

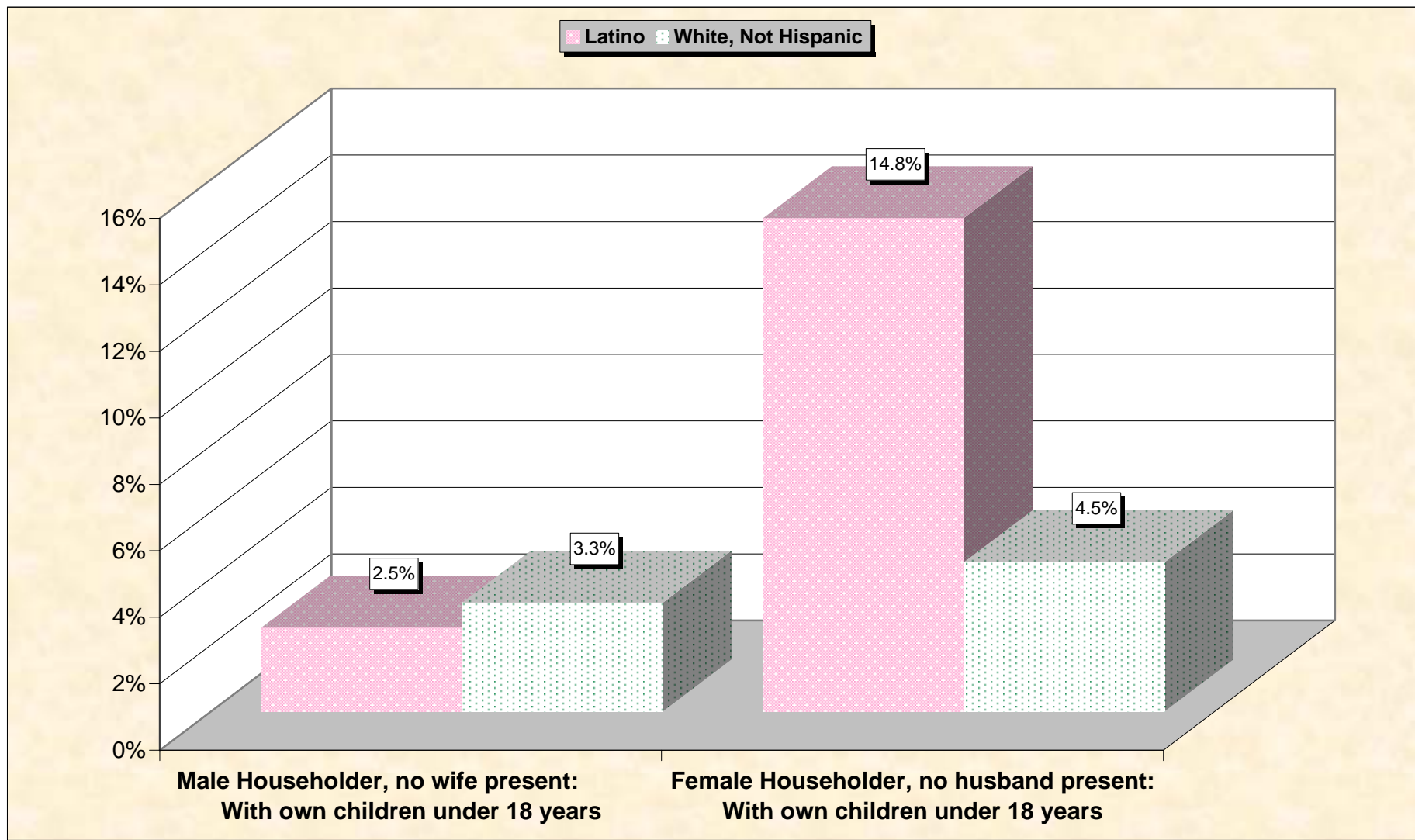

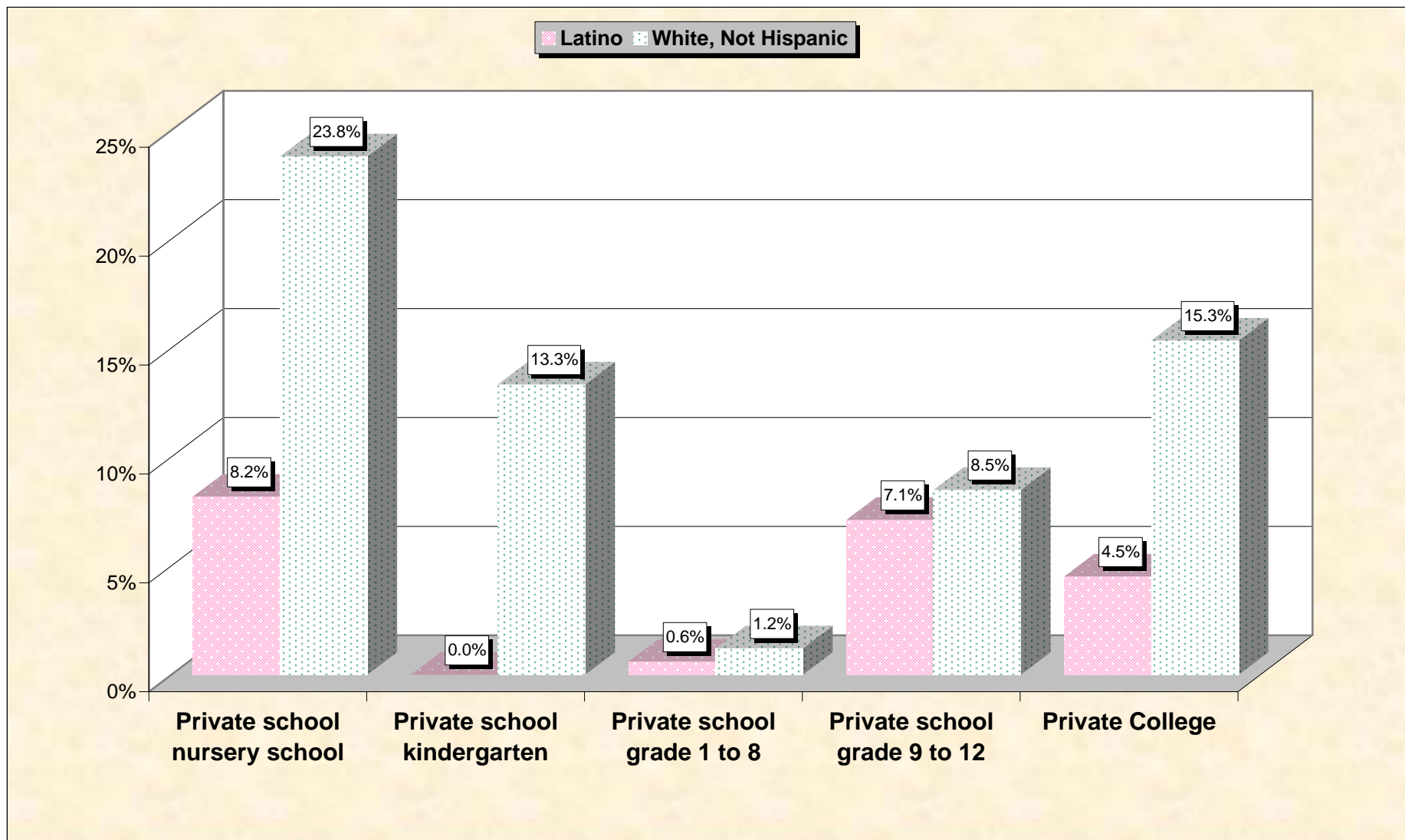

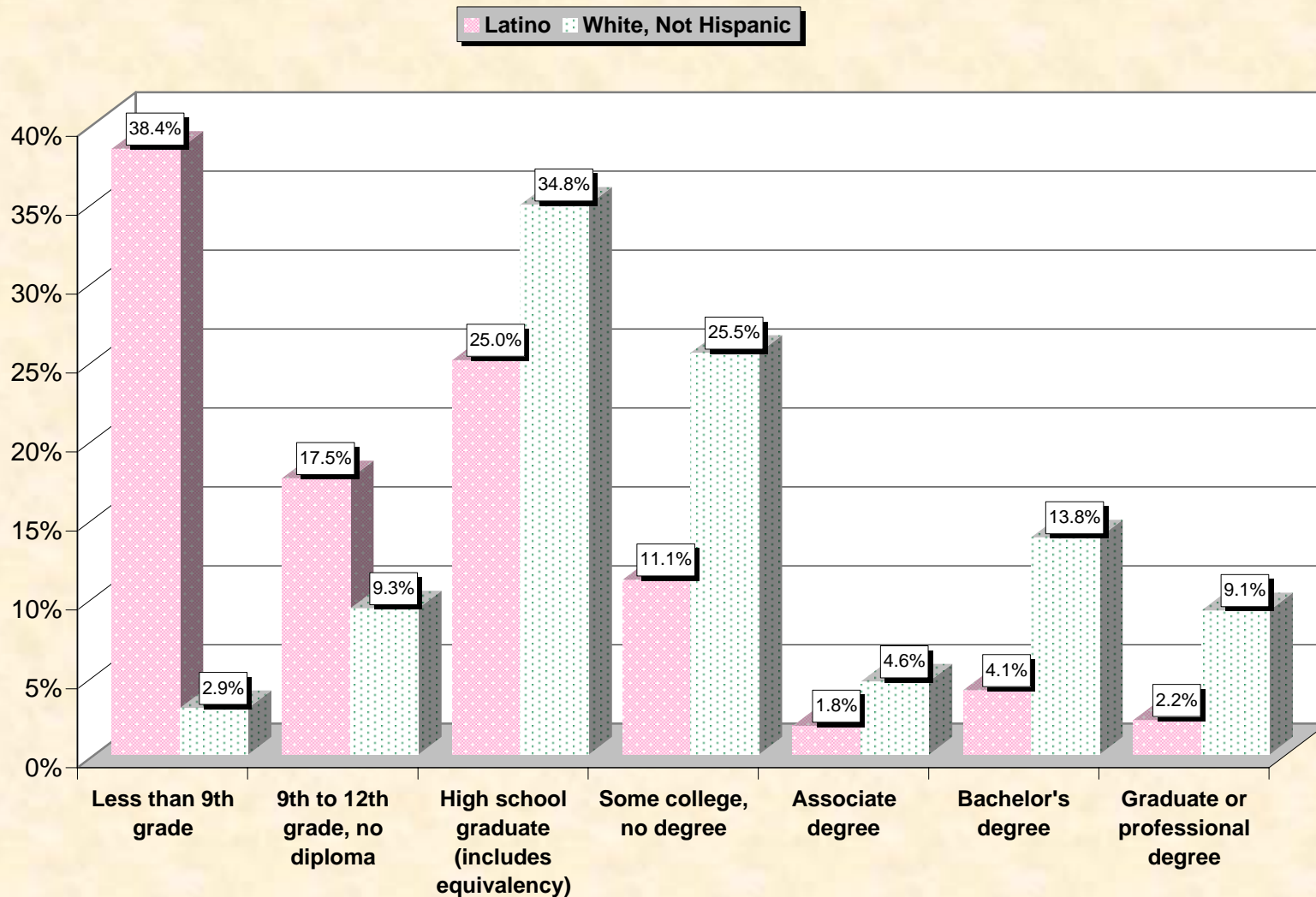
## Chart 2 -- Private School Enrollment (3 years and over)

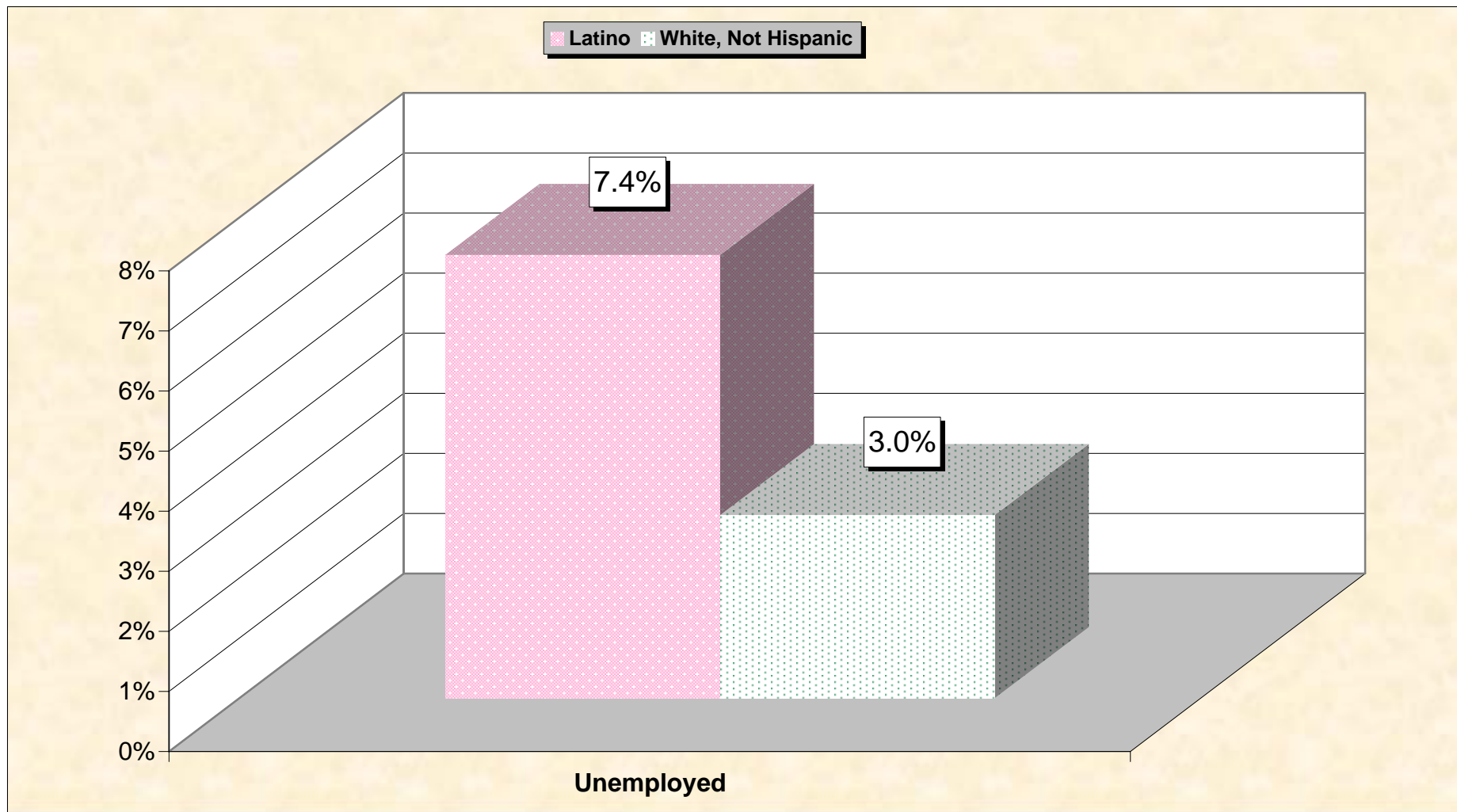

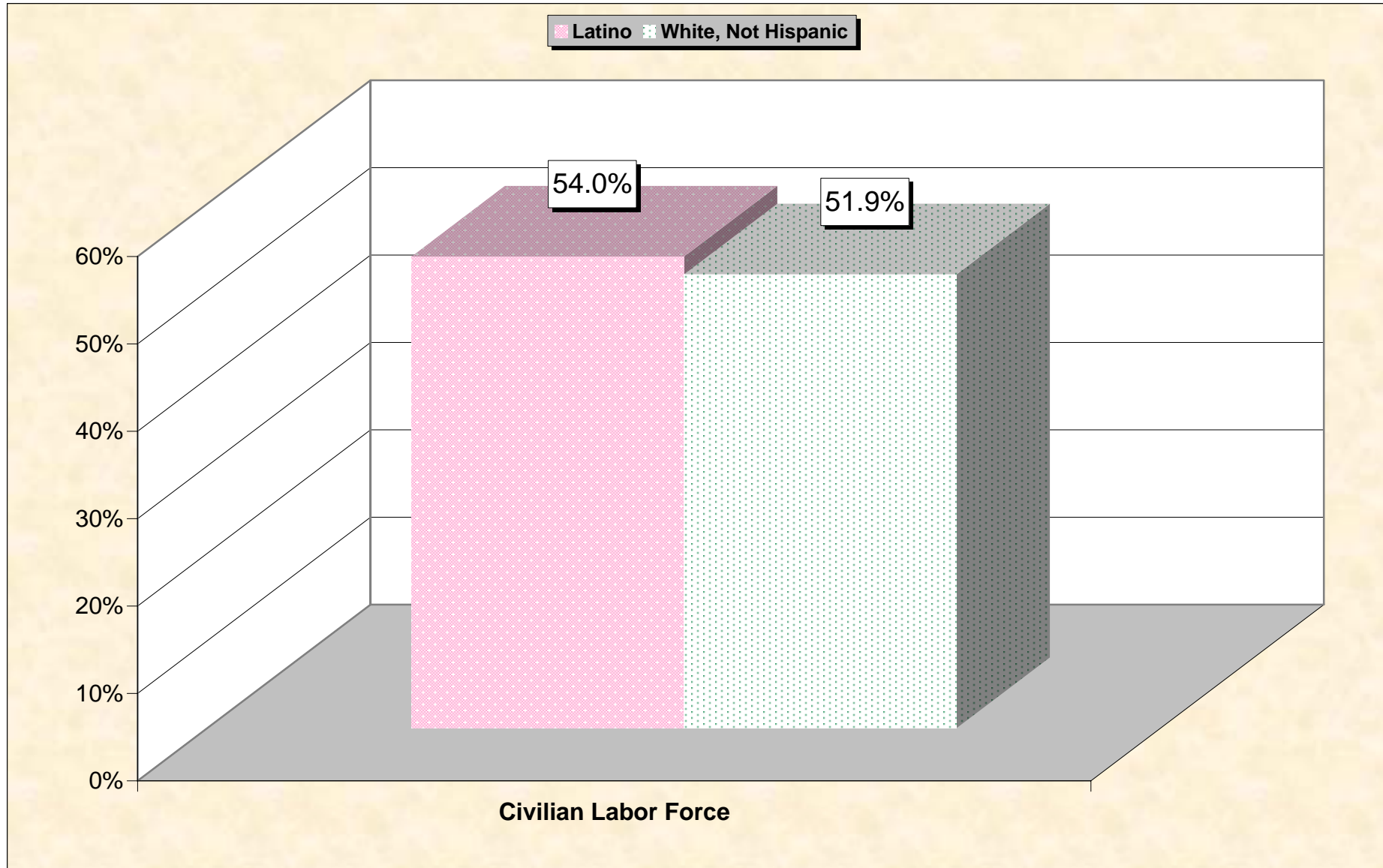
**Chart 4 -- Unemployment Rate (Civilian Labor Force)

