



# Chart 1 -- Single-Parent Family Households (Householder 15 to 64 years) Carson County, Texas





# Chart 2 -- Private School Enrollment (3 years and over) Carson County, Texas






# Chart 4 -- Unemployment Rate (Civilian Labor Force) Carson County, Texas


# Chart 5 -- Labor Force Participation (Civilian Labor Force) Carson County, Texas




# Chart 7 -- Median Family Income In 1999 Carson County, Texas


# **Chart 8 -- Per Capita Income In 1999**



# Chart 9 -- Income in 1999 Below Poverty Level by Age Carson County, Texas





# Chart 10 -- Median Earnings in 1999 Carson County, Texas





# Chart 11 -- Renter-Occupied Housing Carson County, Texas





### Chart 12 -- Occupants Per Room (Crowding) by Household Carson County, Texas





# Chart 13 -- Lack of Telephone Service by Household Carson County, Texas





# Chart 14 -- Lack of Vehicle By Household Carson County, Texas





# Chart 15 -- Lack of Plumbing By Household Carson County, Texas





# Chart 16 -- Gross Rent as a Percentage of Household Income in 1999 Carson County, Texas




