

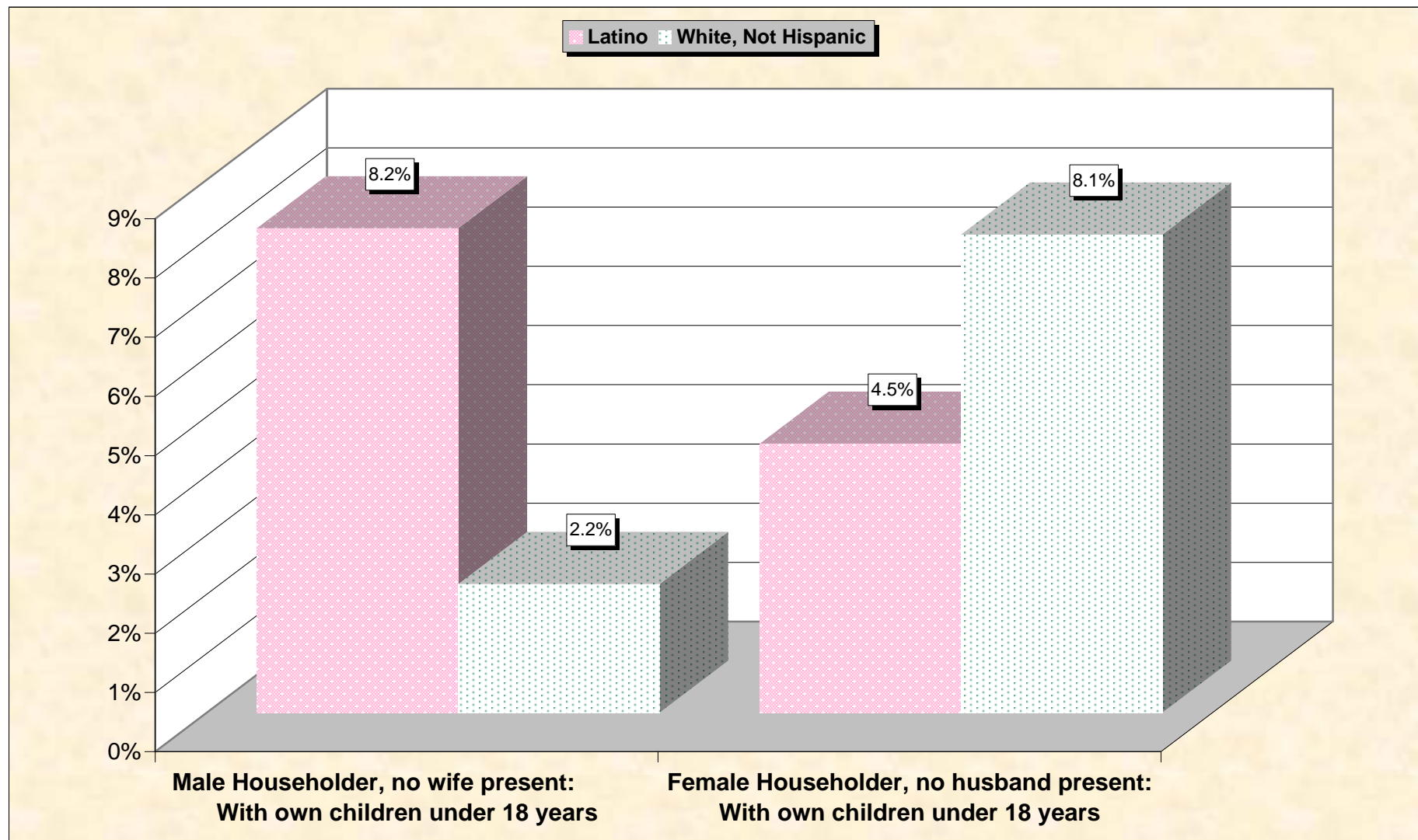

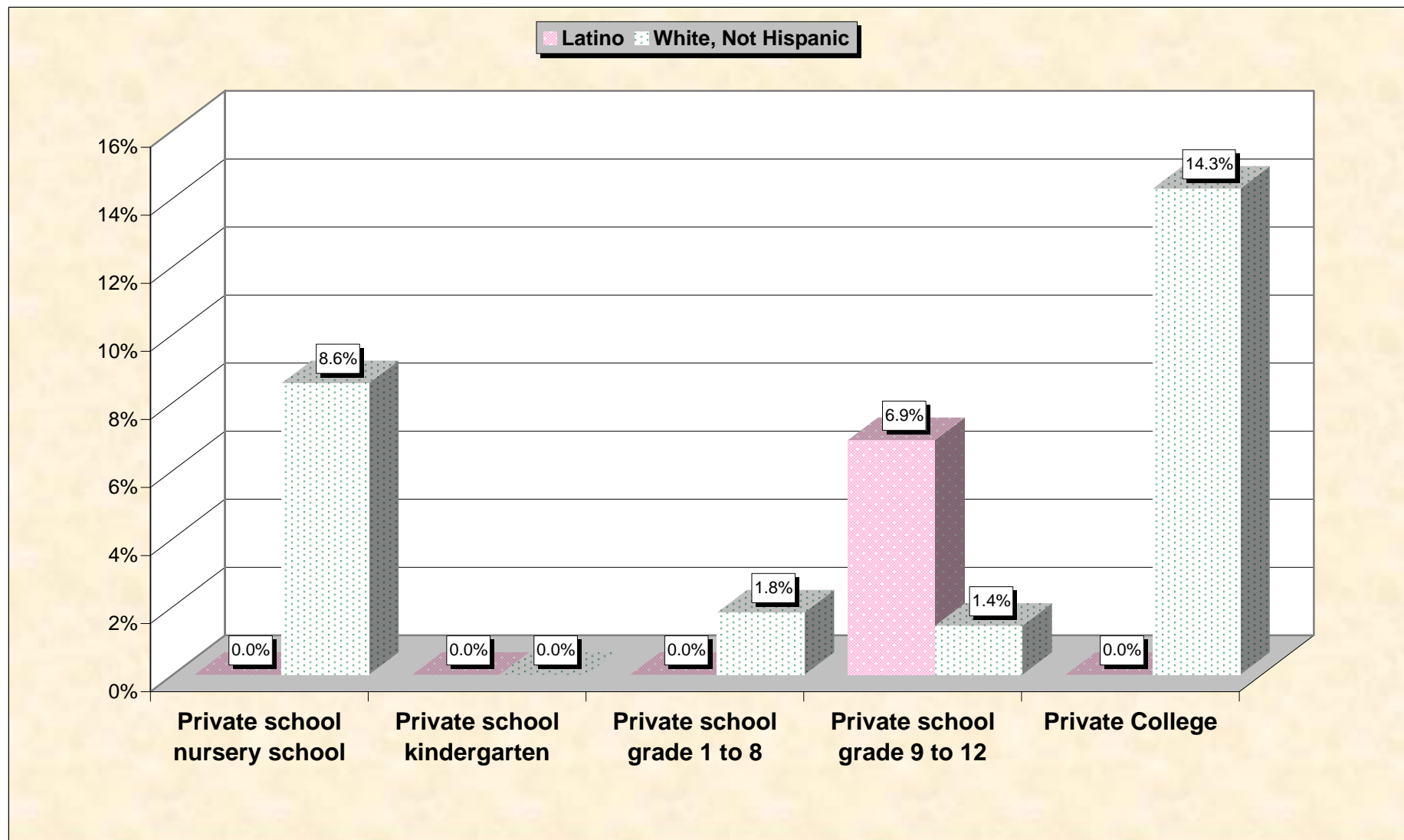
**Chart 1 -- Single-Parent Family Households (Householder 15 to 64 years)

Chart 2 -- Private School Enrollment (3 years and over)

