

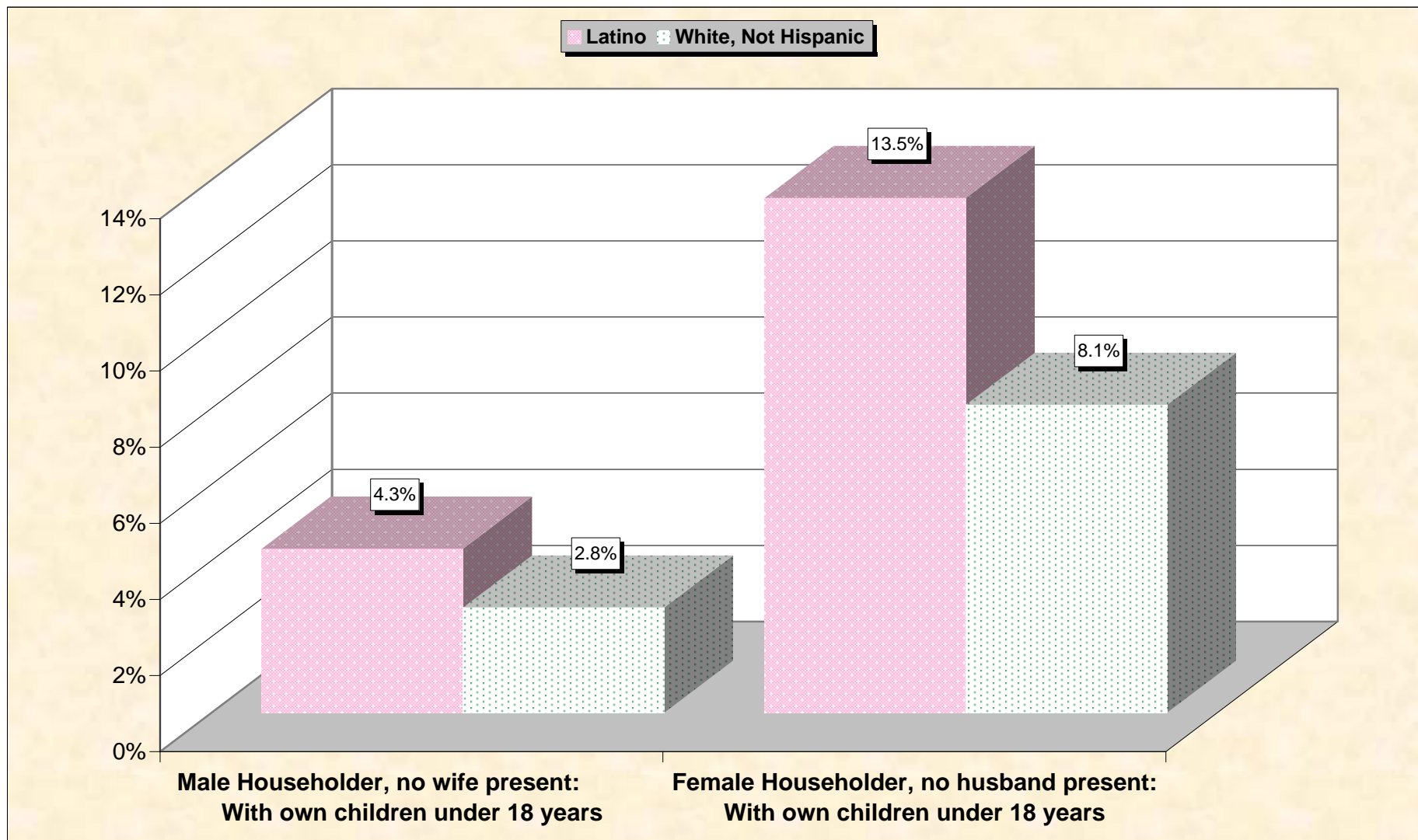

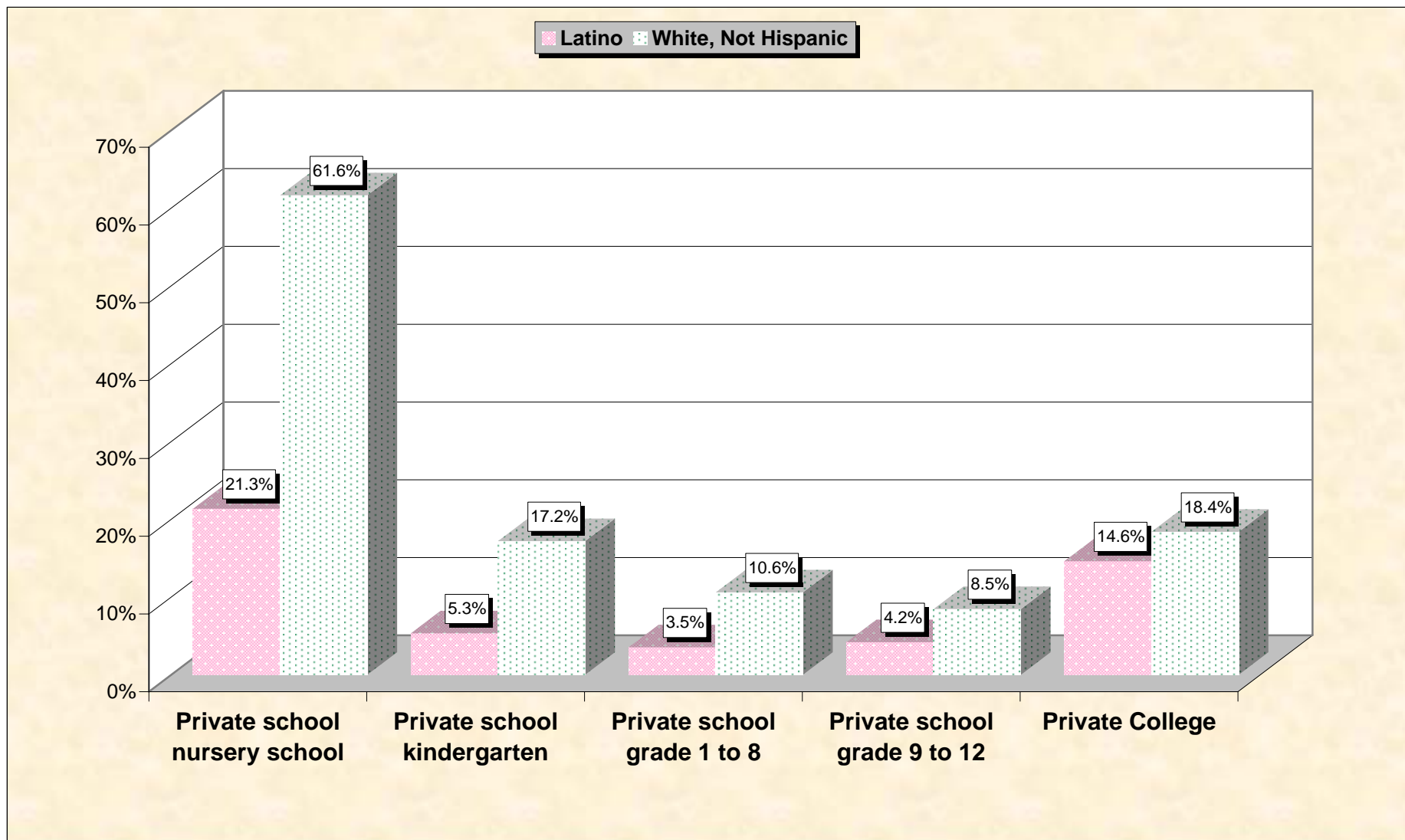
Chart 1 -- Single-Parent Family Households (Householder 15 to 64 years)

Chart 2 -- Private School Enrollment (3 years and over)