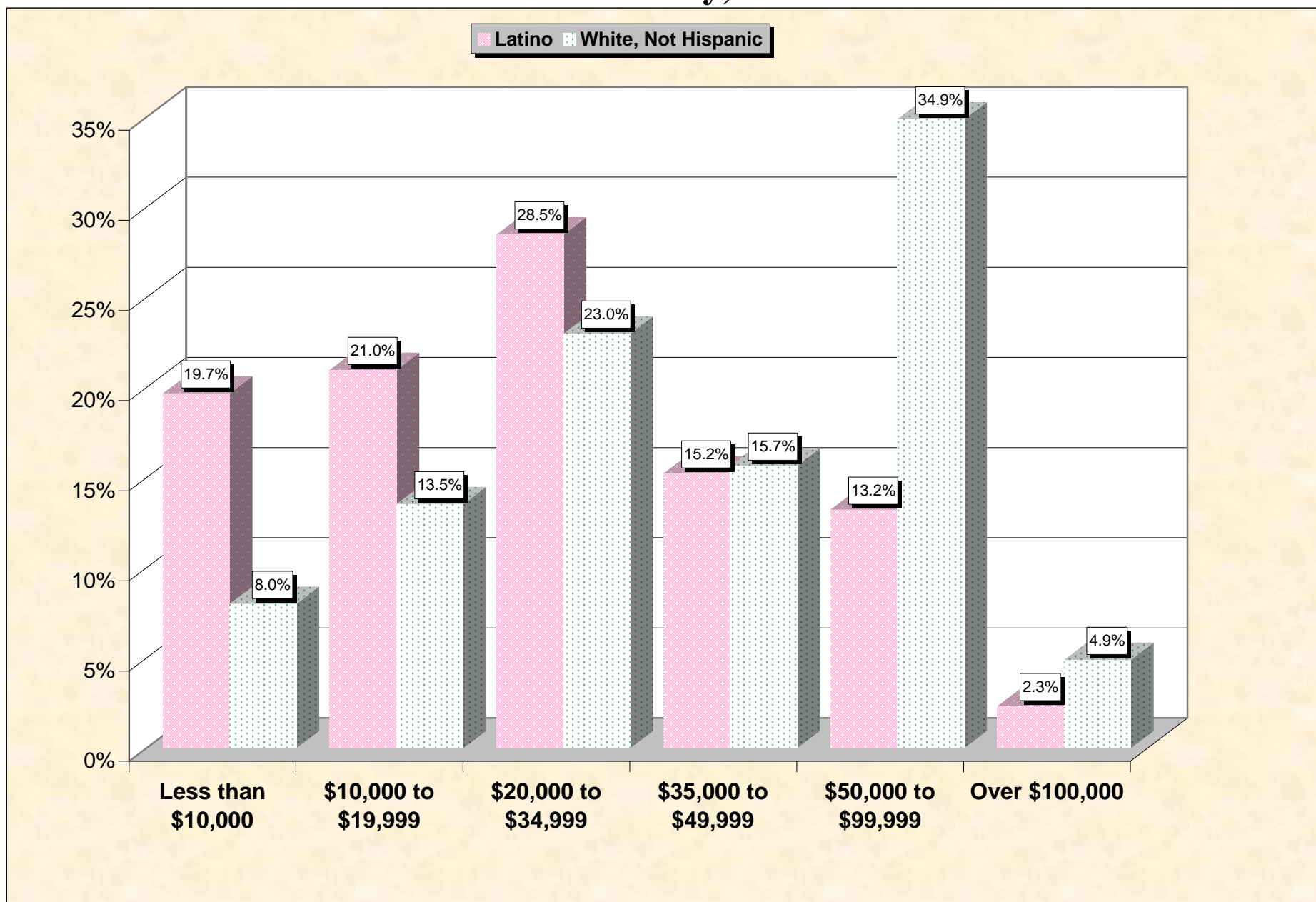
**Chart 5 -- Labor Force Participation (Civilian Labor Force)**

