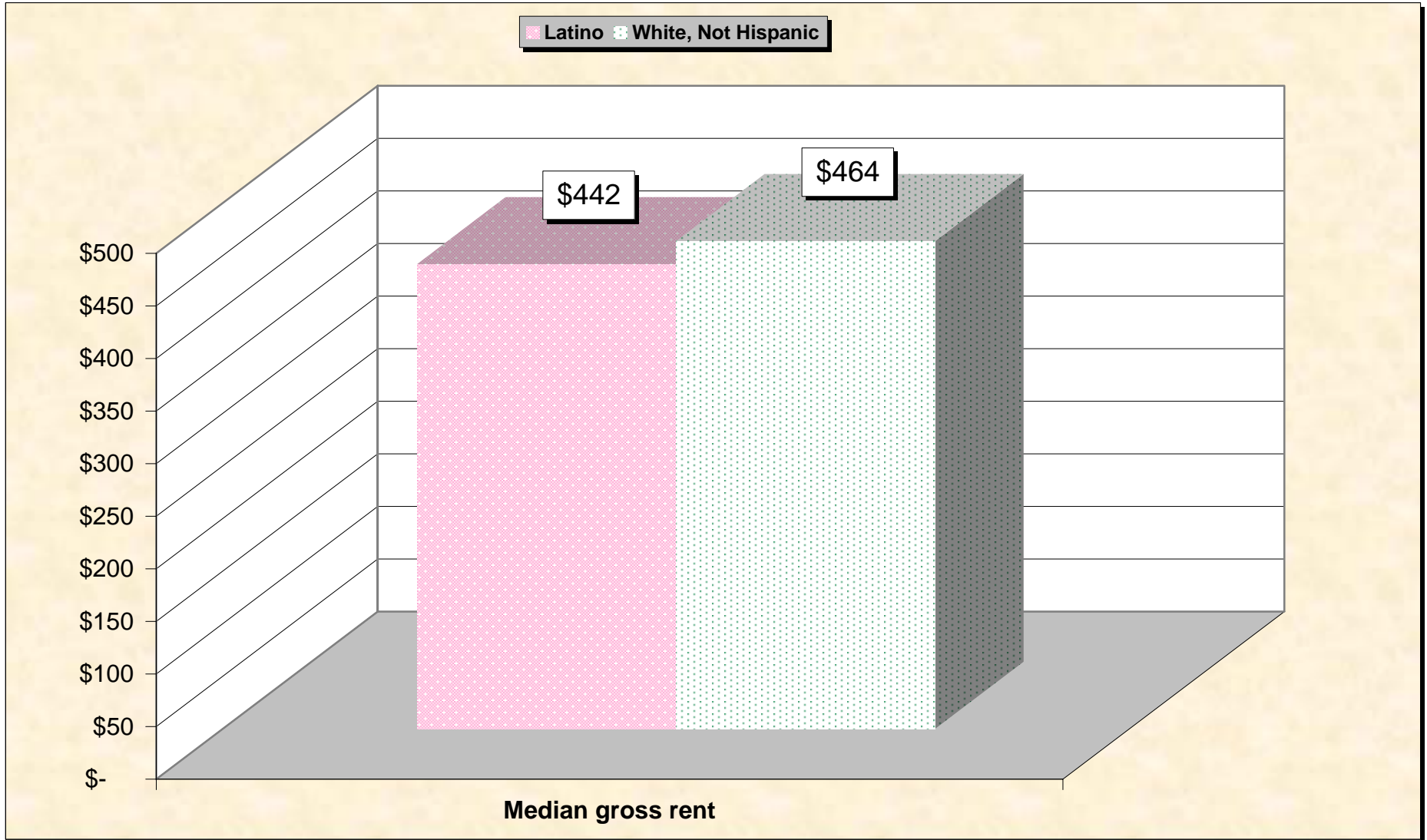


# Chart 16 -- Gross Rent as a Percentage