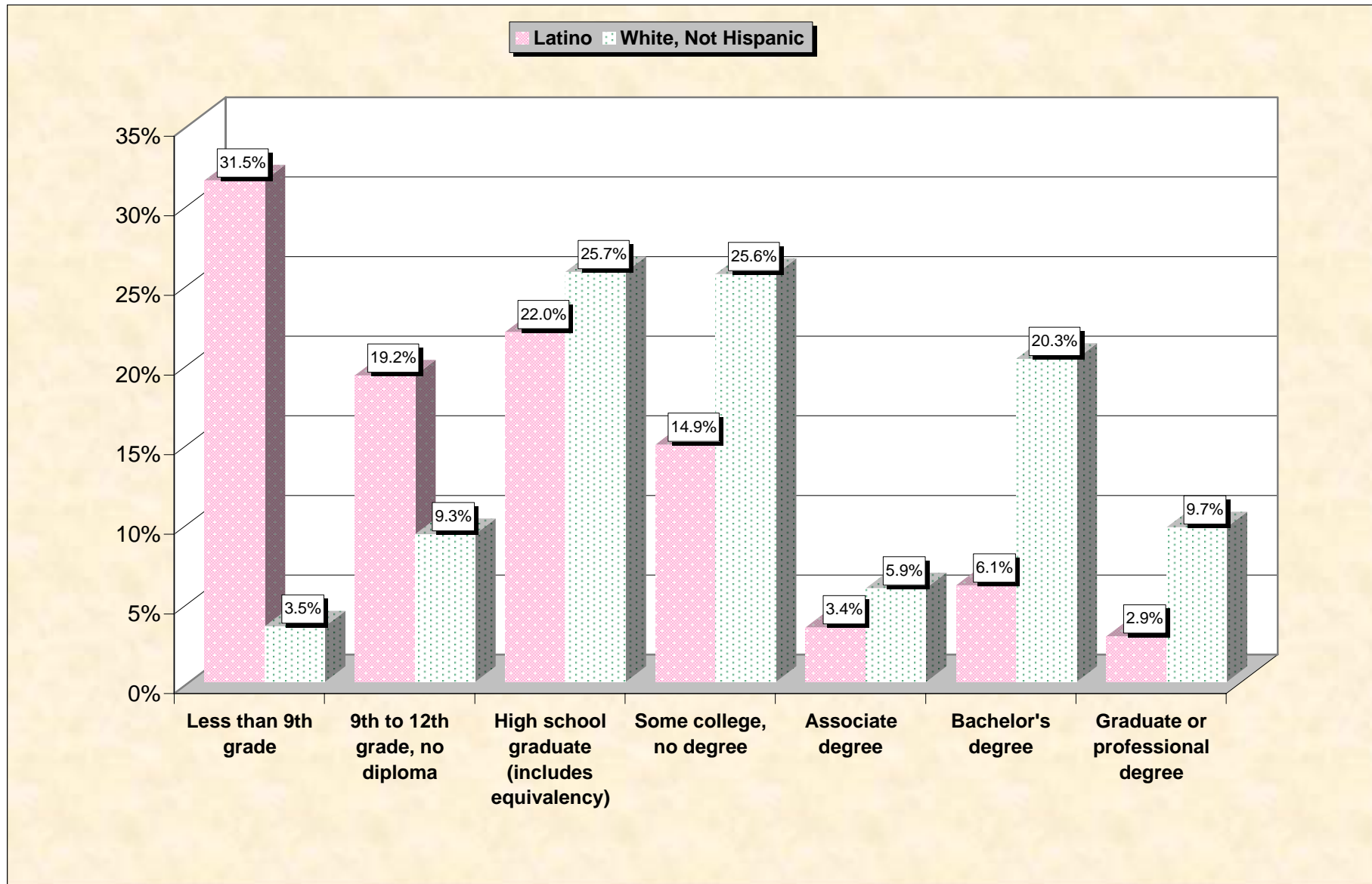

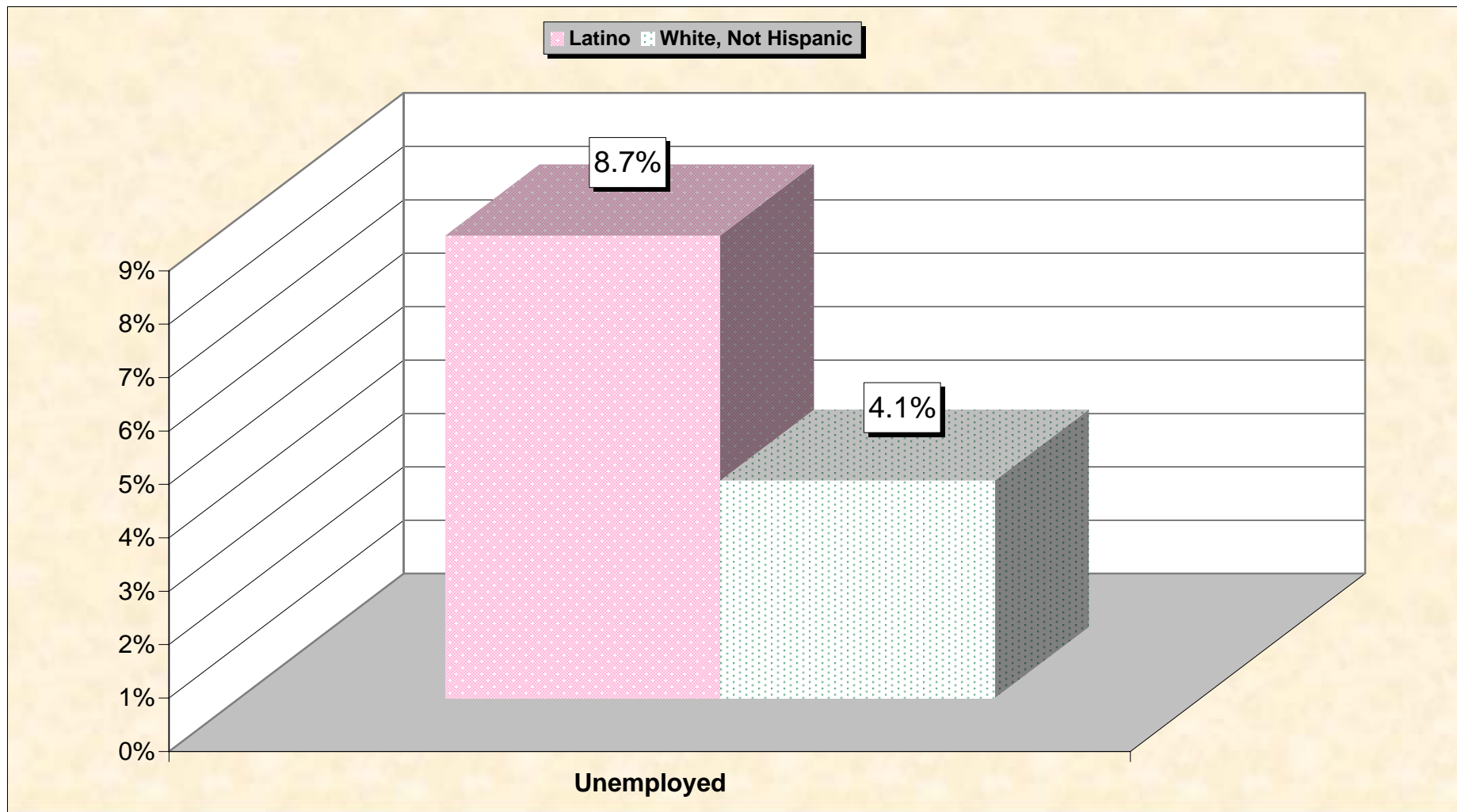
Chart 3 -- Educational Attainment (25 years and over)

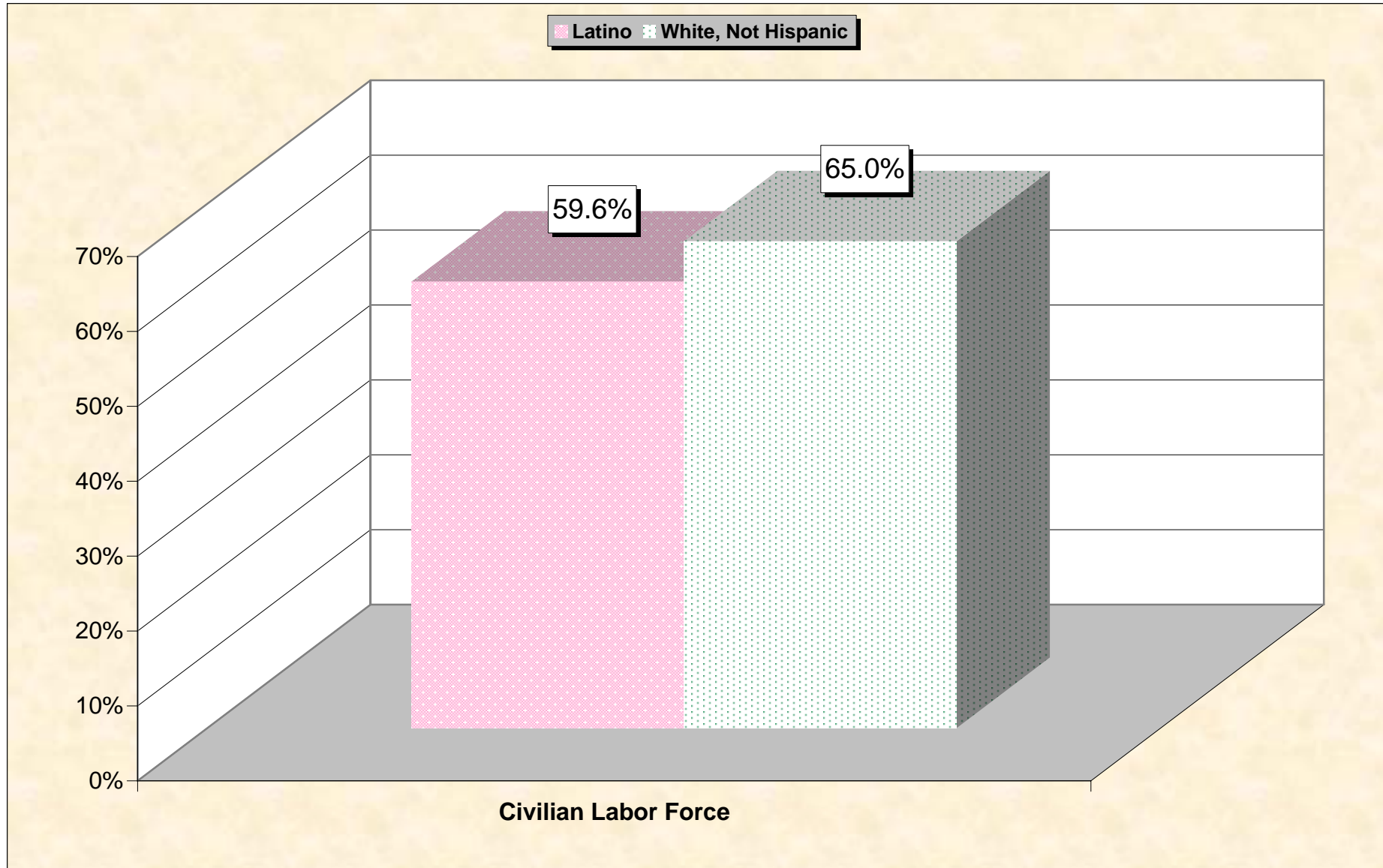
Chart 4 -- Unemployment Rate (Civilian Labor Force) Texas

