

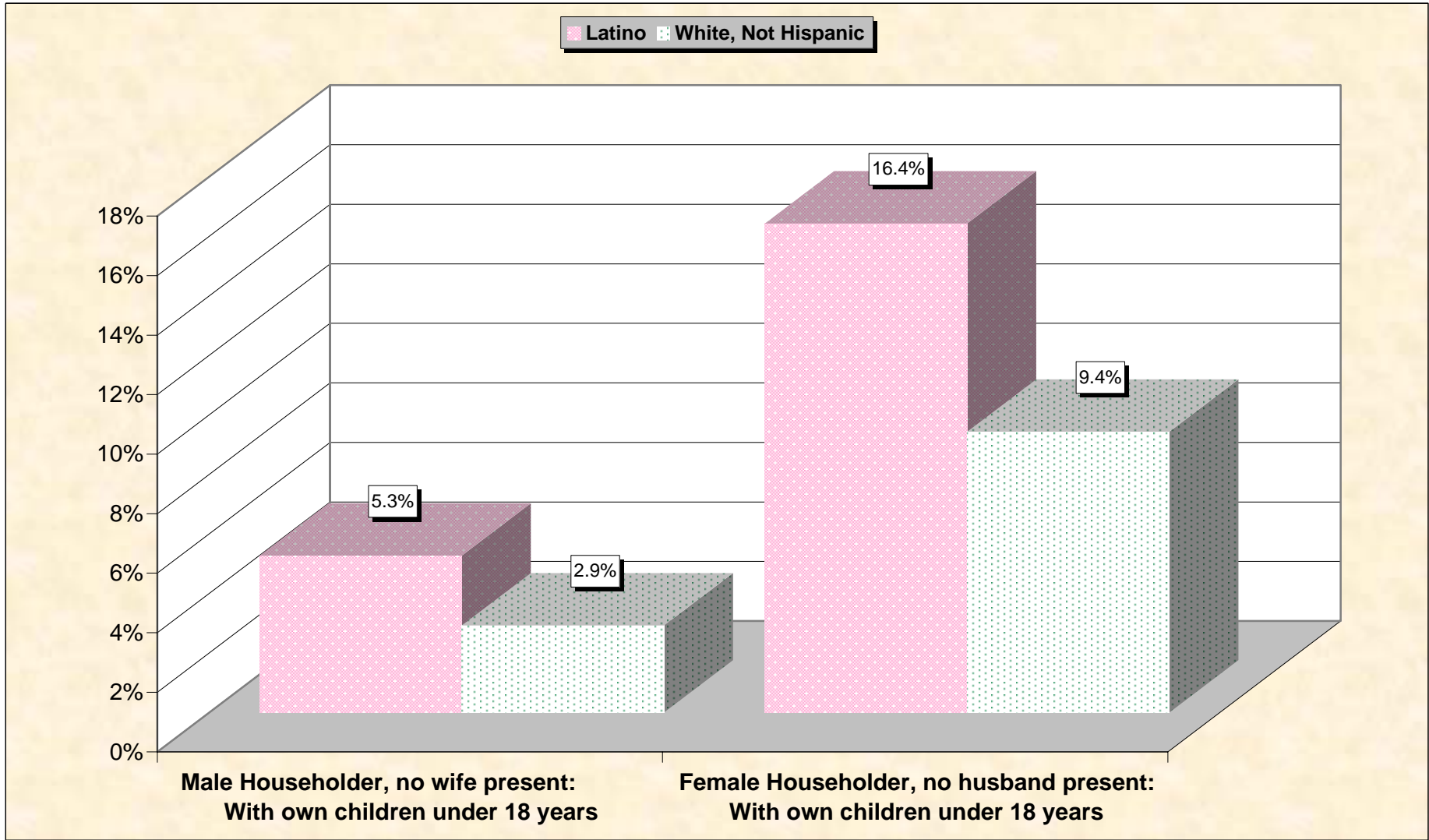

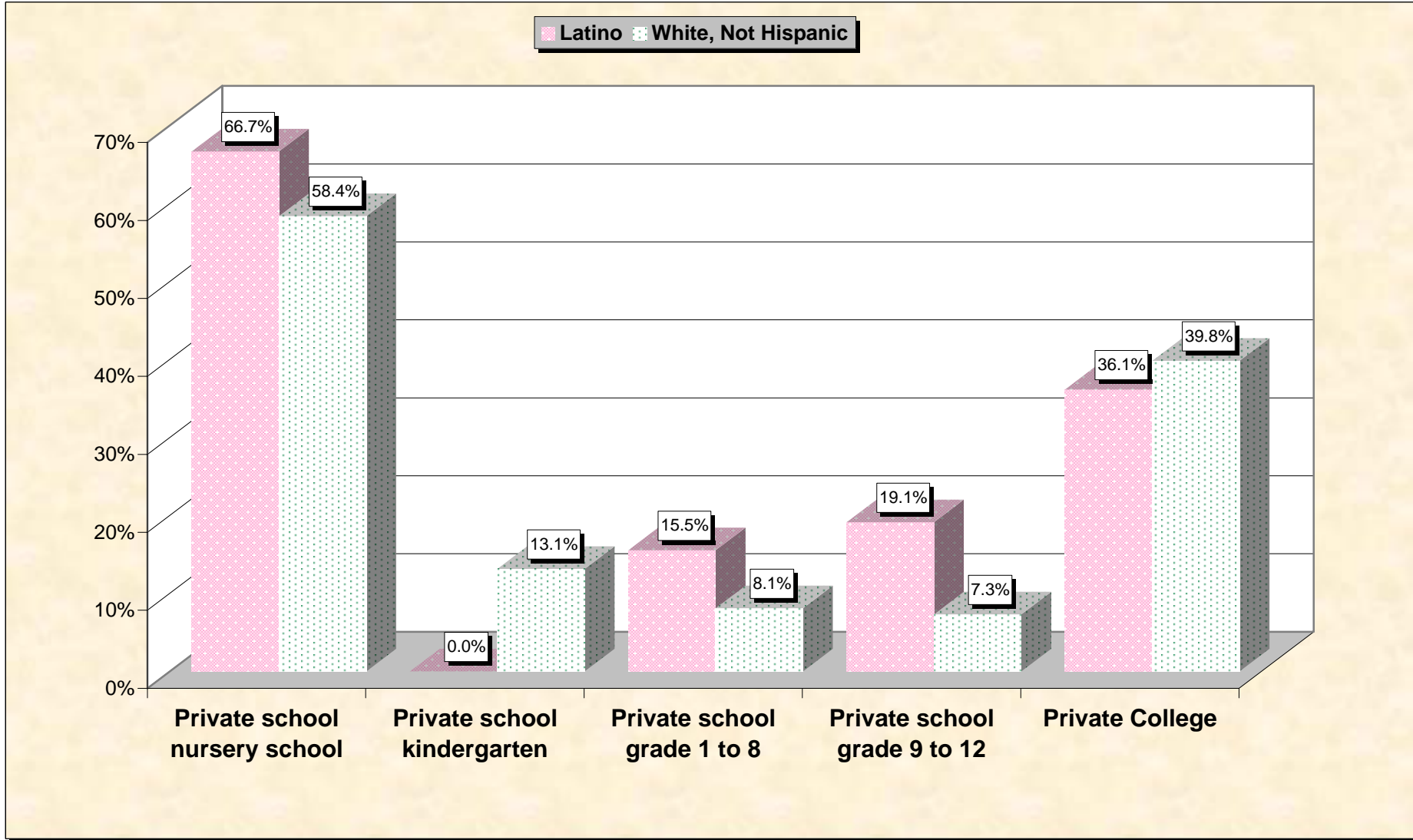

# Chart 1 -- Single-Parent Family Households (Householder 15 to 64 years) Roanoke, VA MSA; Virginia



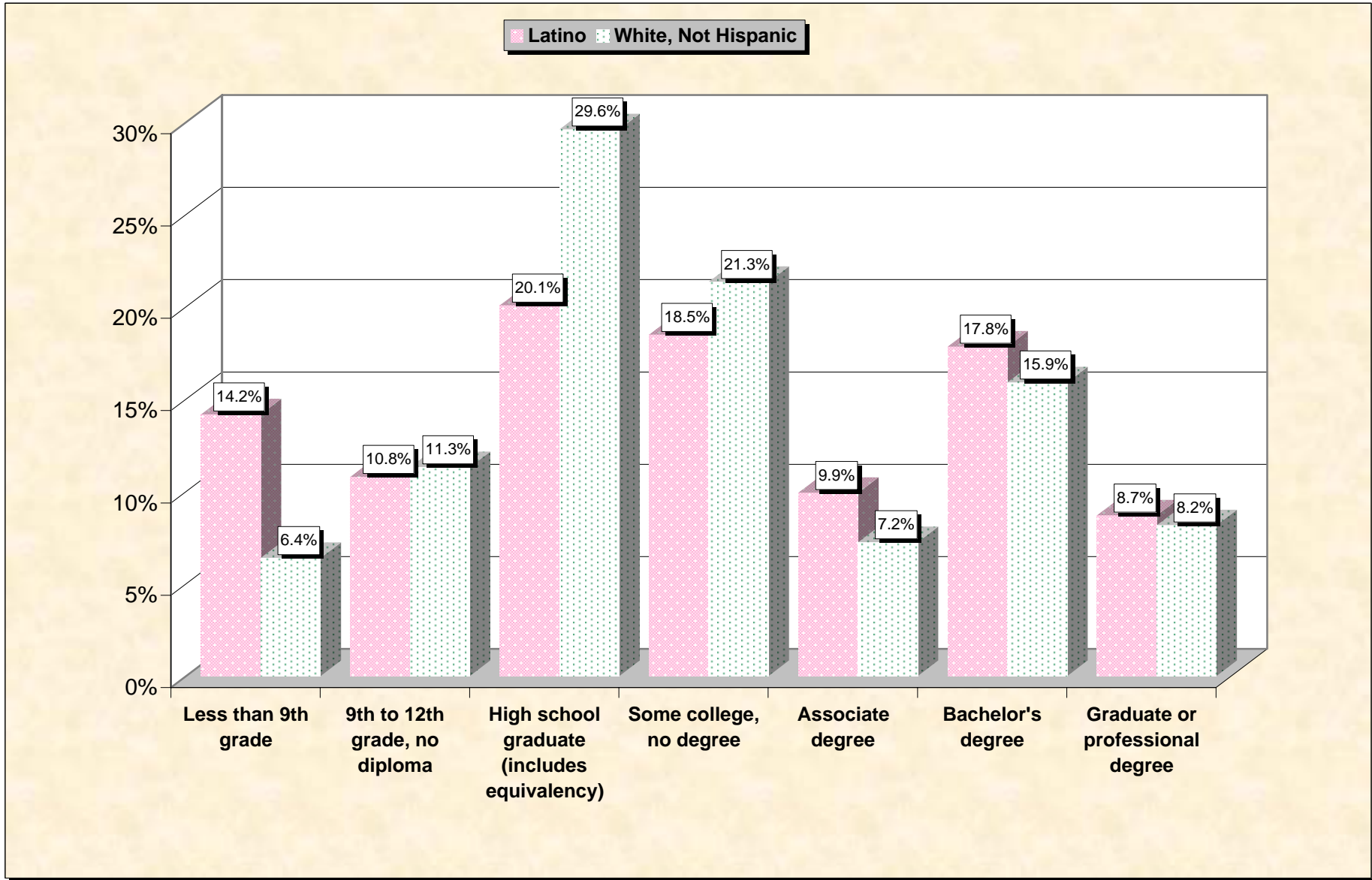