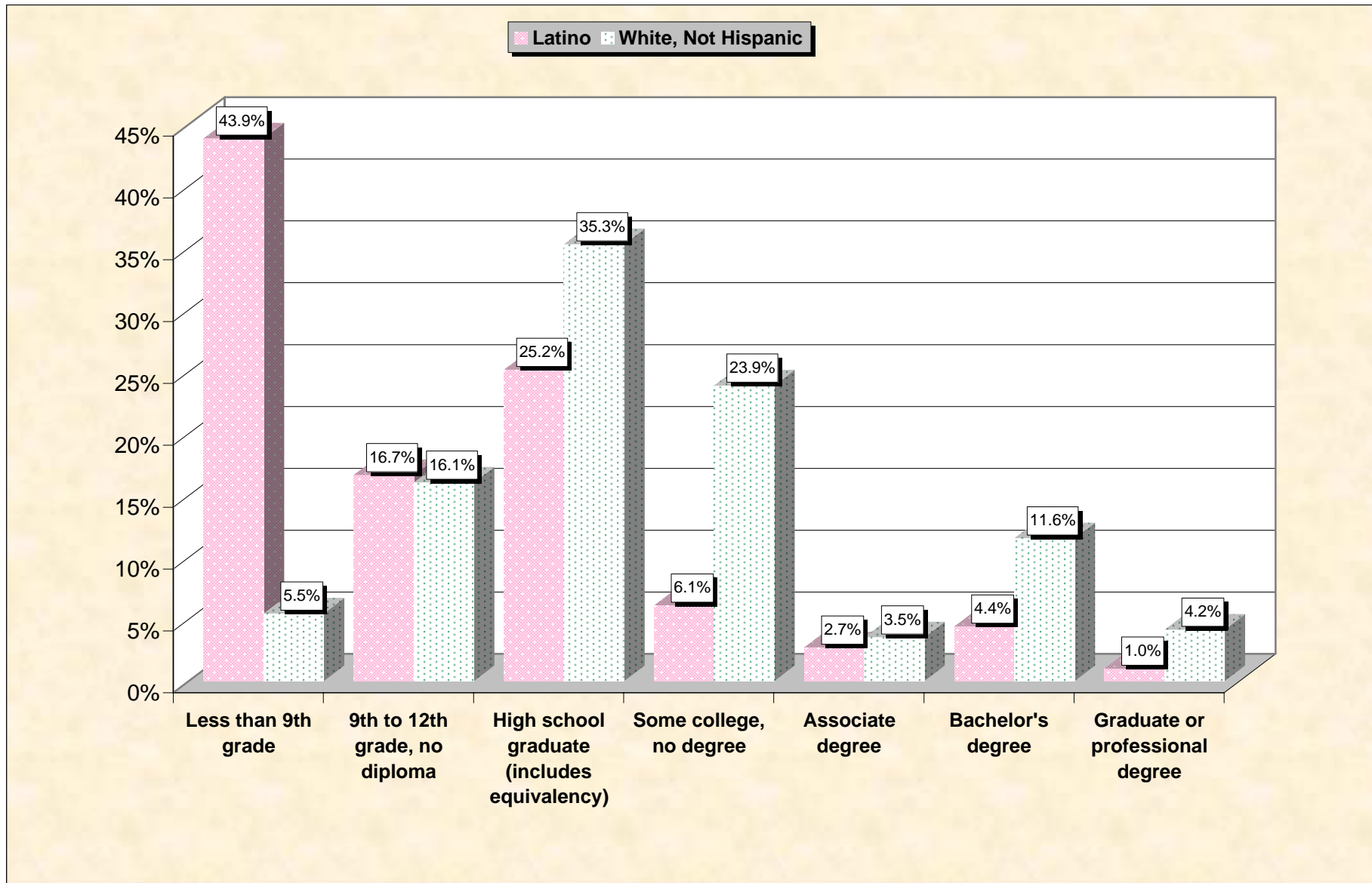

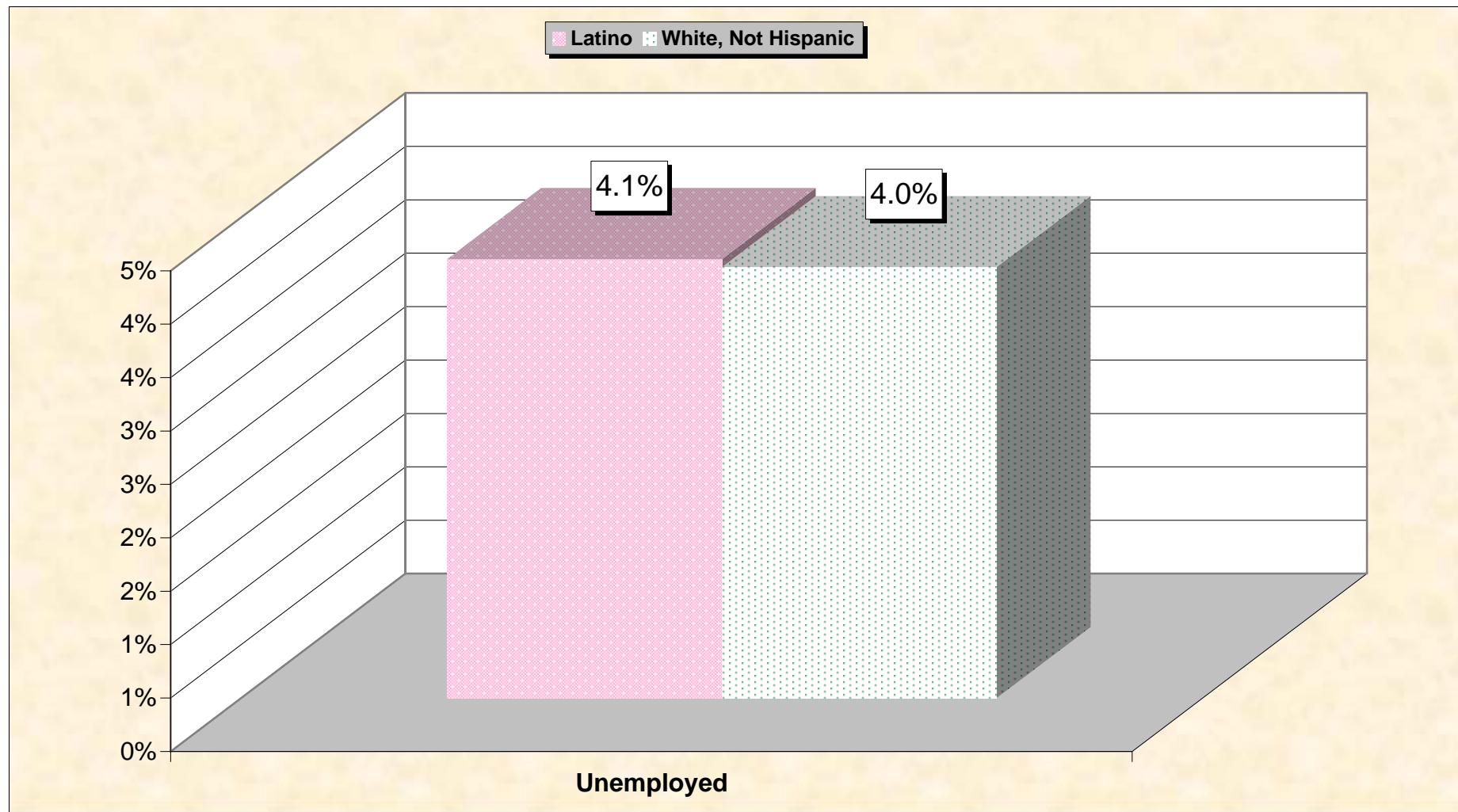
Chart 3 -- Educational Attainment (25 years and over)

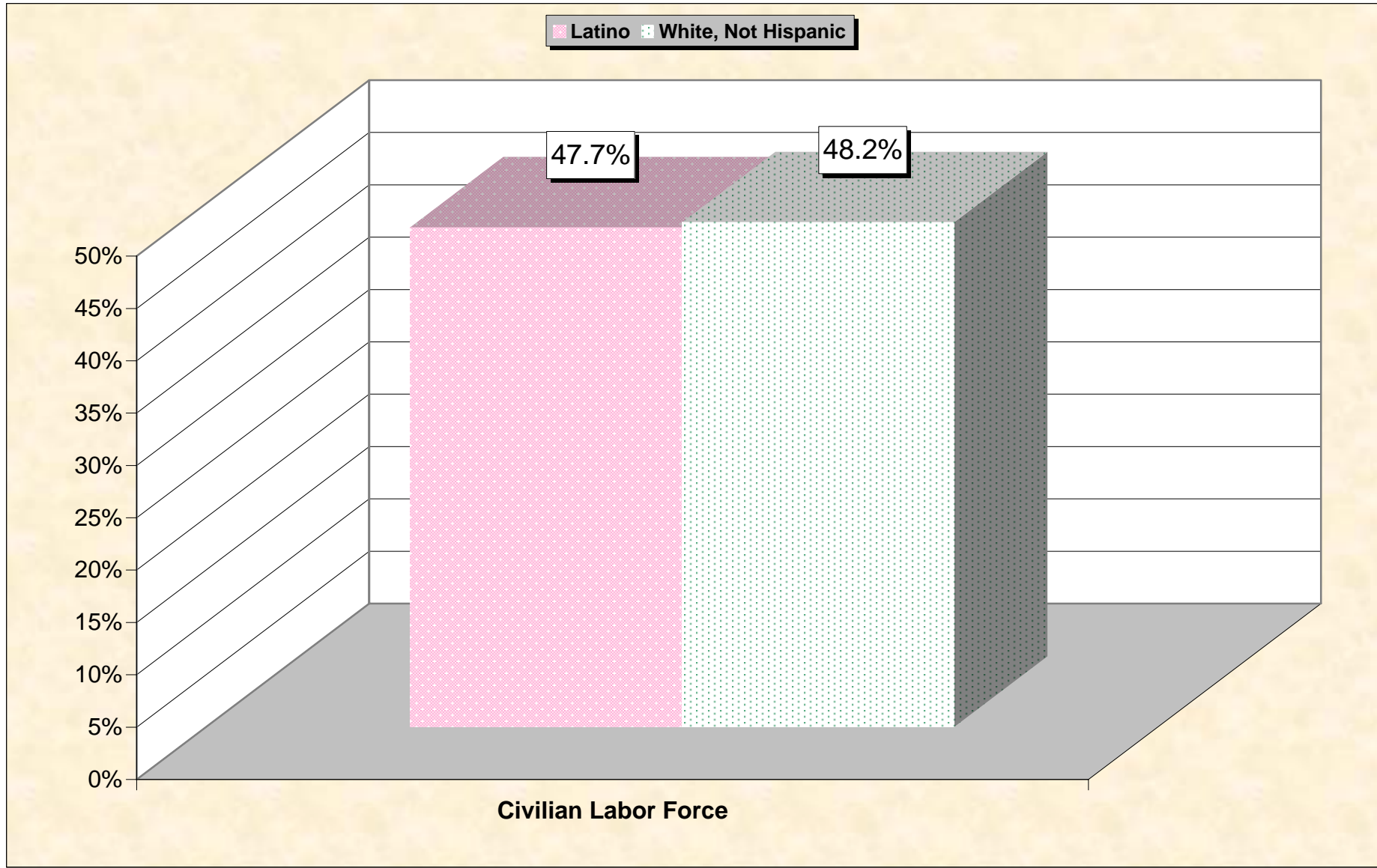
Chart 4 -- Unemployment Rate (Civilian Labor Force)