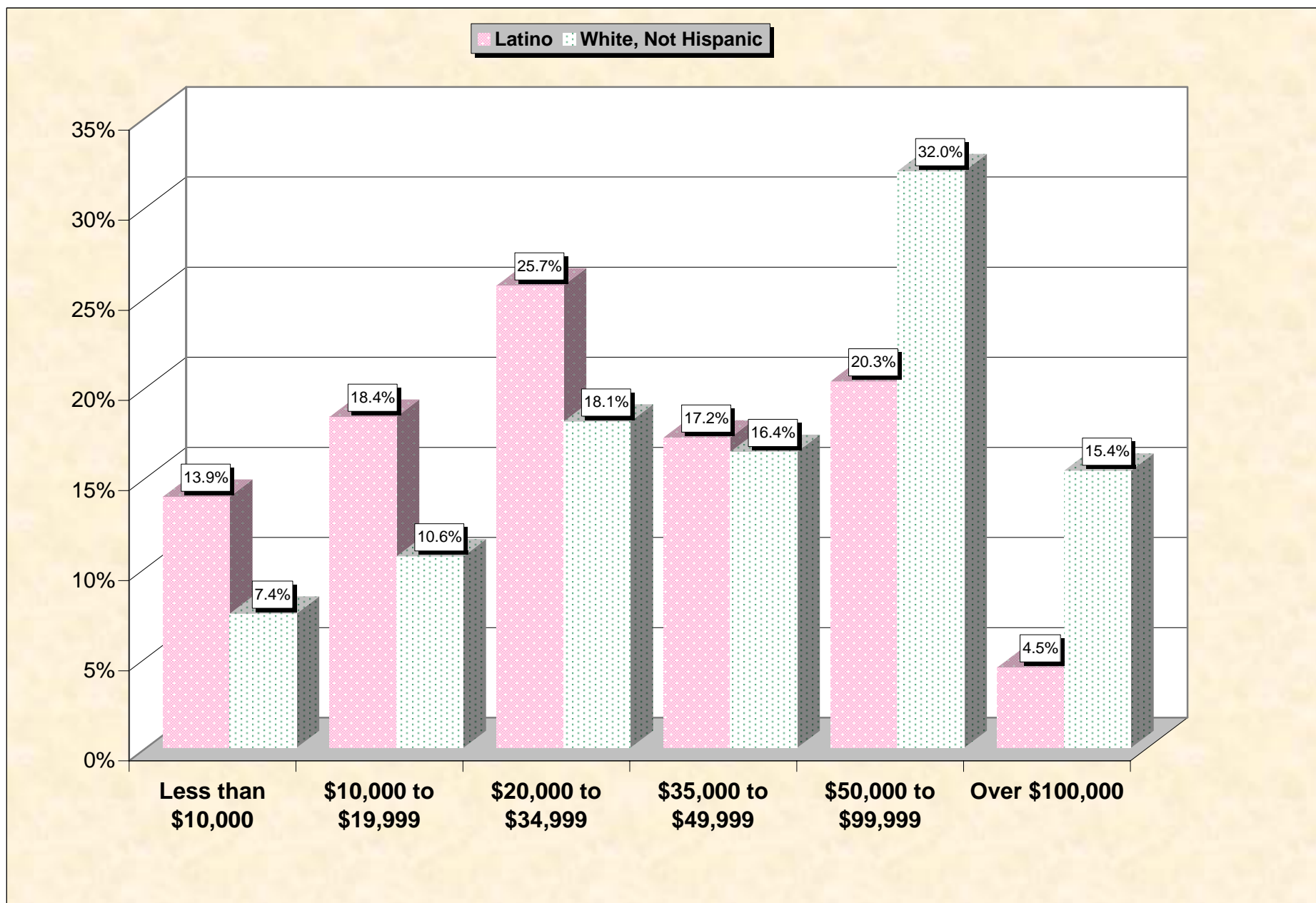
Chart 5 -- Labor Force Participation (Civilian Labor Force) Texas