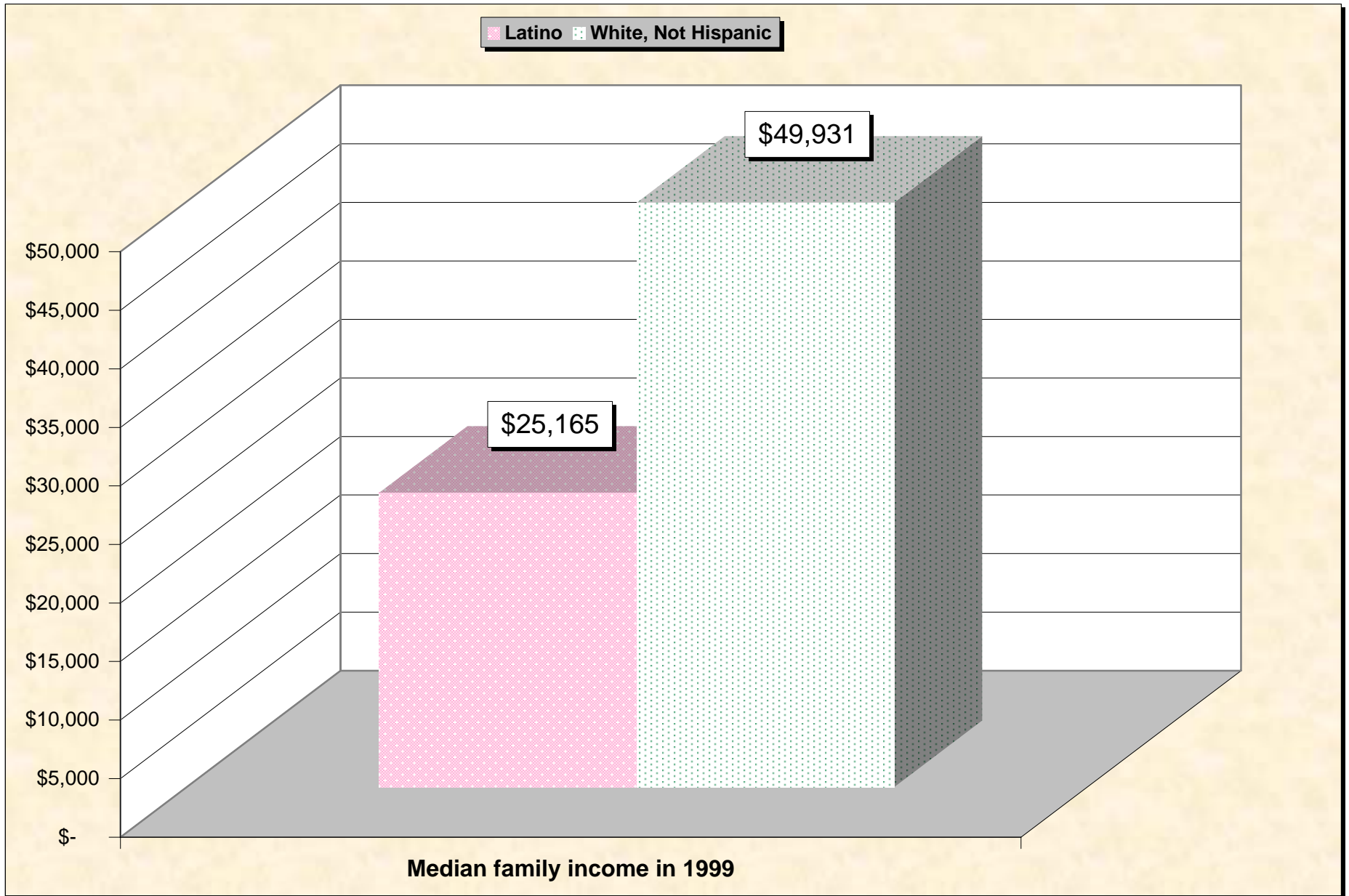

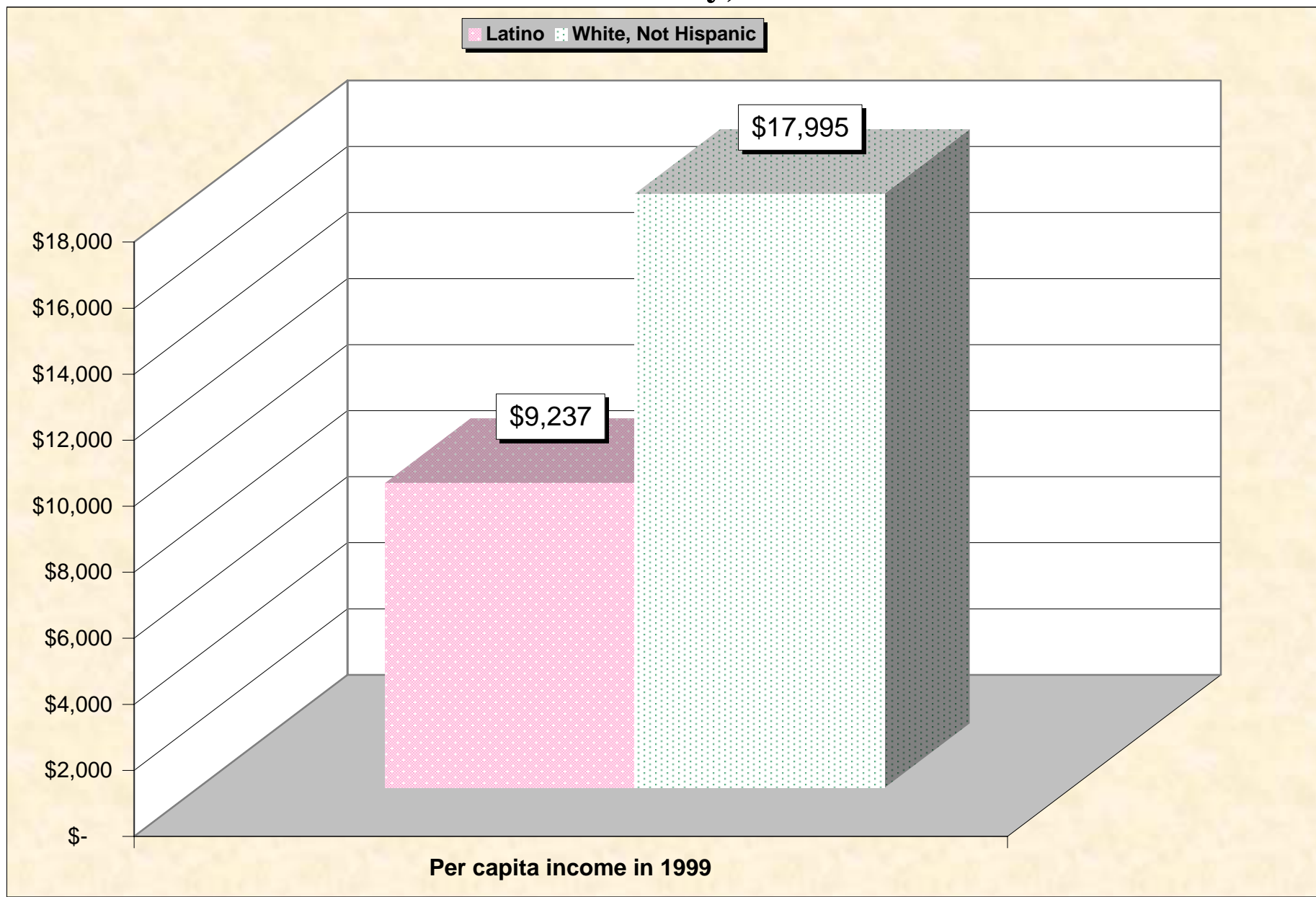

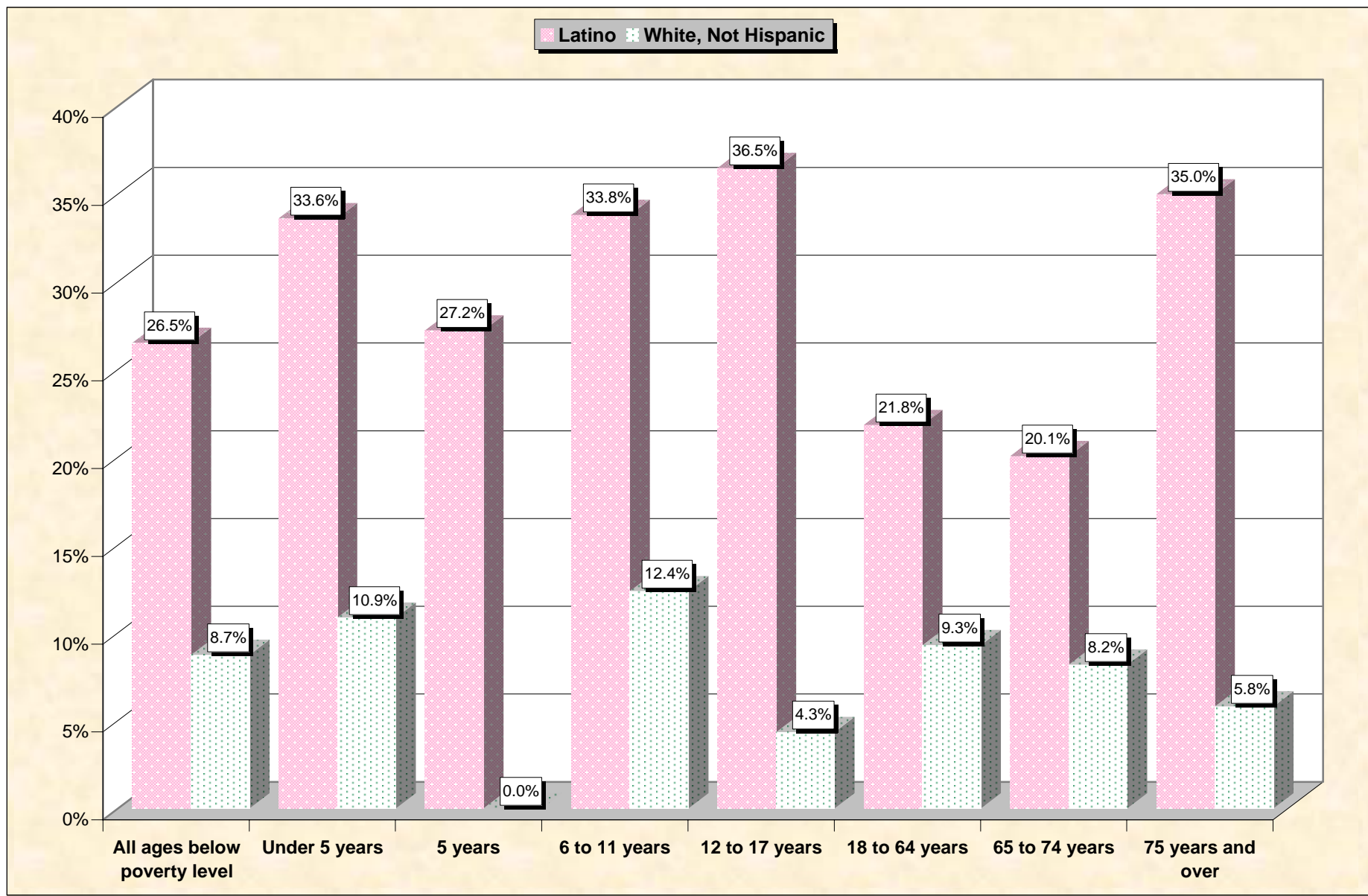
# Chart 8 -- Per Capita Income In 1999