## Chart 2 -- Private School Enrollment (3 years and over) Roanoke, VA MSA; Virginia



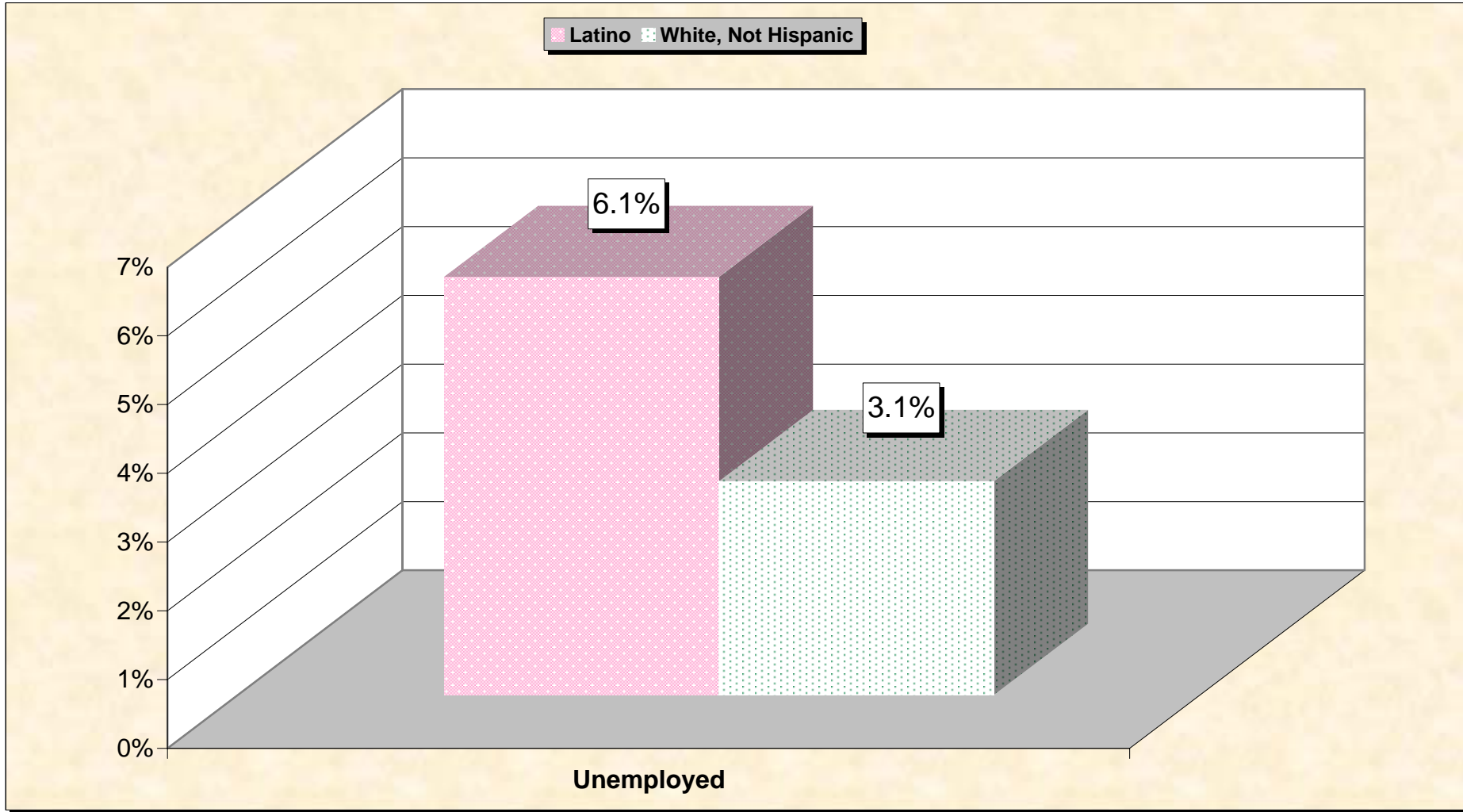

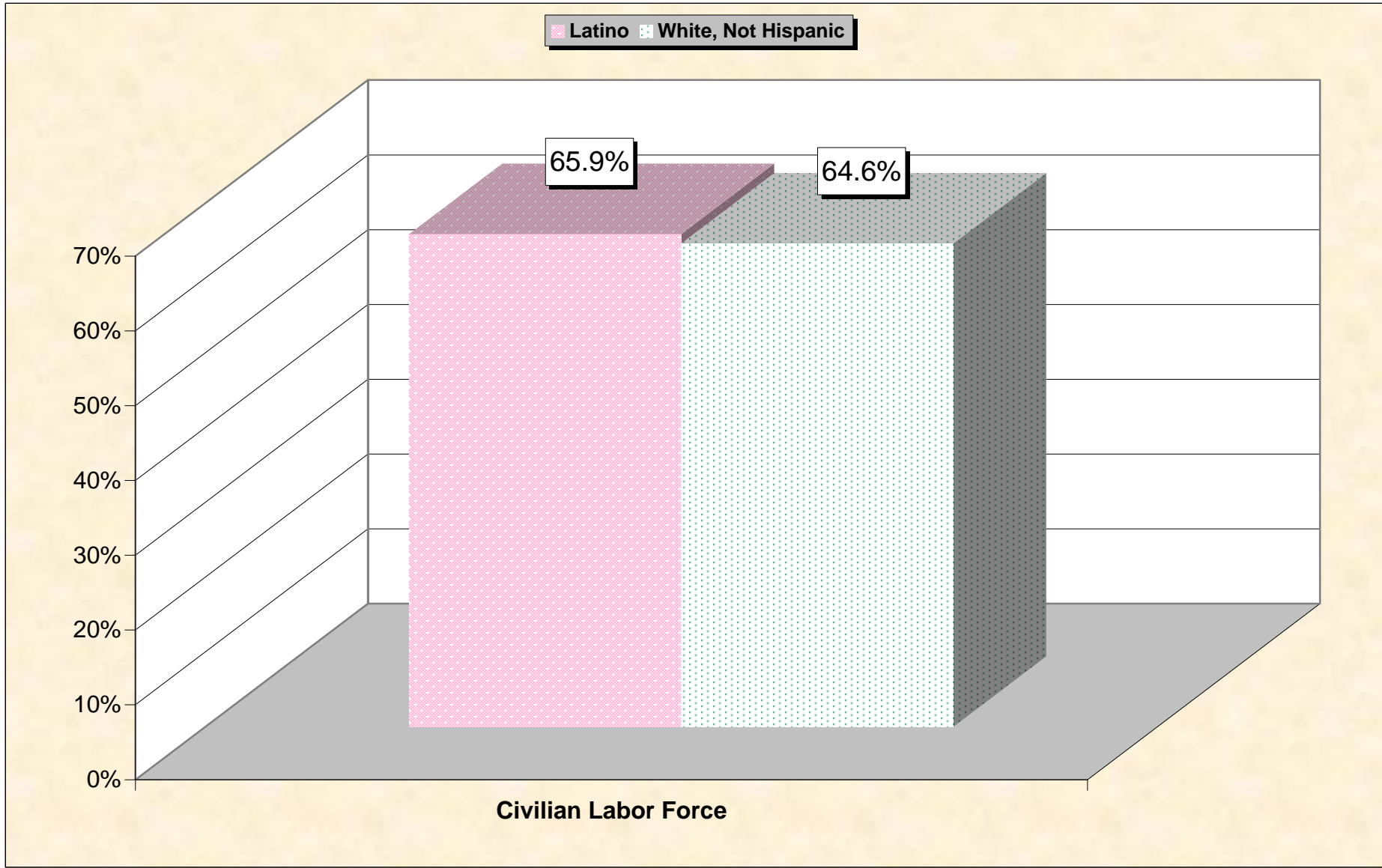
# Chart 4 -- Unemployment Rate (Civilian Labor Force) Roanoke, VA MSA; Virginia