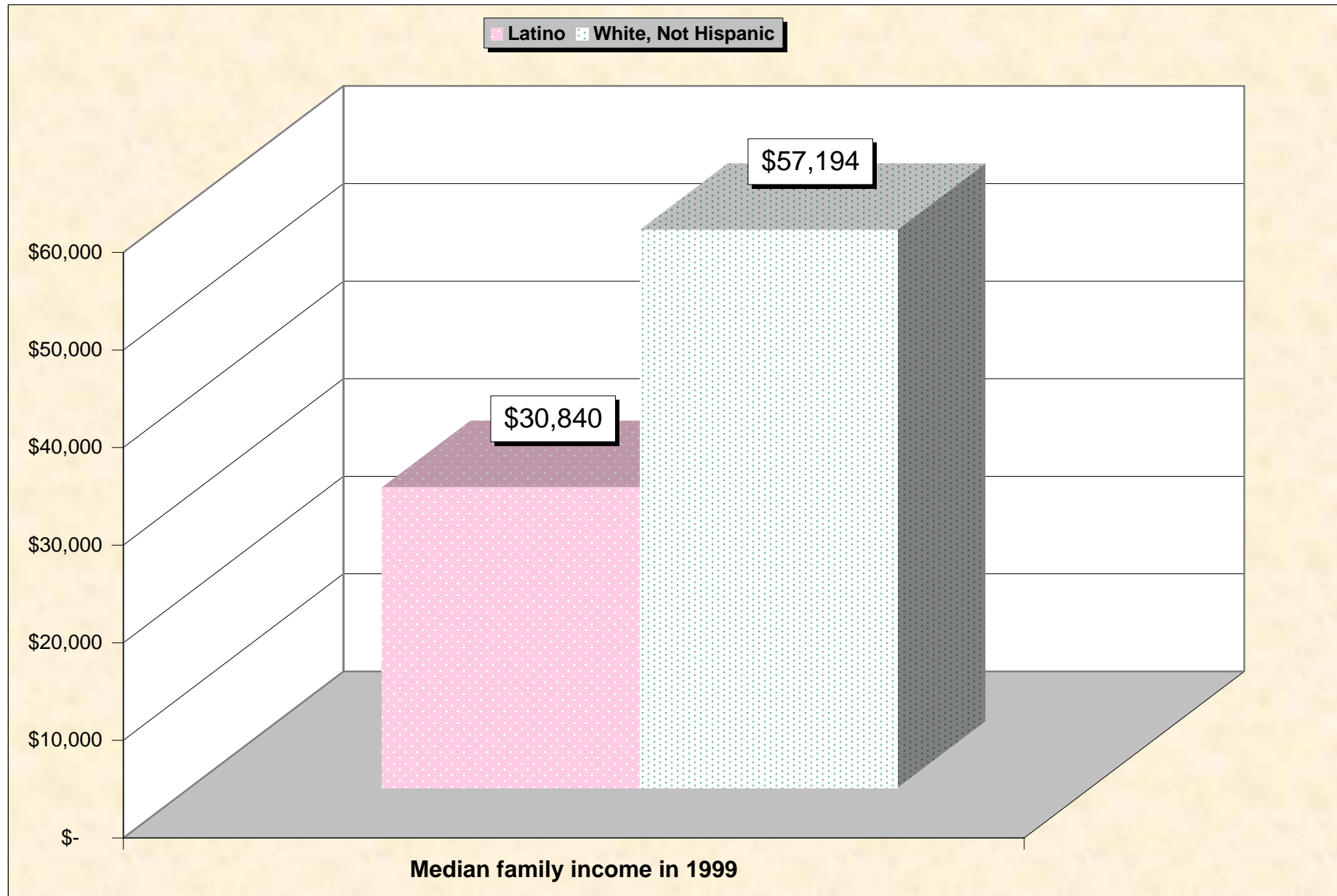

Chart 6 -- Household Income in 1999 Texas



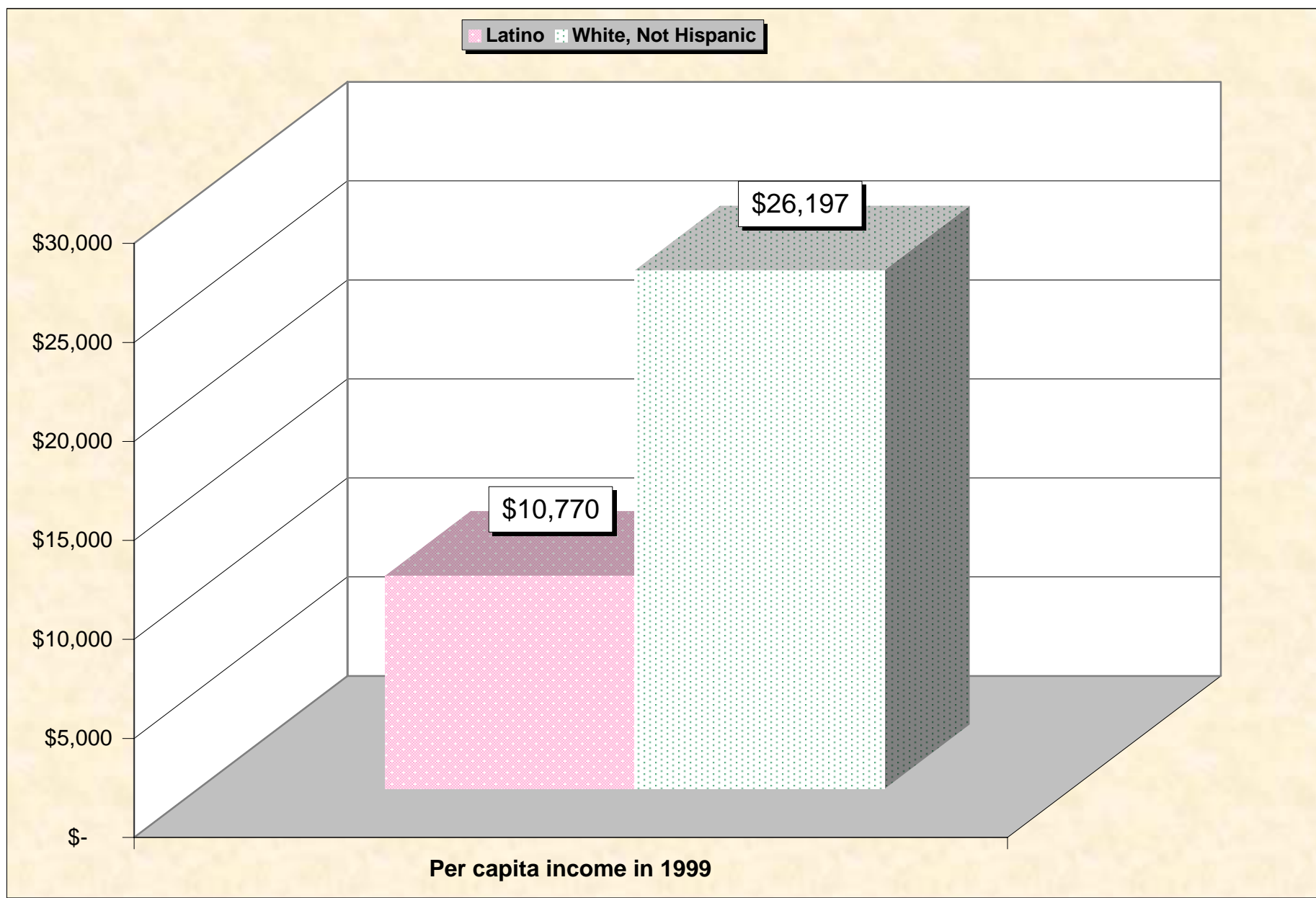

Chart 7 -- Median Family Income In 1999 Texas