Coke County, Texas**

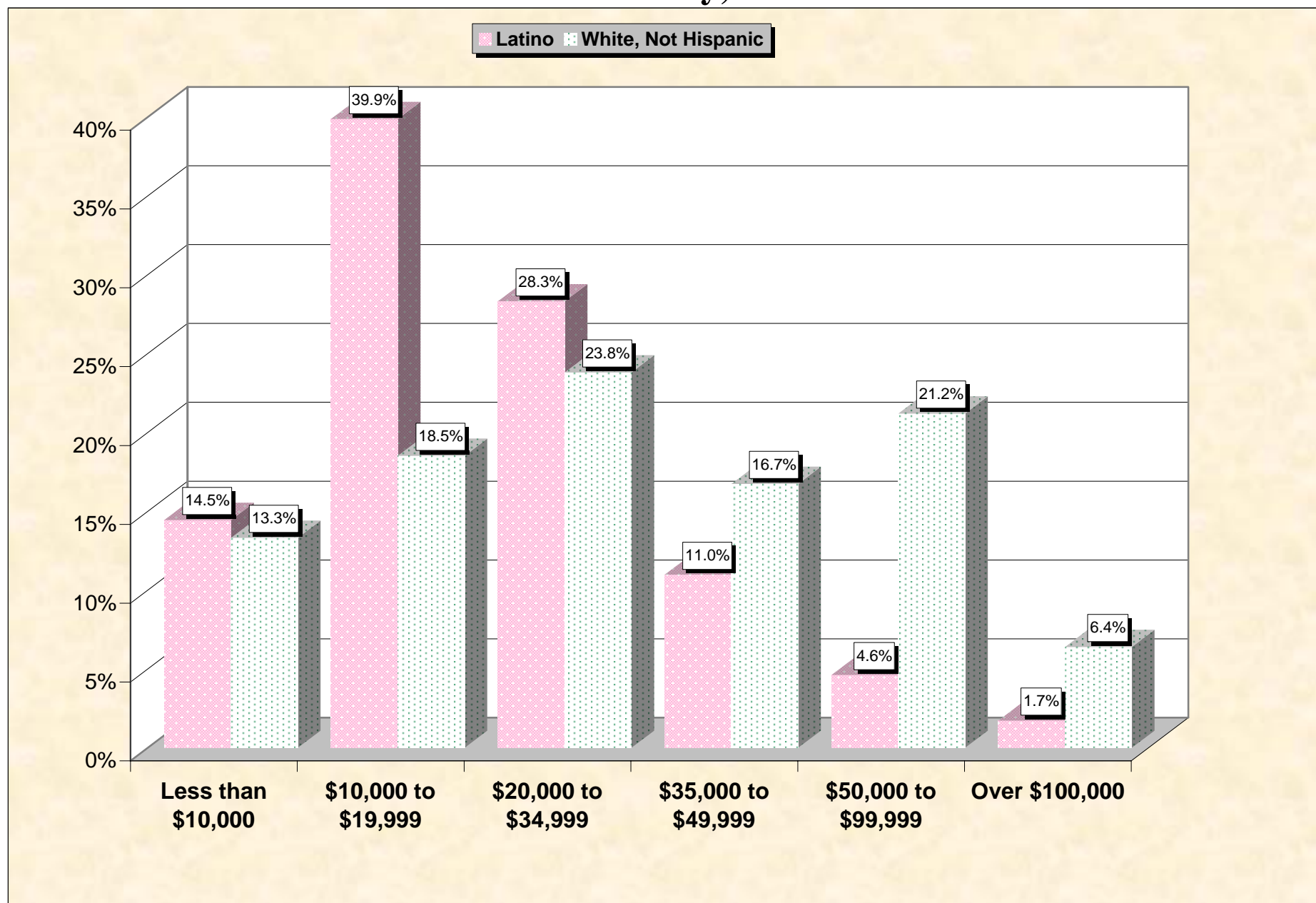

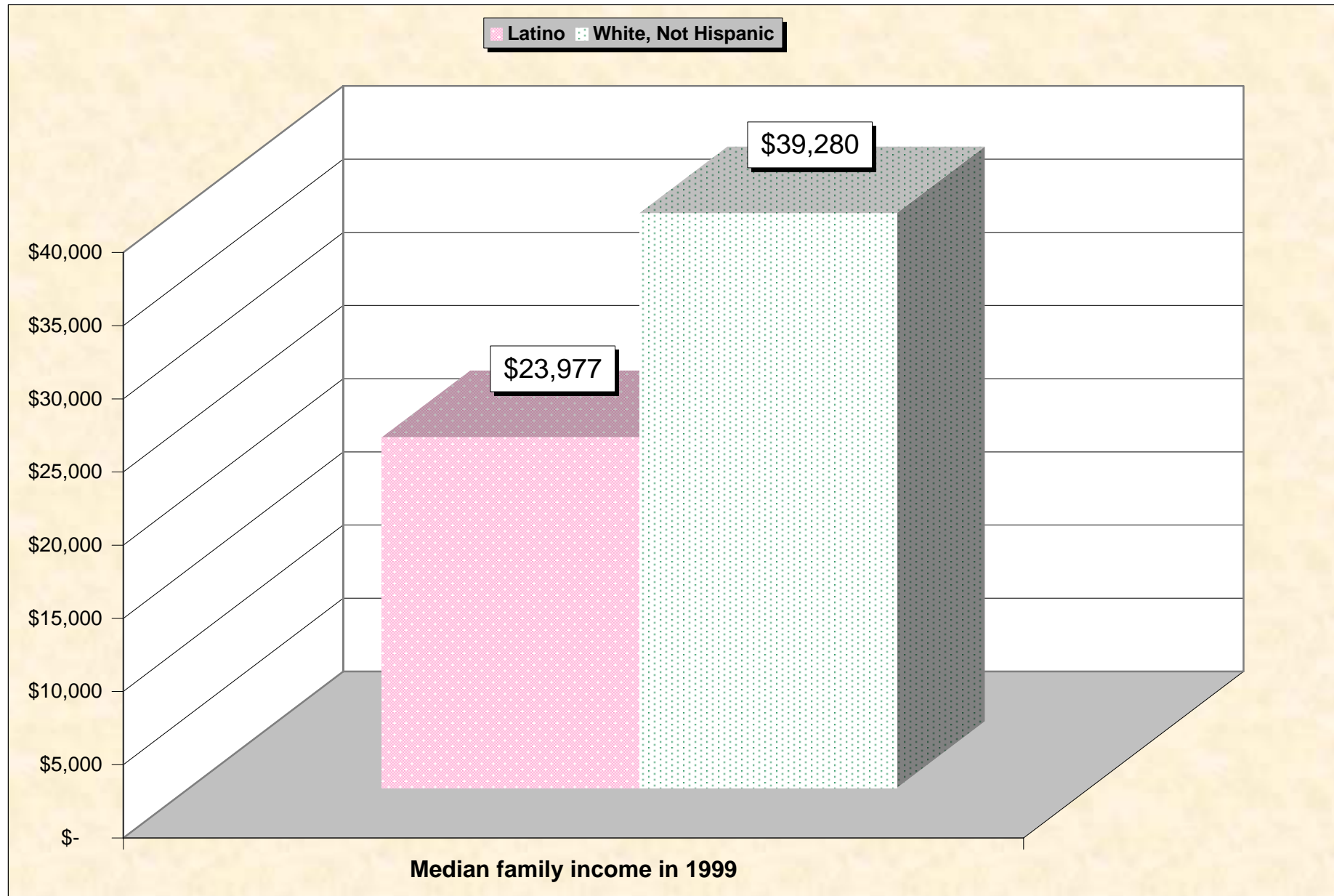
Chart 6 -- Household Income in 1999