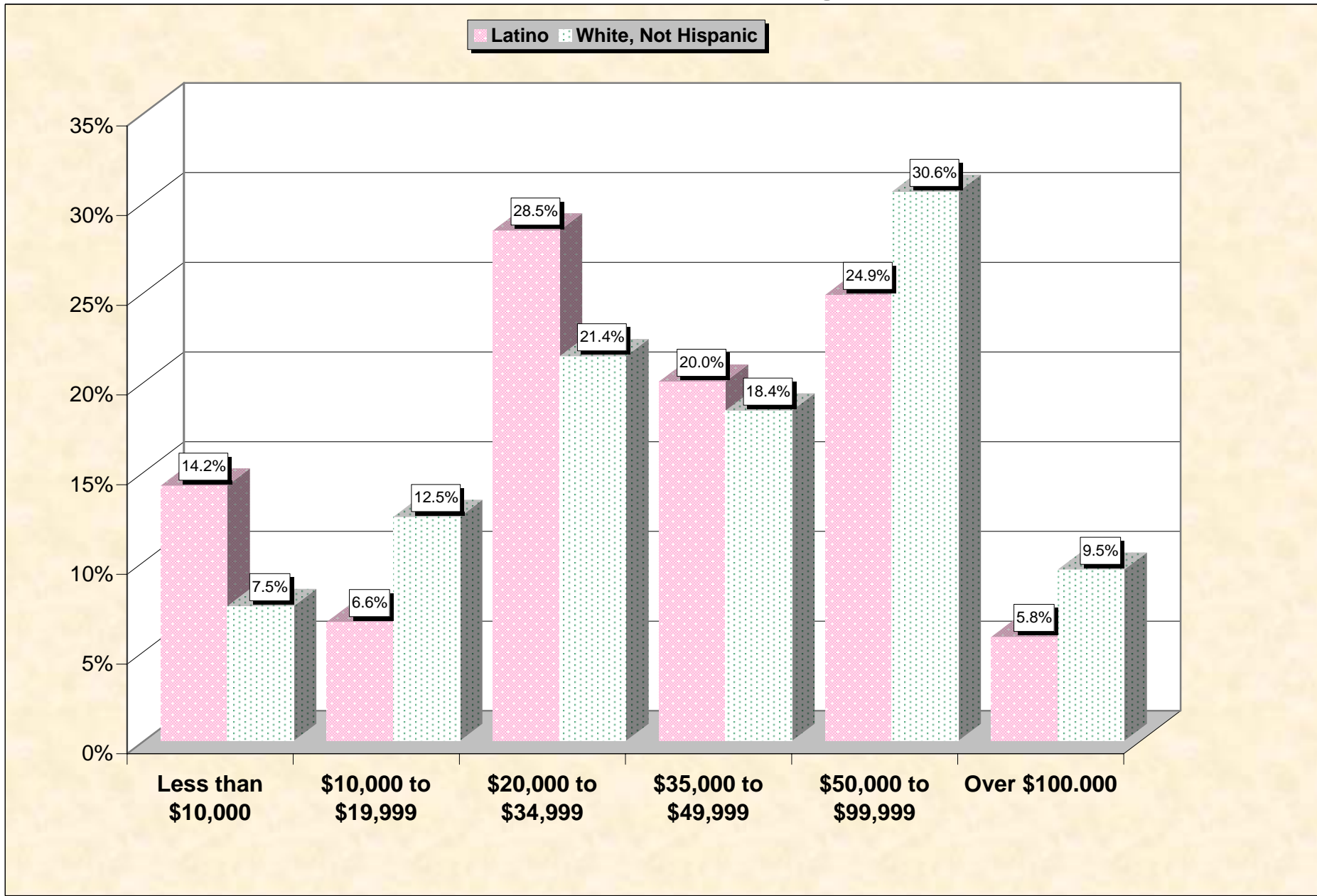
# Chart 5 -- Labor Force Participation (Civilian Labor Force) Roanoke, VA MSA; Virginia