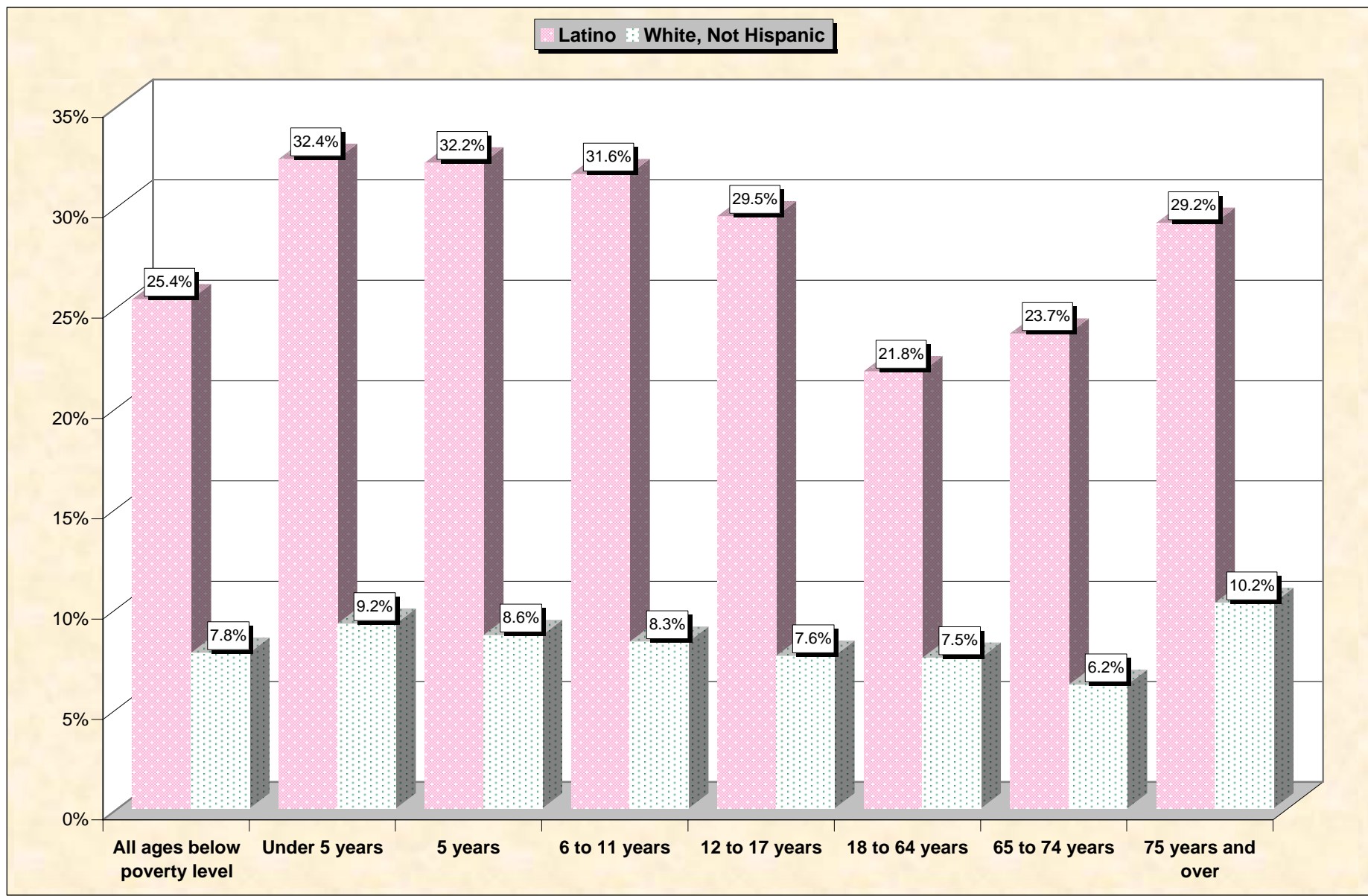

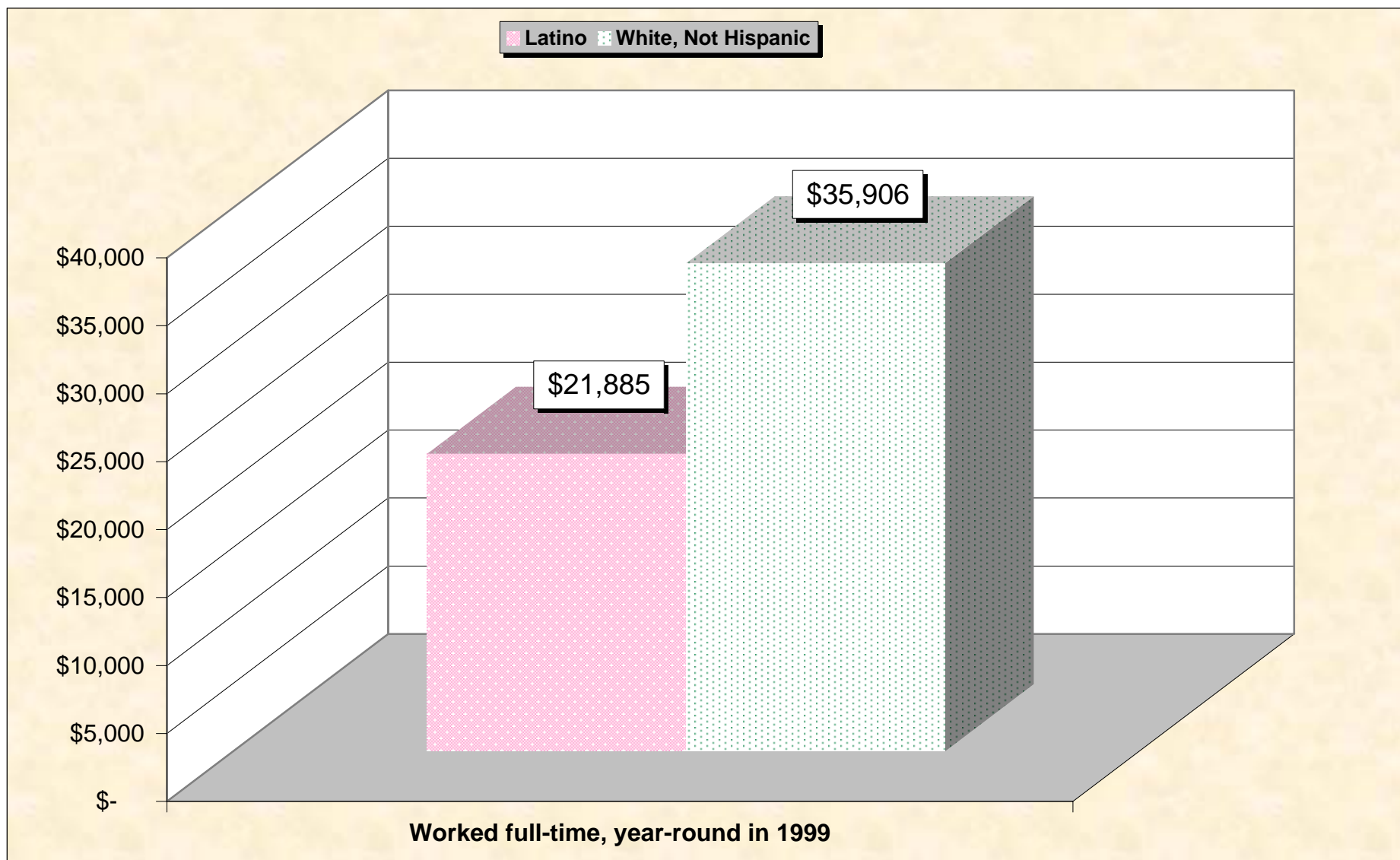
Chart 9 -- Income in 1999 Below Poverty Level by Age Texas