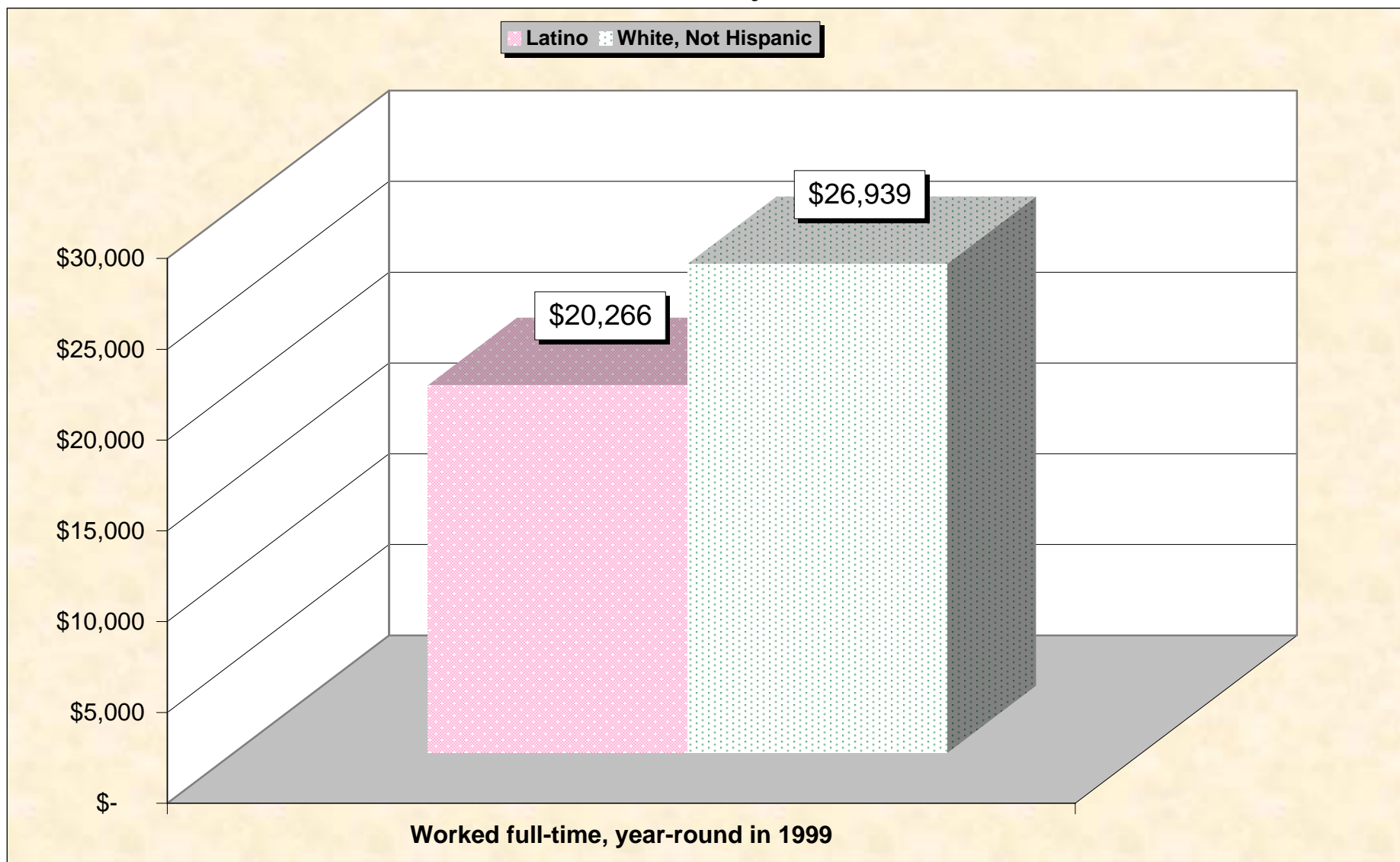

# **Chart 9 -- Income in 1999 Below Poverty Level by Age Pecos County, Texas**



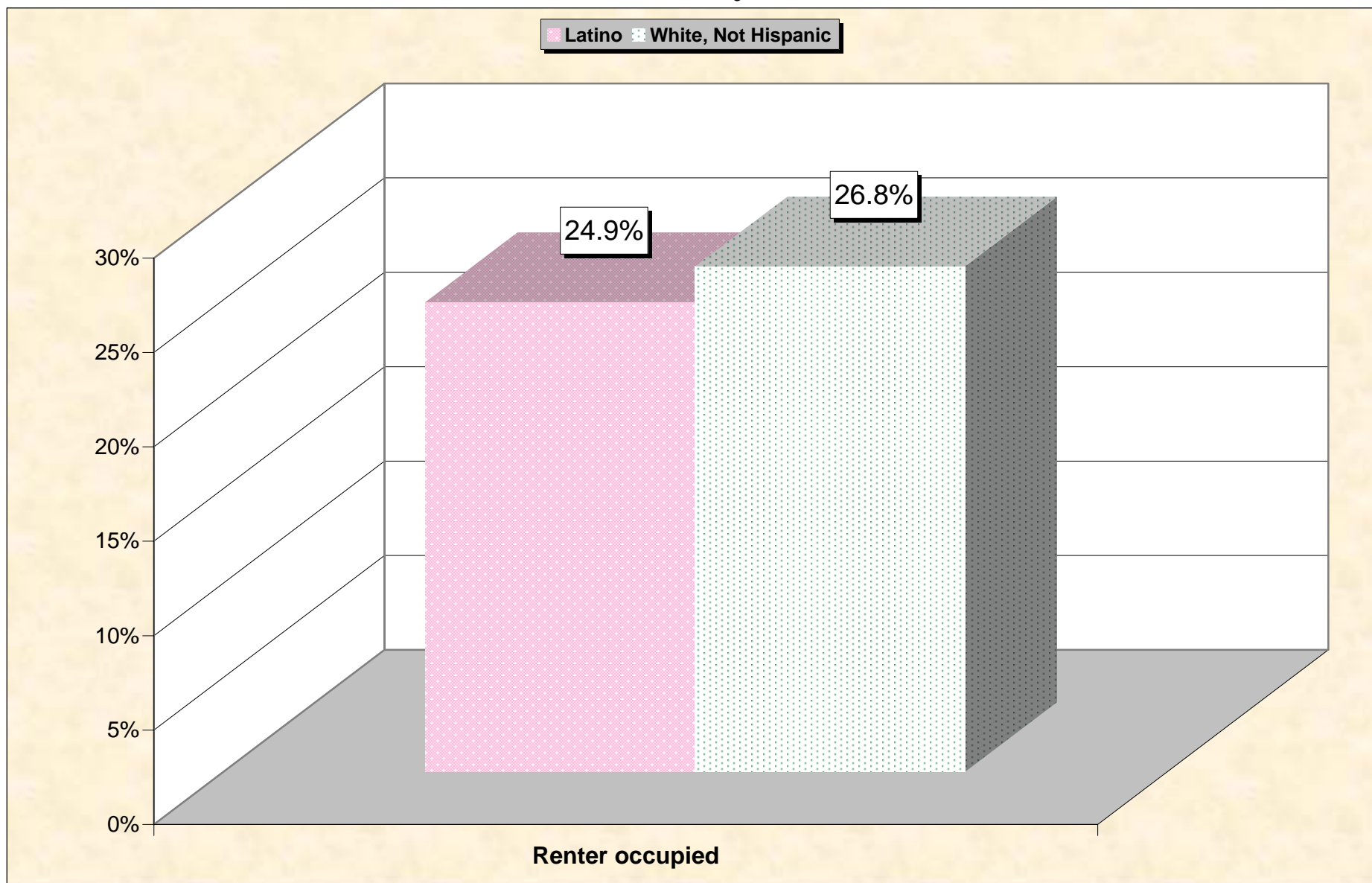

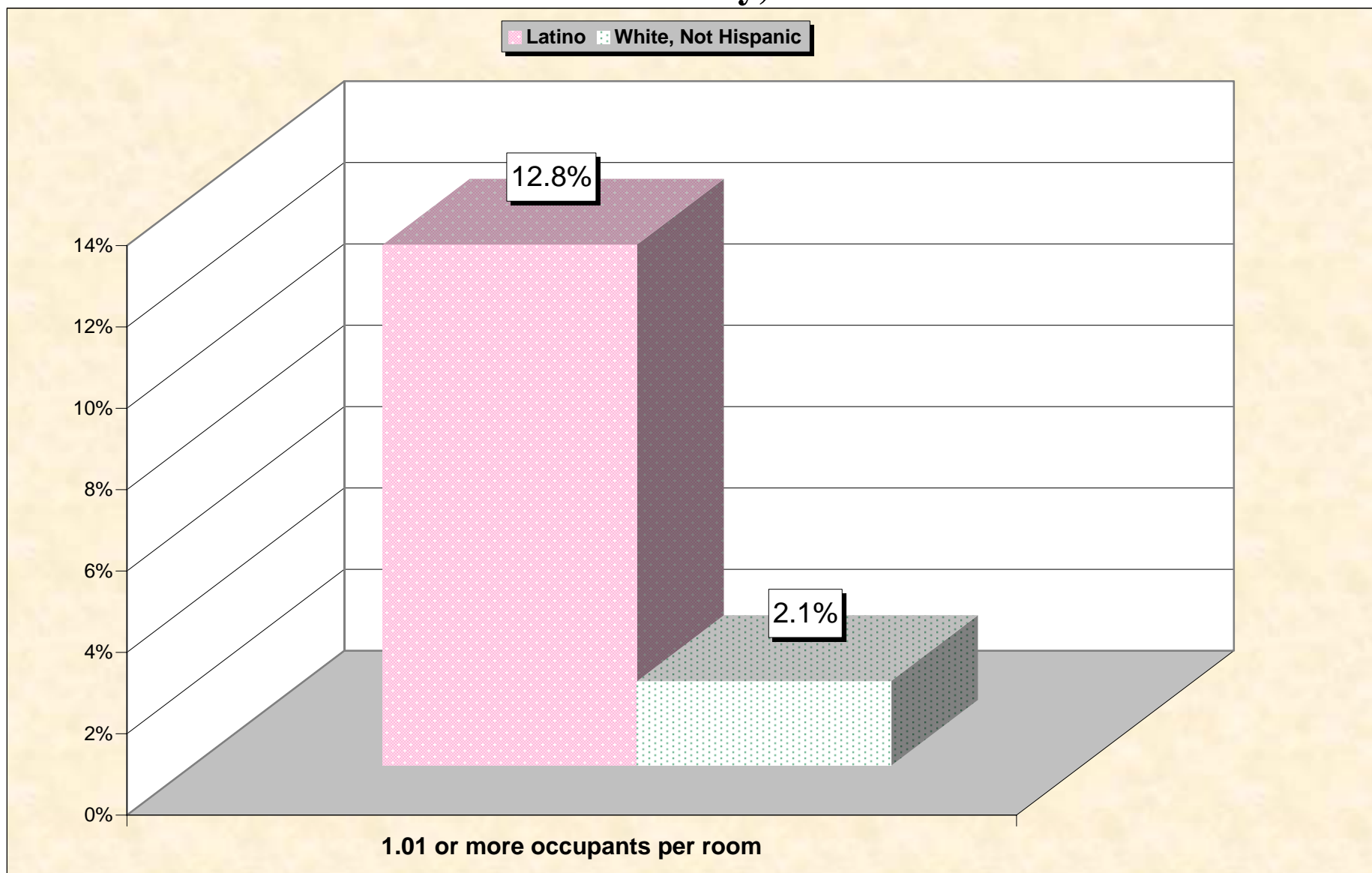