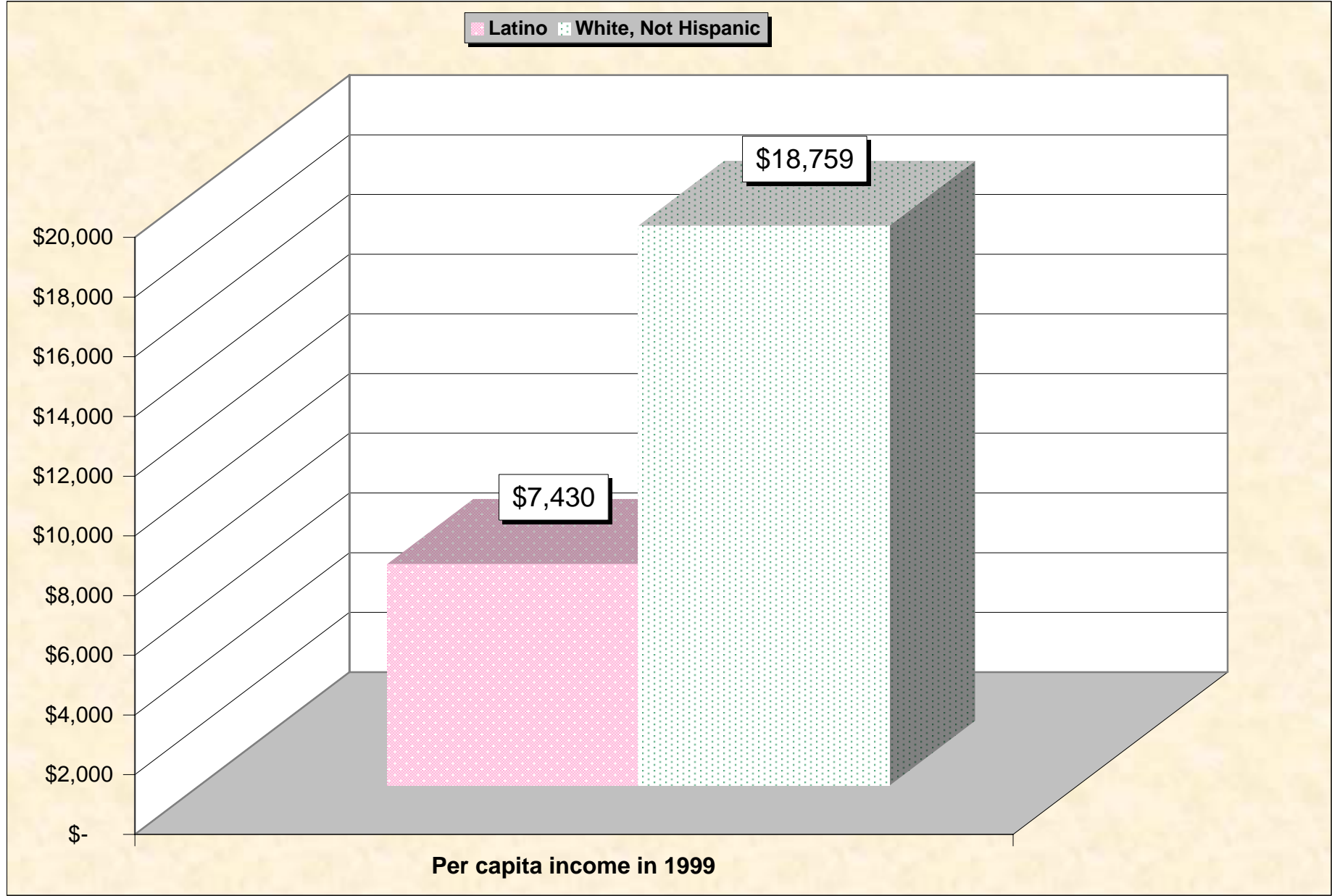

Coke County, Texas



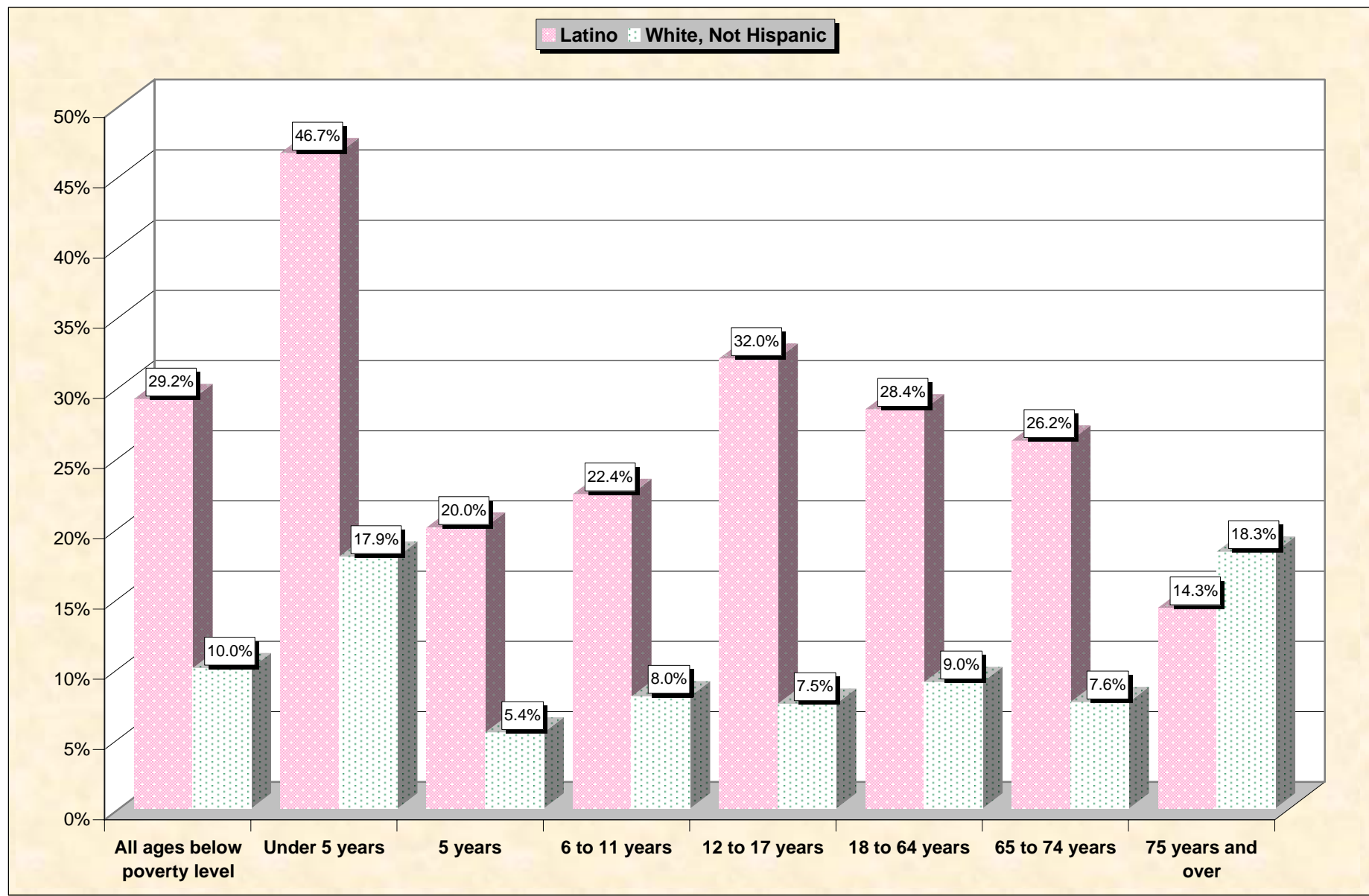

Coke County, Texas



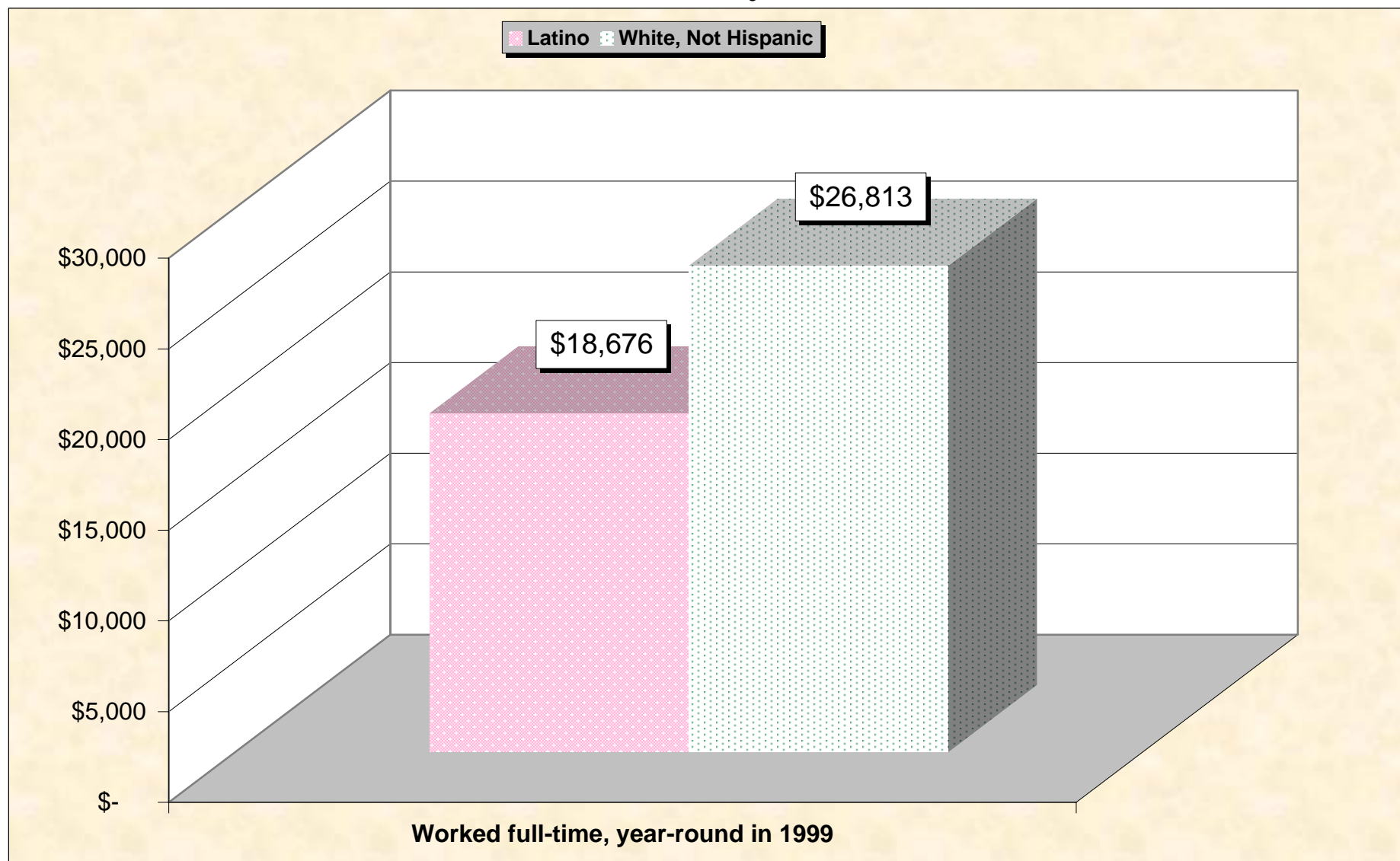

