





Chart 1 -- Single-Parent Family Households (Householder 15 to 64 years) Oregon





Chart 2 -- Private School Enrollment (3 years and over) Oregon






Chart 4 -- Unemployment Rate (Civilian Labor Force) Oregon


Chart 5 -- Labor Force Participation (Civilian Labor Force) Oregon



Chart 6 -- Household Income in 1999 Oregon





Chart 7 -- Median Family Income In 1999 Oregon





Chart 8 -- Per Capita Income In 1999 Oregon





Chart 9 -- Income in 1999 Below Poverty Level by Age Oregon





Chart 10 -- Median Earnings in 1999 Oregon





Chart 11 -- Renter-Occupied Housing Oregon





Chart 12 -- Occupants Per Room (Crowding) by Household Oregon





Chart 13 -- Lack of Telephone Service by Household Oregon





Chart 14 -- Lack of Vehicle By Household Oregon





Chart 15 -- Lack of Plumbing By Household Oregon





Chart 16 -- Gross Rent as a Percentage of Household Income in 1999 Oregon




