



# Chart 1 -- Single-Parent Family Households (Householder 15 to 64 years) Wisconsin





# Chart 2 -- Private School Enrollment (3 years and over) Wisconsin






# Chart 4 -- Unemployment Rate (Civilian Labor Force) Wisconsin


# **Chart 5 -- Labor Force Participation (Civilian Labor Force) Wisconsin**



### Chart 6 -- Household Income in 1999 Wisconsin





# Chart 7 -- Median Family Income In 1999 Wisconsin





# Chart 8 -- Per Capita Income In 1999





# Chart 9 -- Income in 1999 Below Poverty Level by Age Wisconsin





# Chart 10 -- Median Earnings in 1999 Wisconsin





# Chart 11 -- Renter-Occupied Housing Wisconsin





## Chart 12 -- Occupants Per Room (Crowding) by Household Wisconsin





# Chart 13 -- Lack of Telephone Service by Household Wisconsin





# Chart 14 -- Lack of Vehicle By Household Wisconsin





# Chart 15 -- Lack of Plumbing By Household Wisconsin





# Chart 16 -- Gross Rent as a Percentage of Household Income in 1999 Wisconsin