Chart 9 -- Income in 1999 Below Poverty Level by Age Coke County, Texas



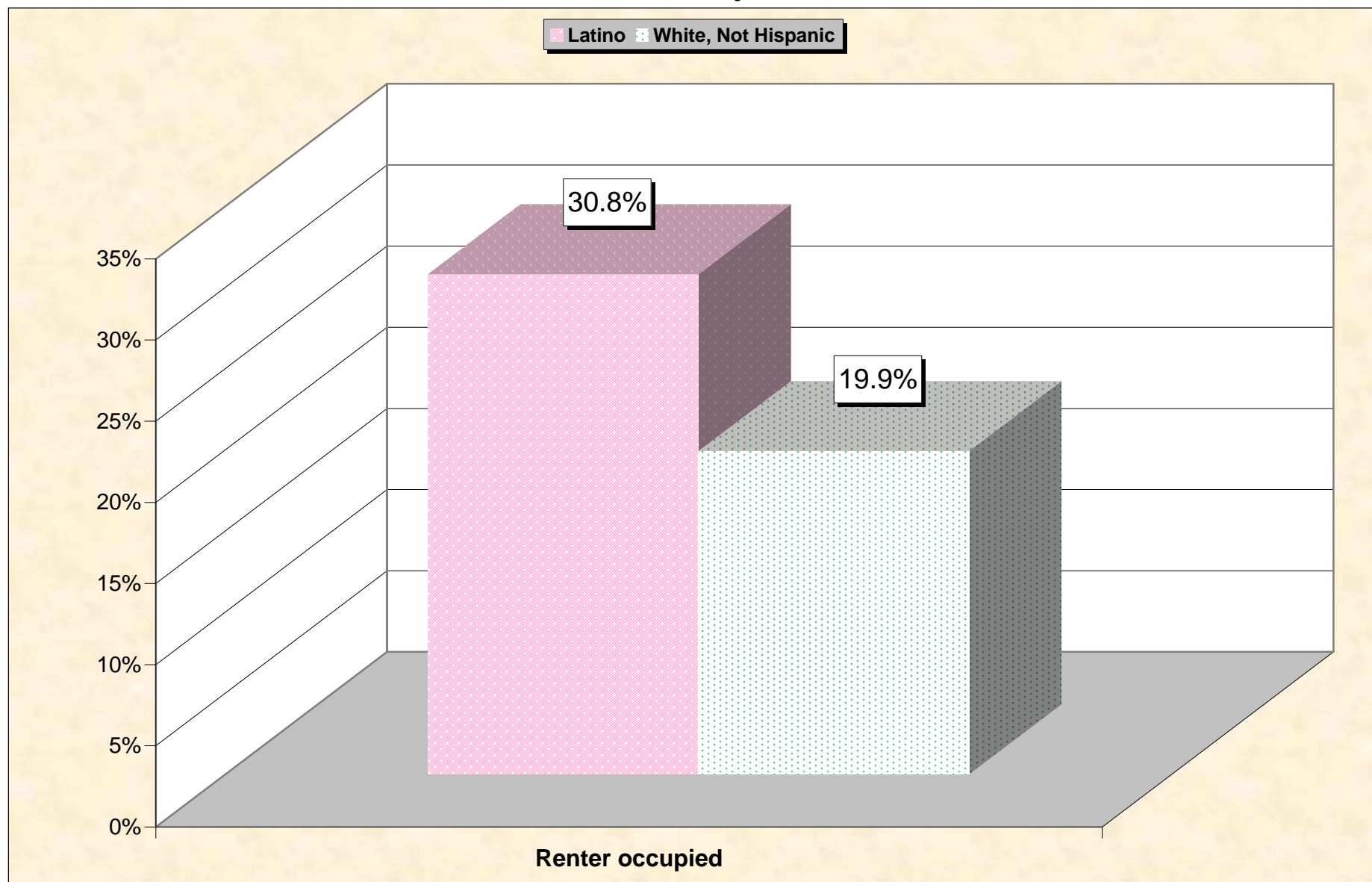

Coke County, Texas



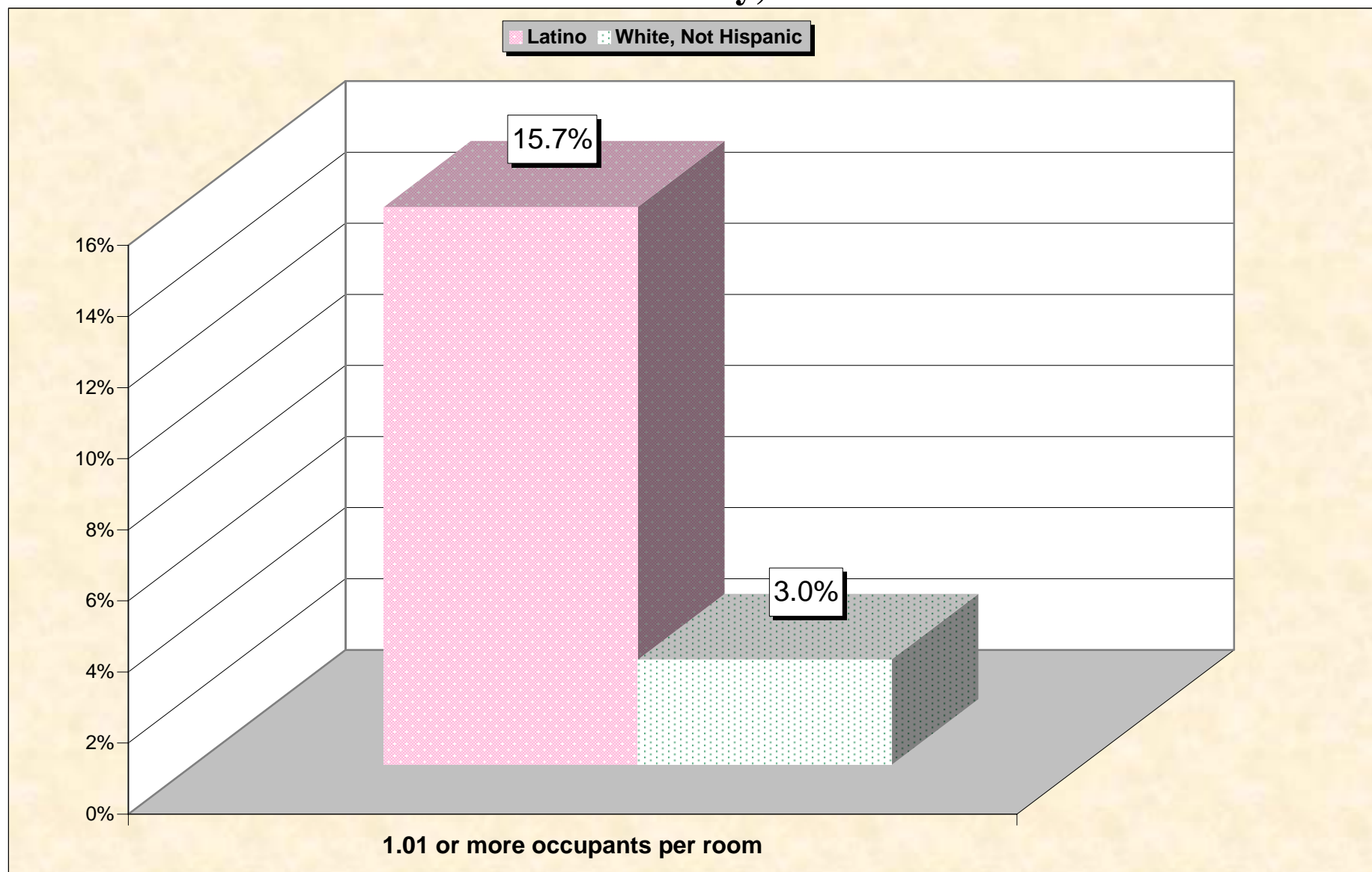