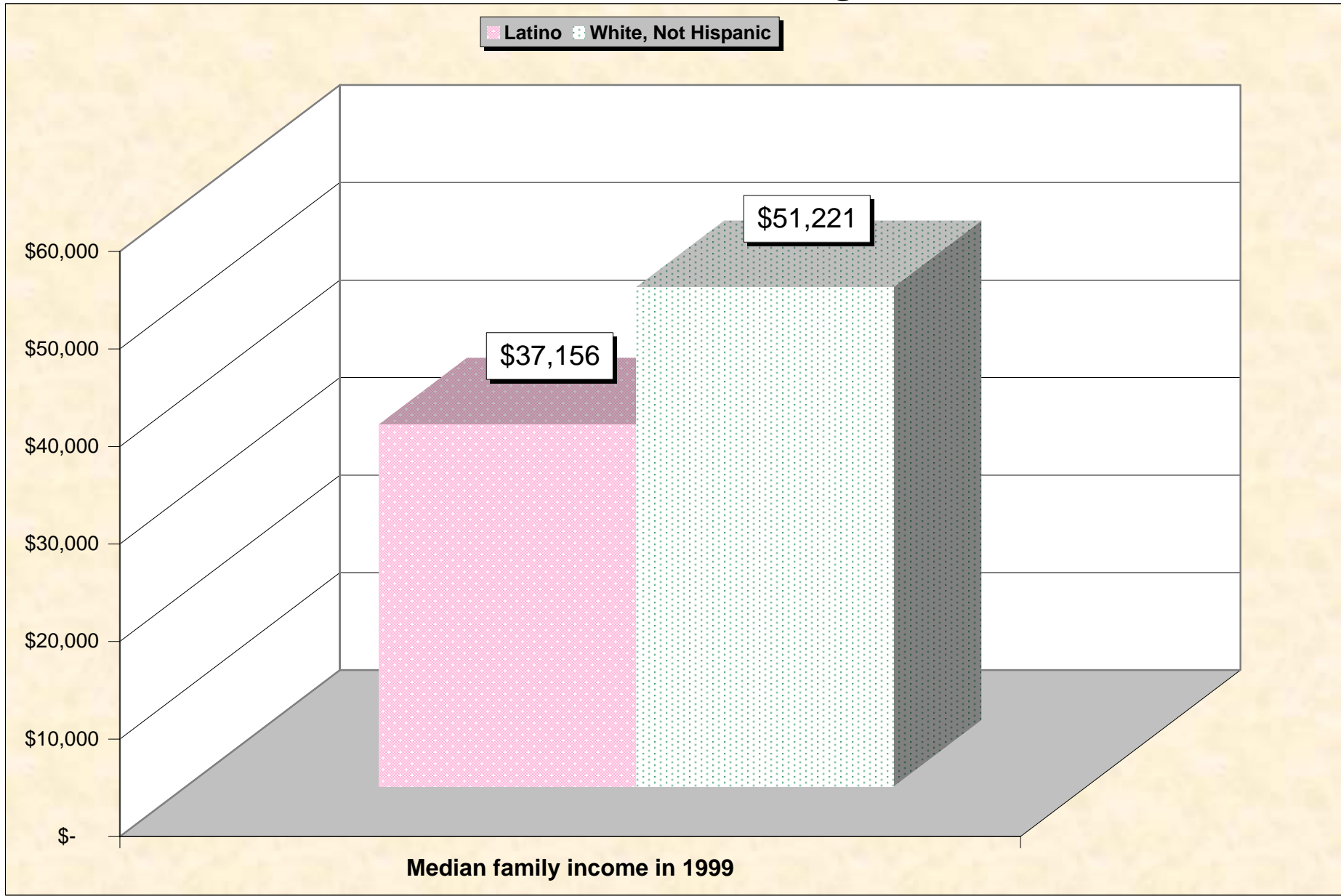

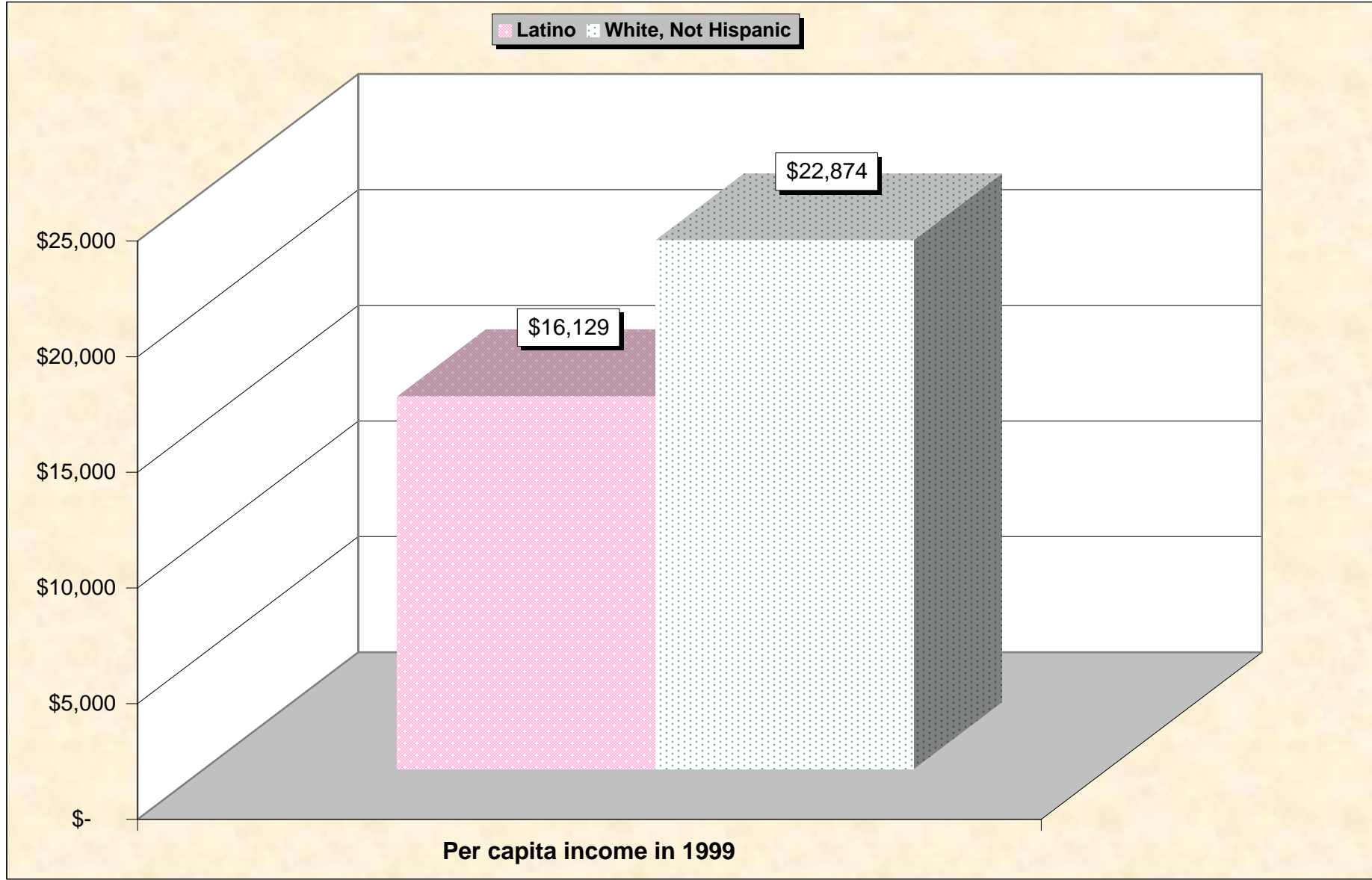
# Chart 7 -- Median Family Income In 1999 Roanoke, VA MSA; Virginia