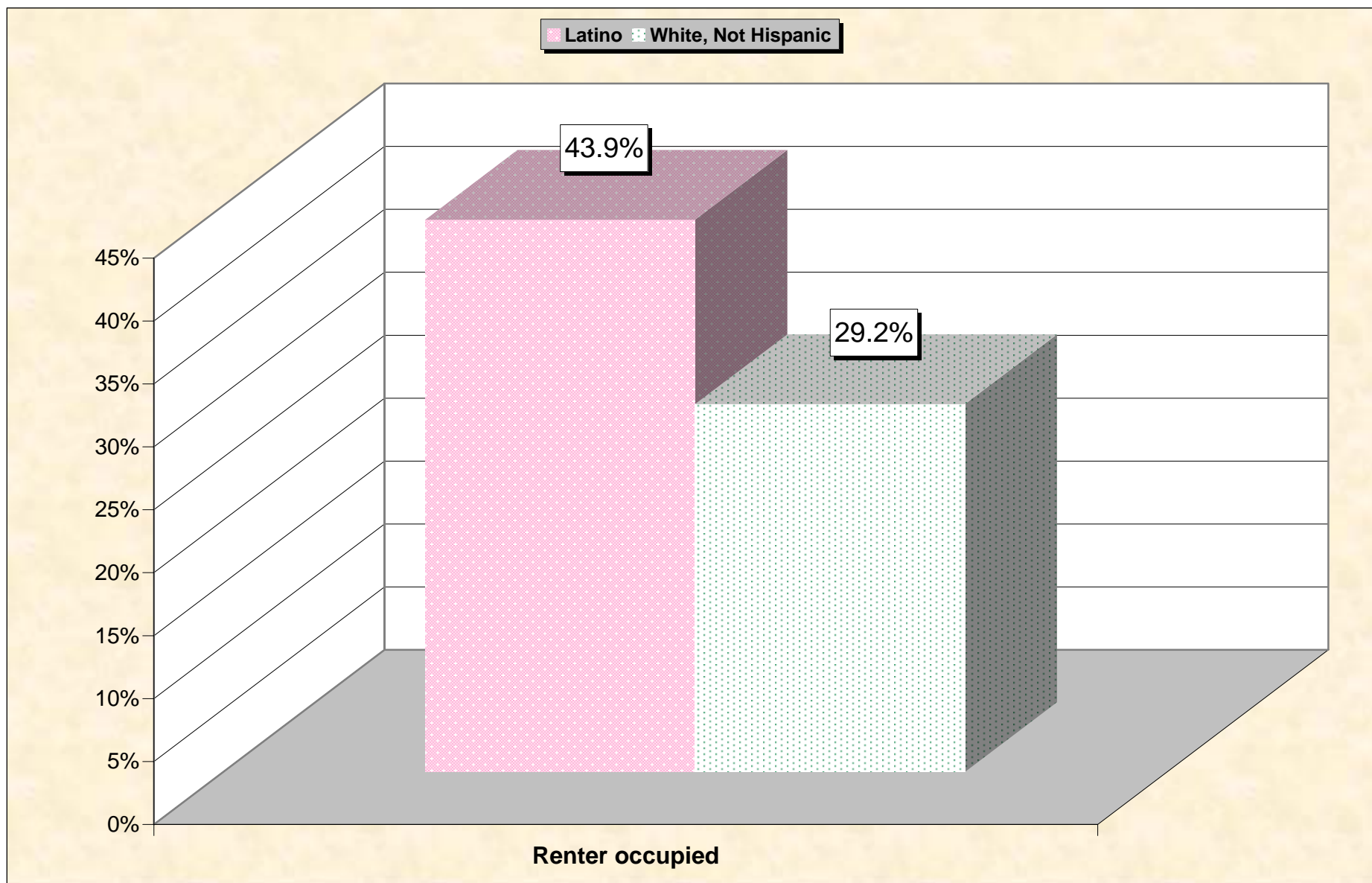
Chart 10 -- Median Earnings in 1999

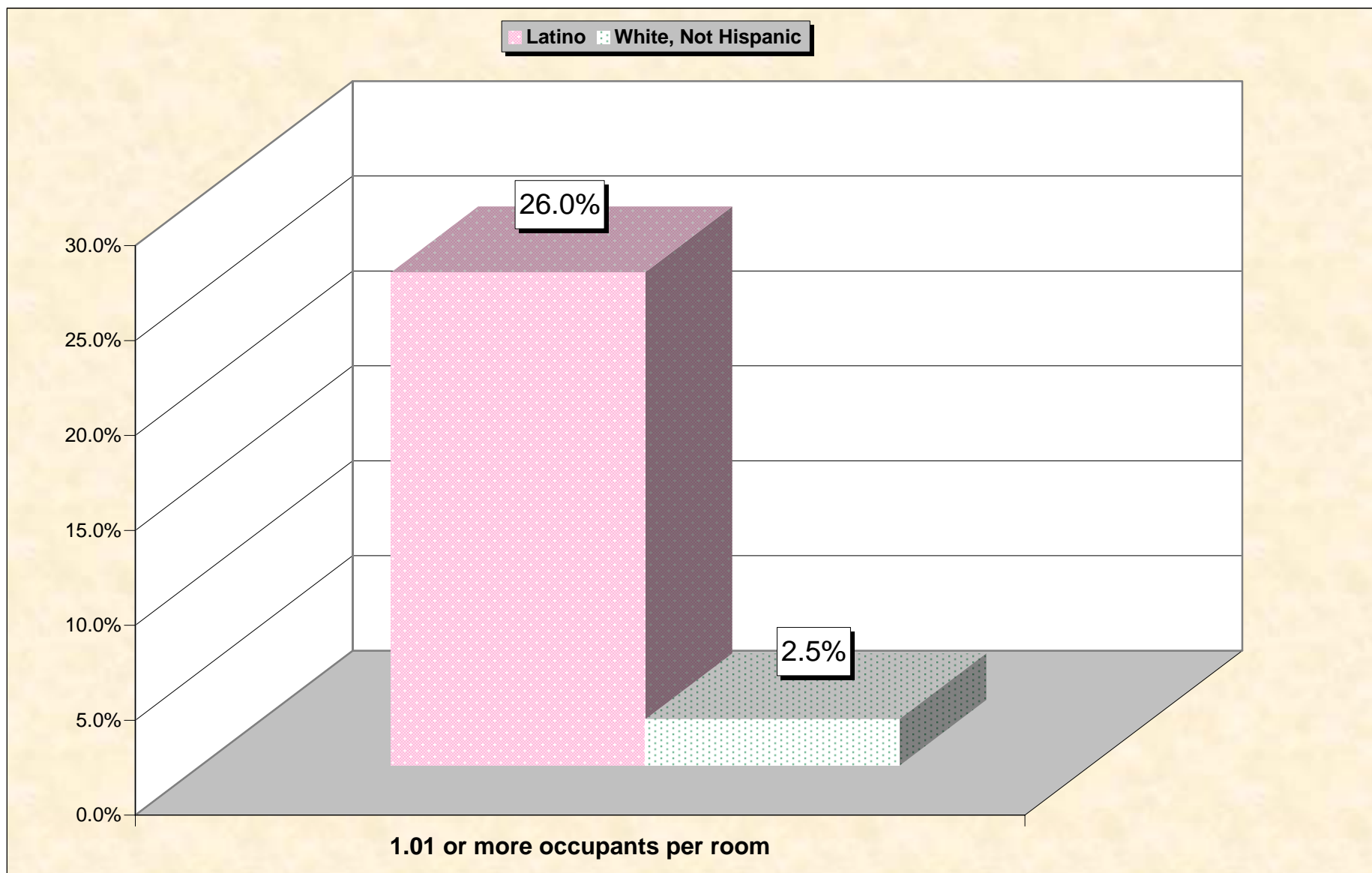

Chart 11 -- Renter-Occupied Housing Texas



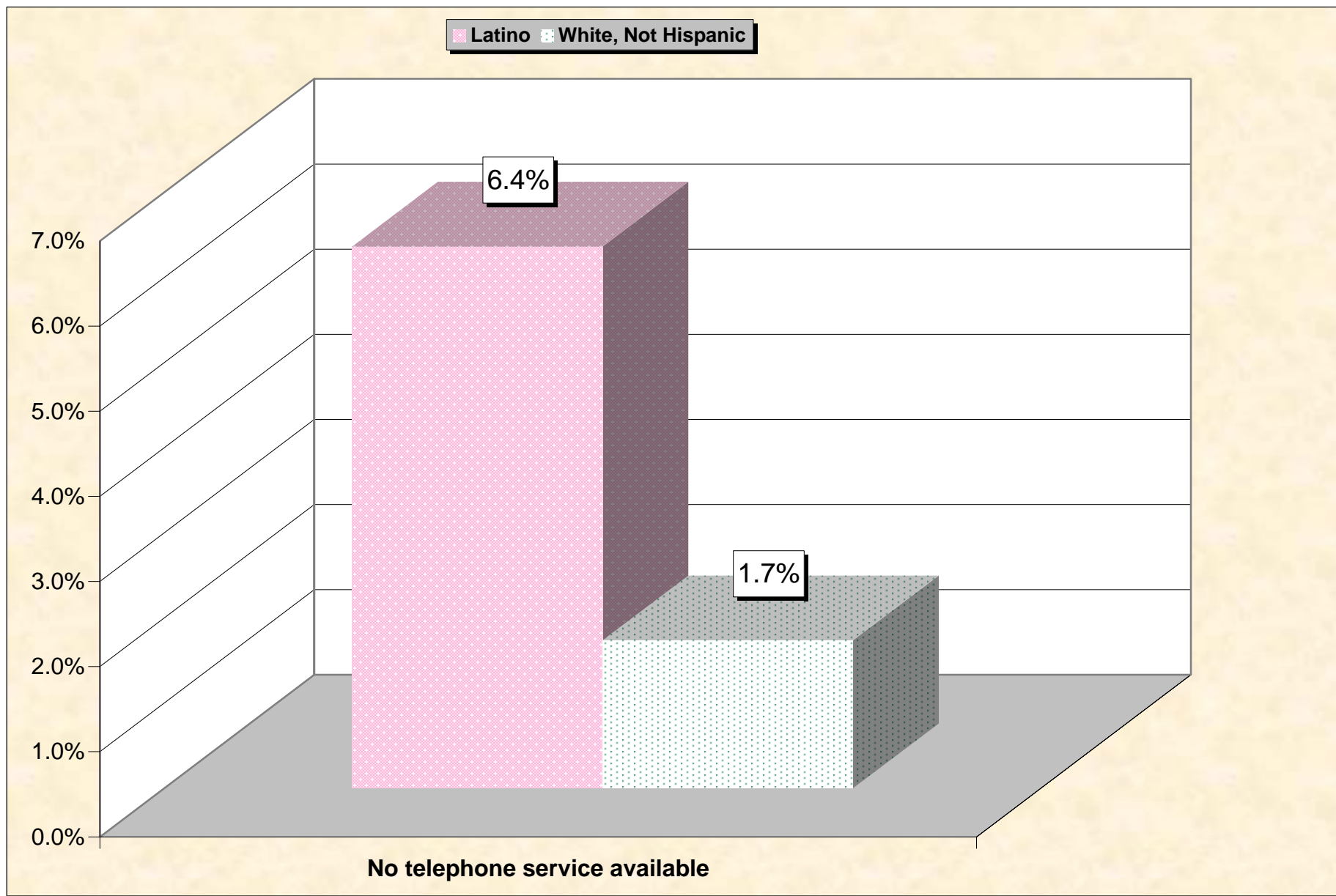