Chart 11 -- Renter-Occupied Housing Coke County, Texas



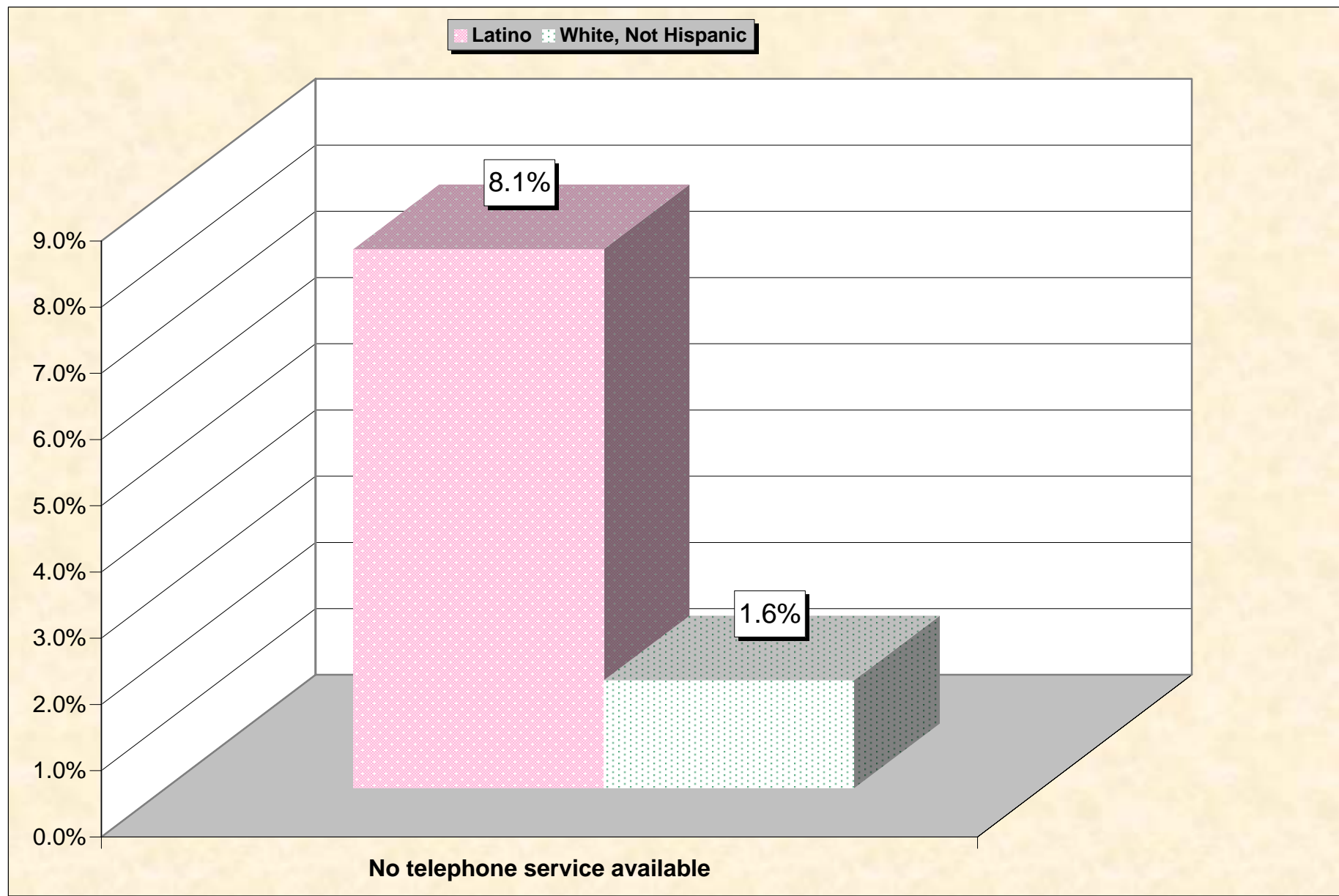

Chart 12 -- Occupants Per Room (Crowding) by