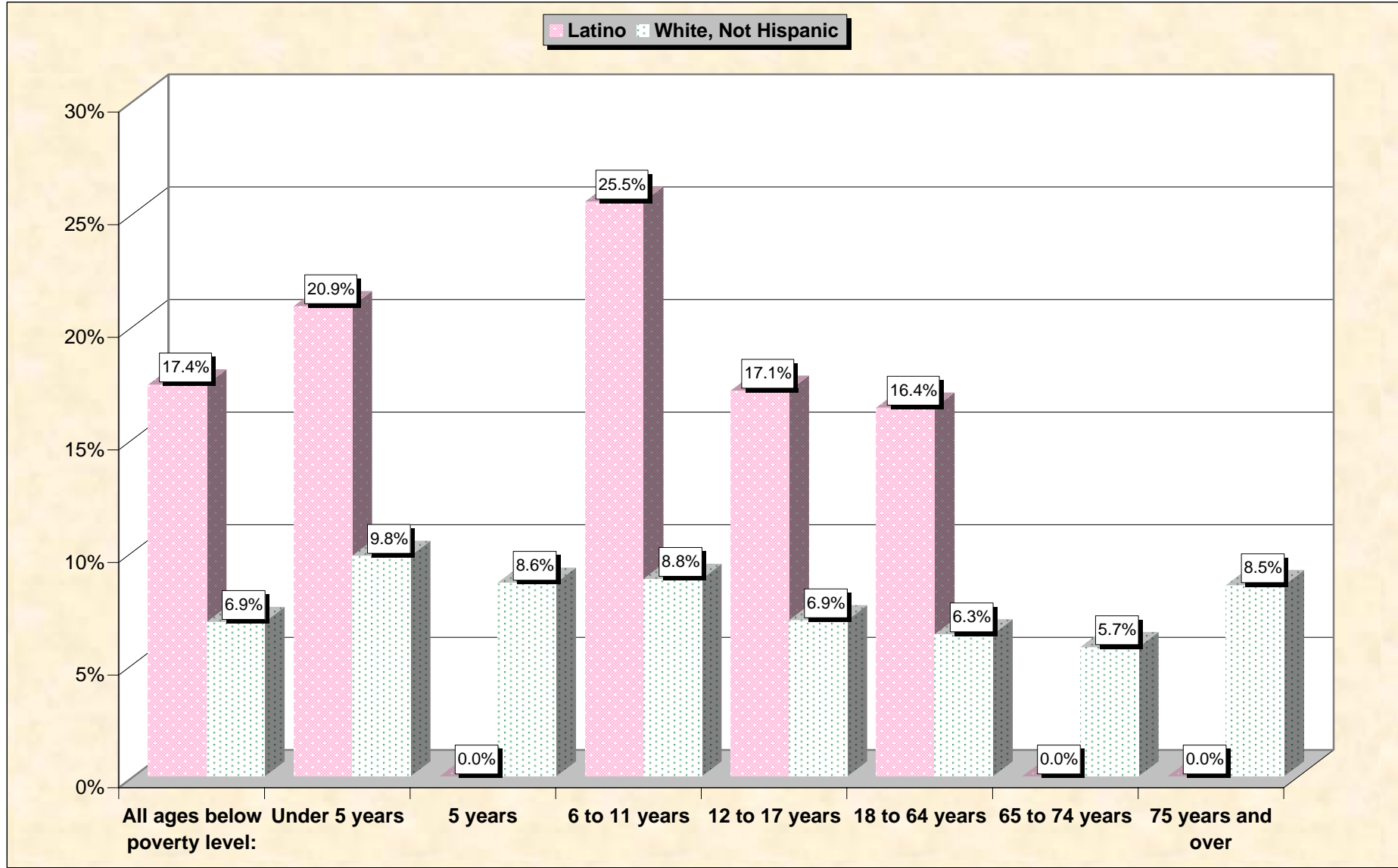


# Chart 8 -- Per Capita Income In 1999 Roanoke, VA MSA; Virginia



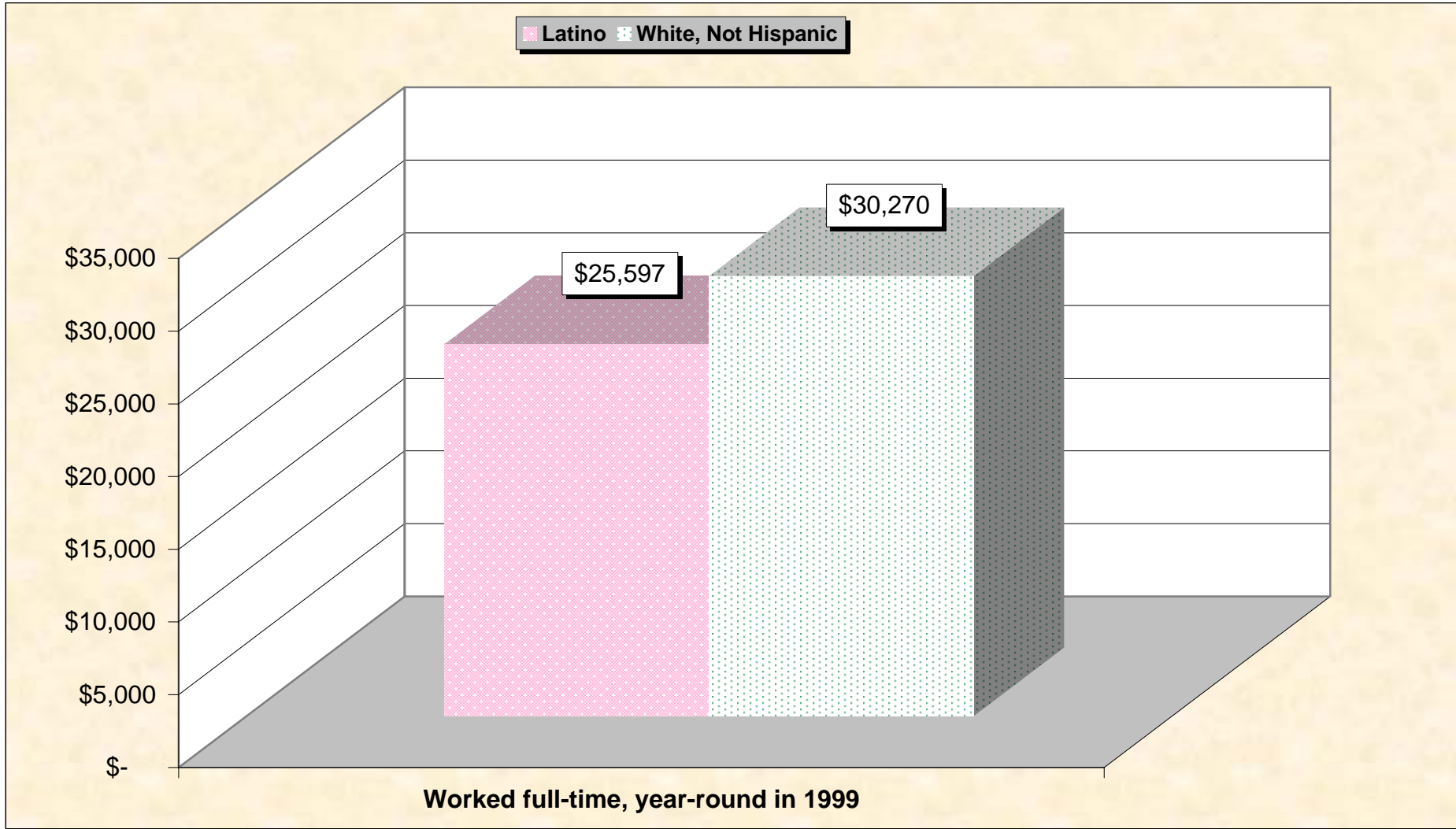

## Chart 9 -- Income in 1999 Below Poverty Level by Age Roanoke, VA MSA; Virginia



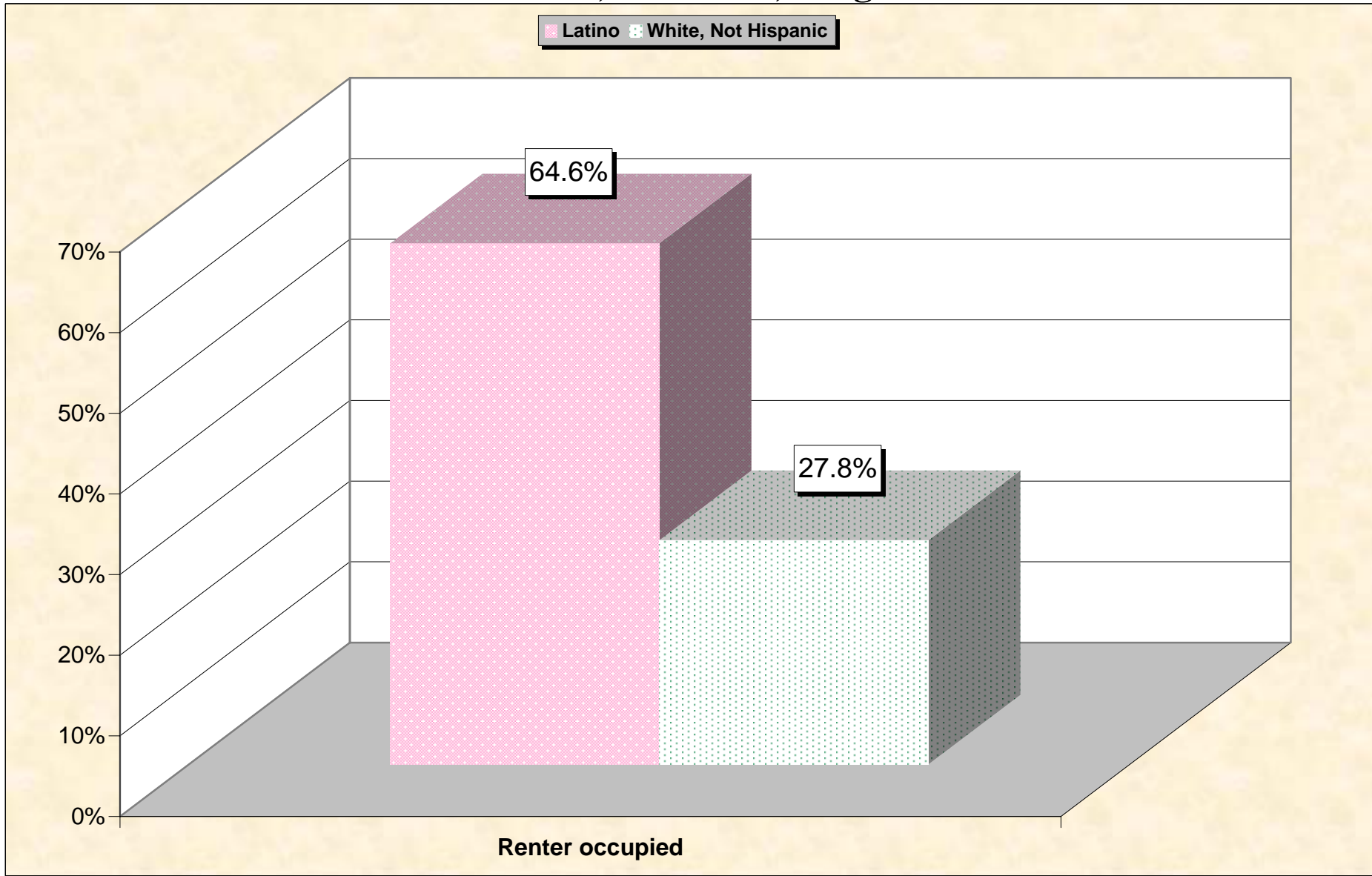