Chart 12 -- Occupants Per Room (Crowding) by Household Texas



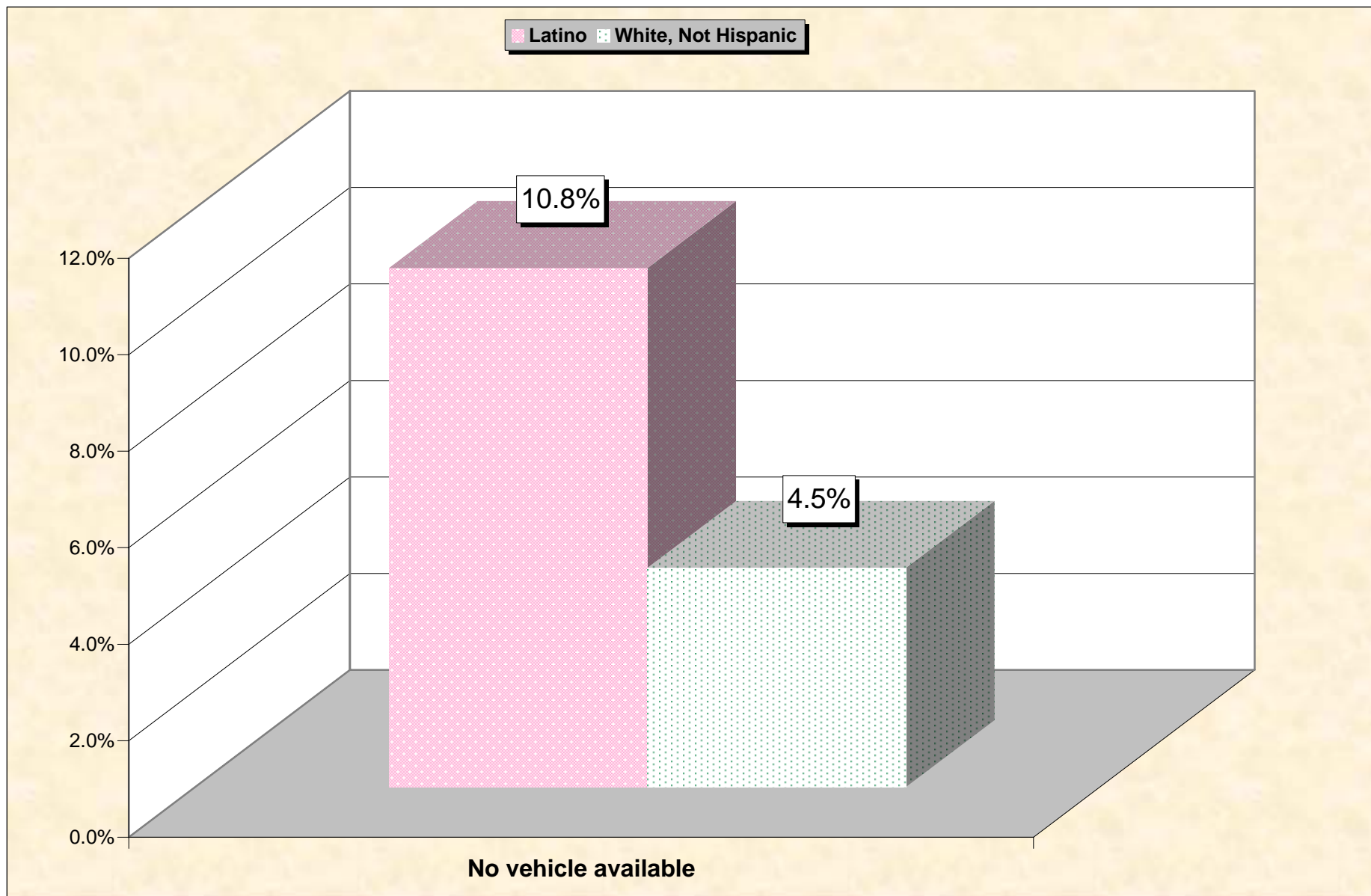

Chart 13 -- Lack of Telephone Service by Household Texas



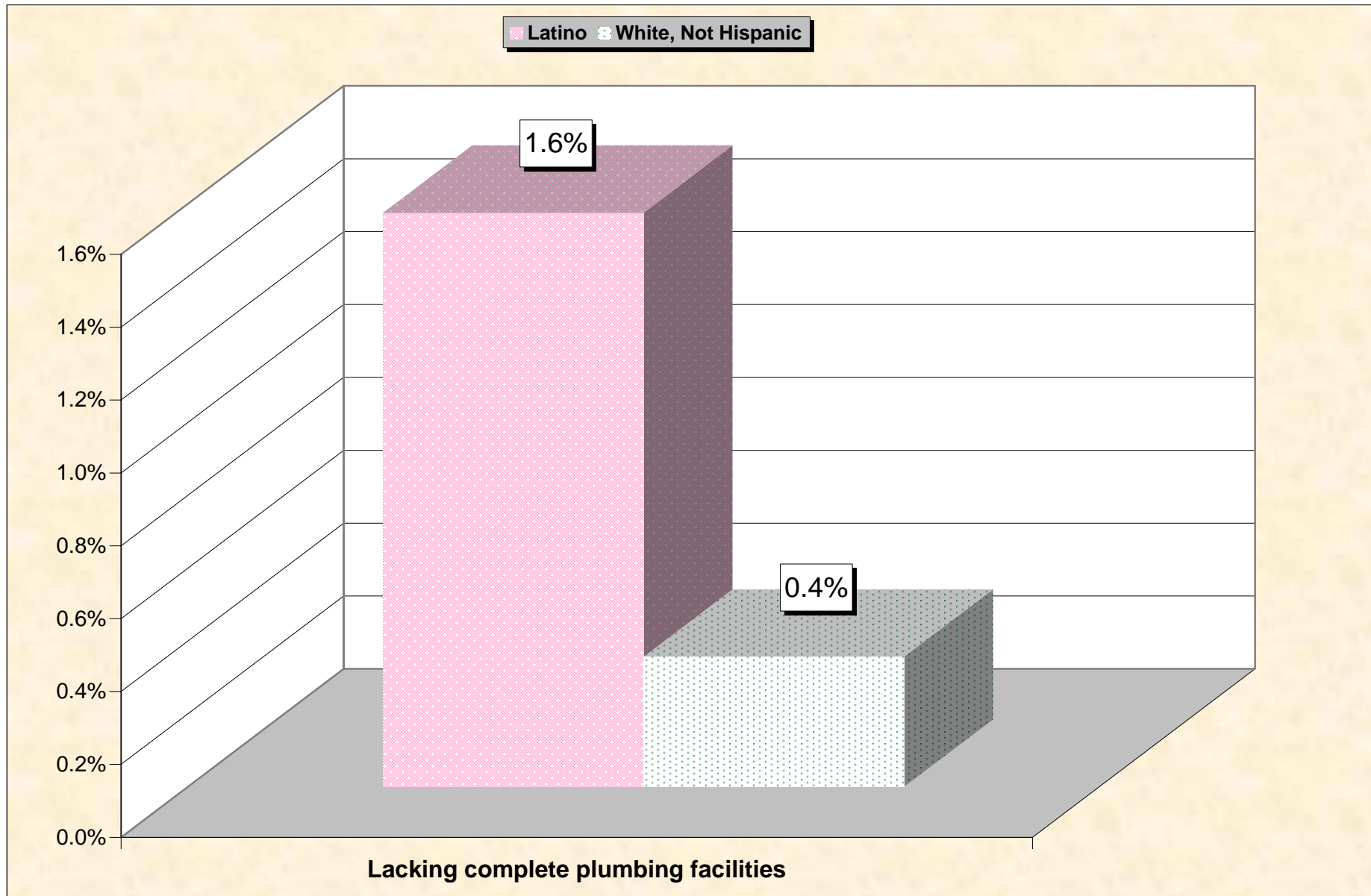