Household Coke County, Texas



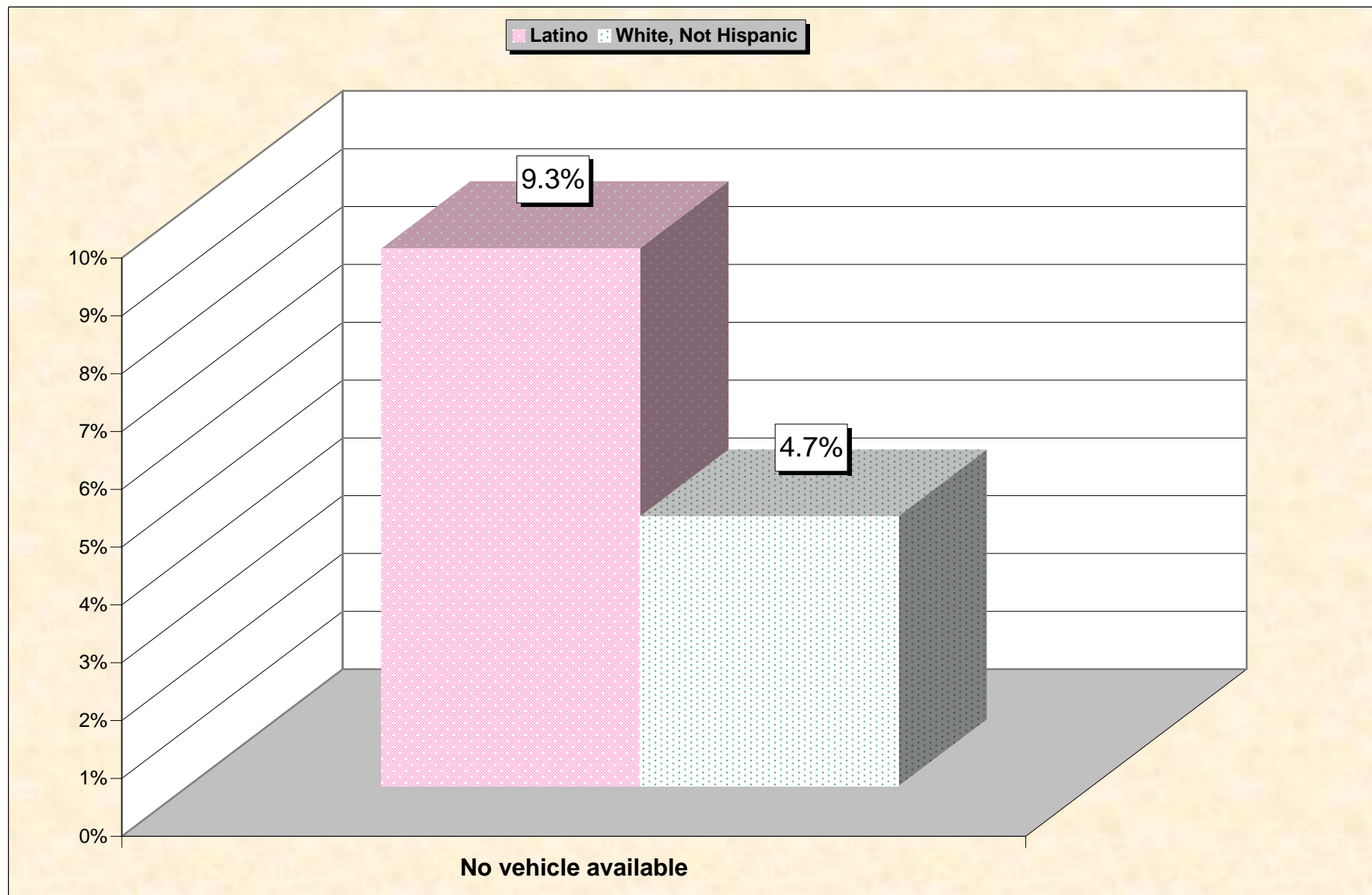

Coke County, Texas**



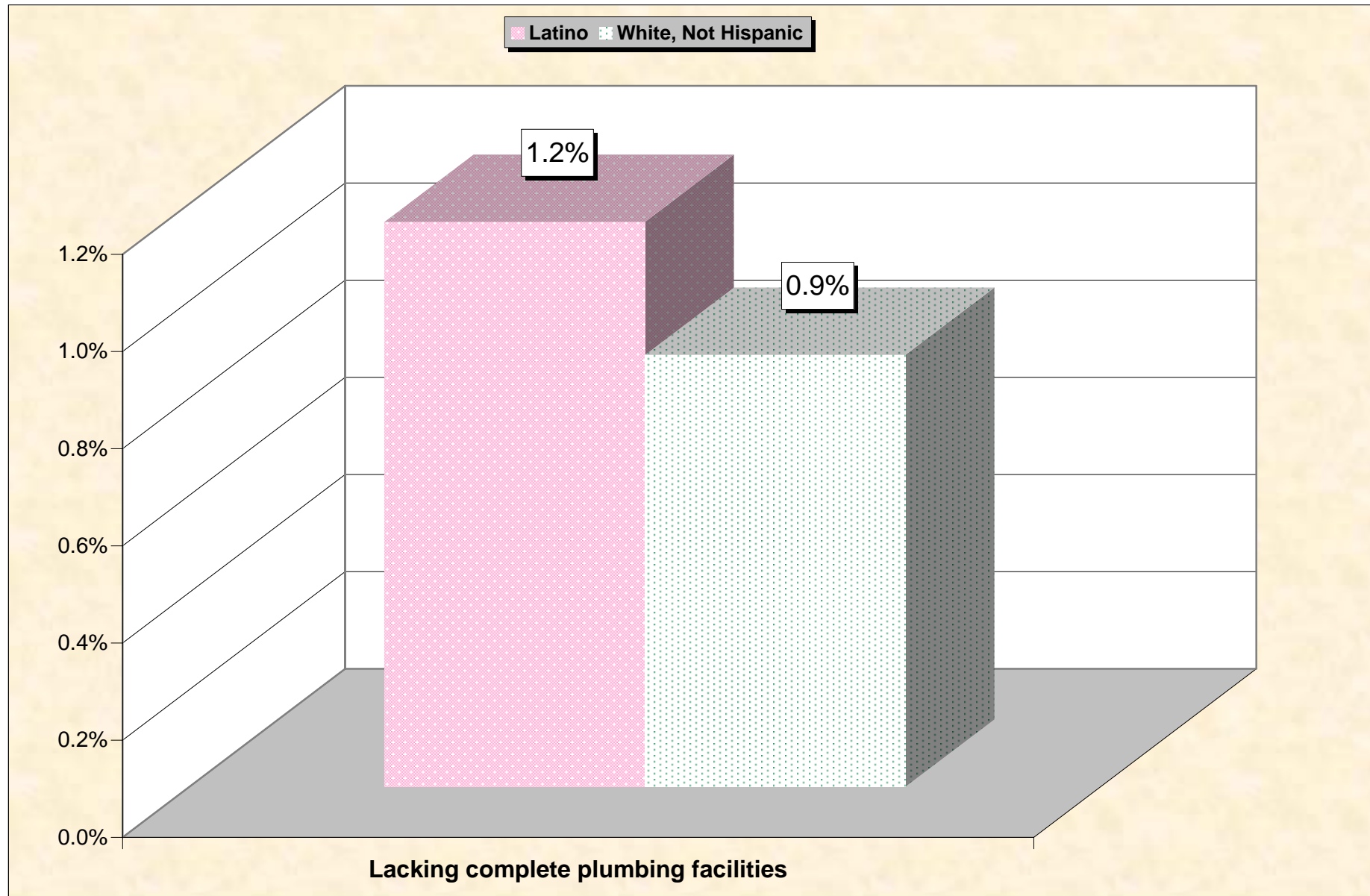