# Chart 10 -- Median Earnings in 1999 Roanoke, VA MSA; Virginia



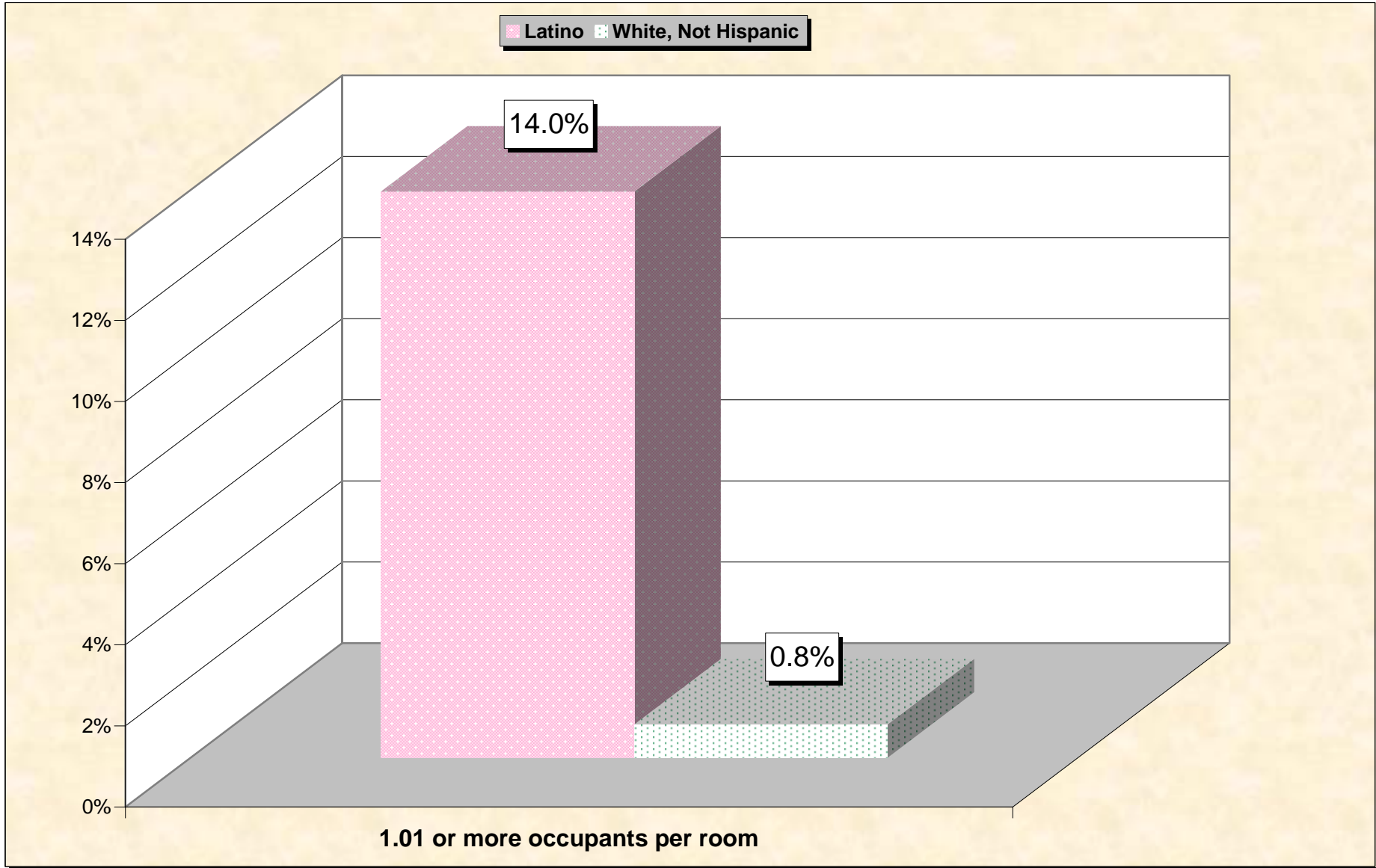

# Chart 11 -- Renter-Occupied Housing Roanoke, VA MSA; Virginia



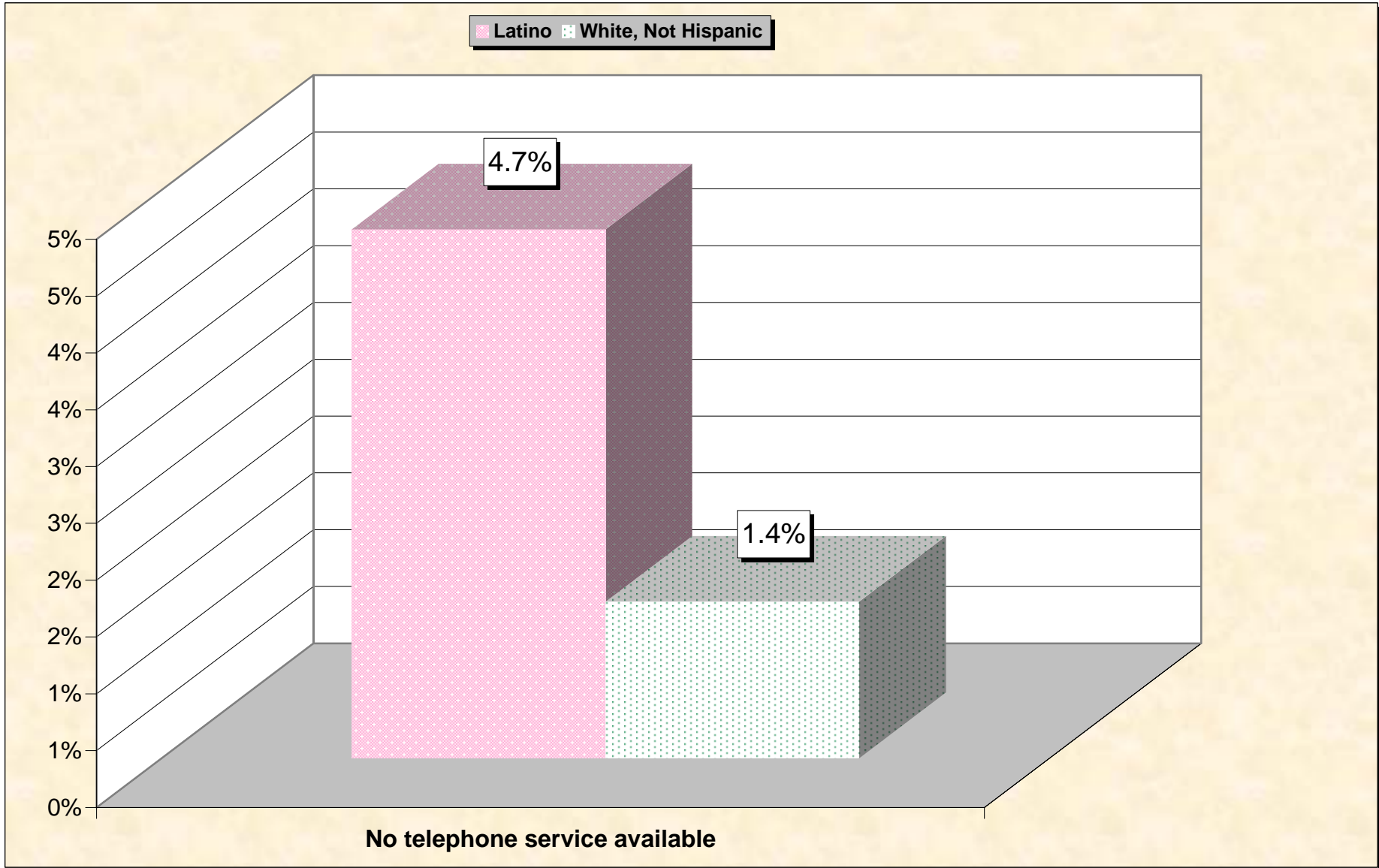