# Chart 11 -- Renter-Occupied Housing Pecos County, Texas



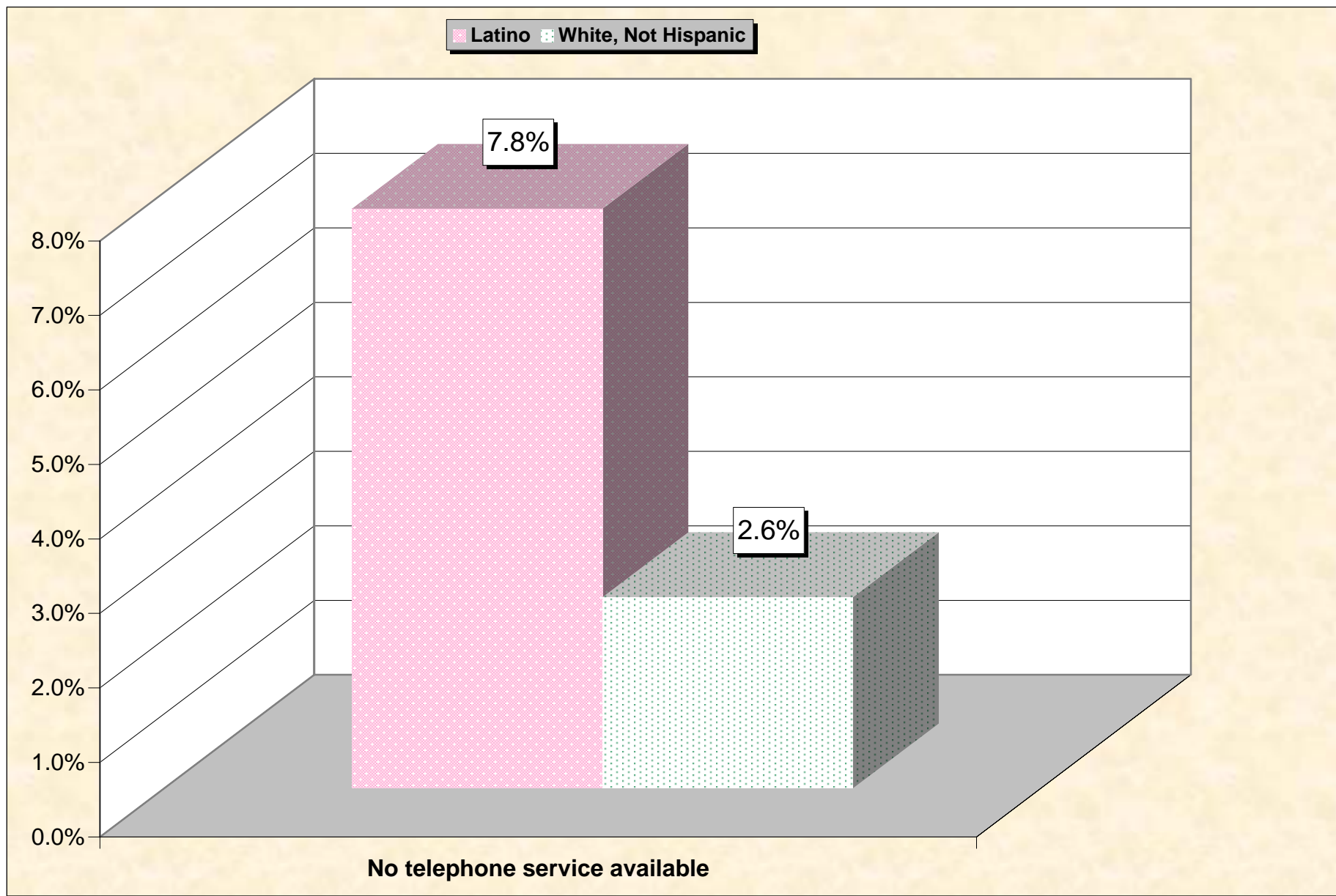

Pecos County, Texas**



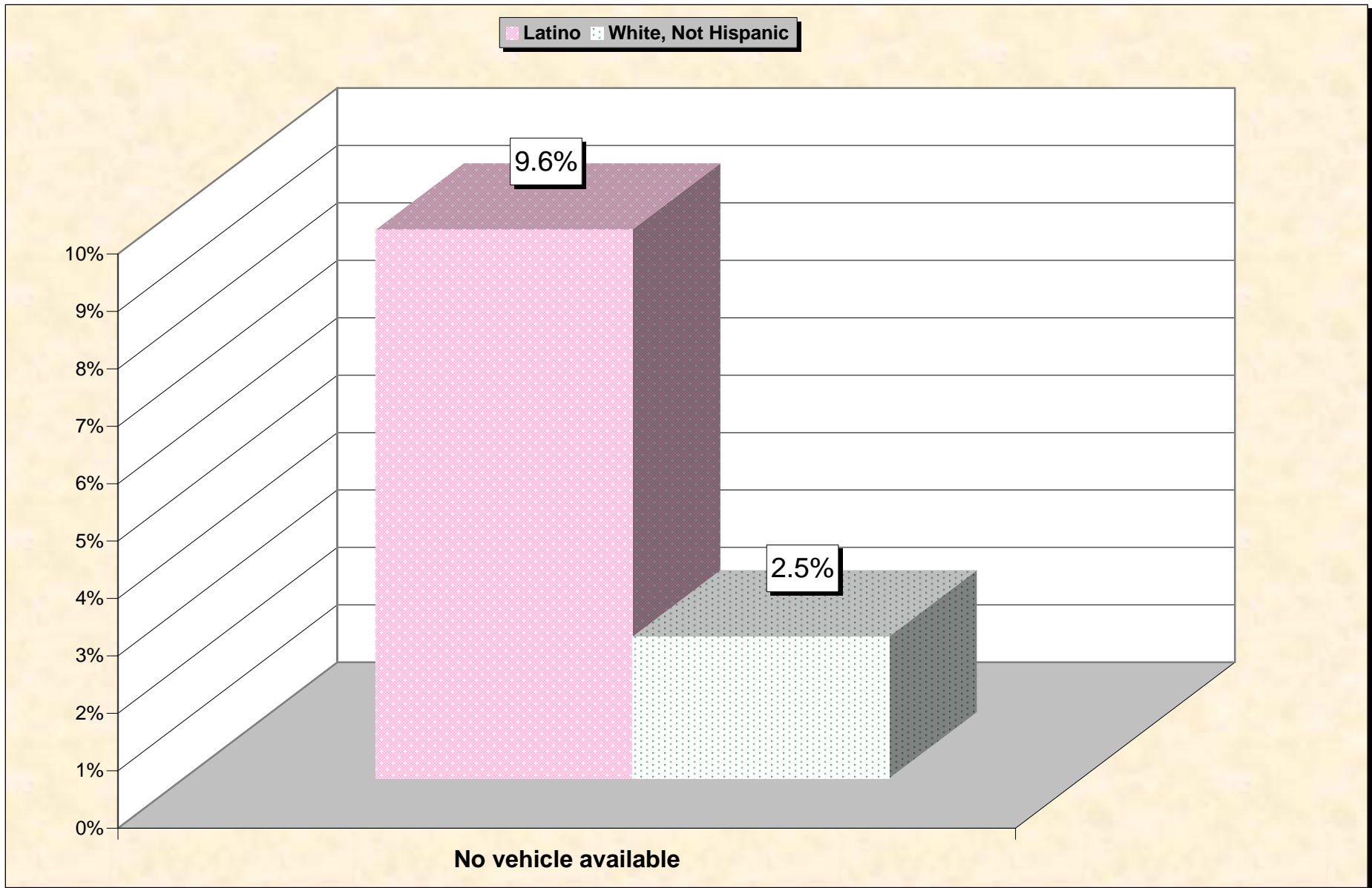

