




**Chart 1 -- Single-Parent Family Households (Householder 15 to 64 years)


Chart 2 -- Private School Enrollment (3 years and over)




Chart 4 -- Unemployment Rate (Civilian Labor Force)


Chart 5 -- Labor Force Participation (Civilian Labor Force) Bexar County, Texas




Chart 7 -- Median Family Income In 1999


Chart 8 -- Per Capita Income In 1999



Bexar County, Texas**





Bexar County, Texas





Chart 11 -- Renter-Occupied Housing Bexar County, Texas





Chart 12 -- Occupants Per Room (Crowding) by Household Bexar County, Texas





Bexar County, Texas**





Bexar County, Texas**





Bexar County, Texas**





Bexar County, Texas