# Chart 12 -- Occupants Per Room (Crowding) by Household Roanoke, VA MSA; Virginia



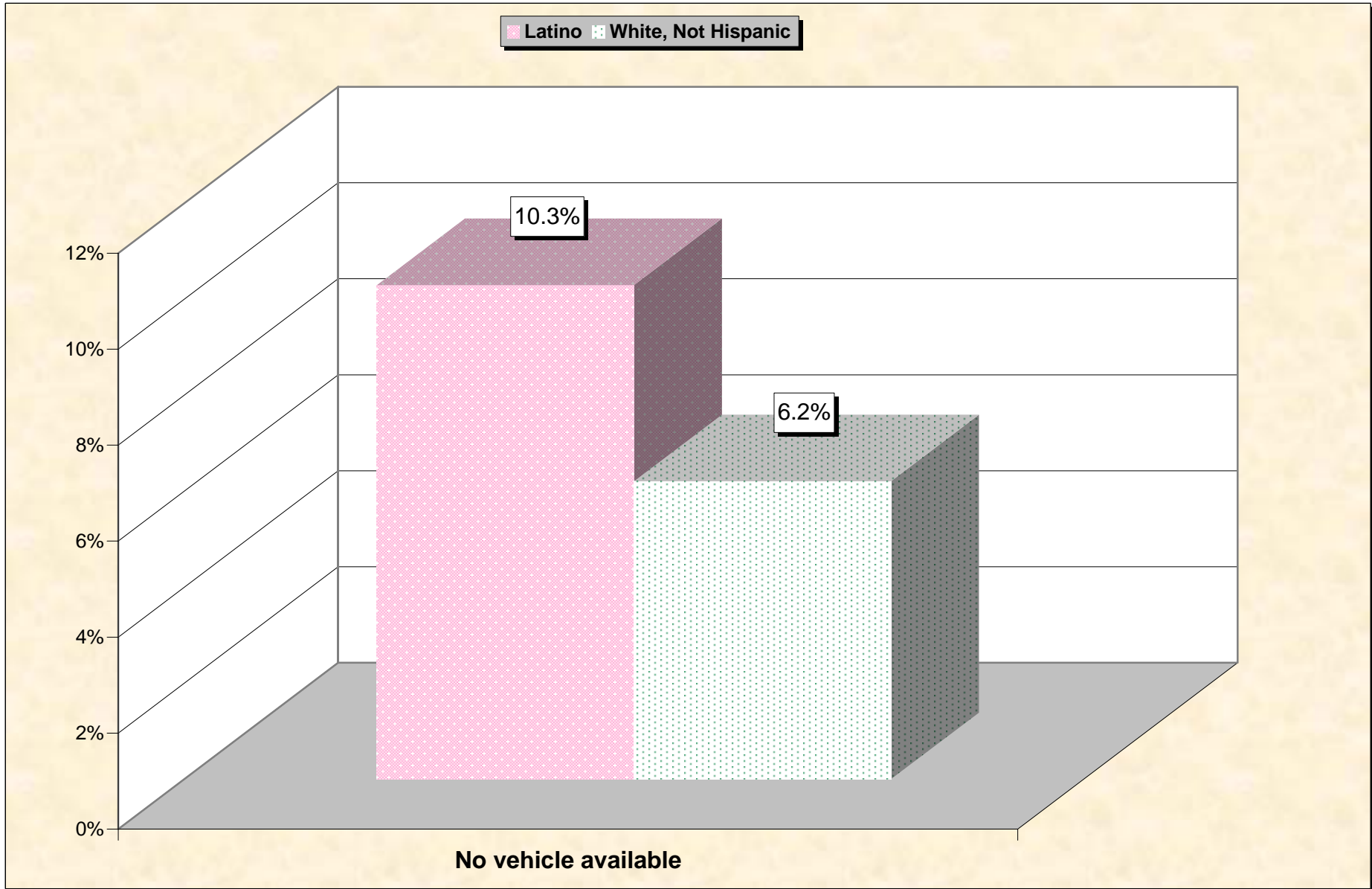

# Chart 13 -- Lack of Telephone Service by Household Roanoke, VA MSA; Virginia



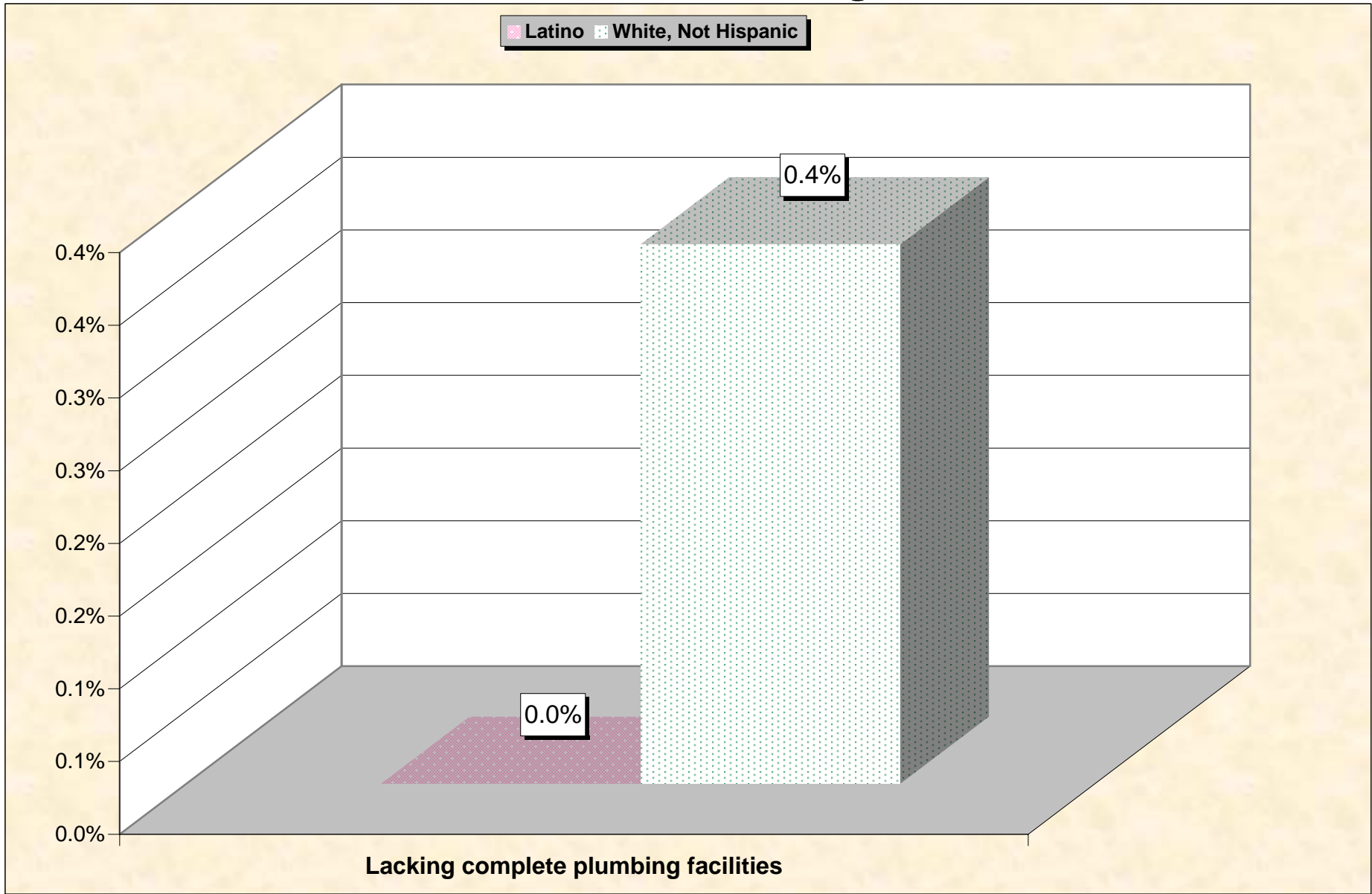