Pecos County, Texas**



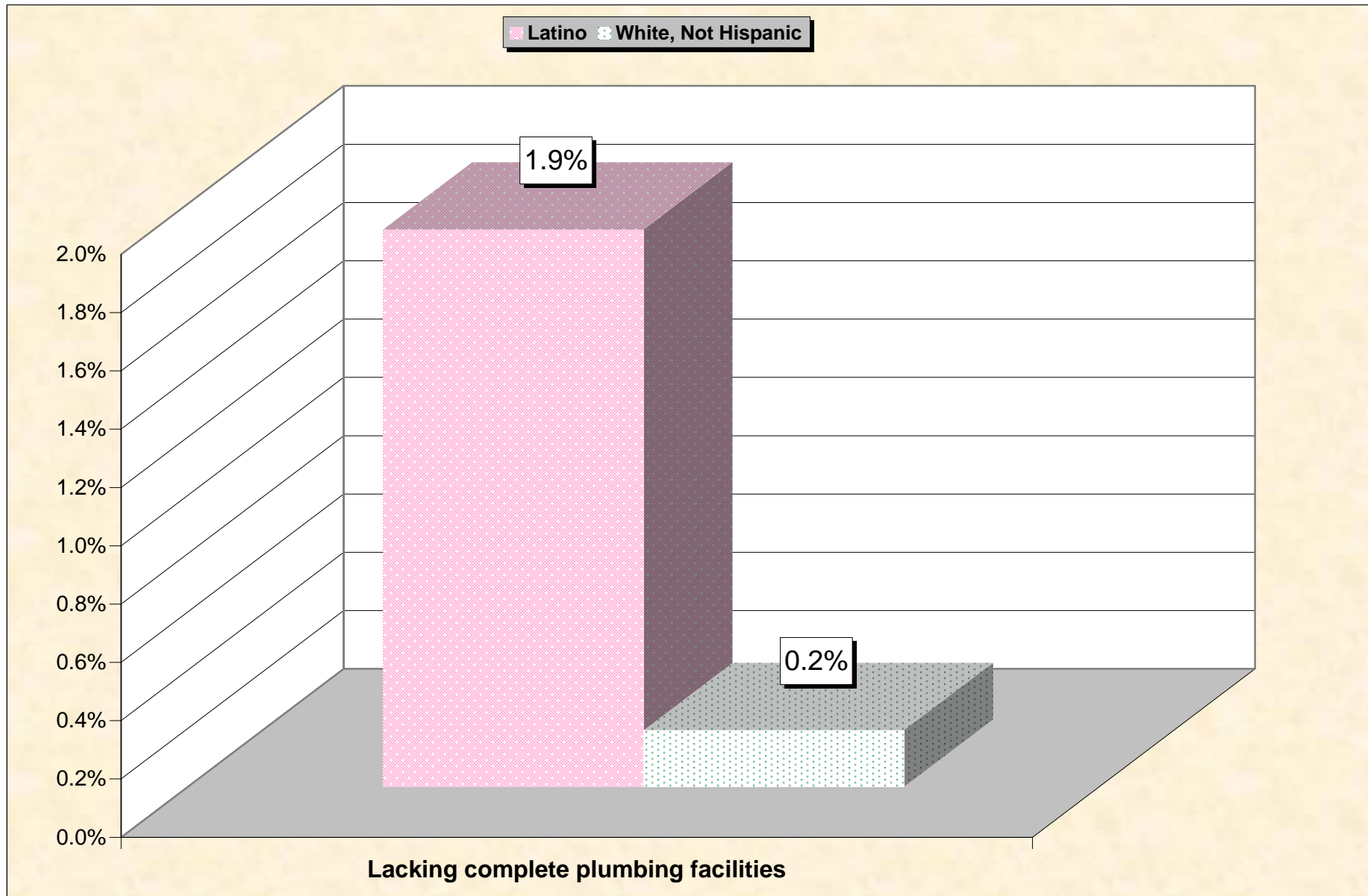

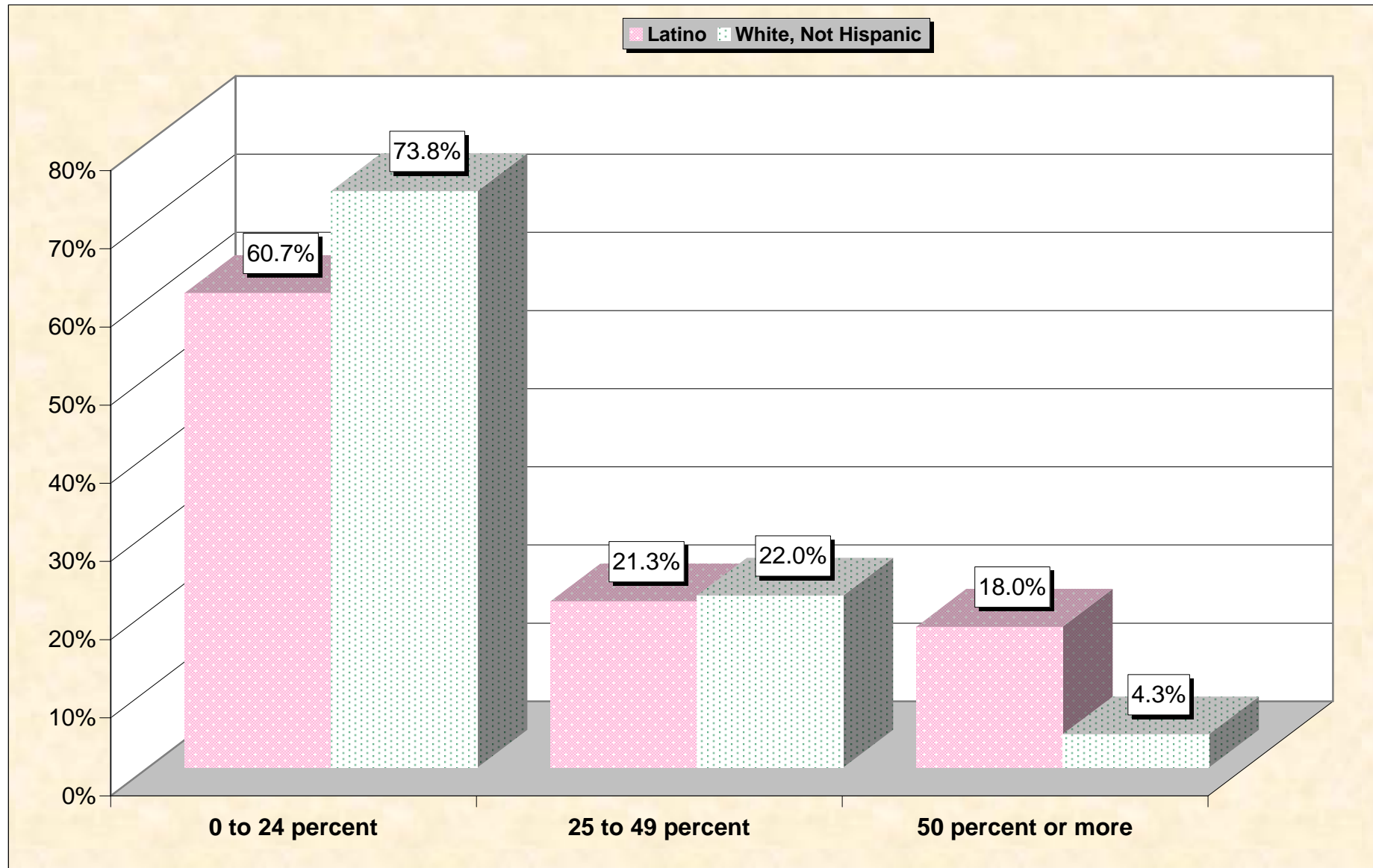
# Chart 15 -- Lack of Plumbing By Household Pecos County, Texas