Chart 14 -- Lack of Vehicle By Household Texas



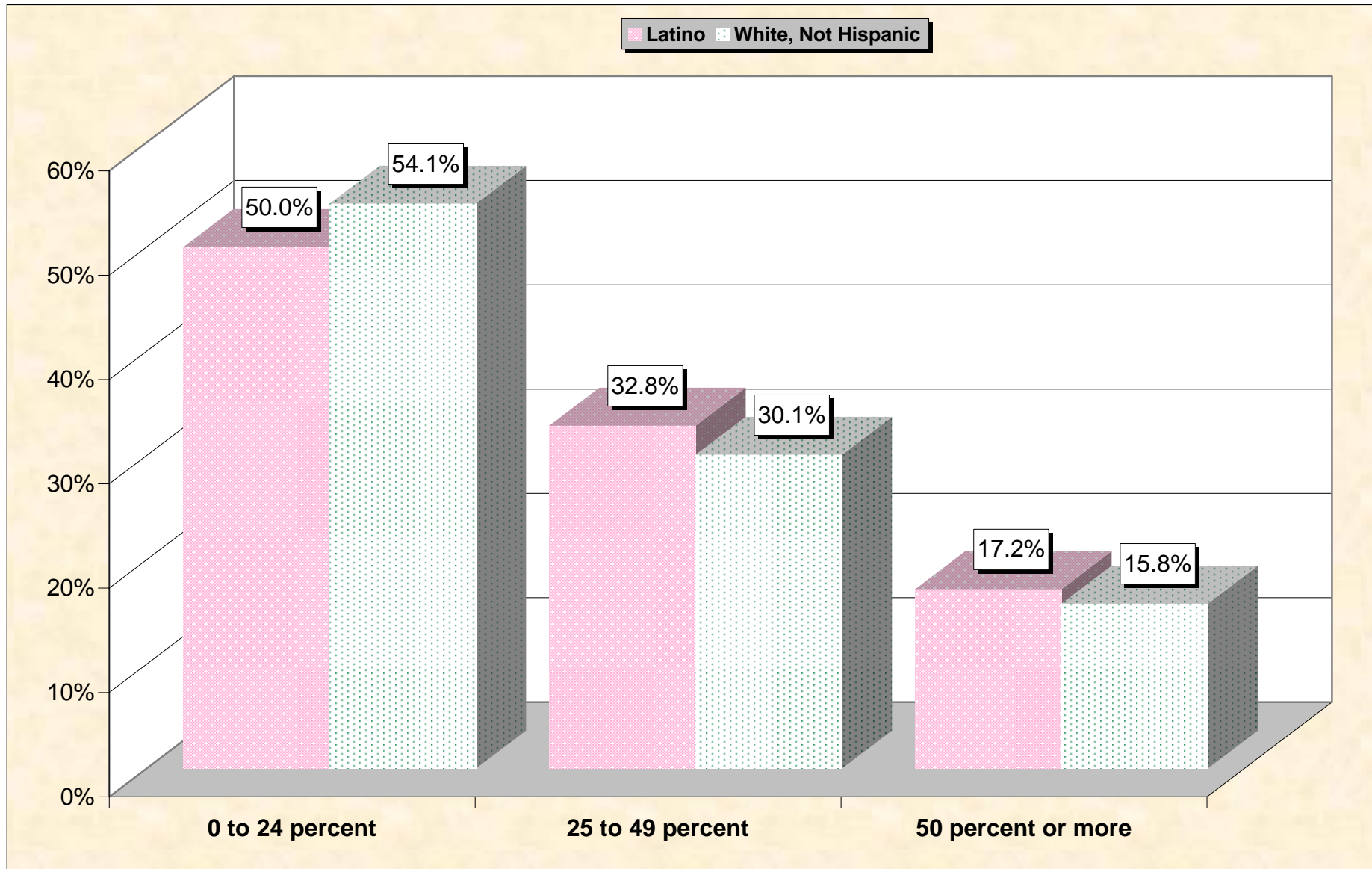

Chart 15 -- Lack of Plumbing By Household Texas



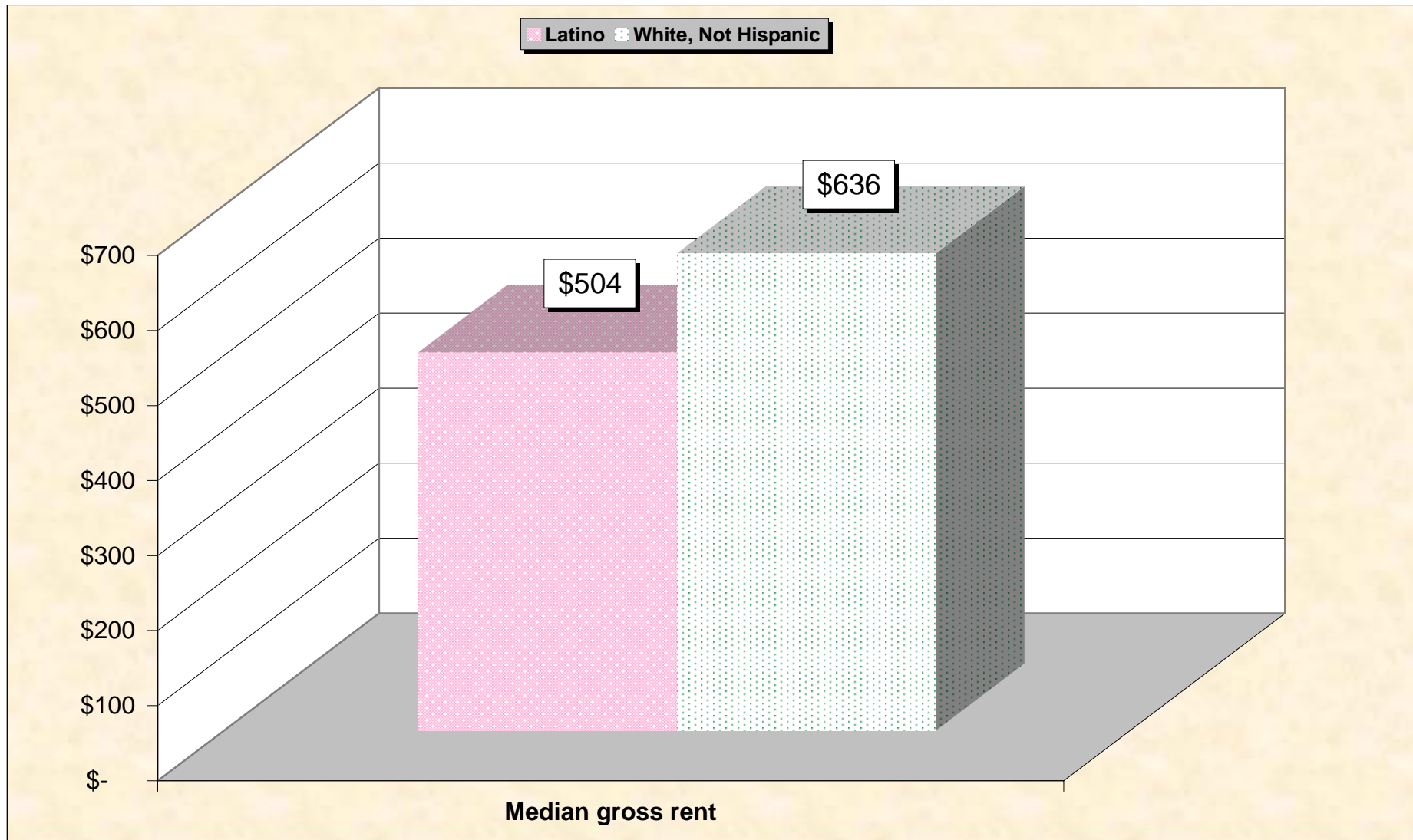

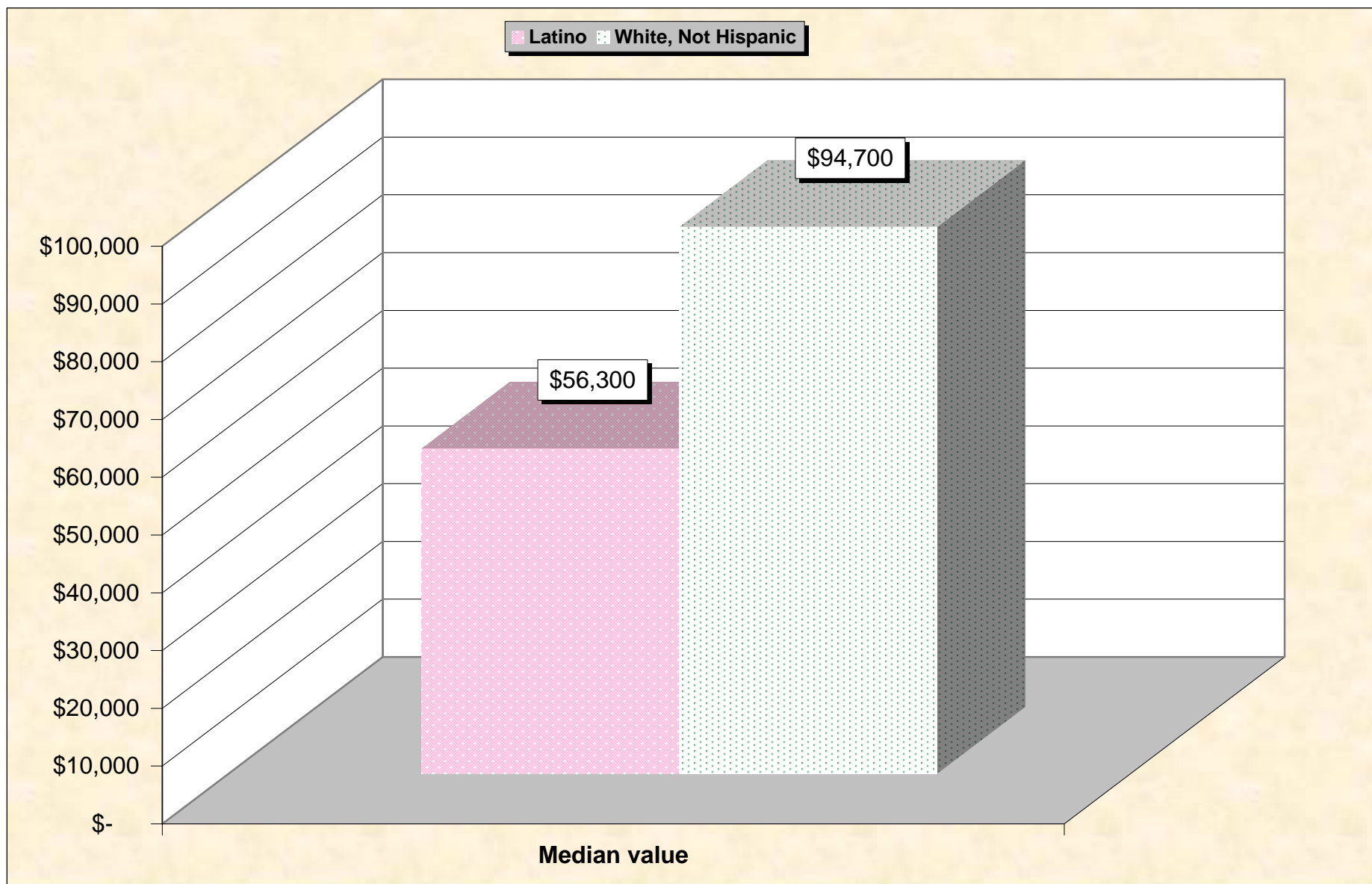