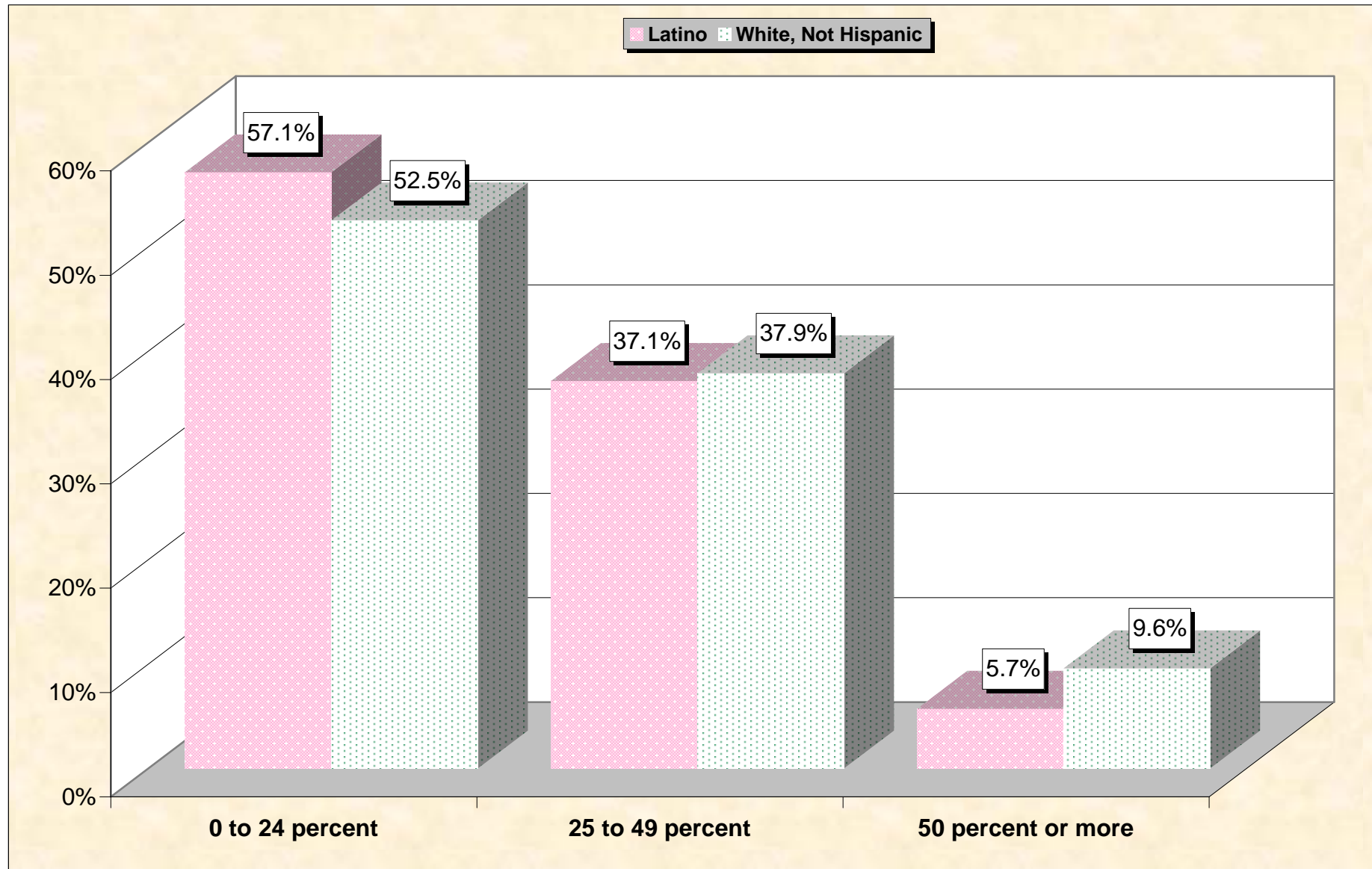

Coke County, Texas**



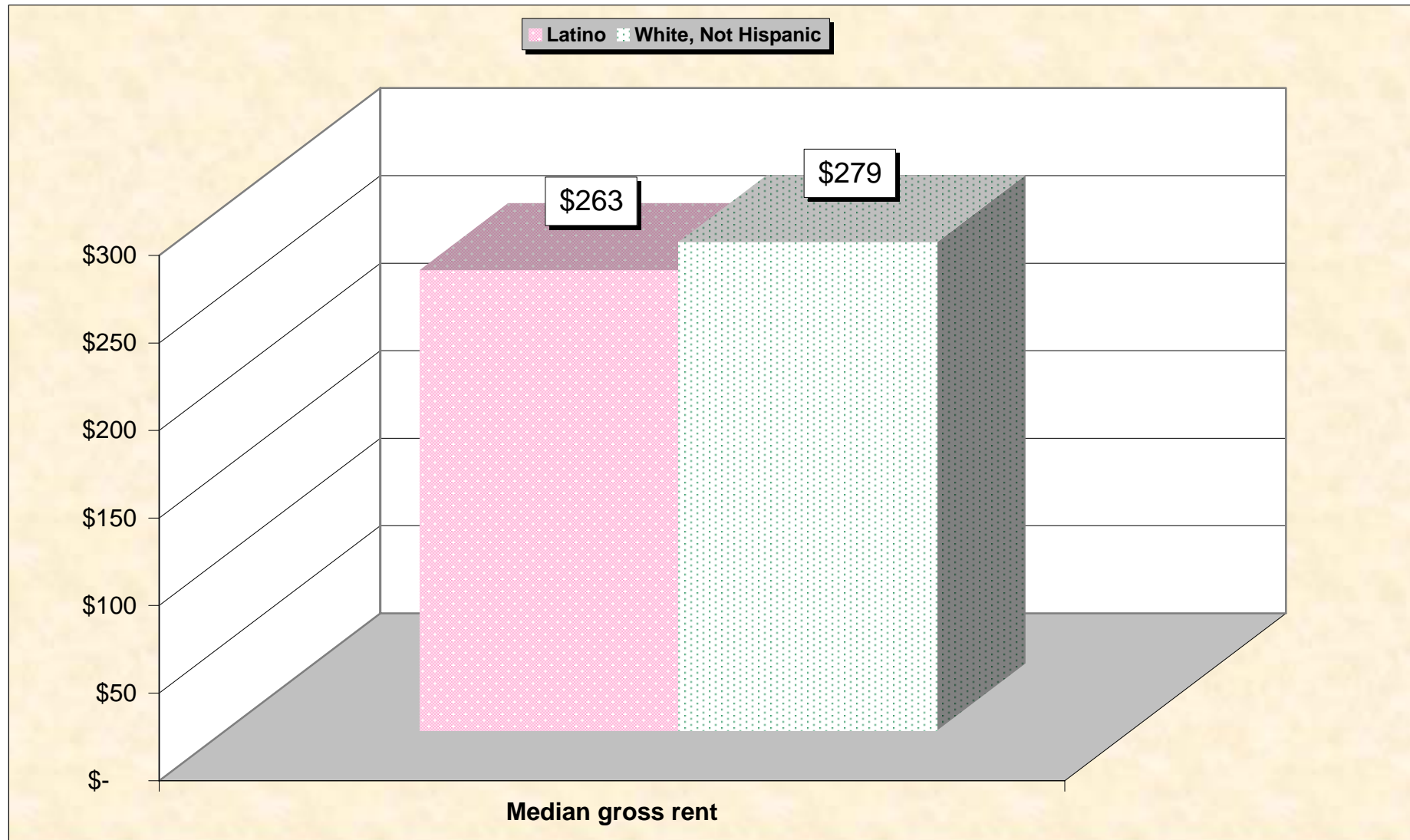

Coke County, Texas



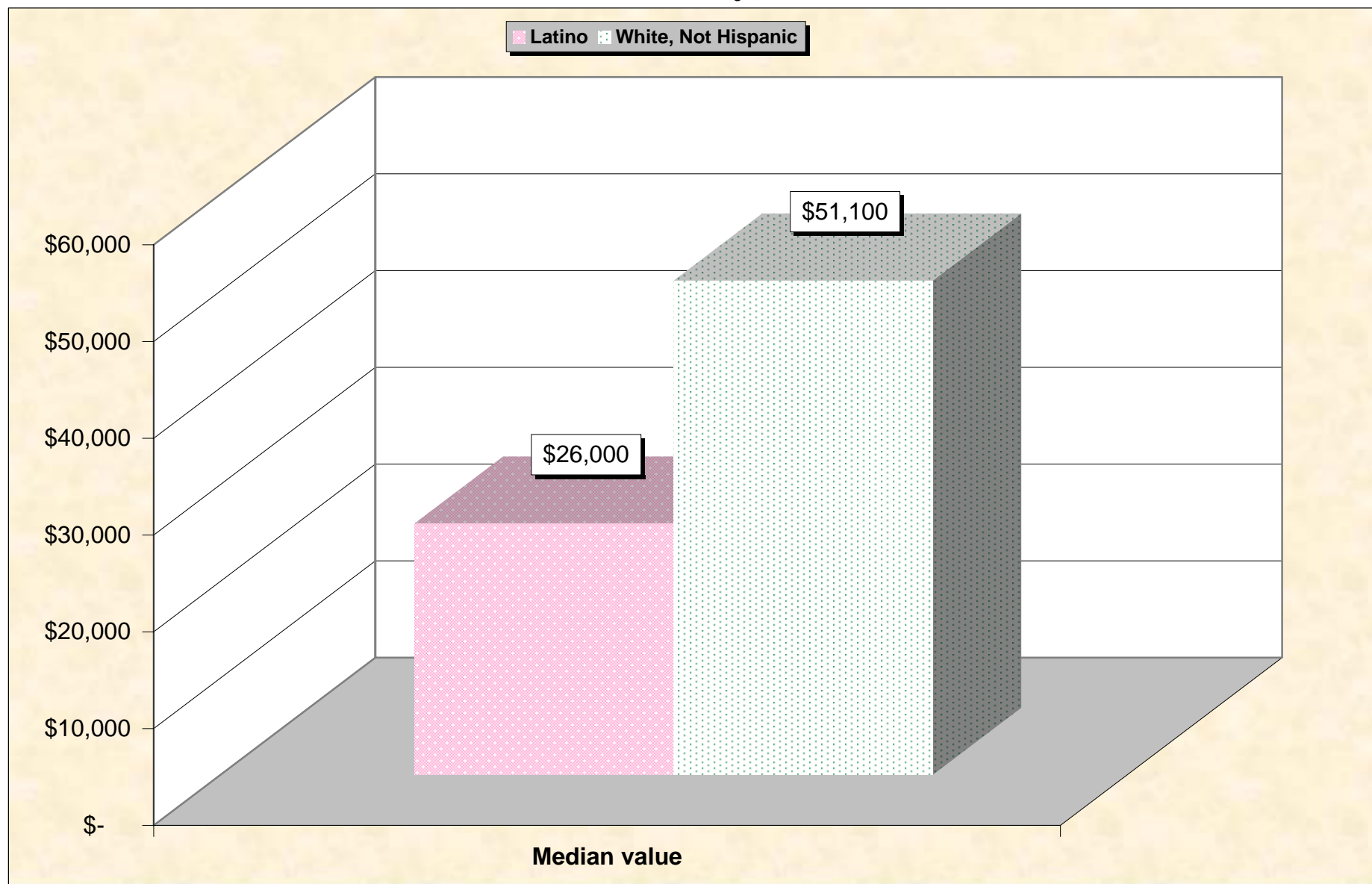