of Household Income in 1999 Oklahoma



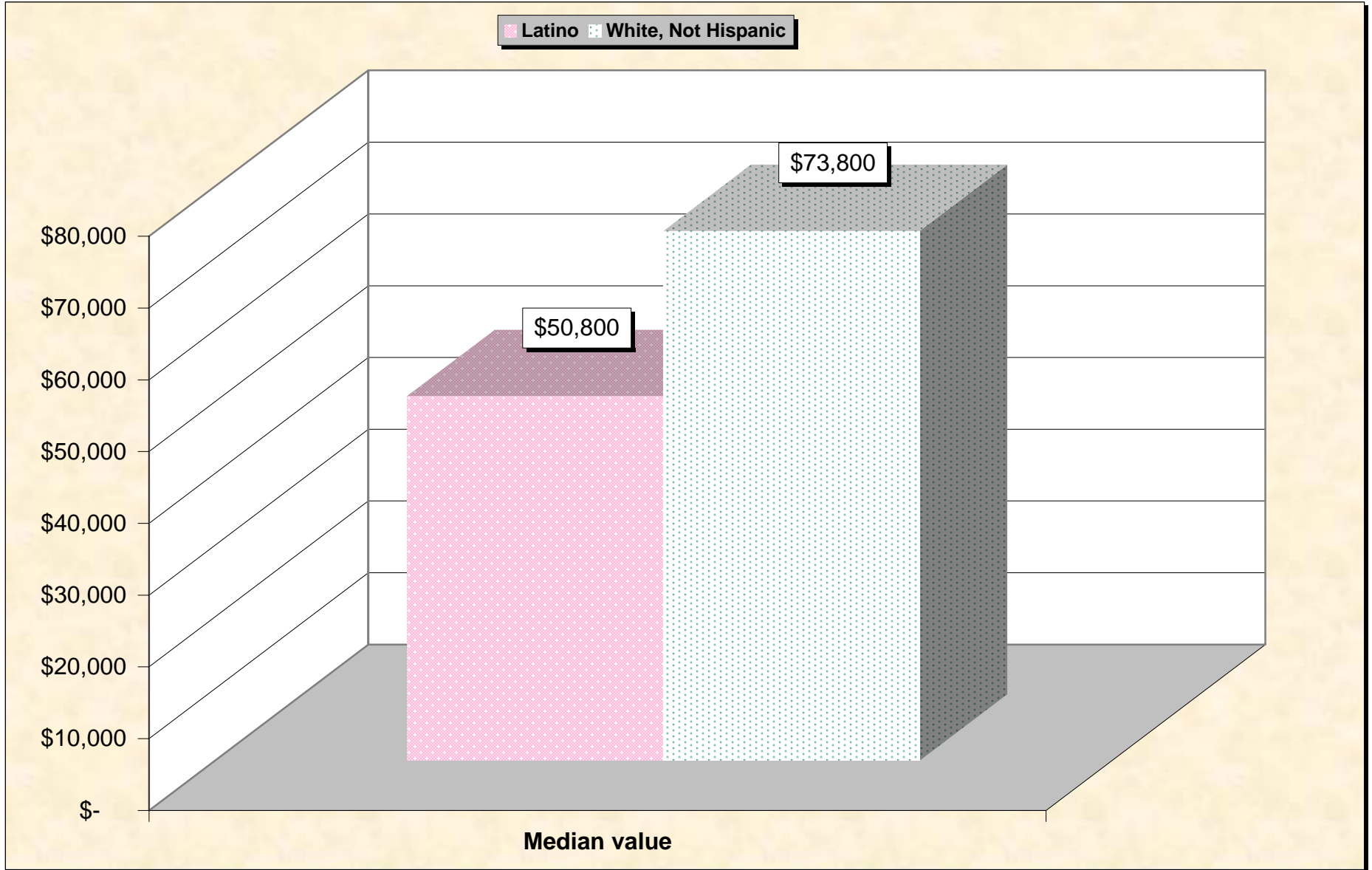
