




**Chart 1 -- Single-Parent Family Households (Householder 15 to 64 years)


Chart 2 -- Private School Enrollment (3 years and over)




Chart 4 -- Unemployment Rate (Civilian Labor Force) Upton County, Texas


Chart 5 -- Labor Force Participation (Civilian Labor Force) Upton County, Texas


**Chart 6 -- Household Income in 1999

Chart 7 -- Median Family Income In 1999




Chart 8 -- Per Capita Income In 1999


**Chart 9 -- Income in 1999 Below Poverty Level by Age


Chart 10 -- Median Earnings in 1999



Chart 11 -- Renter-Occupied Housing Upton County, Texas





Chart 12 -- Occupants Per Room (Crowding) by Household Upton County, Texas





Upton County, Texas**





Chart 14 -- Lack of Vehicle By Household Upton County, Texas