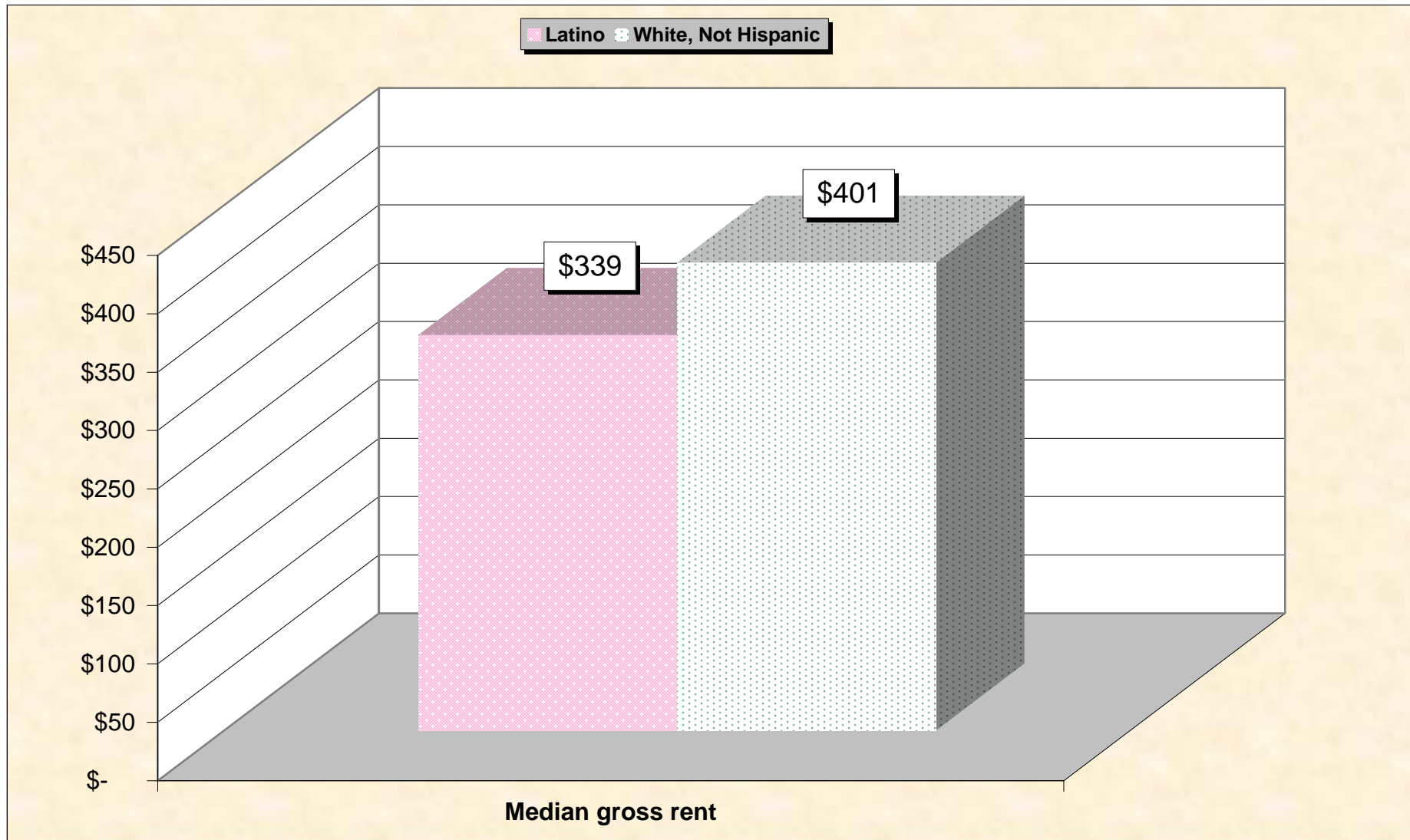


**Chart 16 -- Gross Rent as a Percentage of Household Income in 1999**

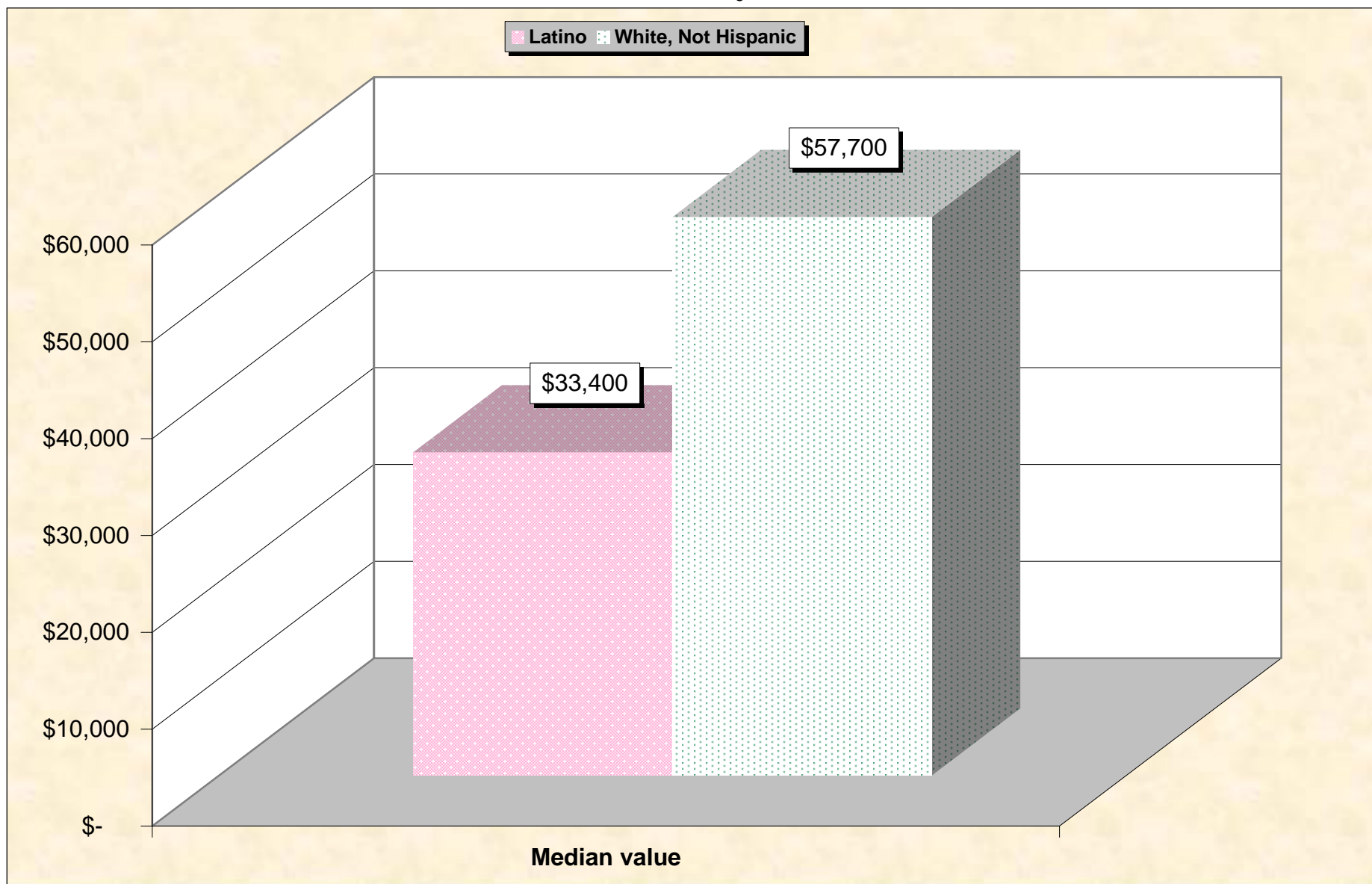