# Chart 15 -- Lack of Plumbing By Household Roanoke, VA MSA; Virginia

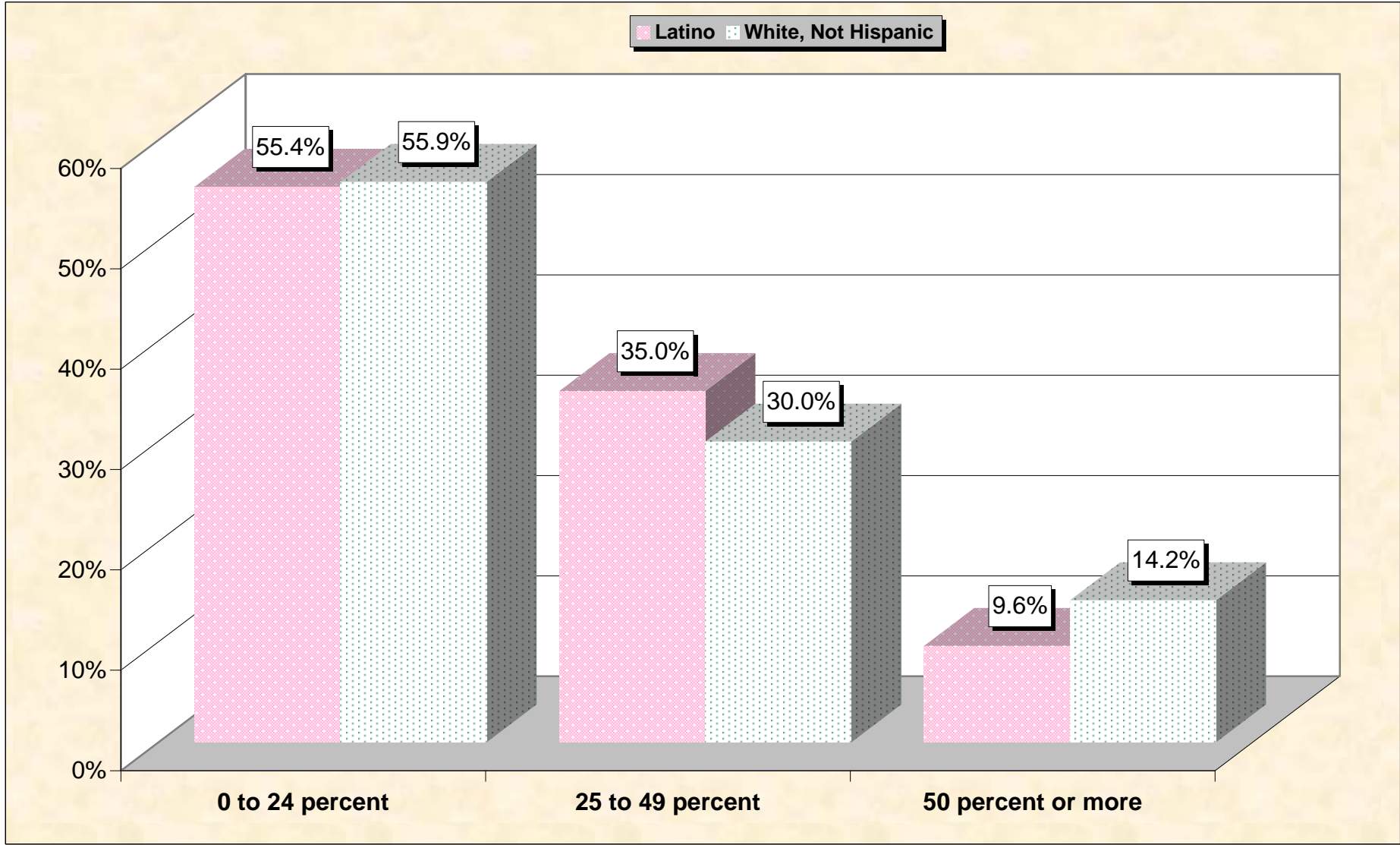

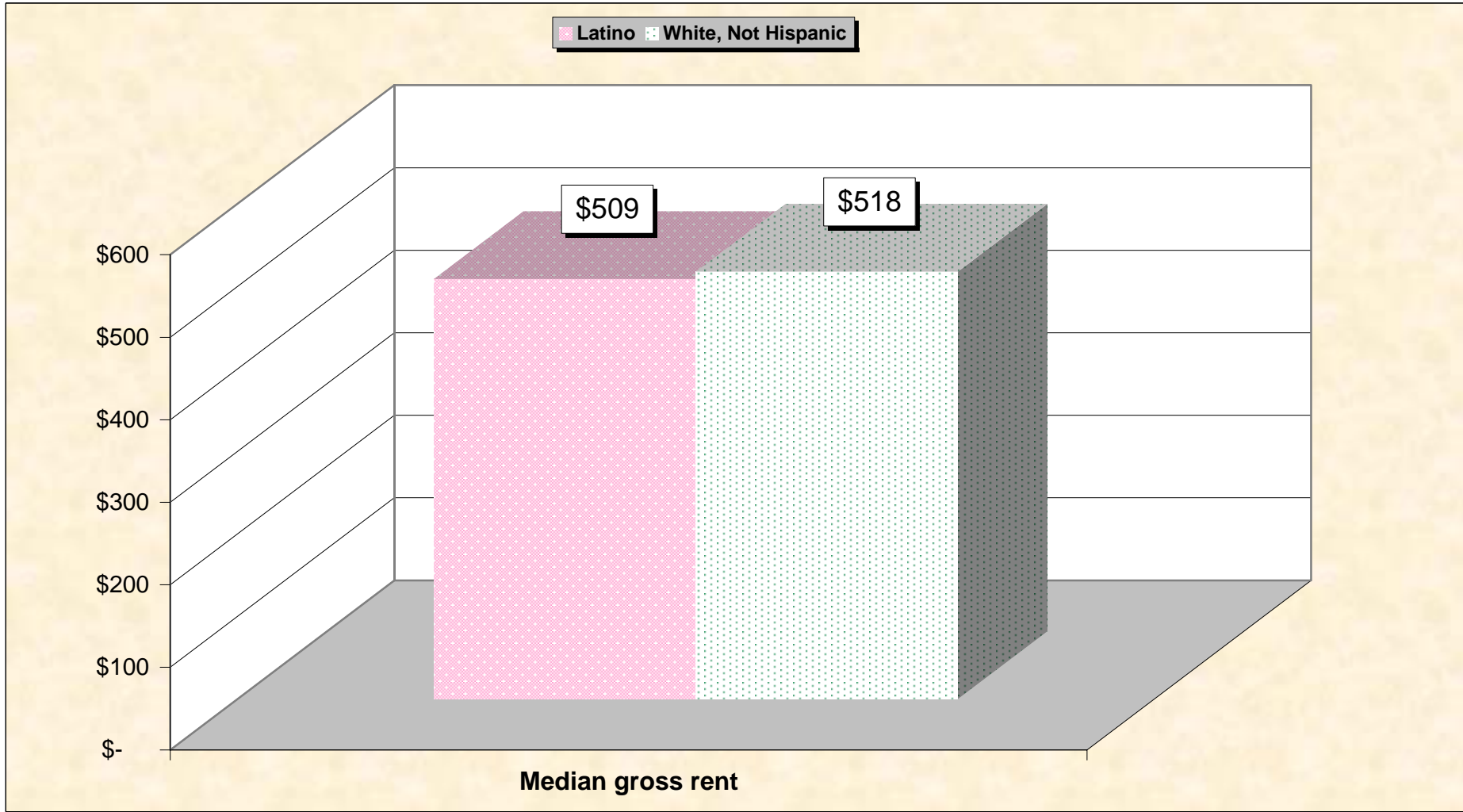
# Chart 16 -- Gross Rent as a Percentage of Household Income in 1999

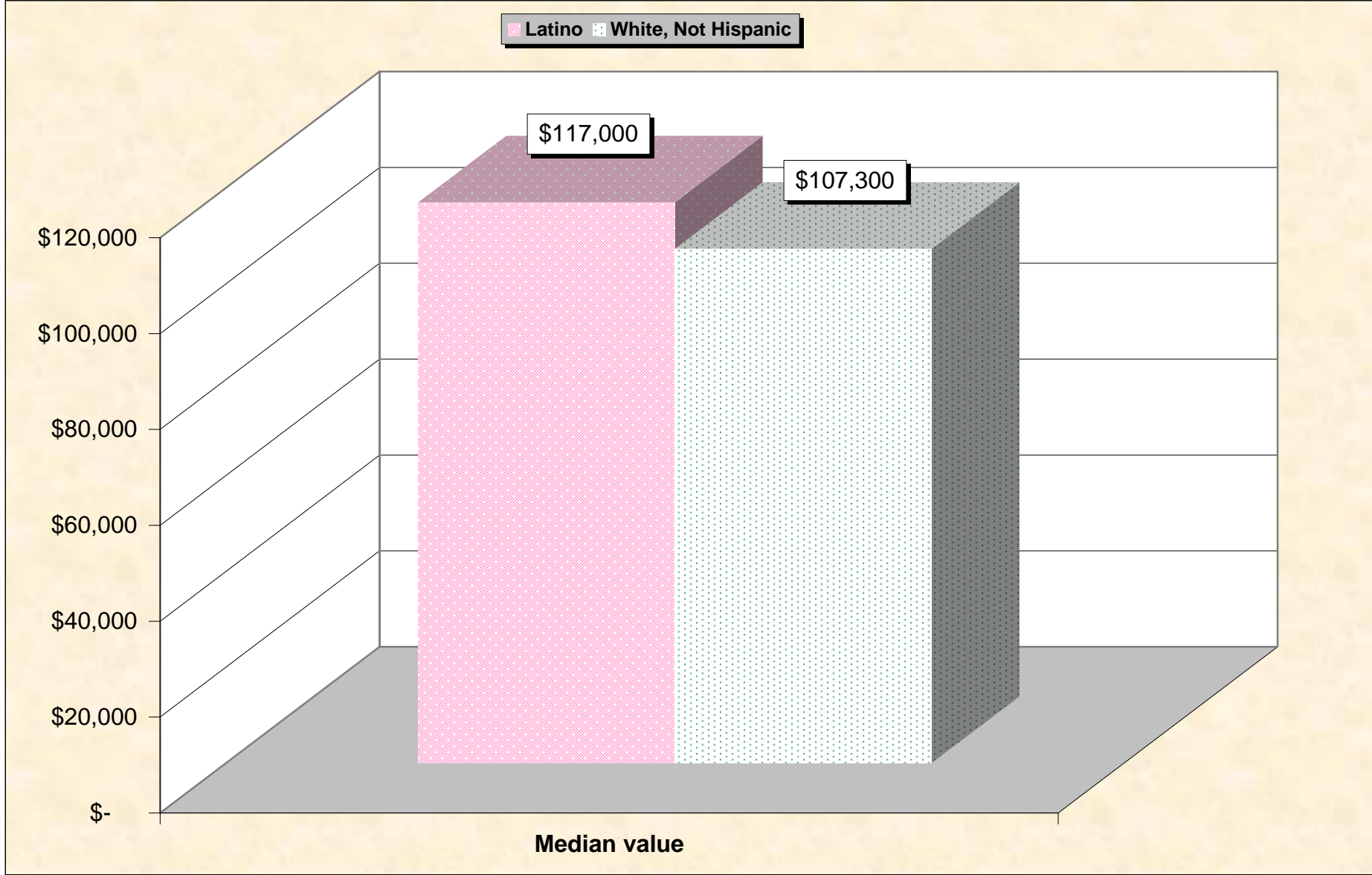
